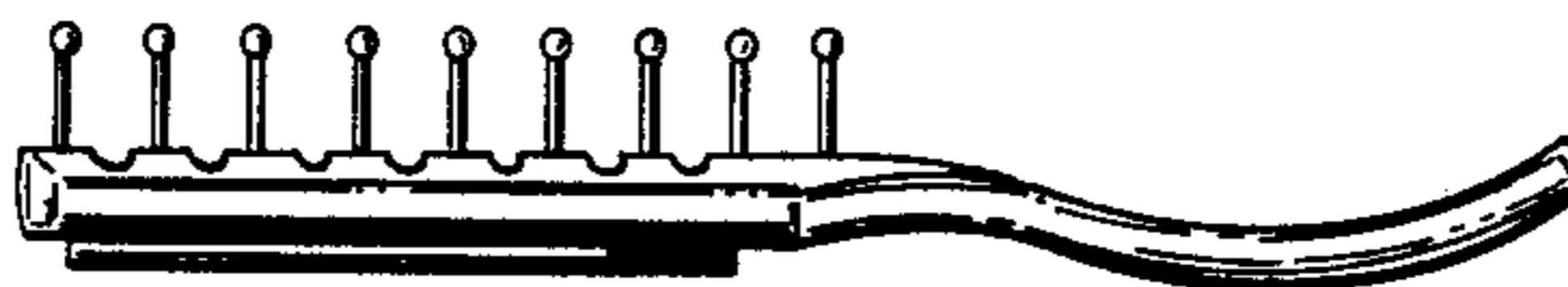
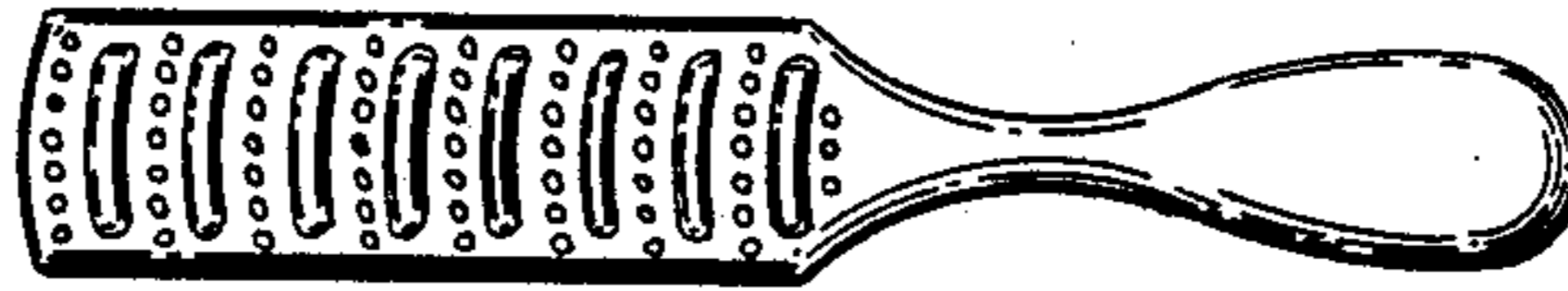

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view as seen from the left of FIG. 1.



