FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 3.

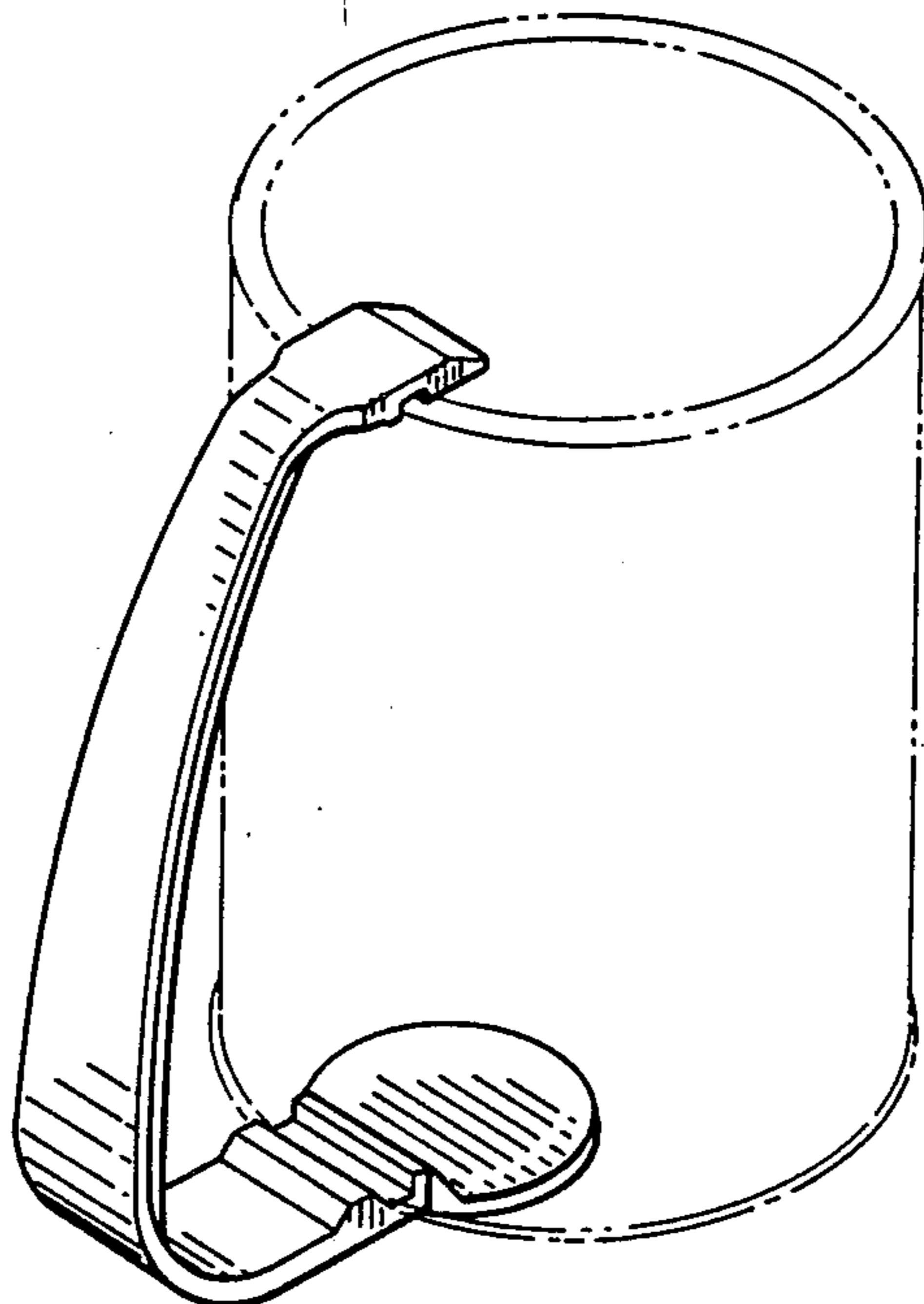

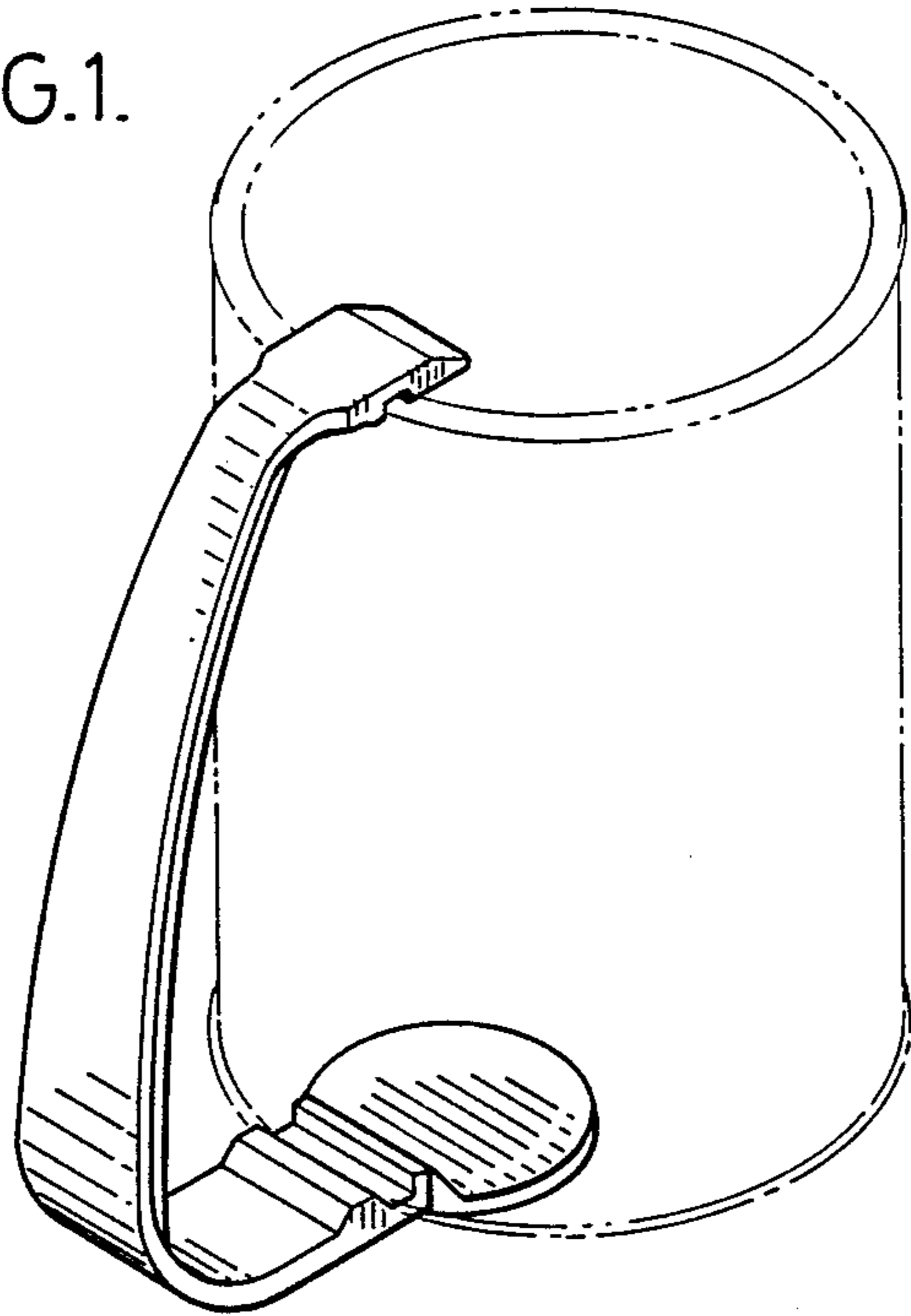

