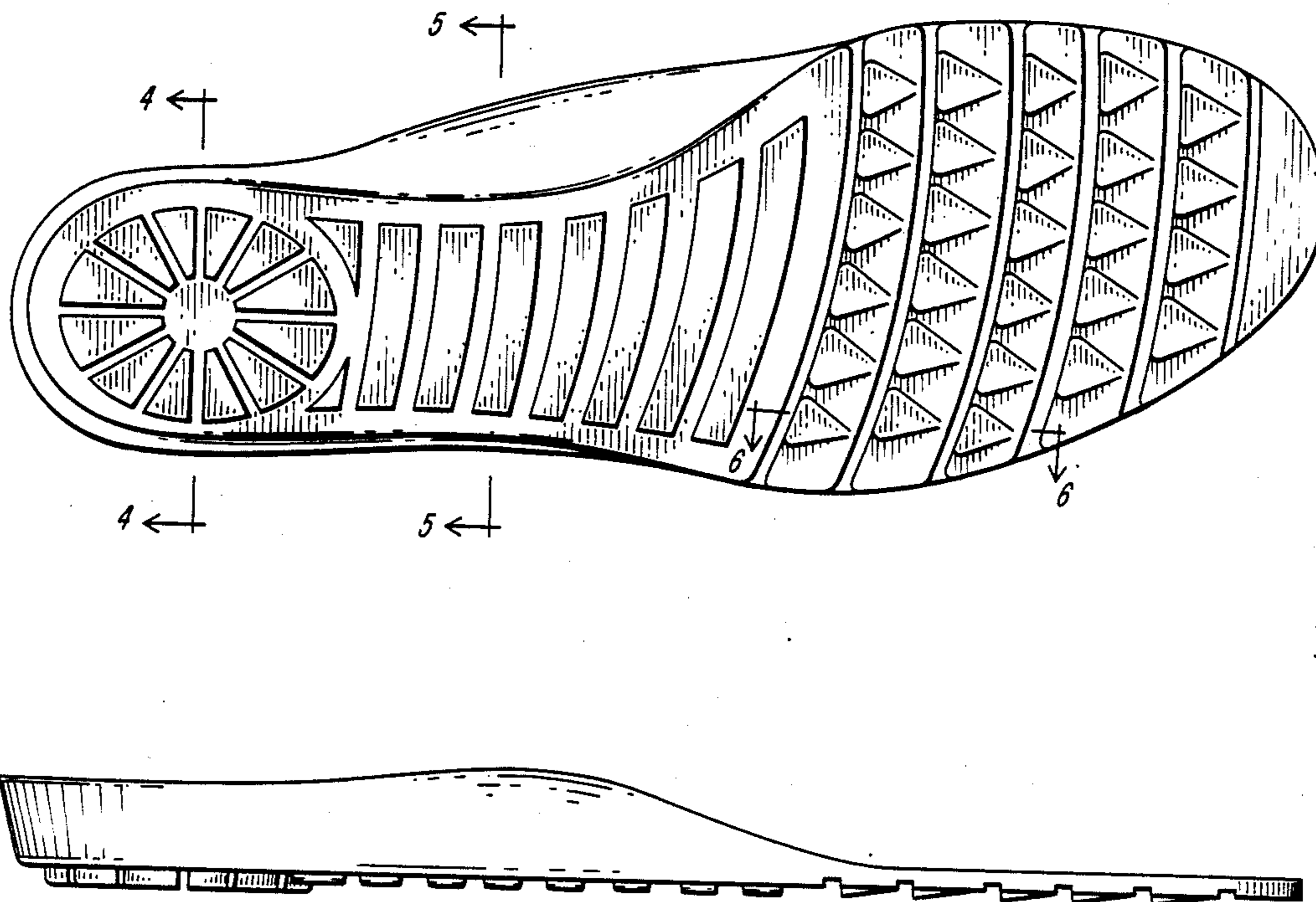

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of an insole showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view; and
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view;

 FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view on the line 6—6 of FIG. 1.



