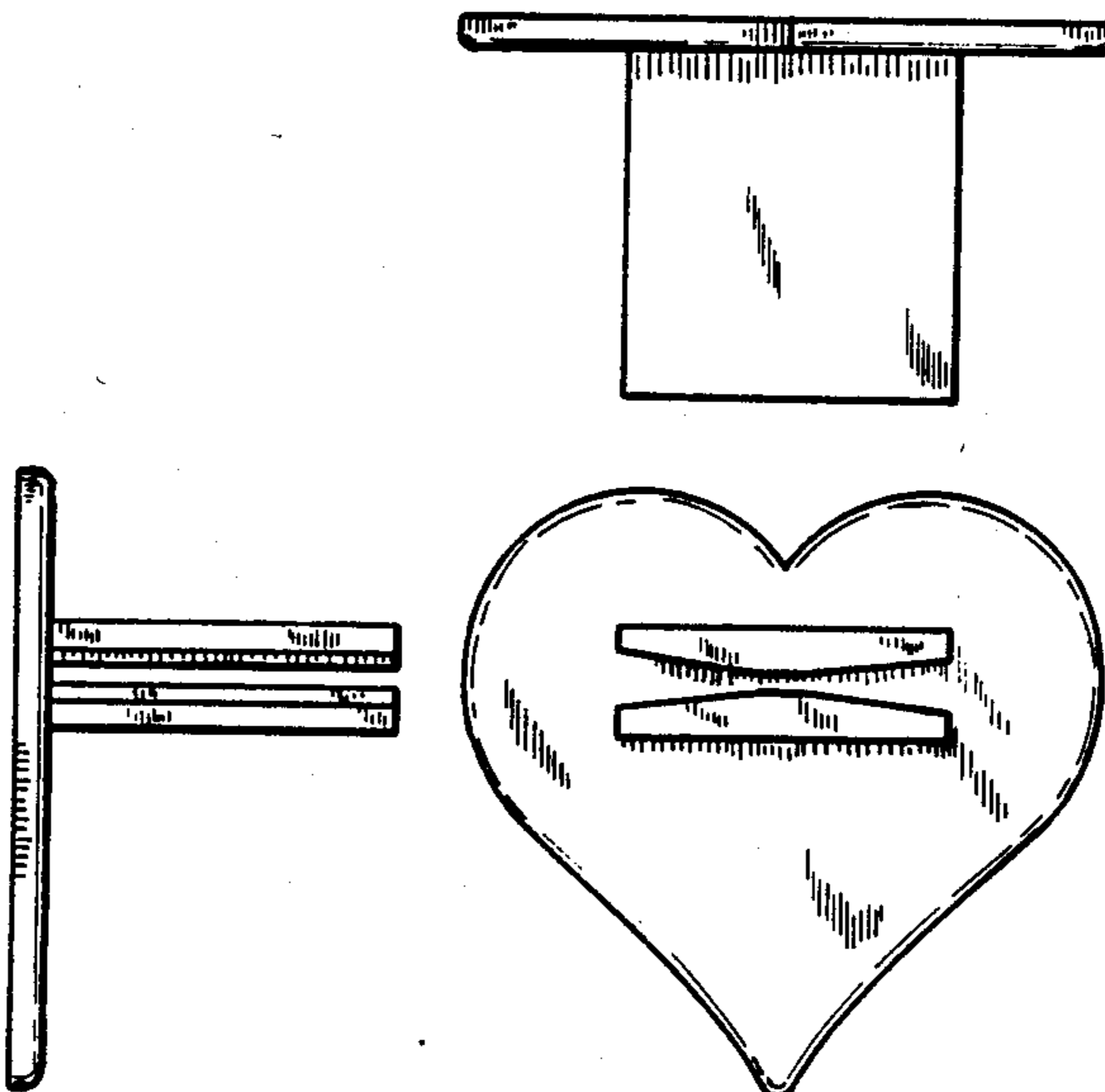

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