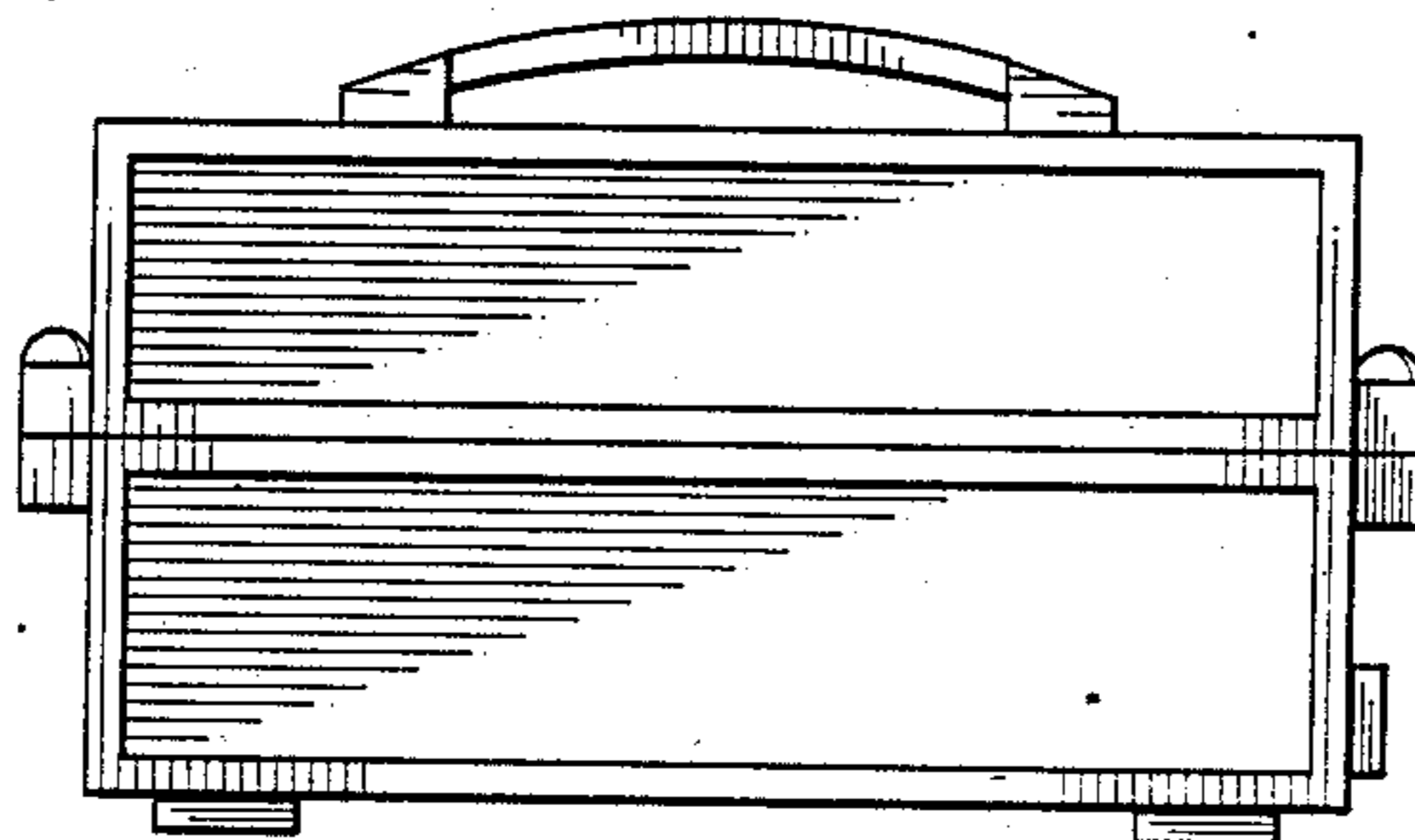