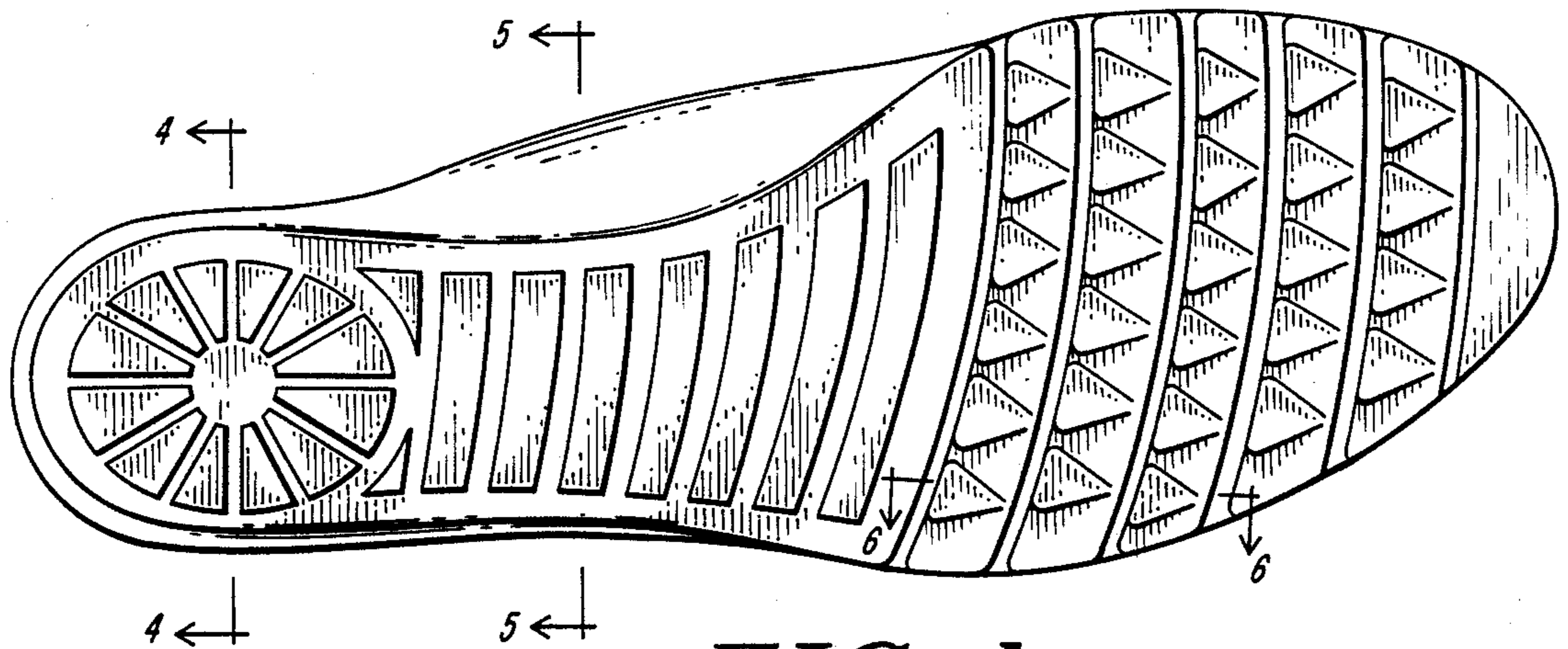

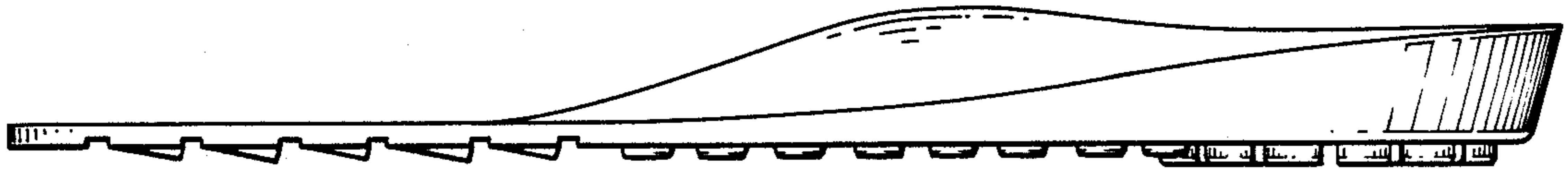

