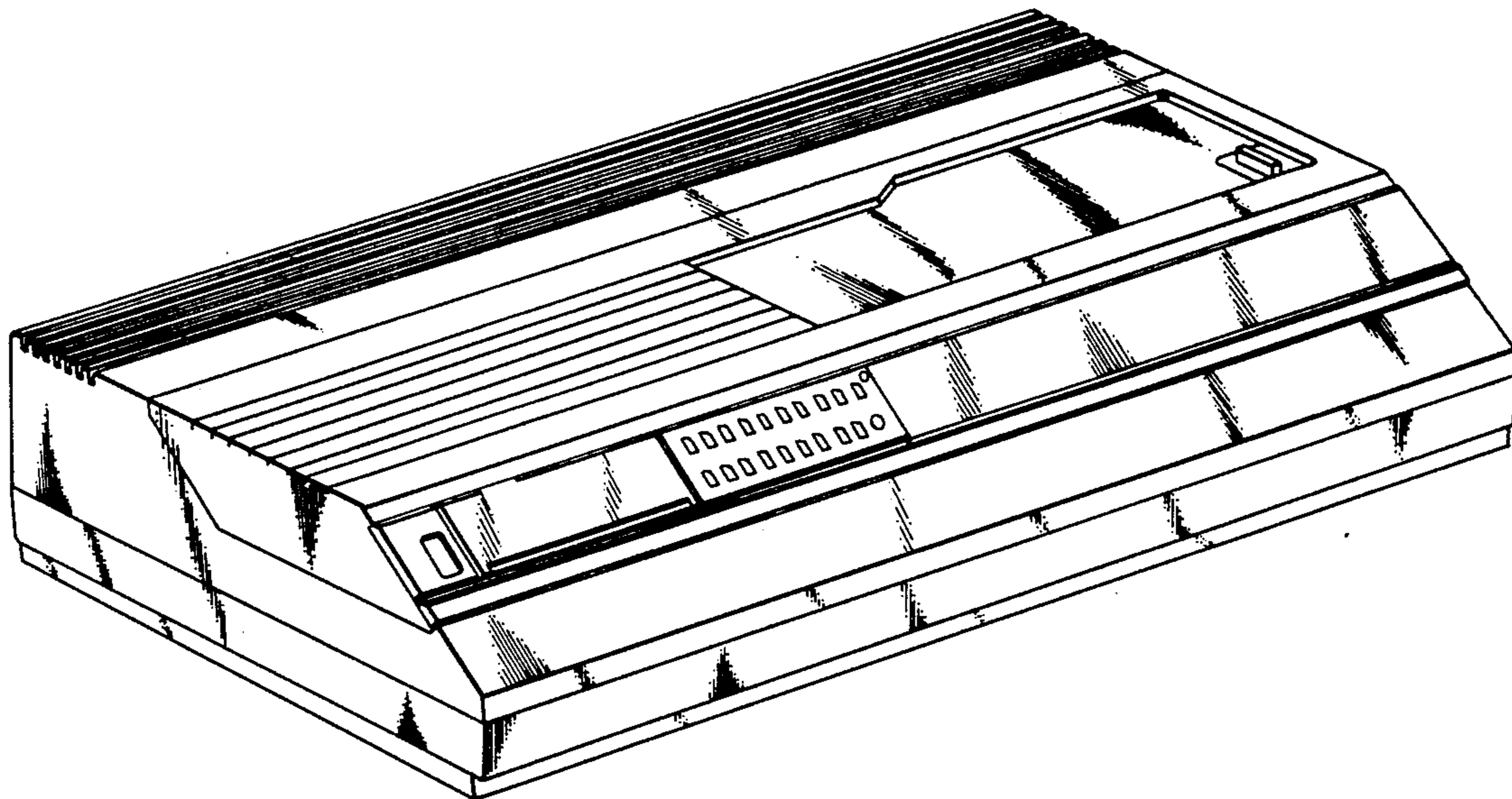

The ornamental design for a video player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a video player showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top, front and left side perspective view thereof, shown with the remote control portion removed; and
FIG. 3 is a top rear and right side perspective view thereof.
