The ornamental design for a medical lab coat, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a medical lab coat showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is an enlarged rear perspective view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a reduced inside elevational view shown open and spread flat;  
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 6 is an enlarged rear perspective view of FIG. 5;  
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 5;  
FIG. 8 is a reduced inside elevational view of FIG. 5, the coat shown open and spread flat.

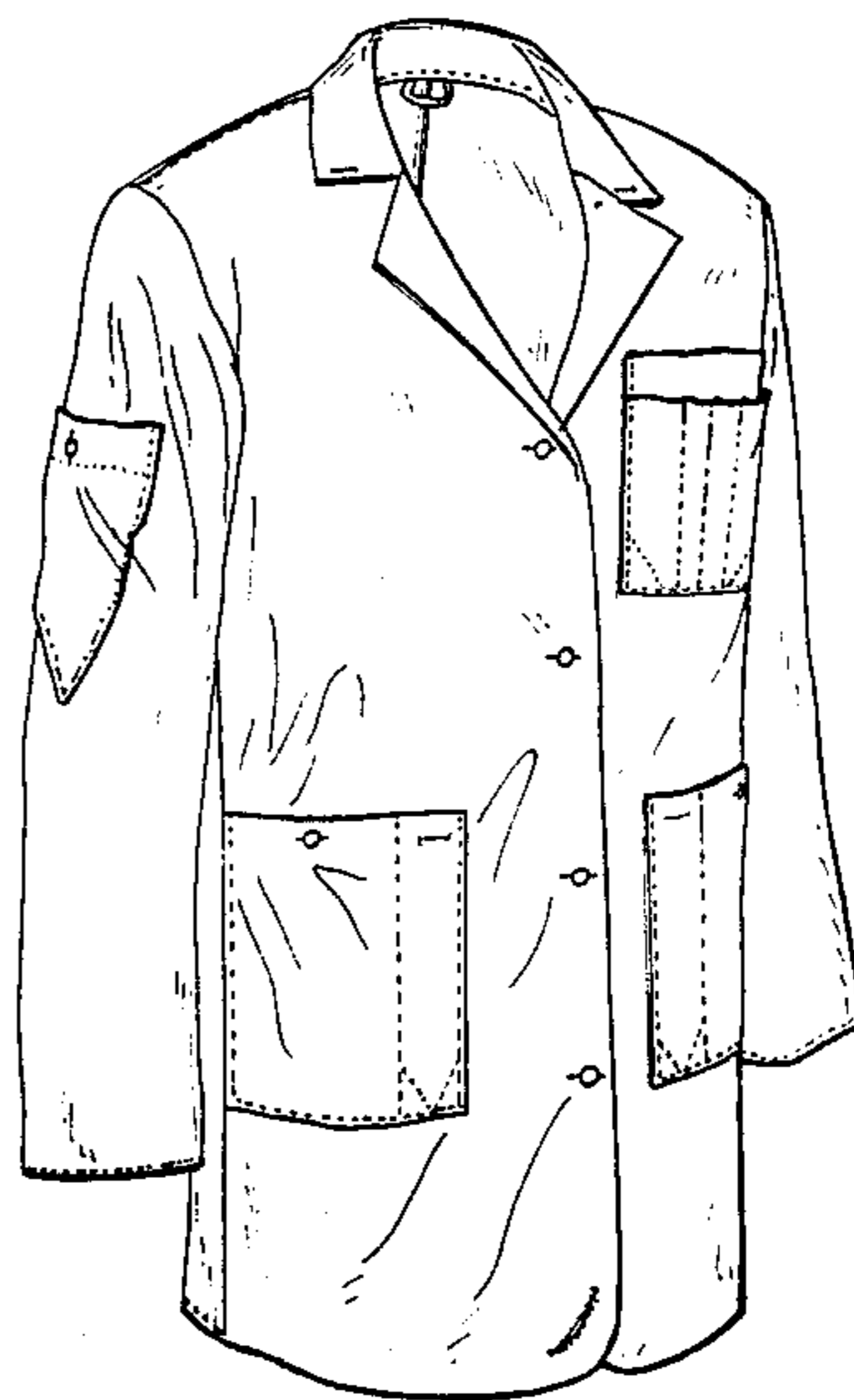
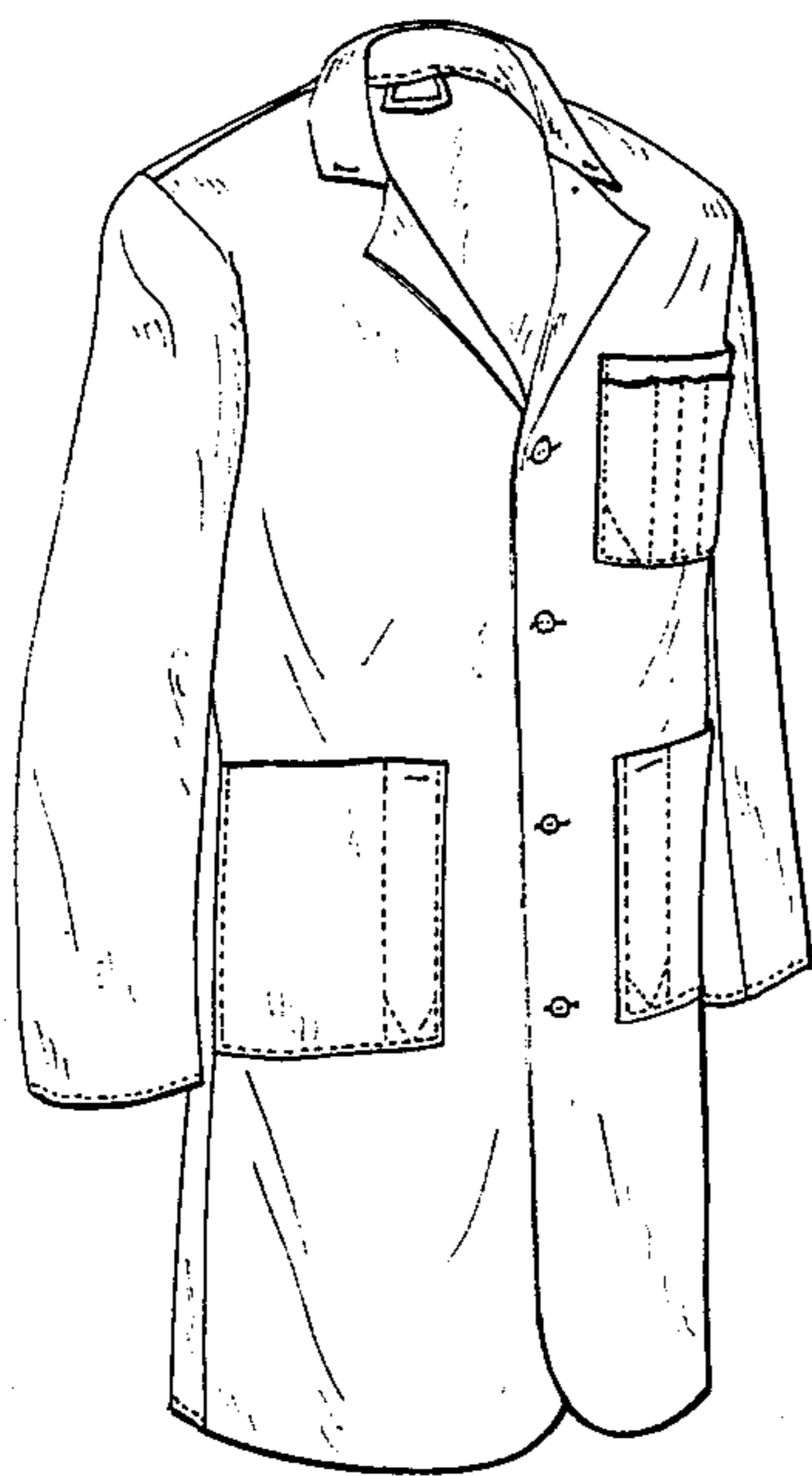

