DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a wheelchair frame showing my new design, the broken lines being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

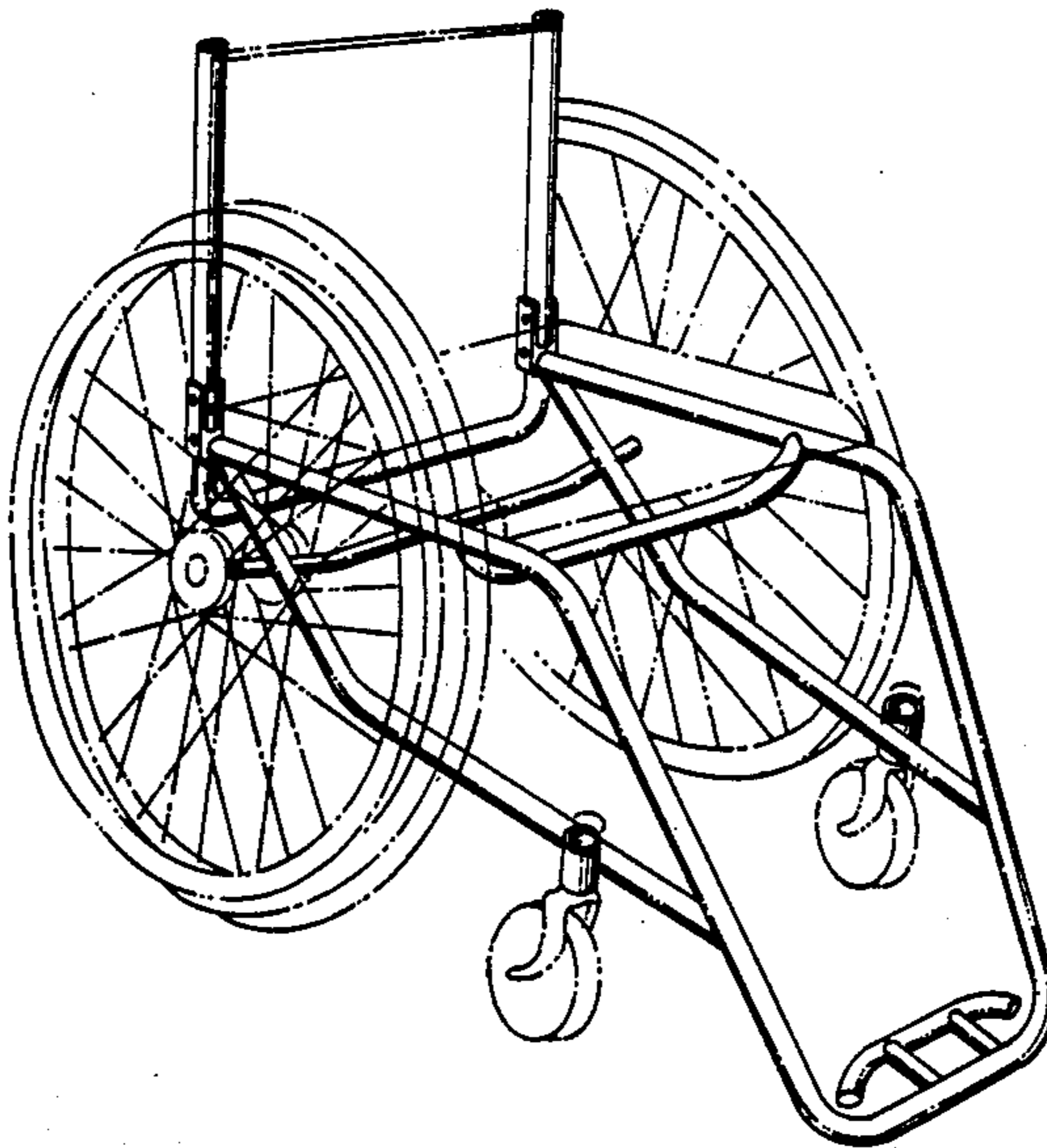
