DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an electronic article surveillance antenna structure showing our new design with the broken lines shown for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The rear and right side elevational views of our new design would be identical, respectively, to FIGS. 2 and 3.
