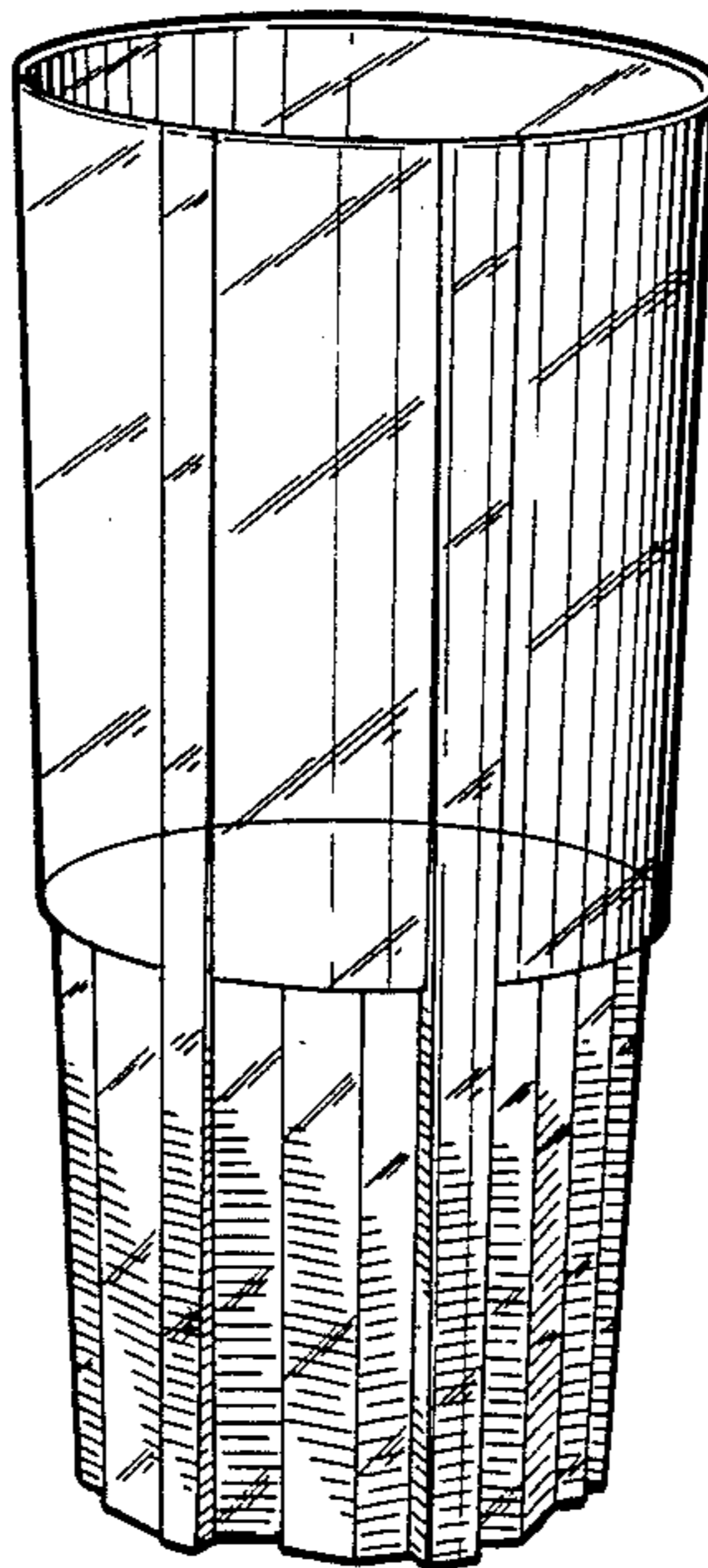

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