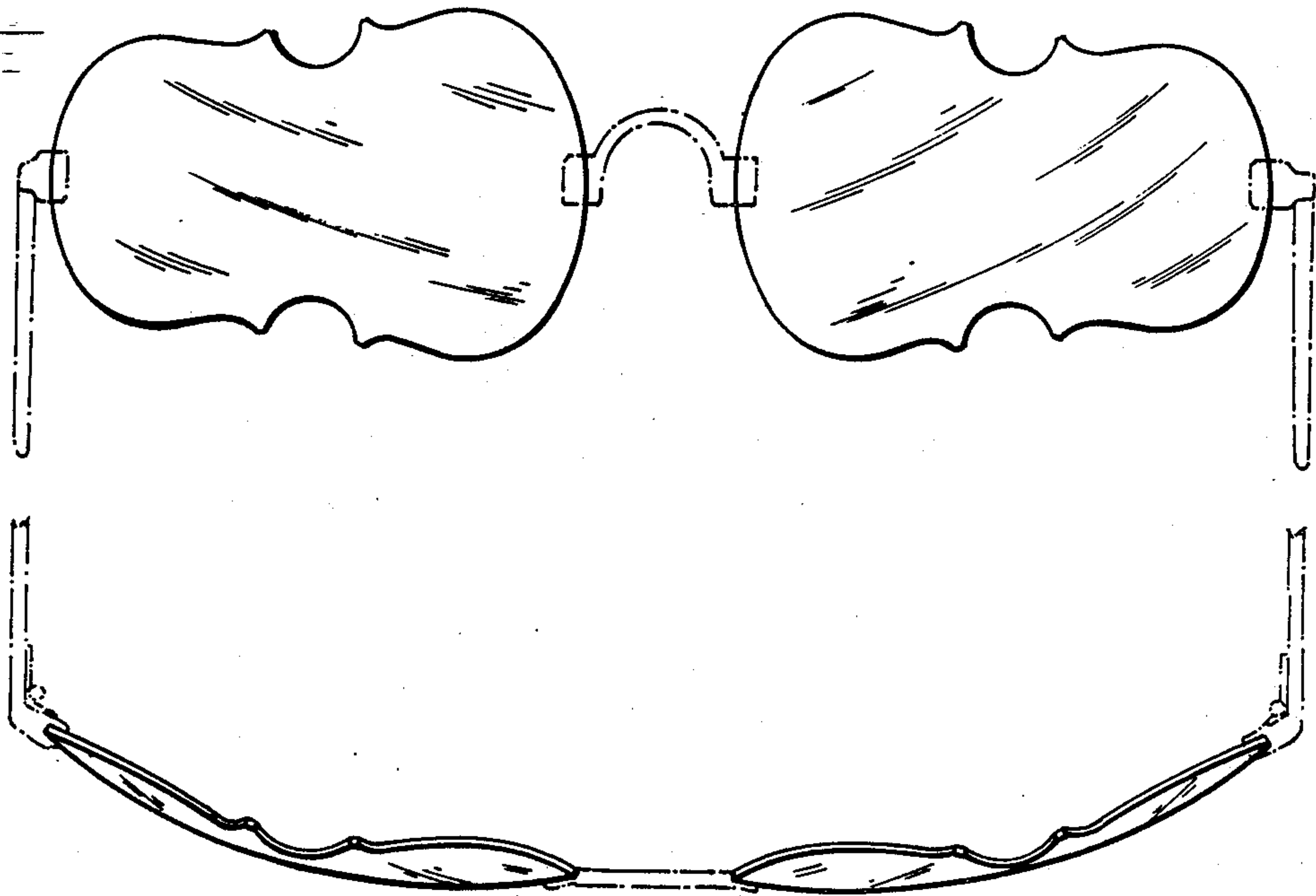

The ornamental design for eye wear or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