The ornamental design for a combined boat trailer light bracket and guide post support, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined boat trailer light bracket and guide post support showing my new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

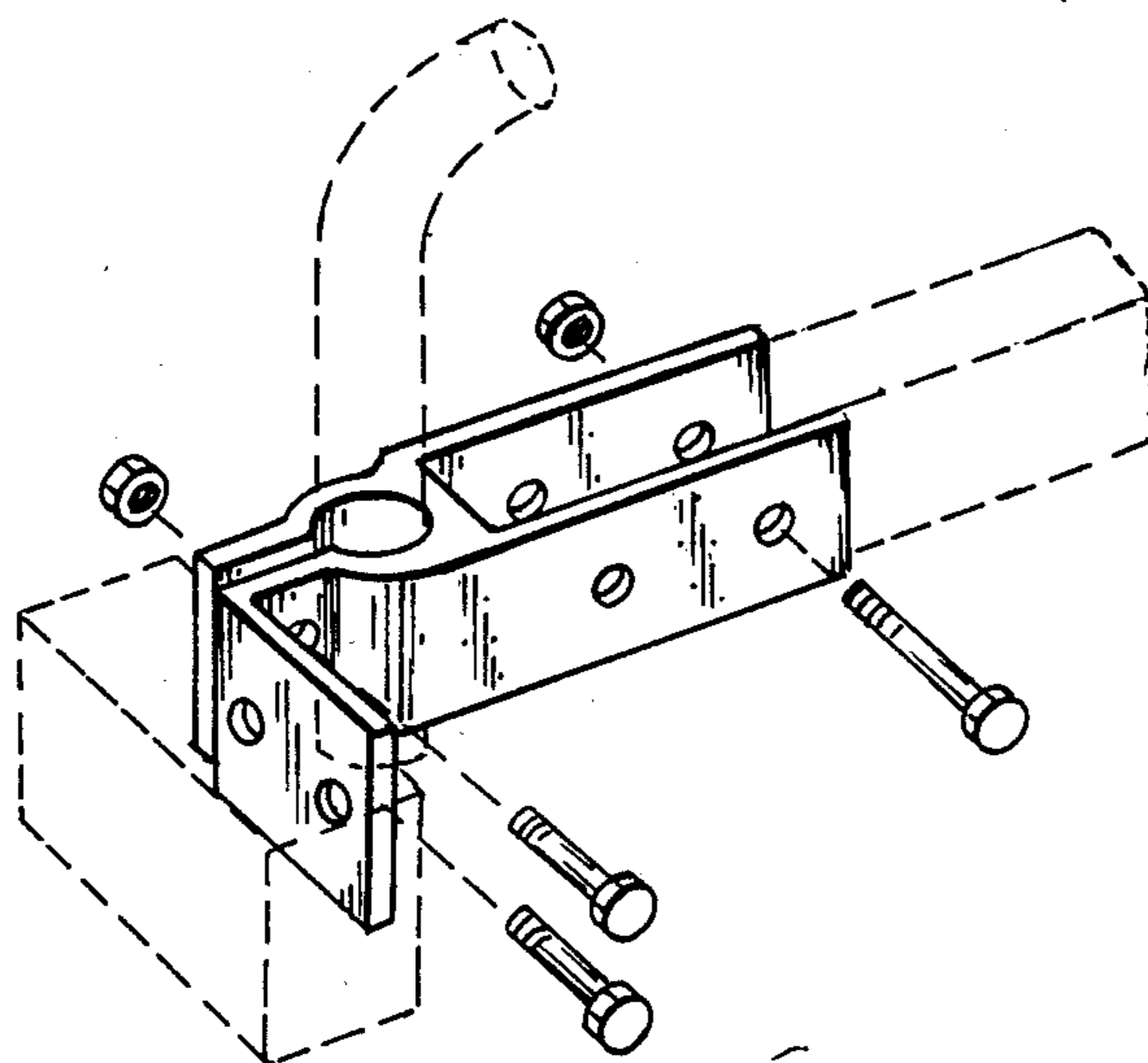
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view is a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a side elevation view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 4; and

FIG. 6 is a side elevation view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 3.



