DESCRIPTION

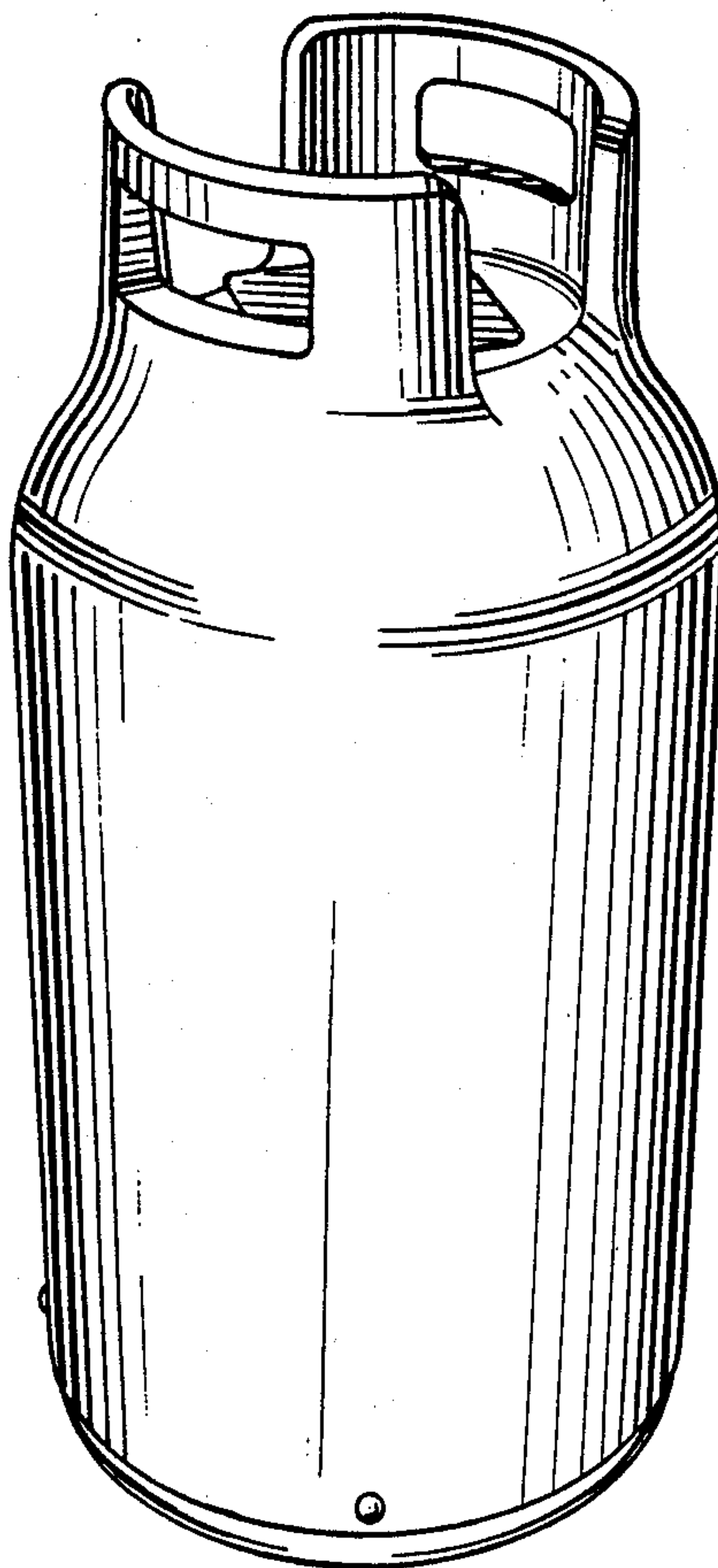
FIG. 1 is a top side perspective