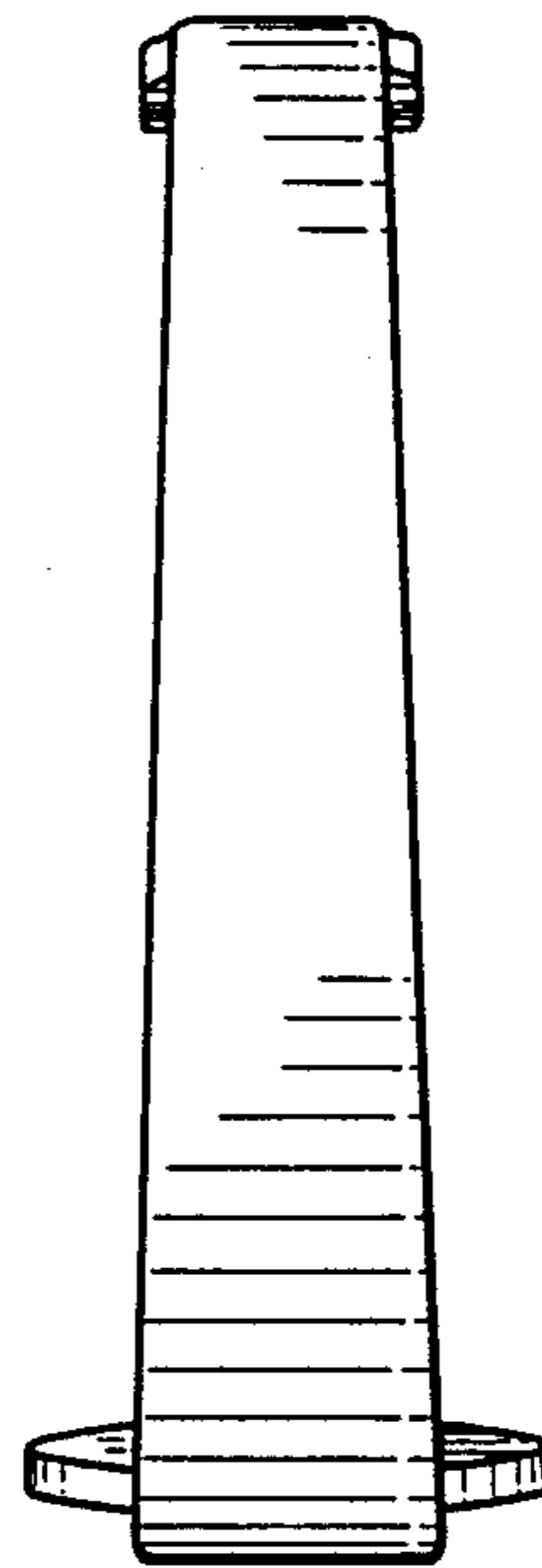

