[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a game ball with textured surface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a game ball with textured surface showing our new design, the side opposite being a mirror image;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof, rotated to the side;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view showing a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the side opposite being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof, rotated to the side;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof, rotated to the side;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view showing a fourth embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the side opposite being a mirror image;

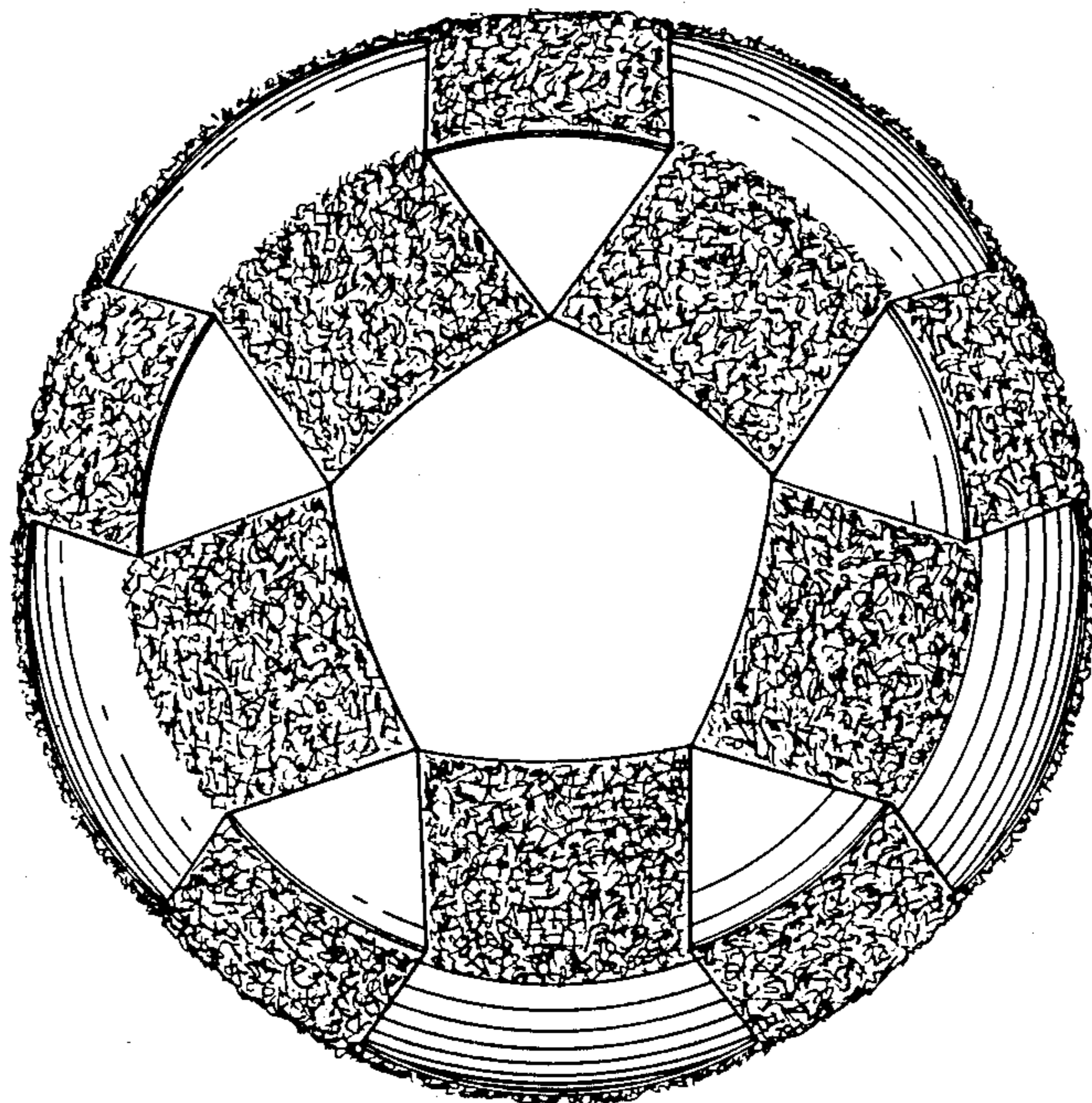
FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof, rotated to the side;

FIG. 12 is a perspective view thereof, rotated to the side.



