The ornamental design for a jewelry pendant, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational of the jewelry pendant showing our new design with the rear elevational being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 2 is a right side elevation thereof with the left side elevation being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

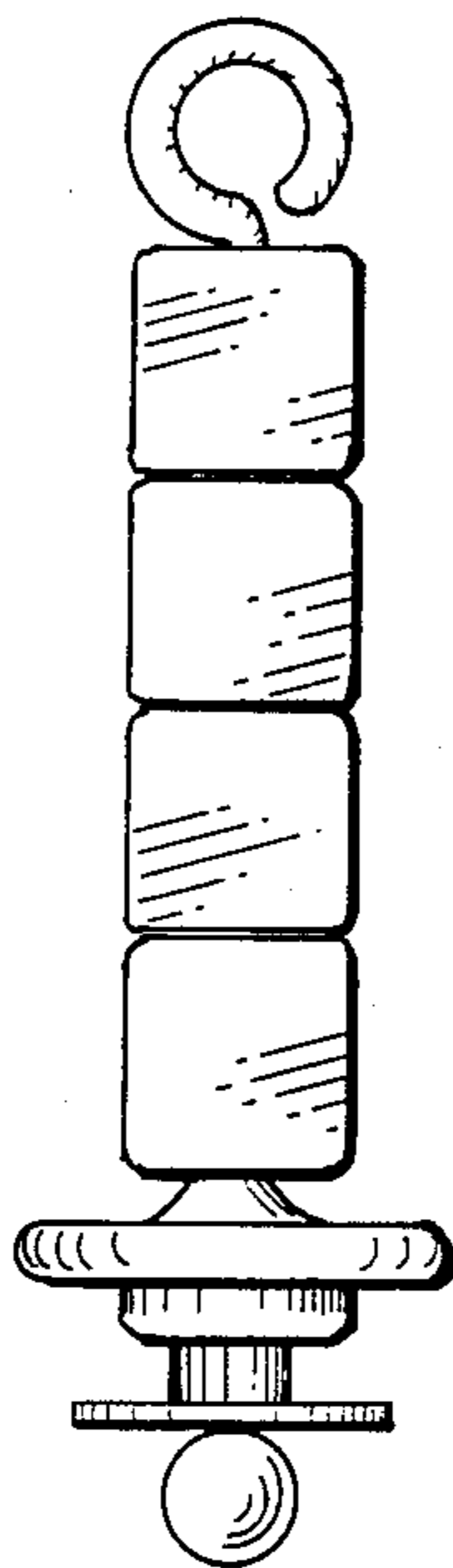

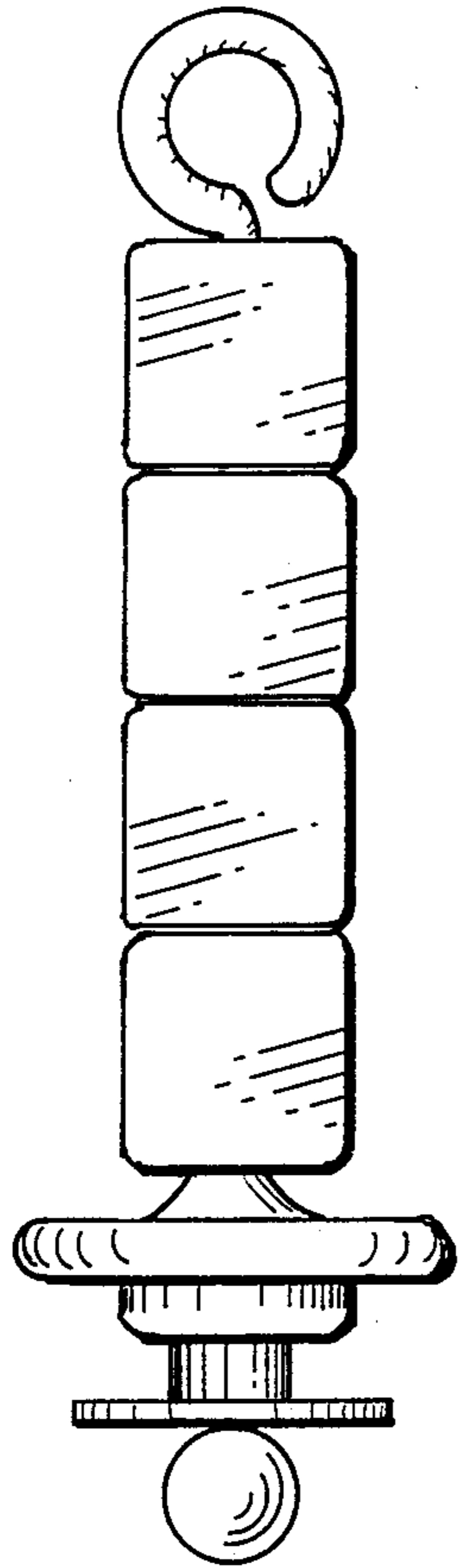

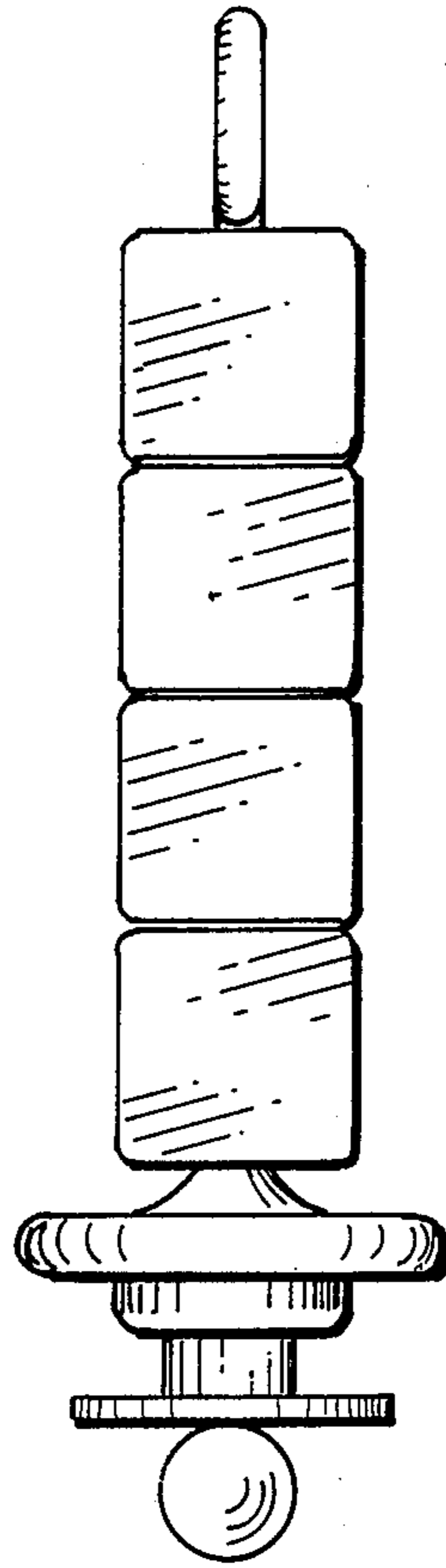

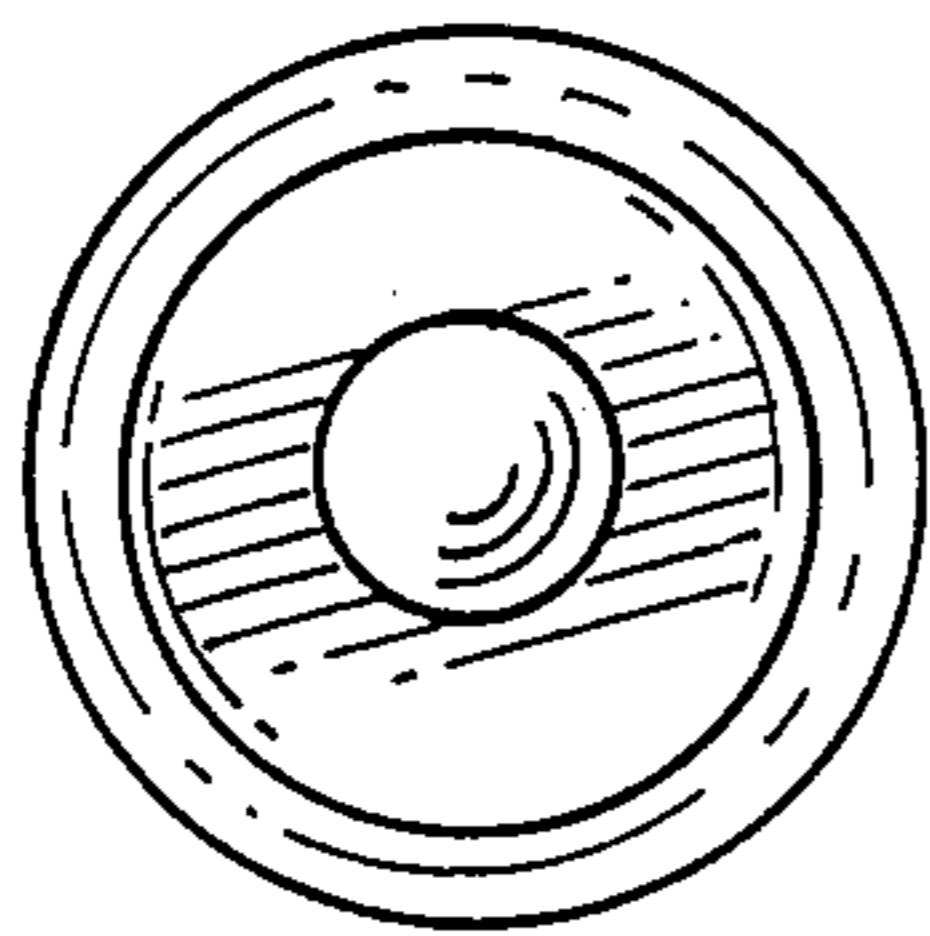