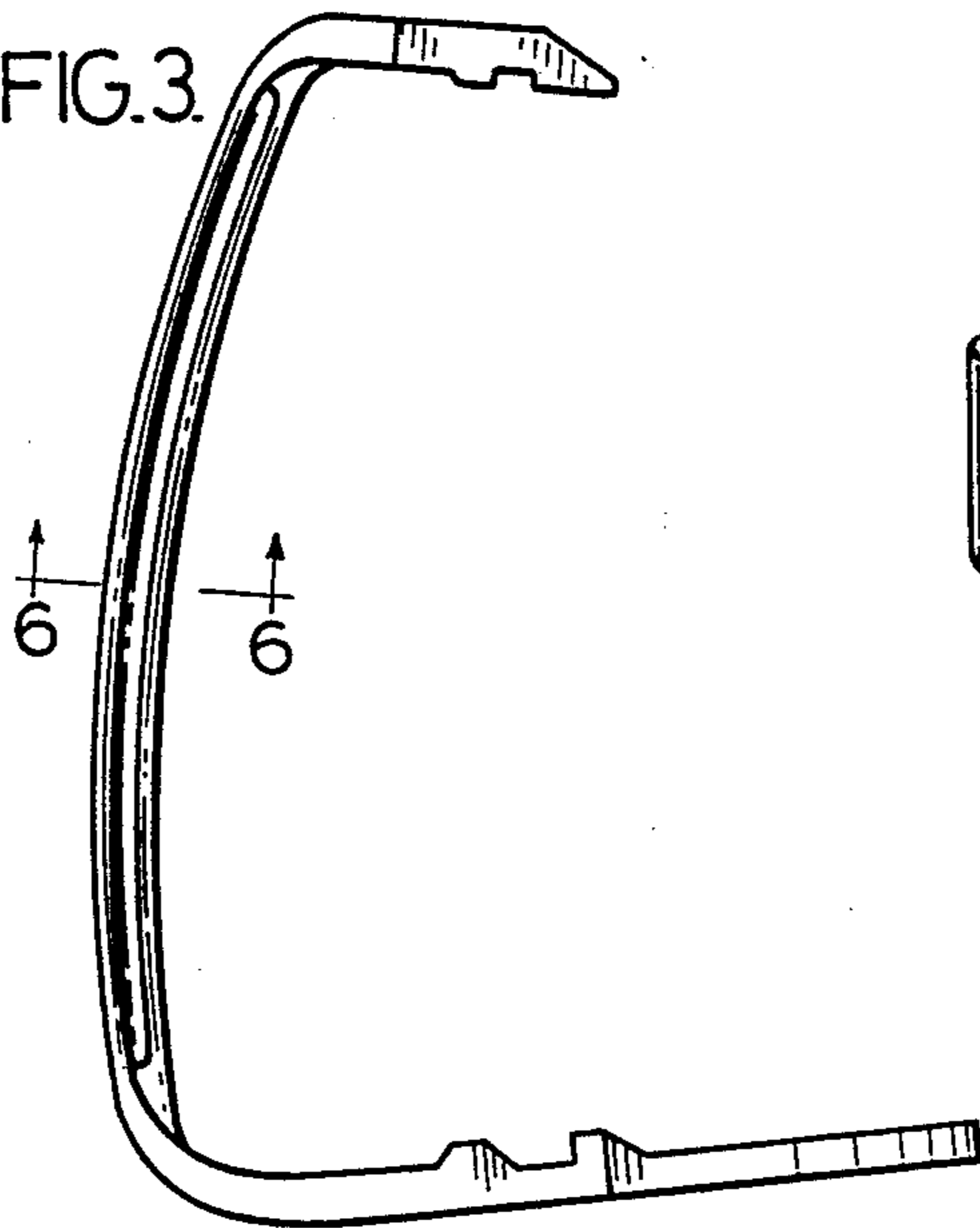

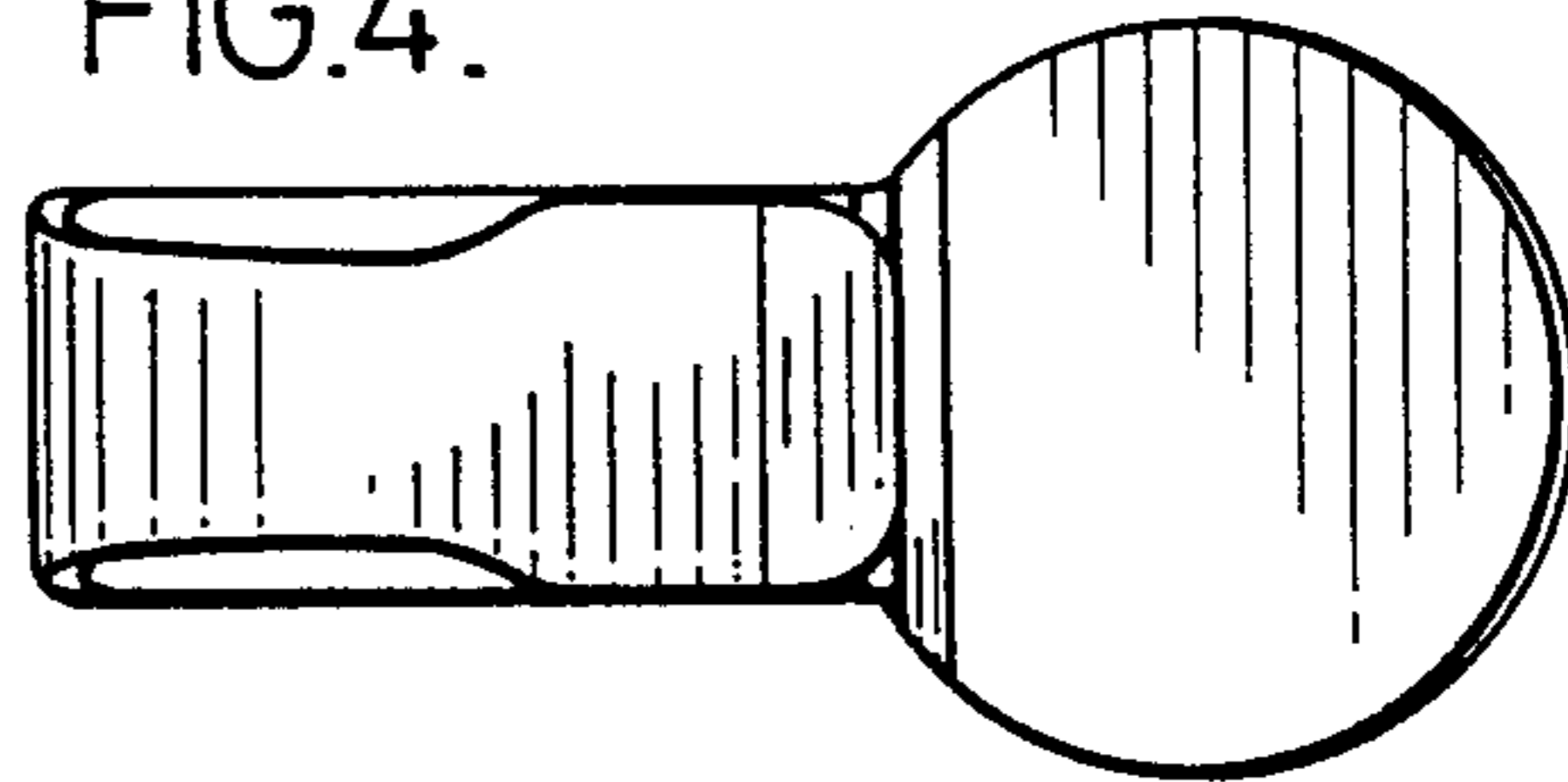

