DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a toilet seat showing our new design;

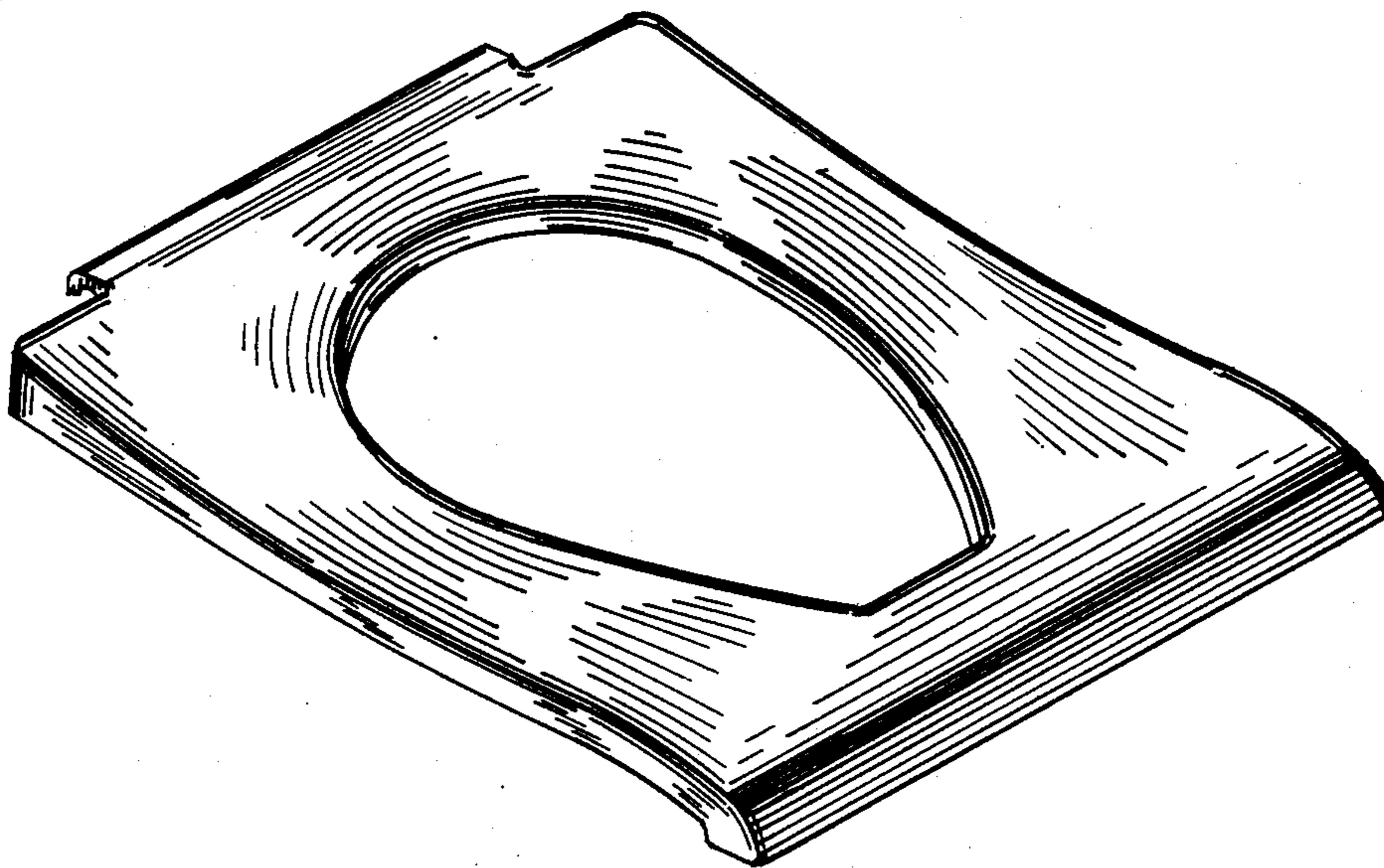
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