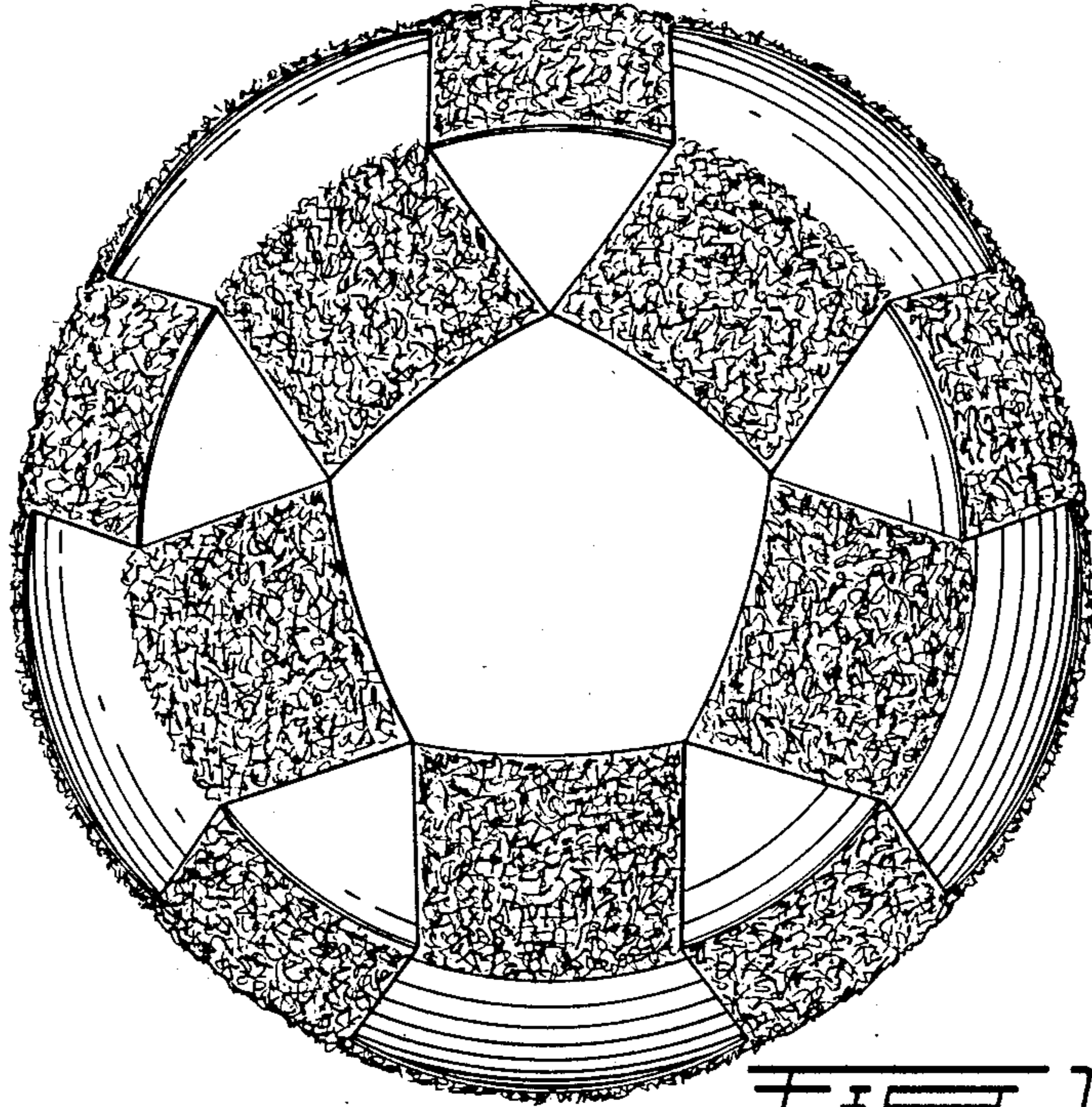
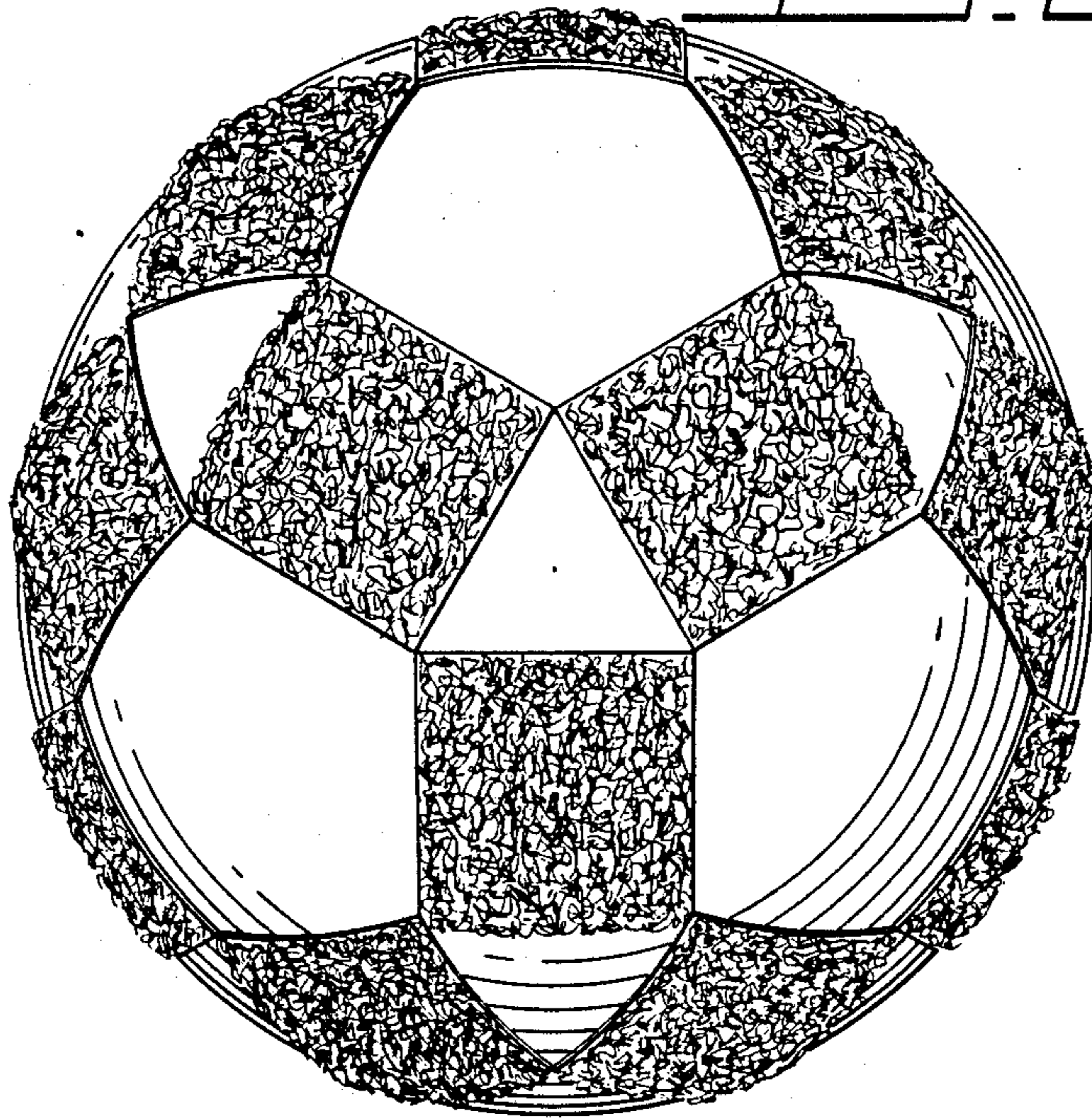