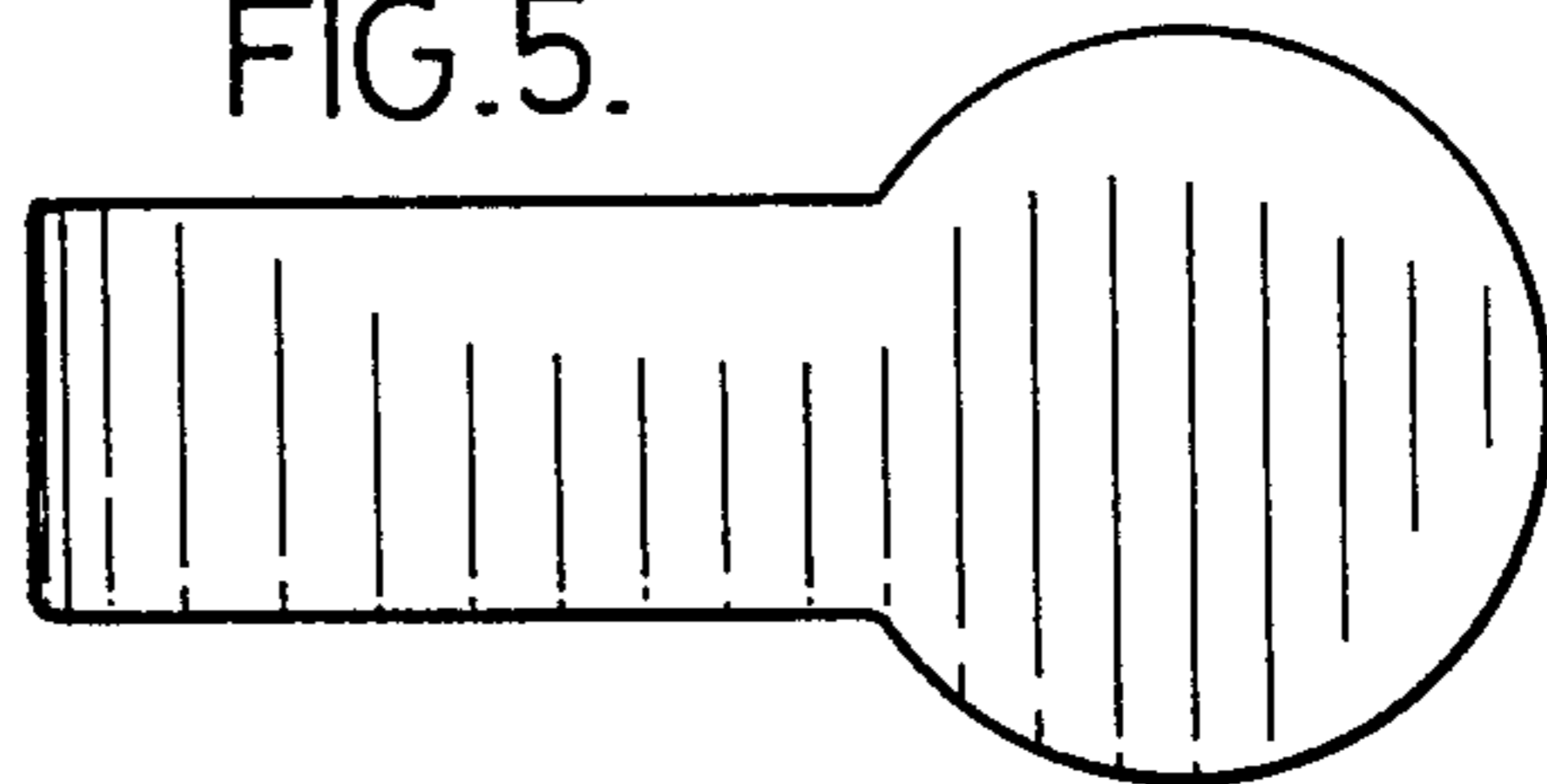
