FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bumper spoiler showing my new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the design;

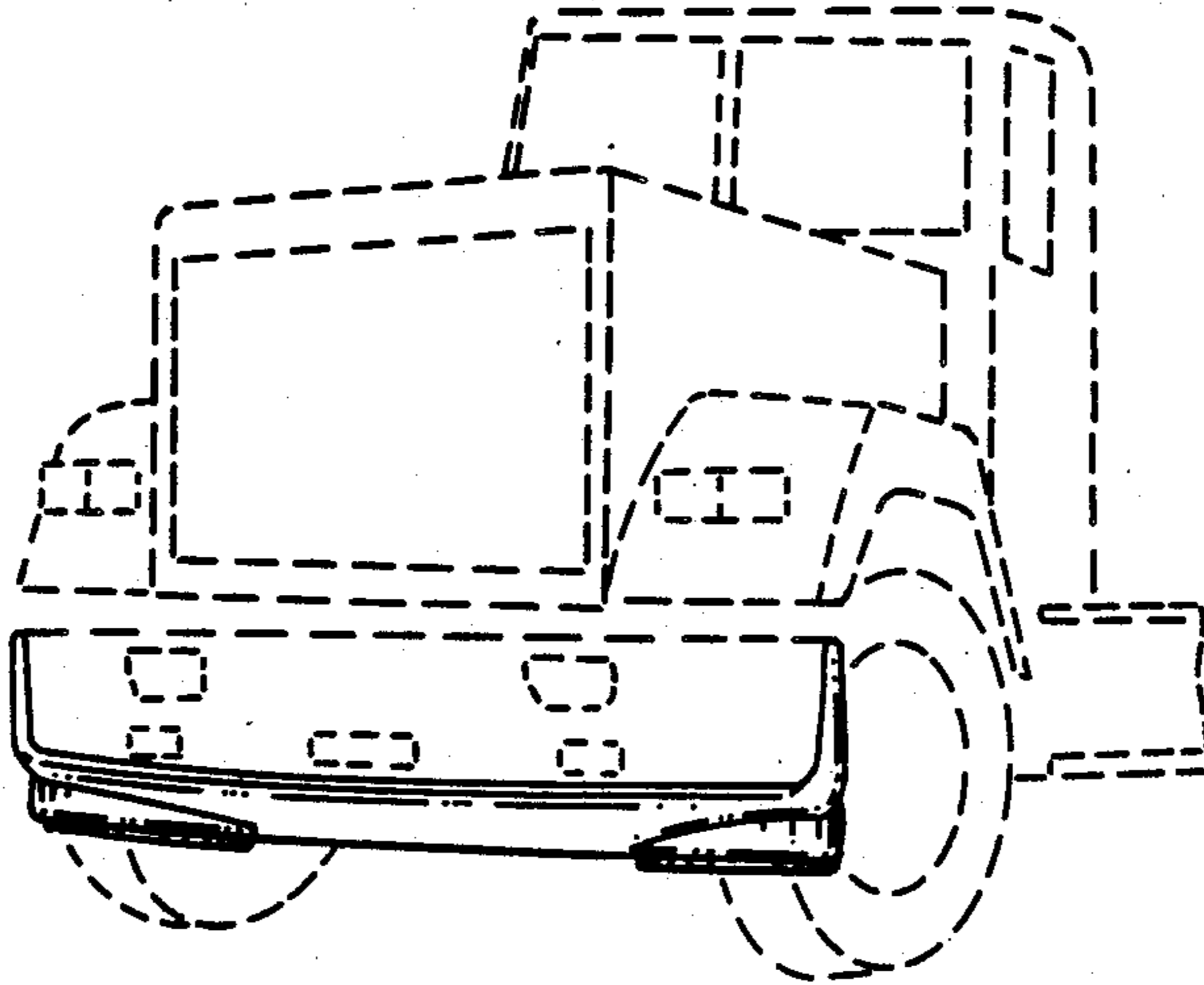
FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof.



