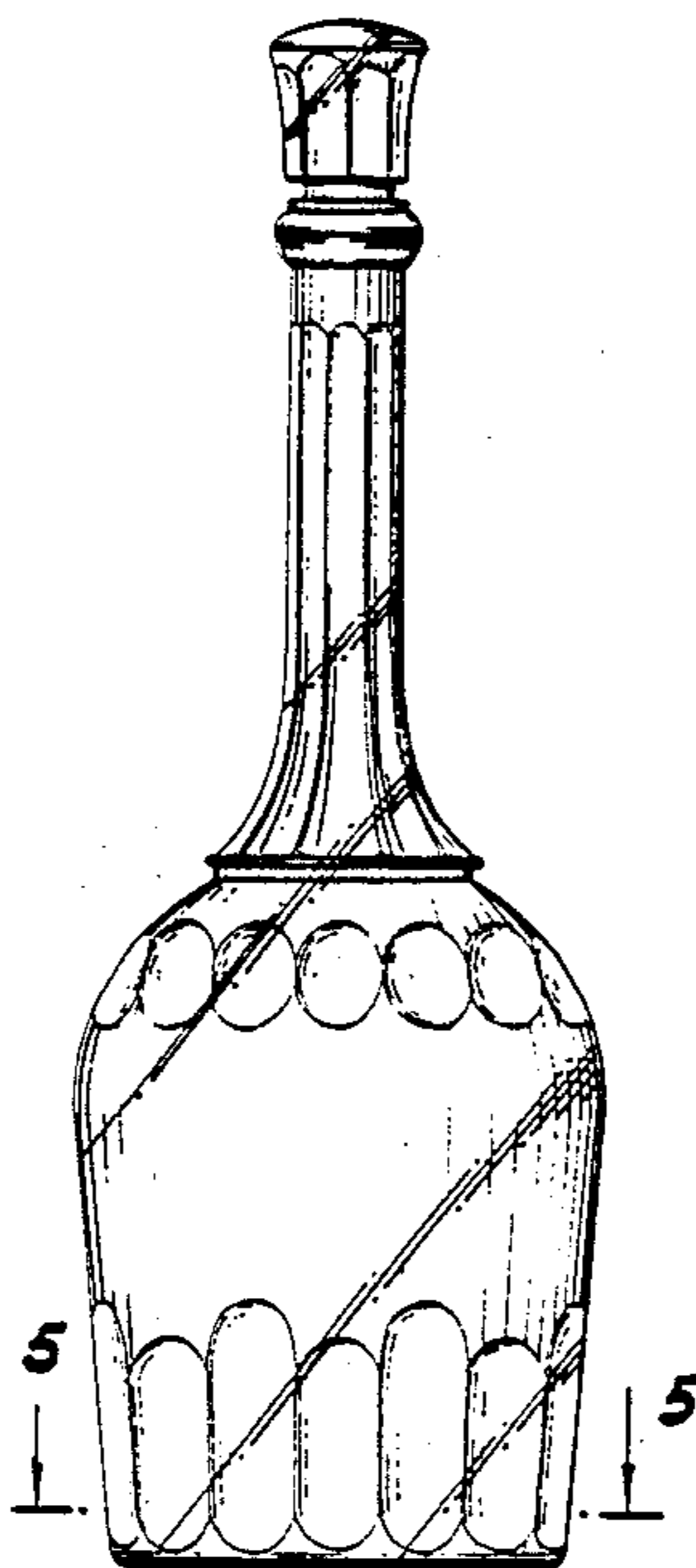

The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a bottle showing my new design, the rear elevation being a mirror image thereof. FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along 5-5 of FIG. 1.