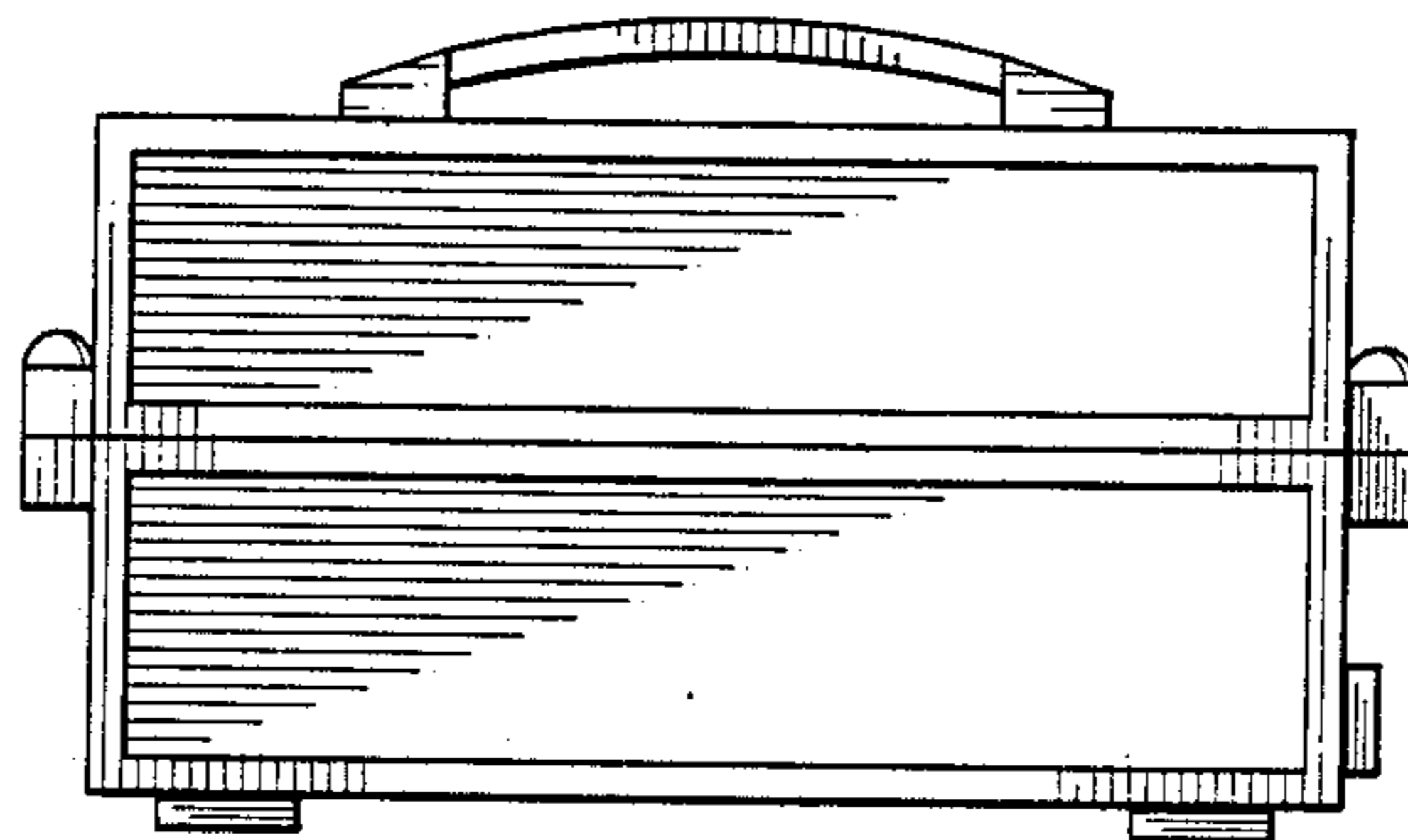

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