[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a vehicle tire, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a vehicle tire showing our new design it being understood that the tread pattern is repeated uniformly throughout the circumference of the tire and the opposite side is the same as that shown;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.

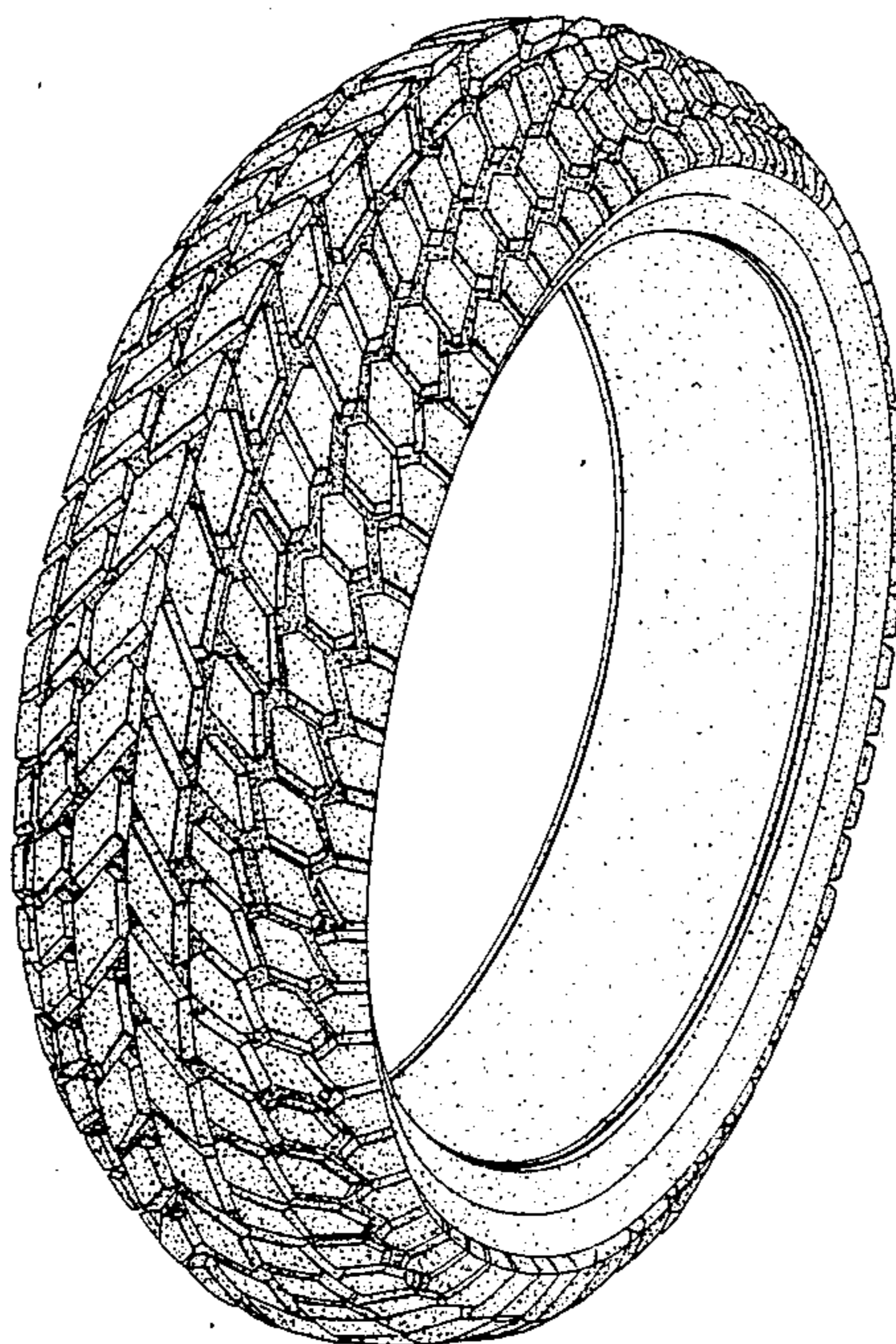

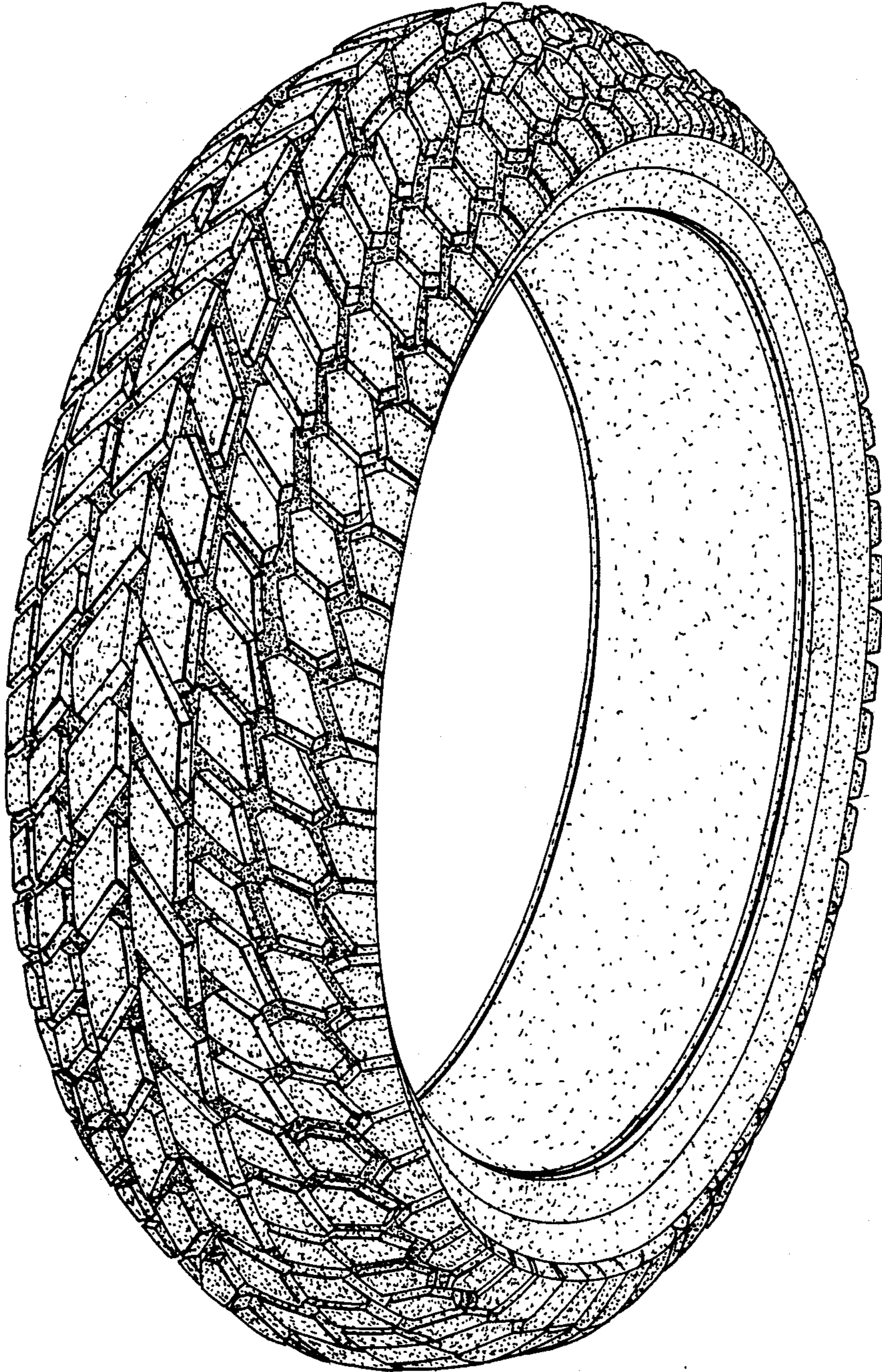

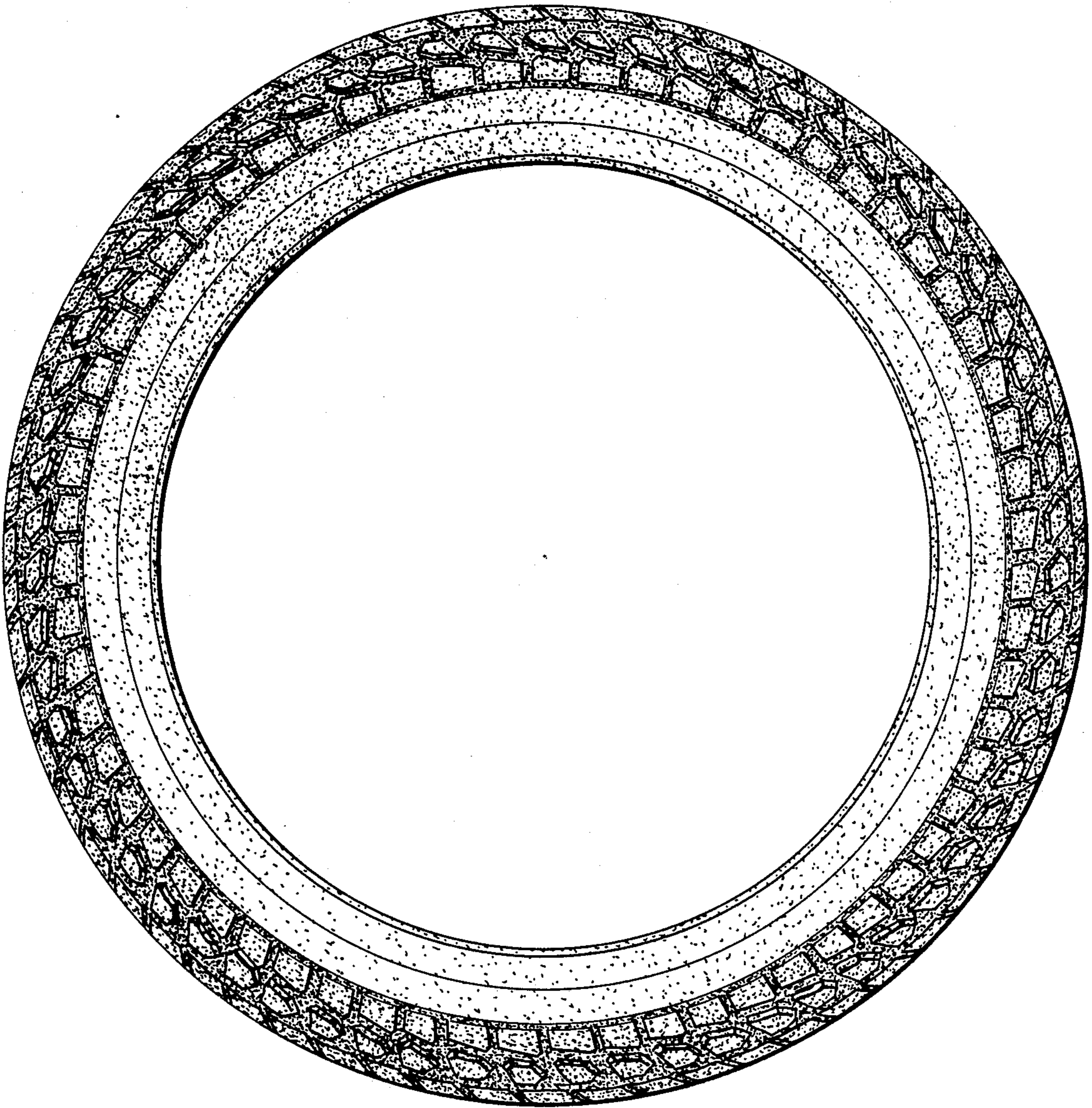
