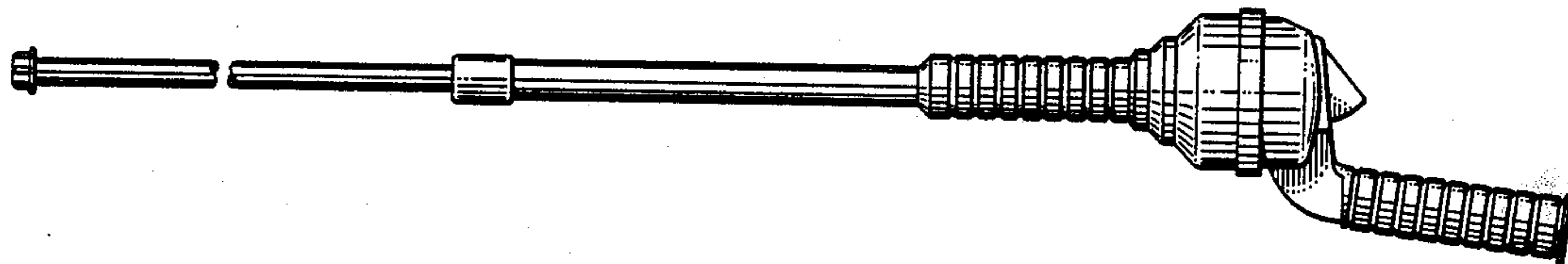

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a fishing pole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left-side elevational view of a fishing pole showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.
In FIGS. 1, 2, 4 and 5, the pole has been broken away in the center thereof to indicate indefinite length.