a case for a vehicular cassette player showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



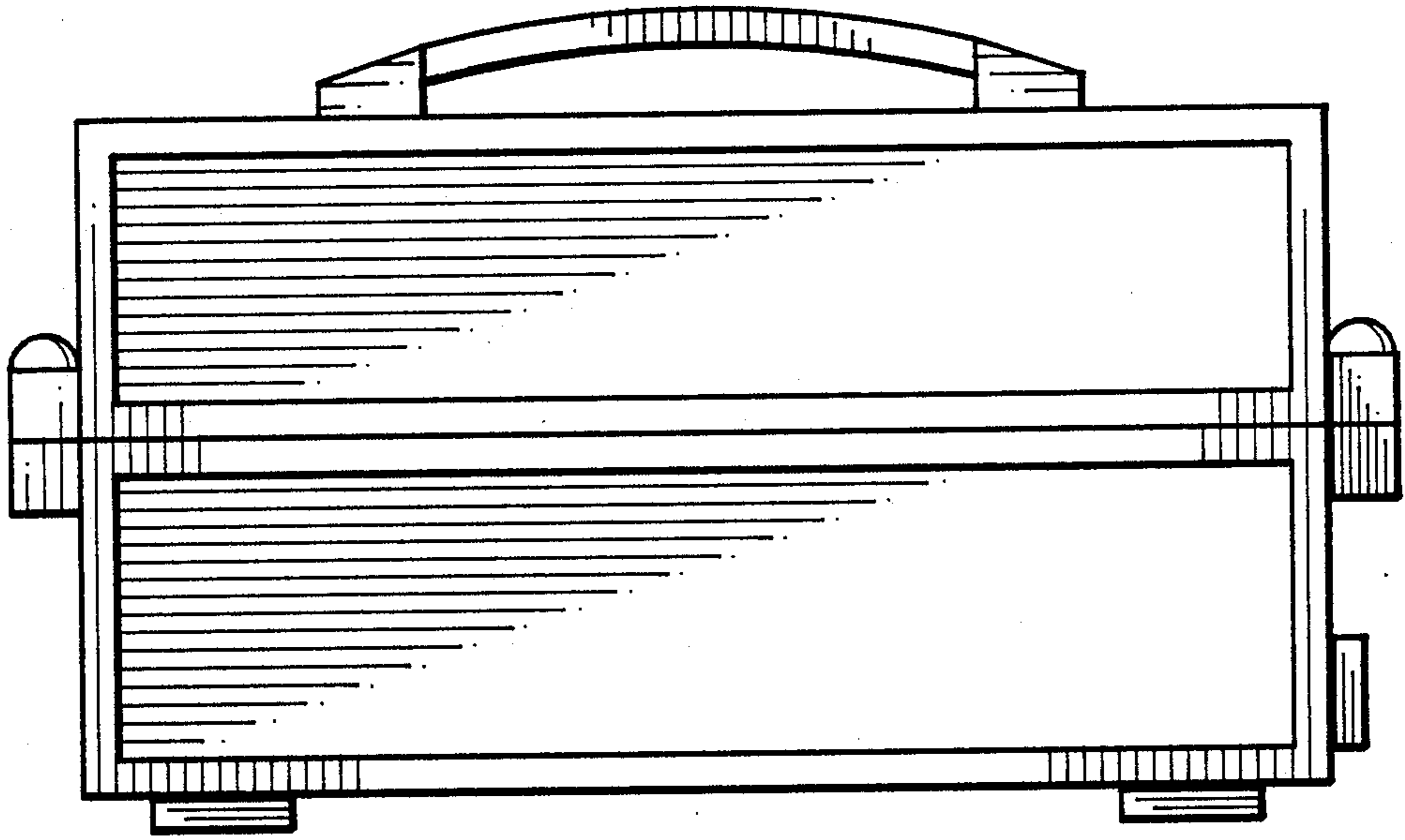

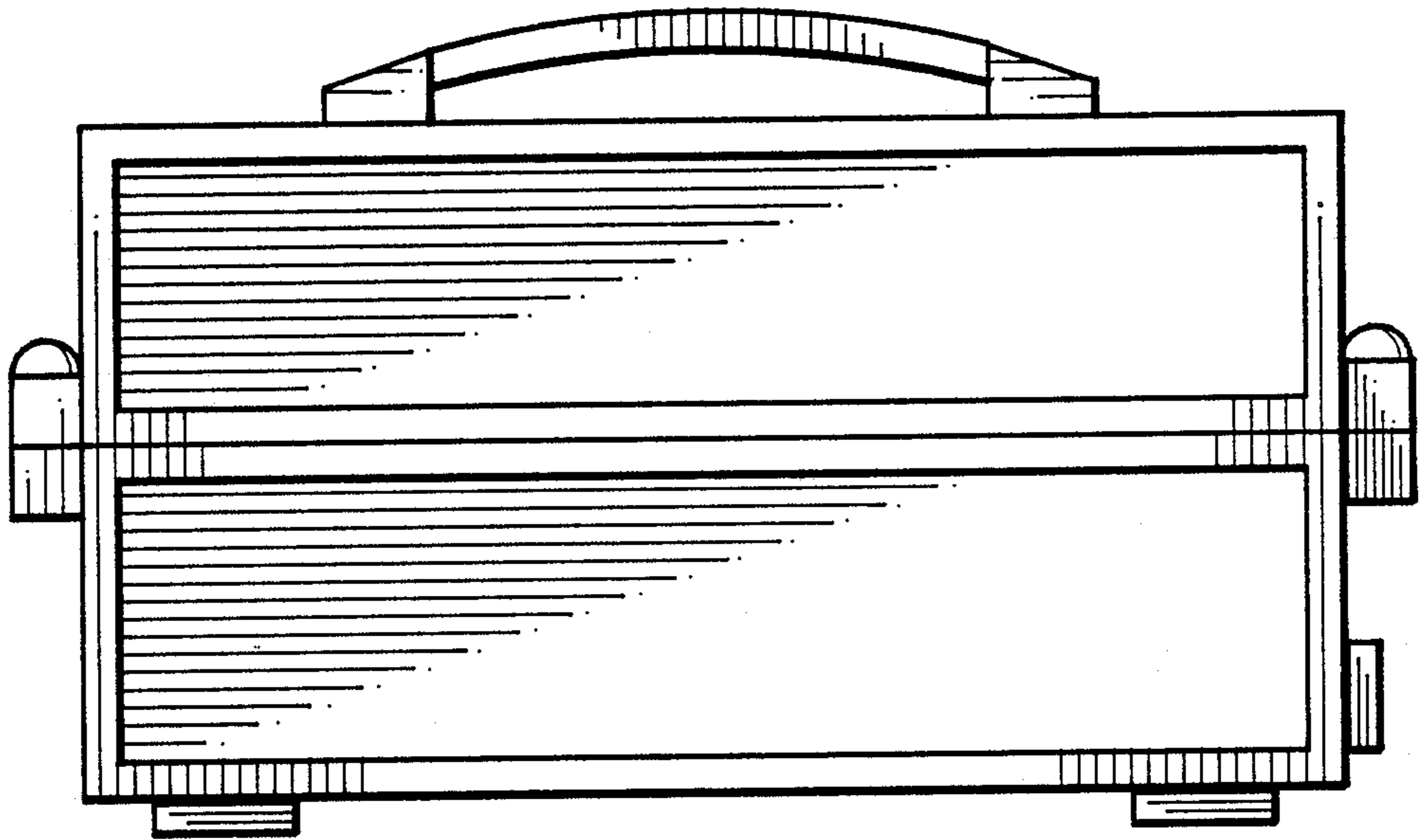