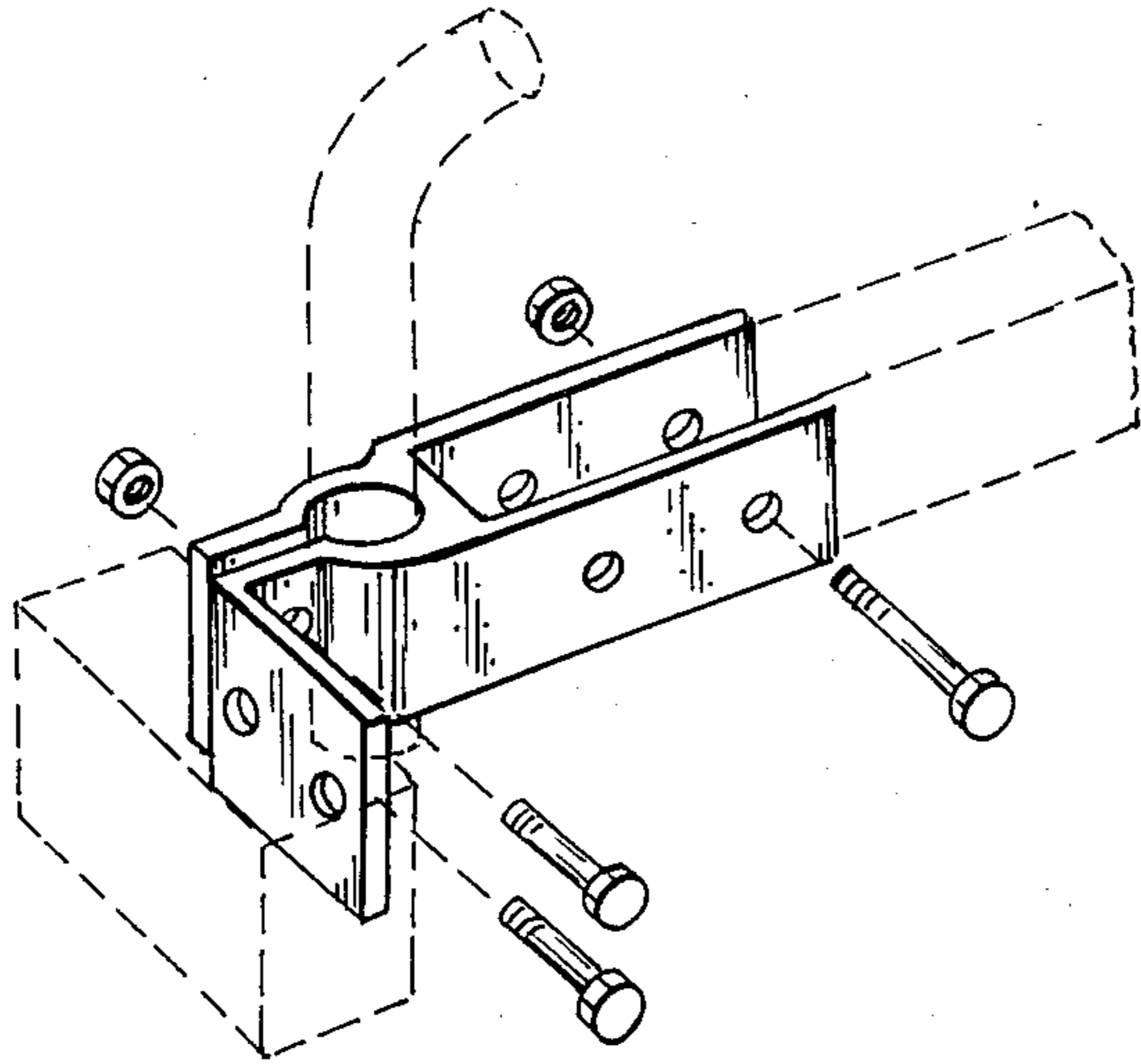