view of a container for pressurized fluids showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



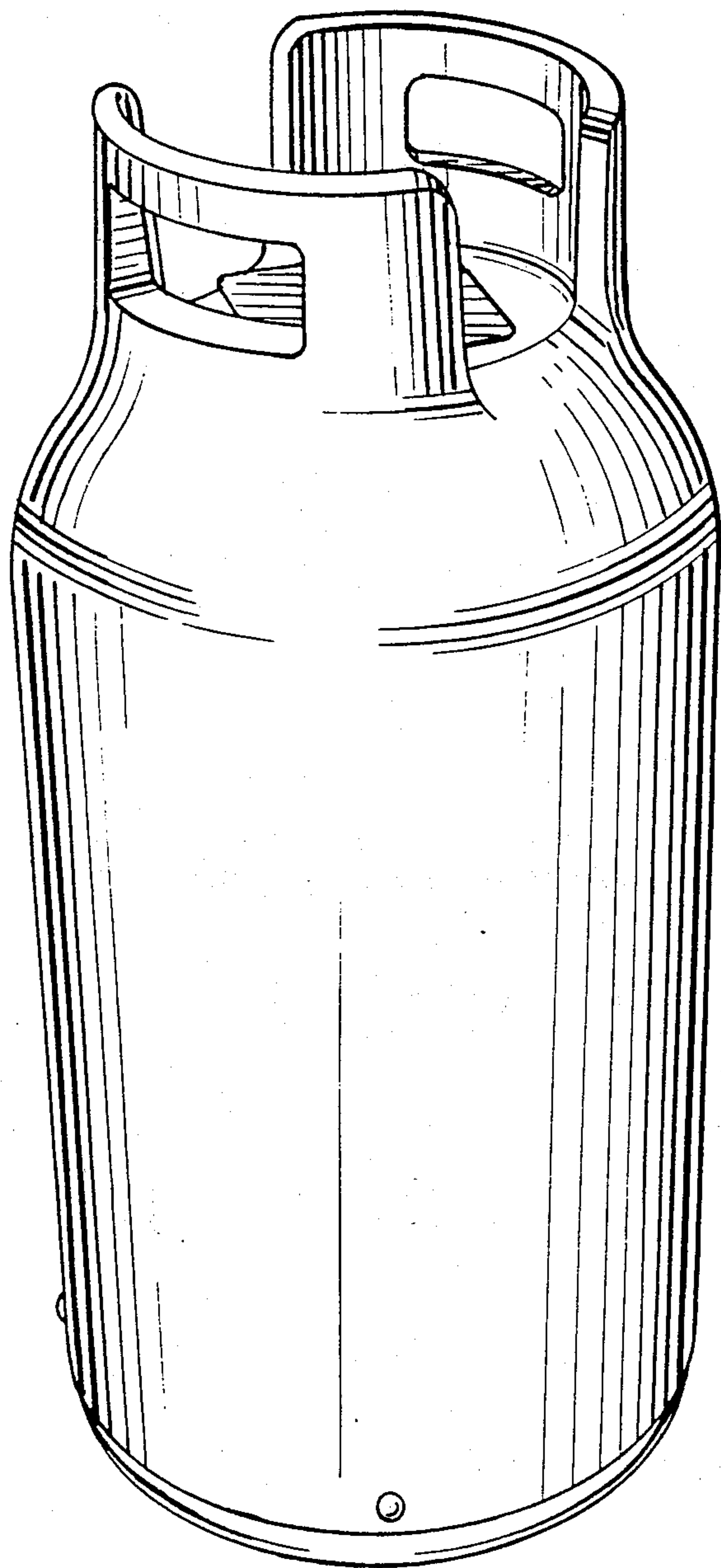

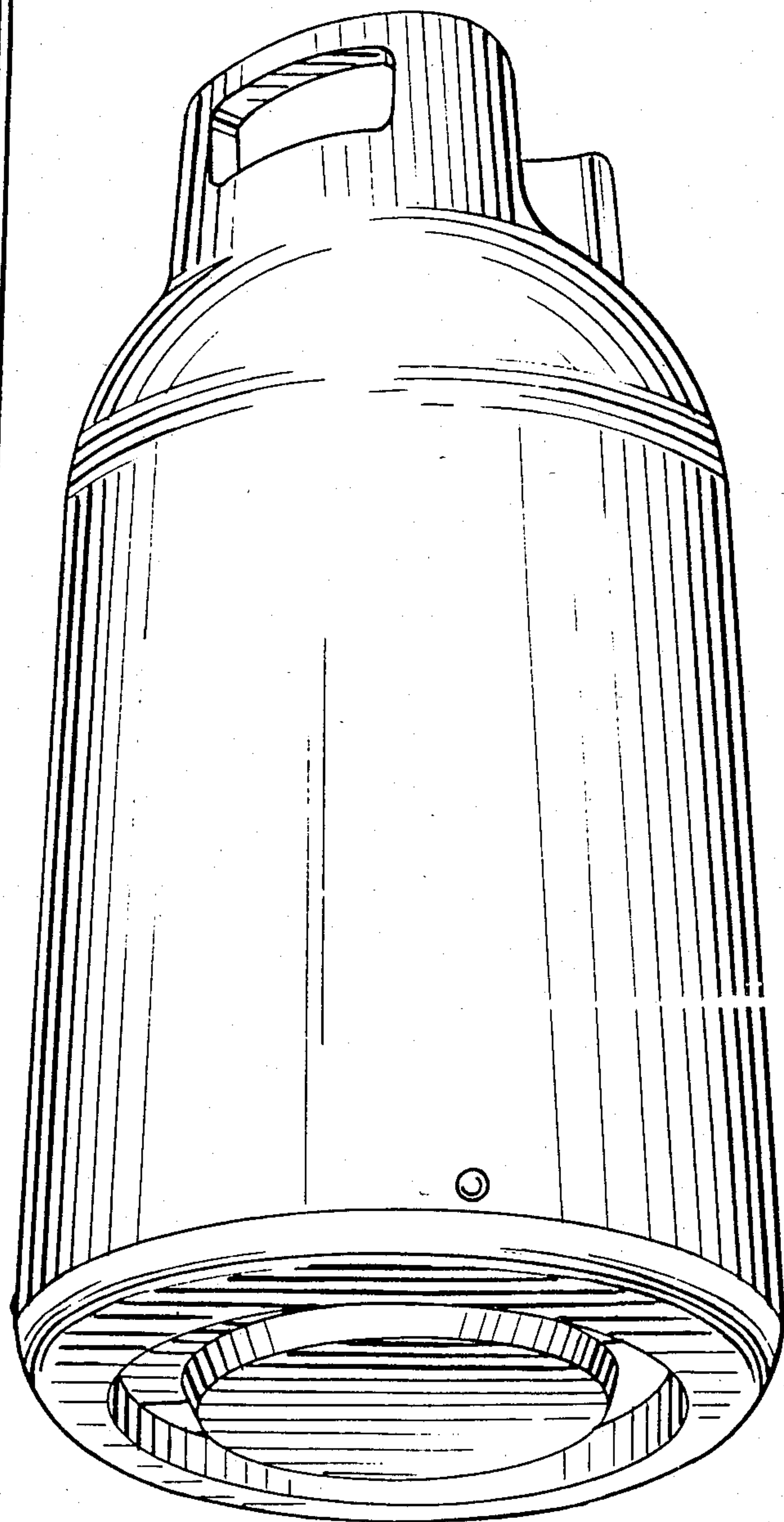

