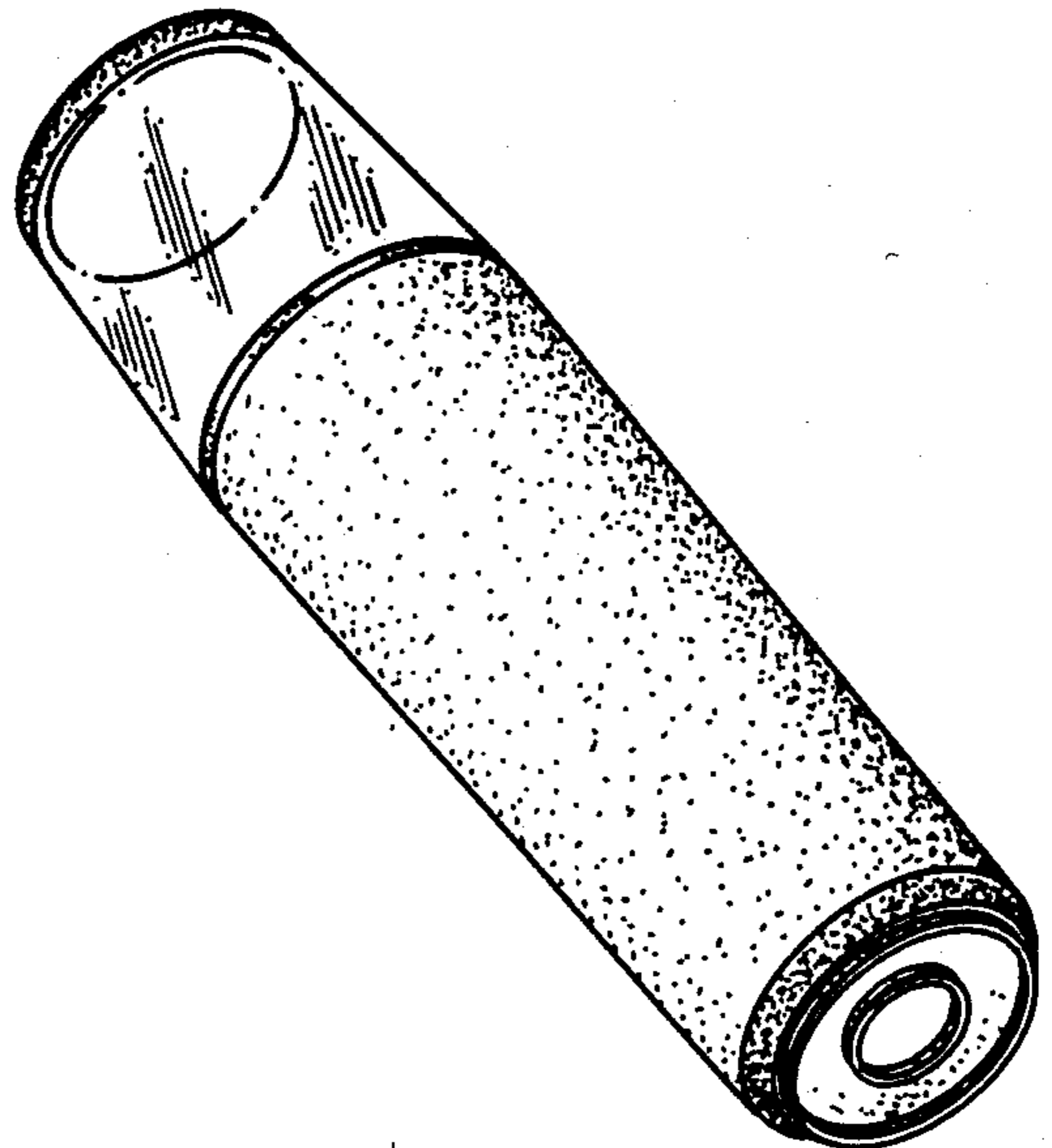
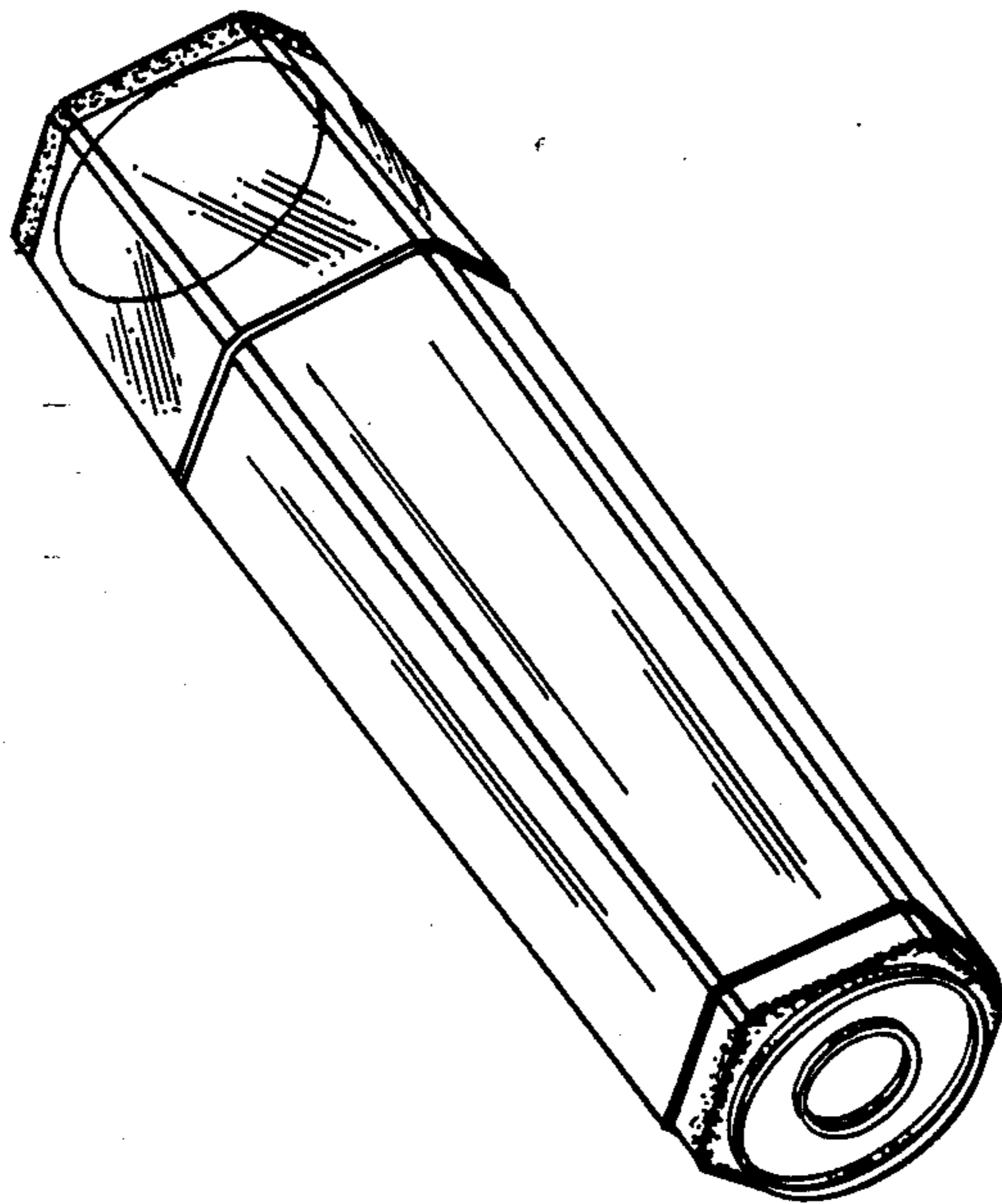

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a kaleidoscope showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;
 FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken substantially in the plane indicated by lines 6—6 of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a modified embodiment of the design shown in FIGS. 1-6;
 FIG. 8 is an elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 9 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view; and
 FIG. 11 is a cross-sectional view thereof corresponding to section line 6—6 of FIG. 2.