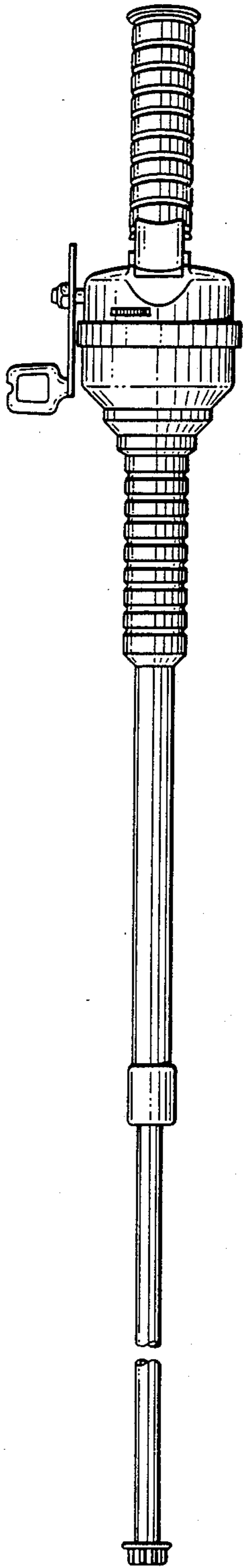

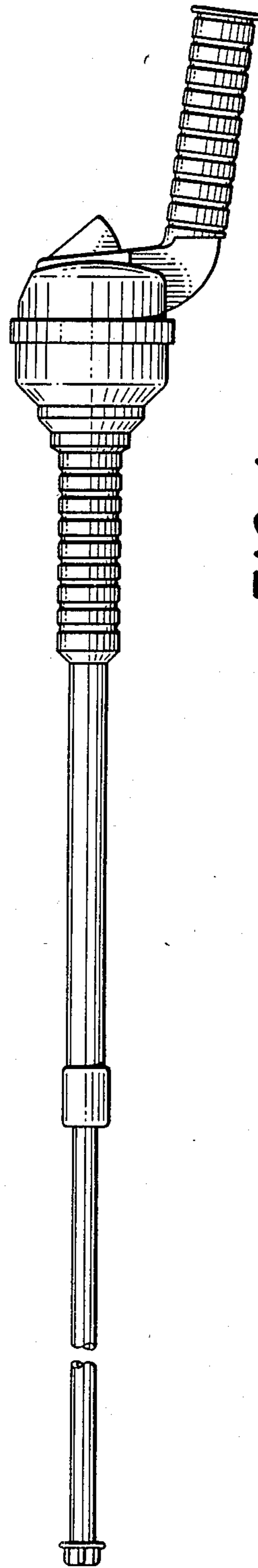

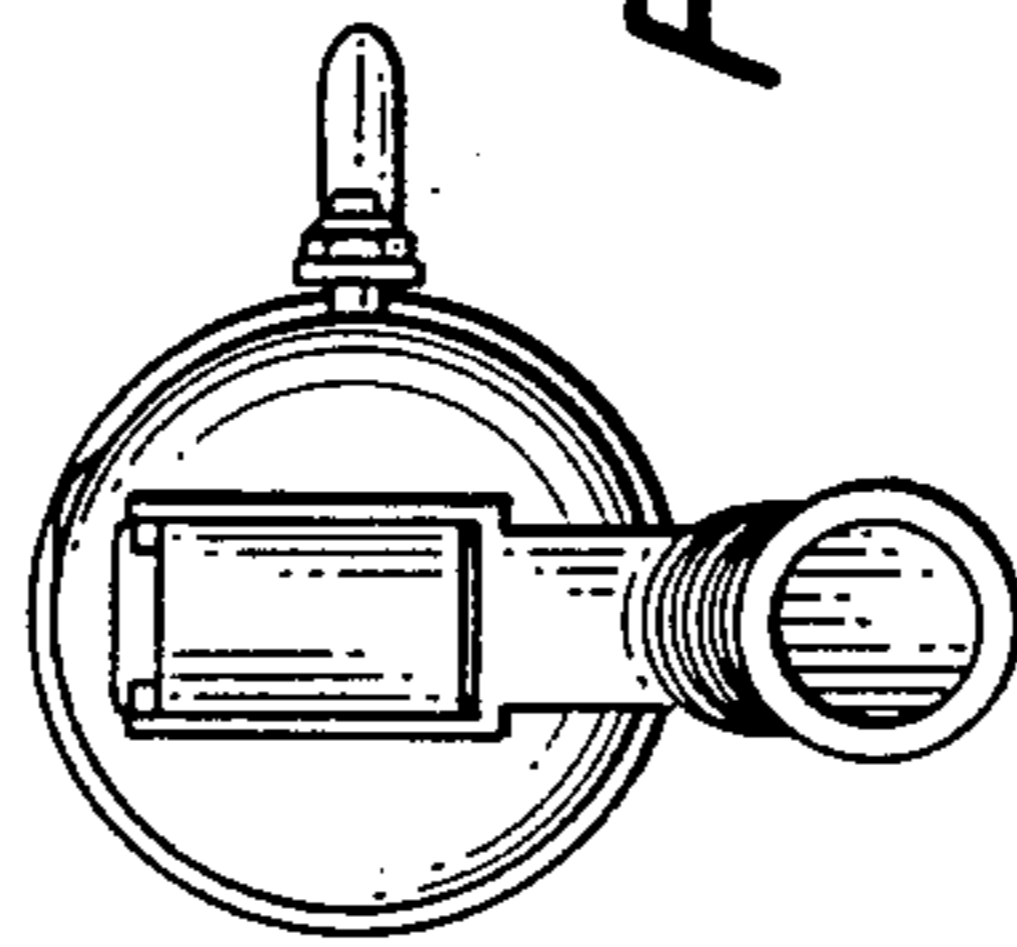