of a tumbler or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



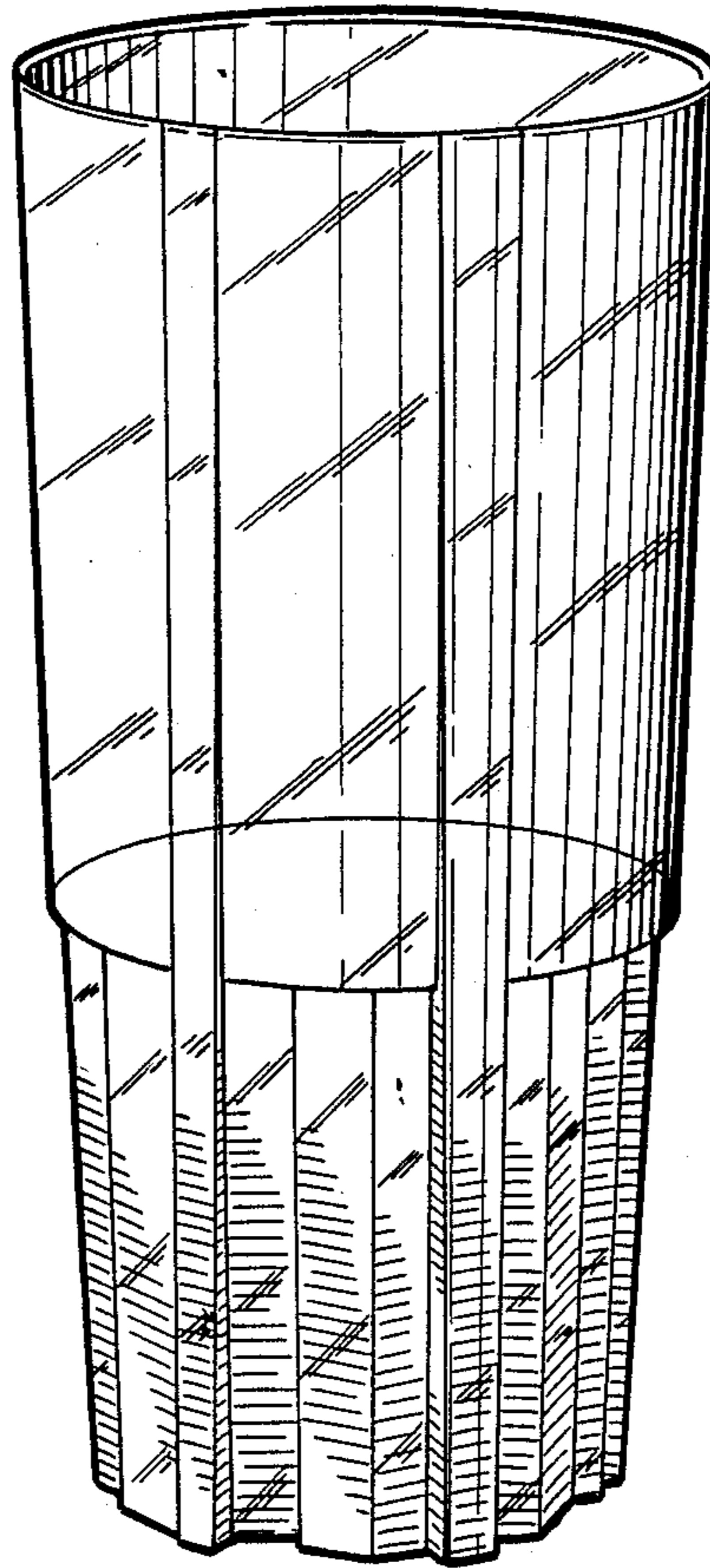

