DESCRIPTION

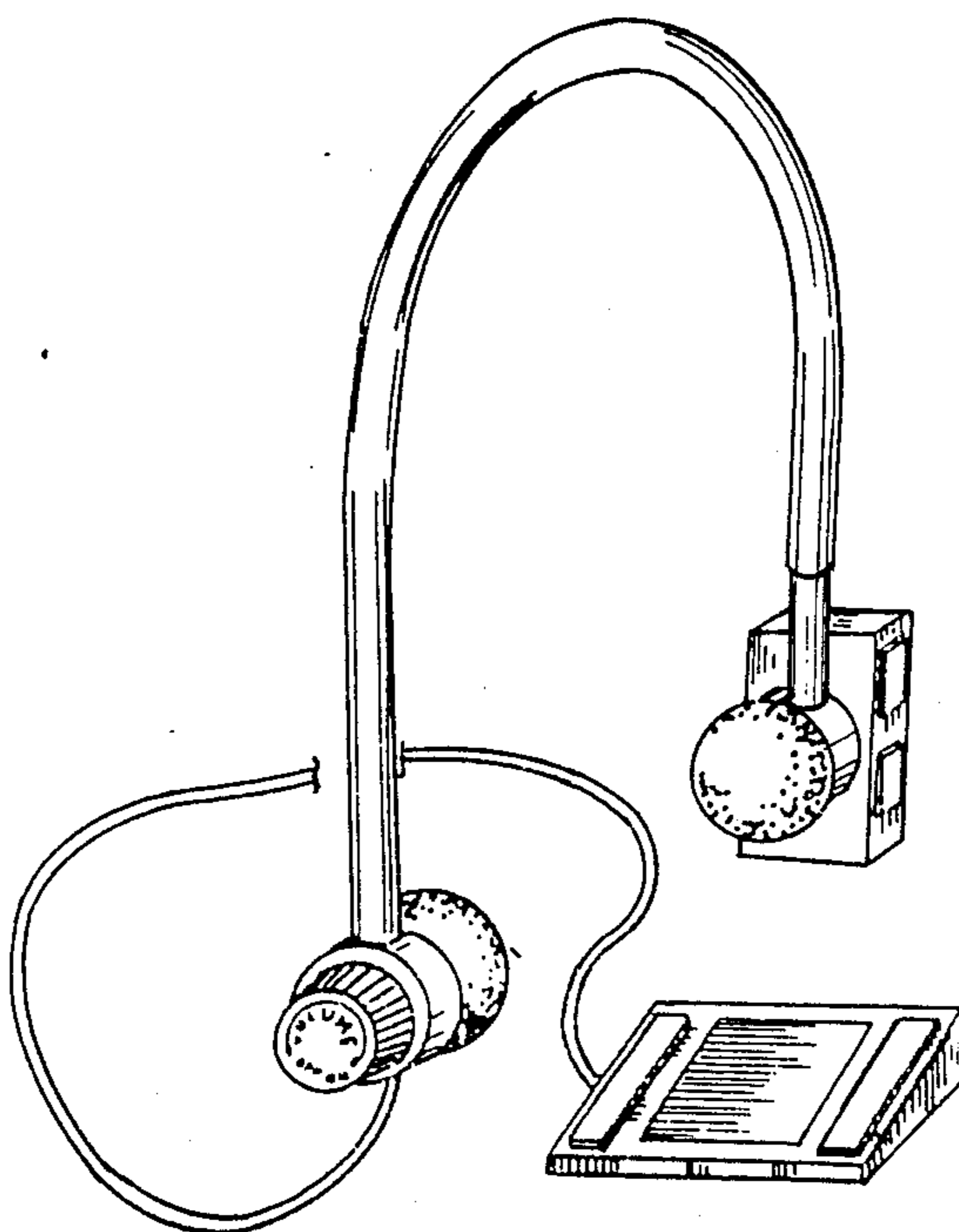
FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side prospective view of a microcassette player/transcriber showing our new design, the footpedal is omitted for ease of illustration; FIG. 2 is a top, front and left side prospective view of the headset and a top, front and right side prospective view of the footpedal thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is top, rear and right side prospective view of the headset and a top, rear and left side prospective view of the footpedal thereof;

FIG. 5 is a prospective view thereof.