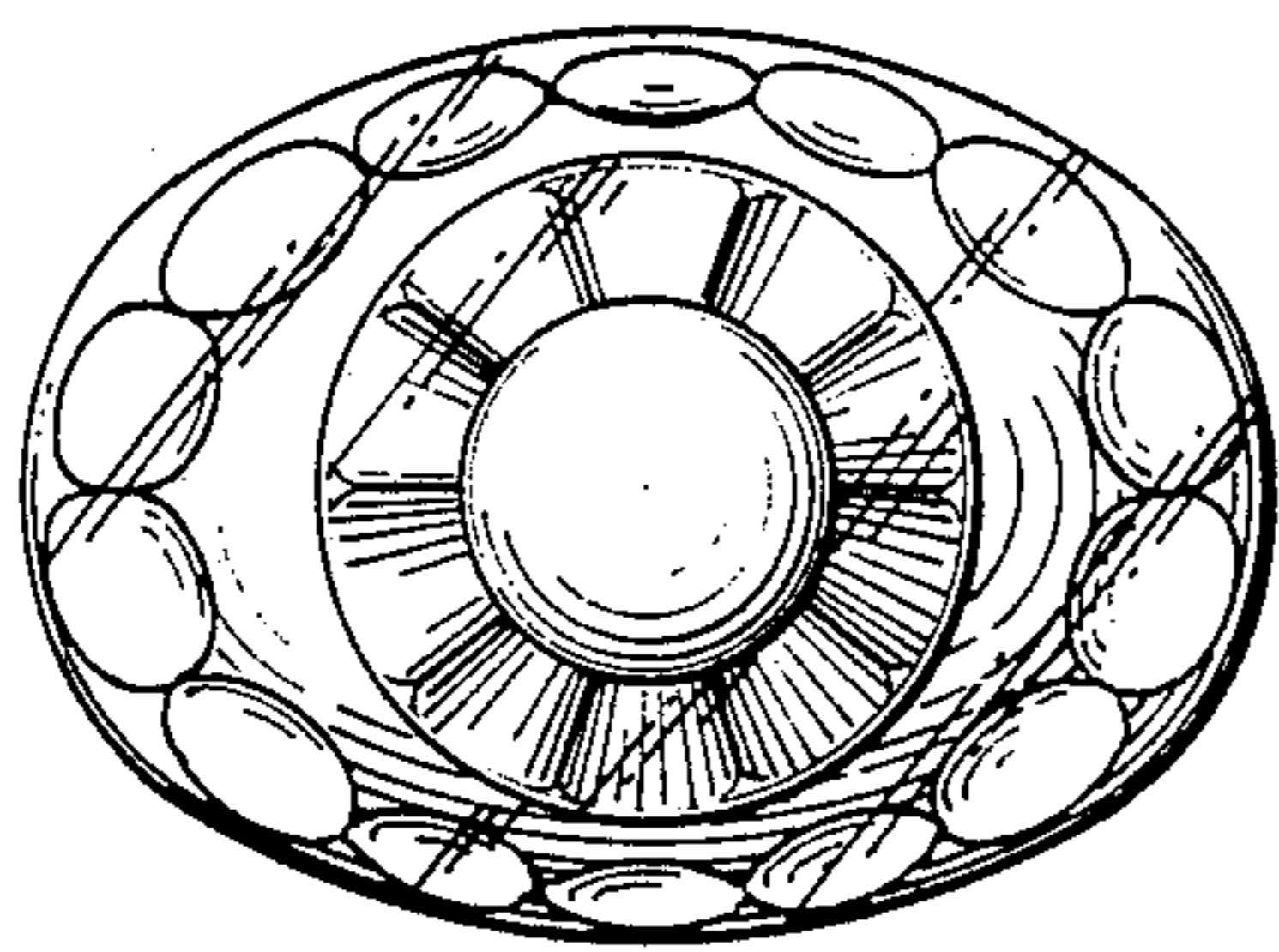

