DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe sole showing my new design in a position of use;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line showing of a shoe upper in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

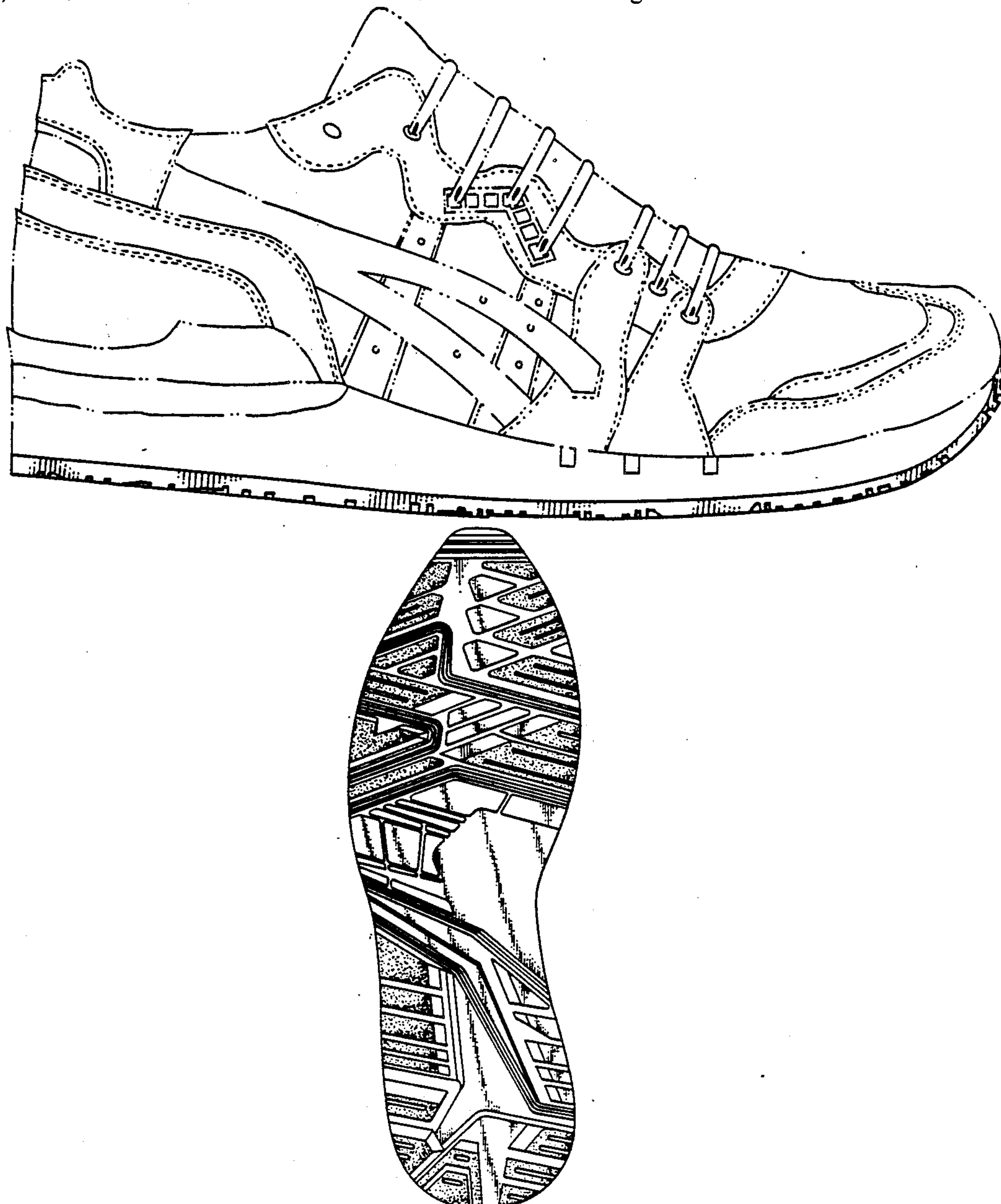