the eyewear or similar article showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the eyewear or similar article showing an alternate embodiment of my new design;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of the temple and bridge portions thereof is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



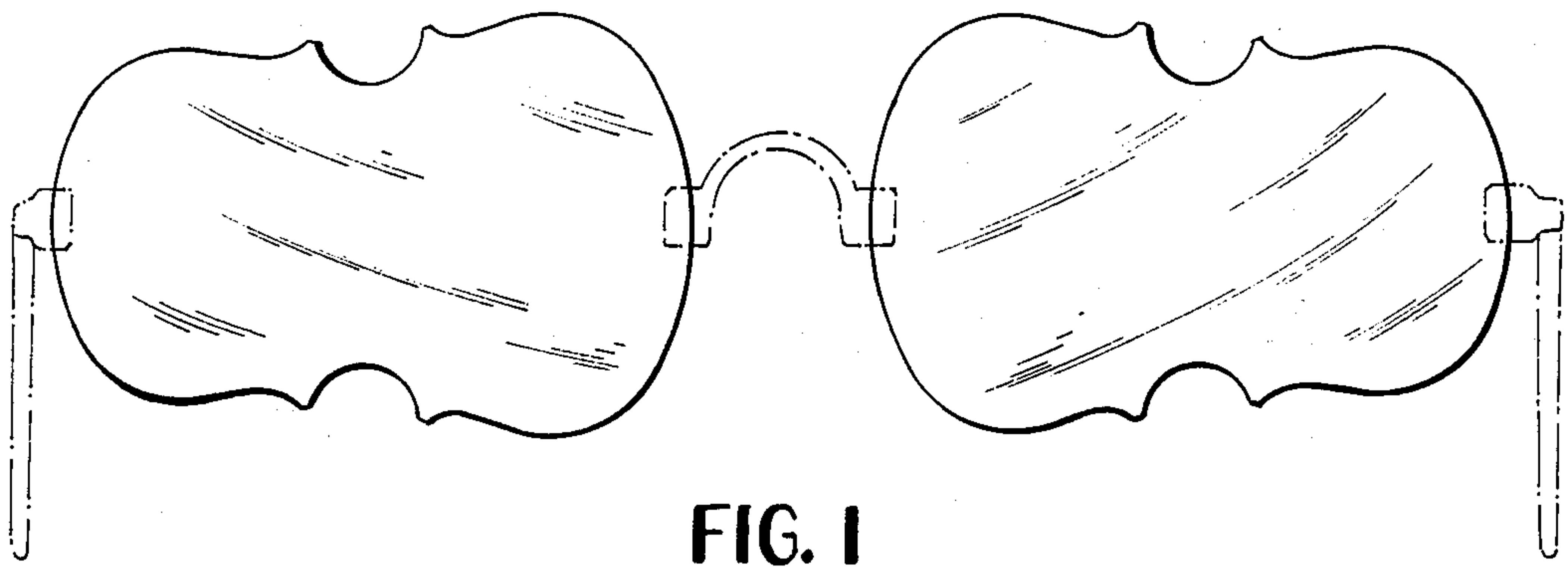

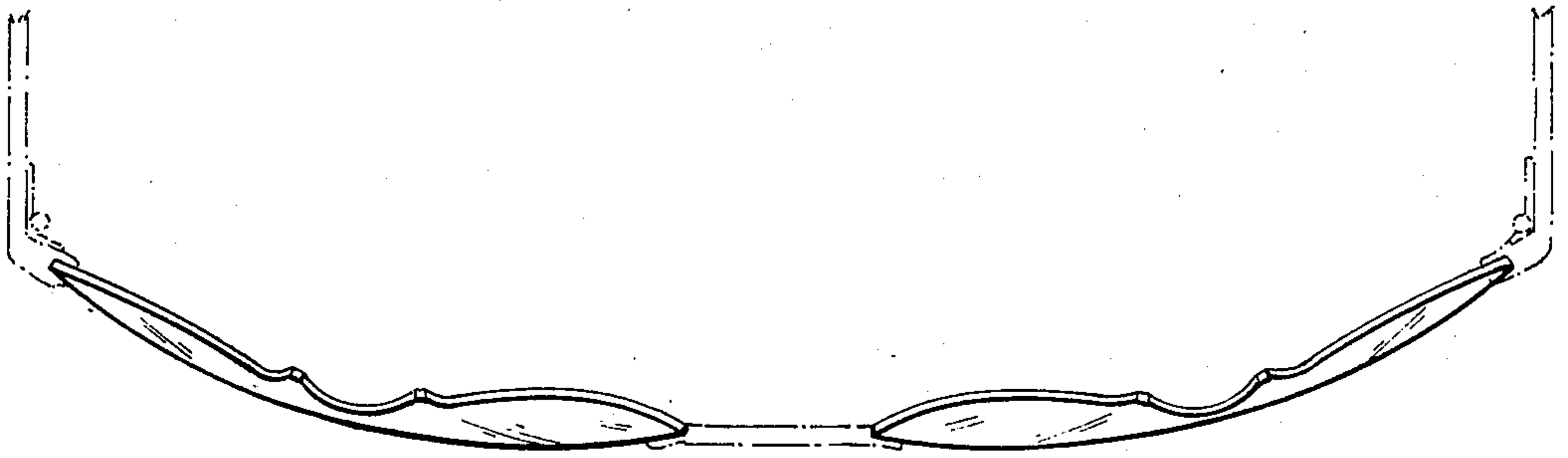

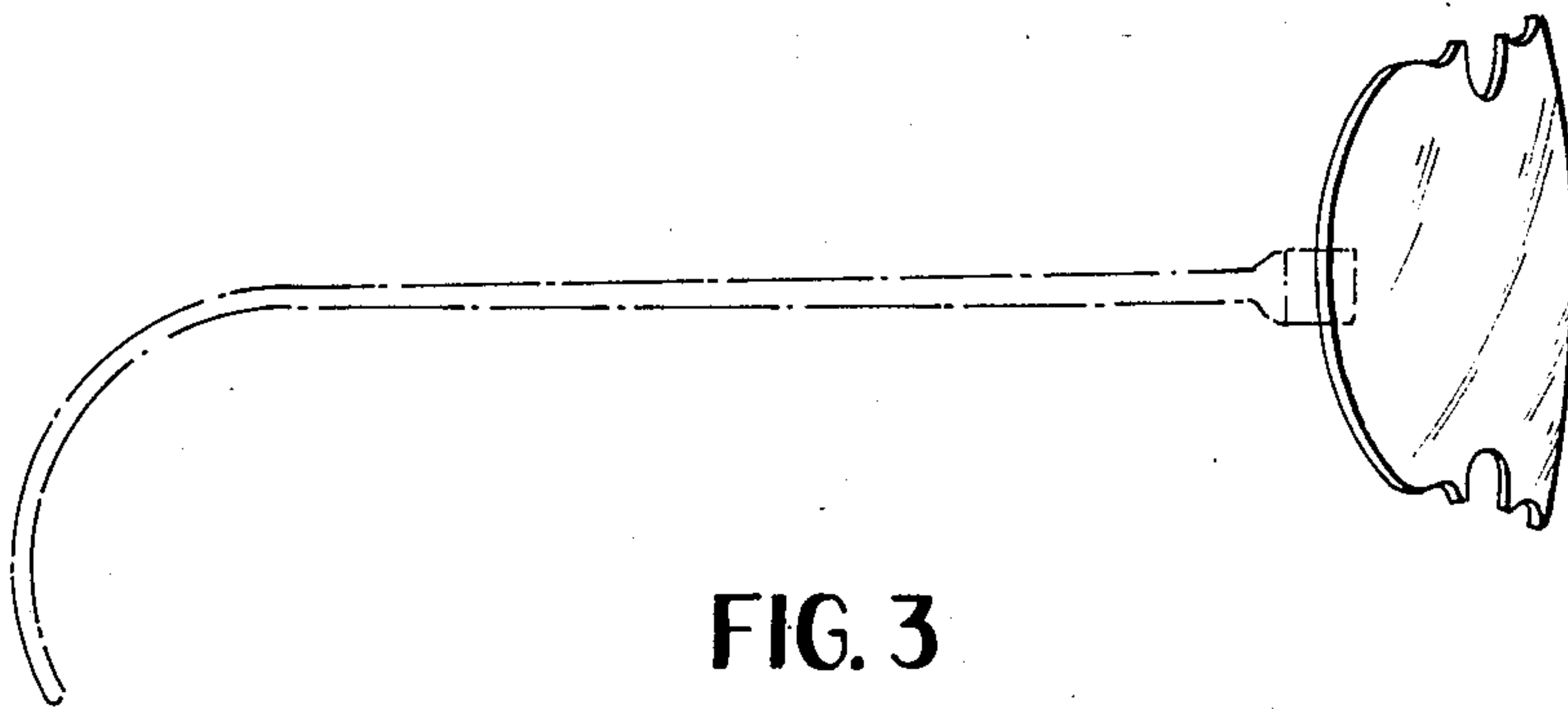