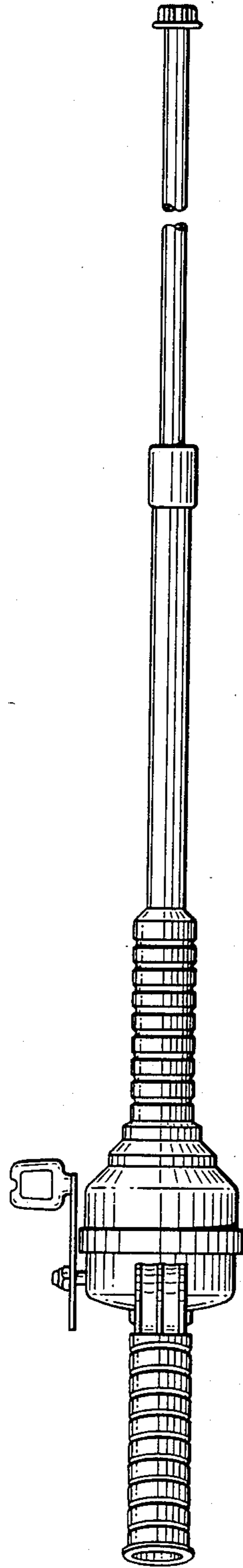

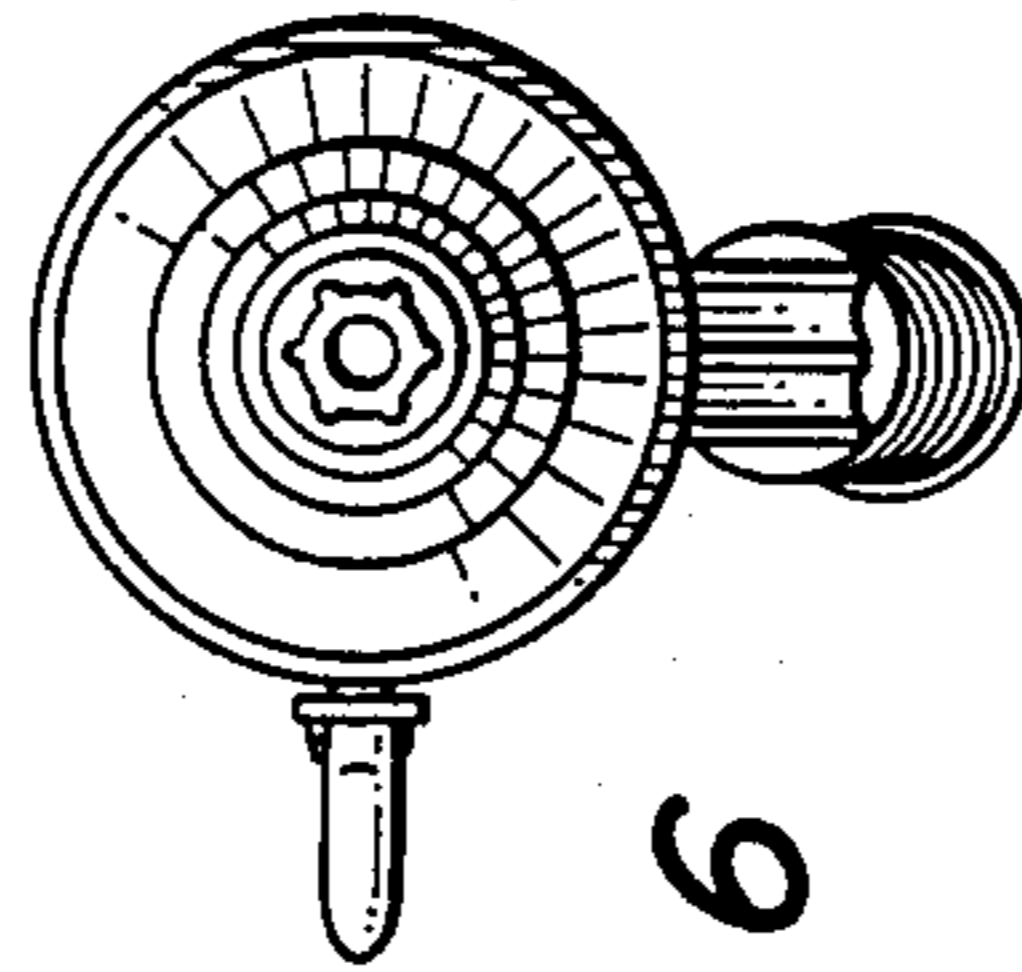

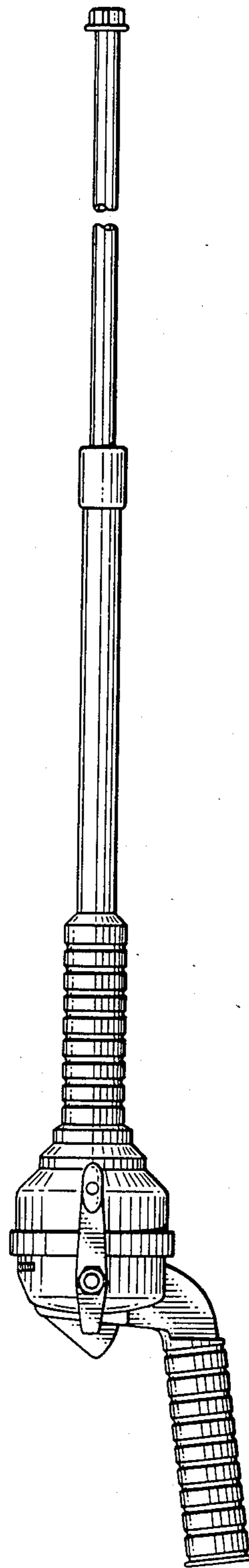