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



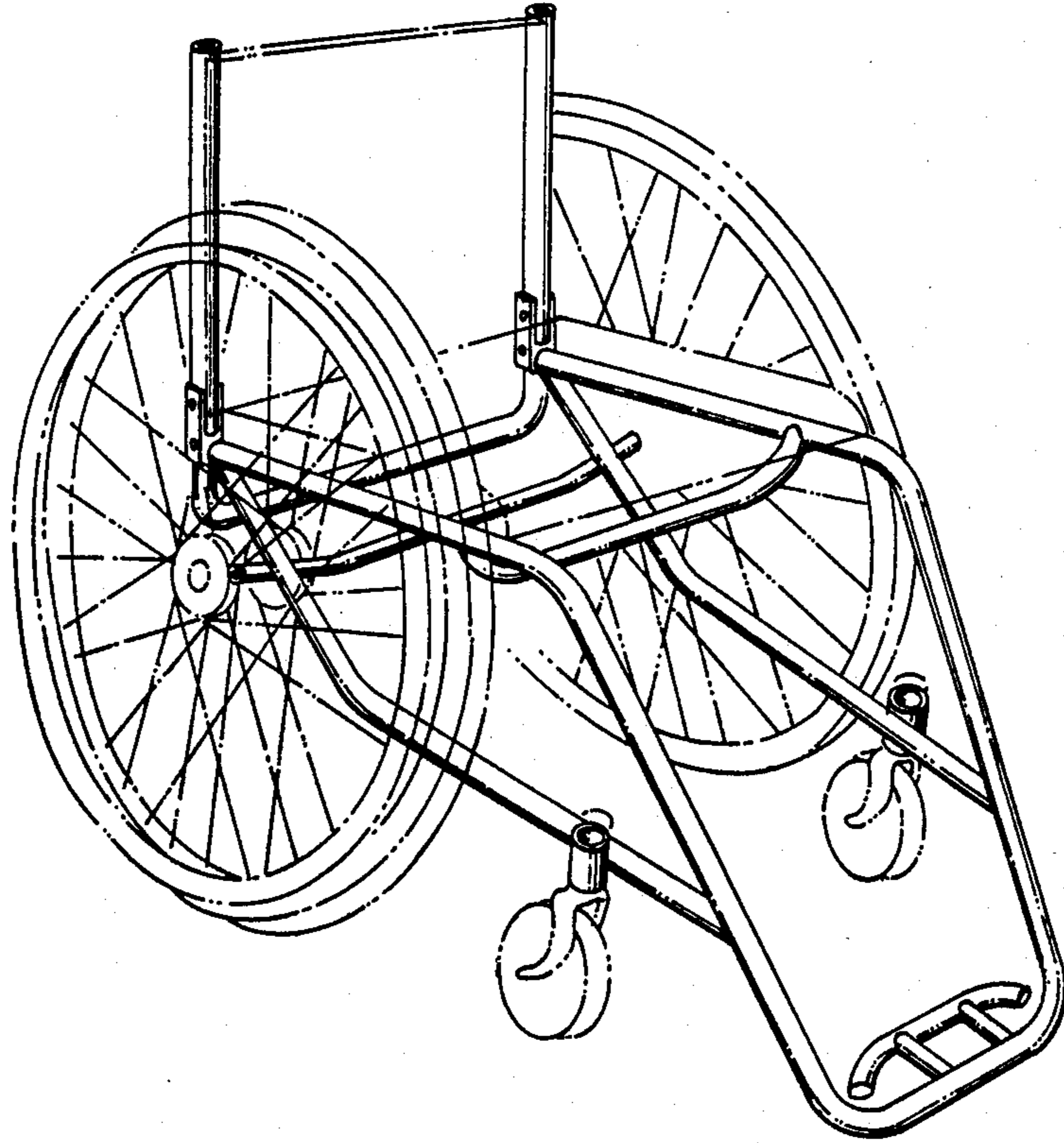