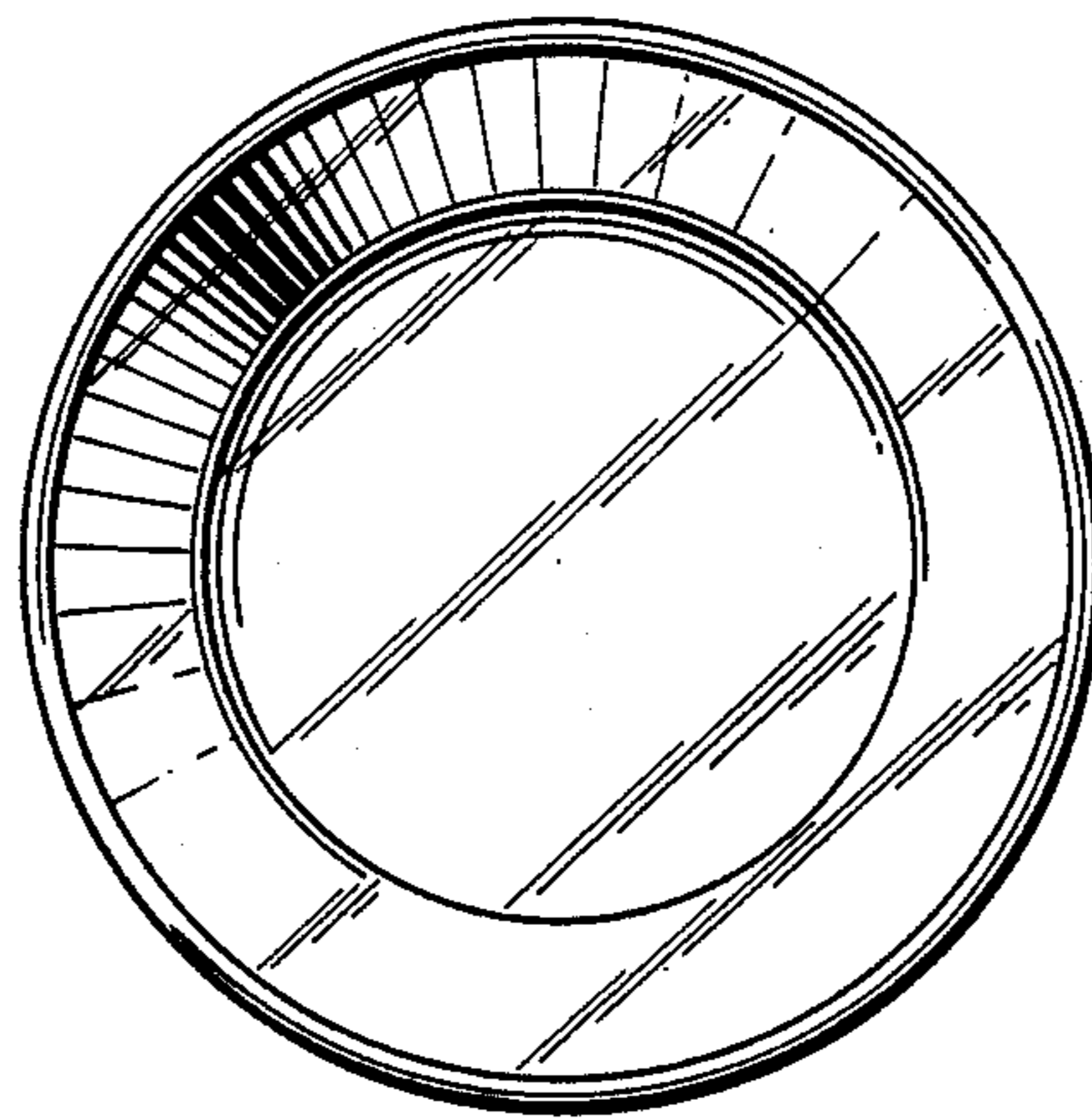

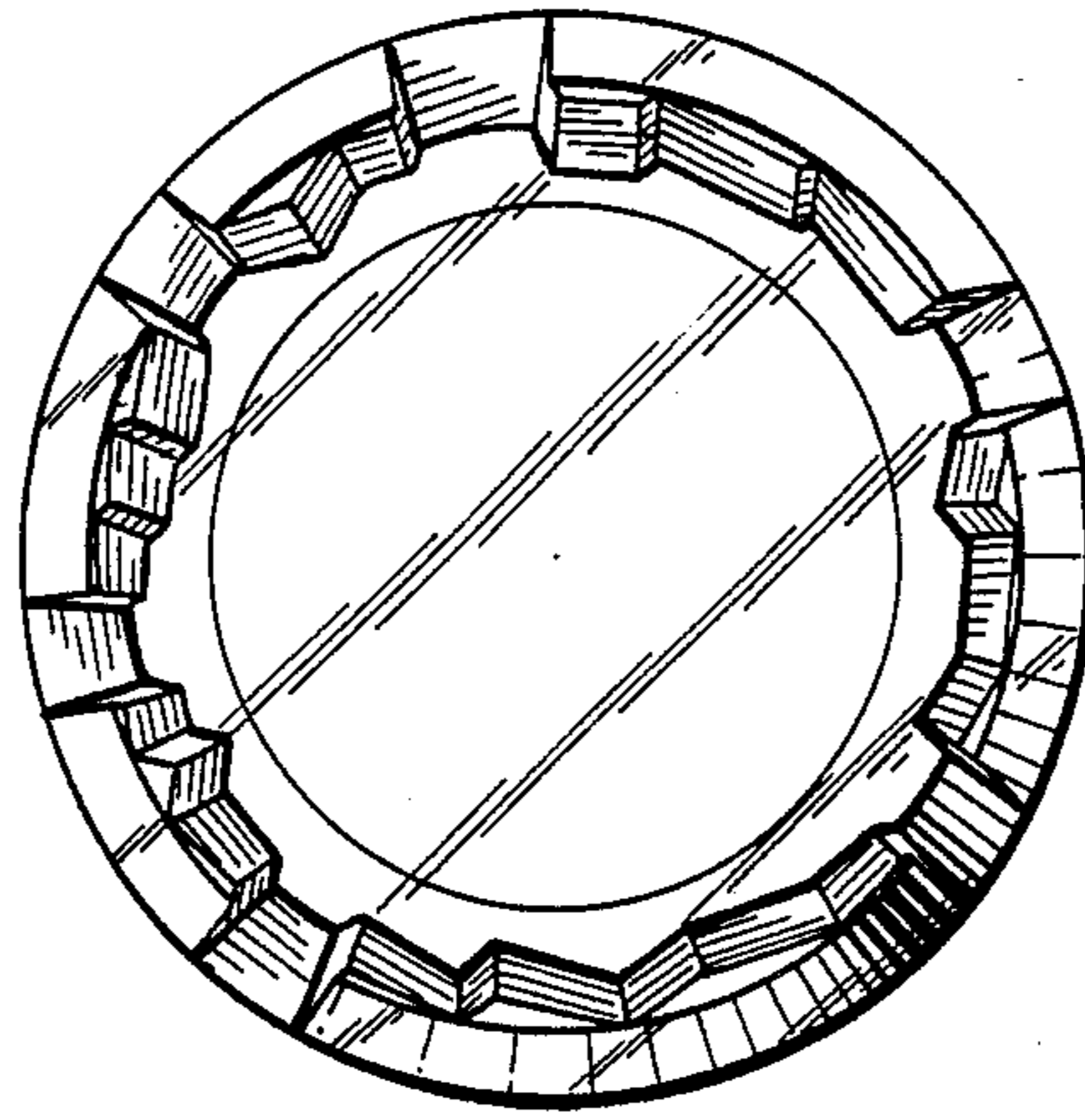

