DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a television receiver showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

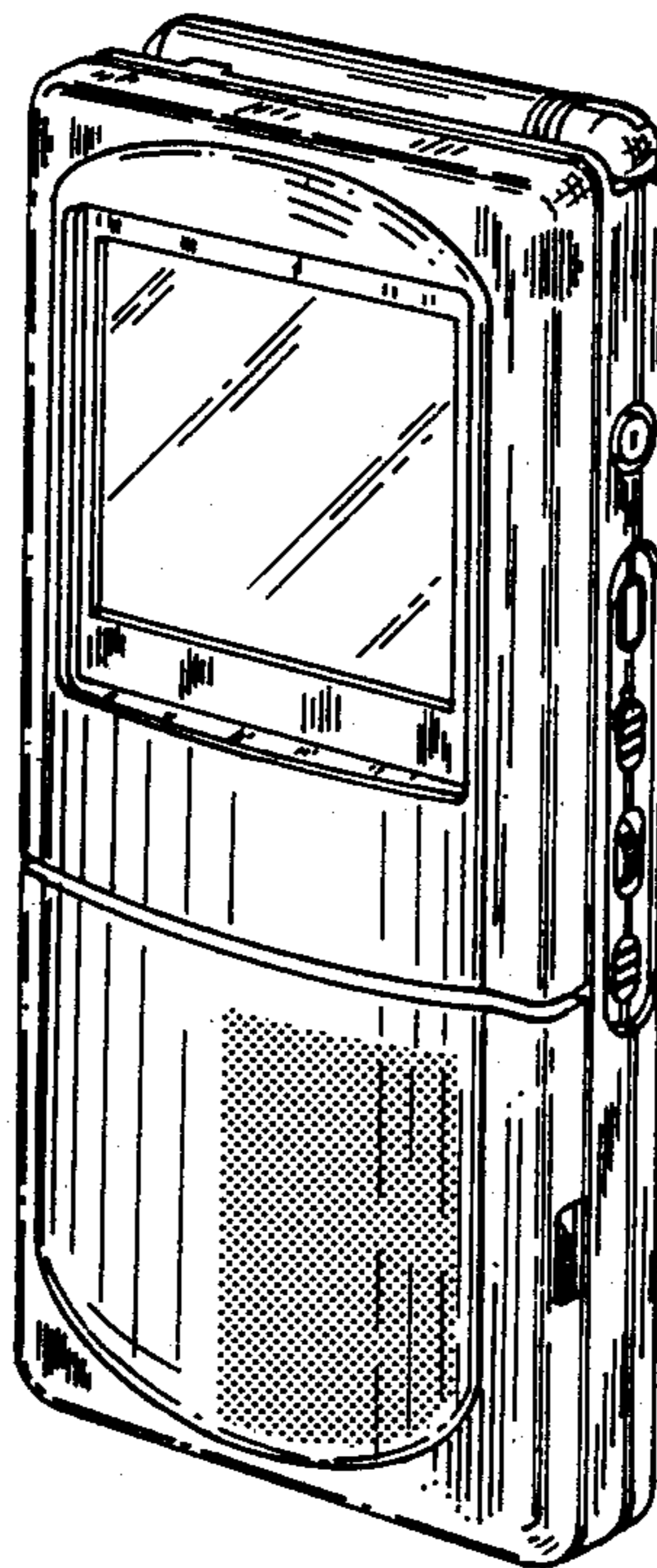