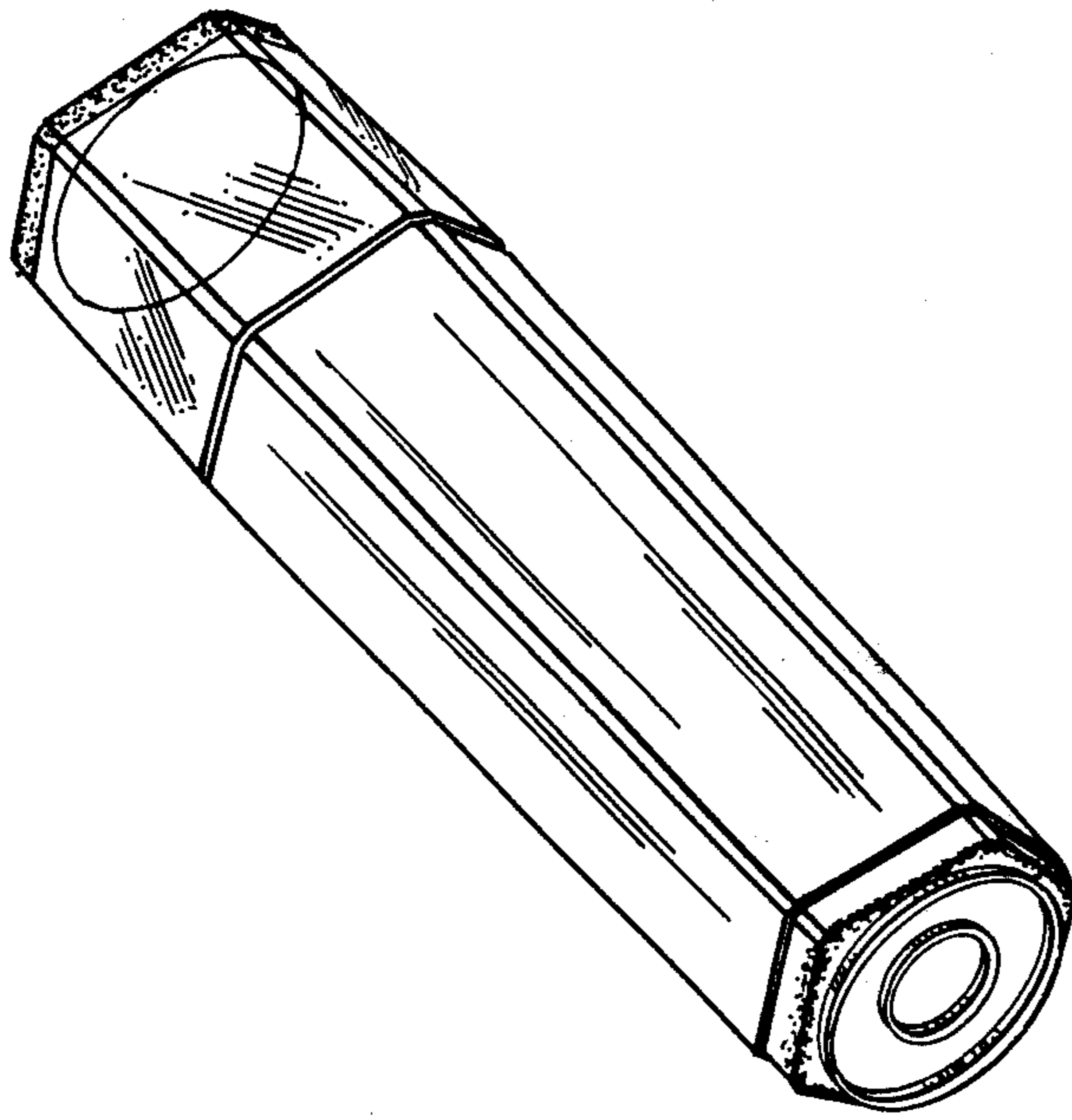

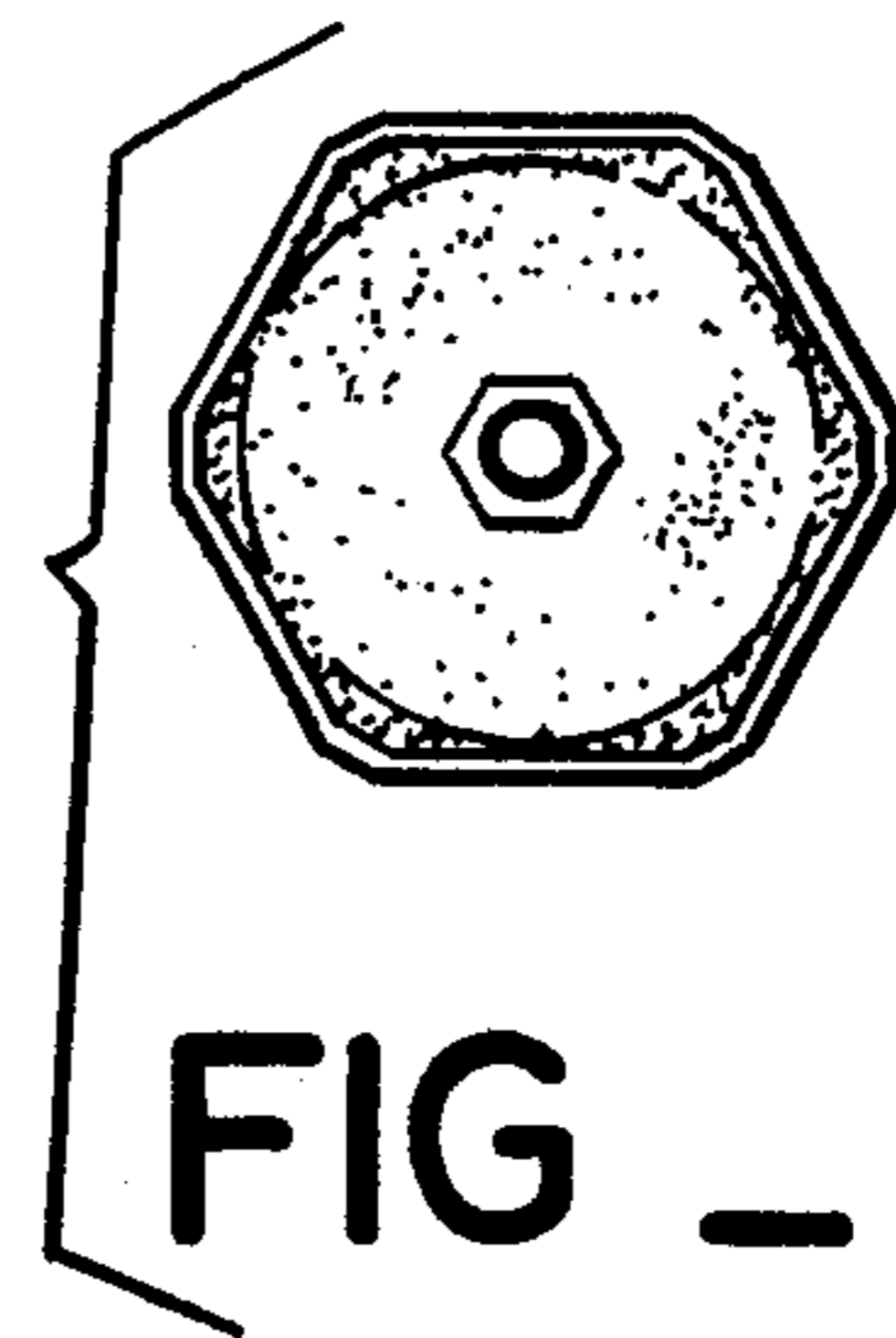

