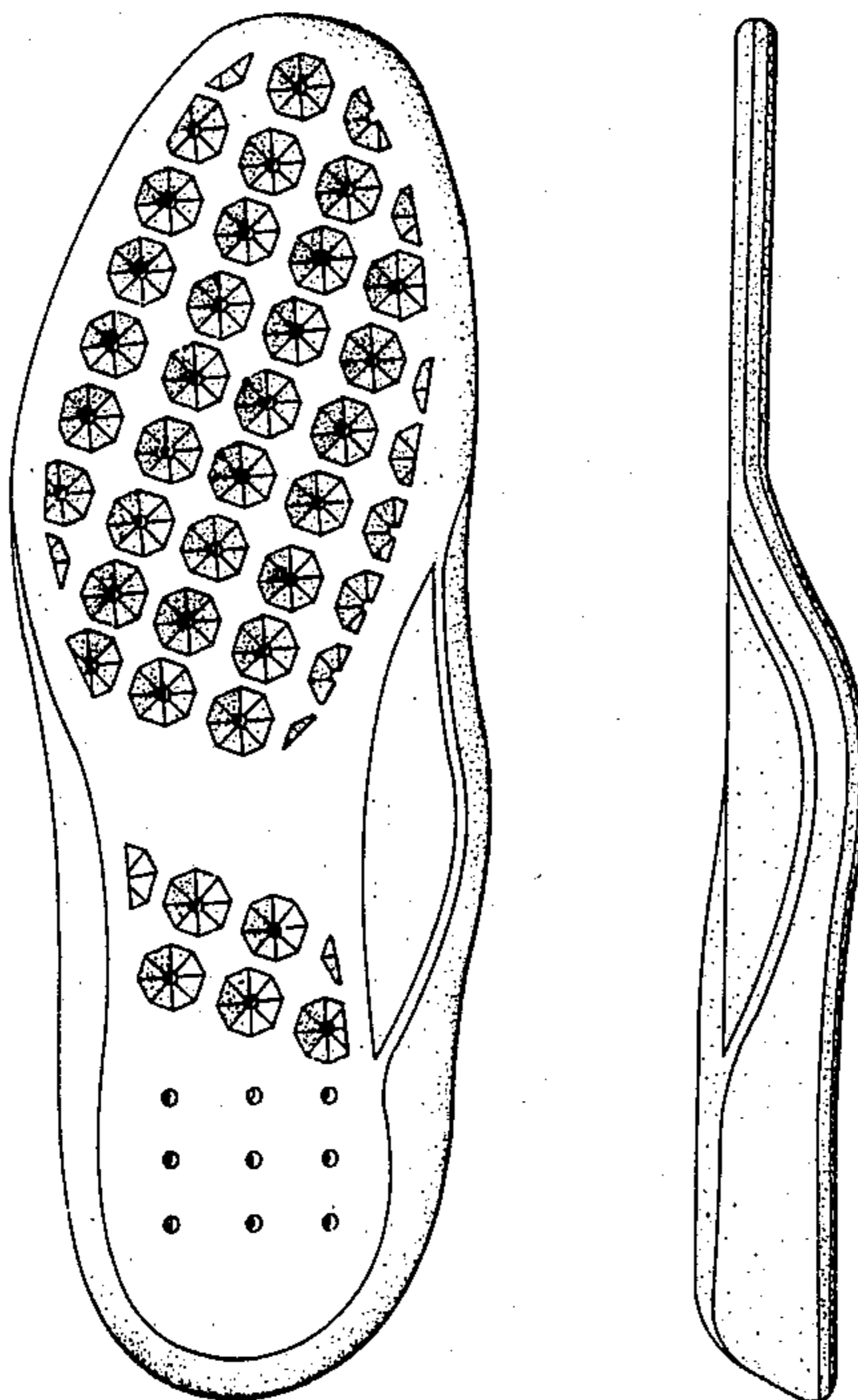

The ornamental design for a shoe pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom side perspective view of a shoe pad showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the shoe pad;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the shoe pad;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the shoe pad;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the shoe pad;
 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of the shoe pad;
 FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of the shoe pad;
 FIG. 8 is a transverse cross section taken along line 8—8 in FIG. 1.