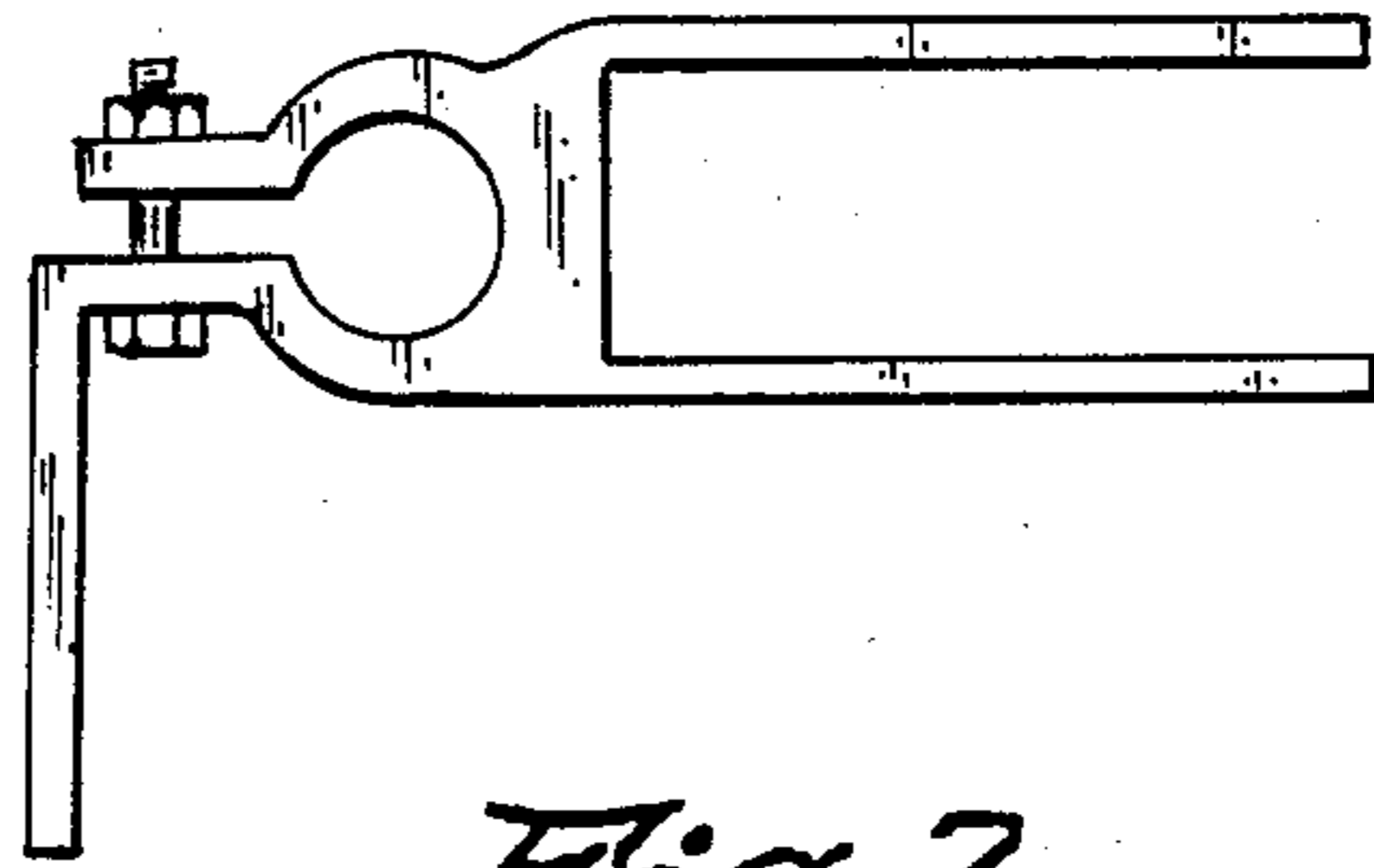