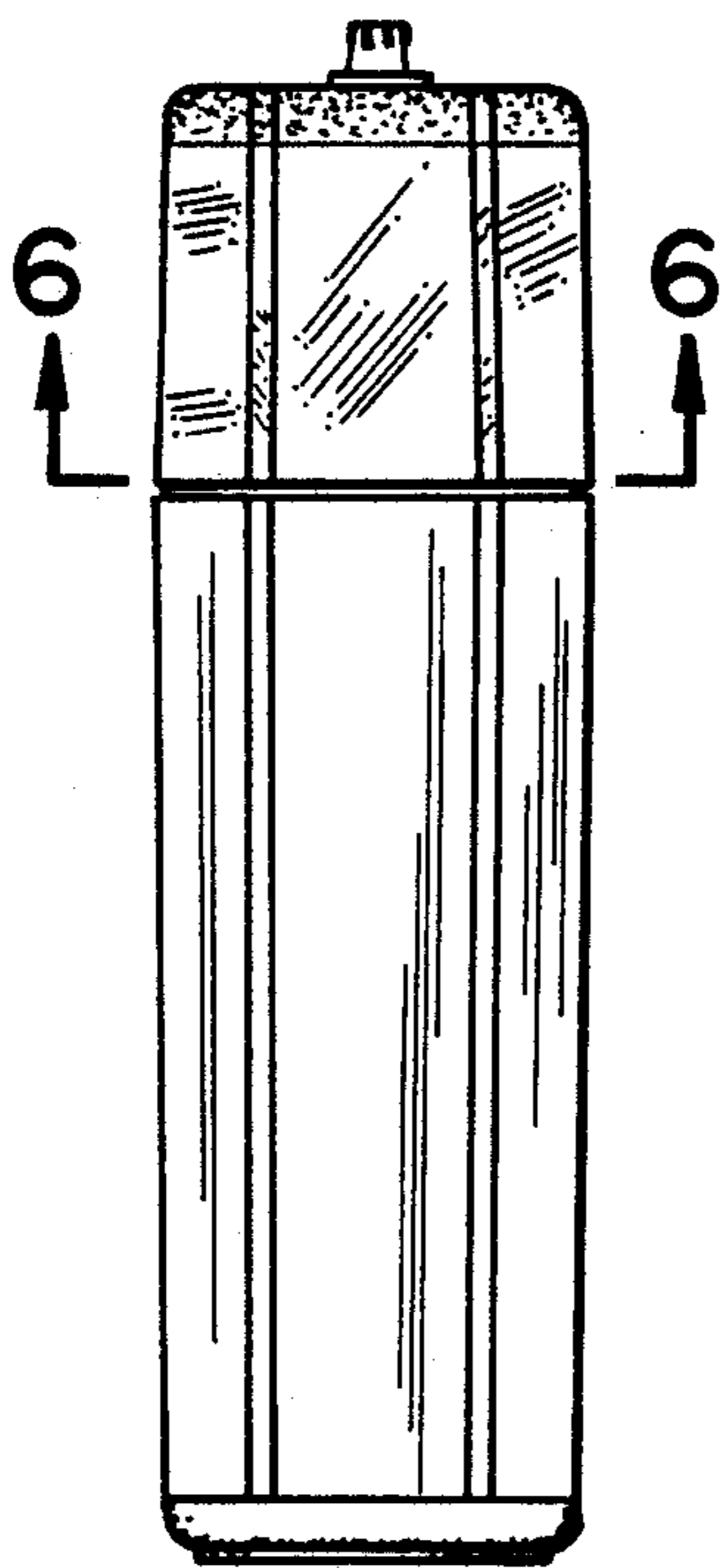

