DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a can holder for an automobile showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top, front, left side perspective view thereof in a partially closed position; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view thereof in a closed position.
















