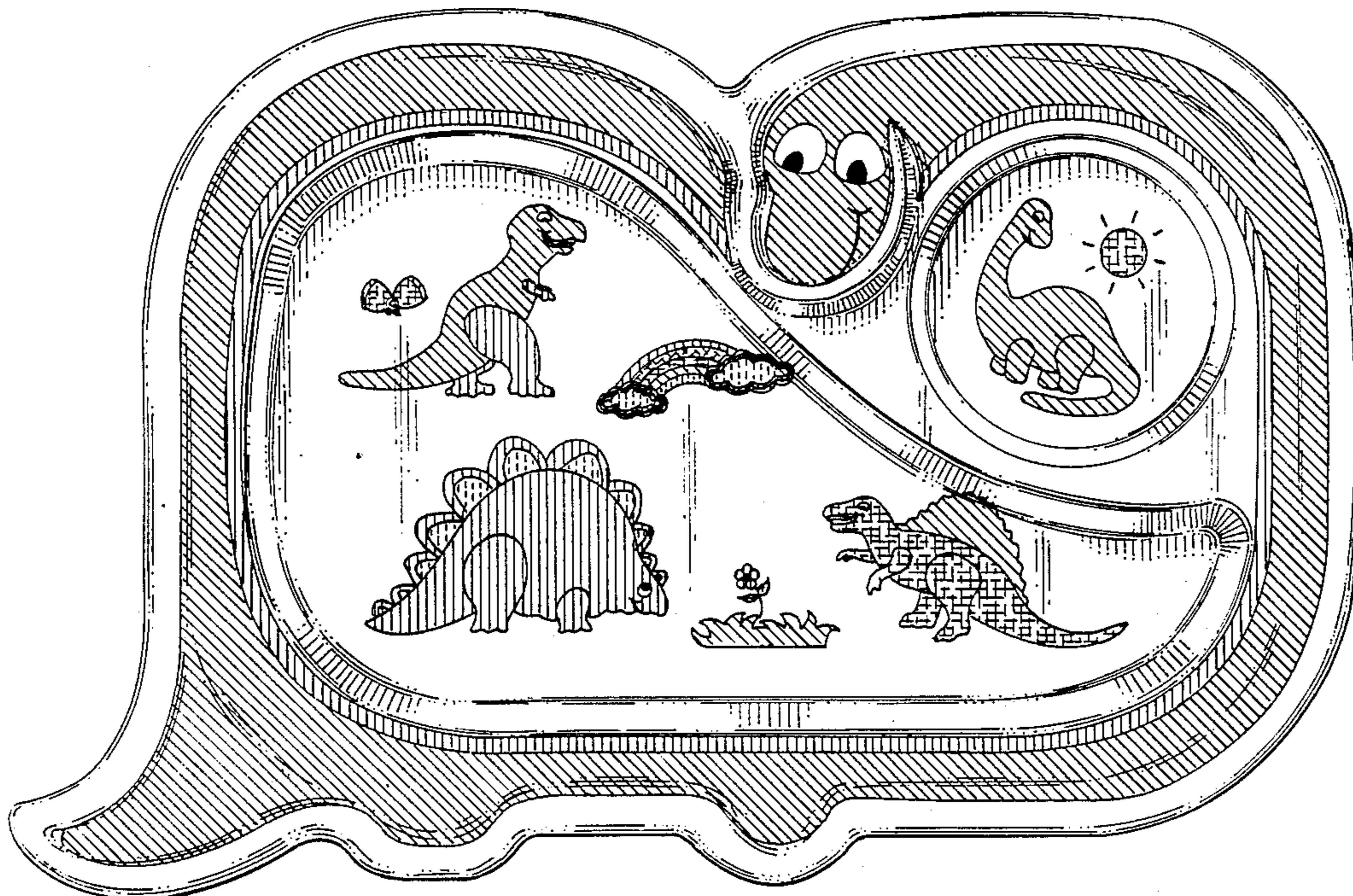

The drawing view FIG. 1 has been lined to show color.