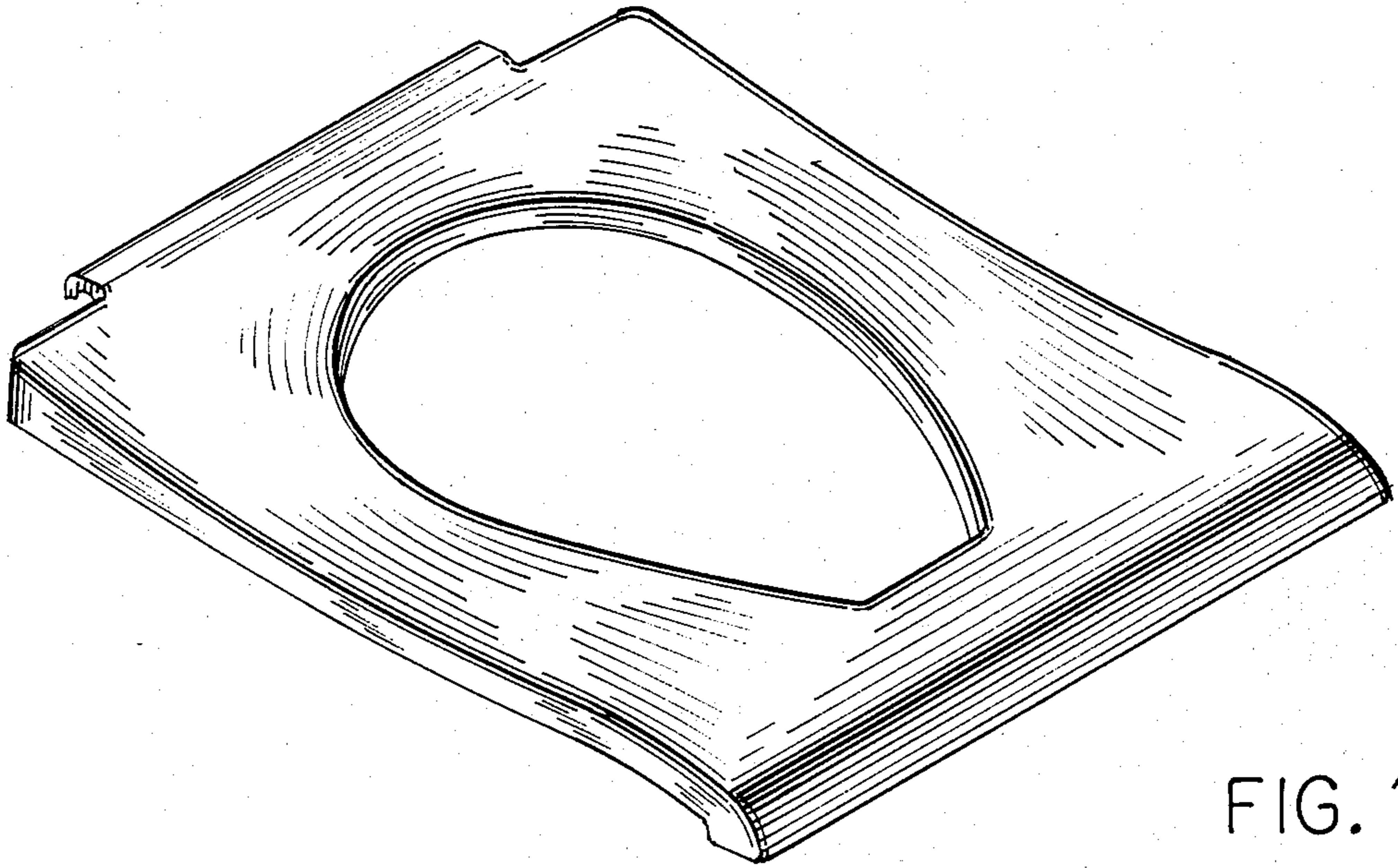

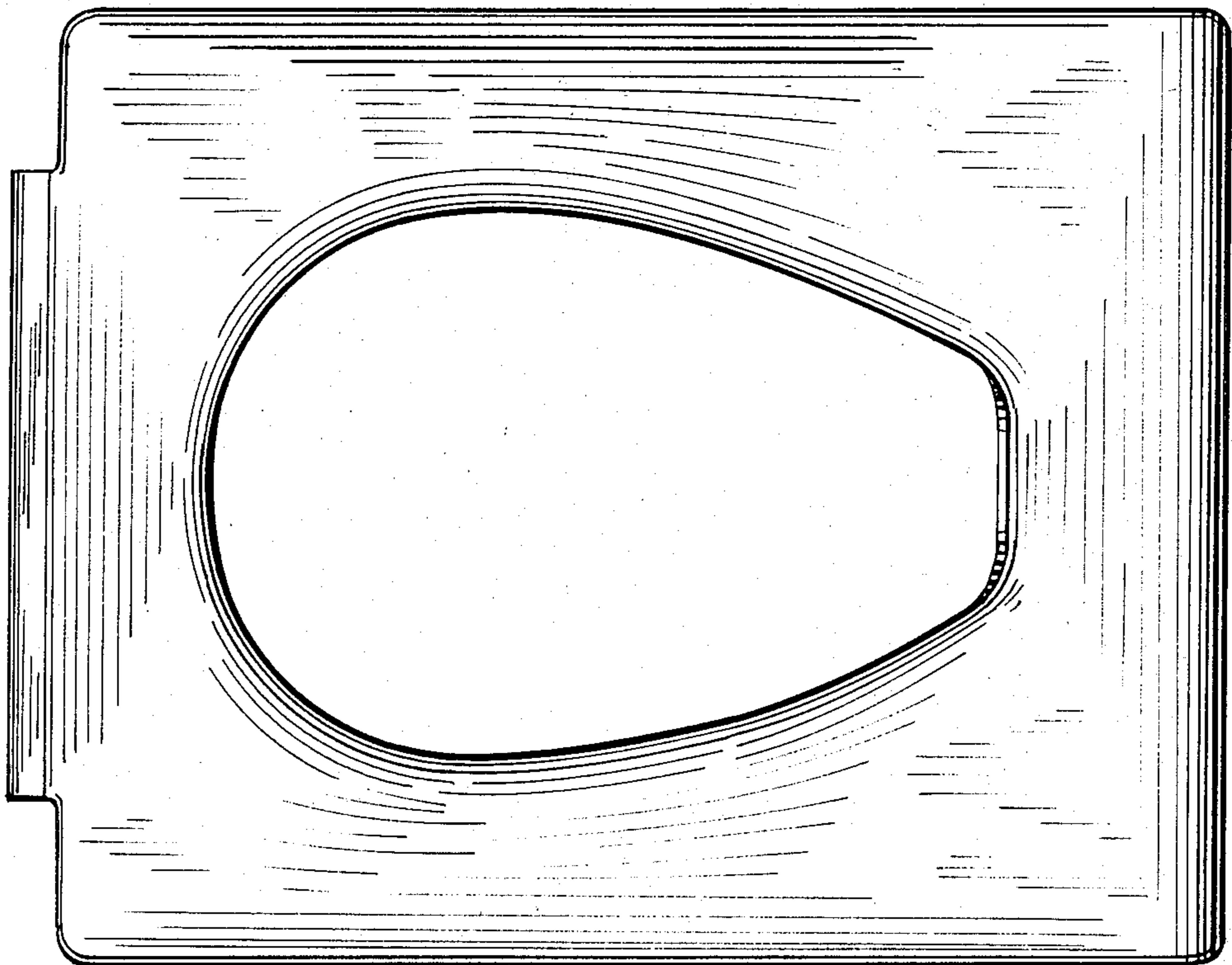

