The ornamental design for a jug, as shown and described.

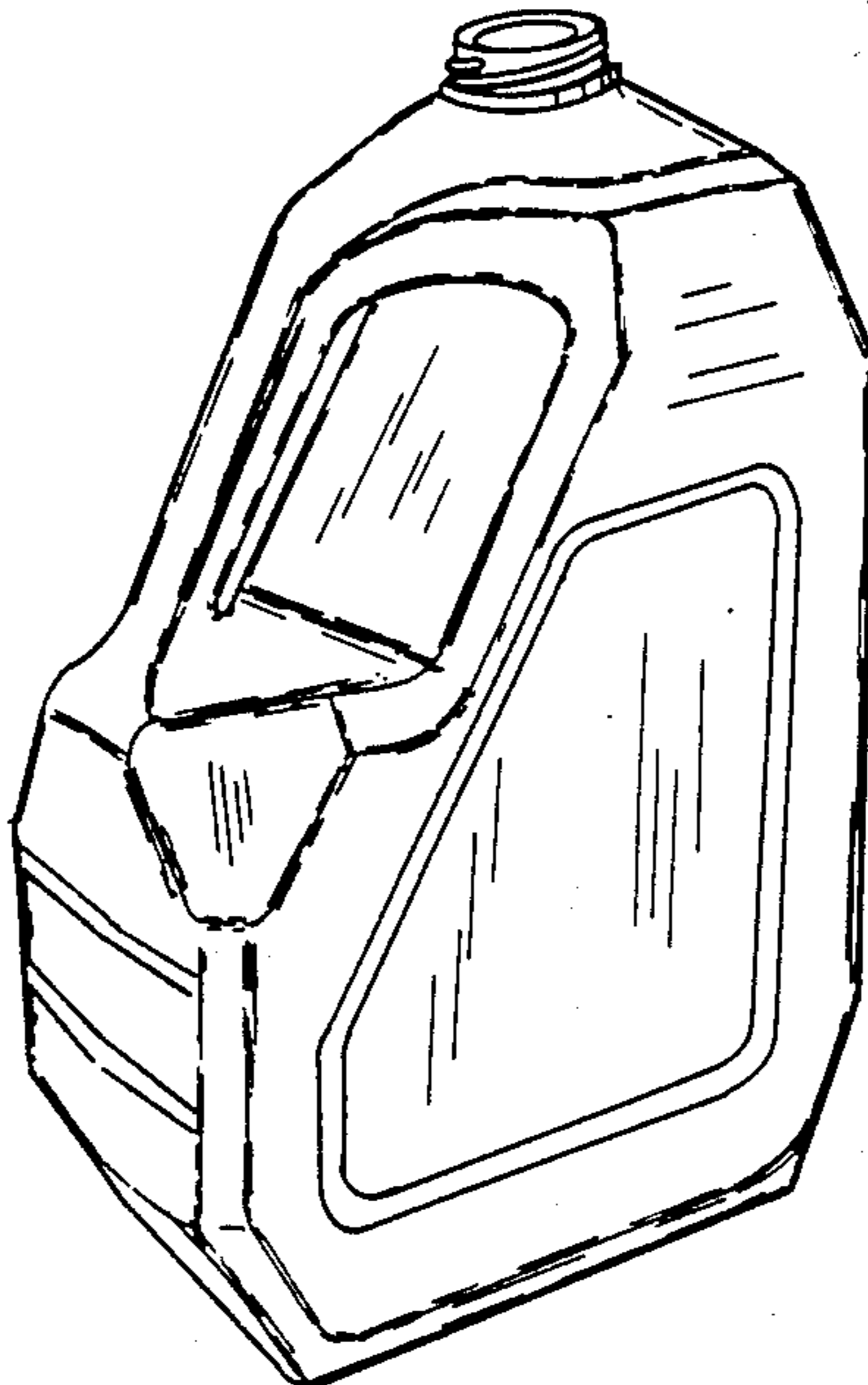
DESCRIPTION