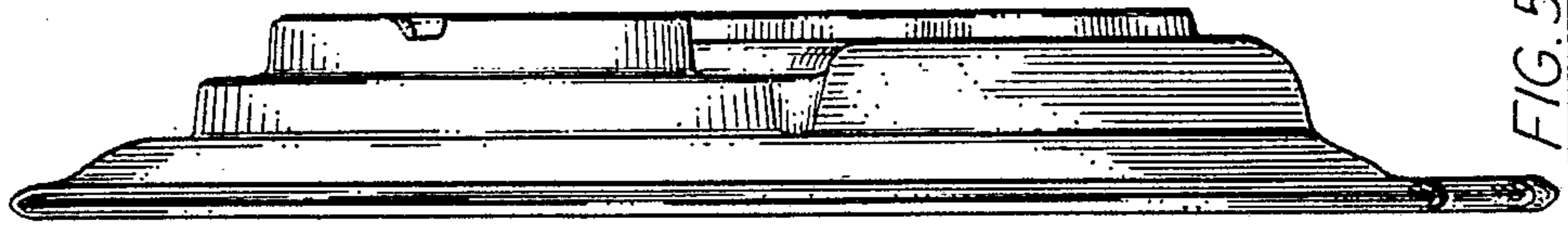

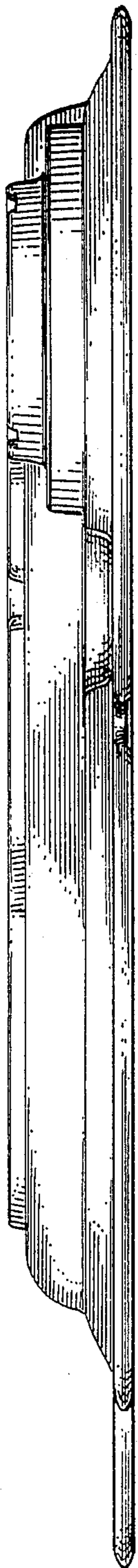