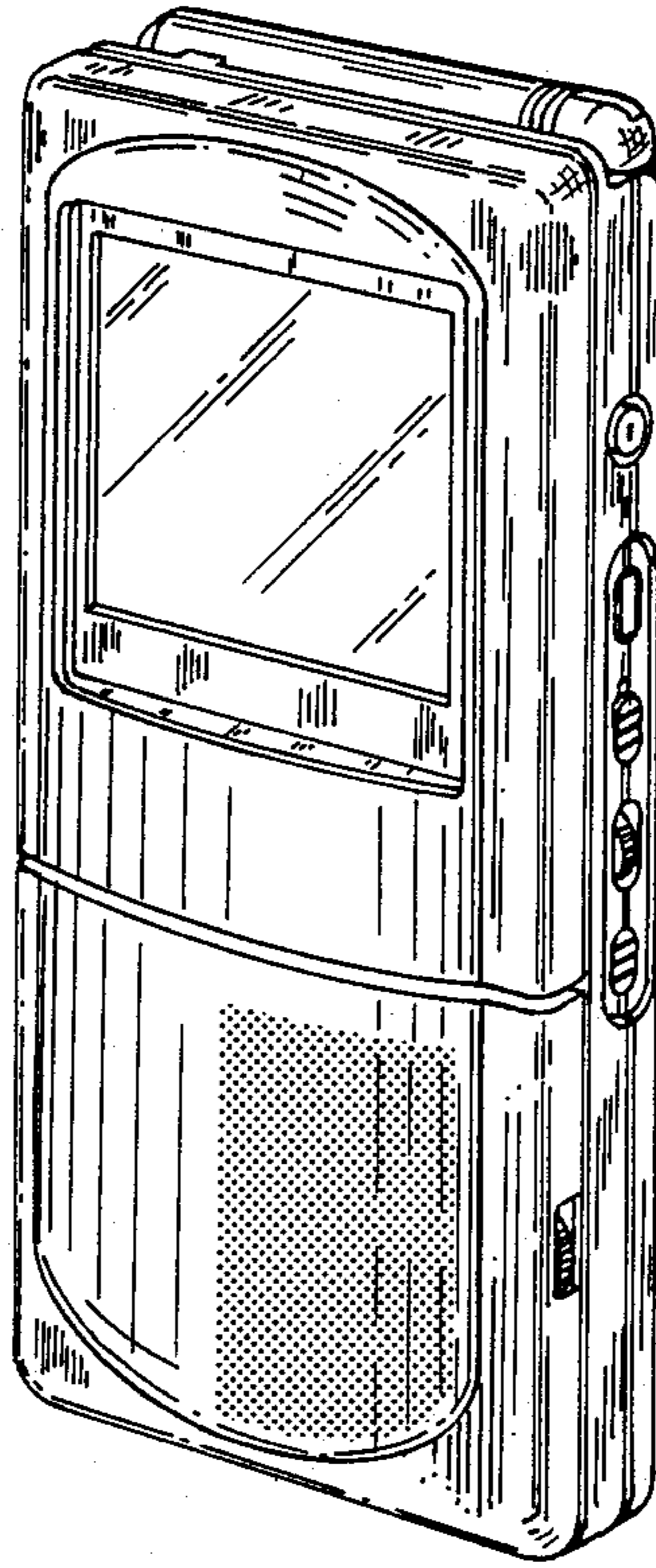

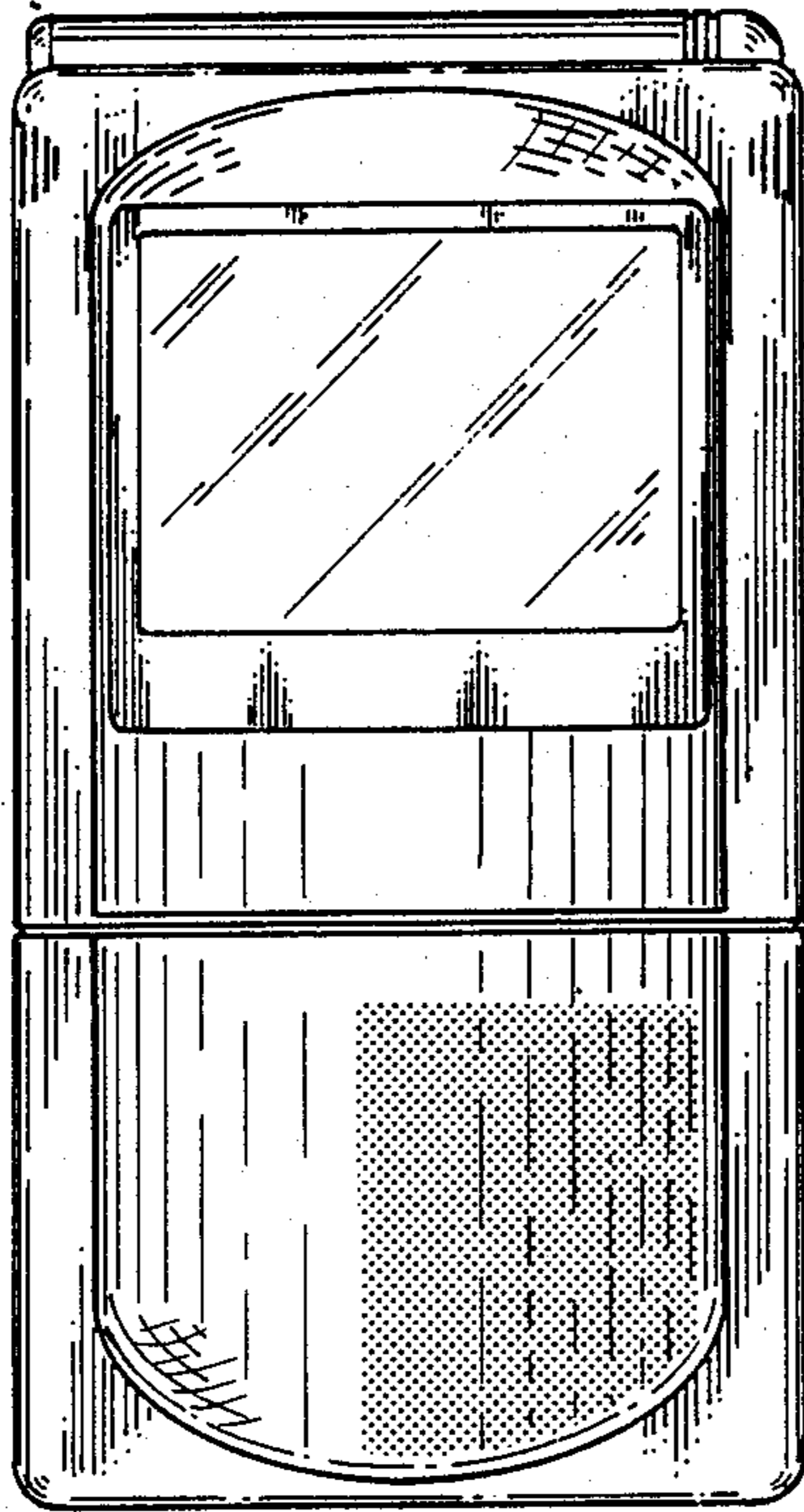

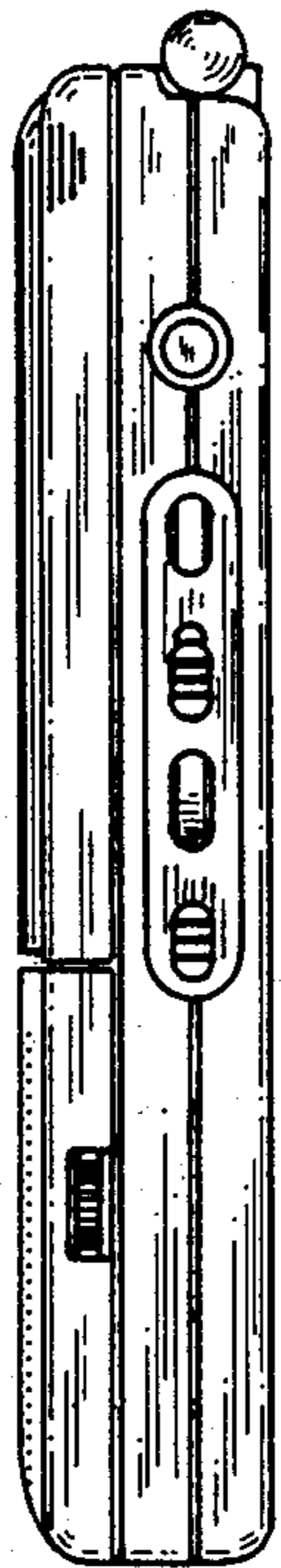