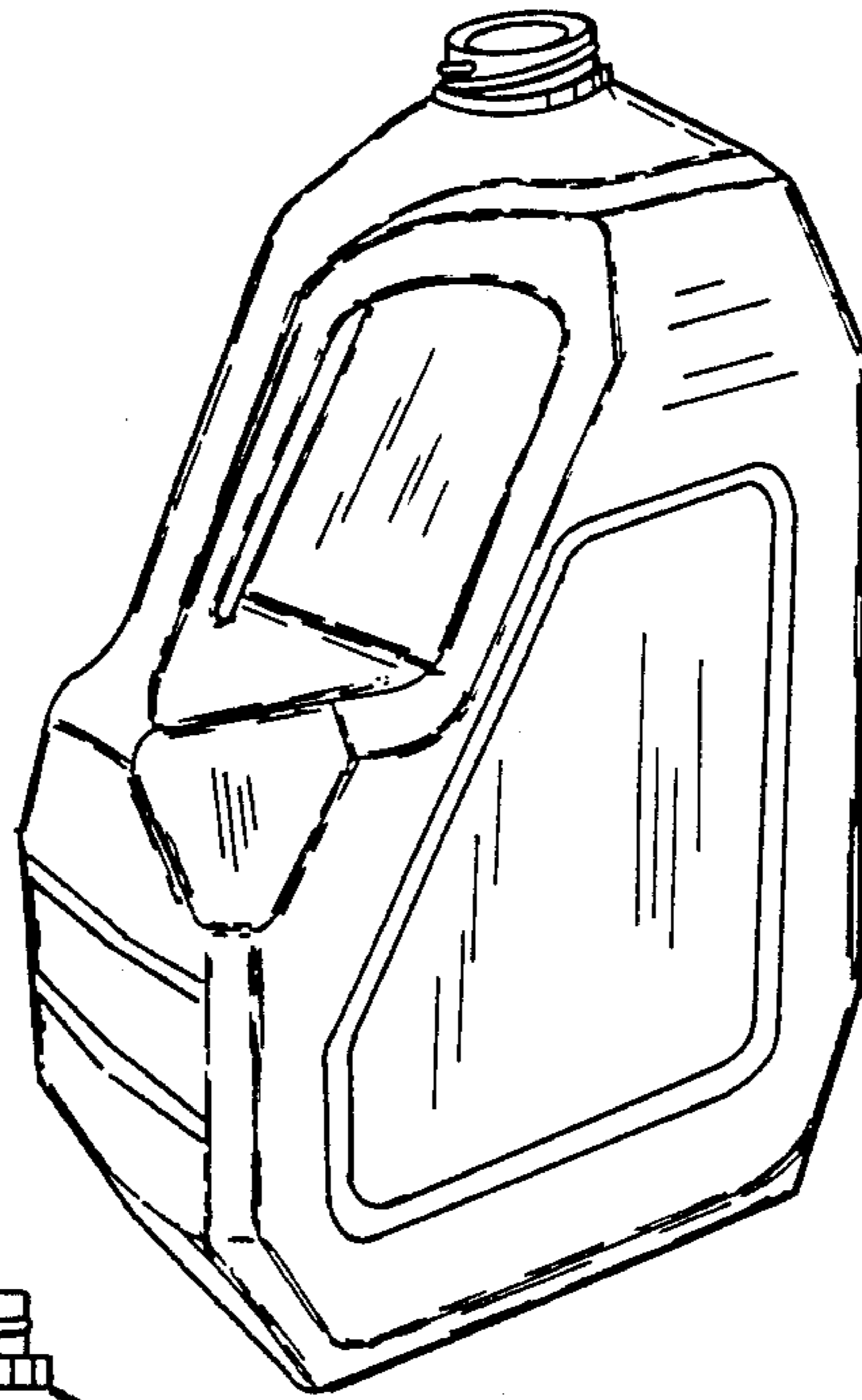

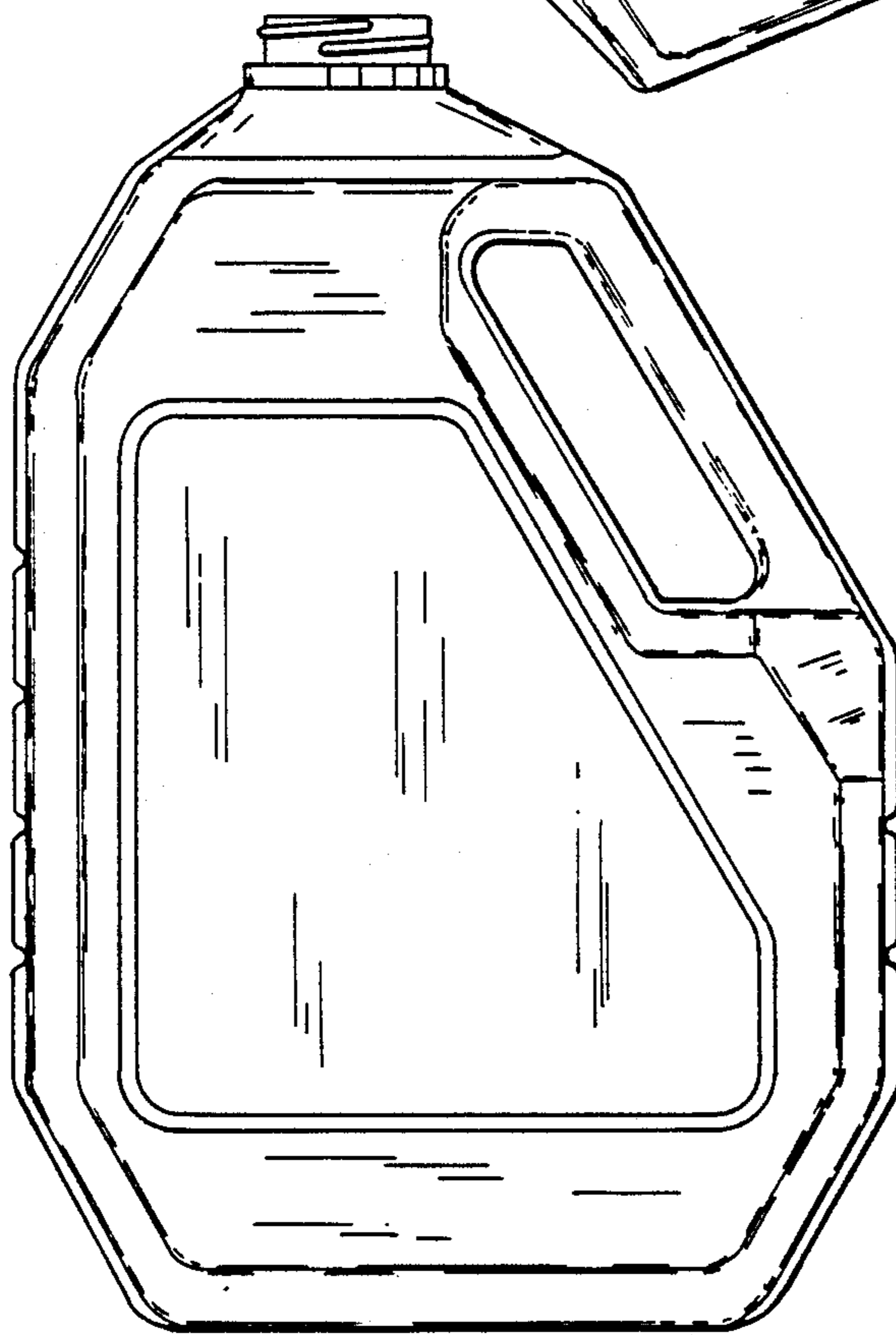

