**DESCRIPTION**

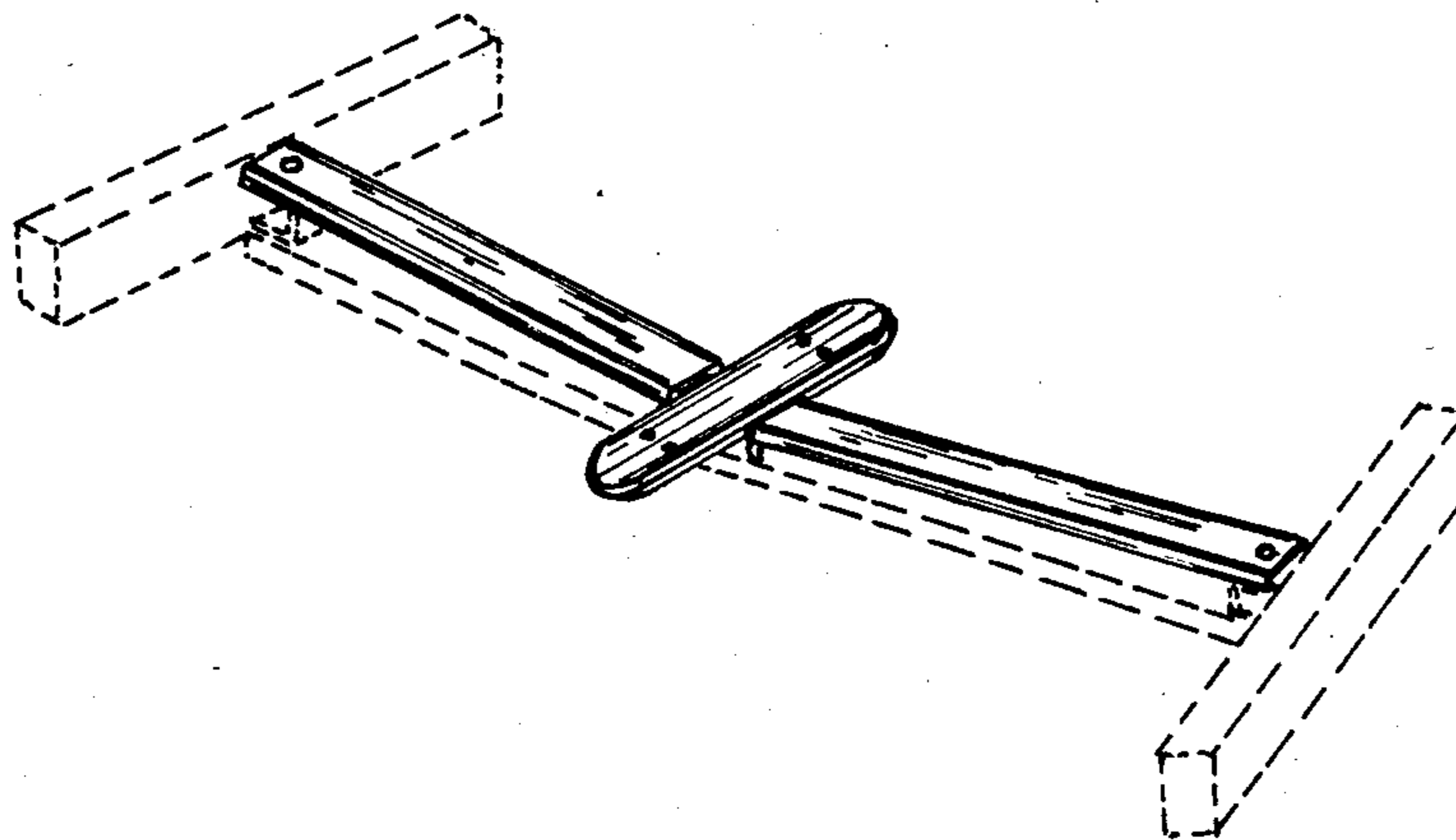

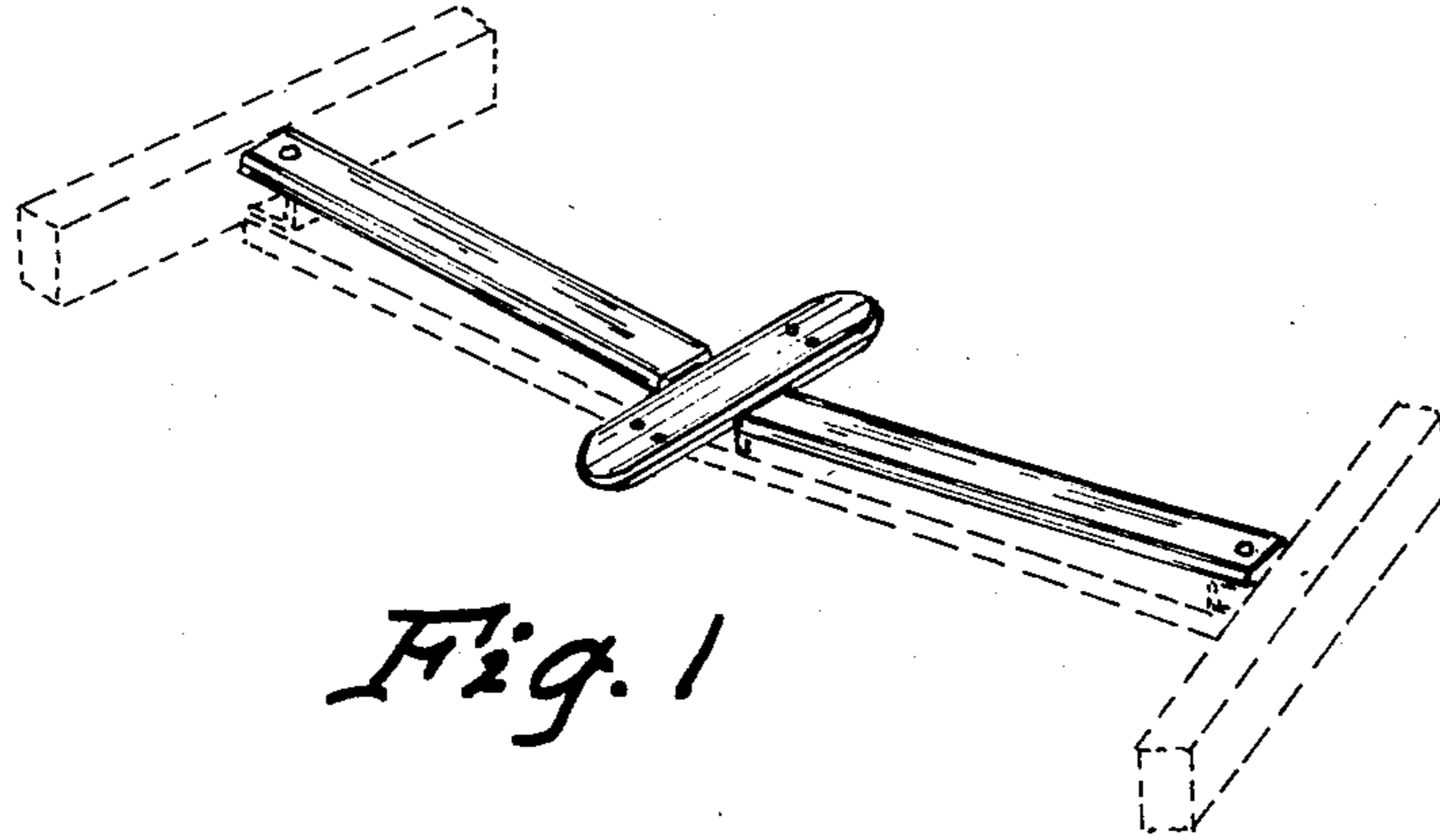
