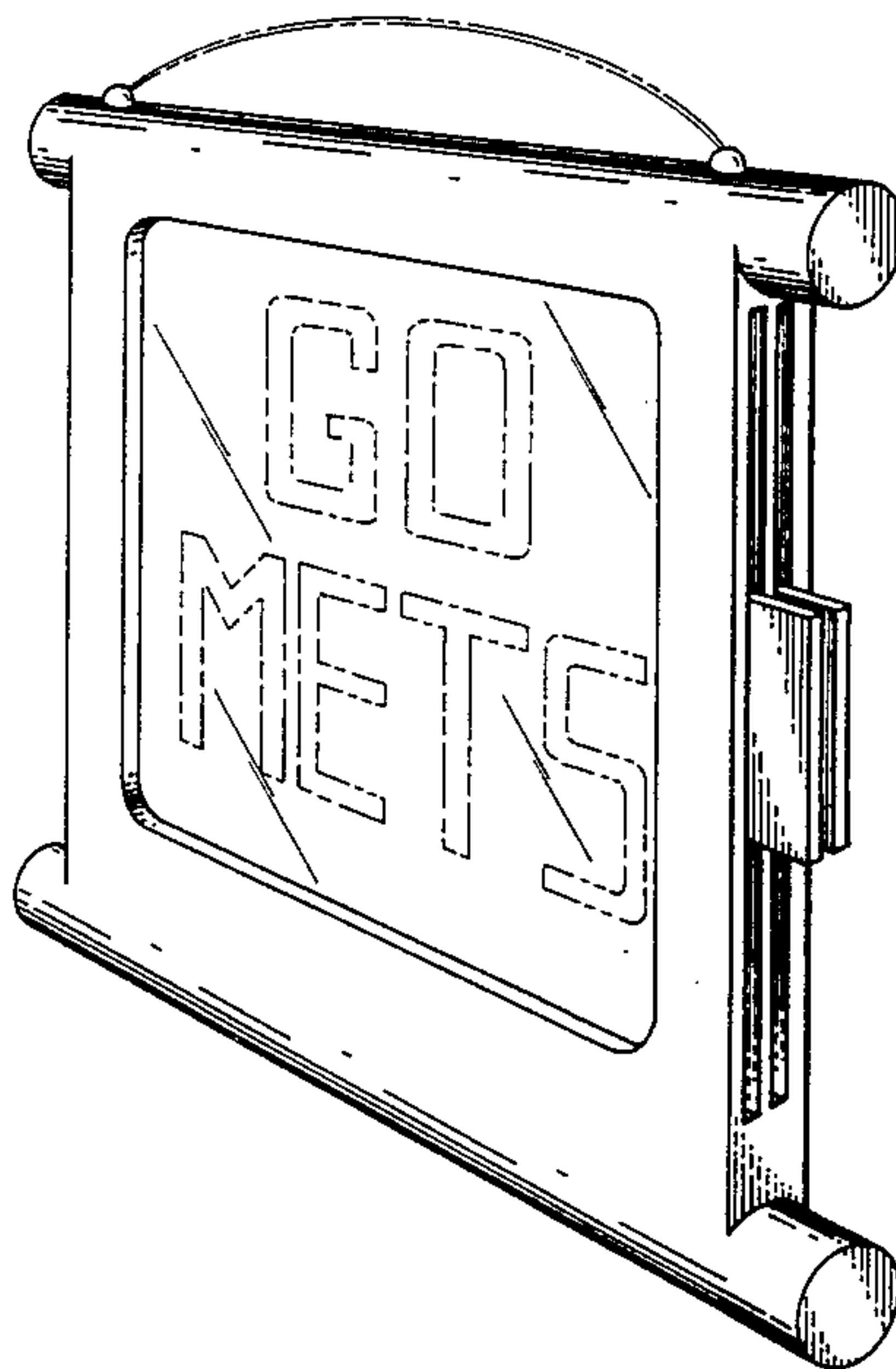

The broken line showing of