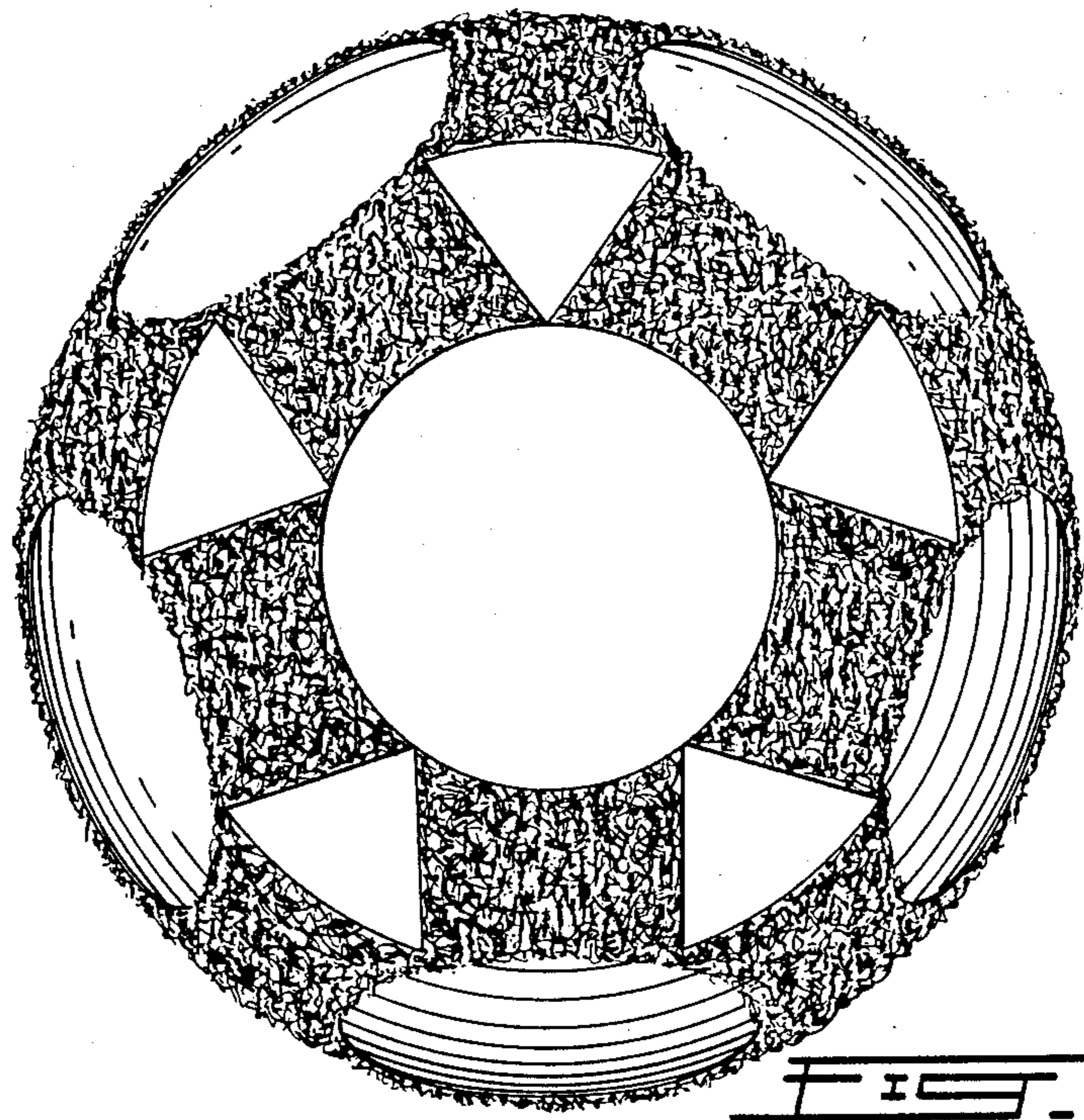