The broken line showing in FIG. 5 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



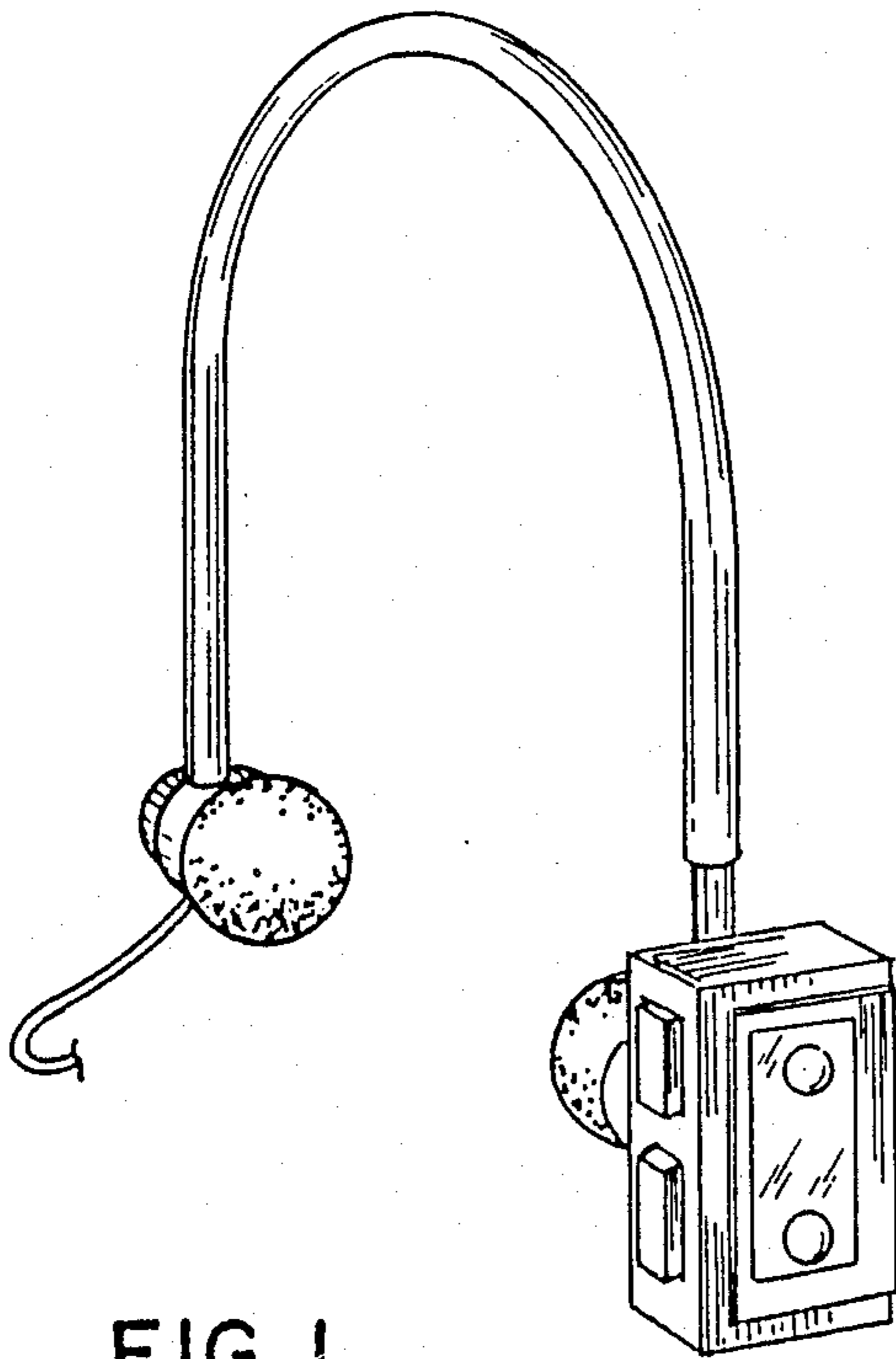

