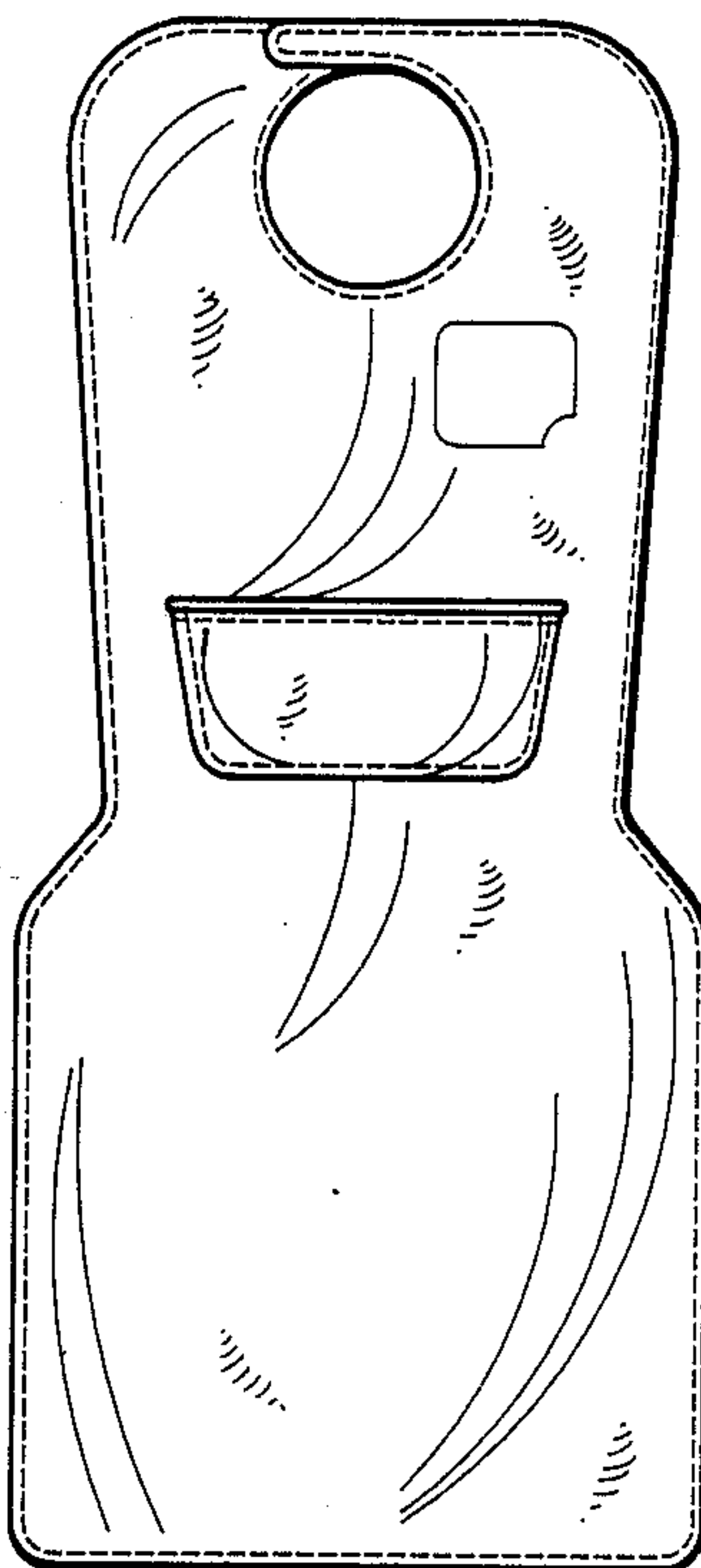

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a