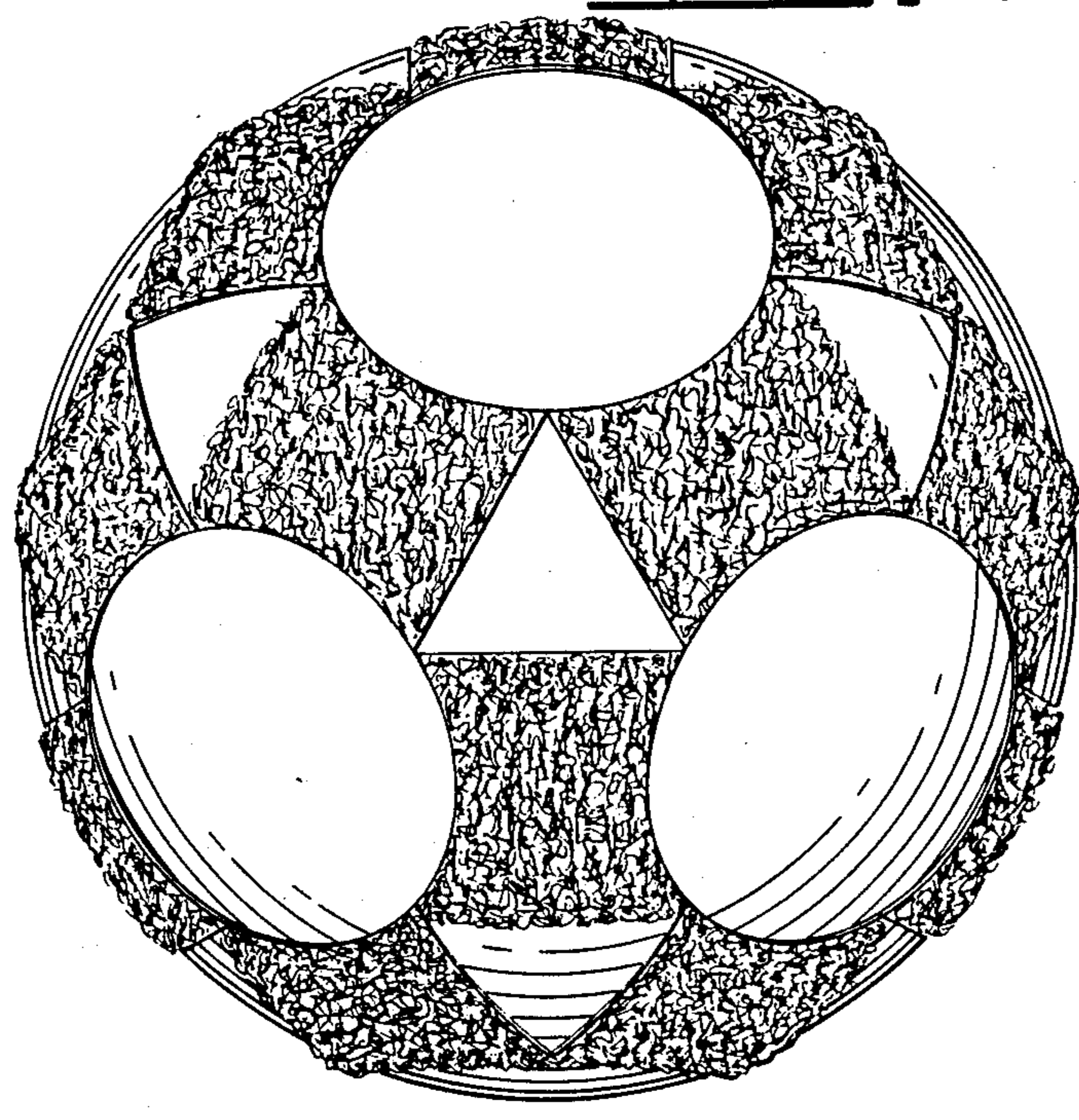

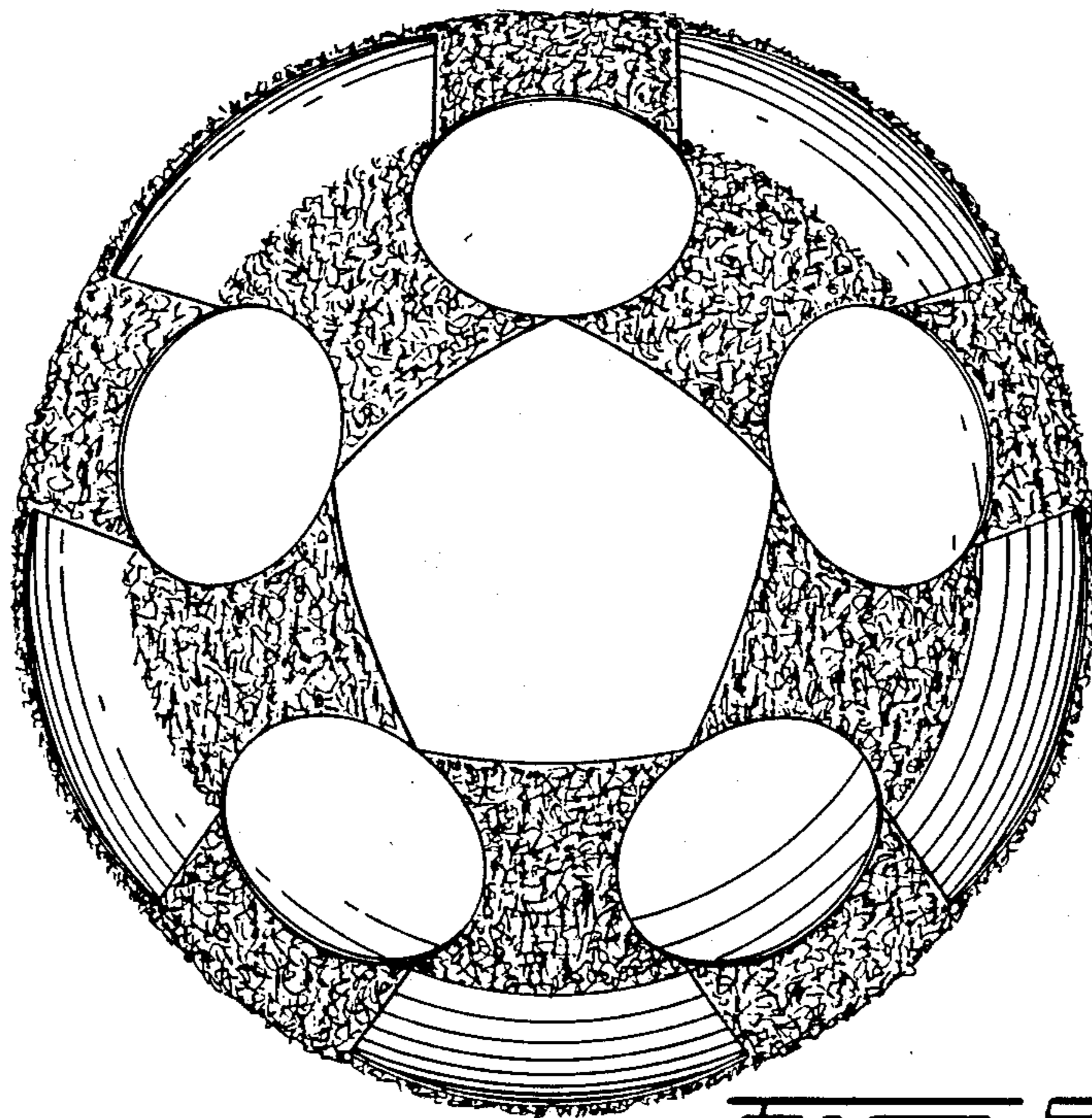