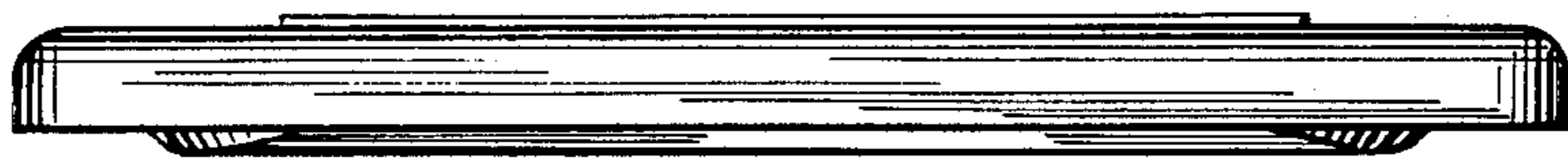

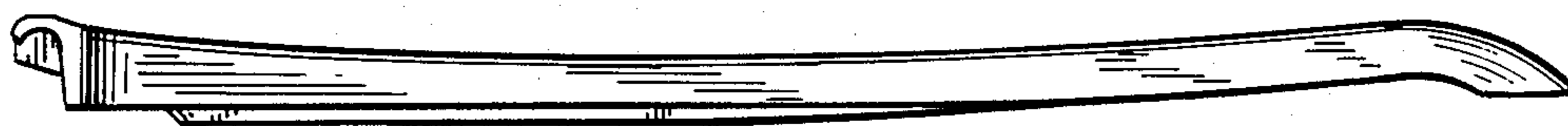

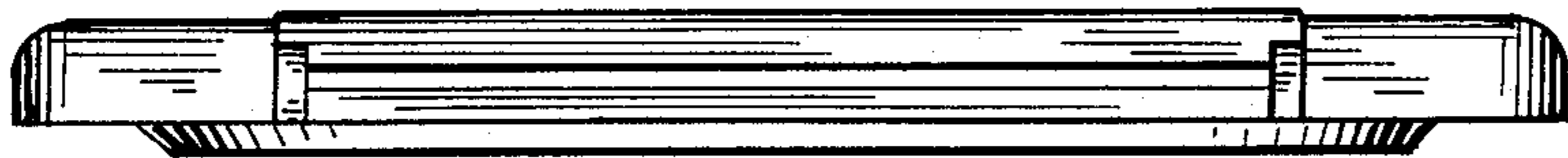