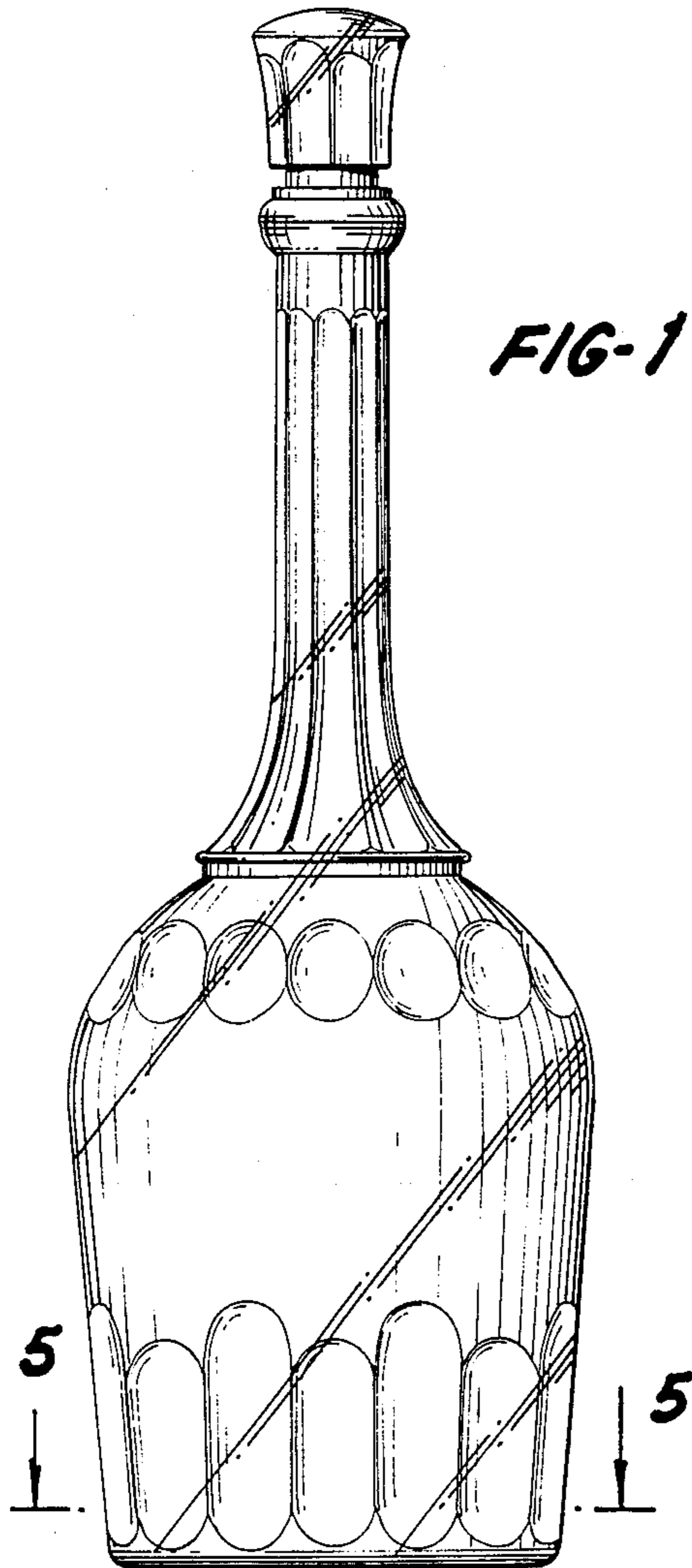