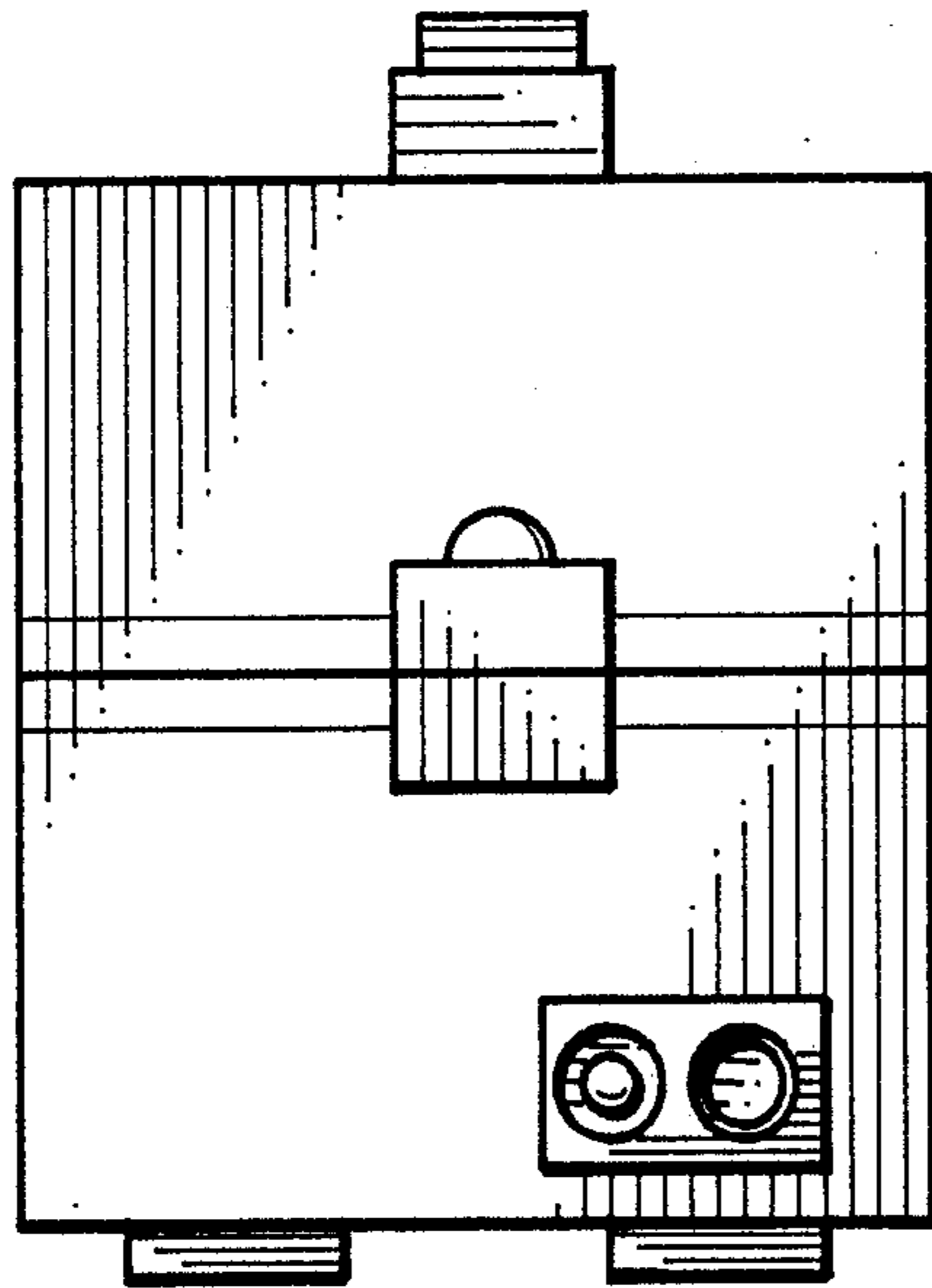