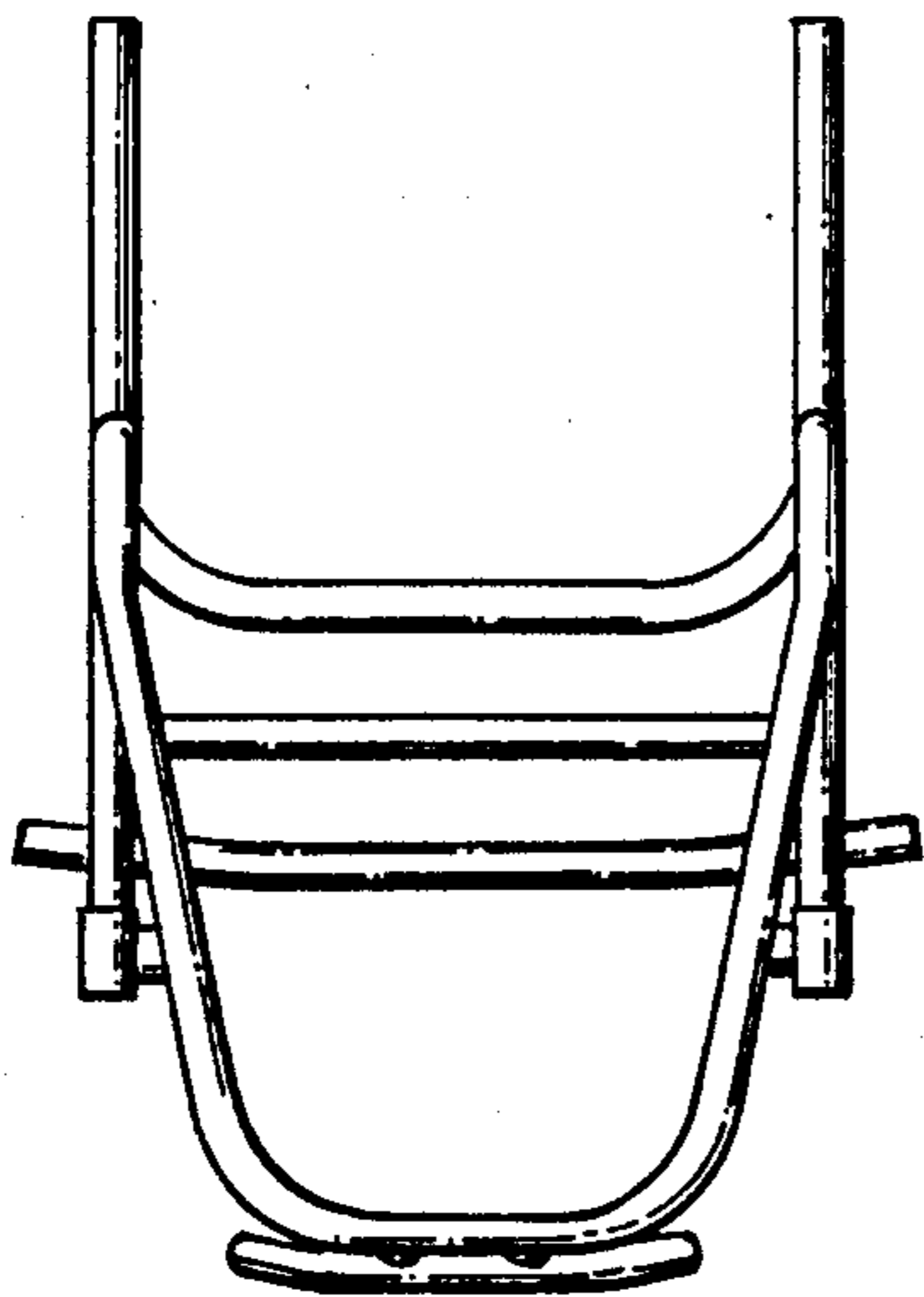