a device for interlocking tongue-and-groove type bags, showing my new design;

 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



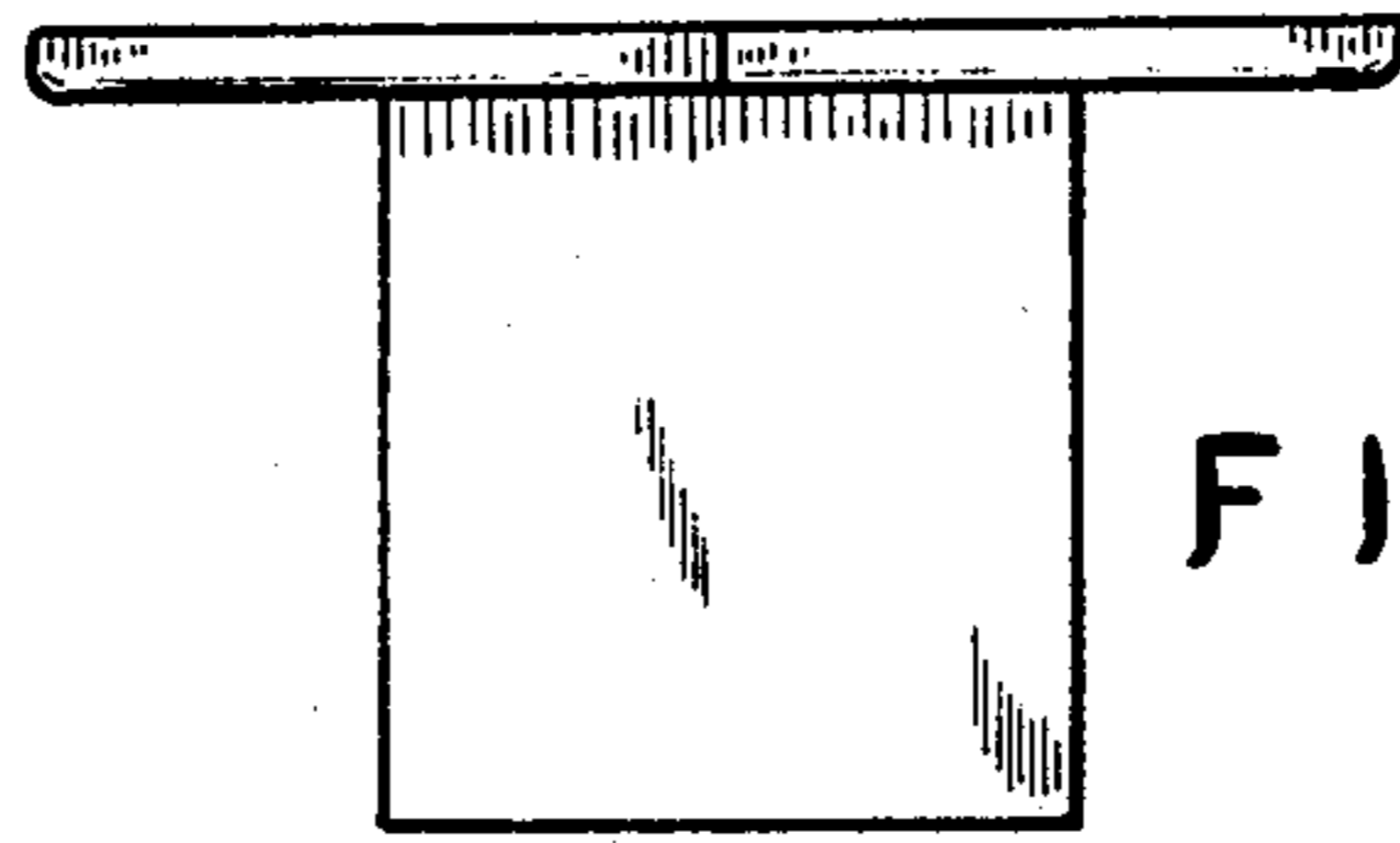

