DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the medication blister card showing my new design.

- FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the bottom thereof.

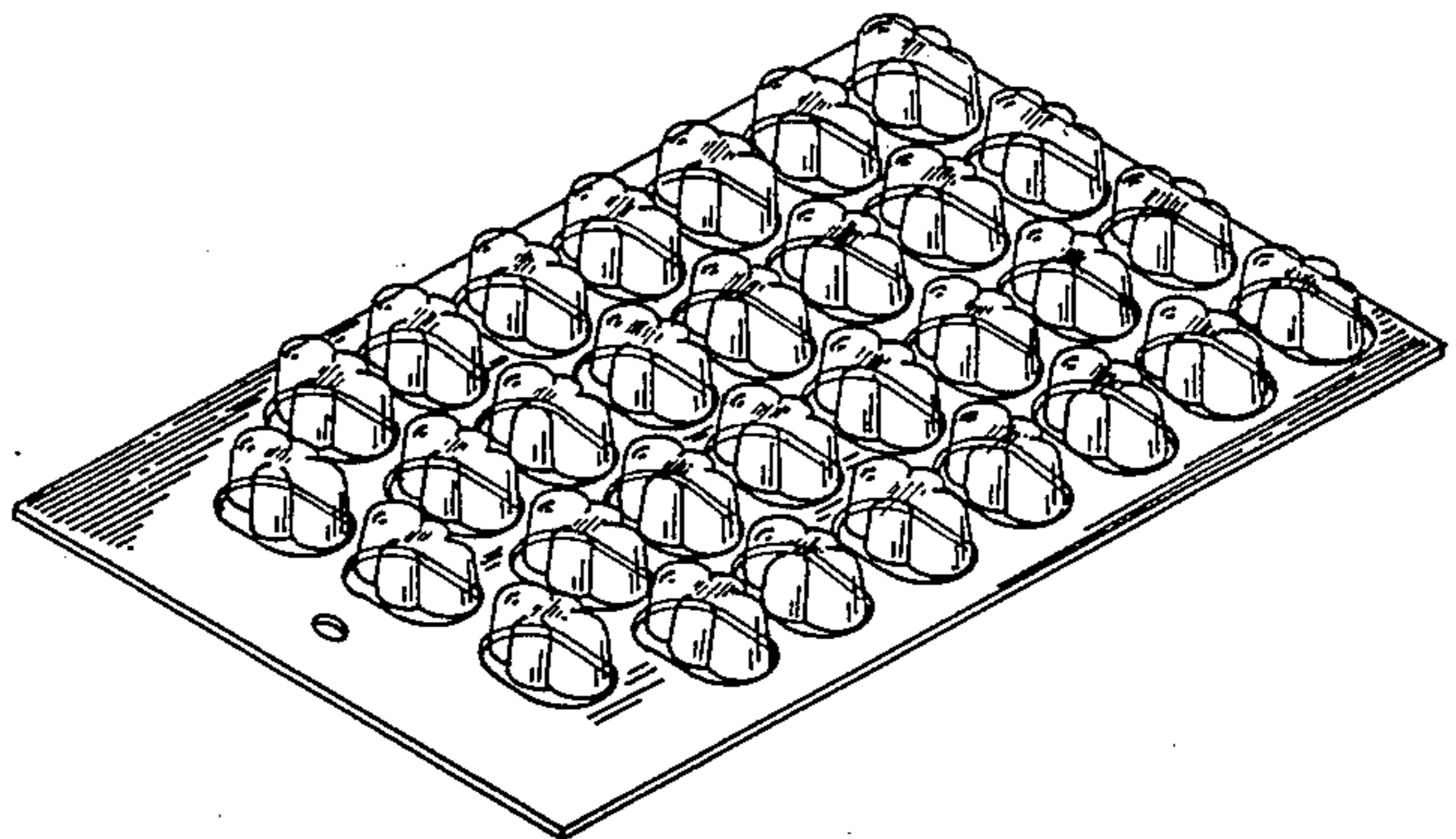
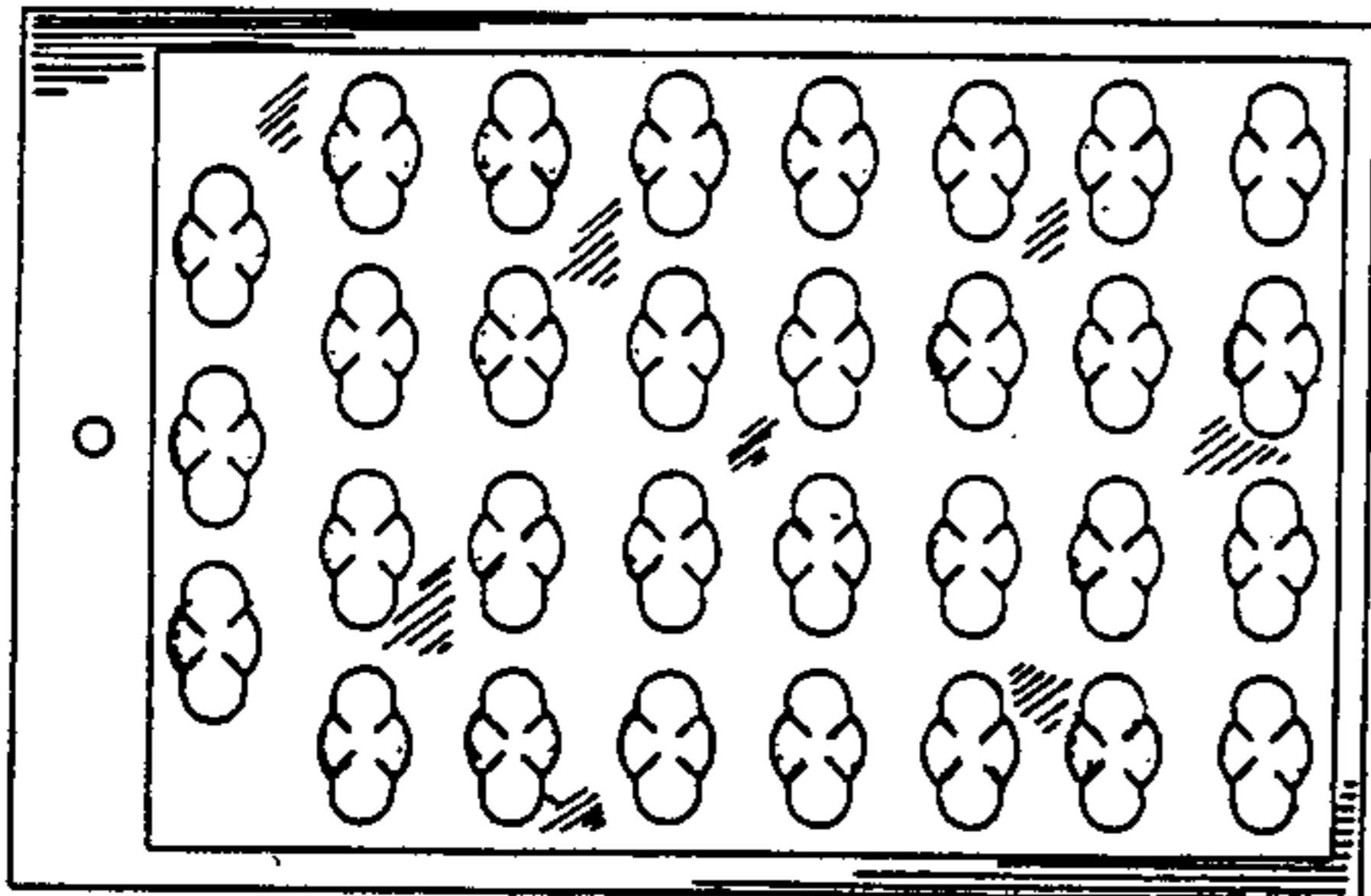