traveler's bib showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



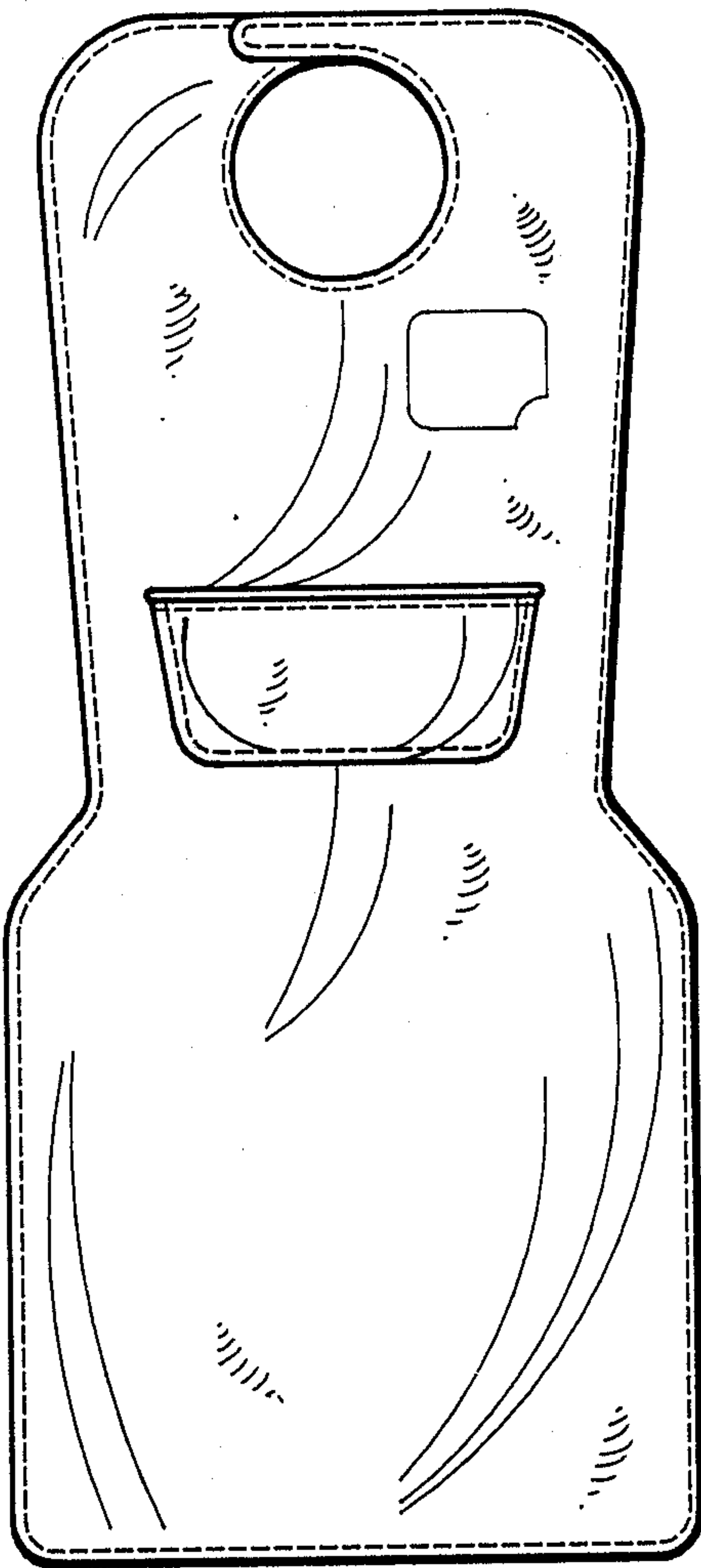