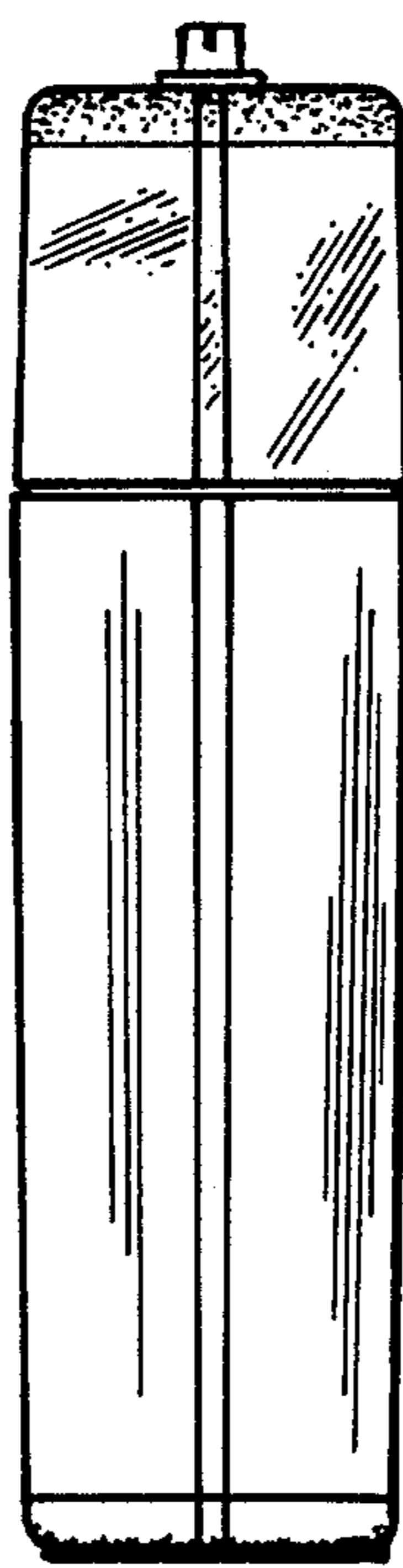

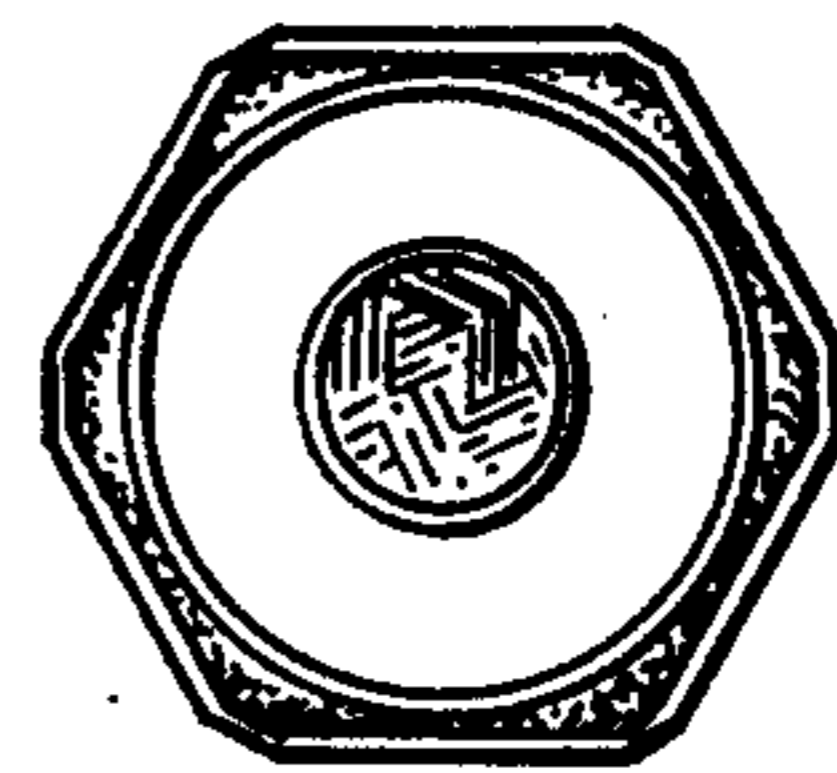