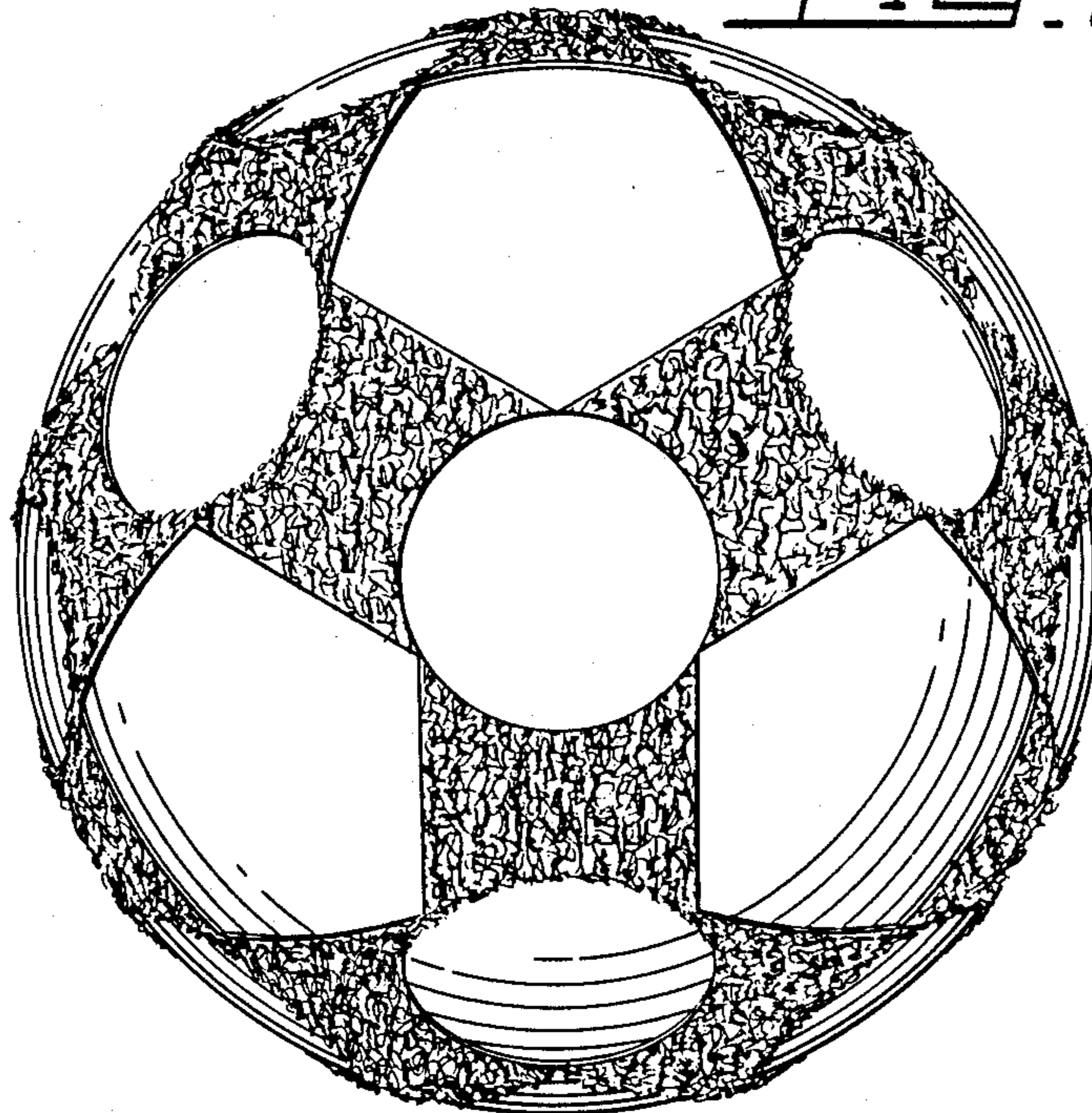