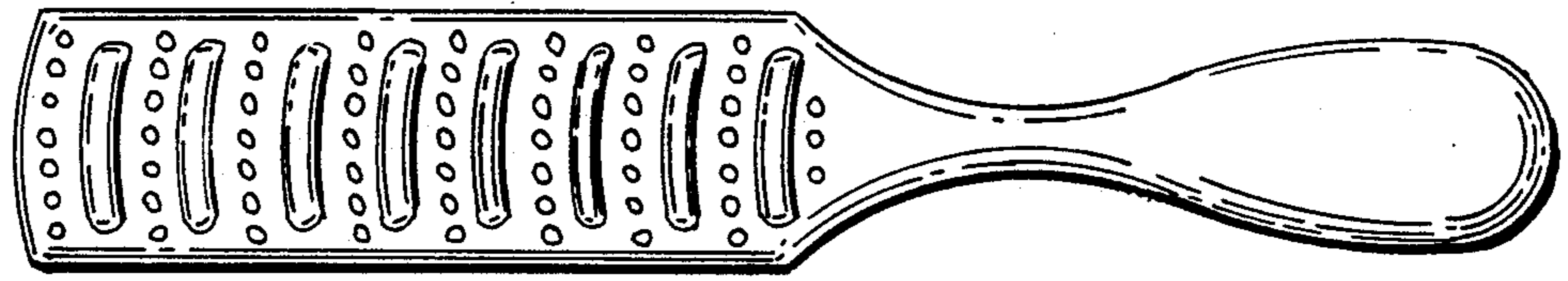

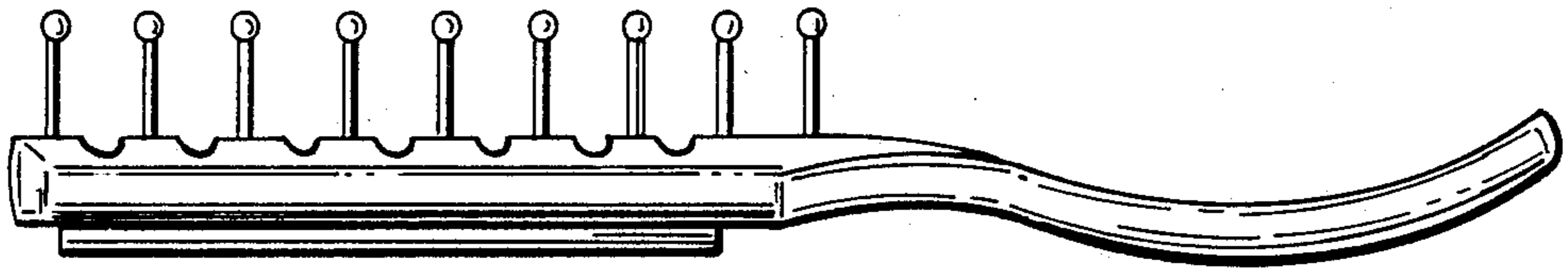

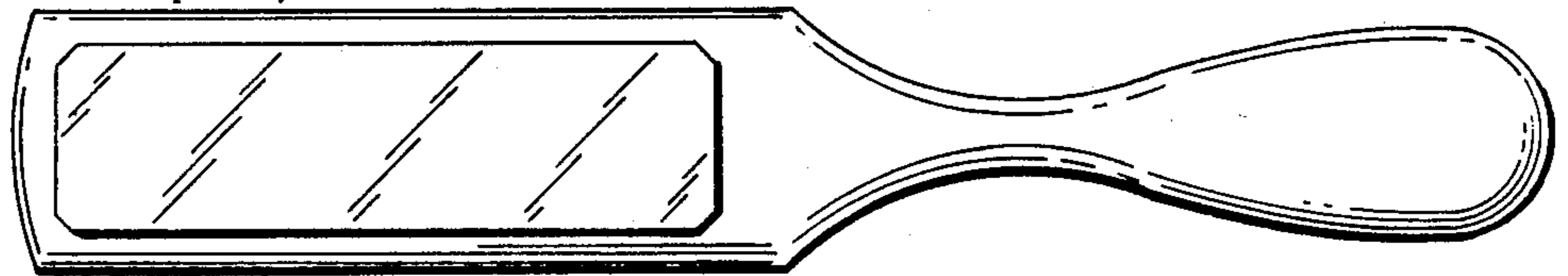

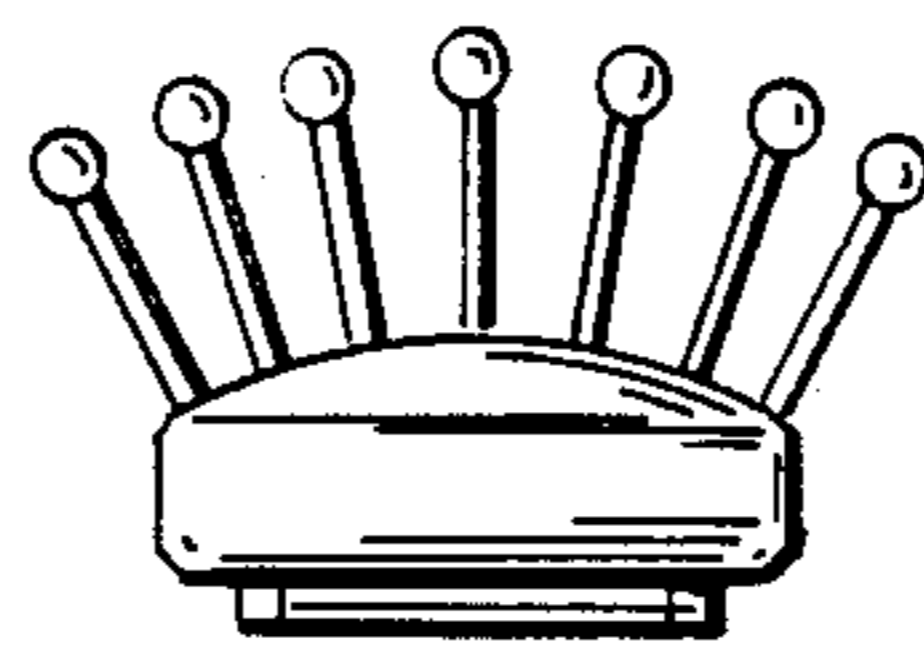