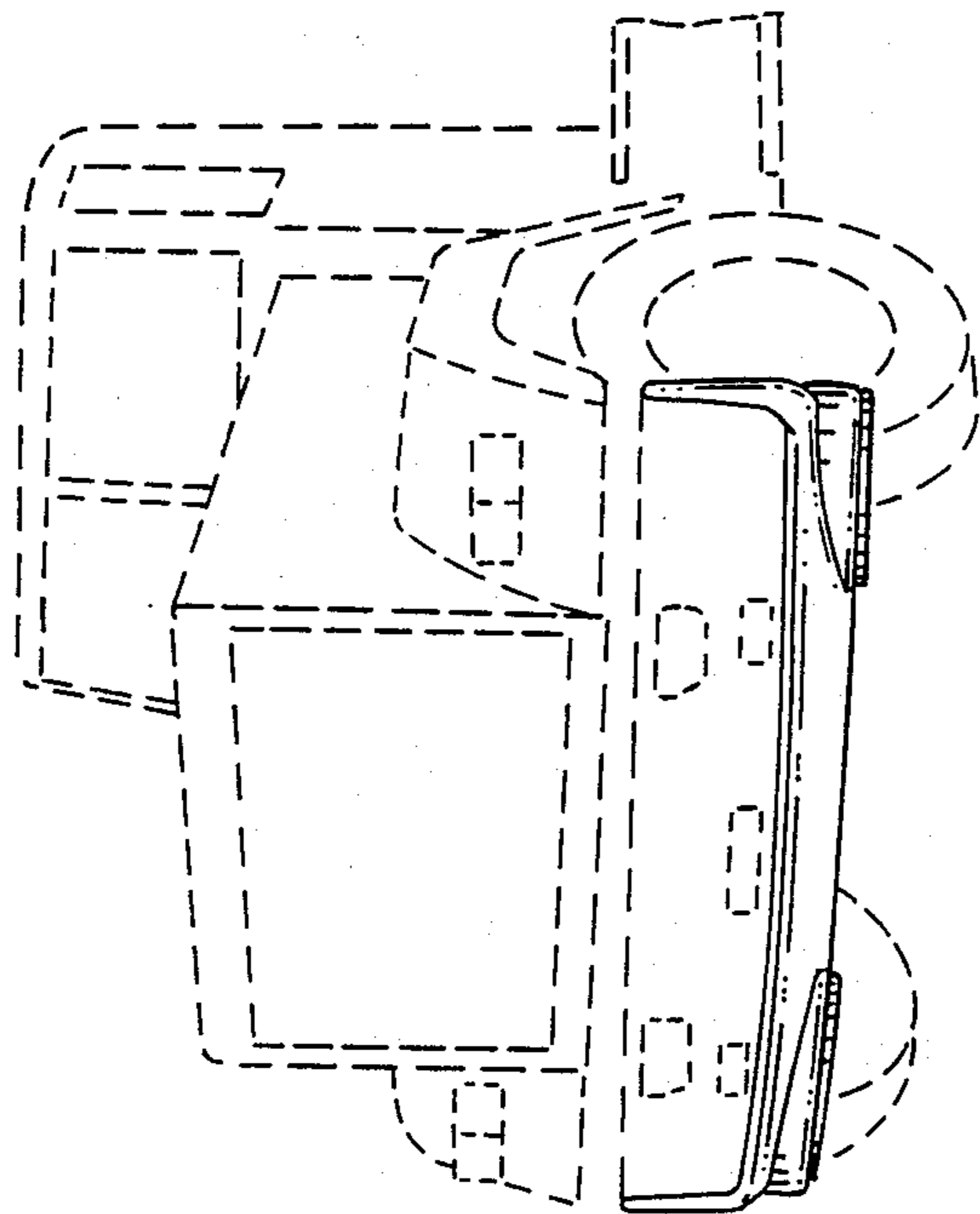

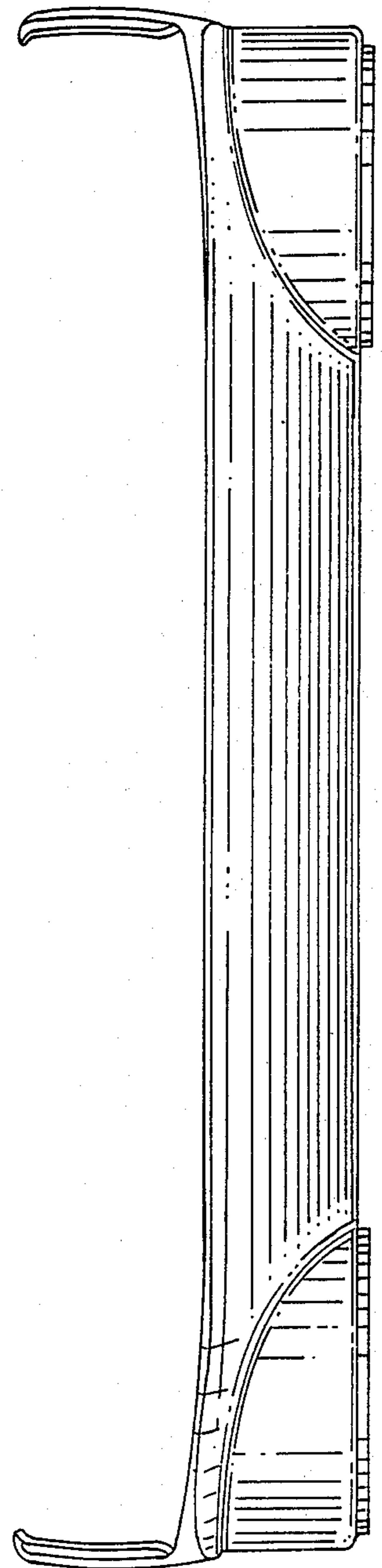

