DESCRIPTION

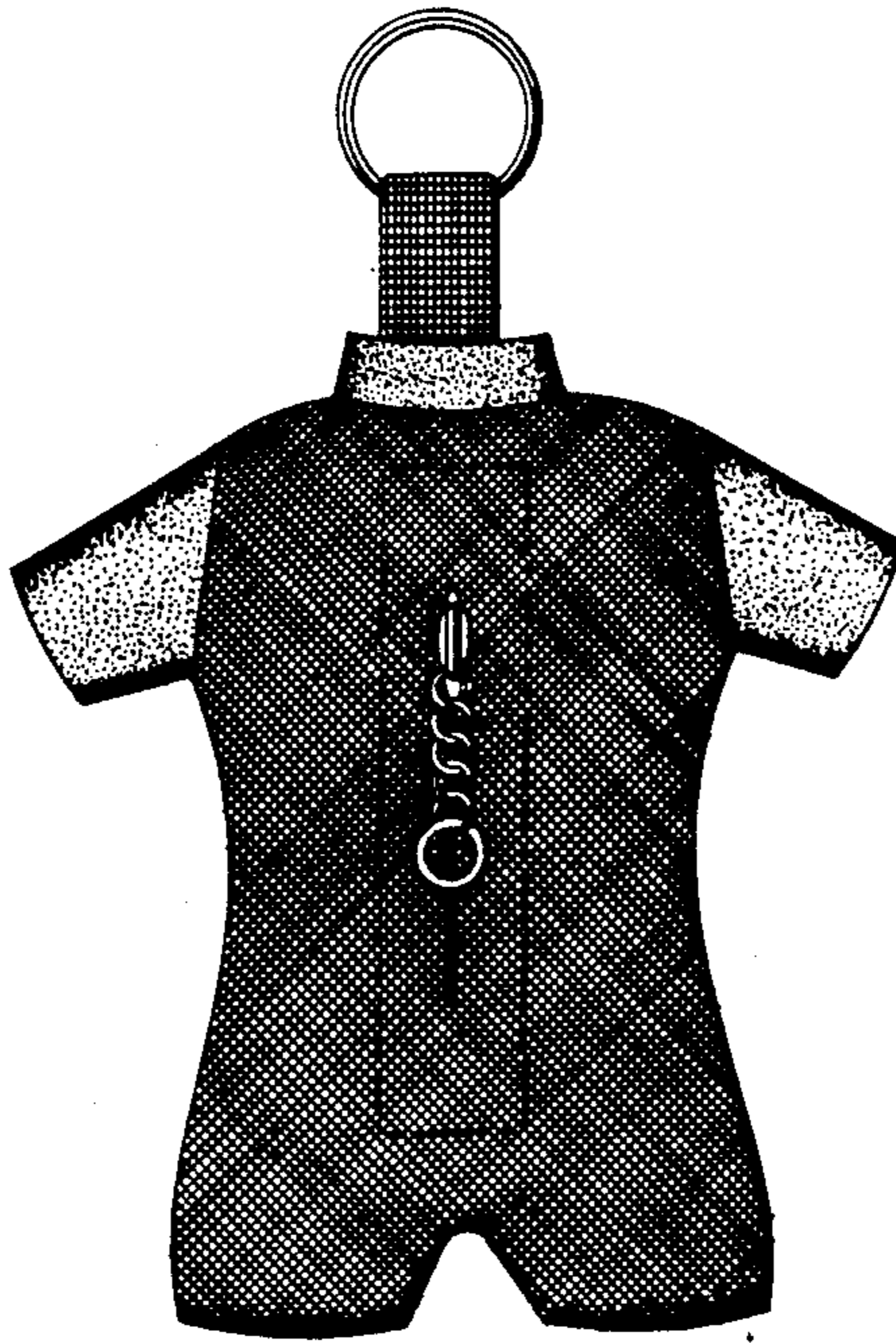
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wet suit simulating key chain showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