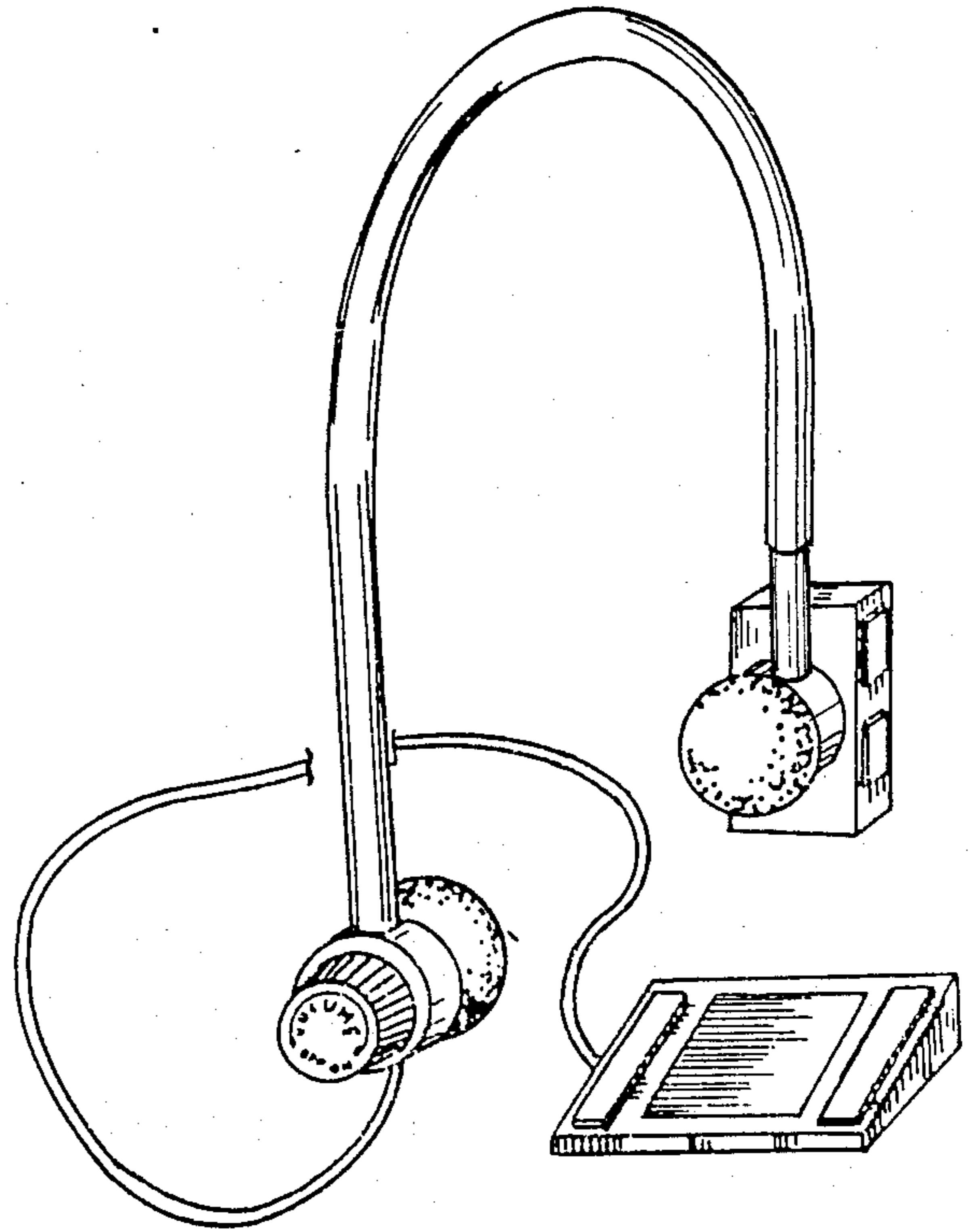