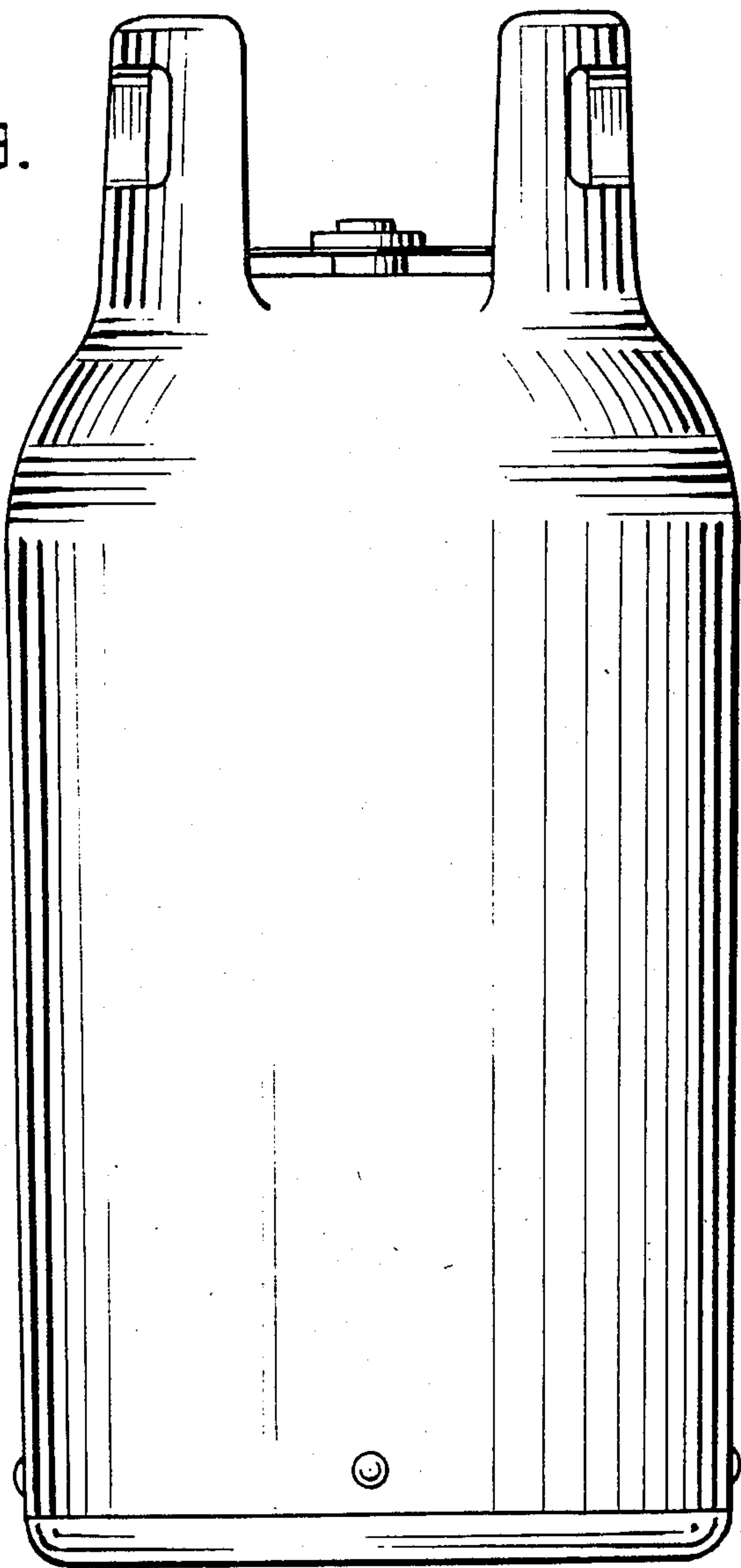

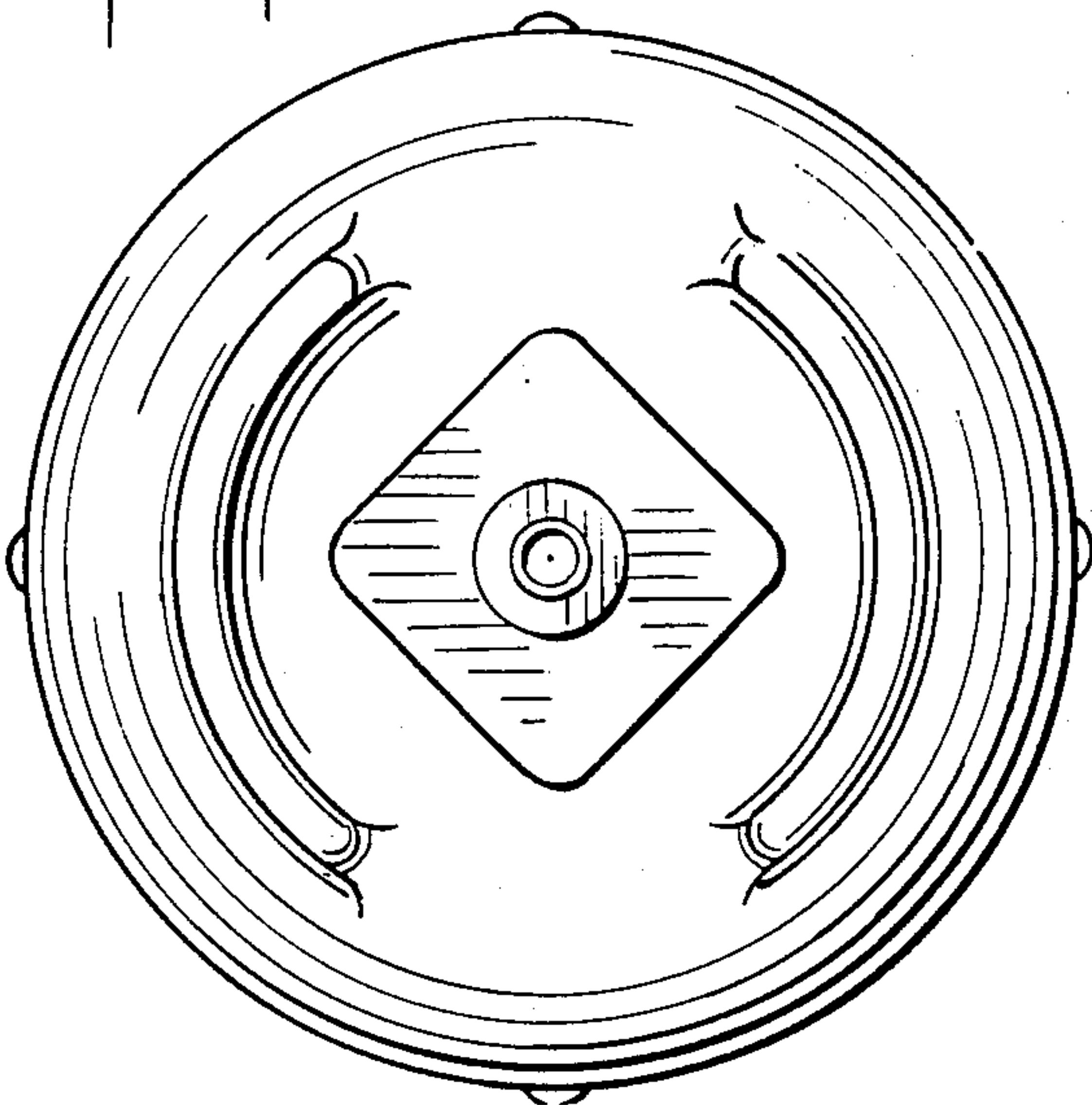