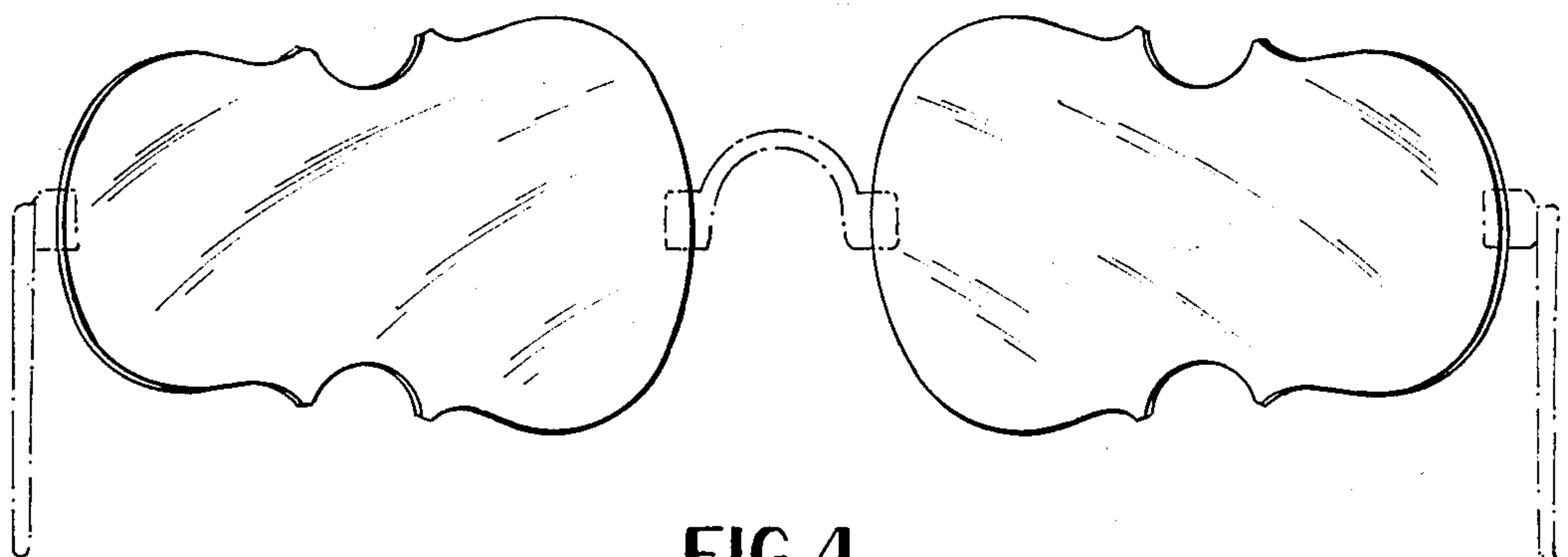

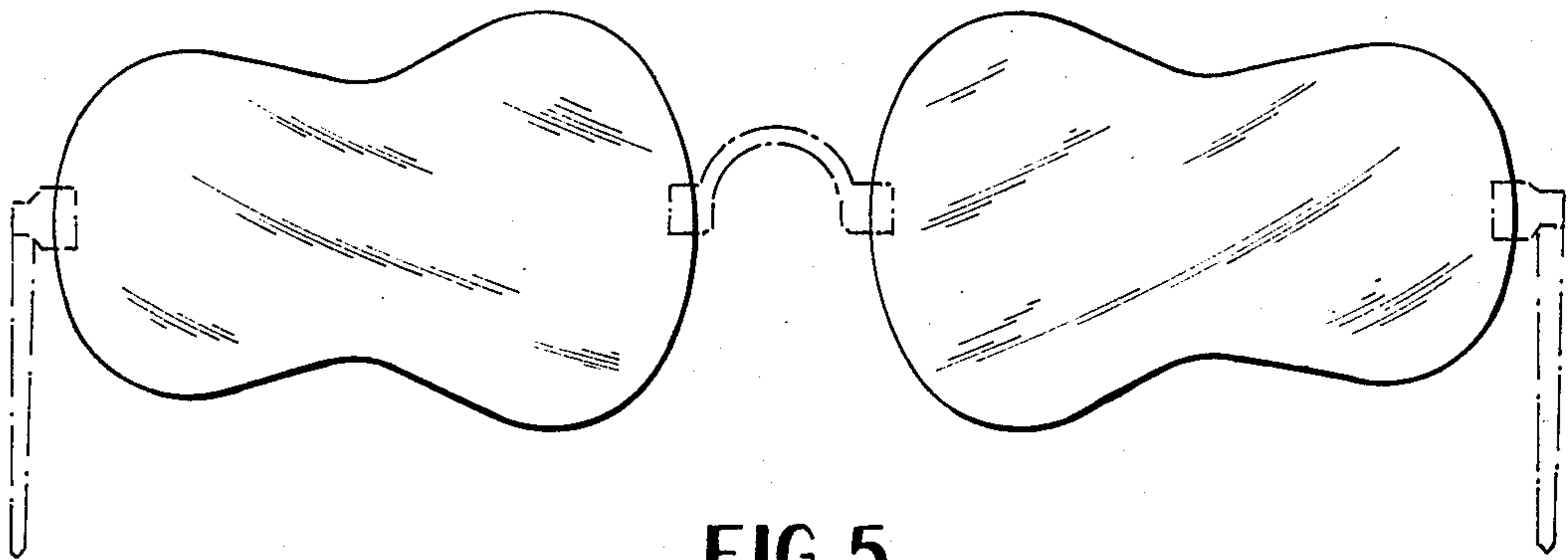