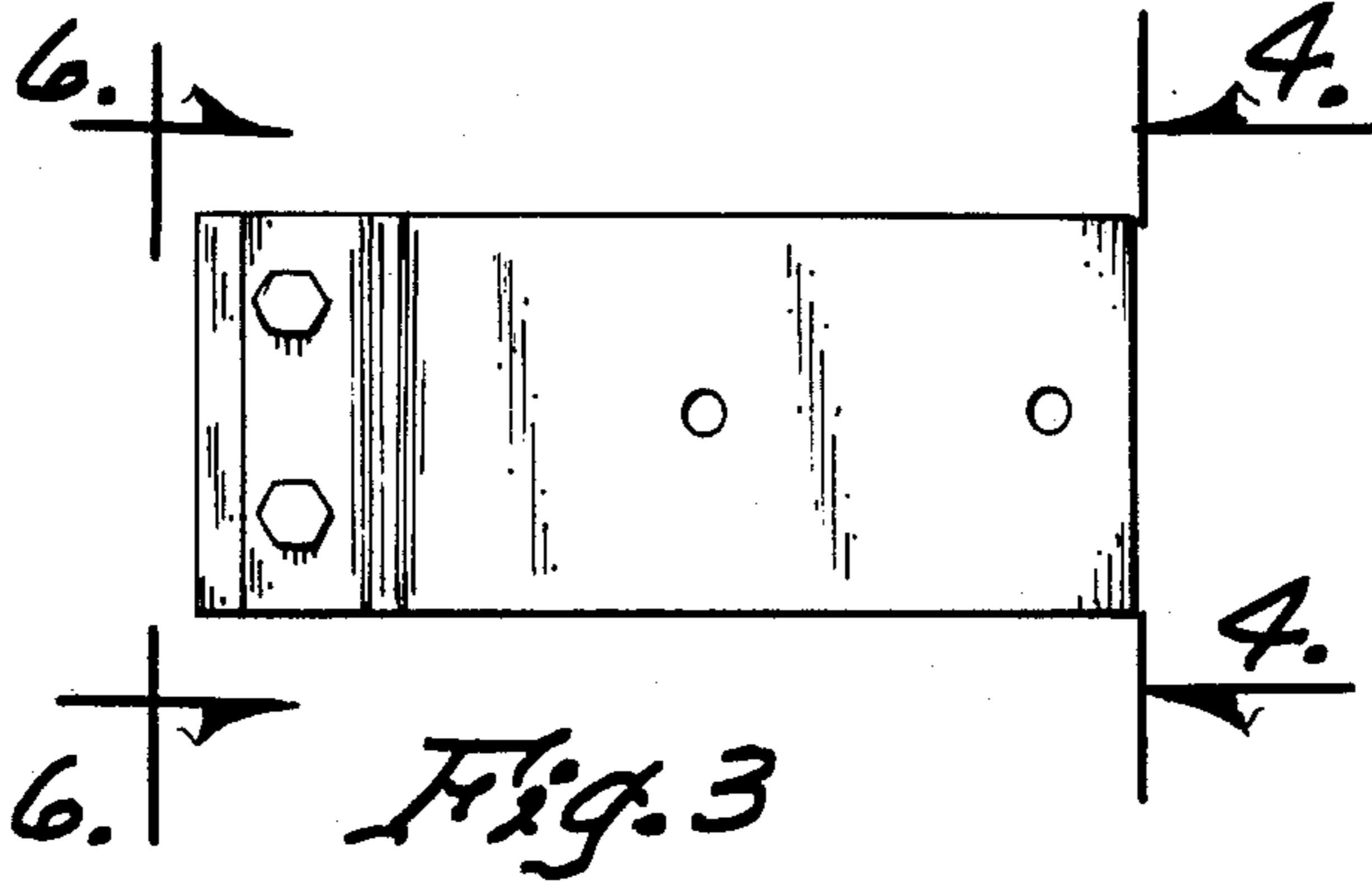

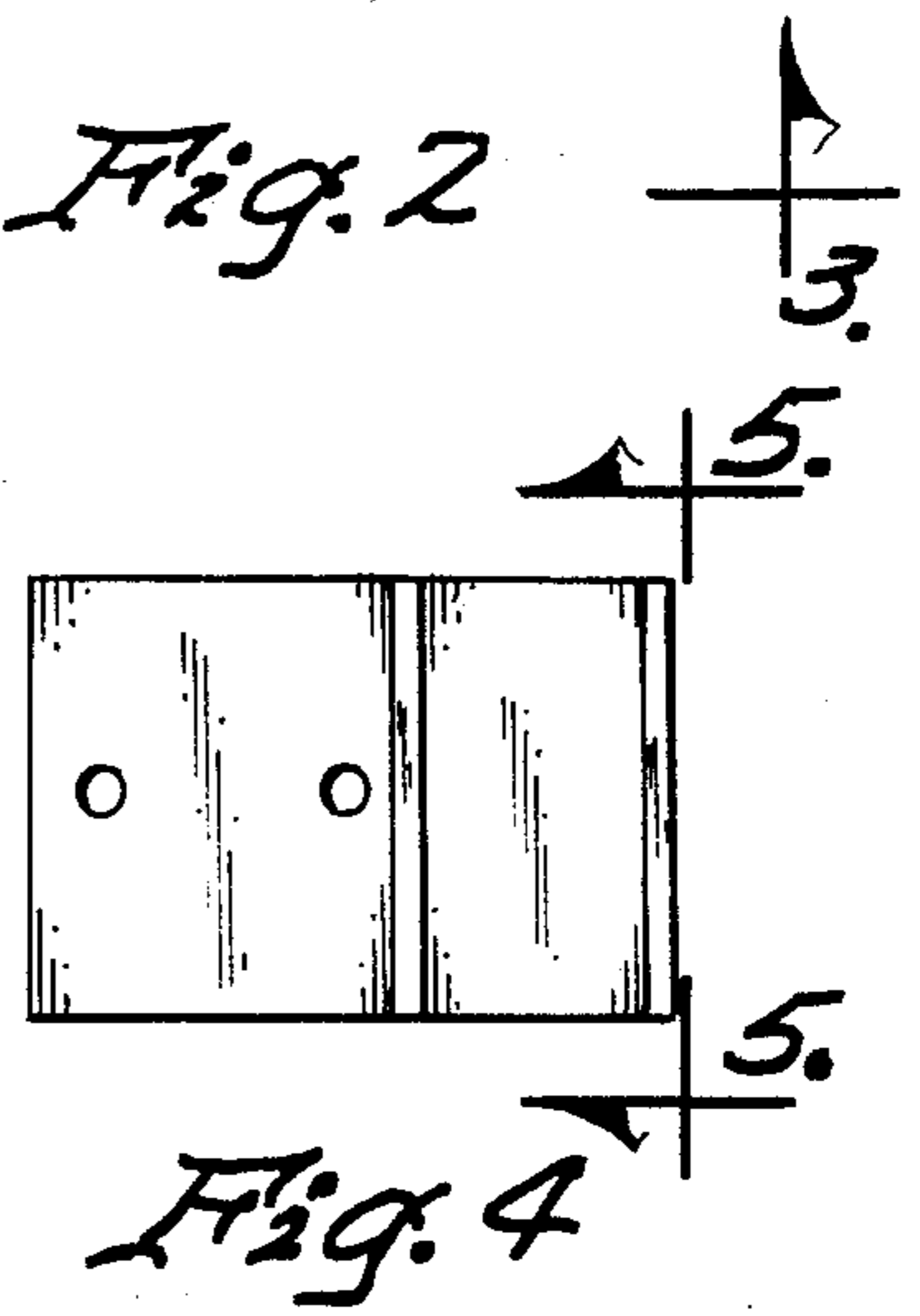

