The ornamental design for a sole for a shoe, or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a sole for a shoe, or similar article, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, viewed from the right of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, viewed from the opposite side thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front or toe end elevational view; and
FIG. 6 is a rear or heel end elevational view thereof.



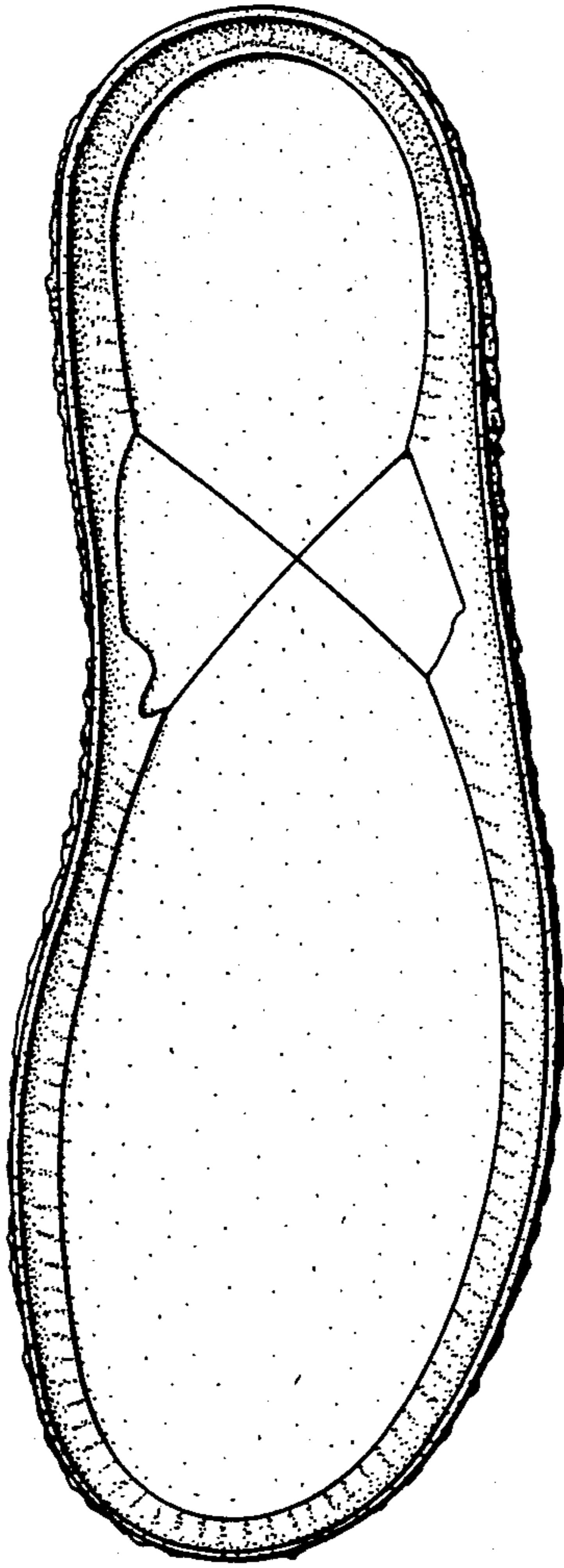

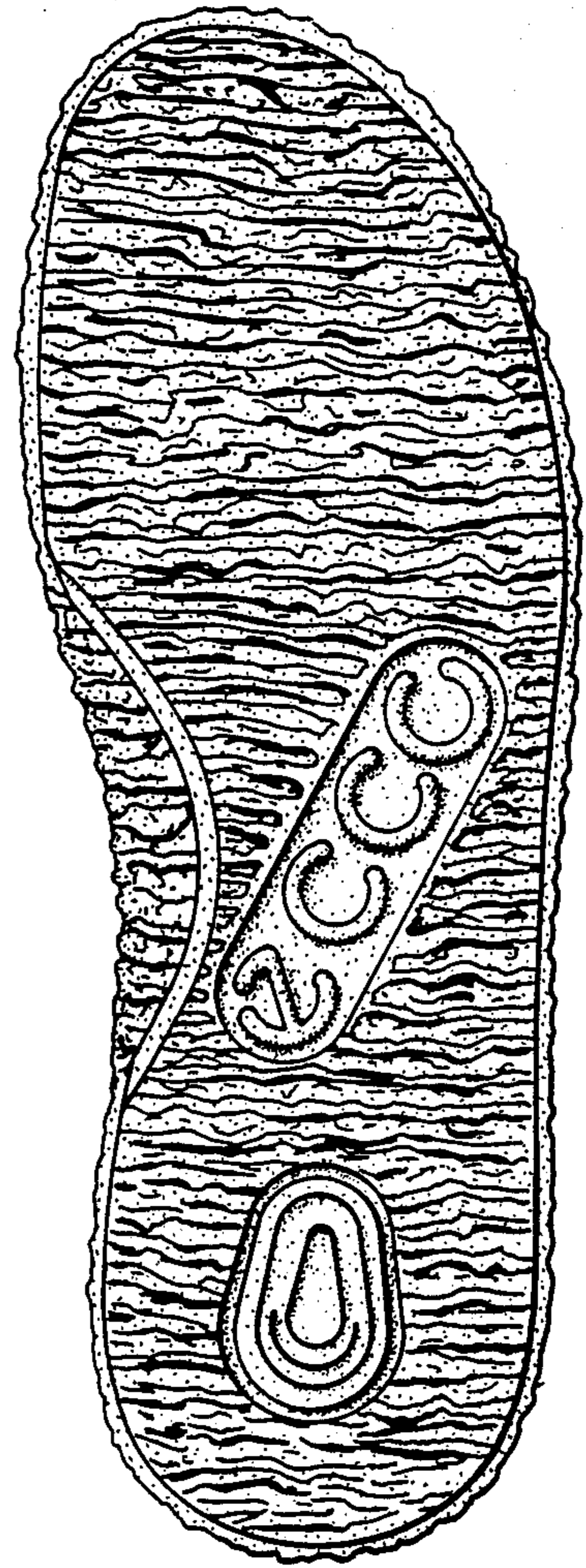

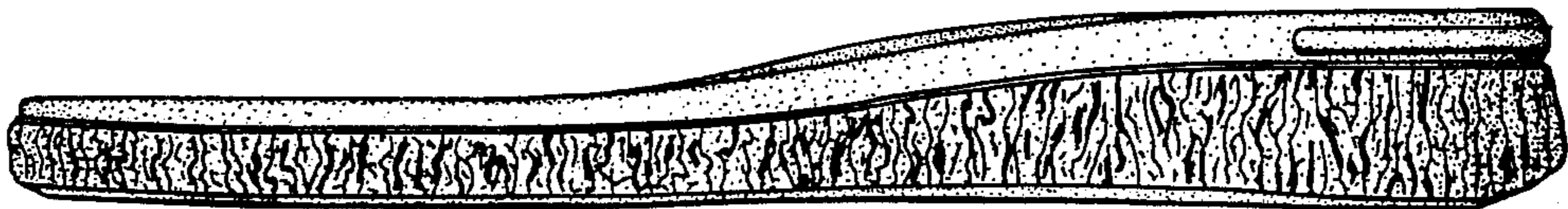

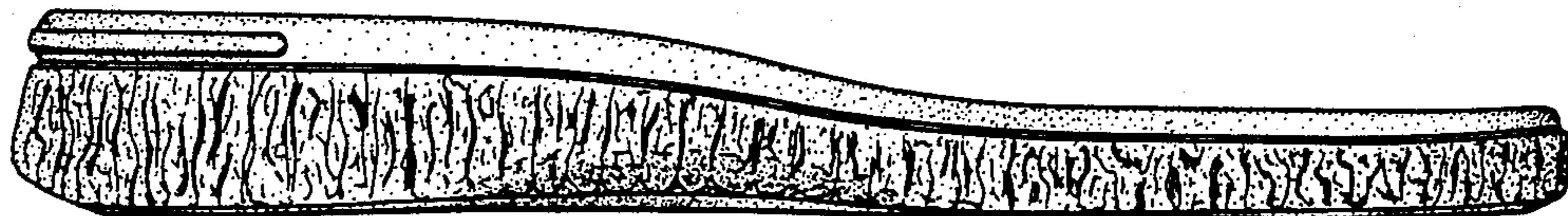

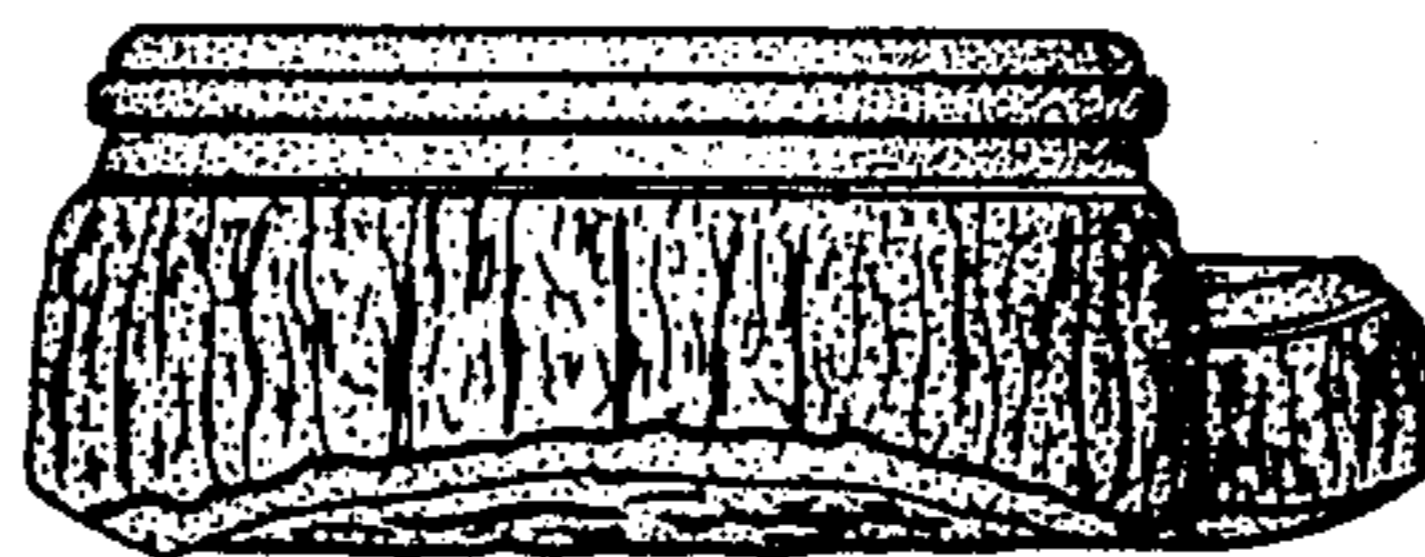