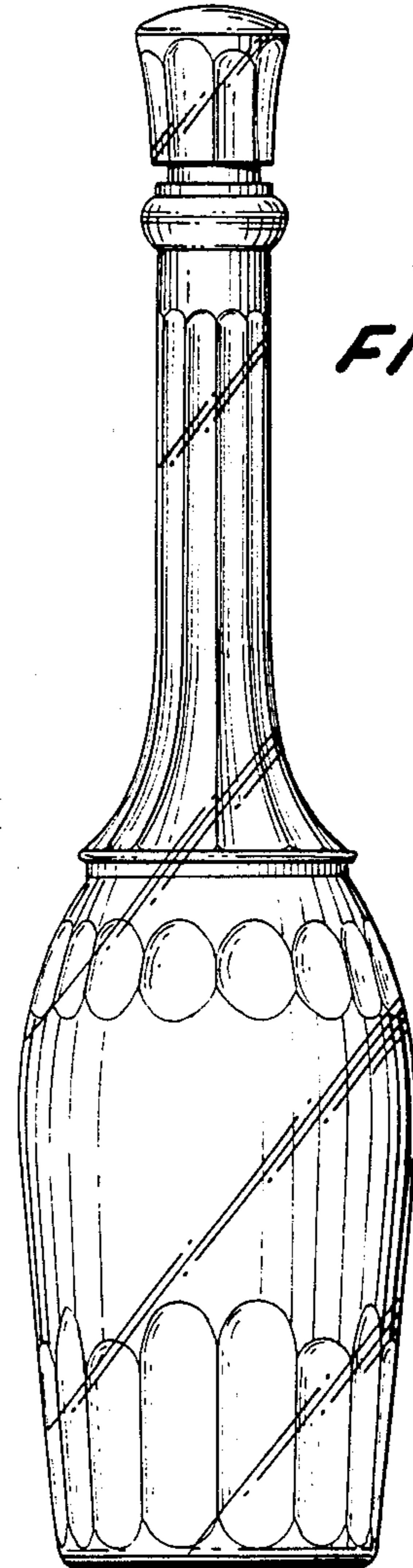

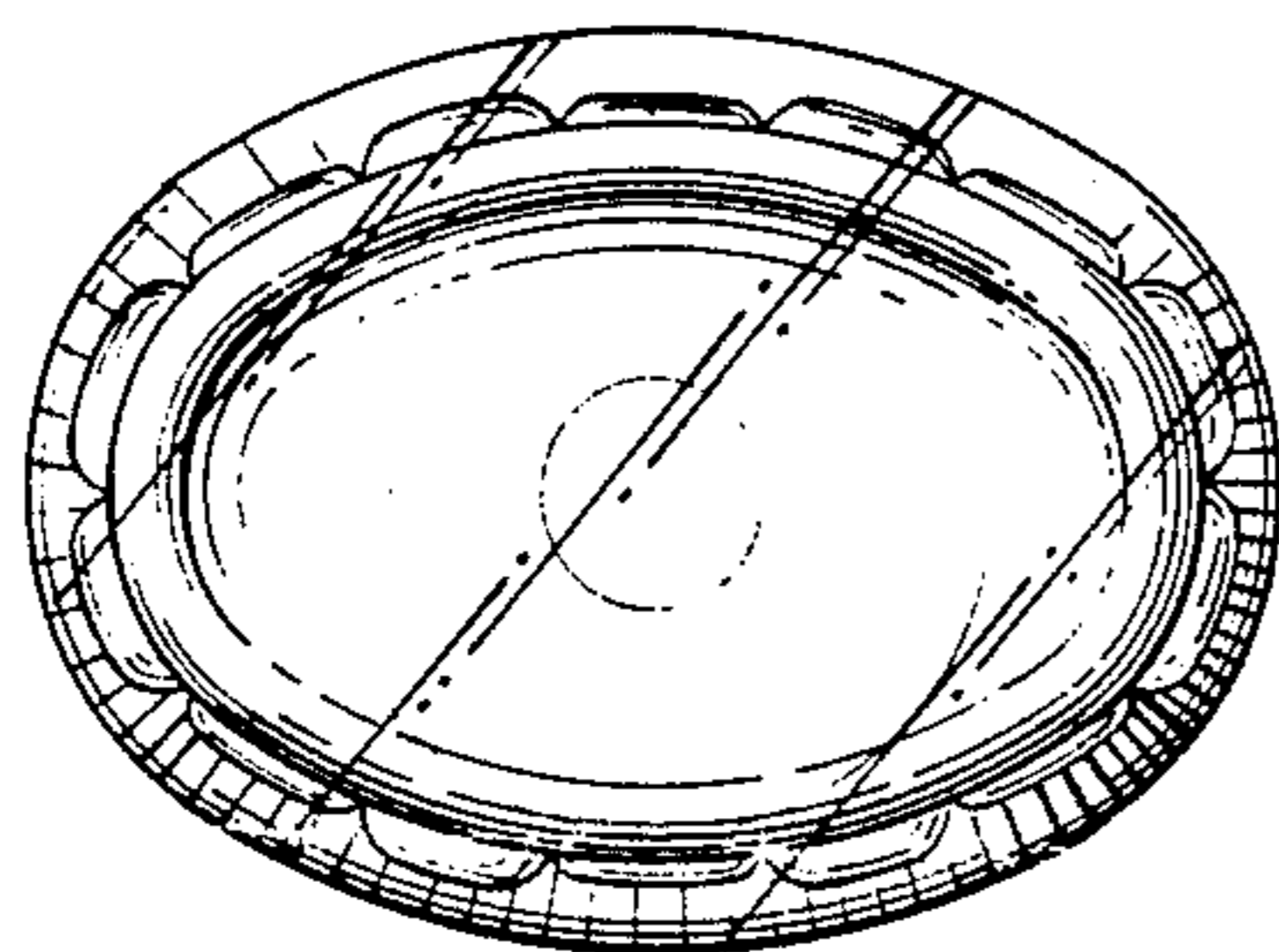