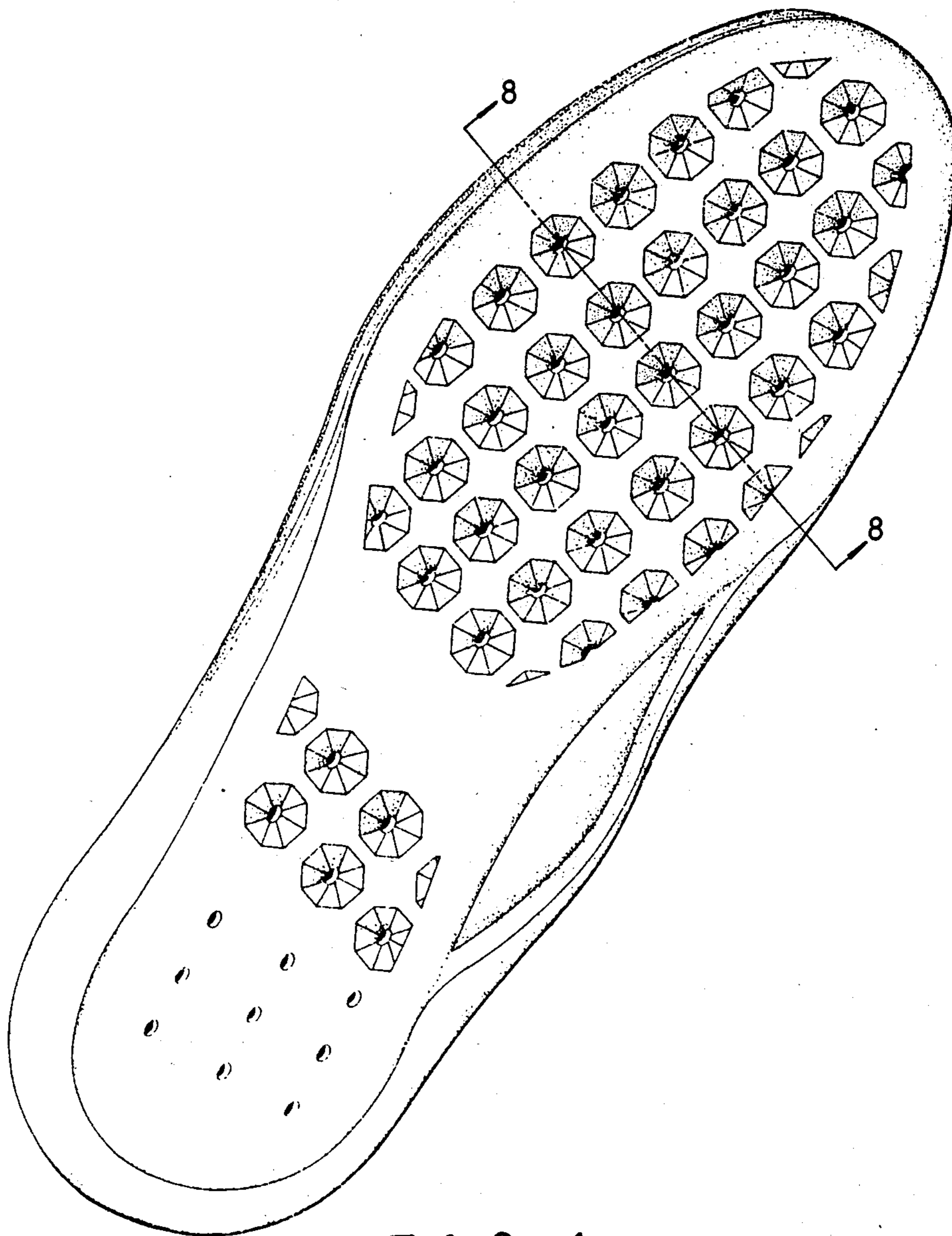

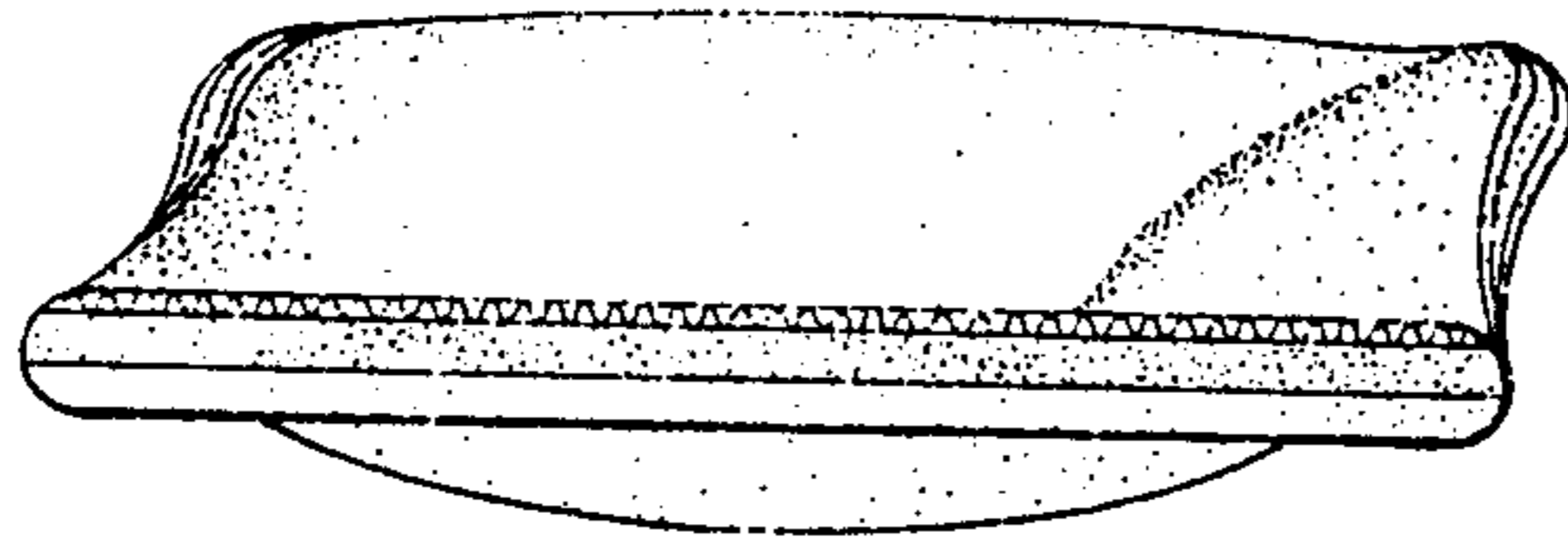