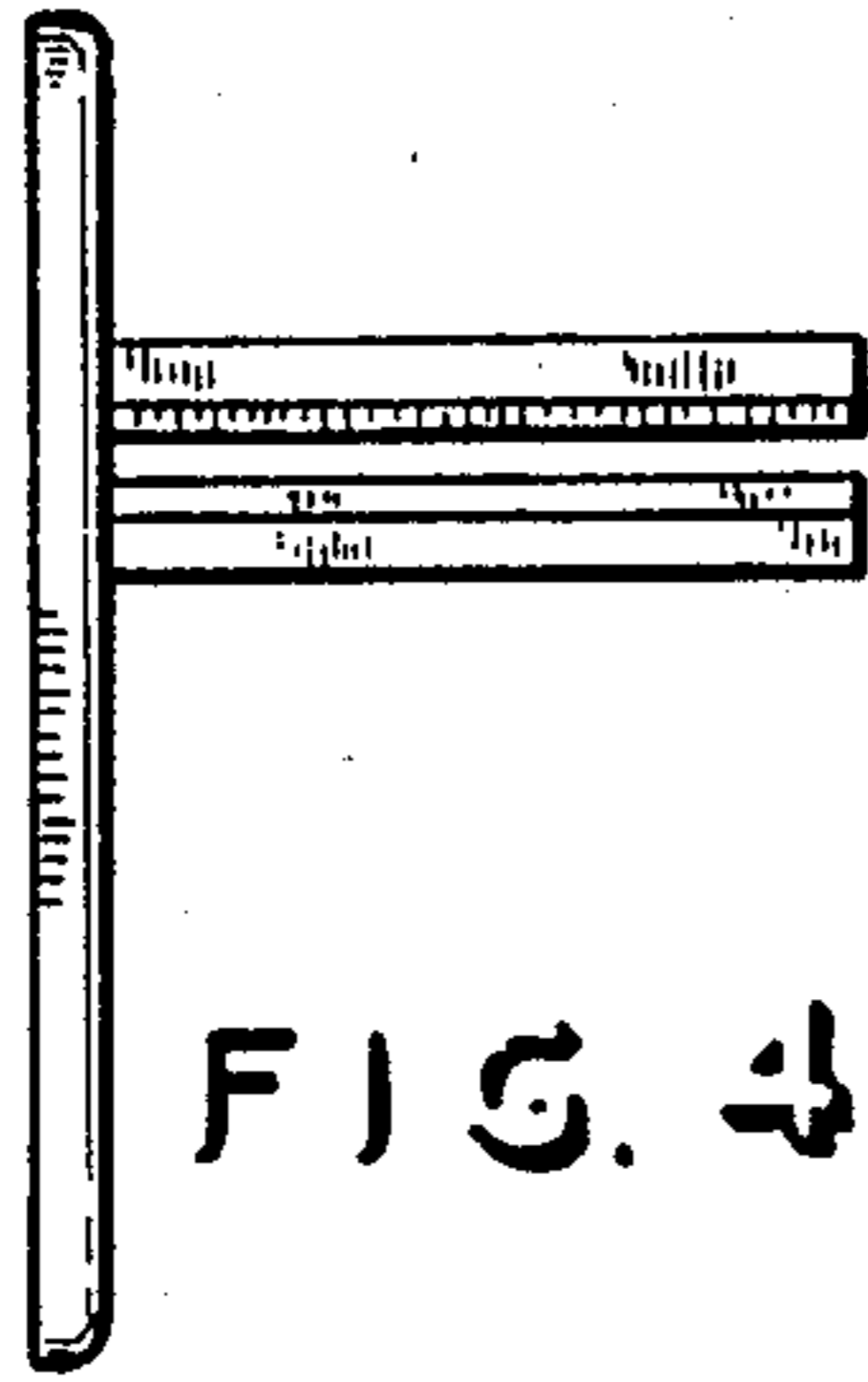

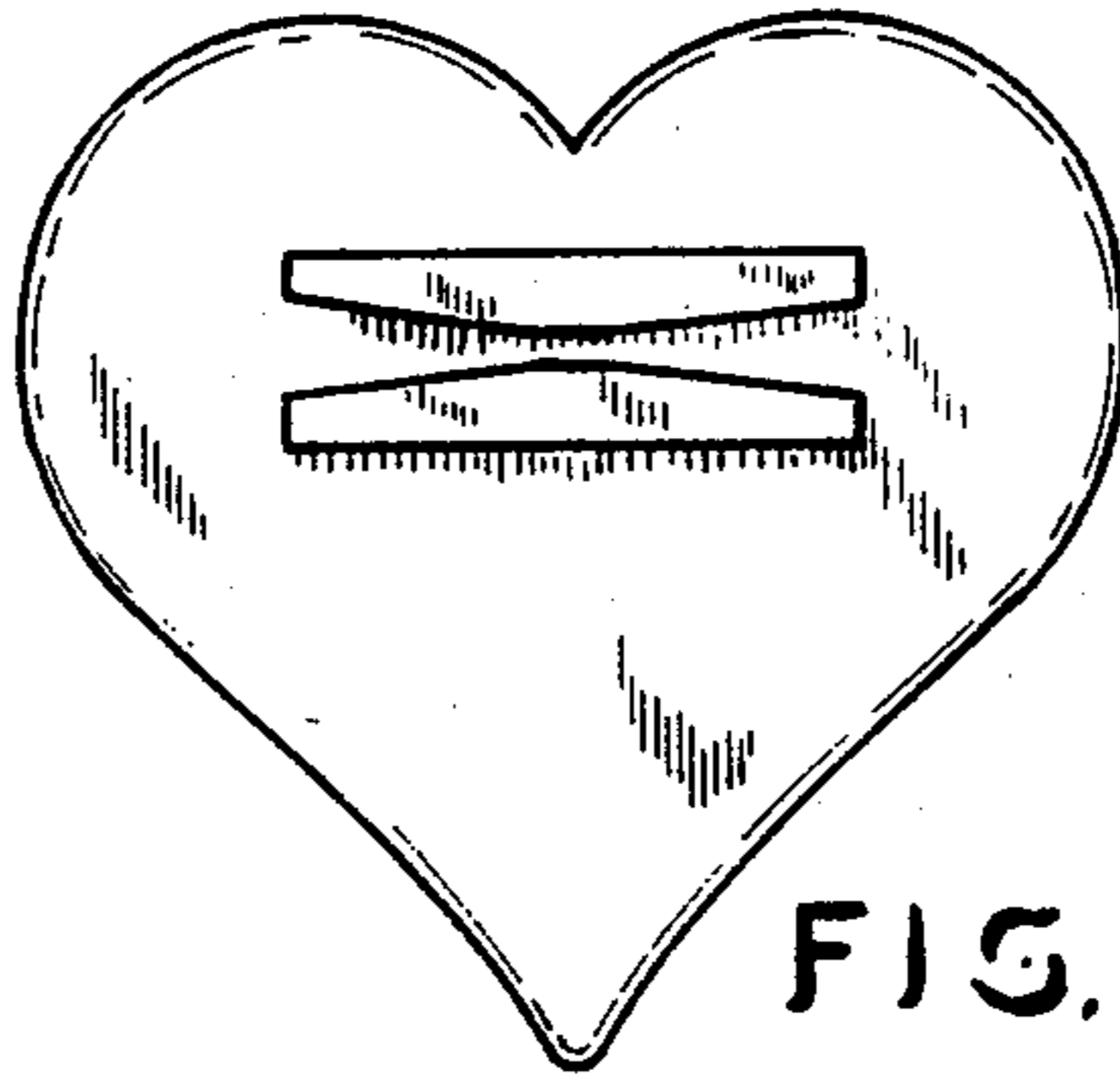