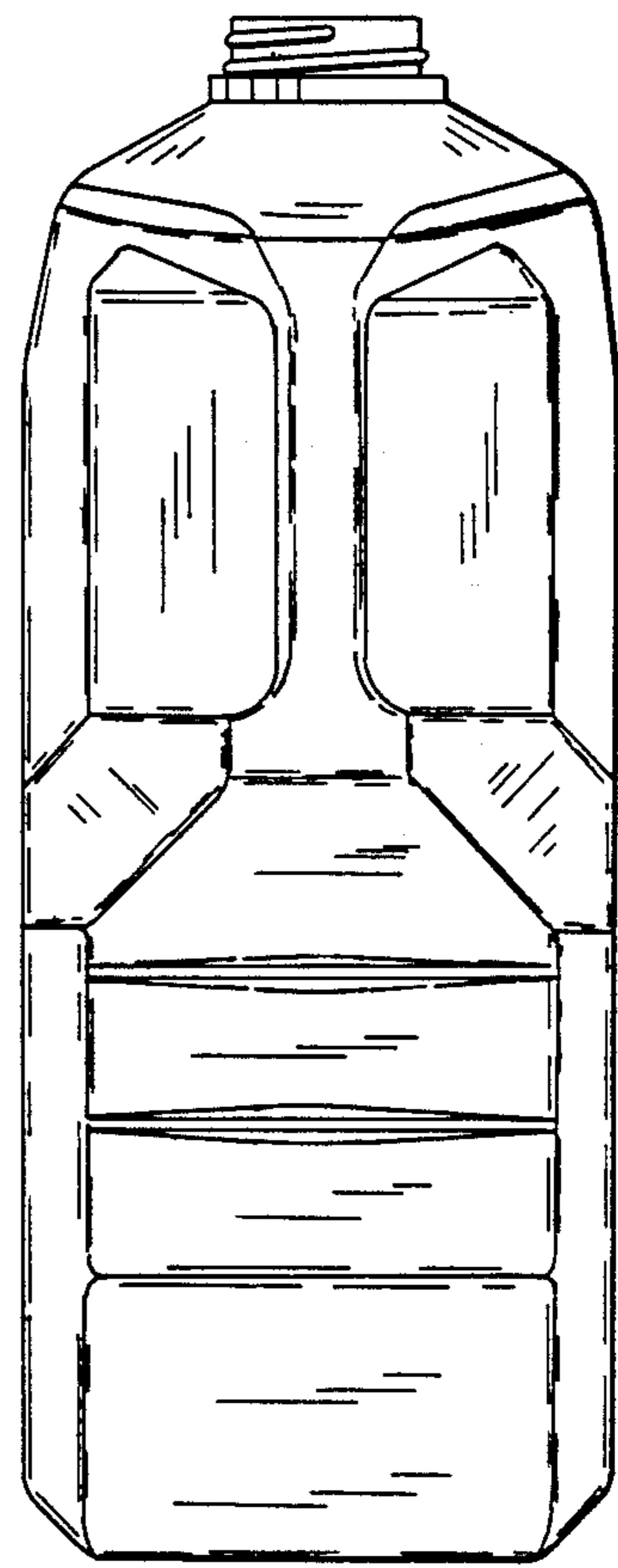