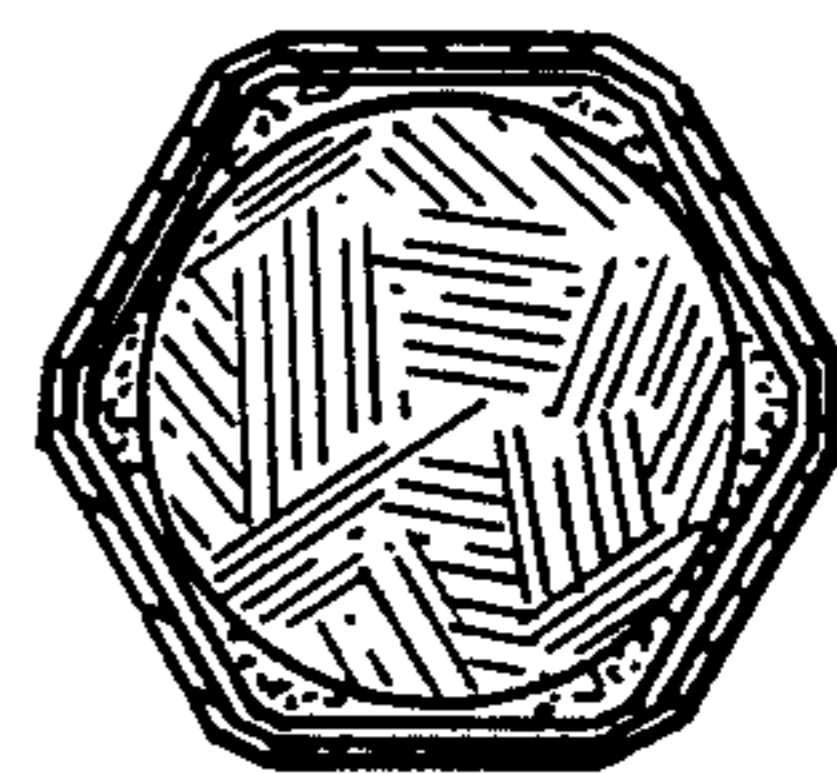

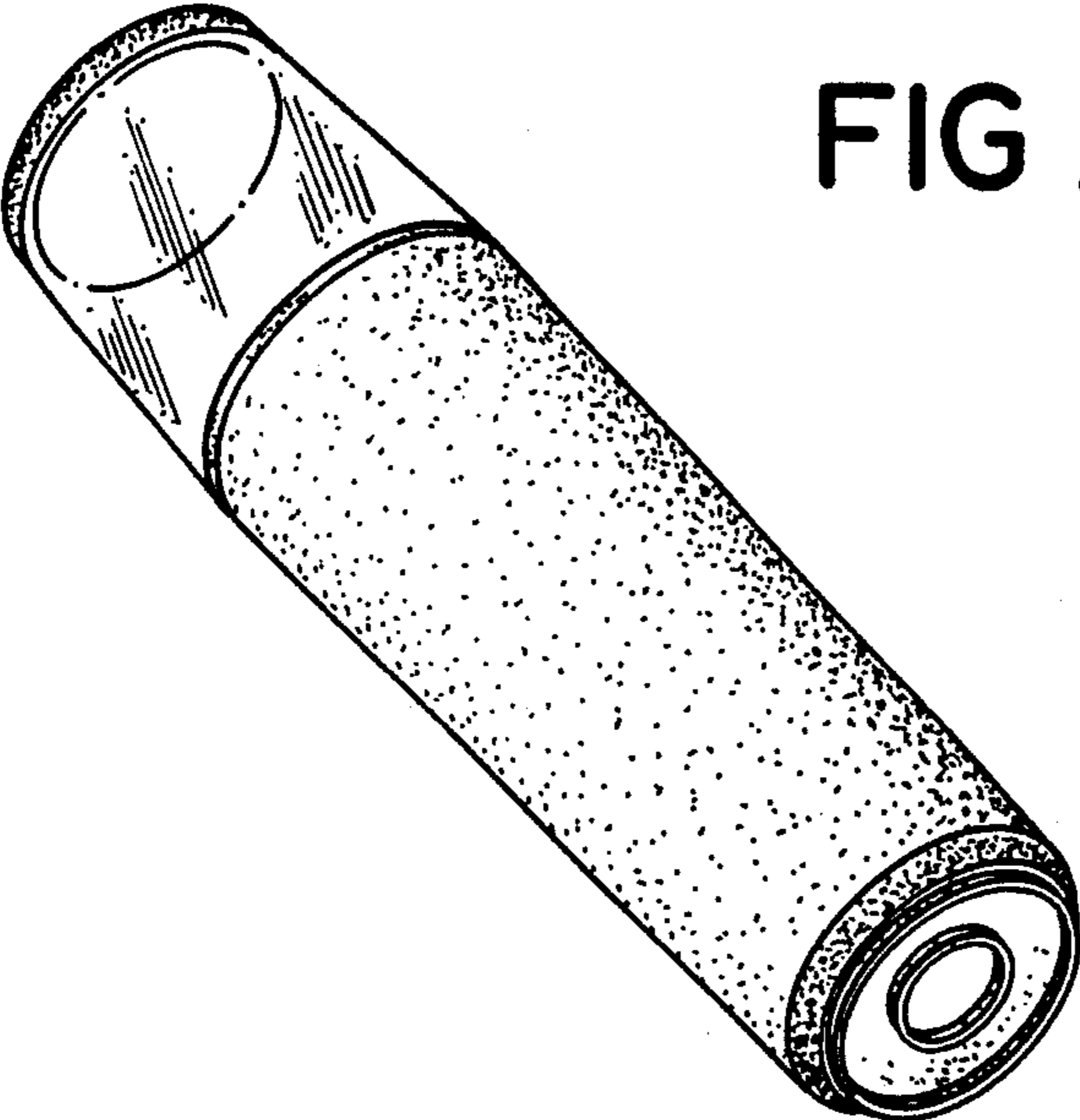