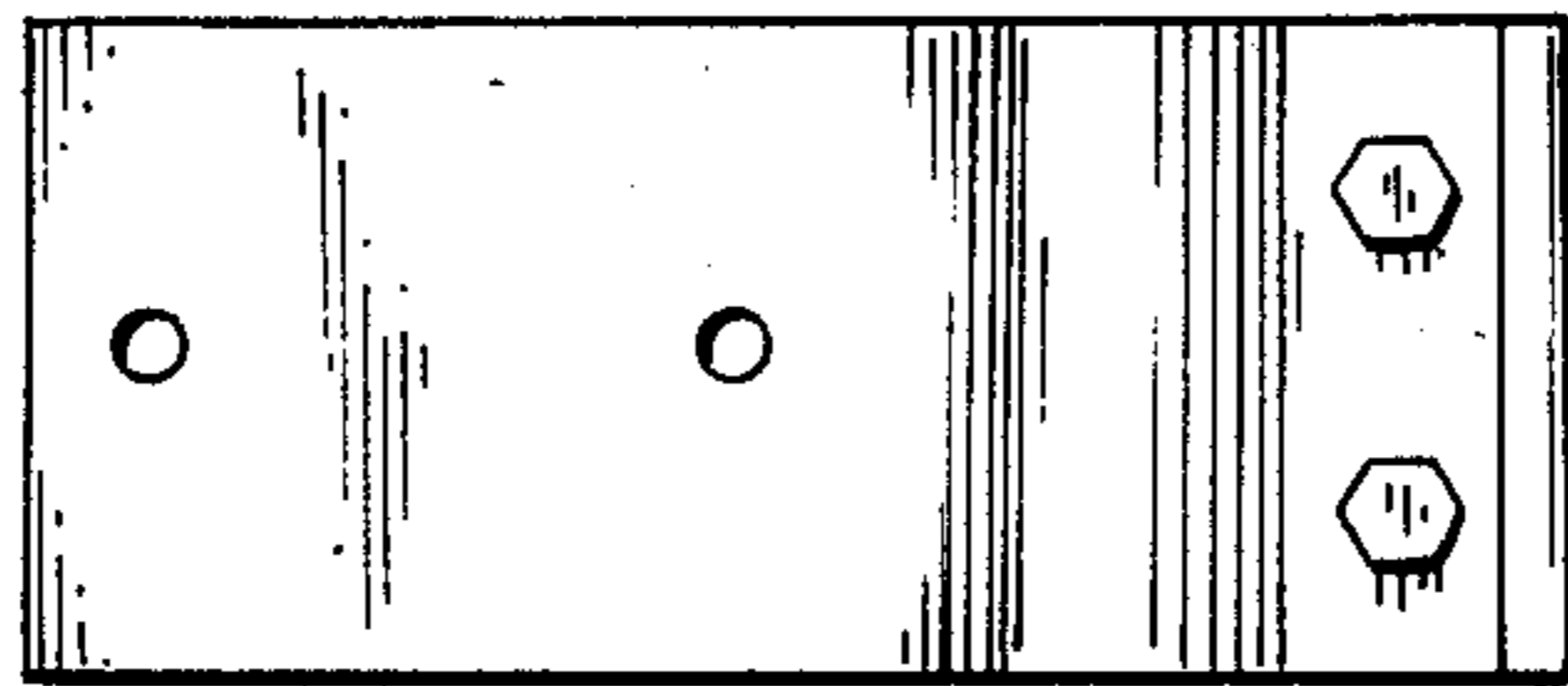