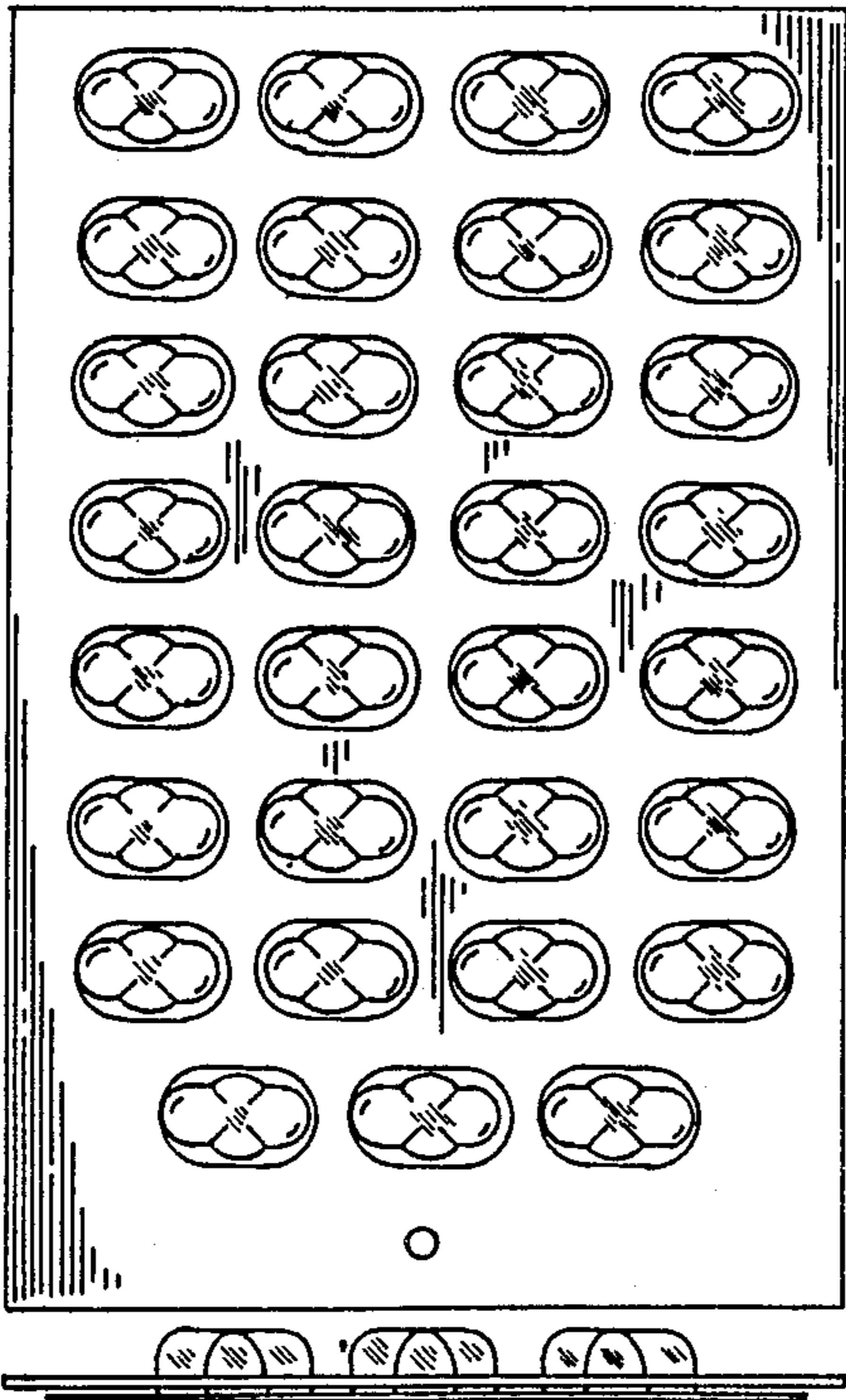

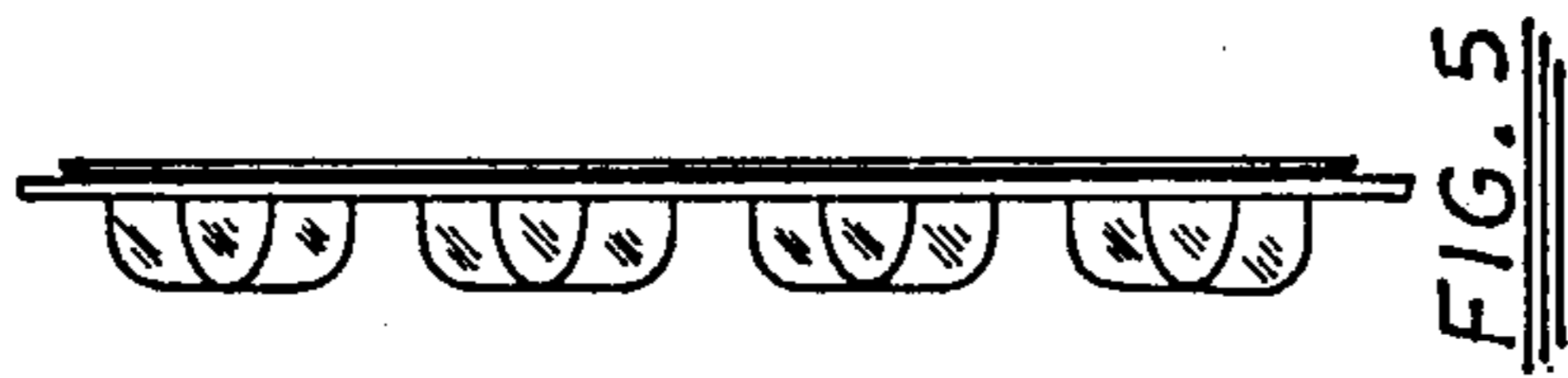
