**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a crutch pad or the like, showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of a crutch pad, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof. The broken lines depicted in FIGS. 1 and 2 are shown for illustrative purposes only. The rear view of FIG. 1 is conventional in appearance.

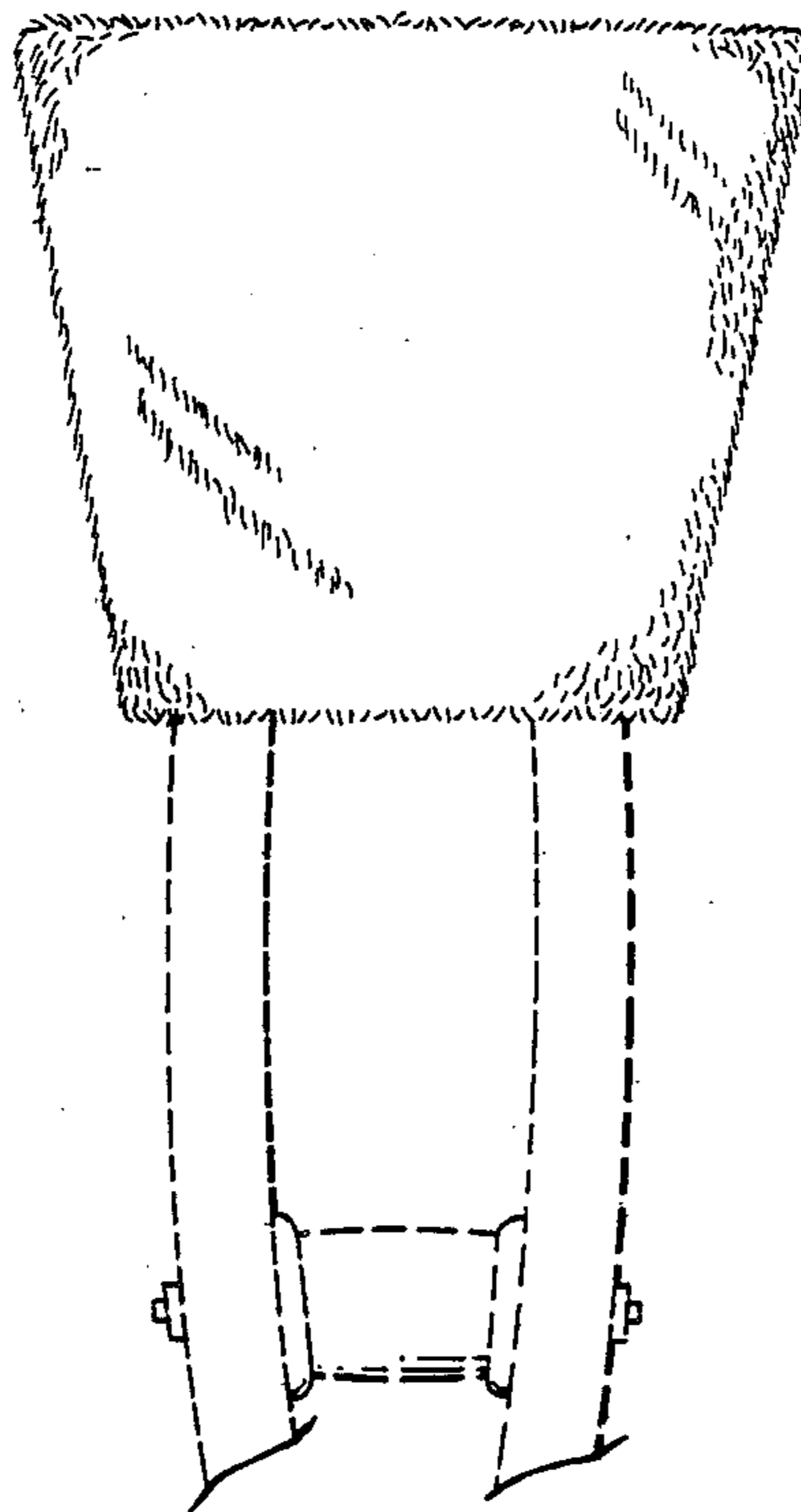

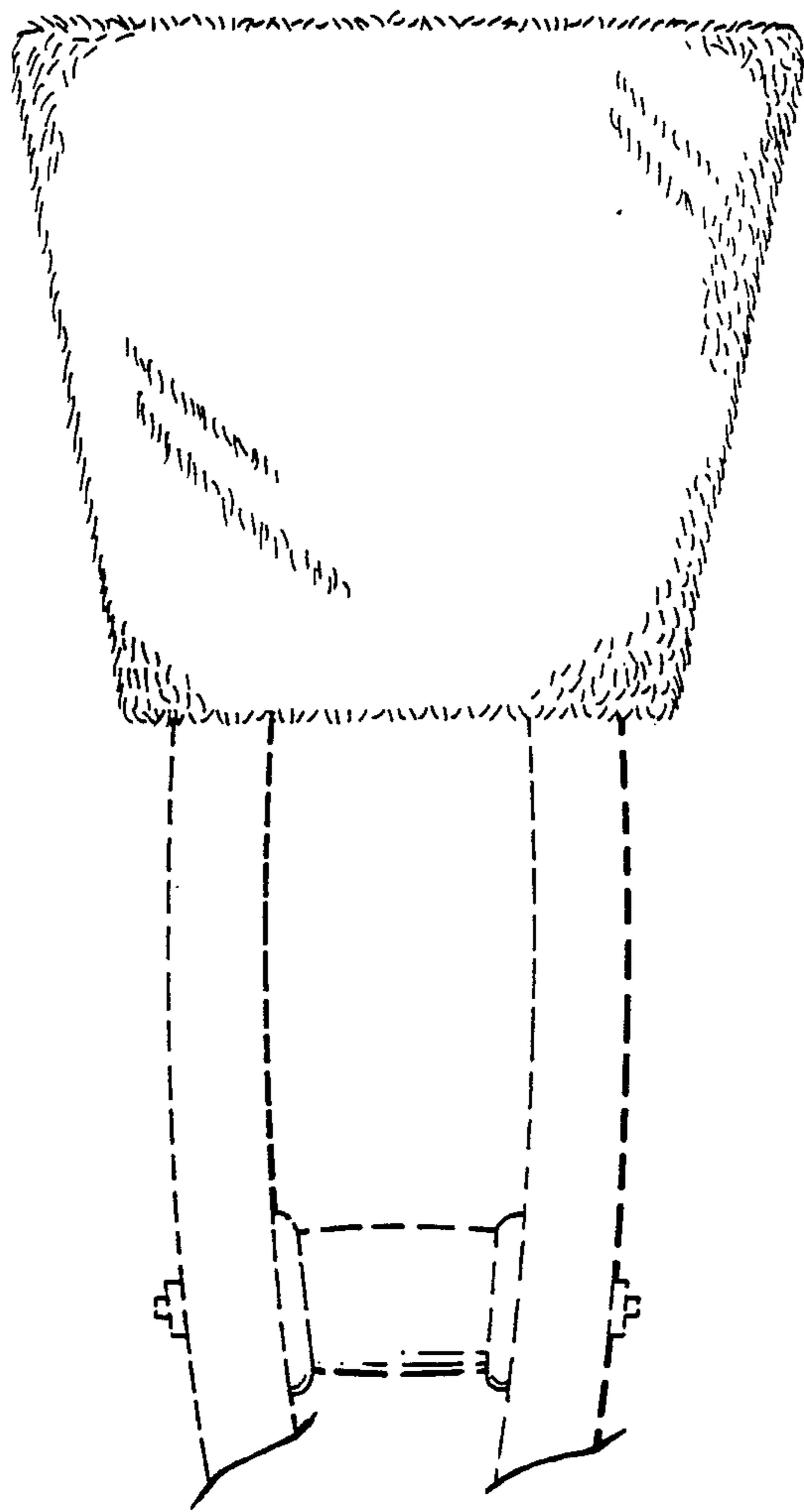