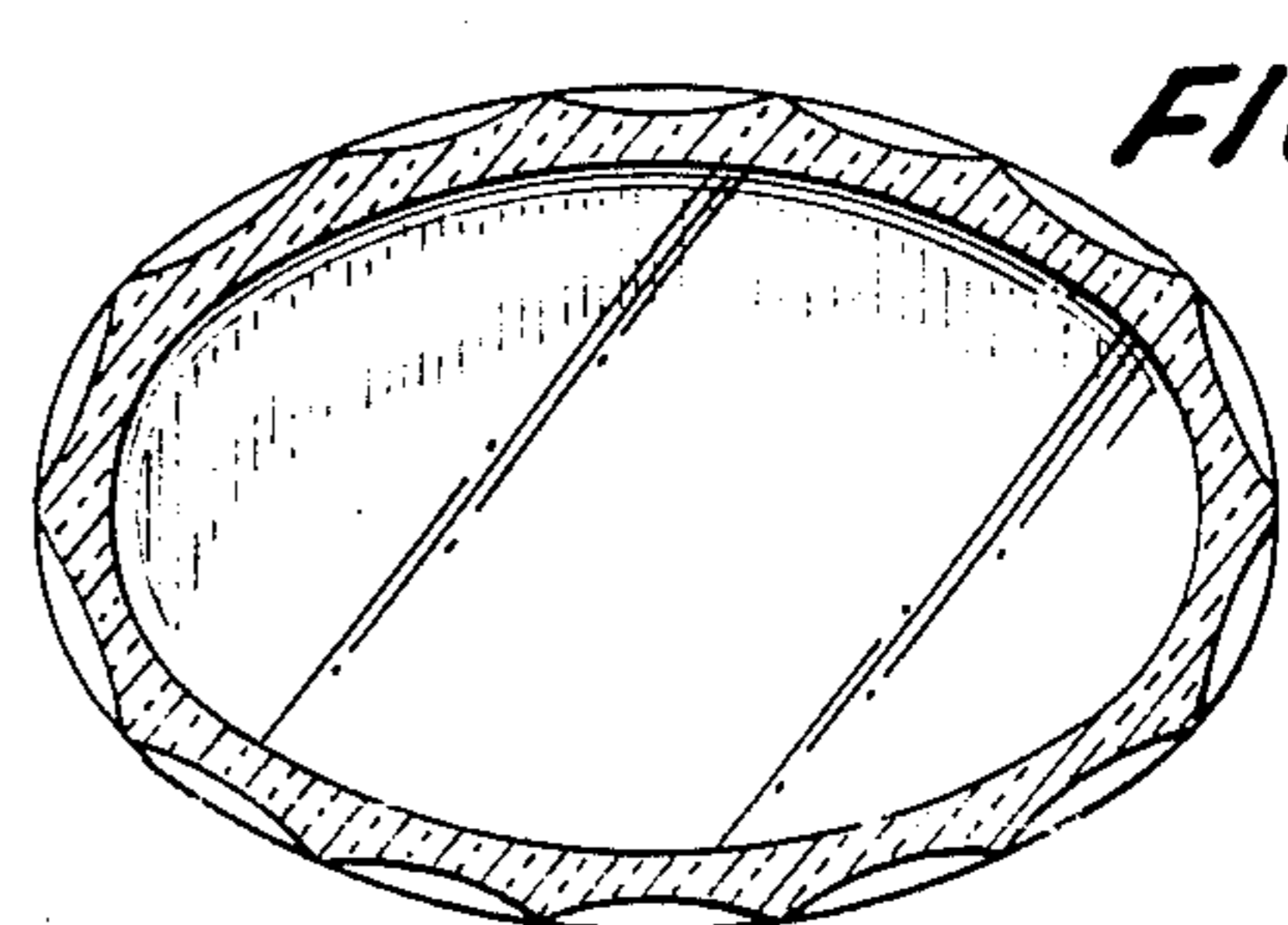