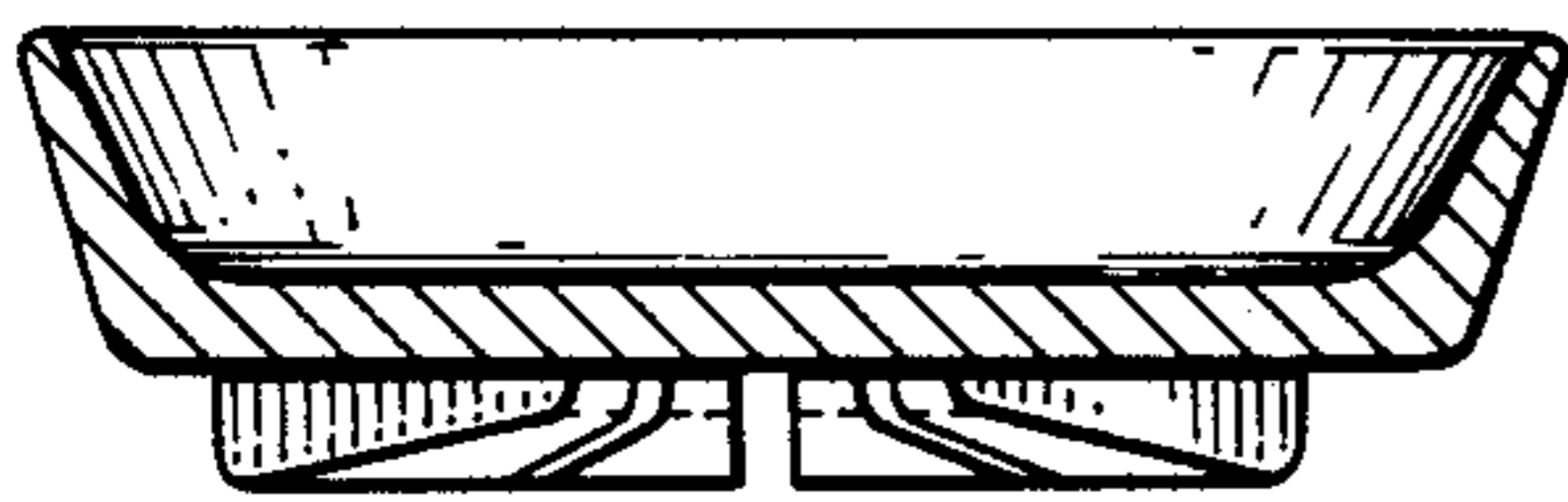

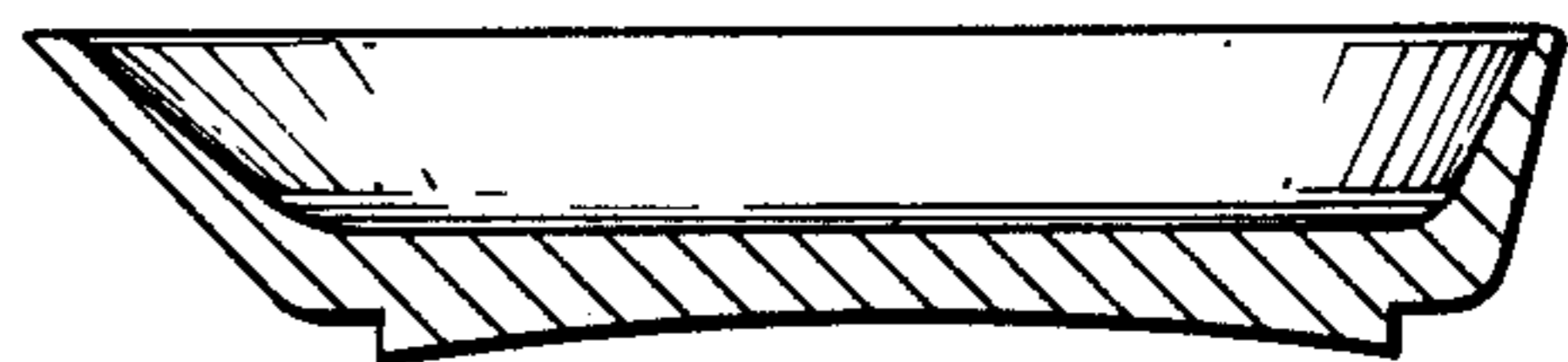