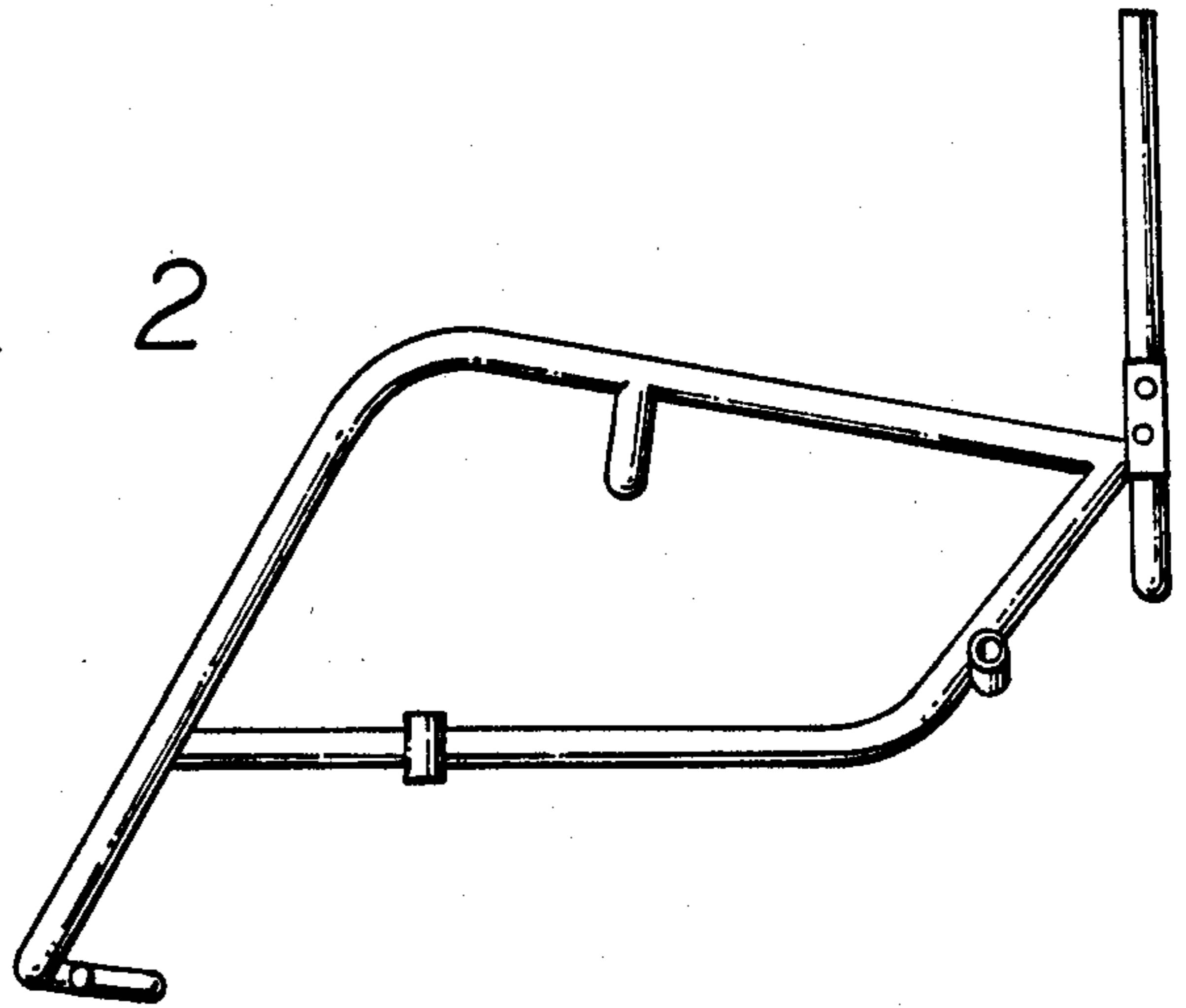

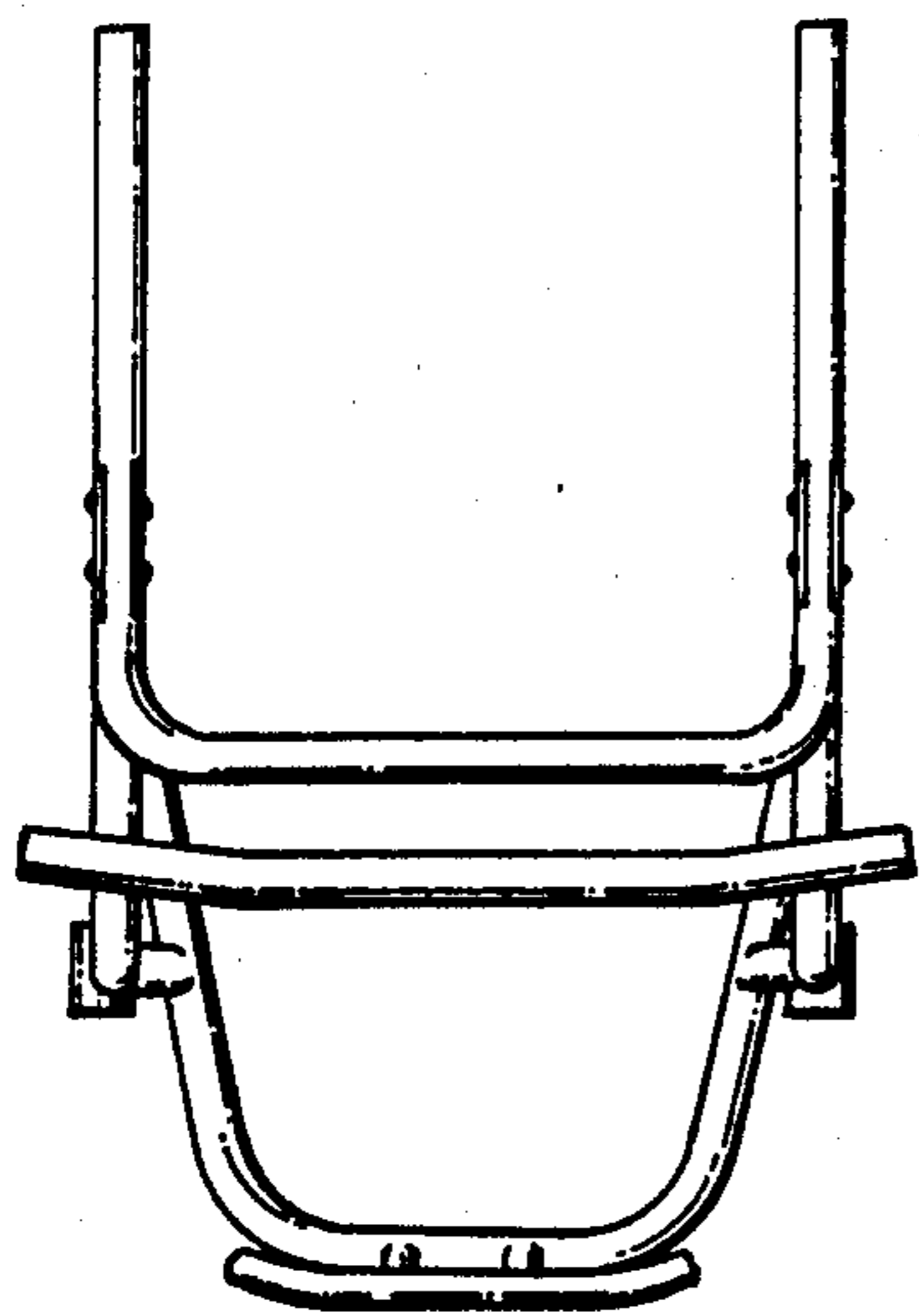