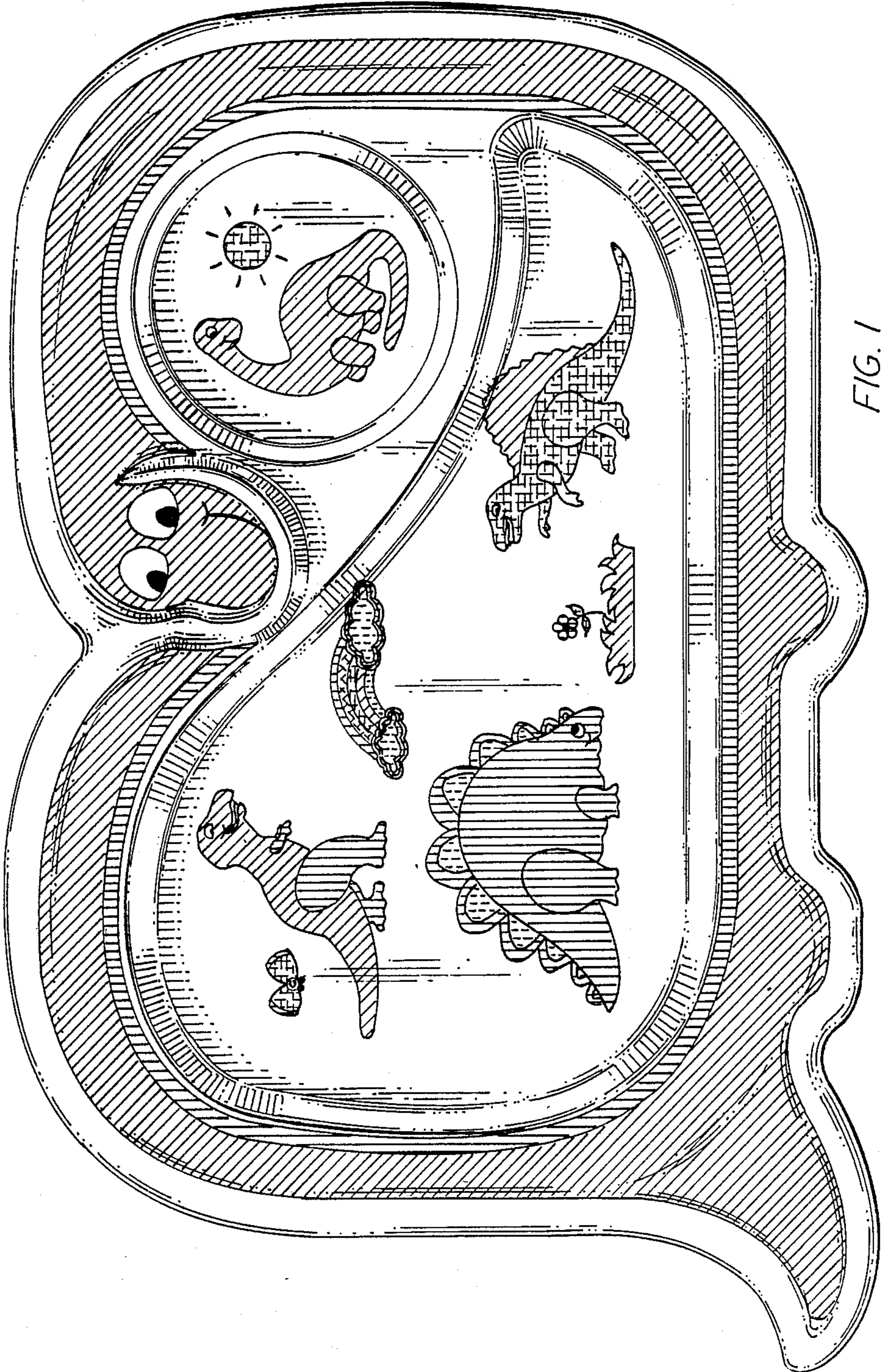

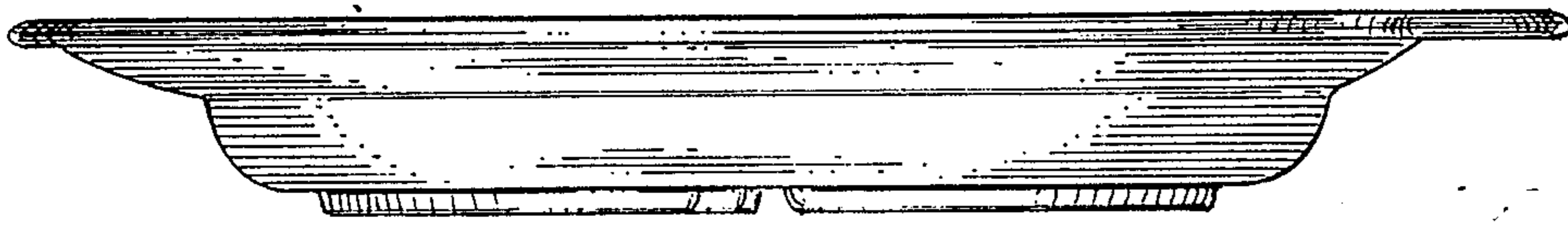