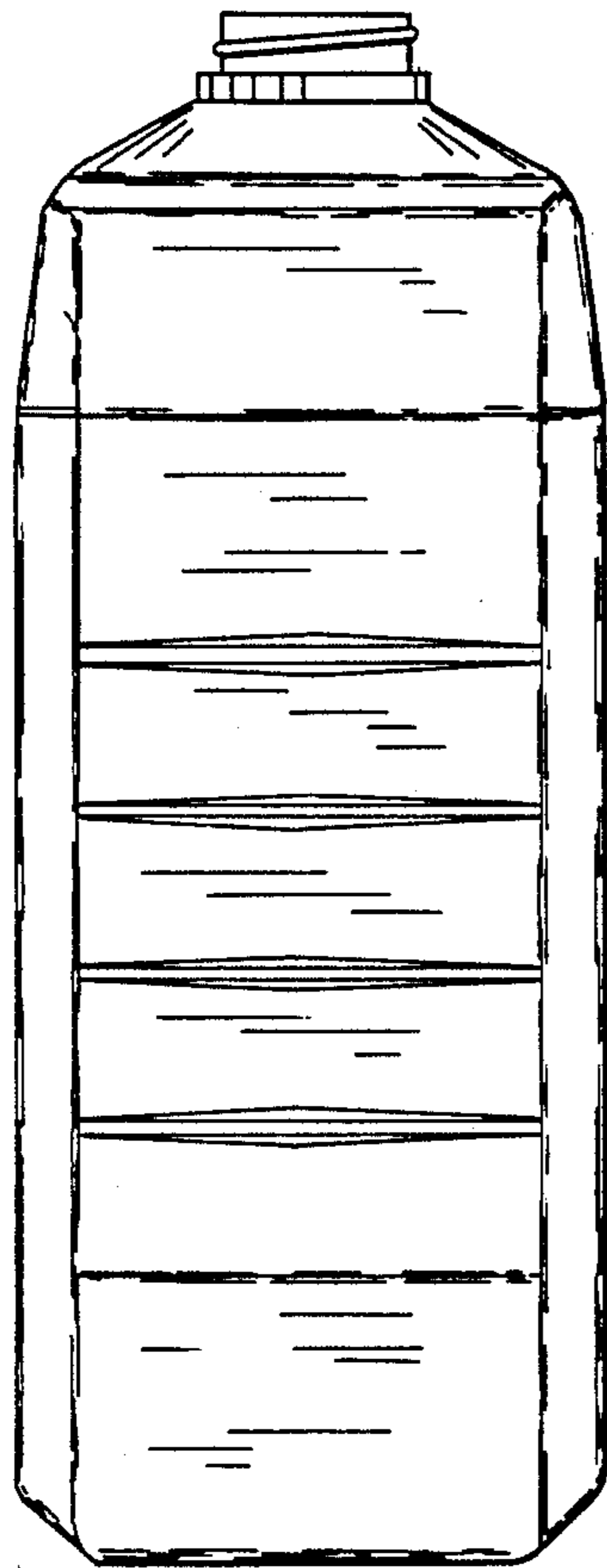

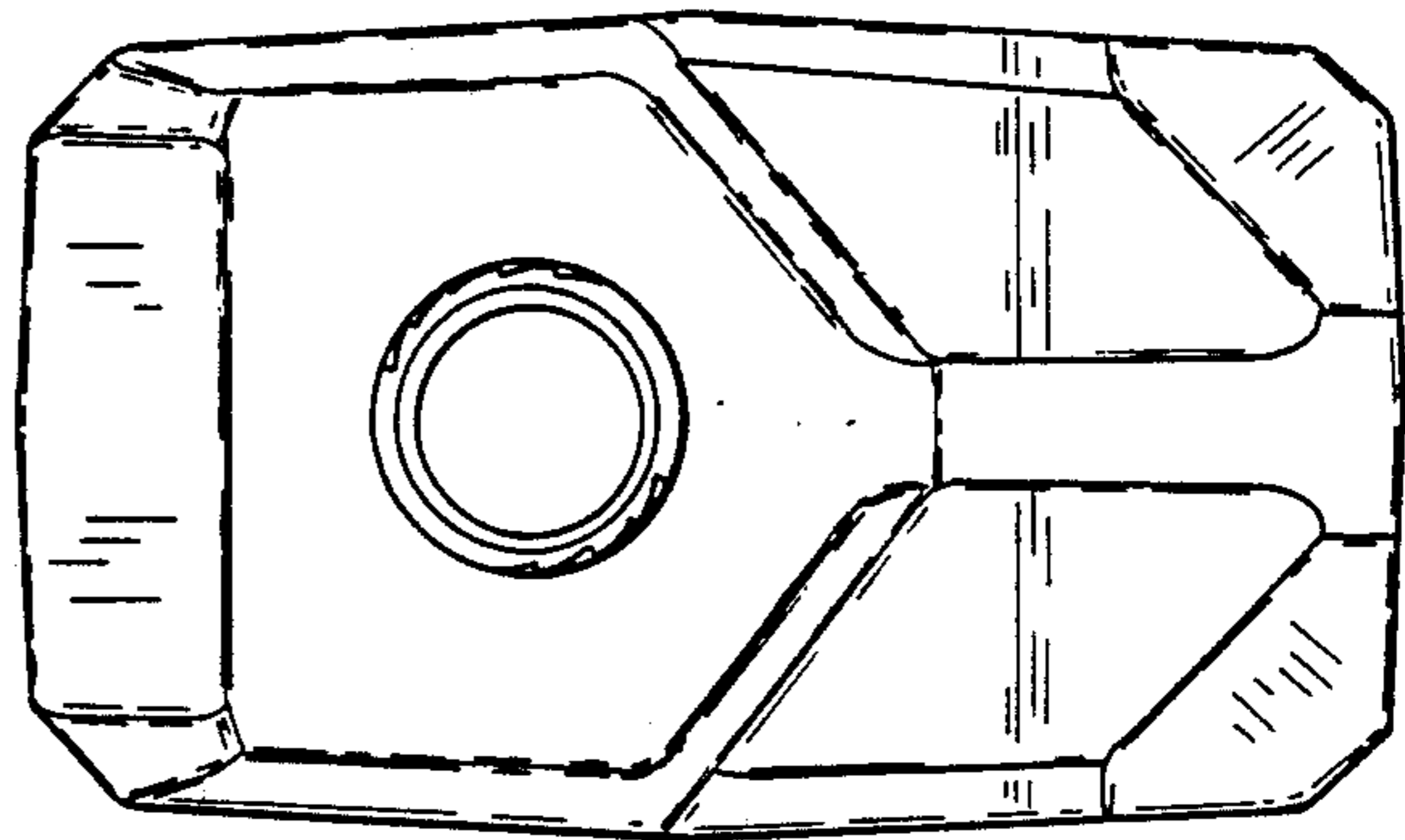