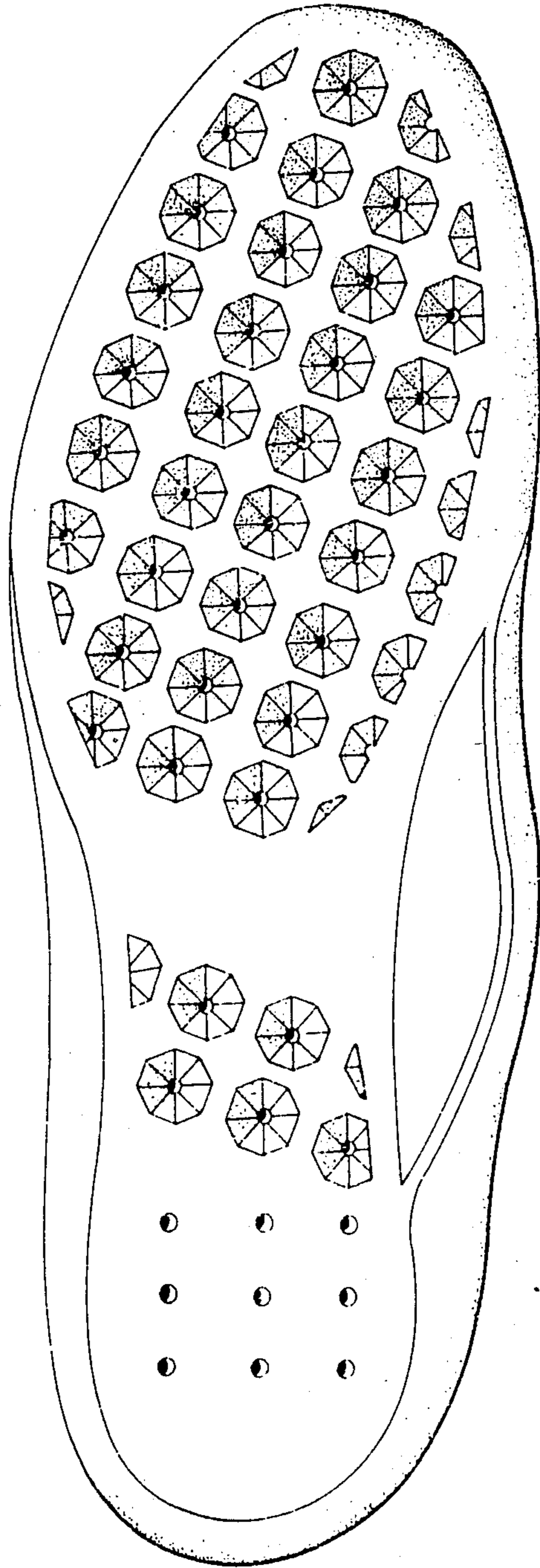