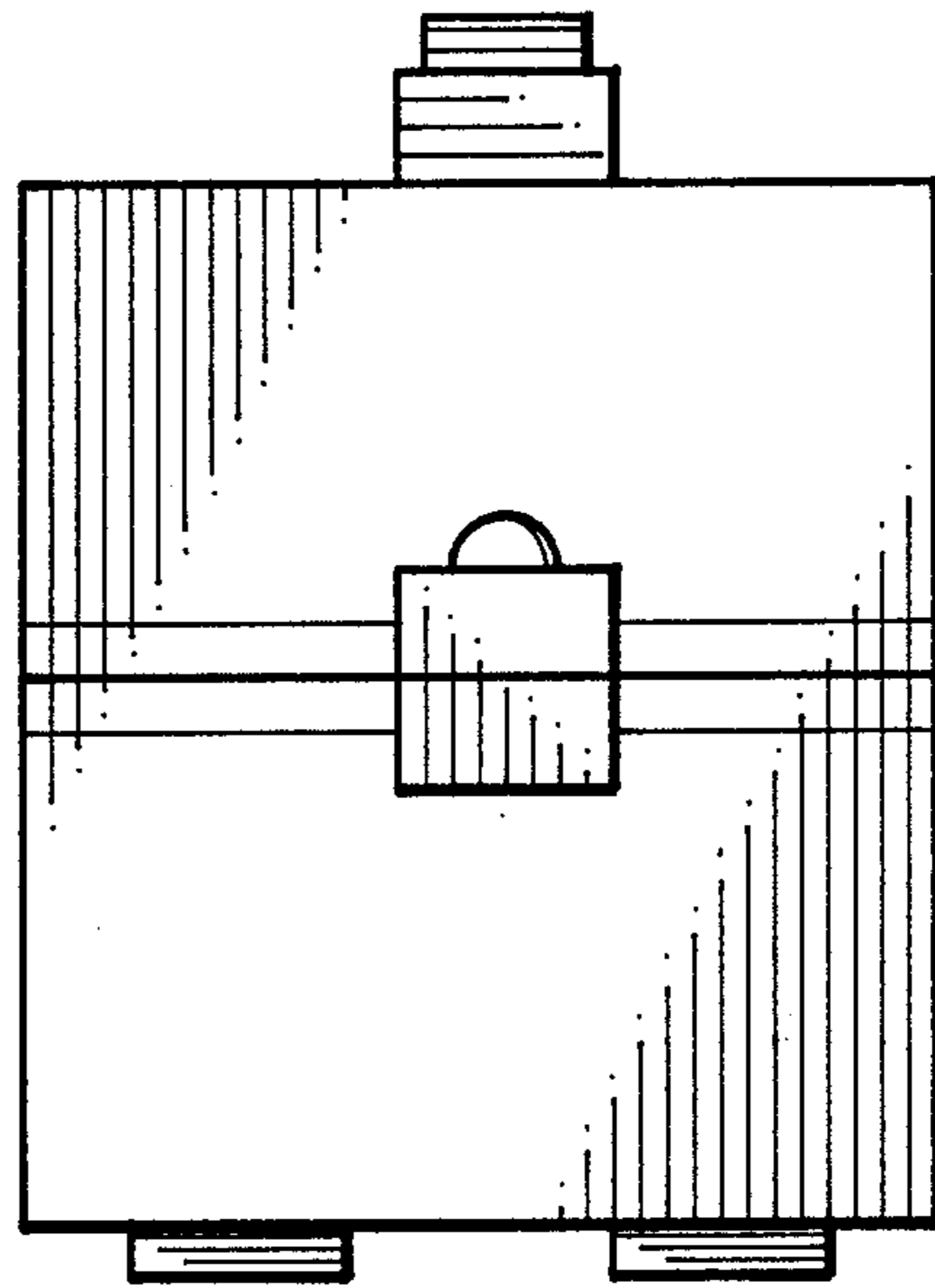

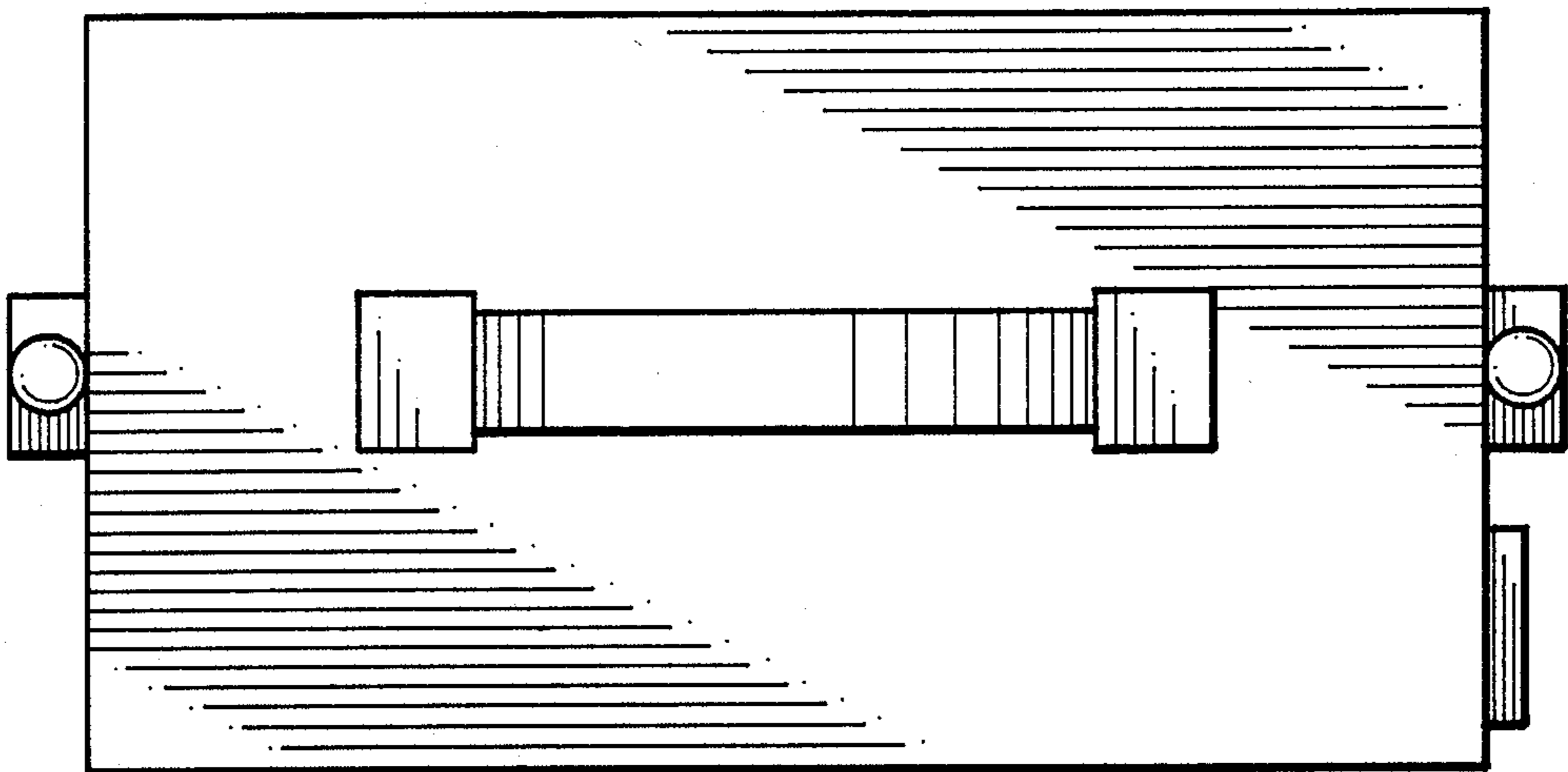