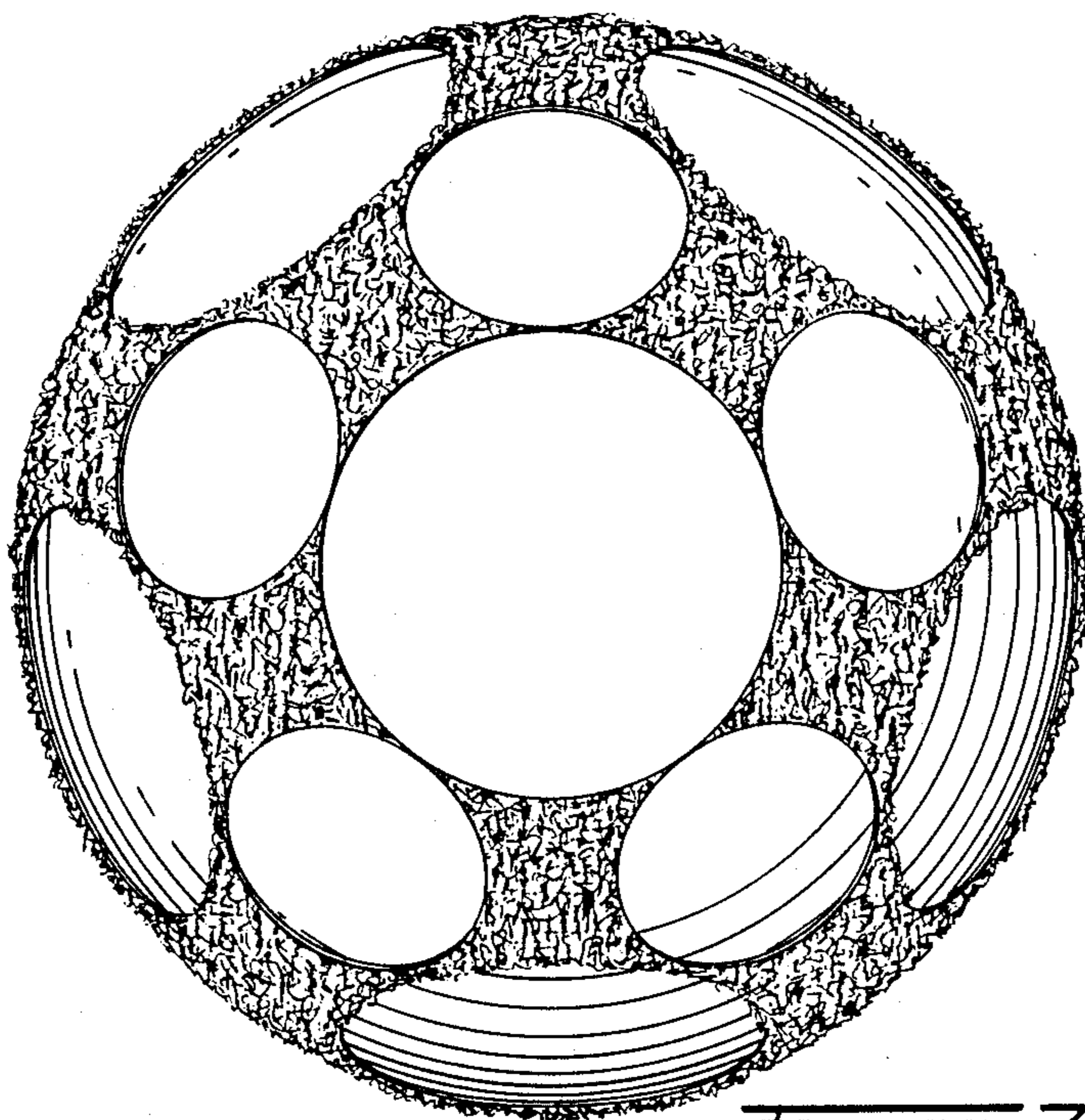

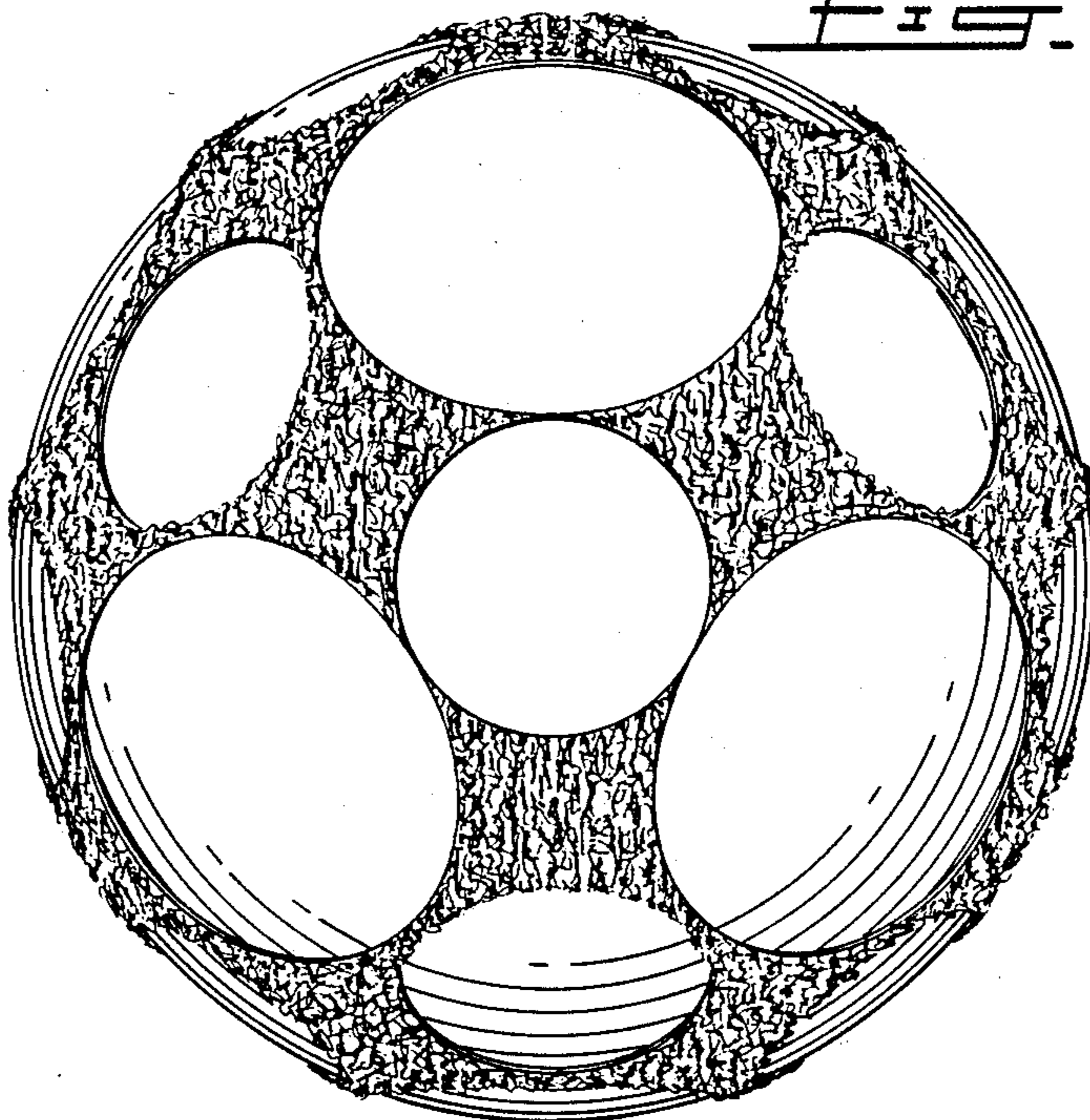