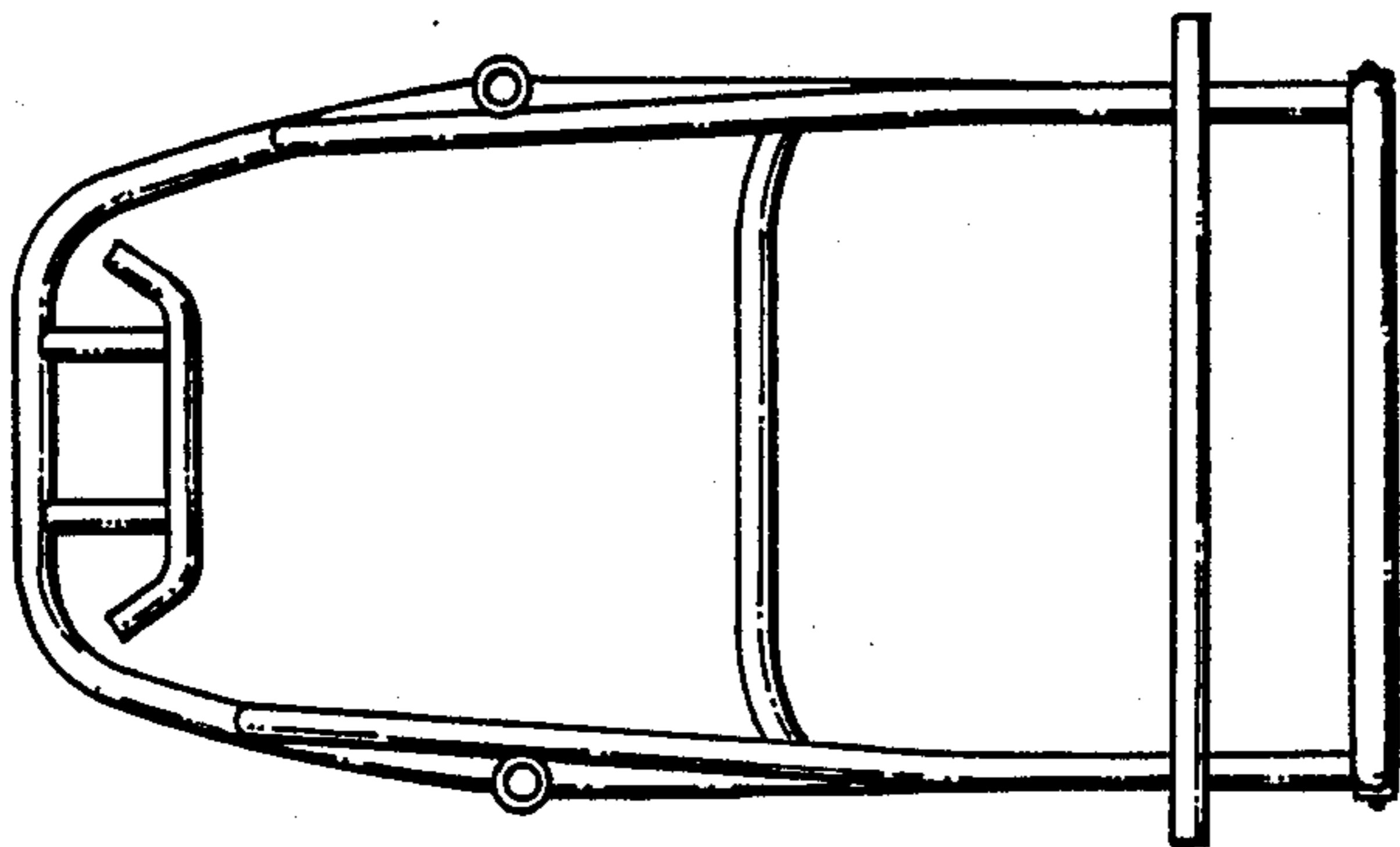
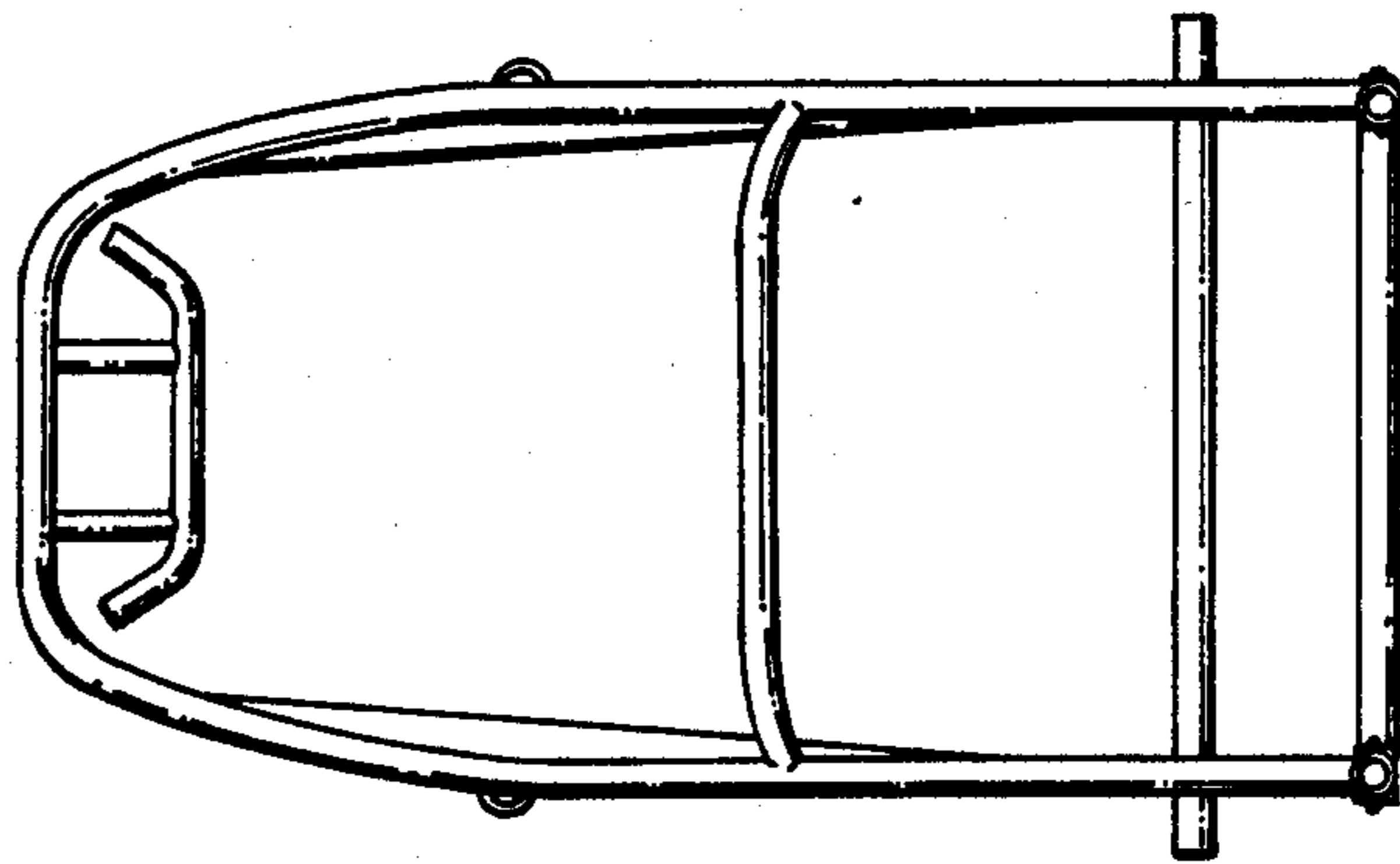
