[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a nebulizer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a nebulizer, showing our new design with the cover in open position; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, with the cover in closed position; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, opposite that shown in FIG. 2. FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