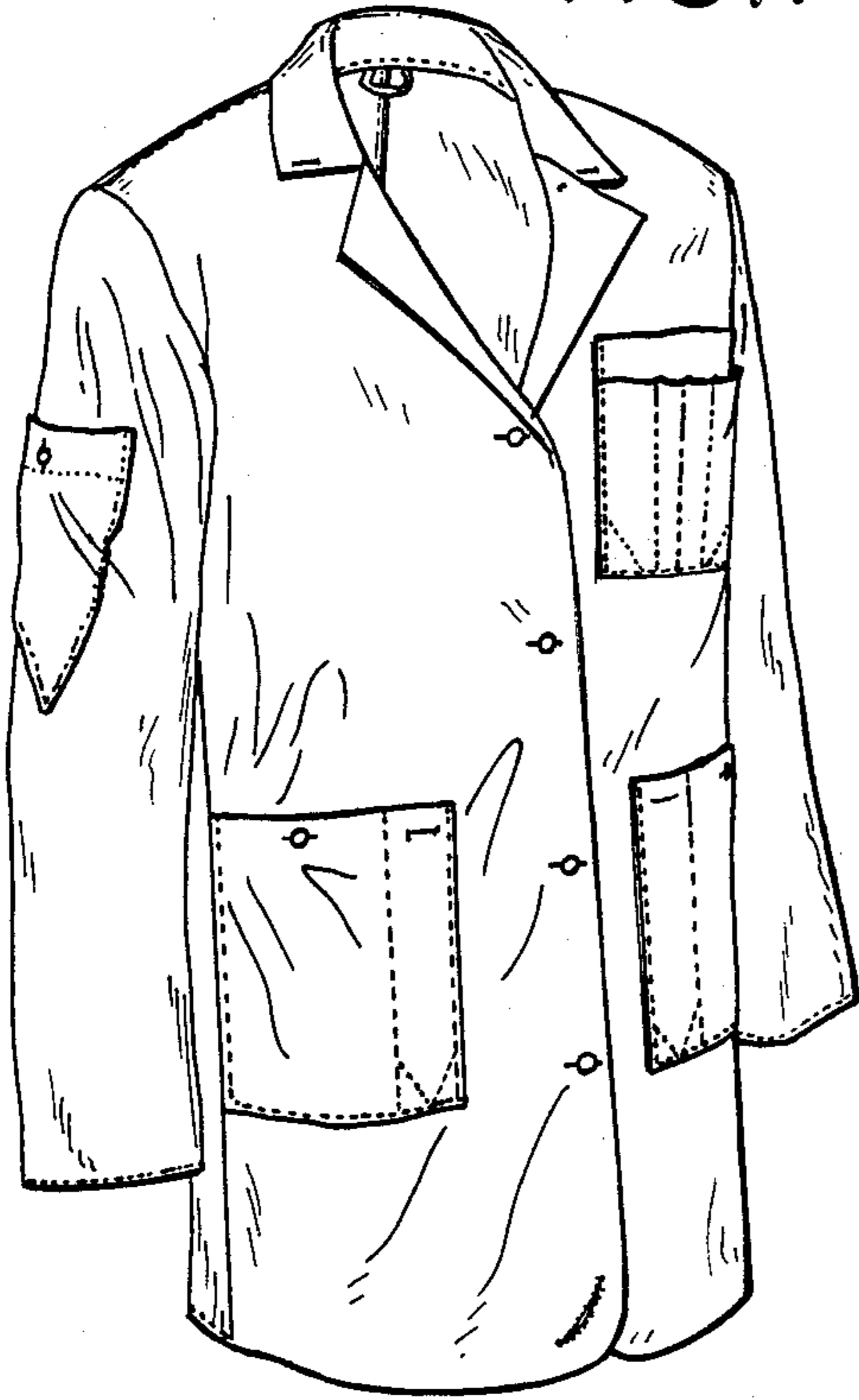

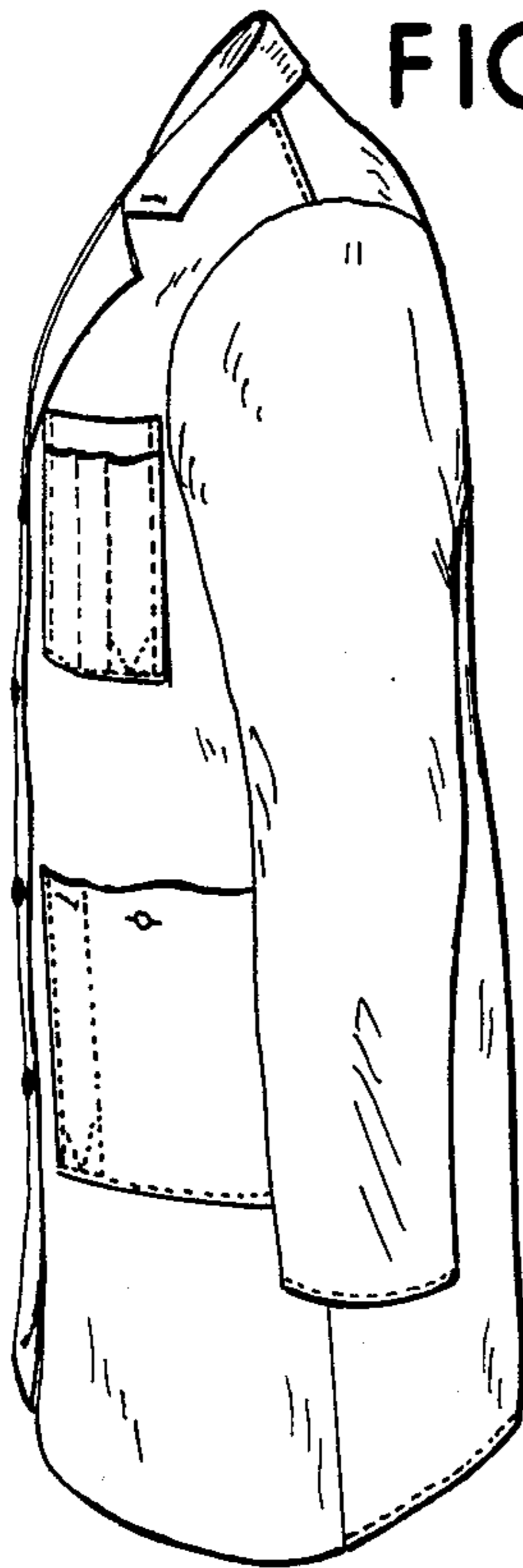

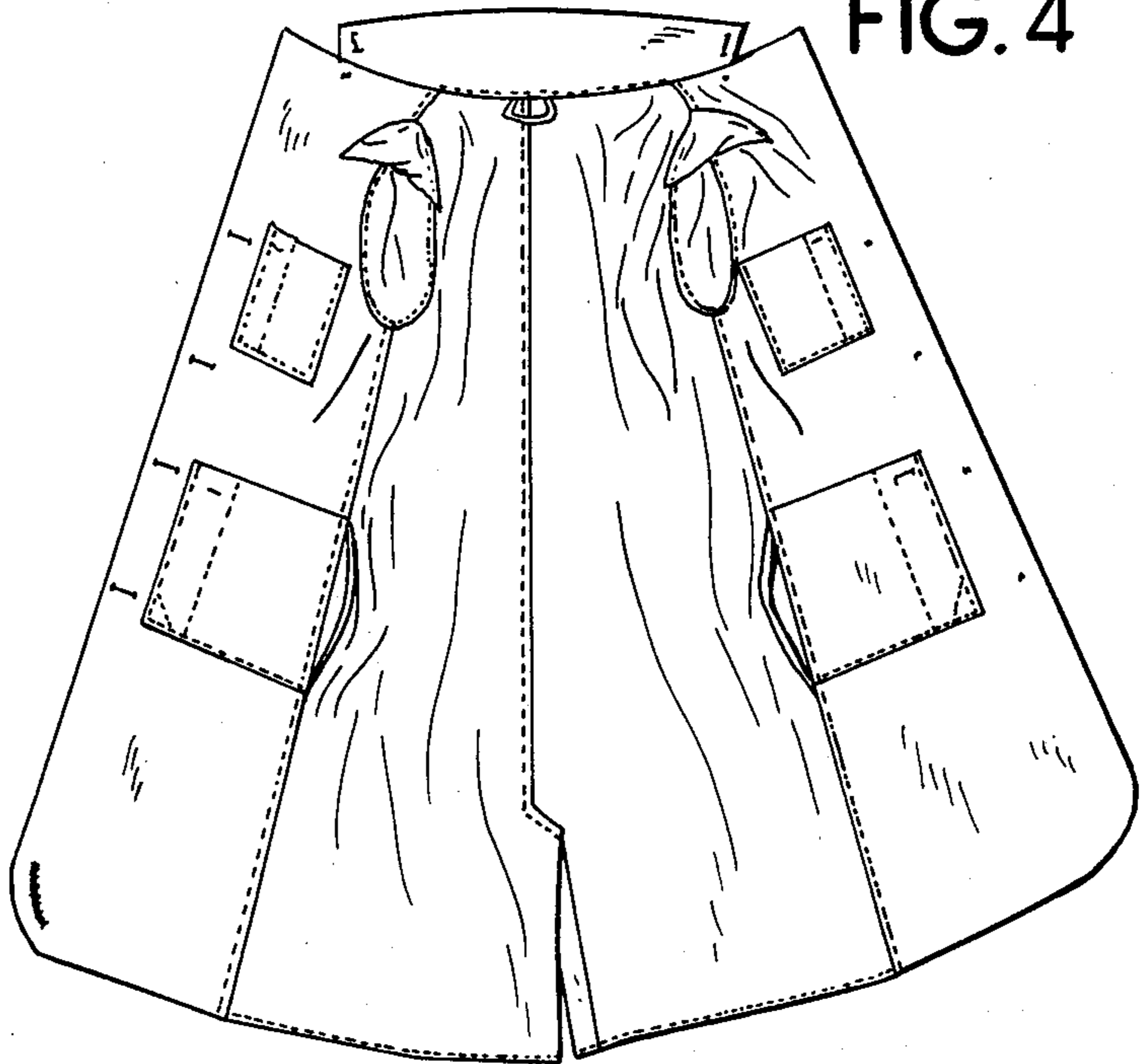