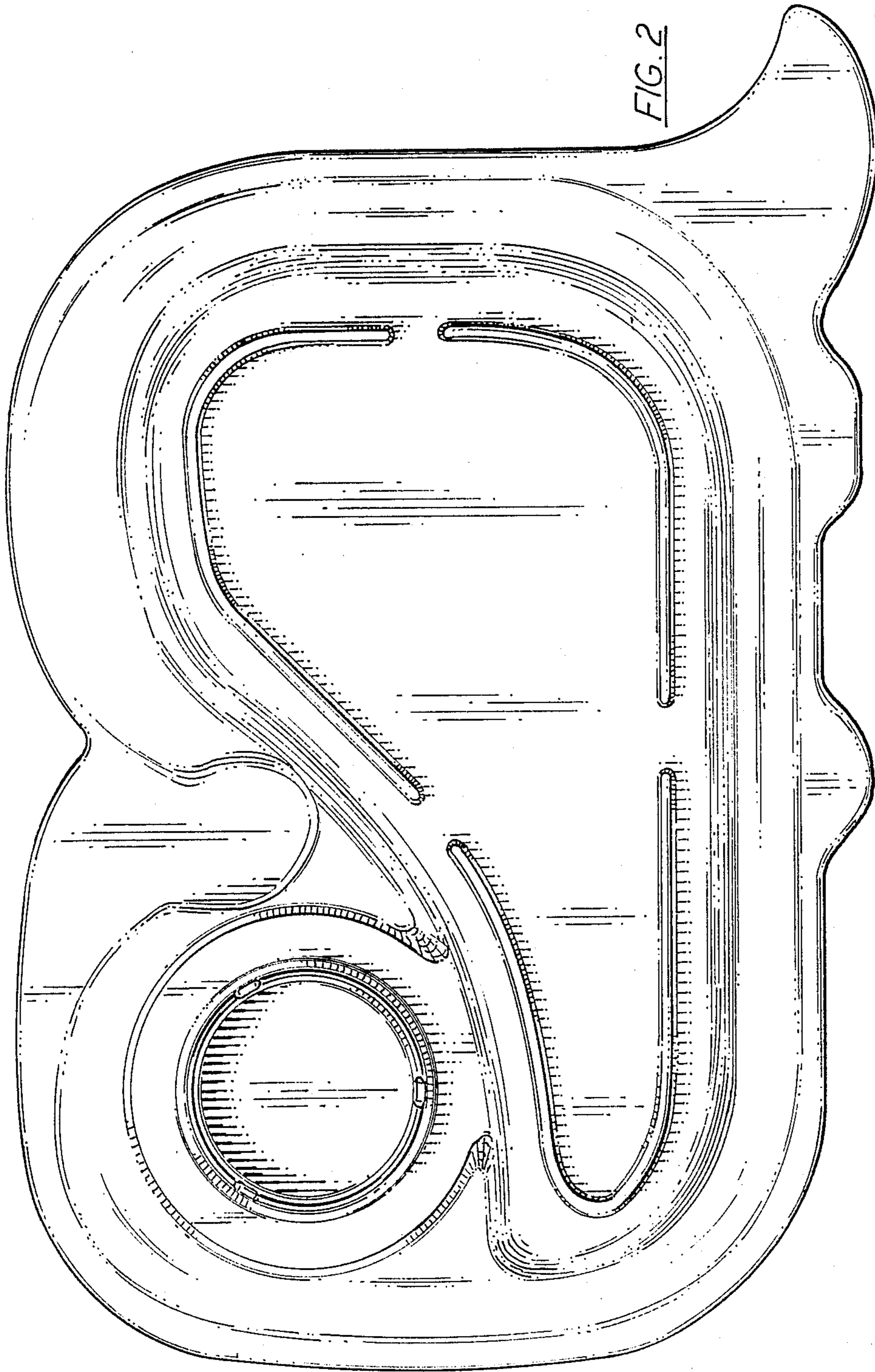

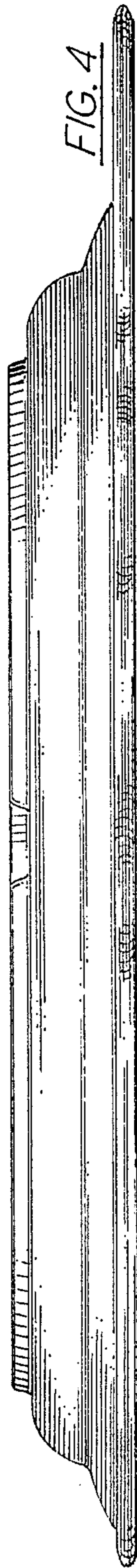