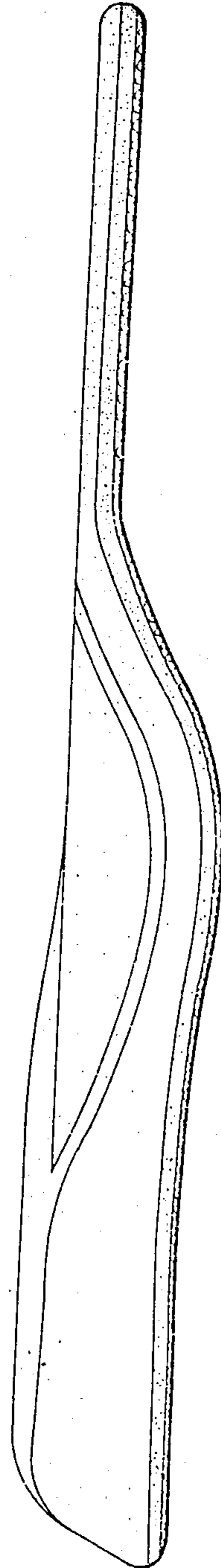

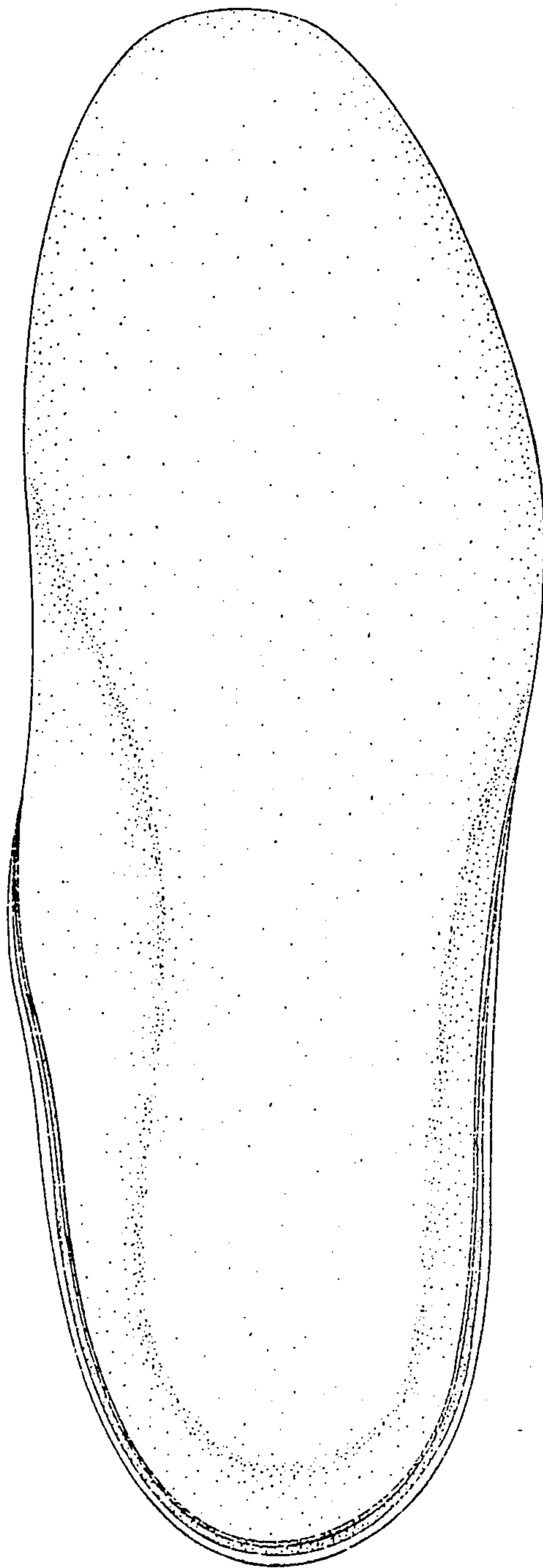