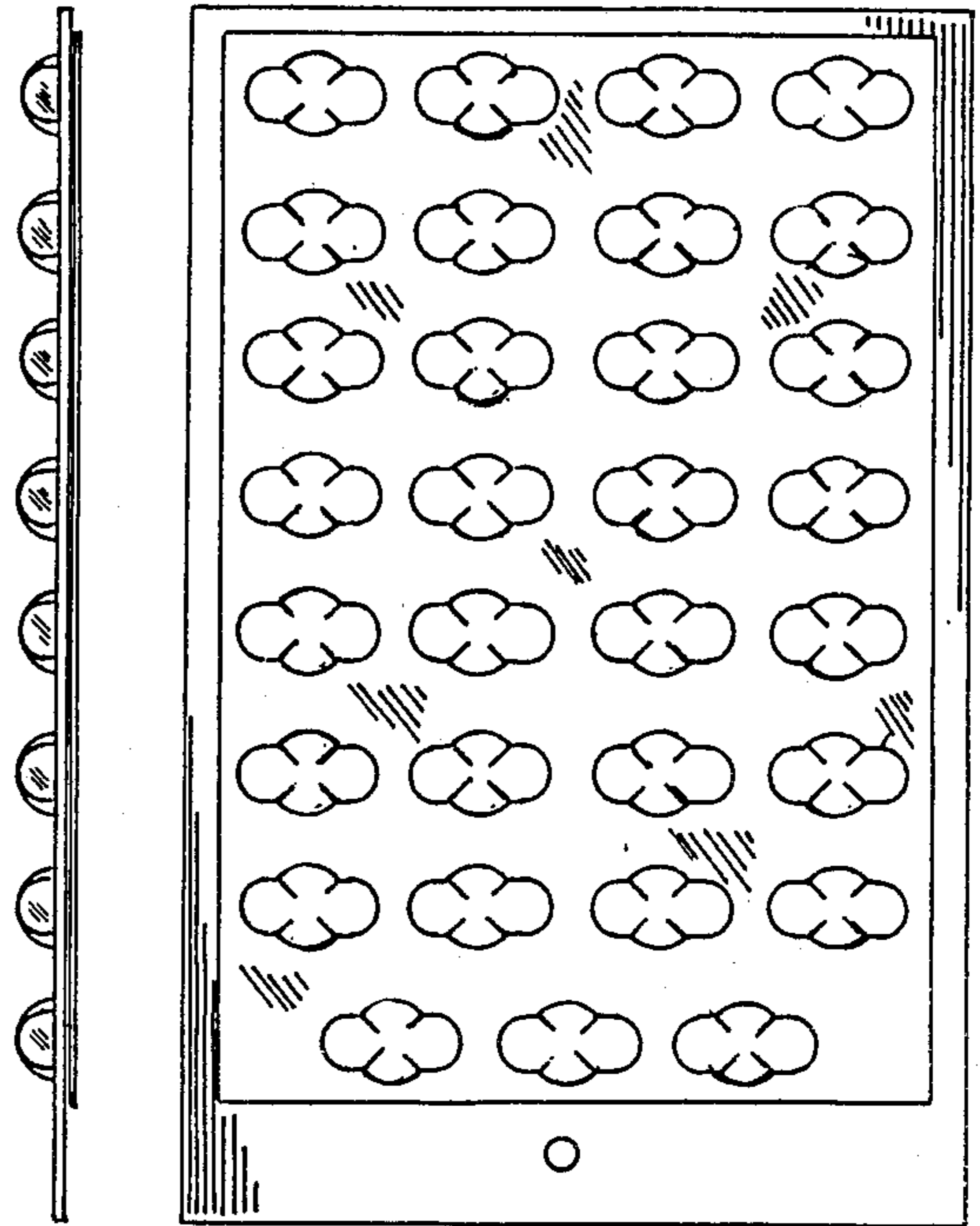

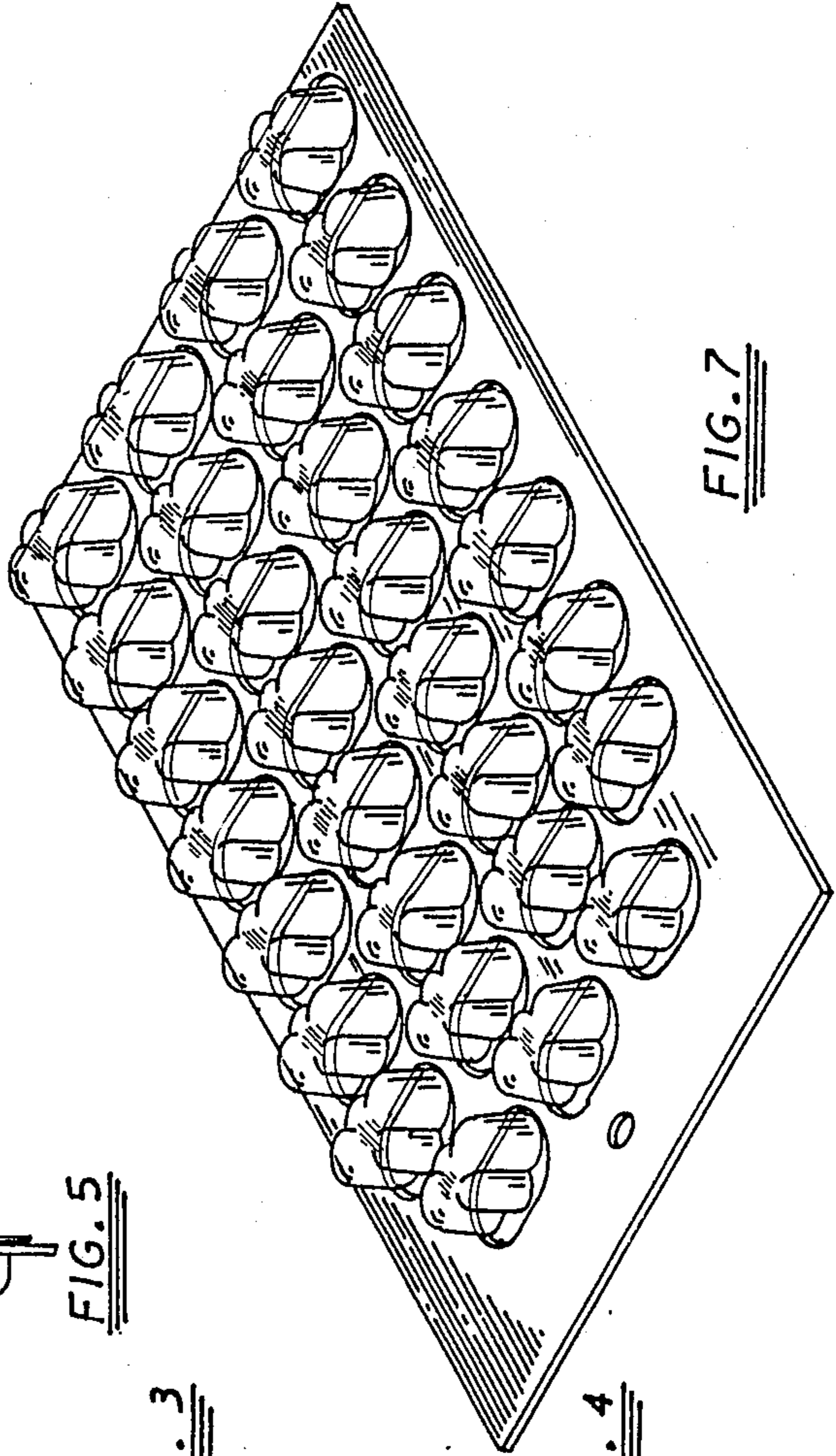
