[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a disposal container for sharp articles or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a disposal container for sharp articles showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation thereof, the left side elevation being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a rear side elevation thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

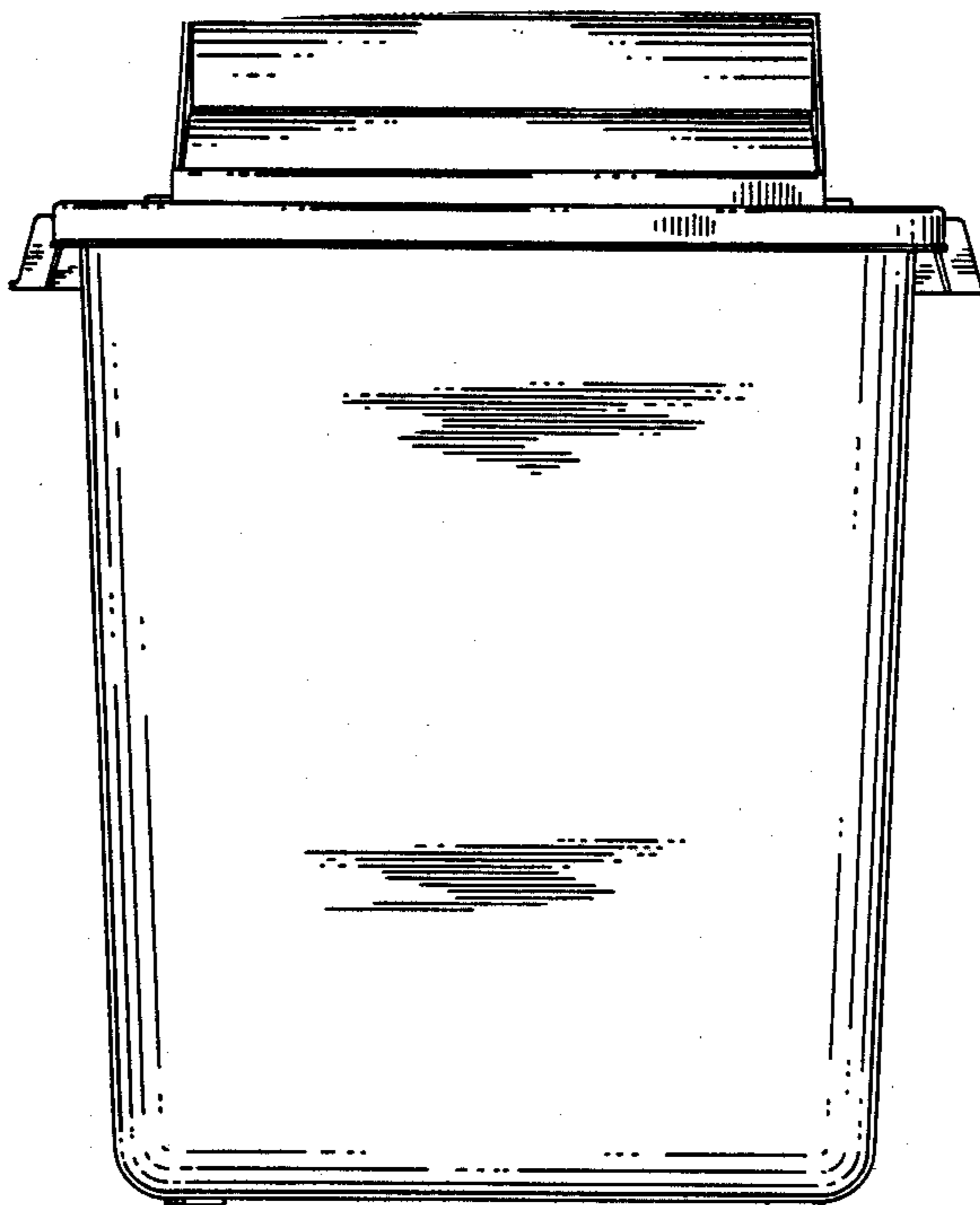

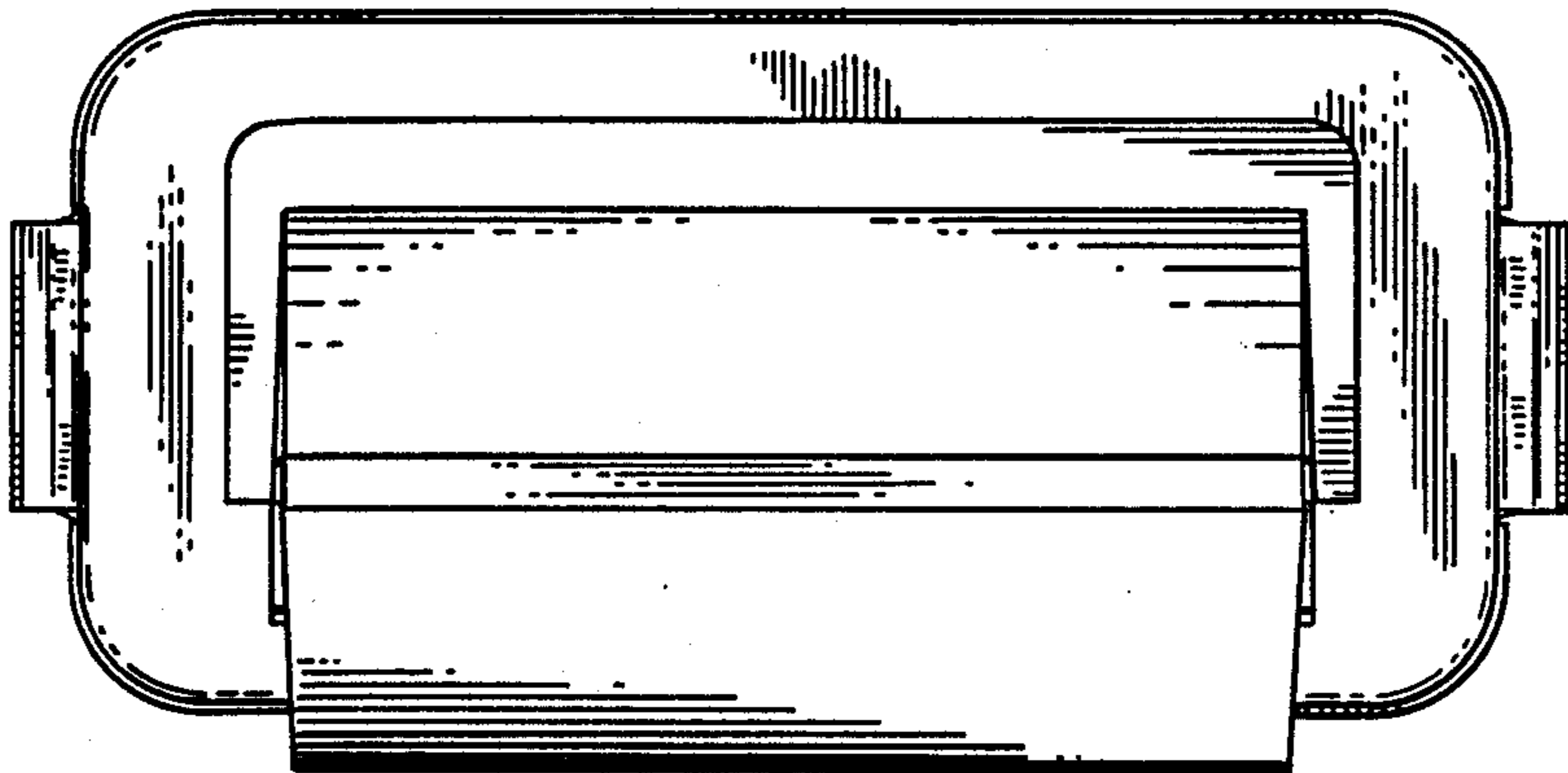
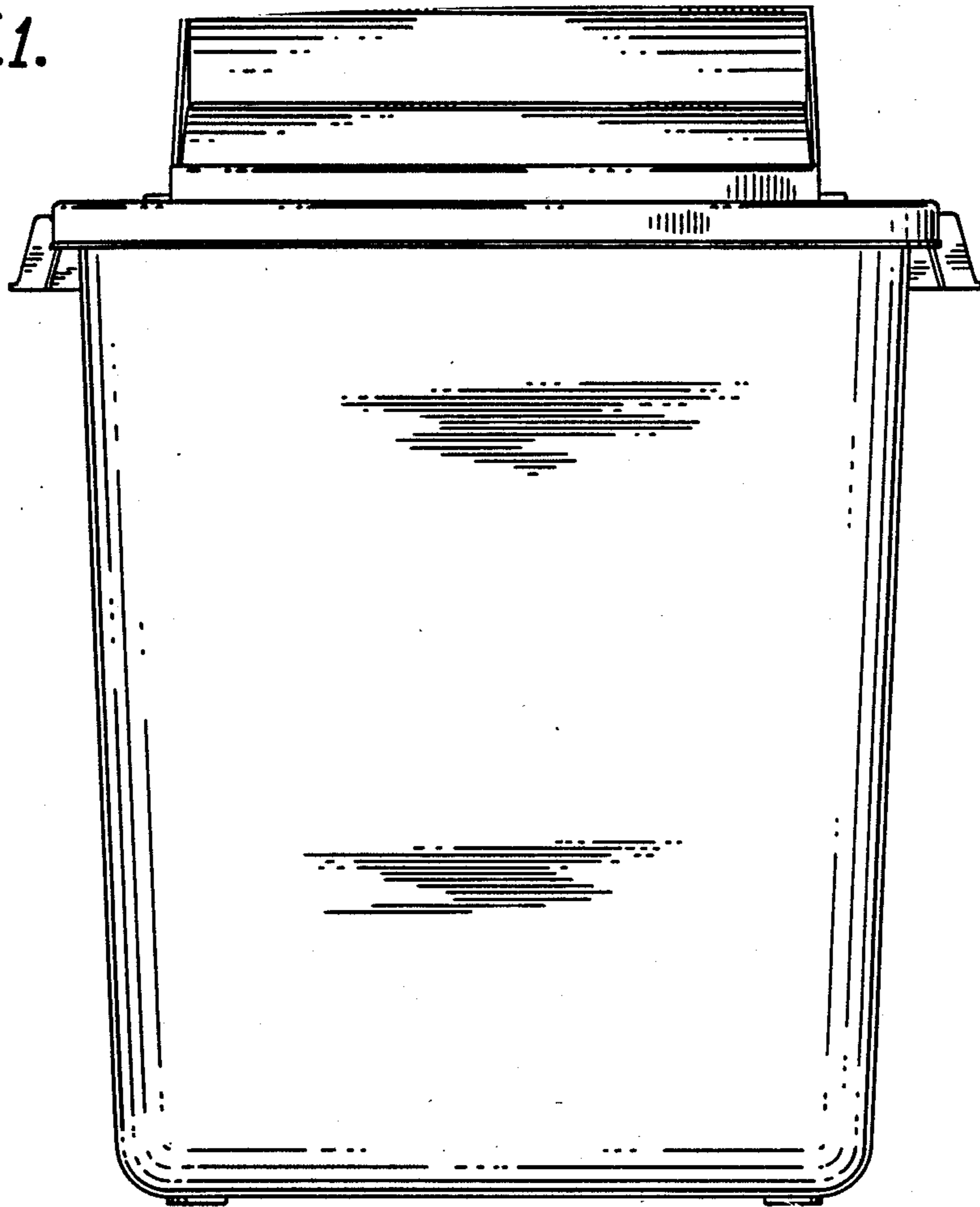