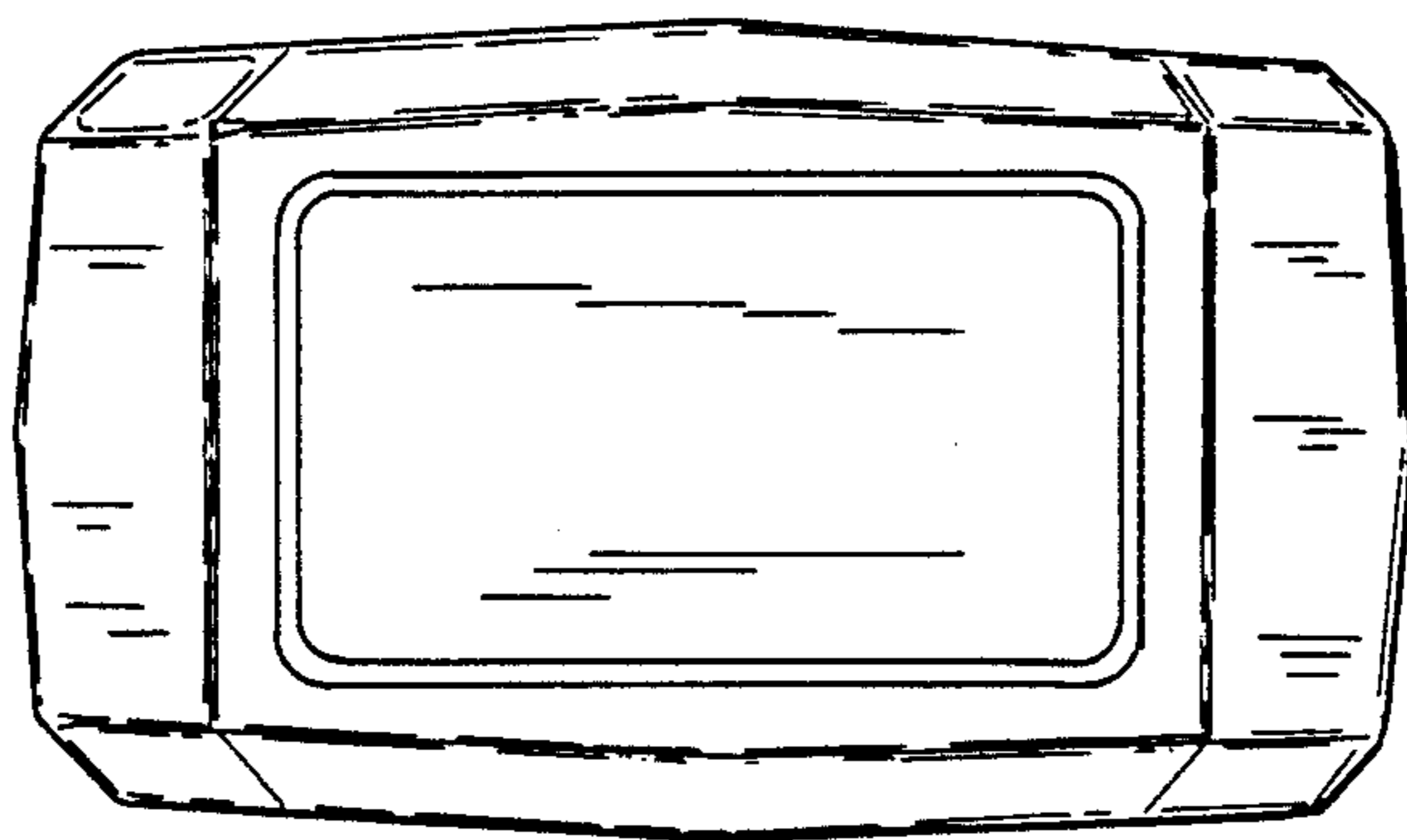