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image of that shown;

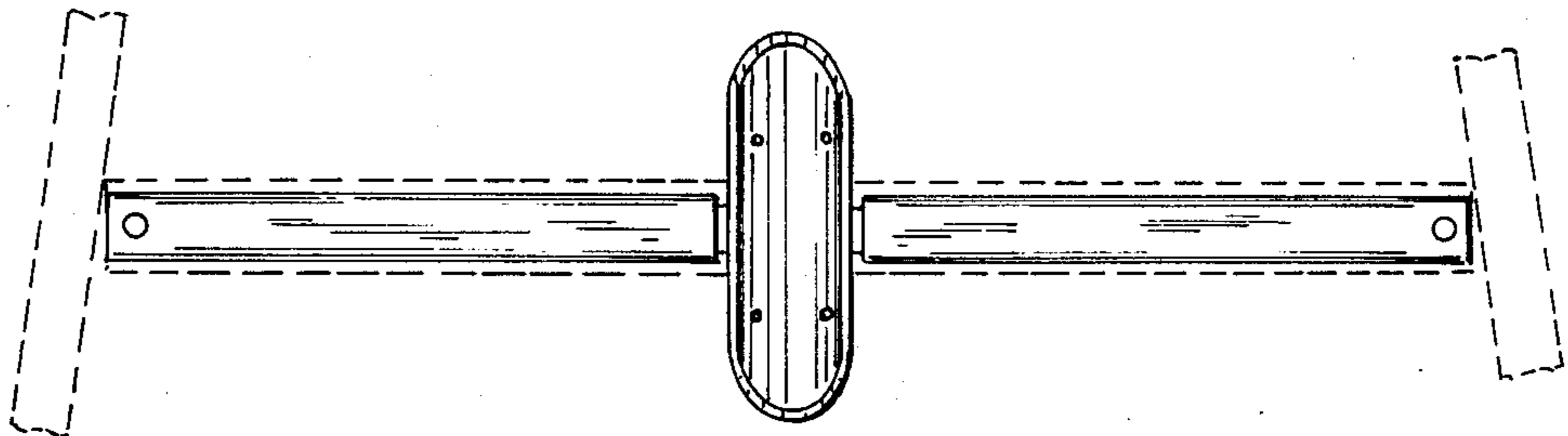