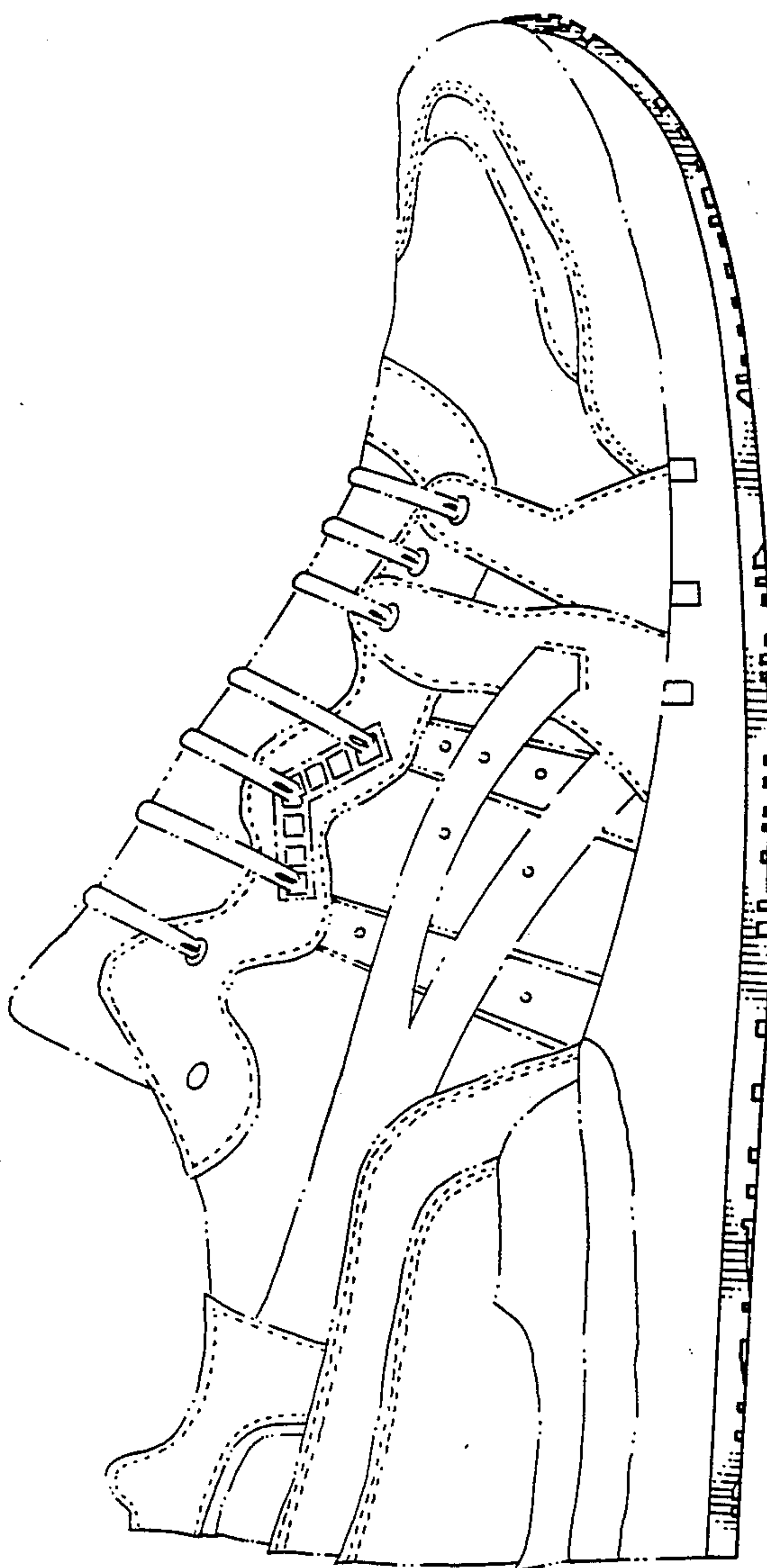

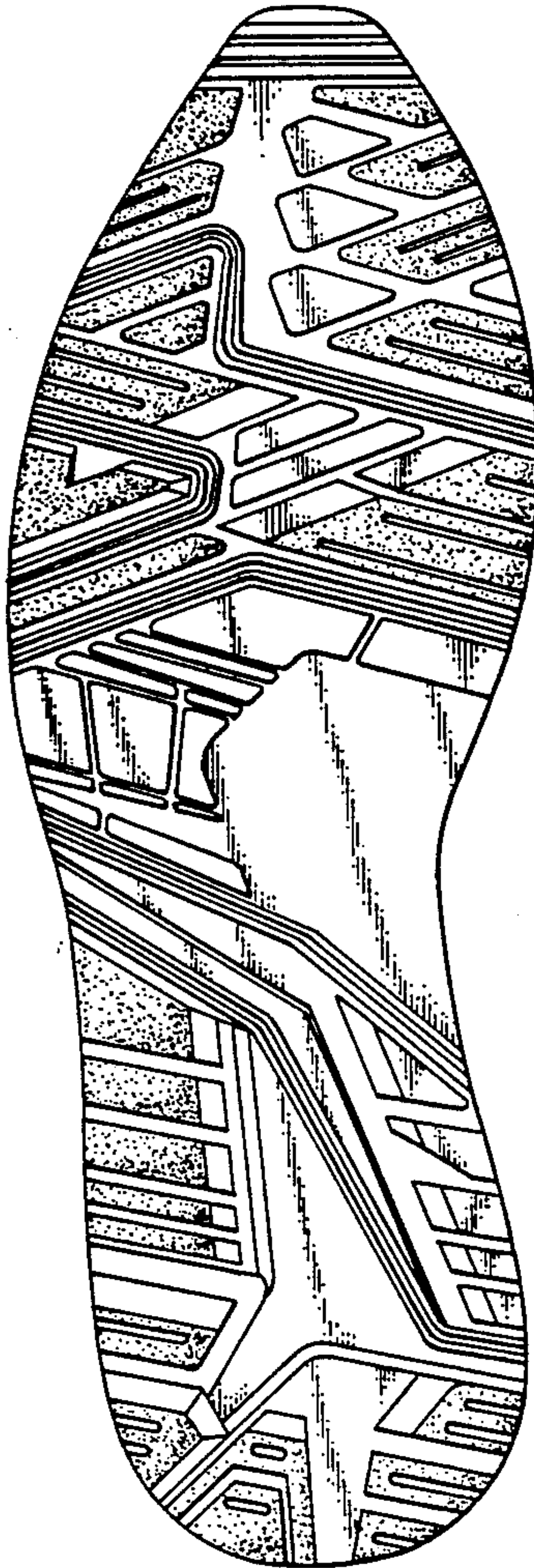

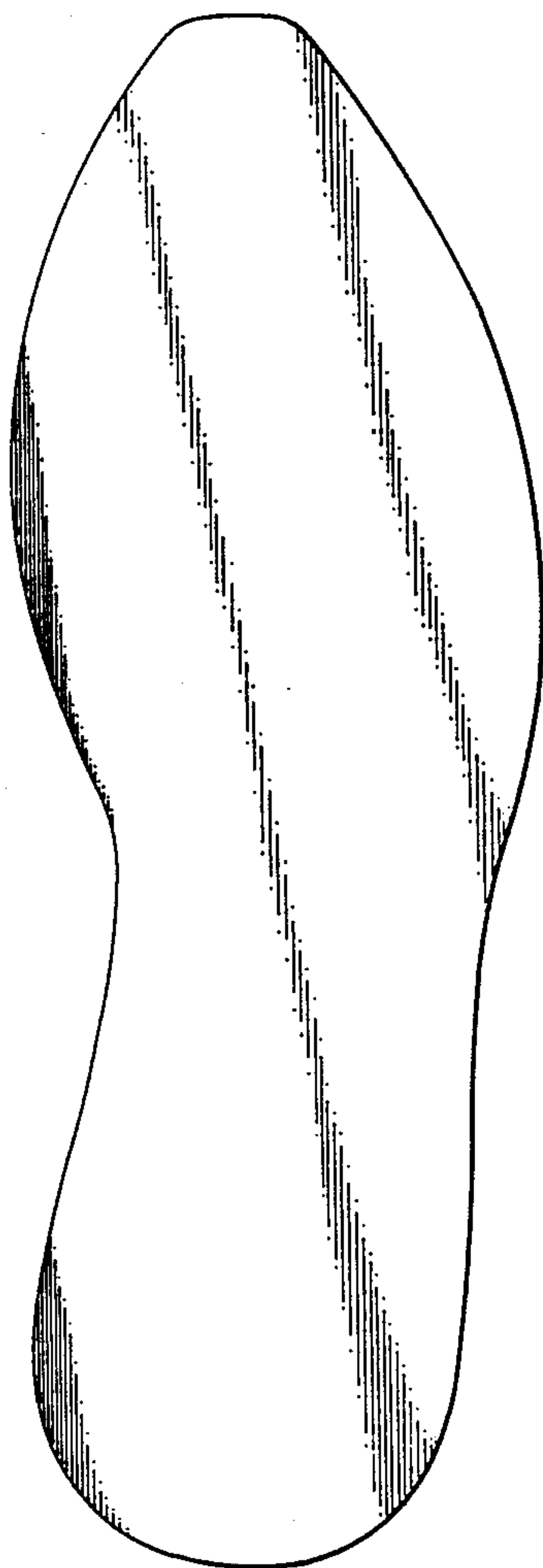