The undisclosed bottom of the video player is plane and unornamented.



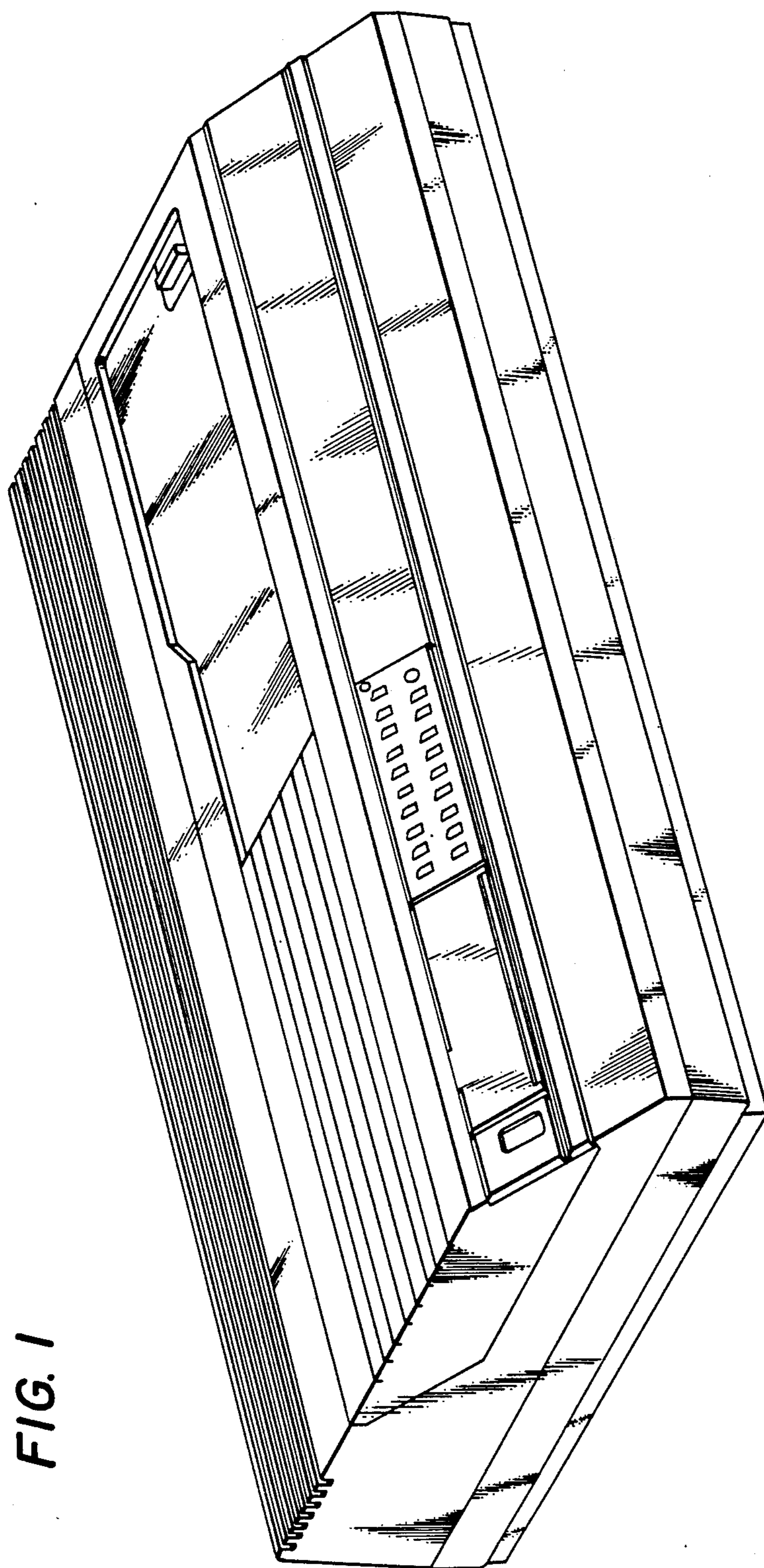