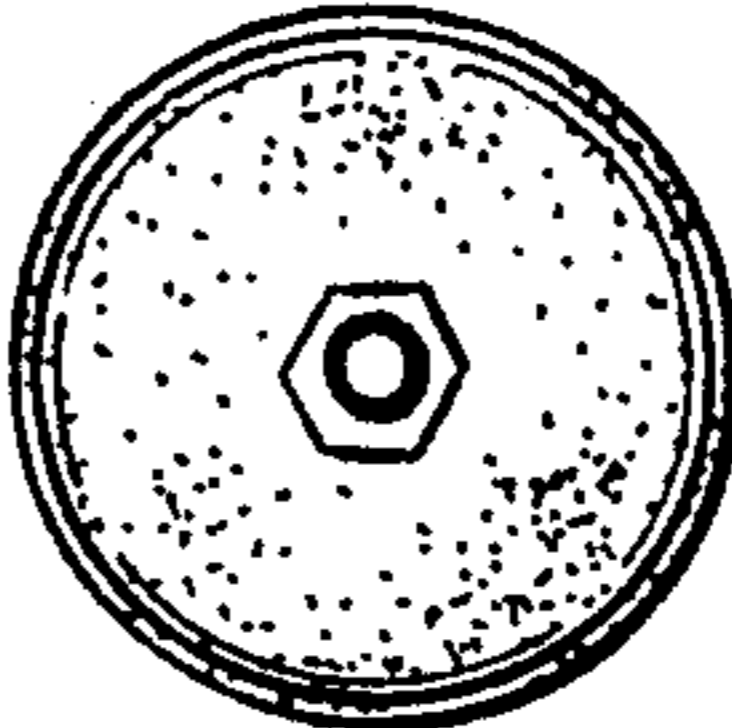