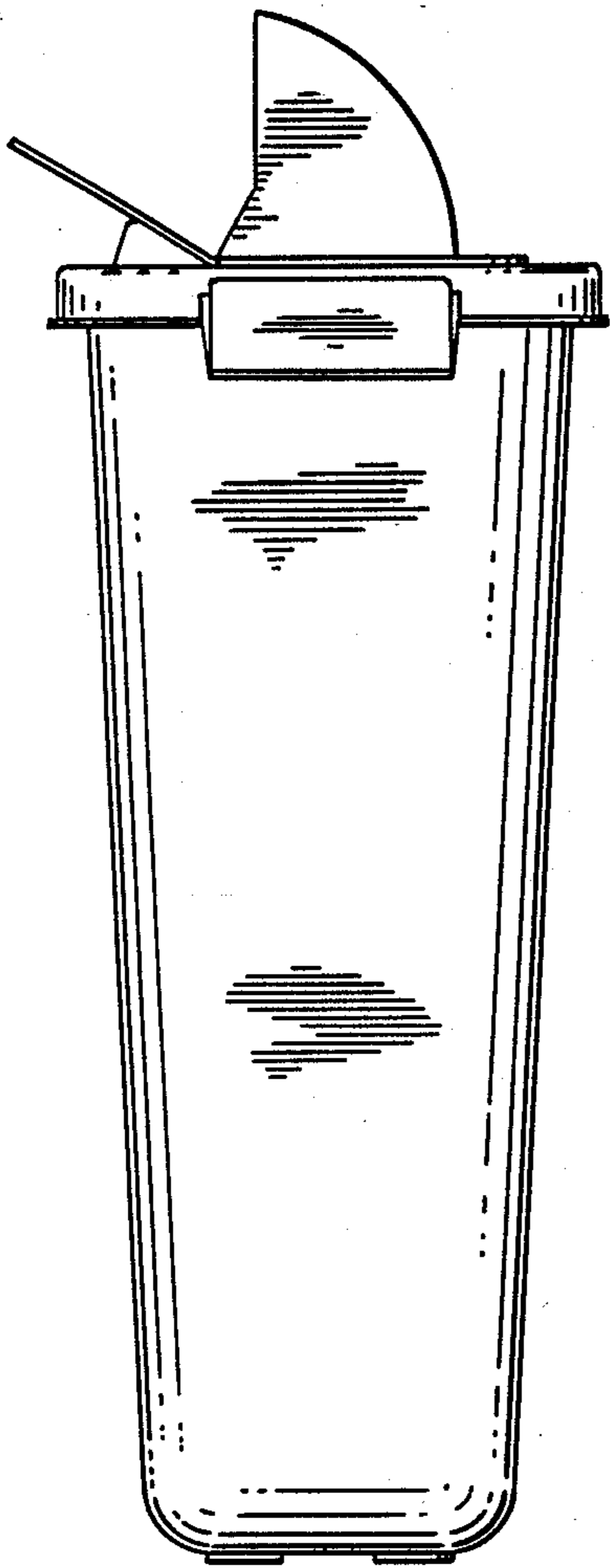

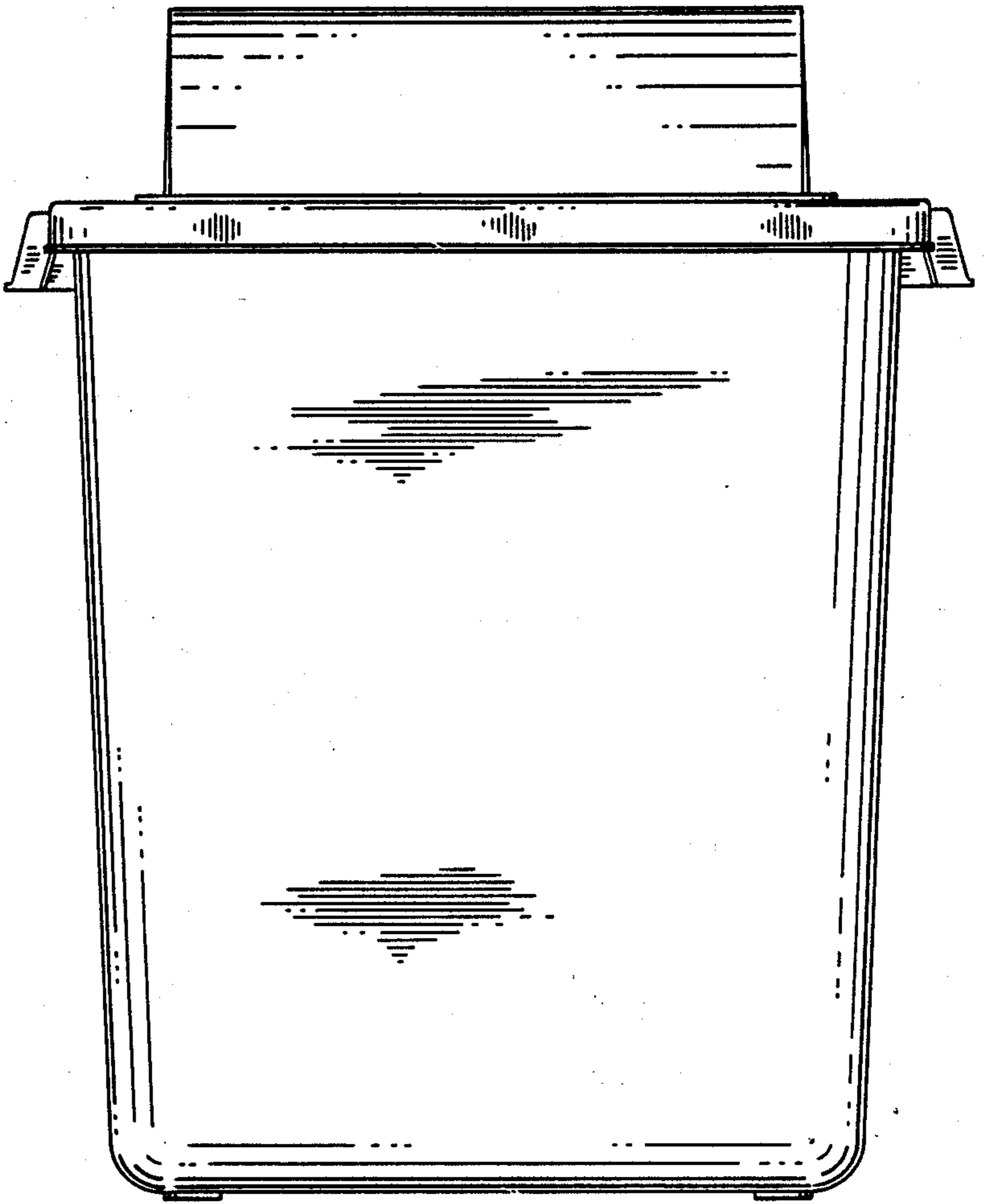

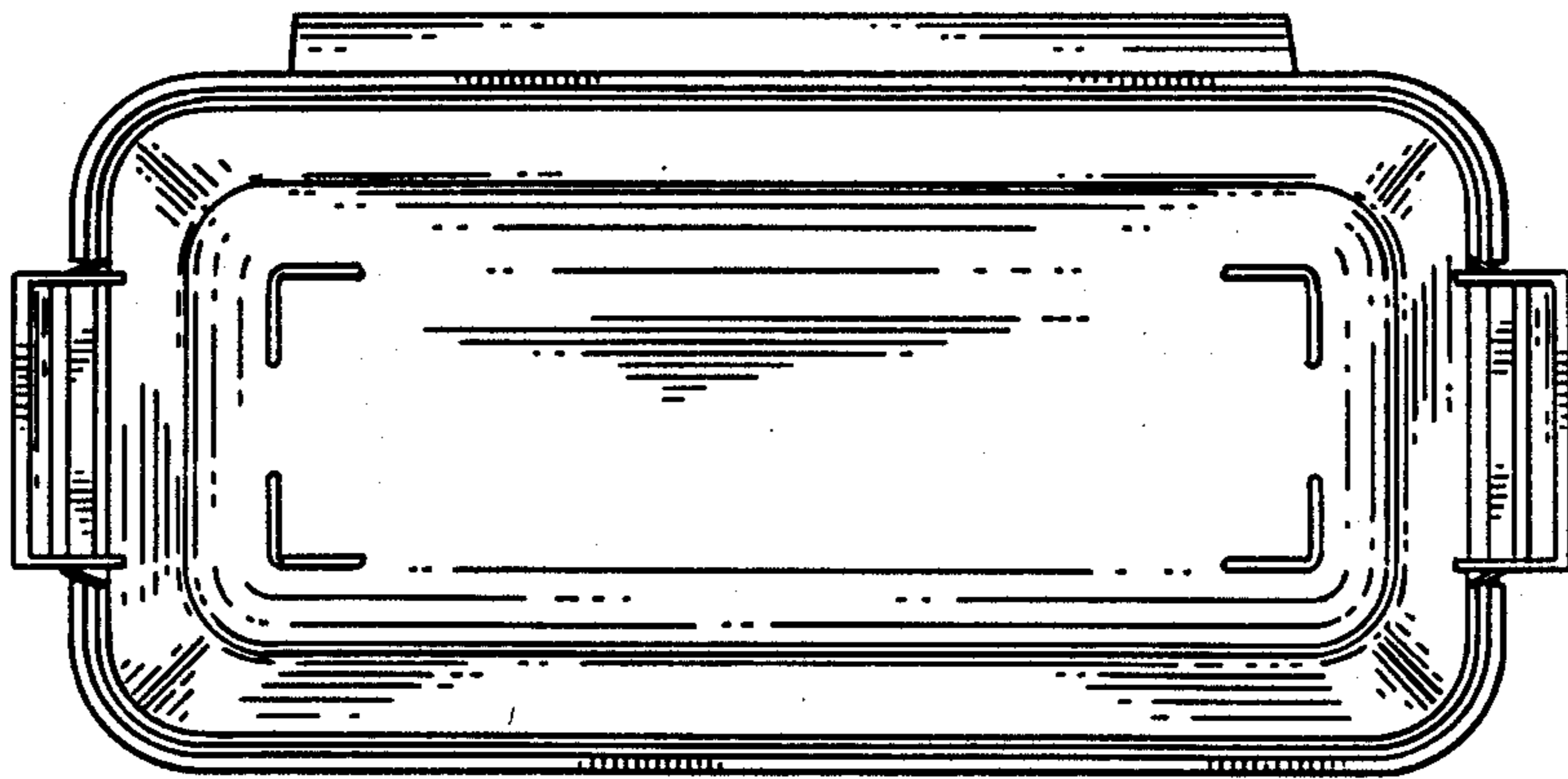