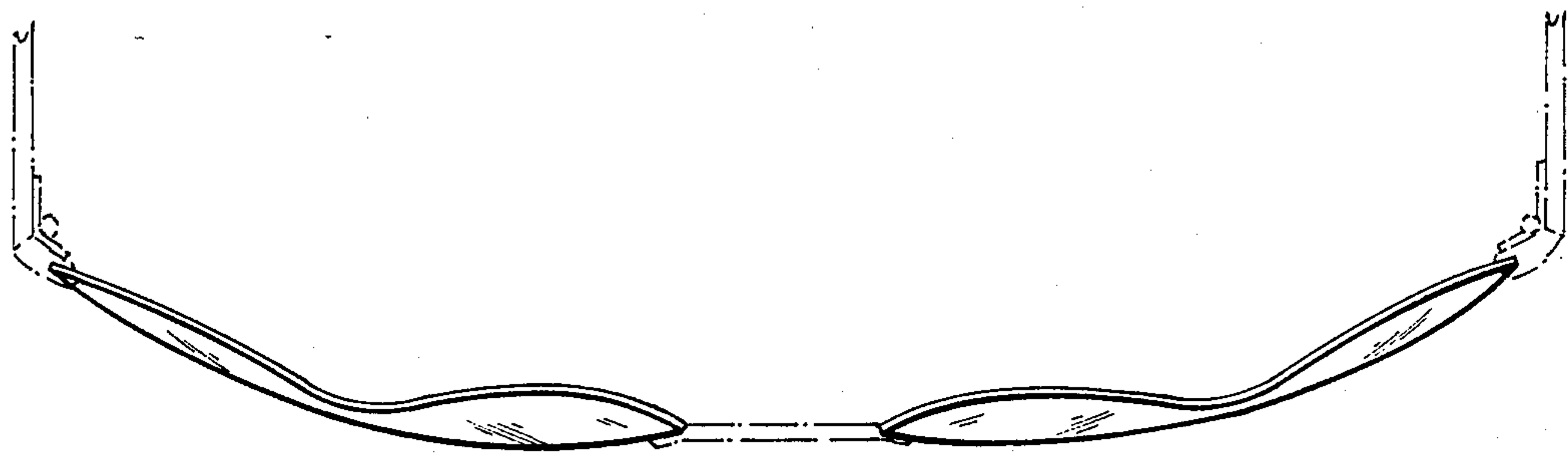

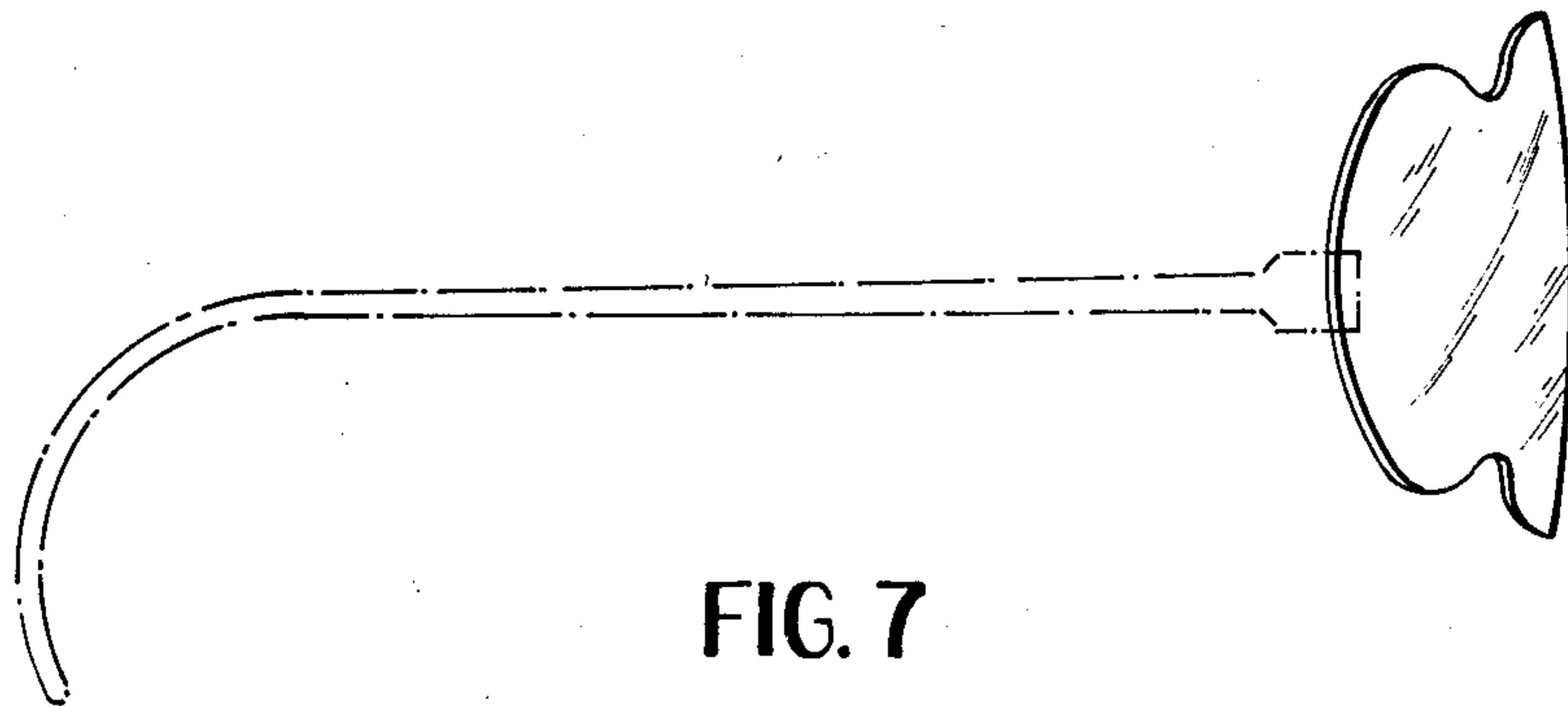

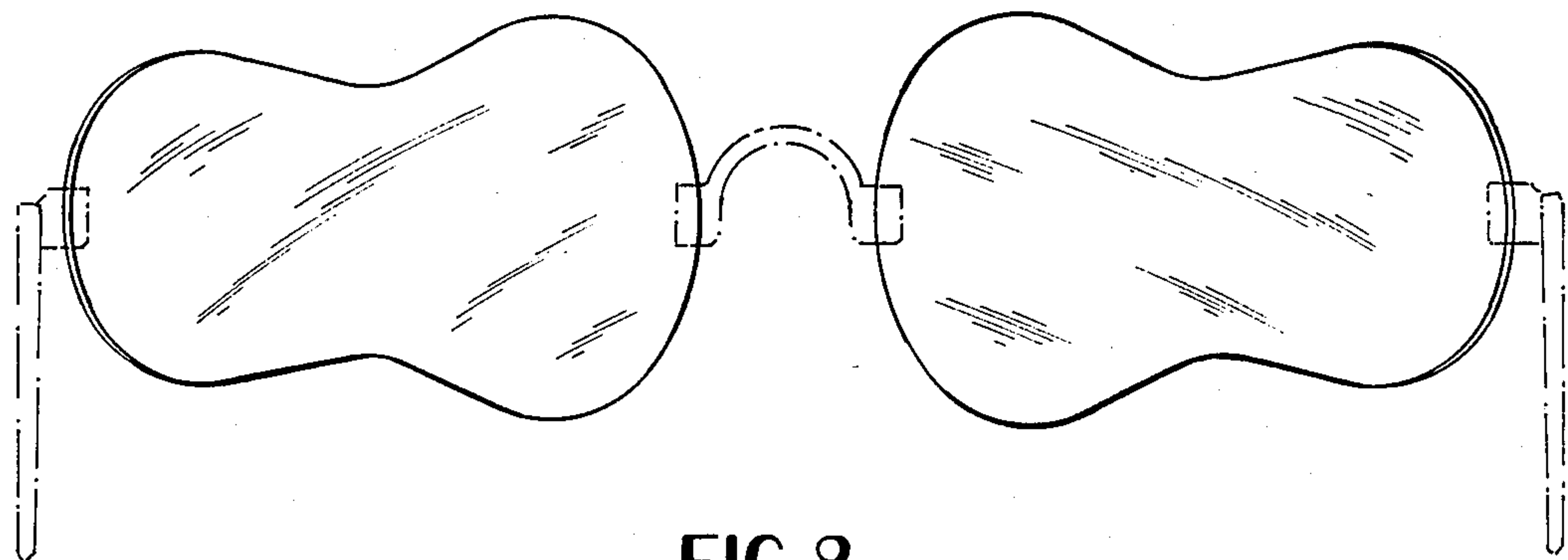