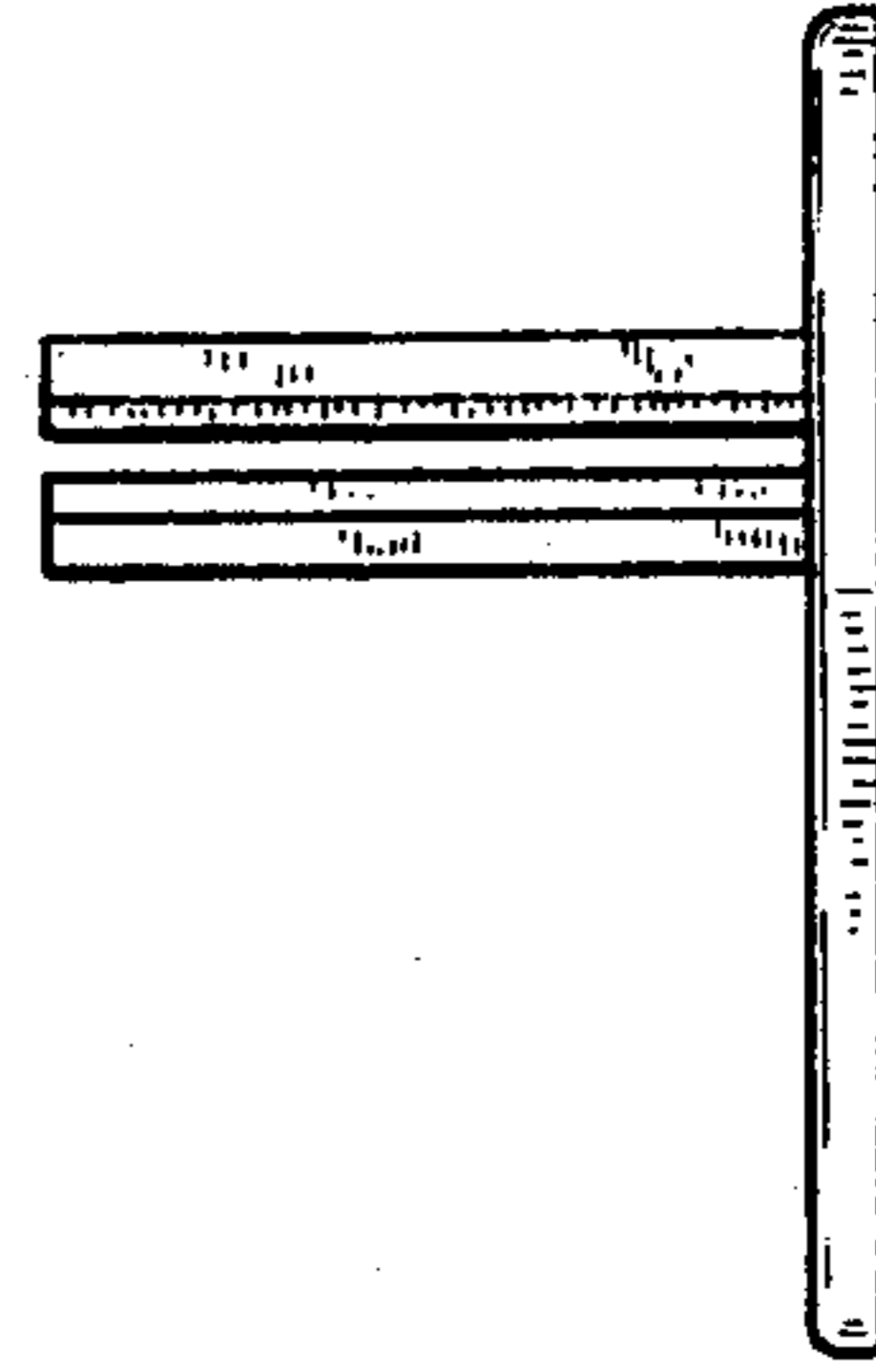