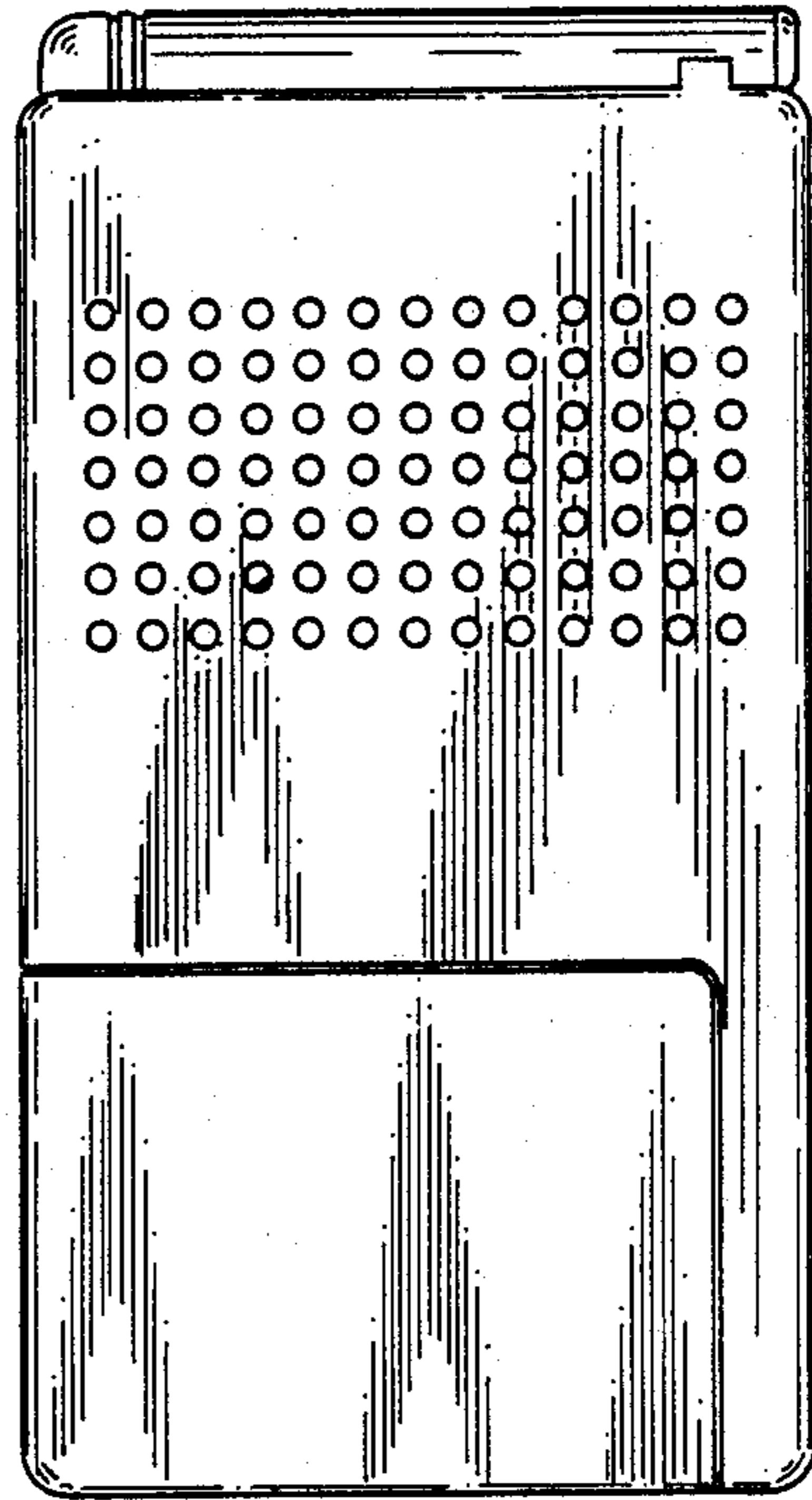

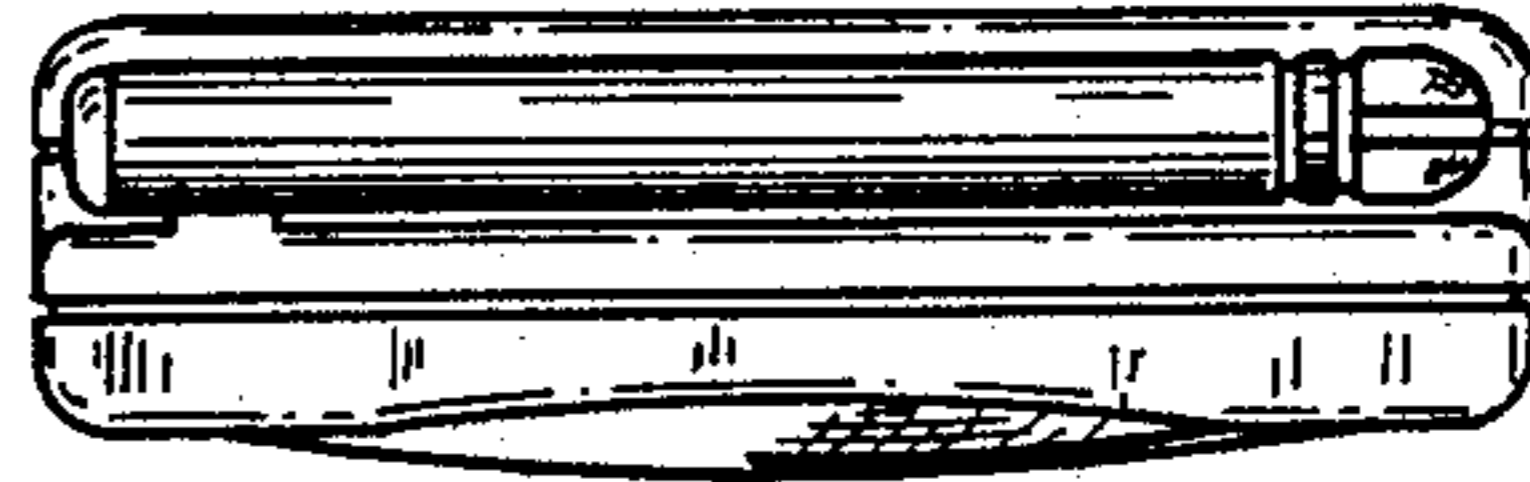