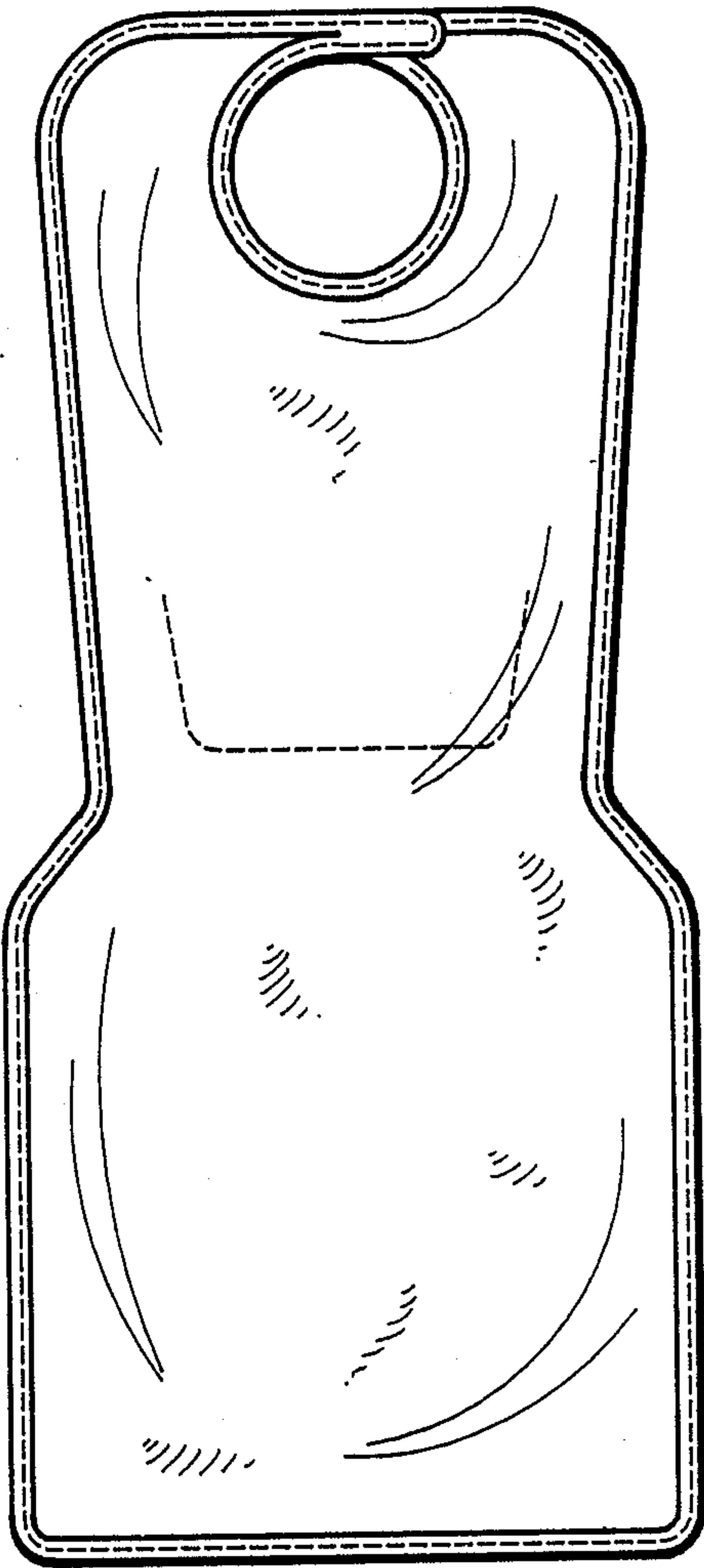

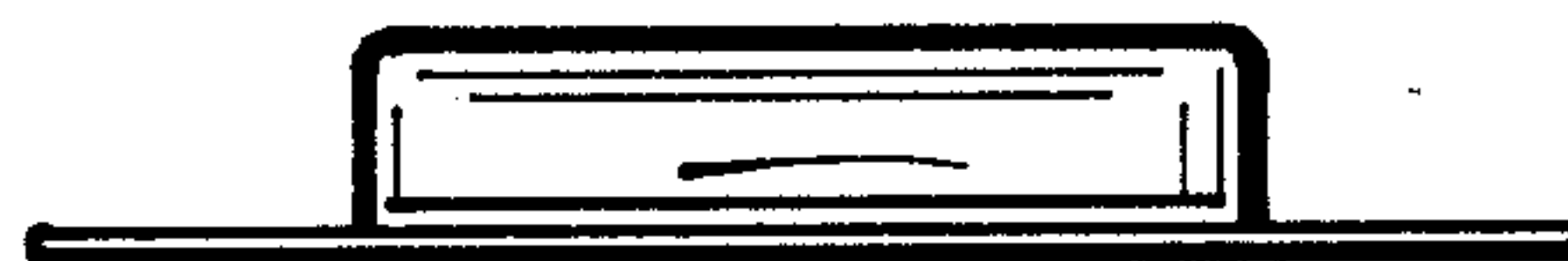