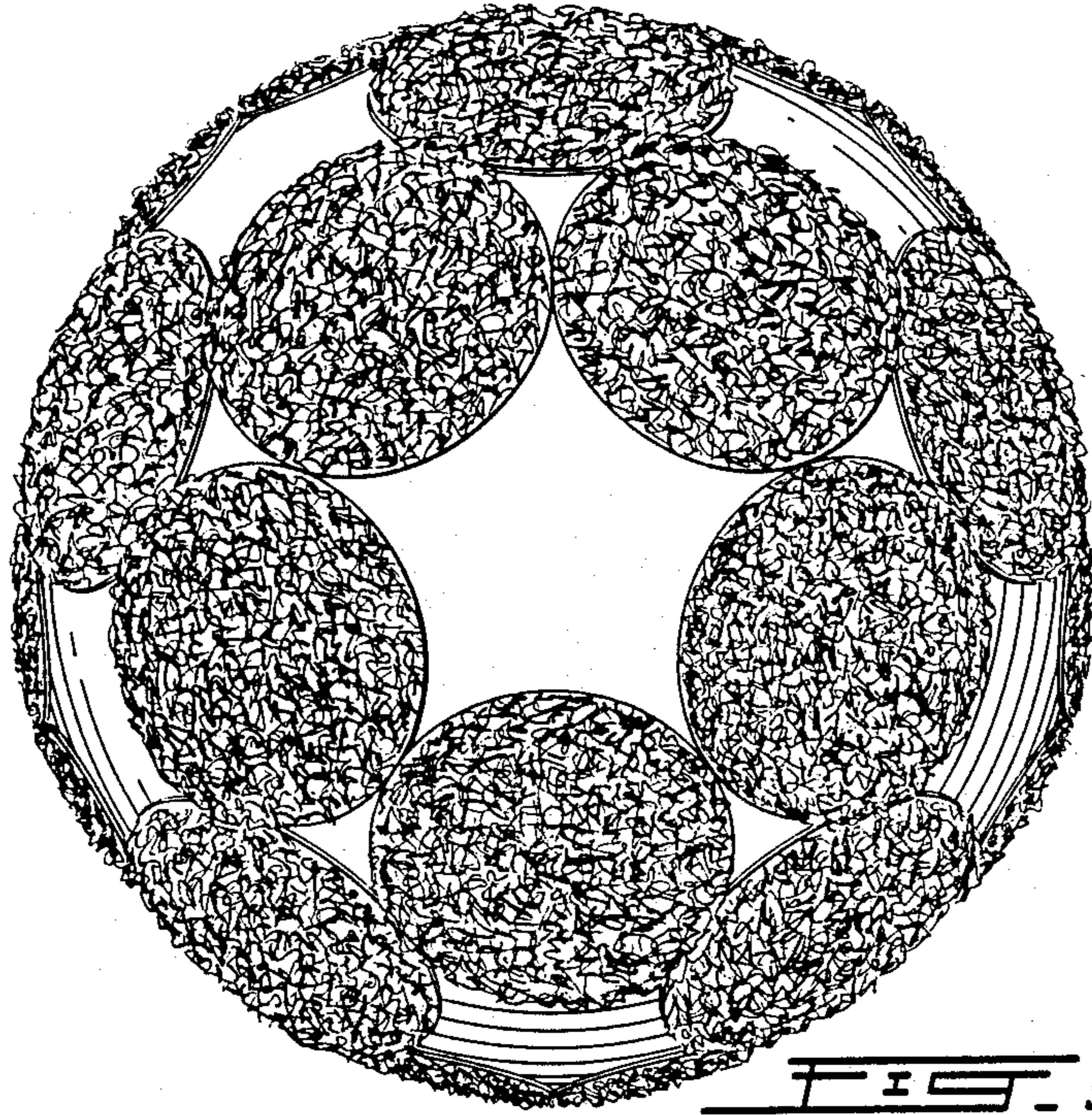