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 3.

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view as taken along the line 5—5 in FIG. 3.

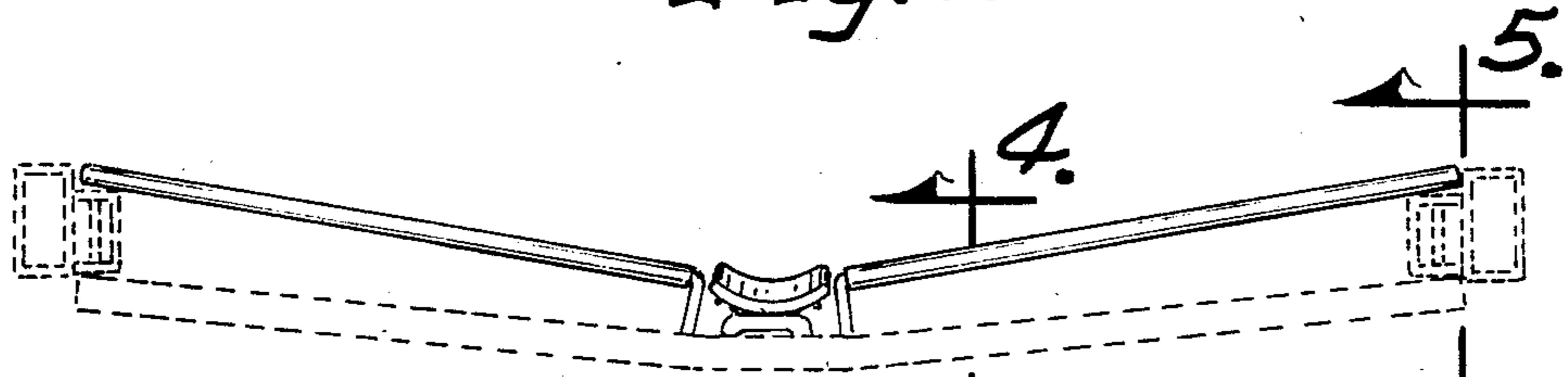