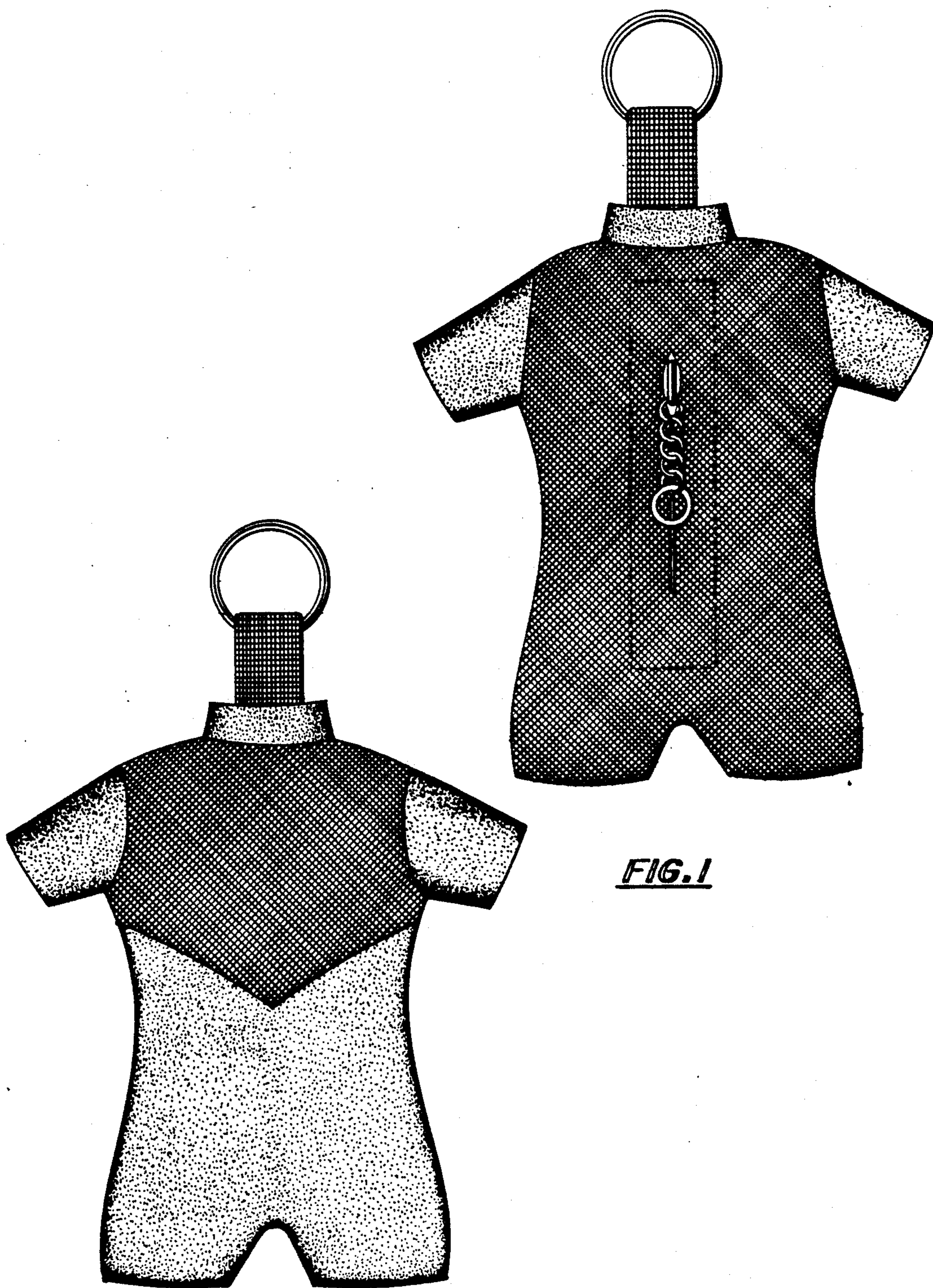

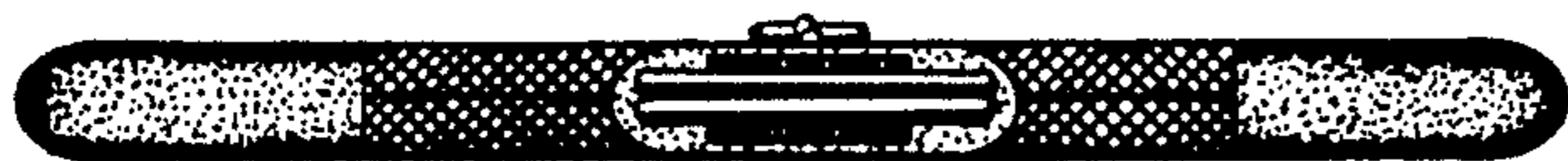