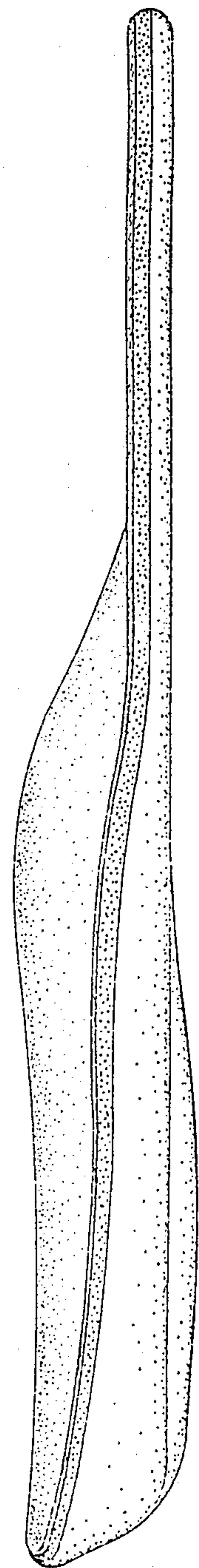

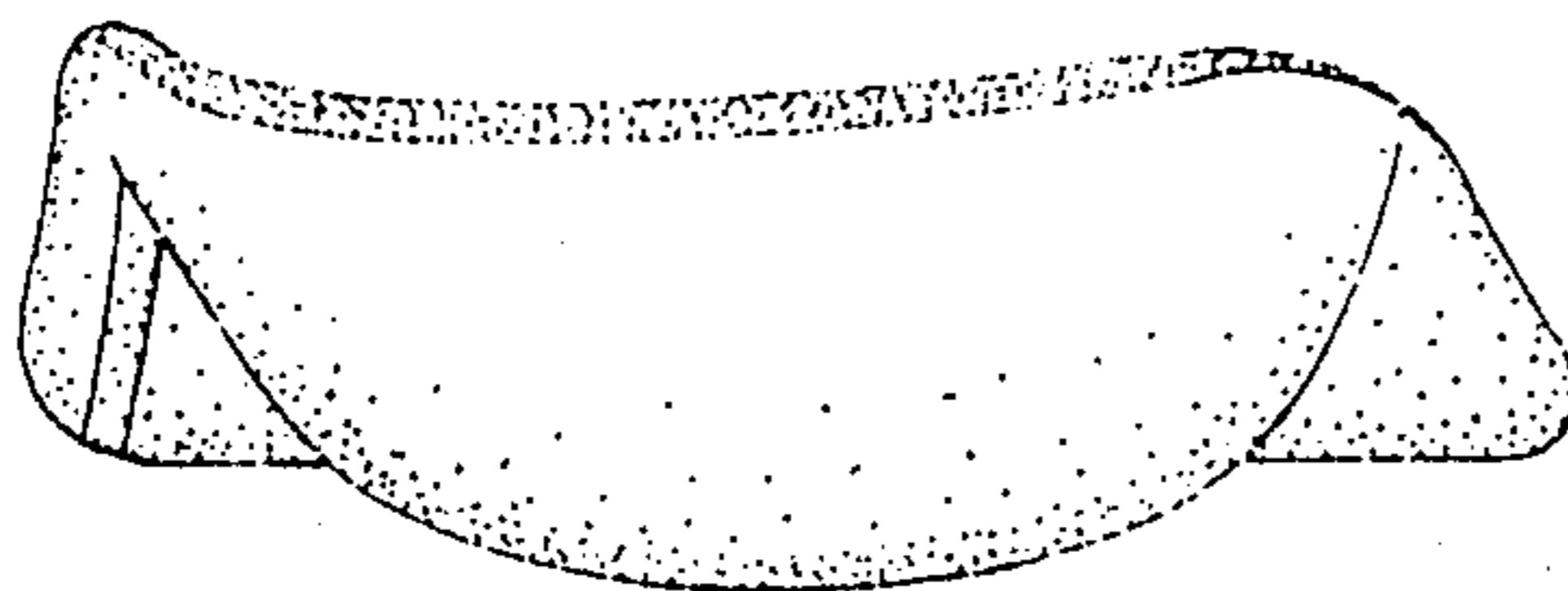