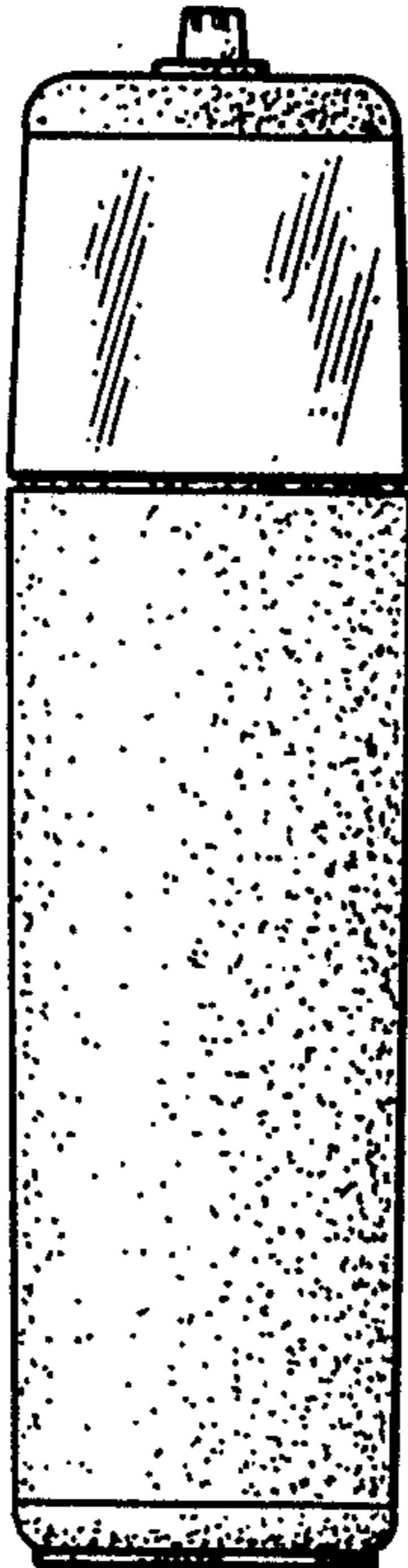

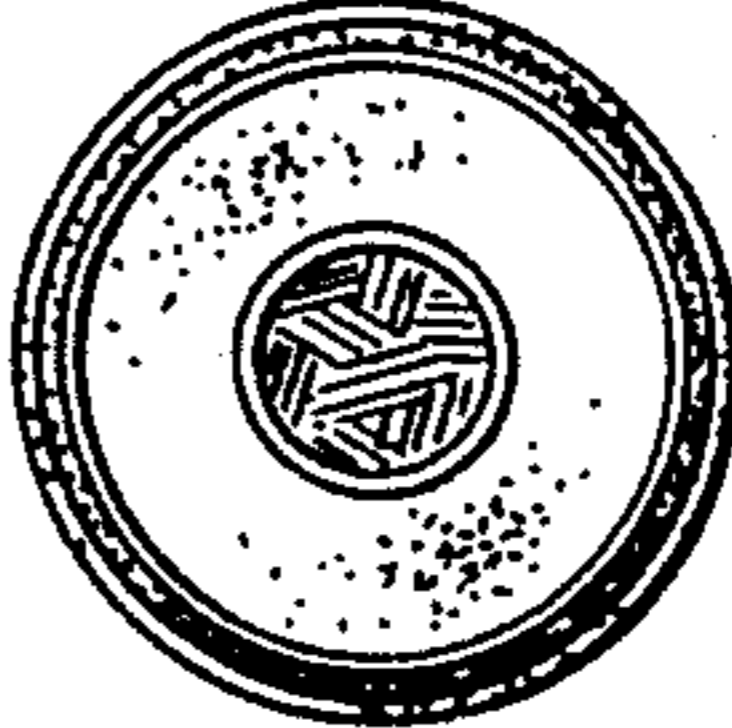