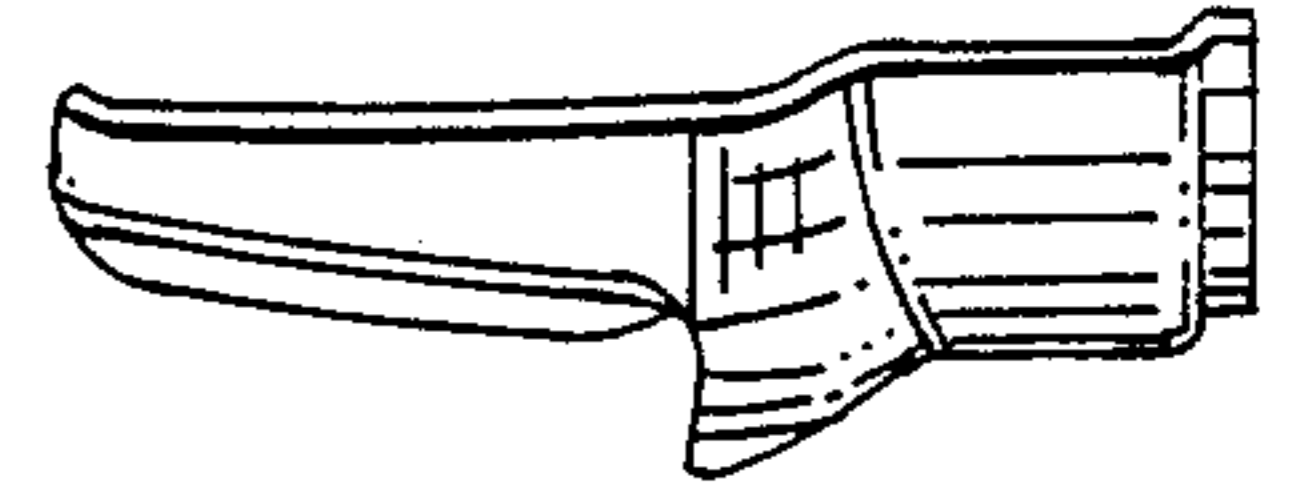

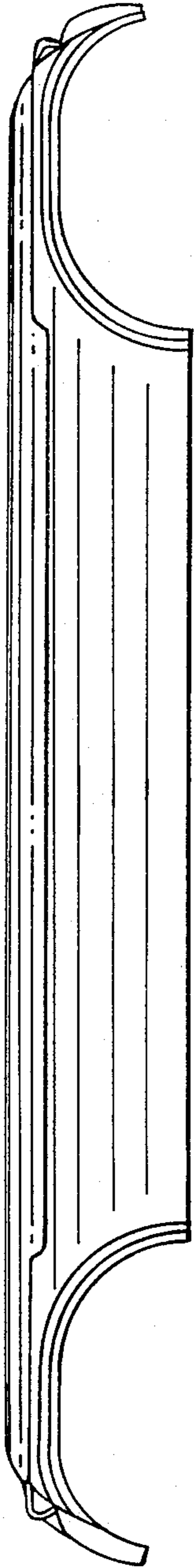

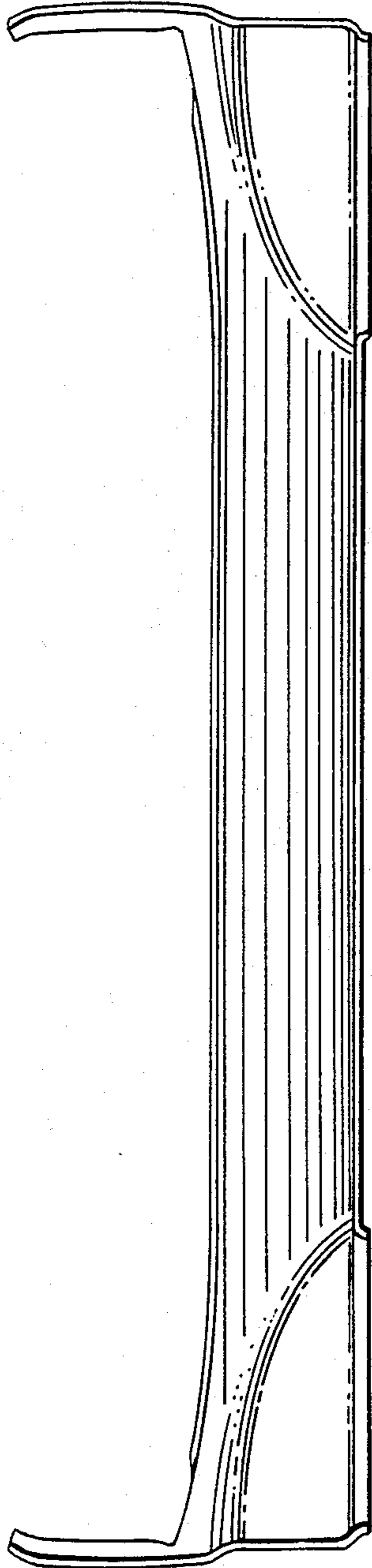
