DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a photograph or document holder, showing my new design;

The undisclosed bottom view is plane and unornamented.

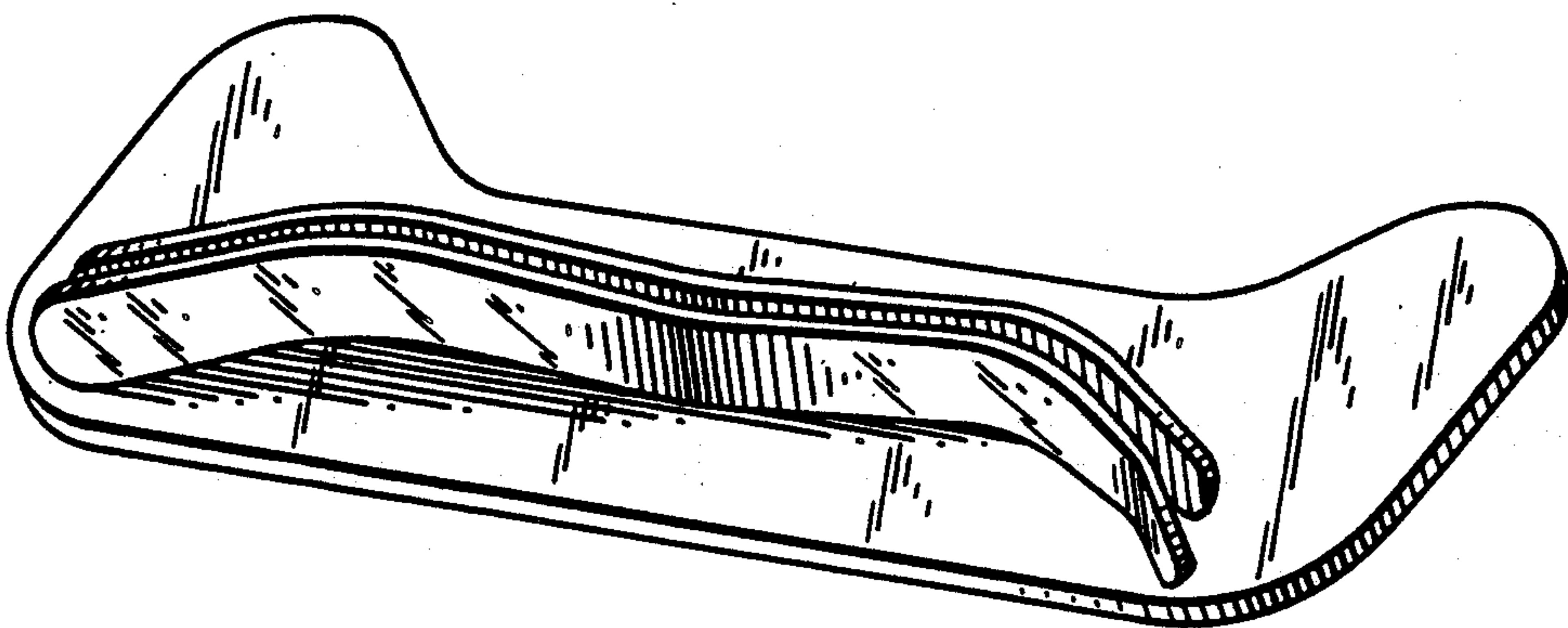

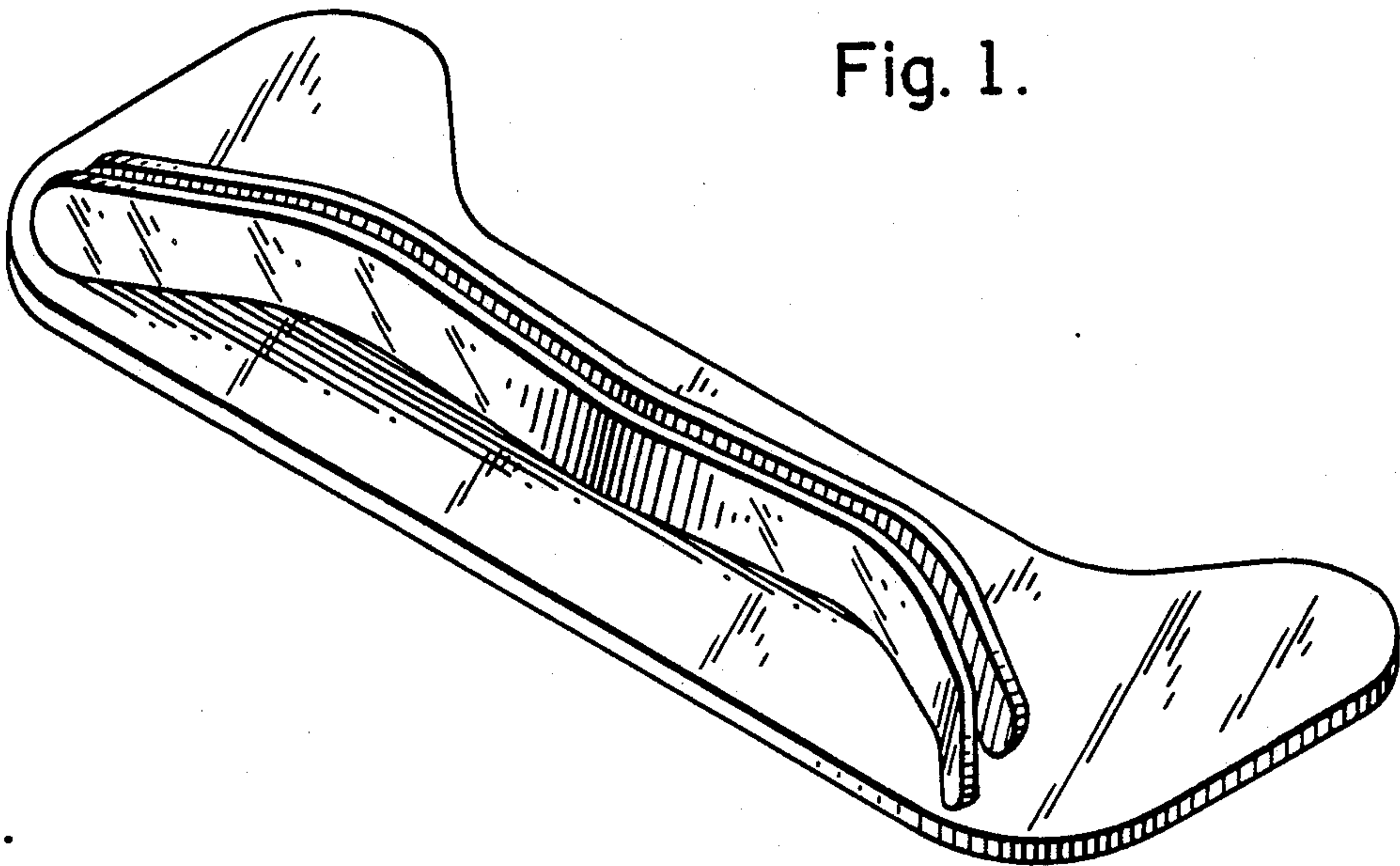

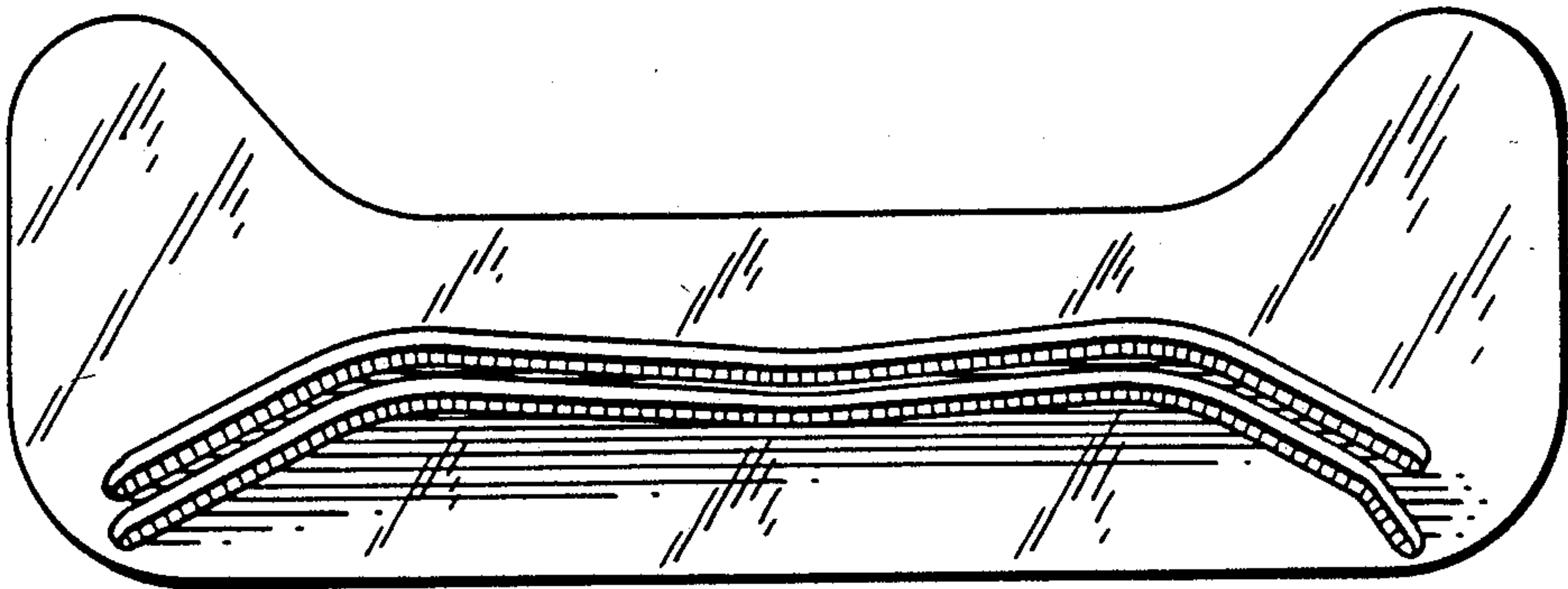