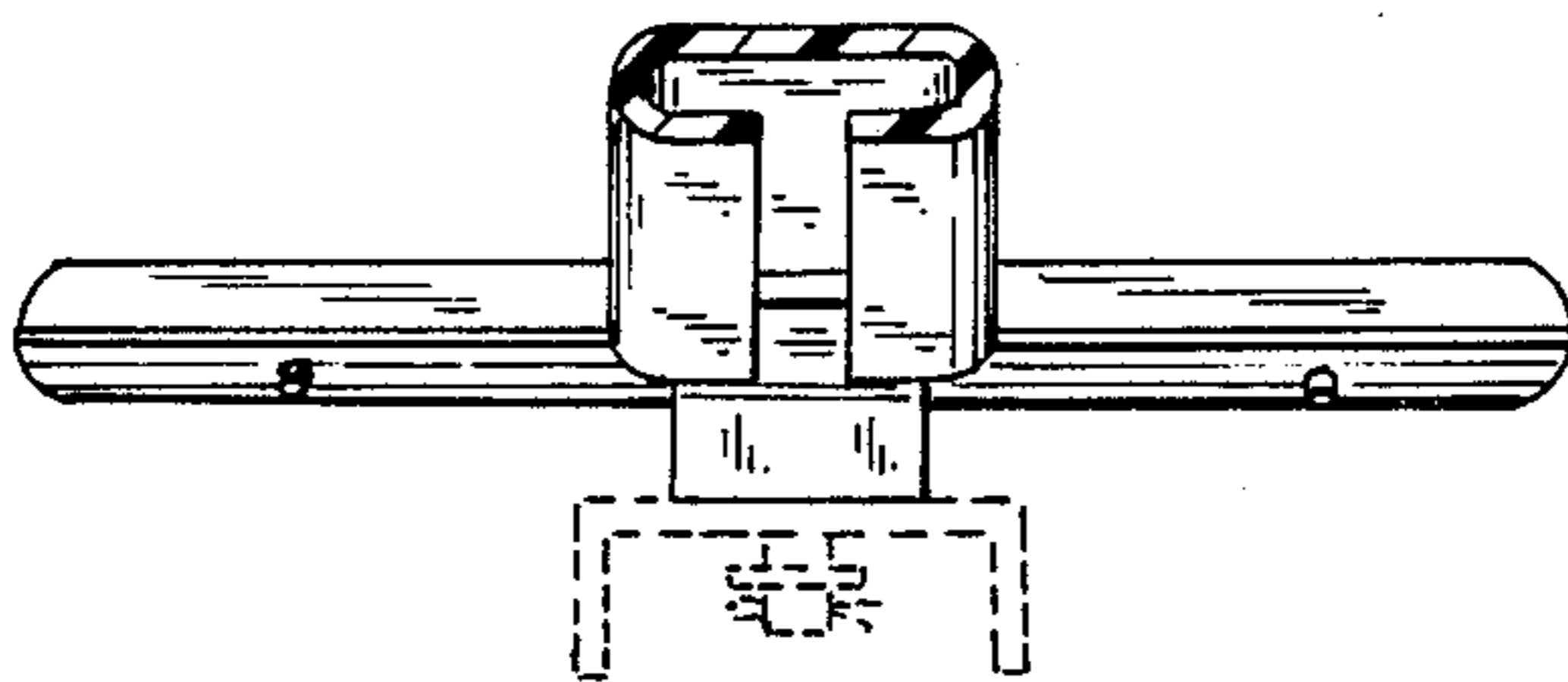

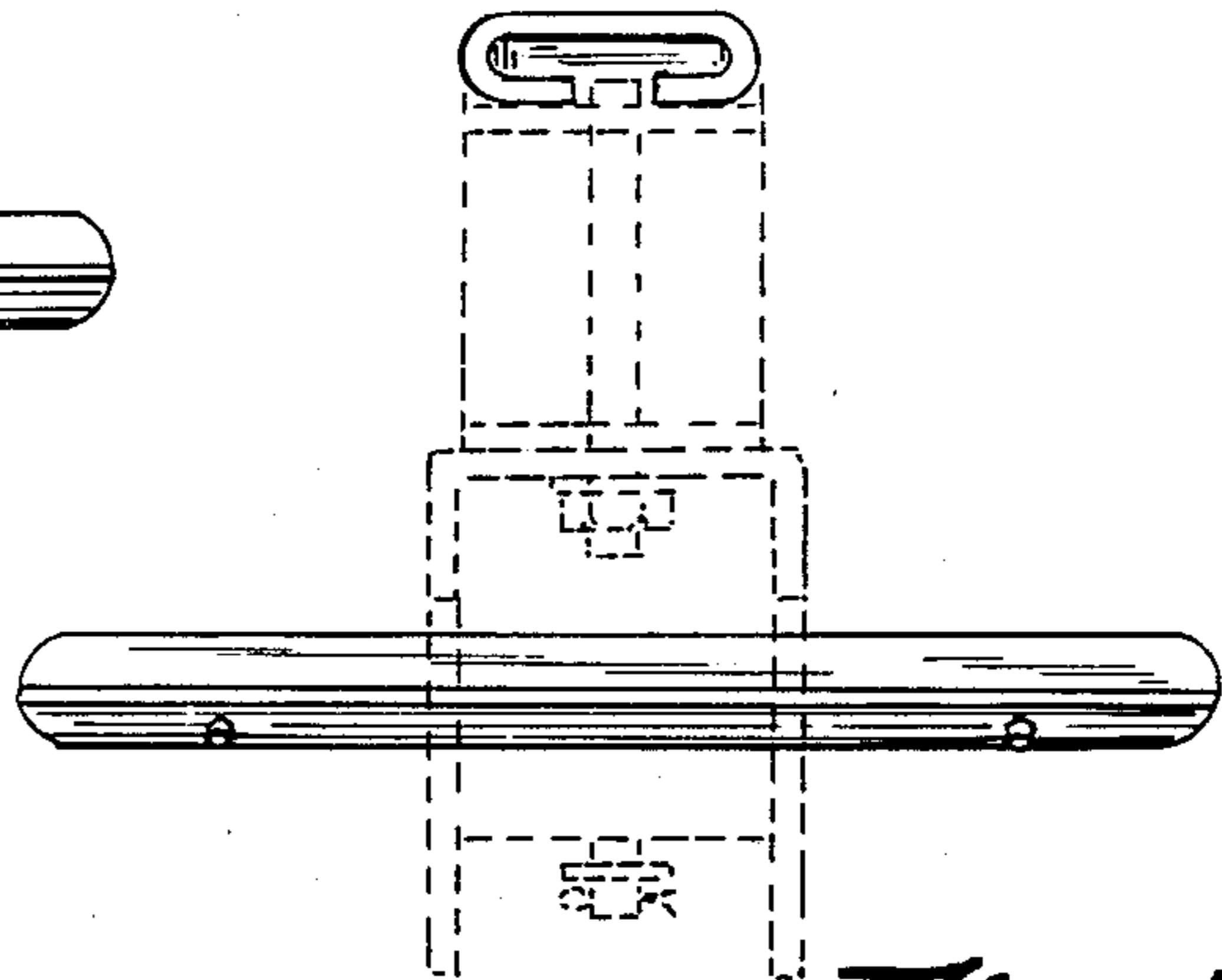