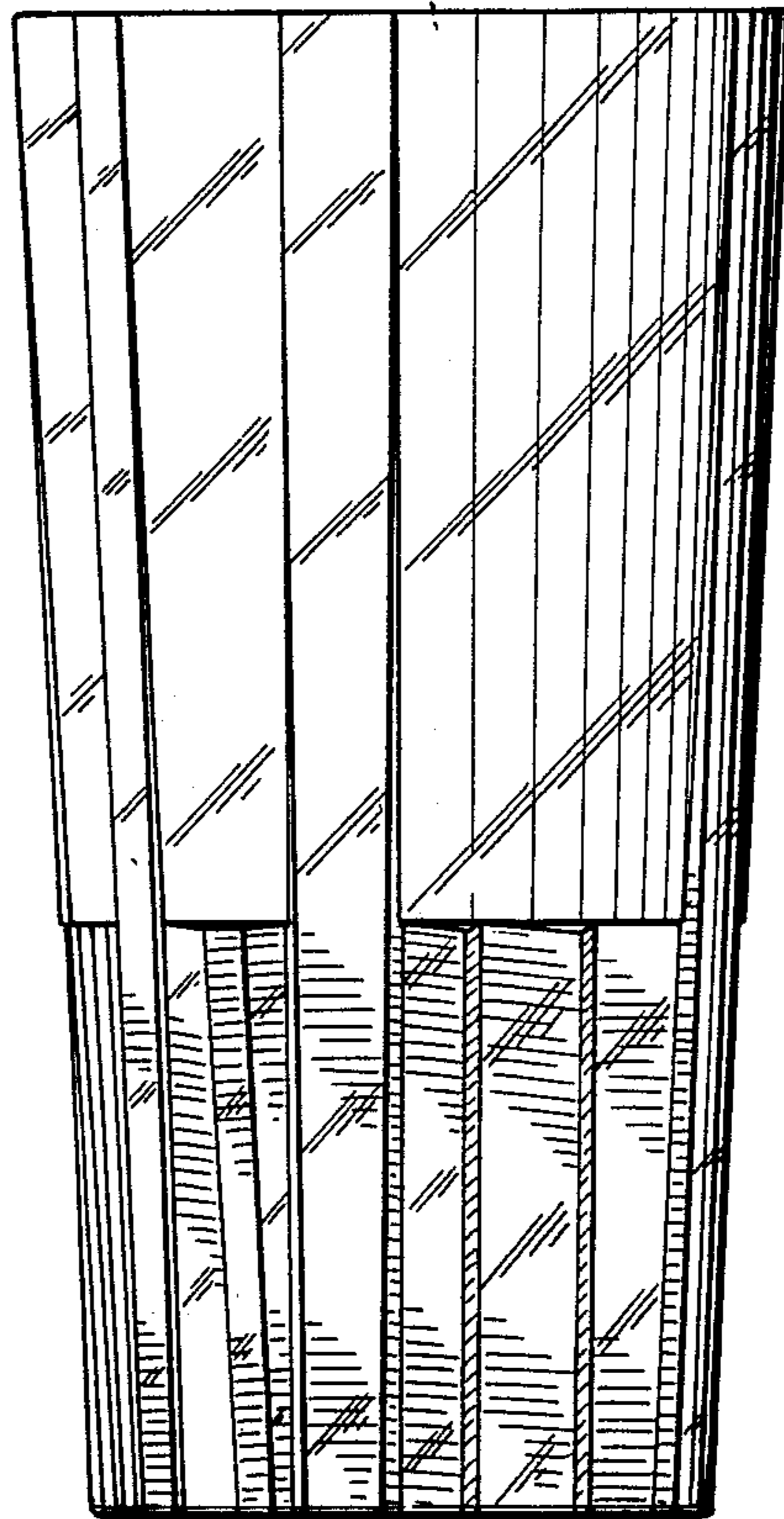
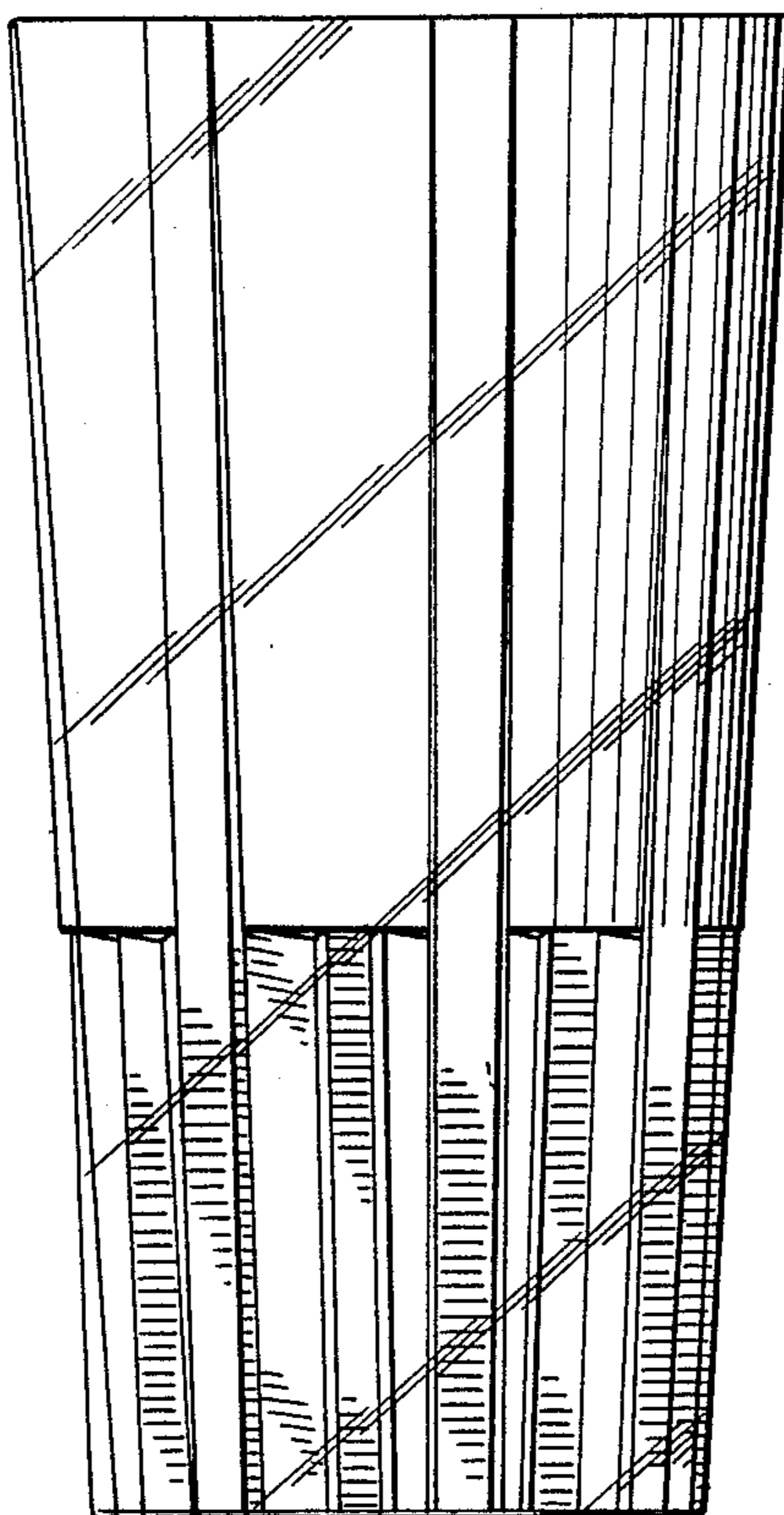