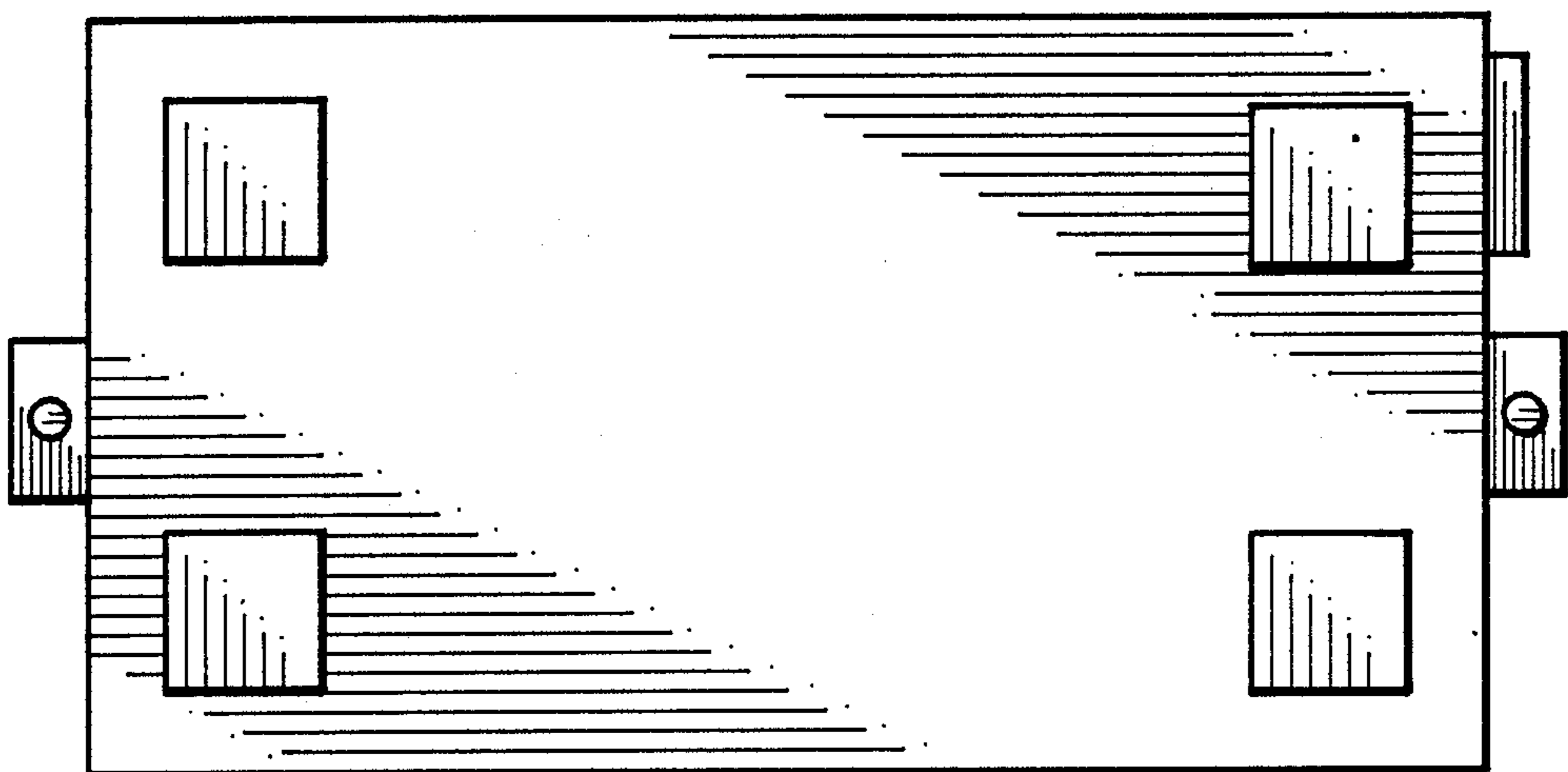