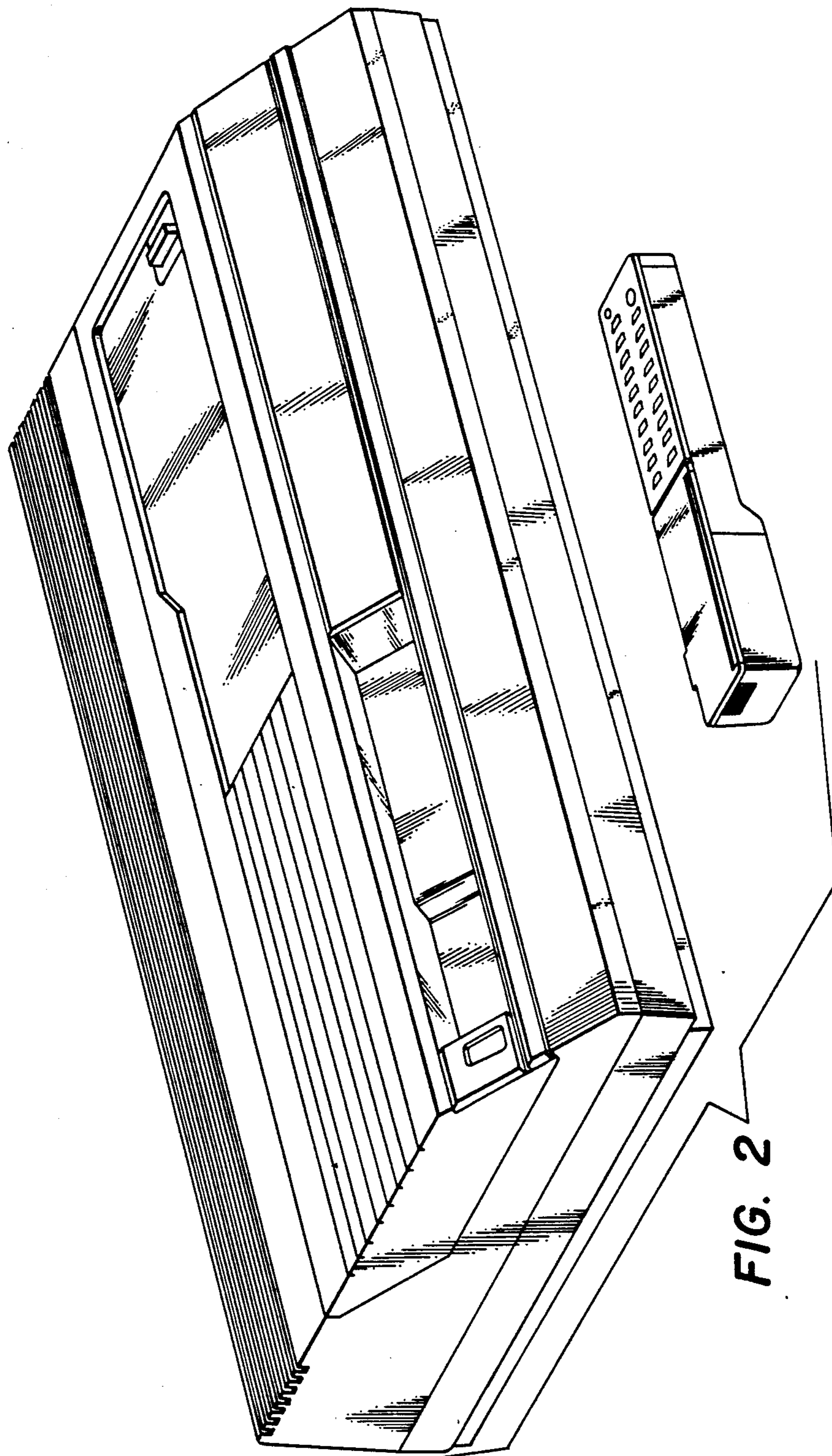

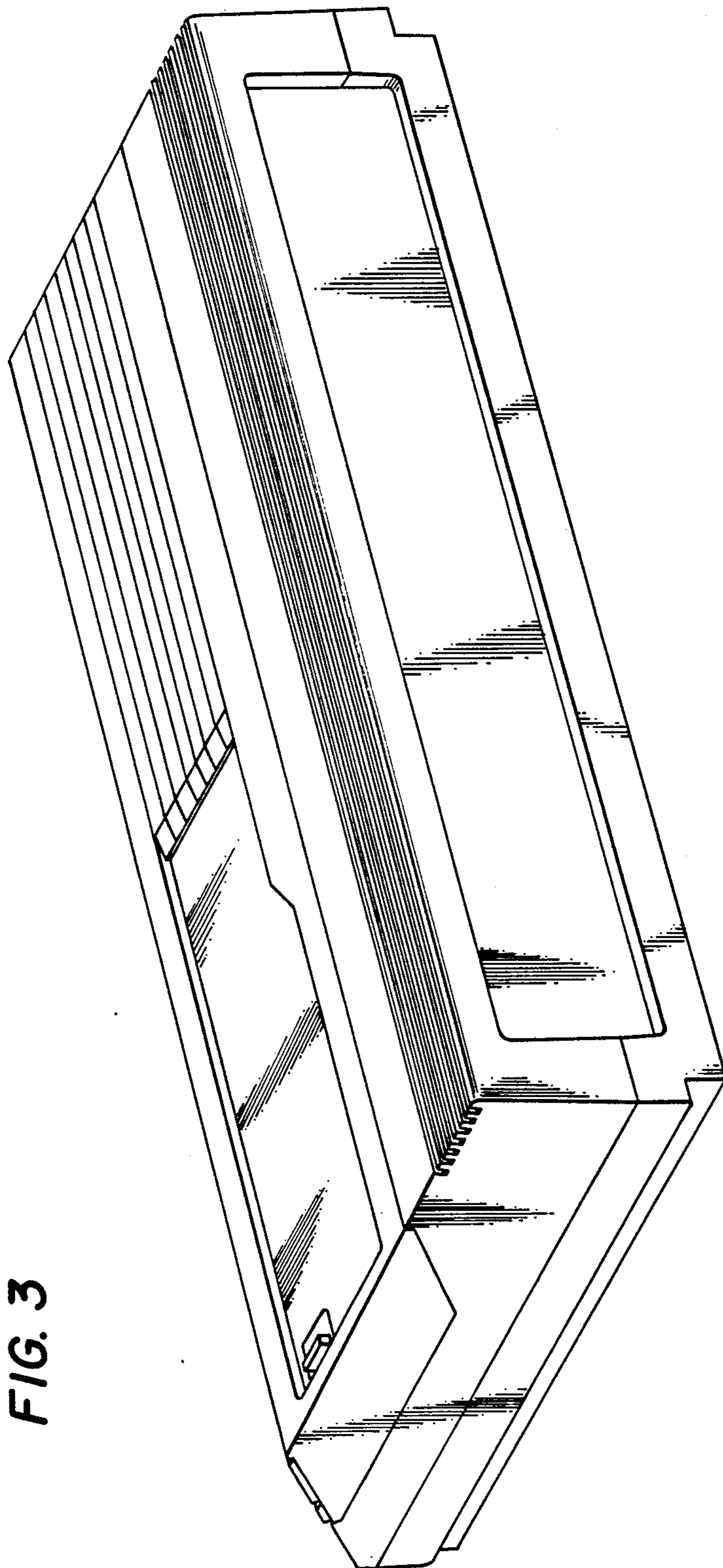