indicia is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



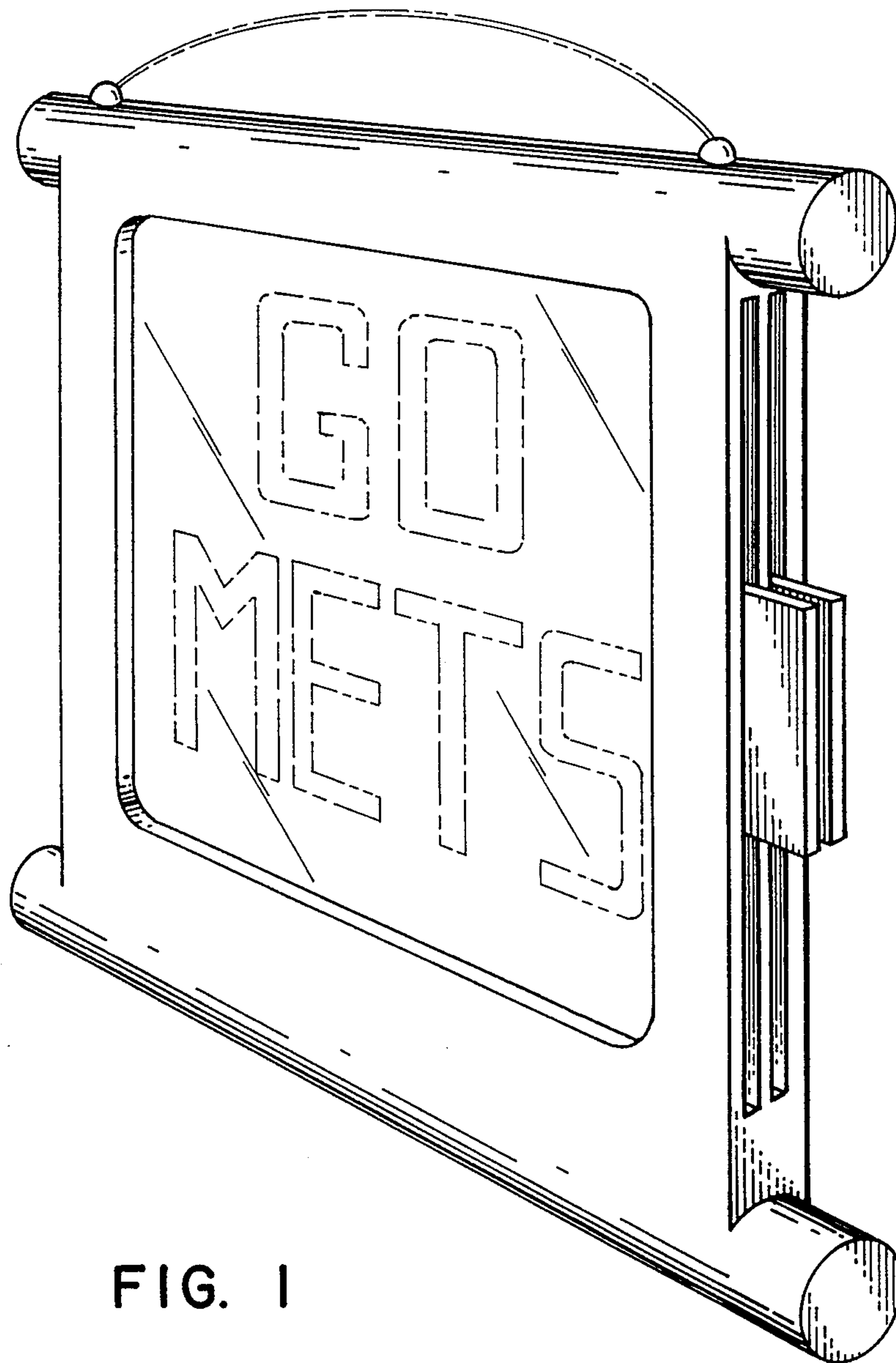

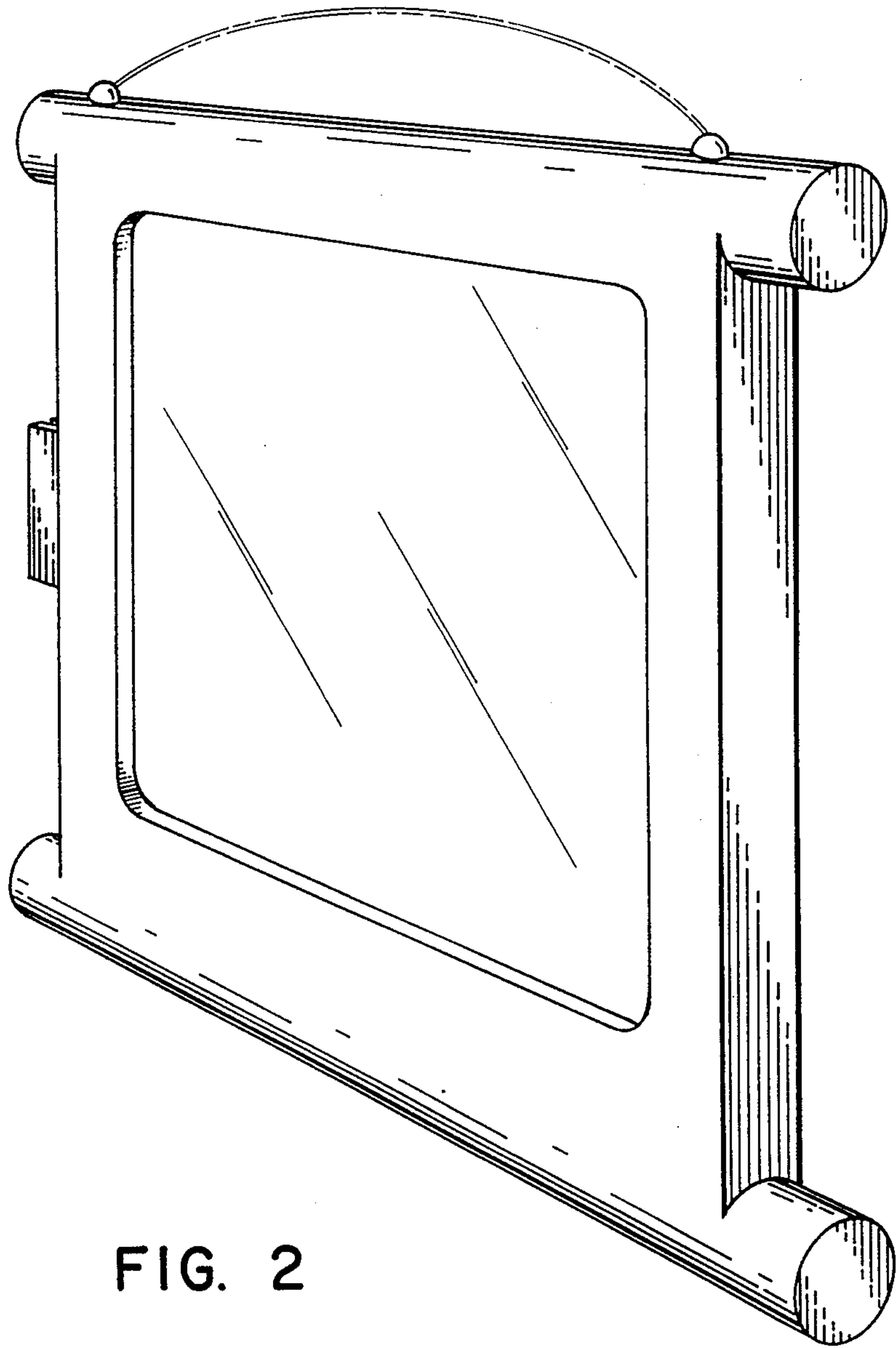