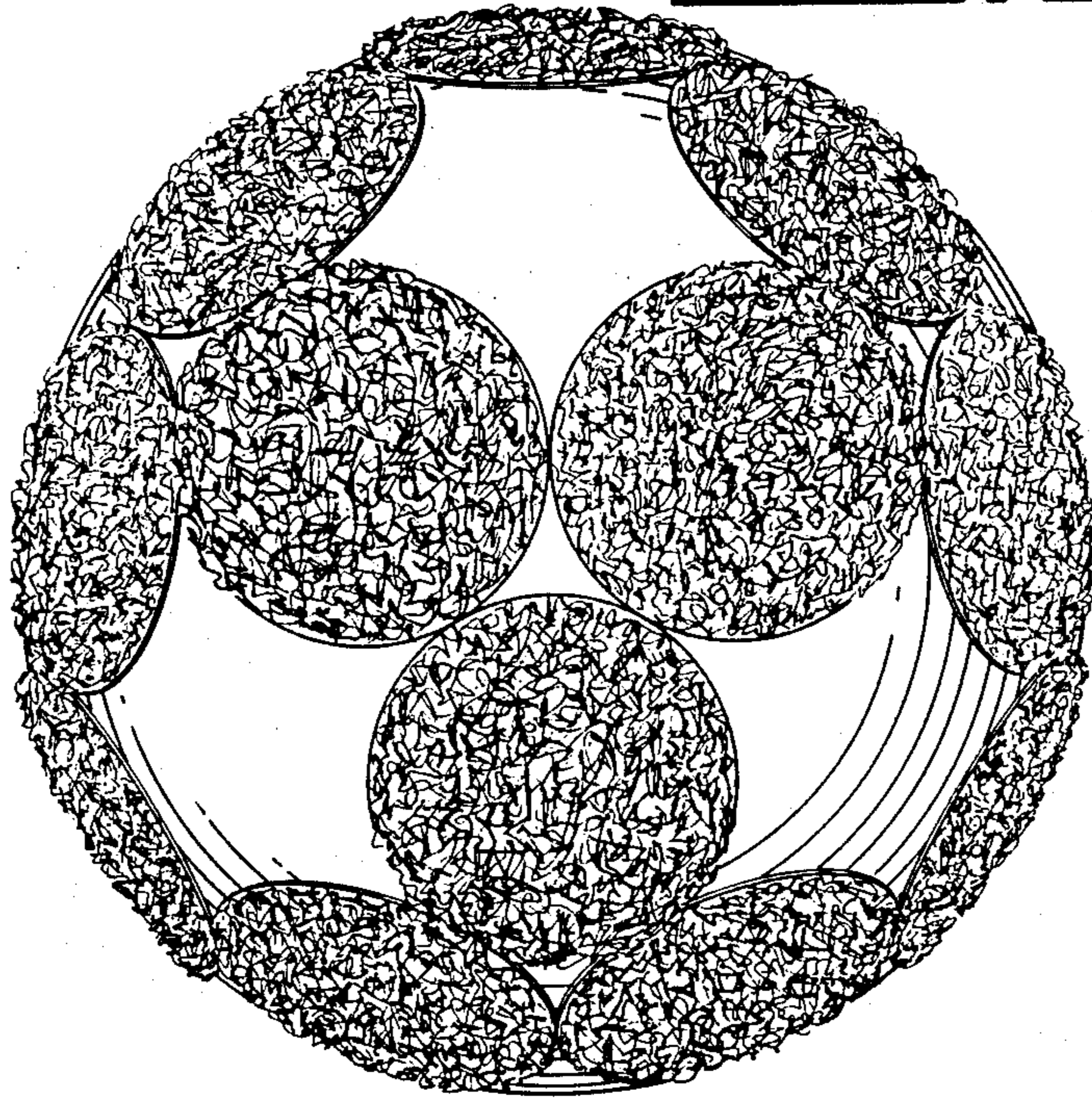

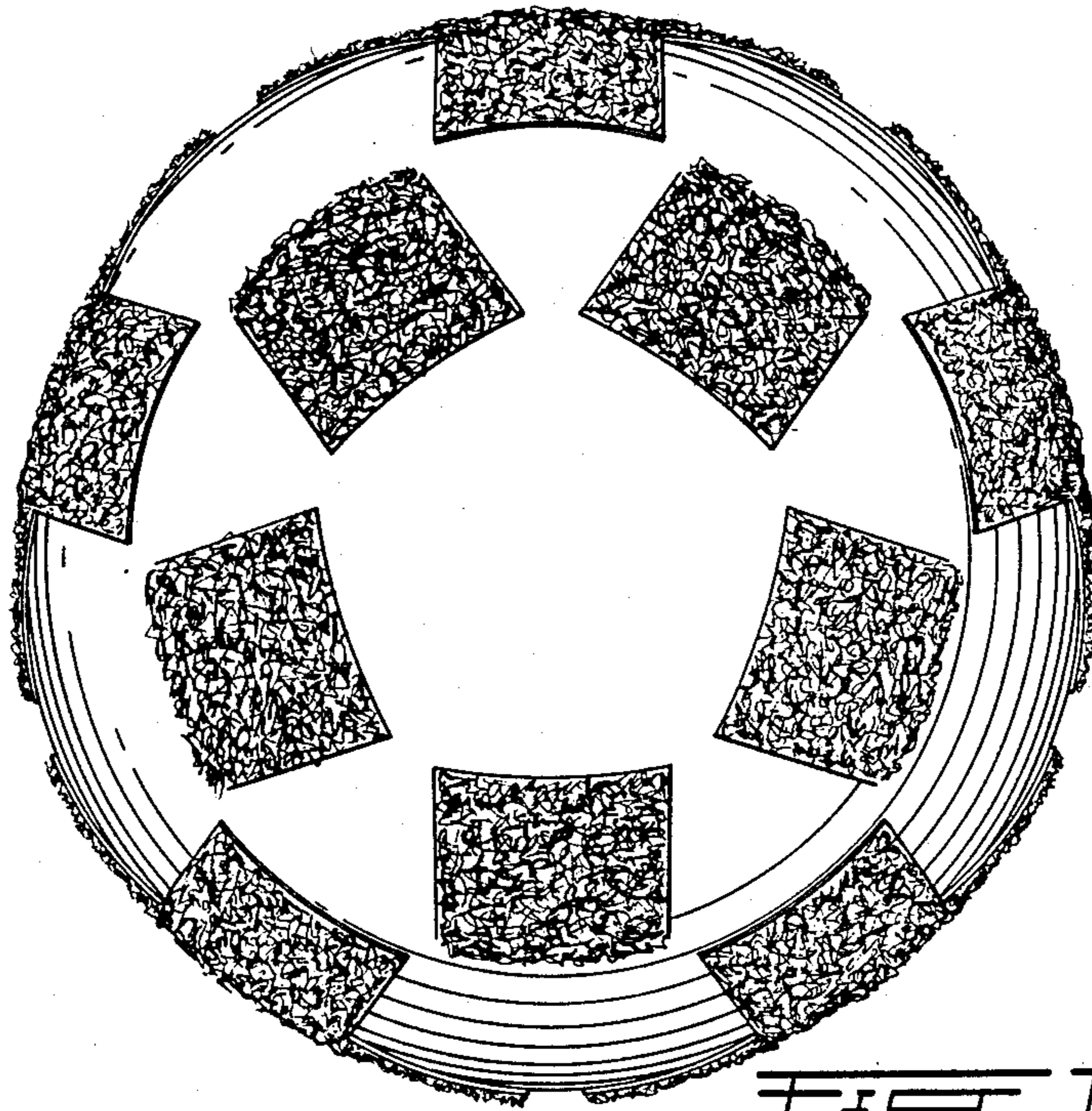