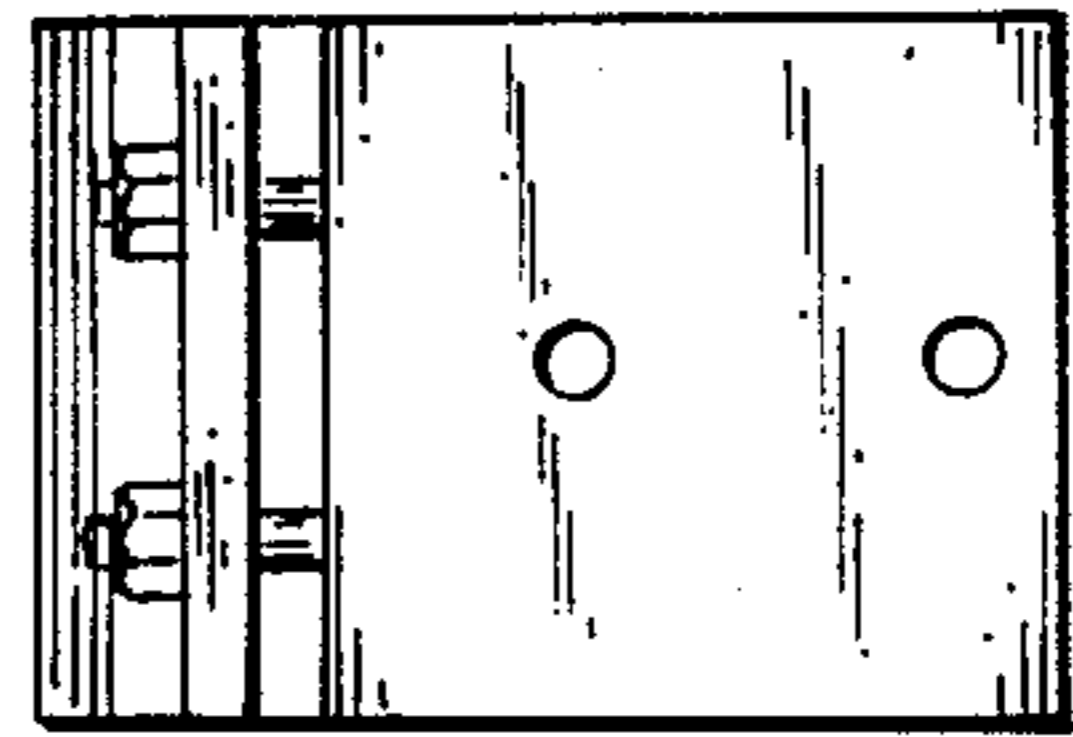