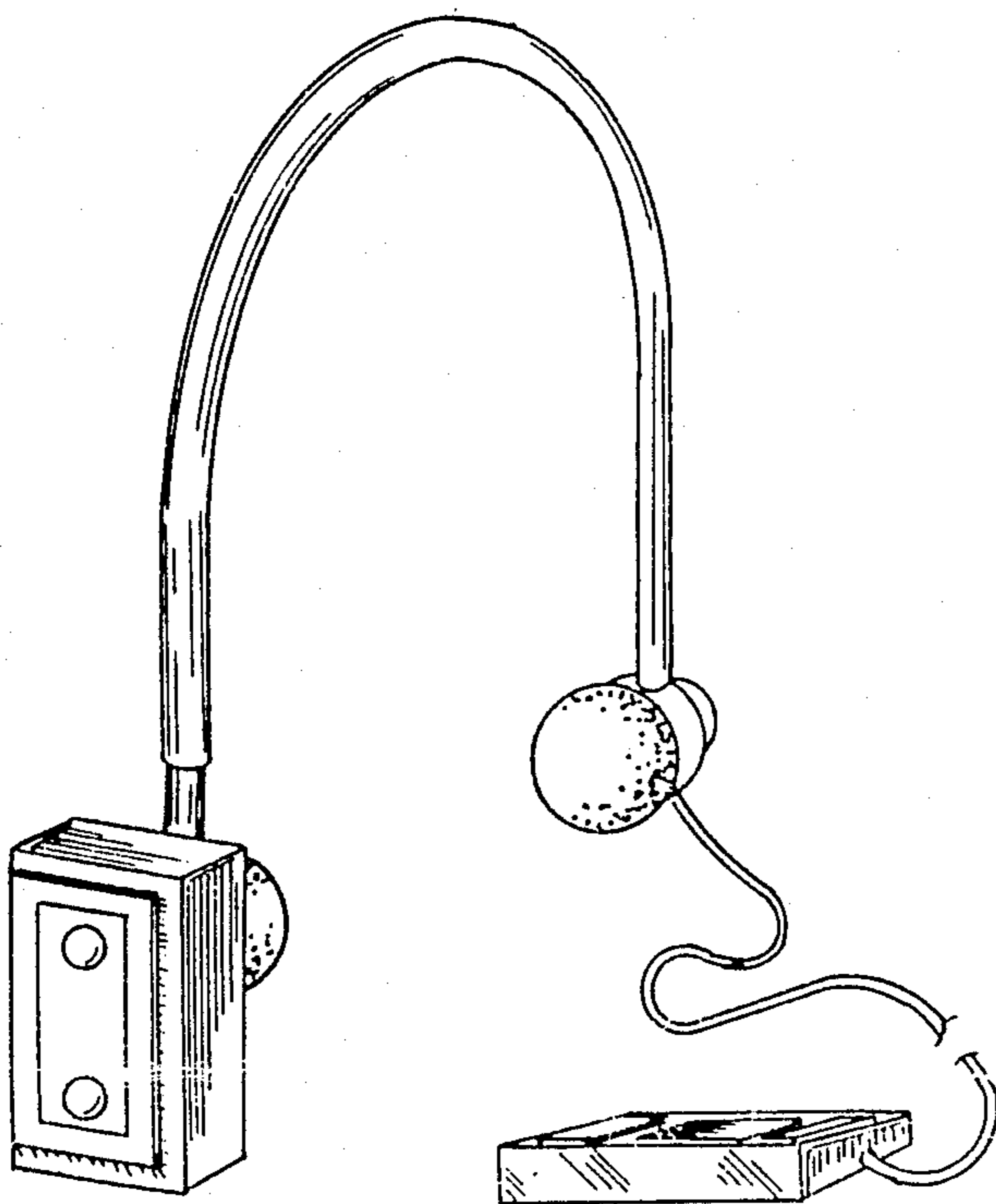

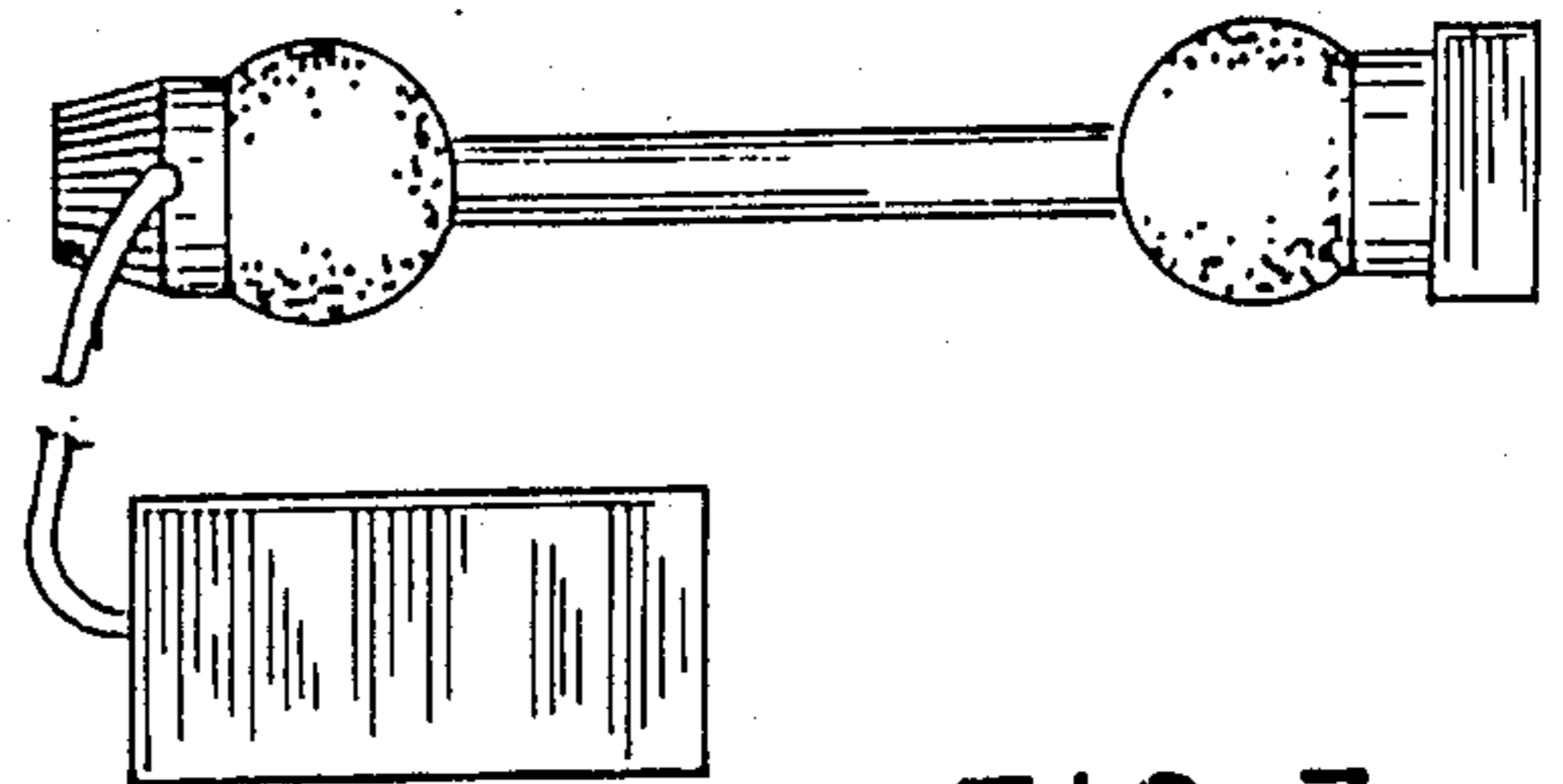