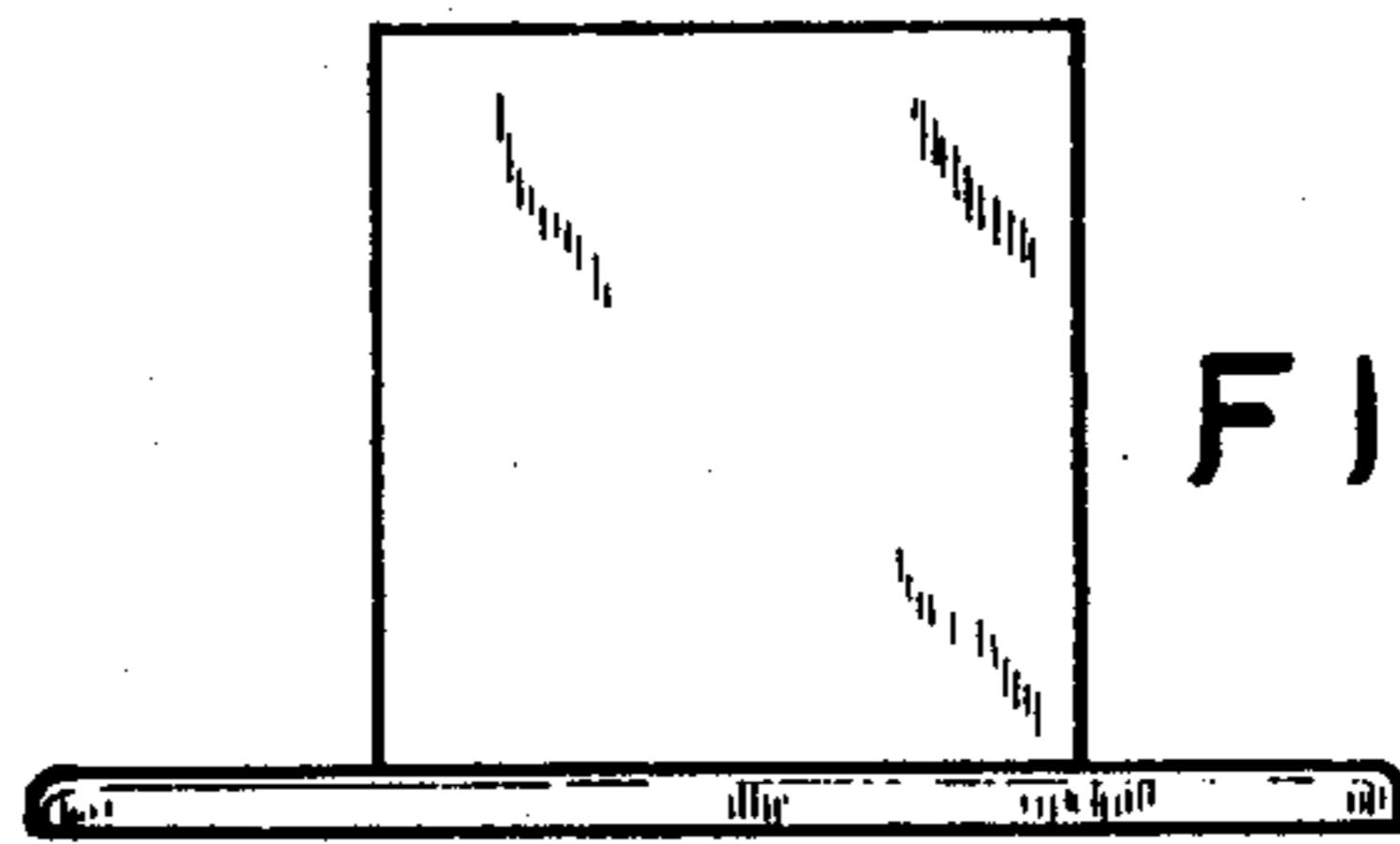

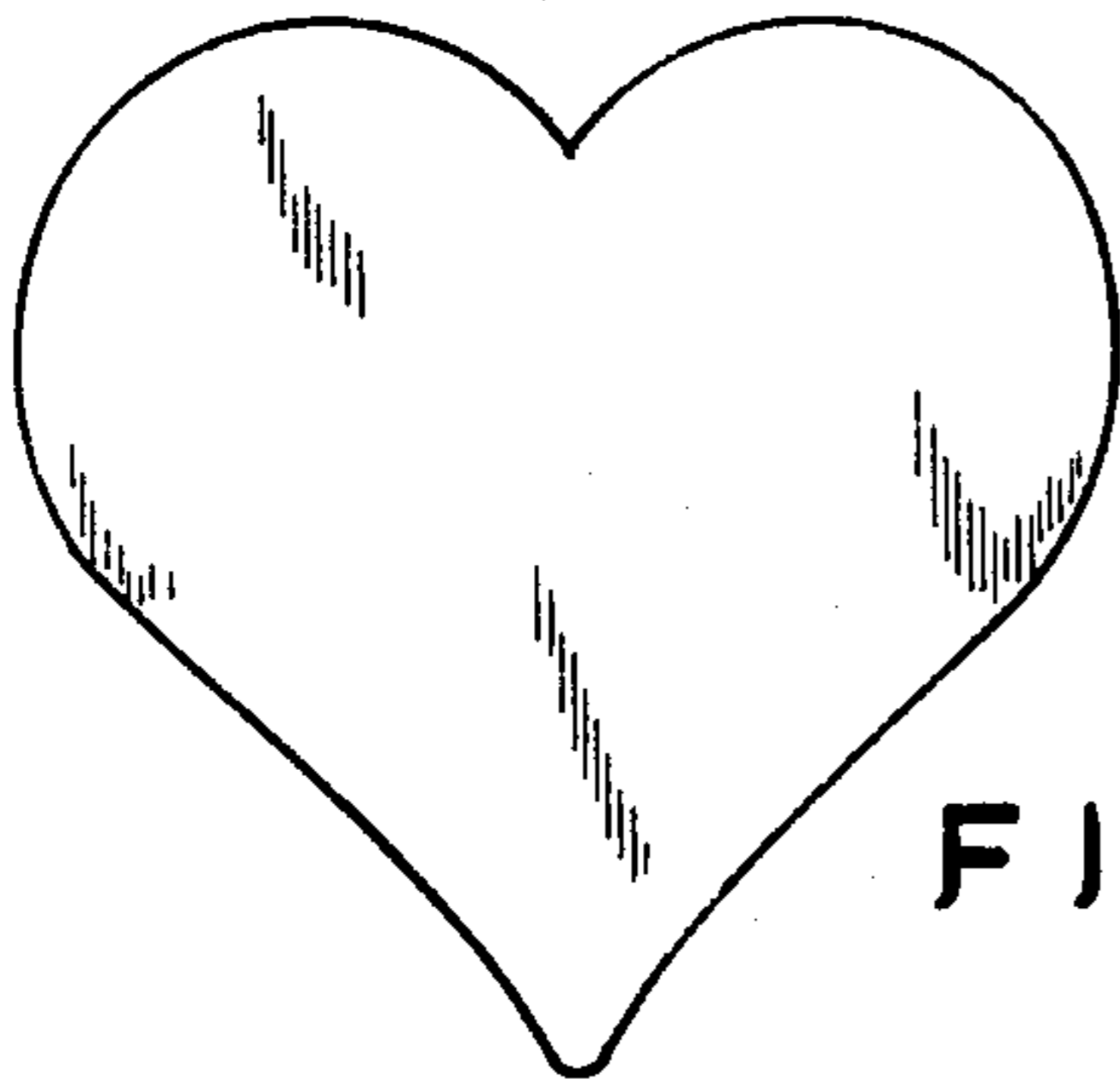