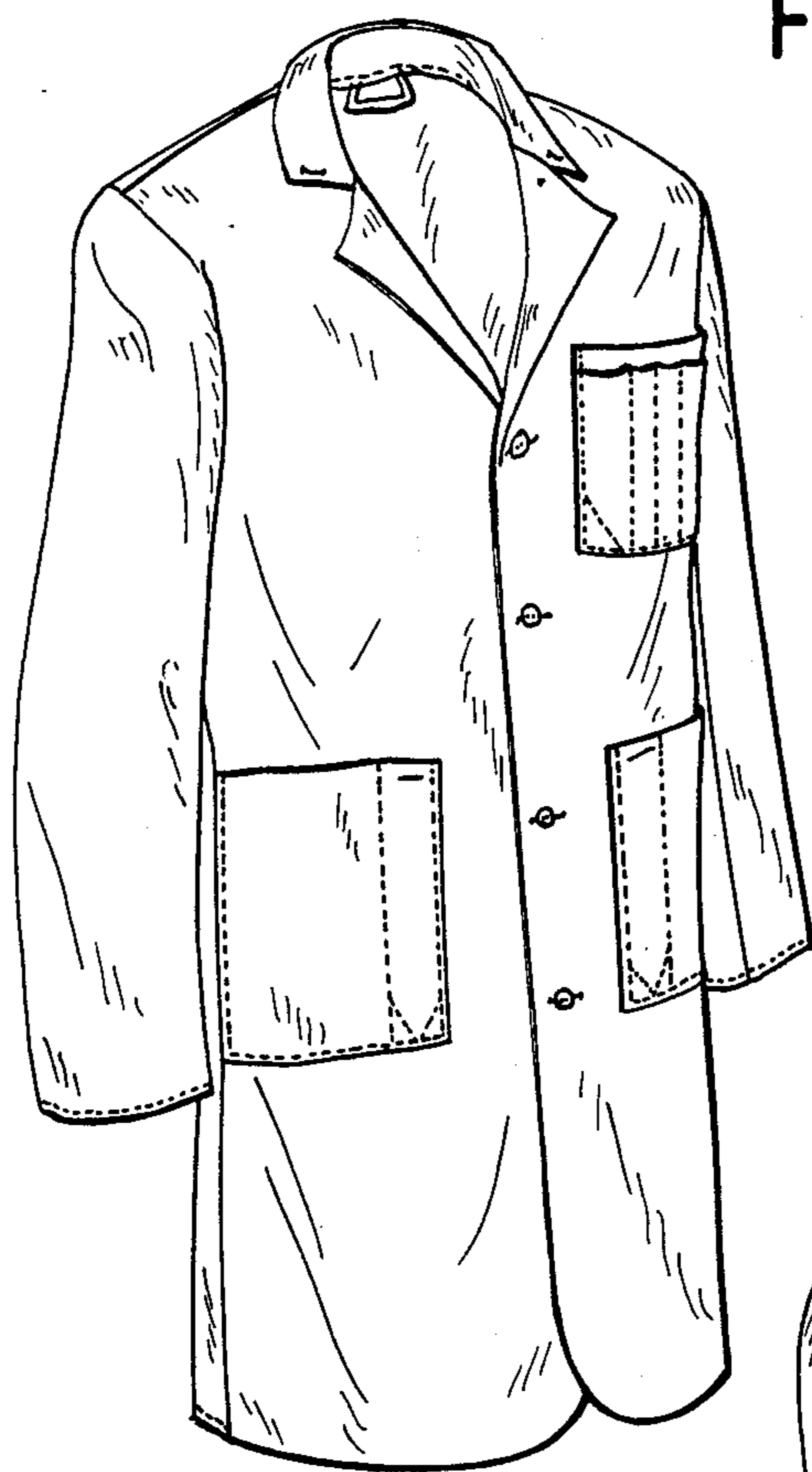

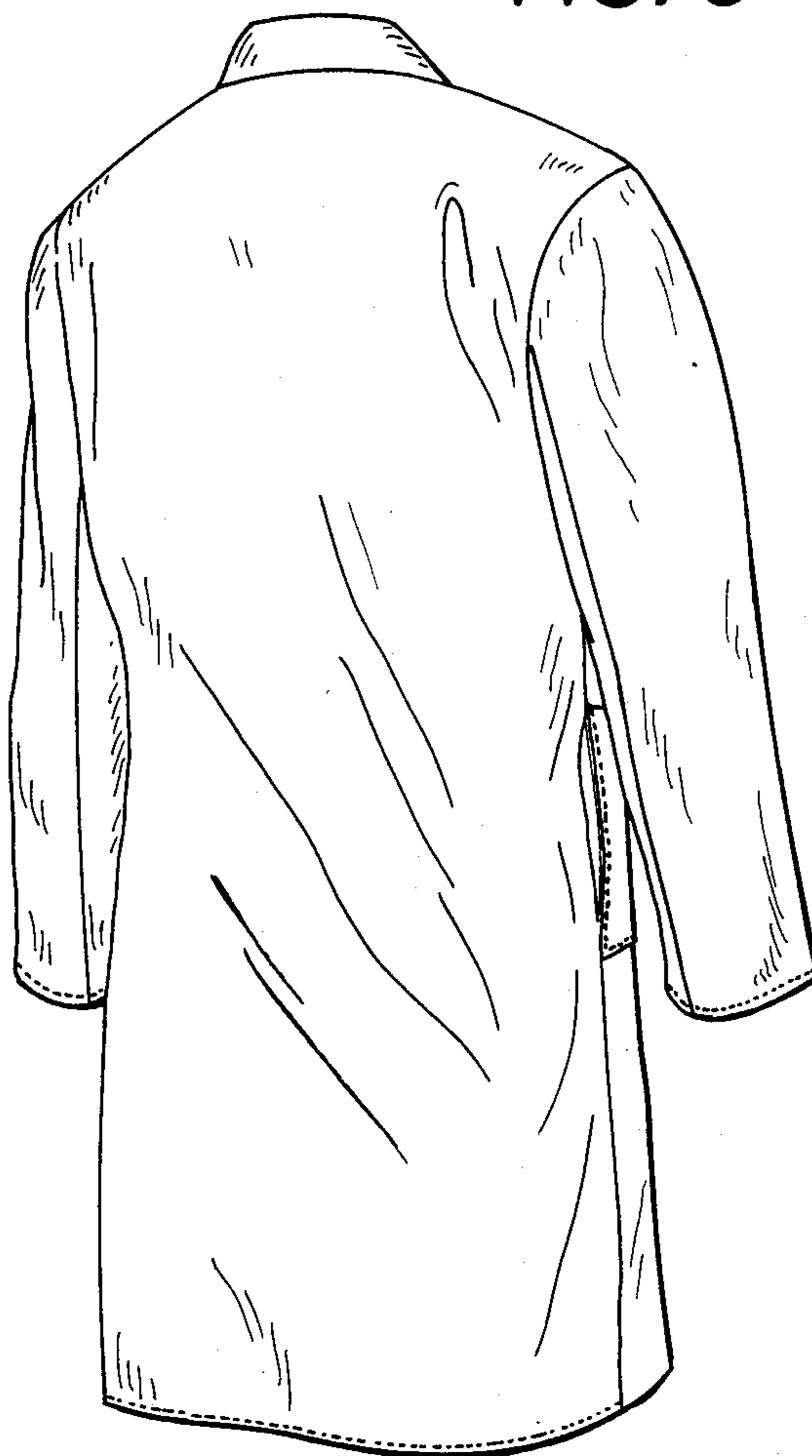

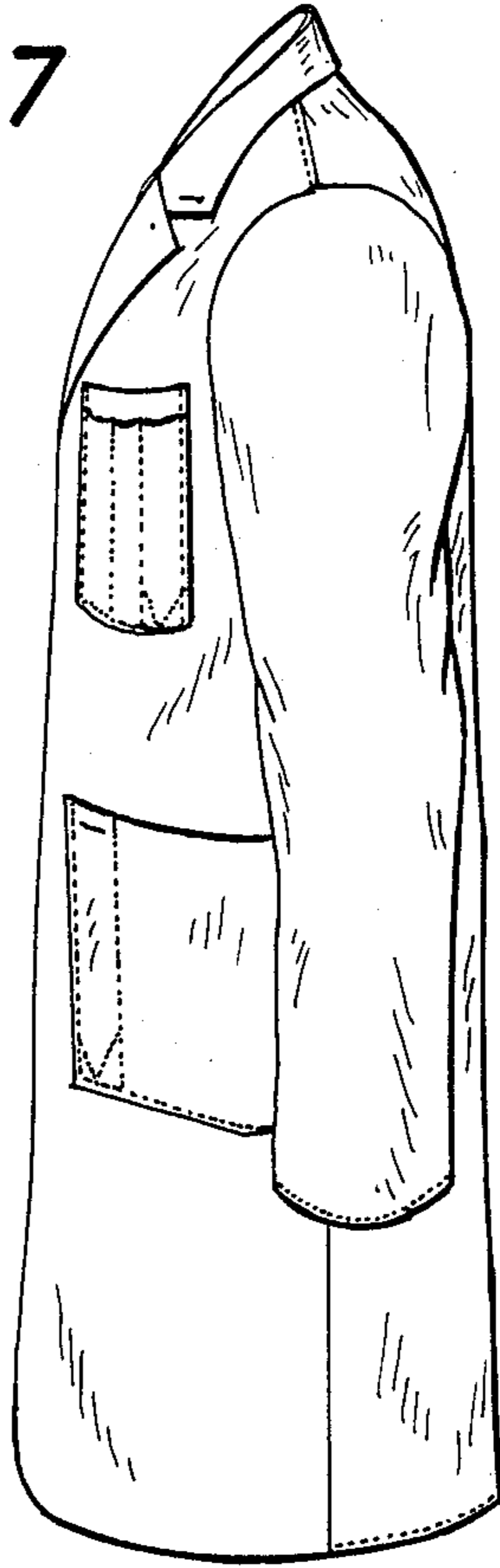
