DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a vending machine for foods showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view; FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view; FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view; FIG. 5 is a top plan view; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; and FIG. 7 is a perspective view taken from the front and left side.

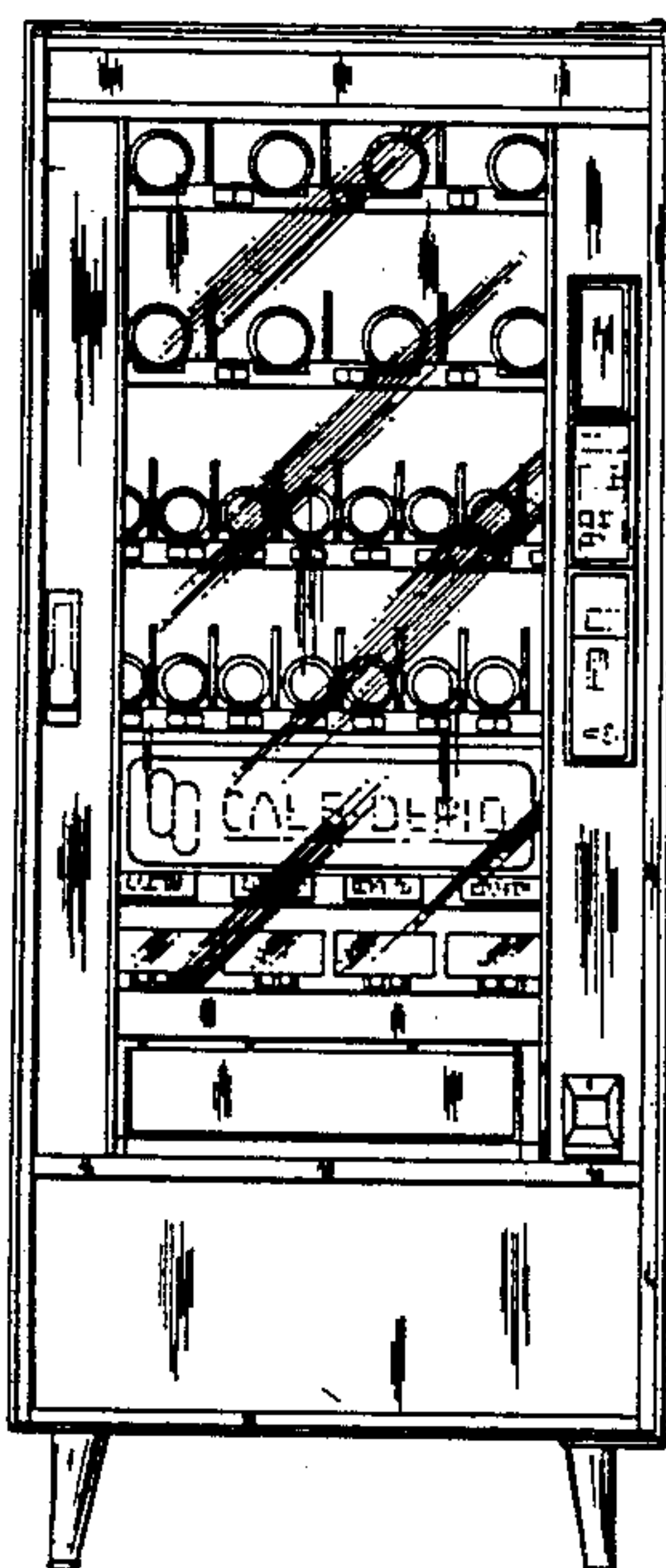

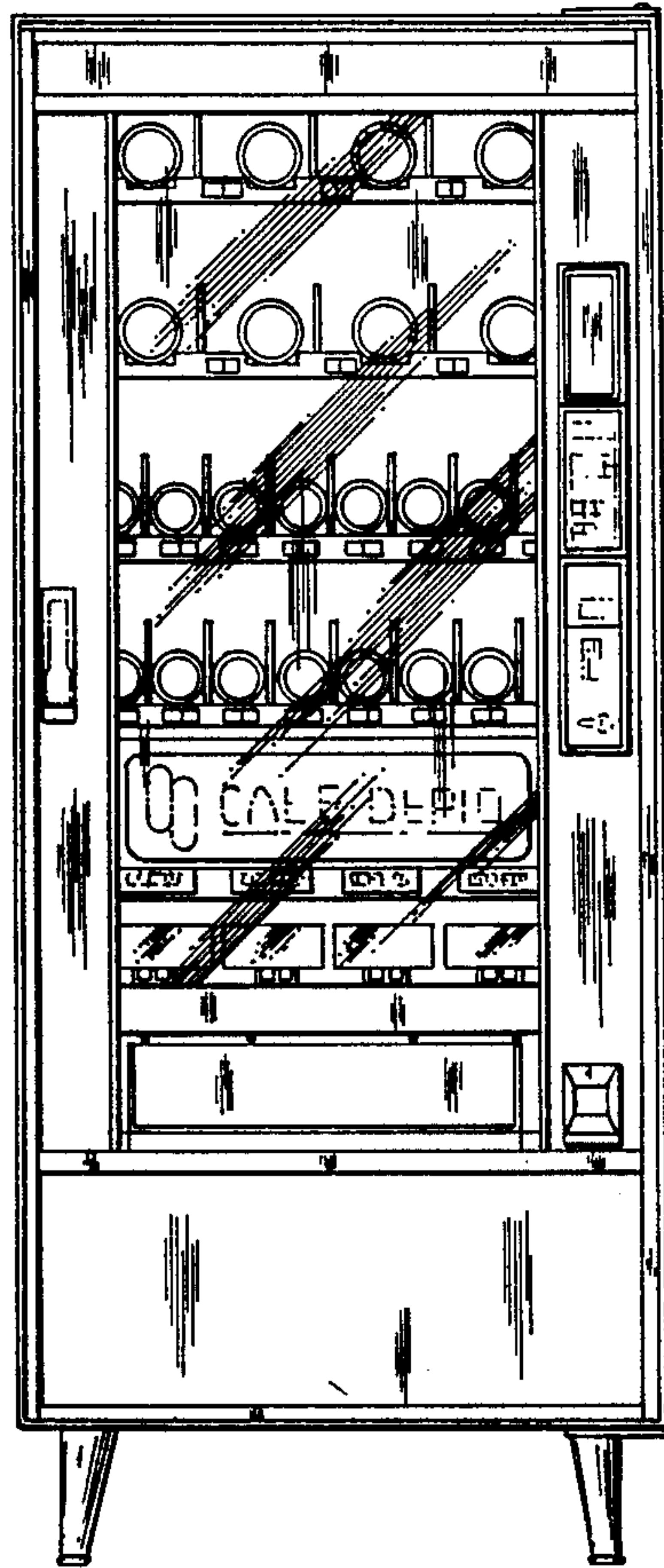

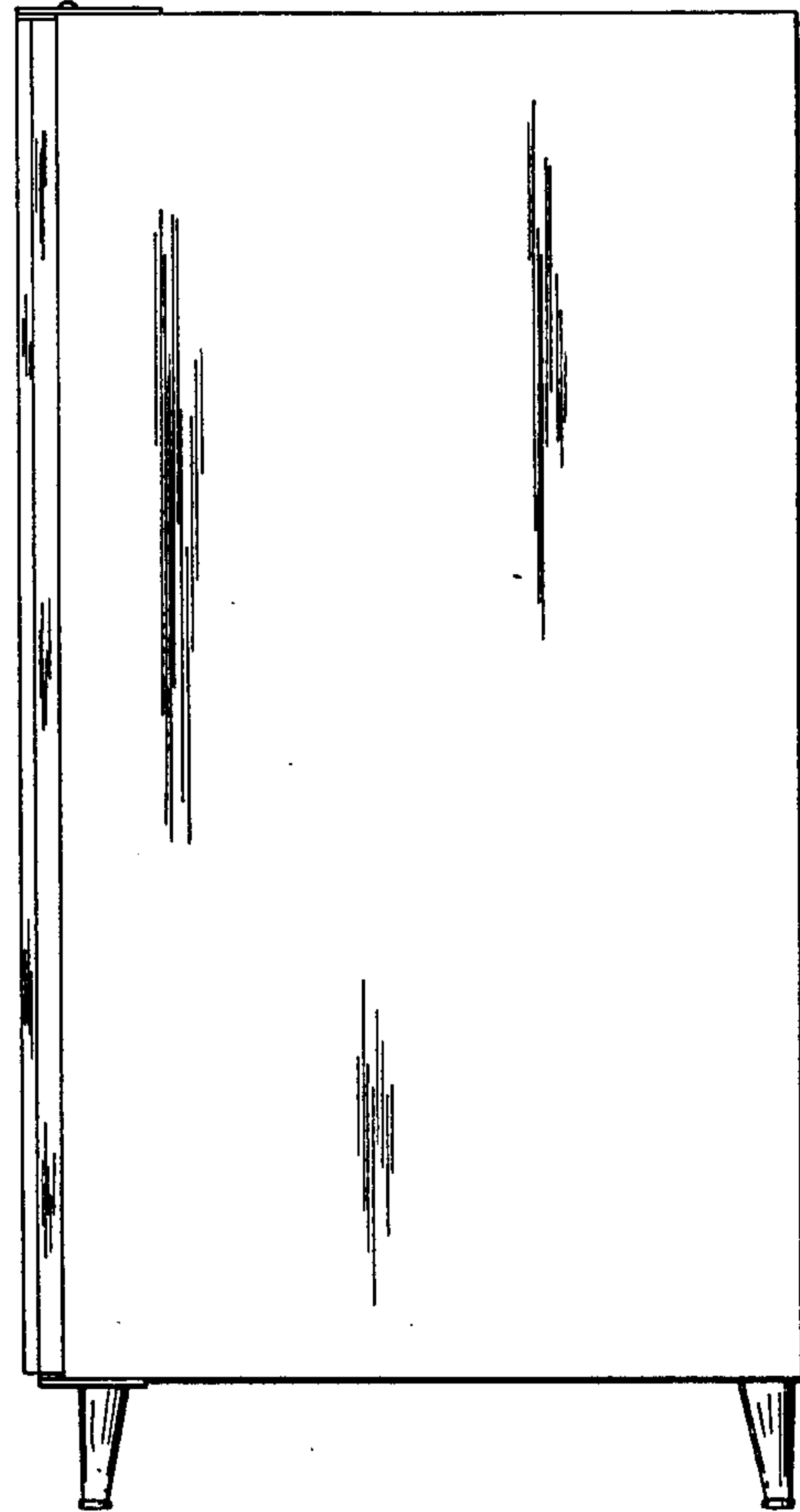

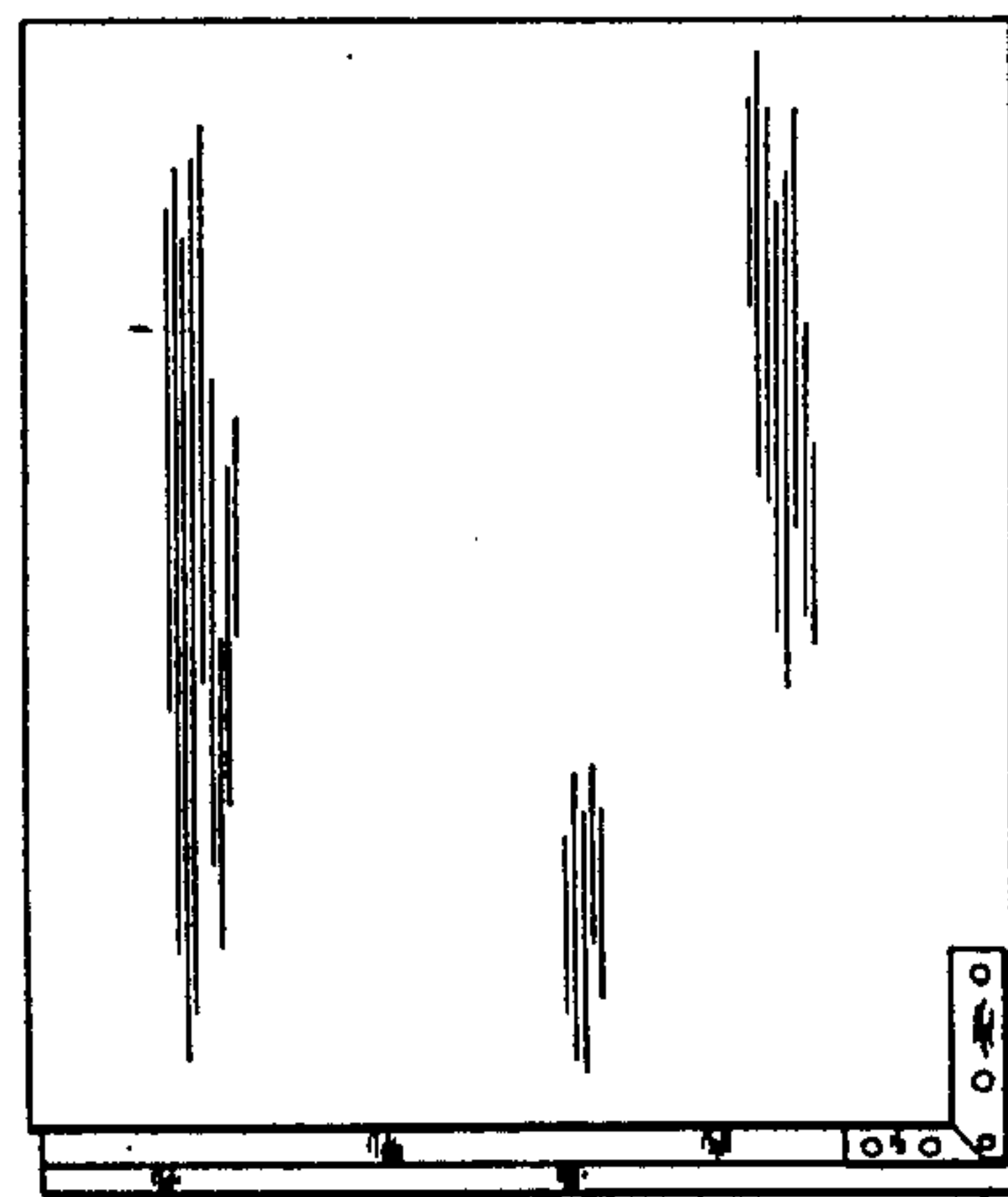

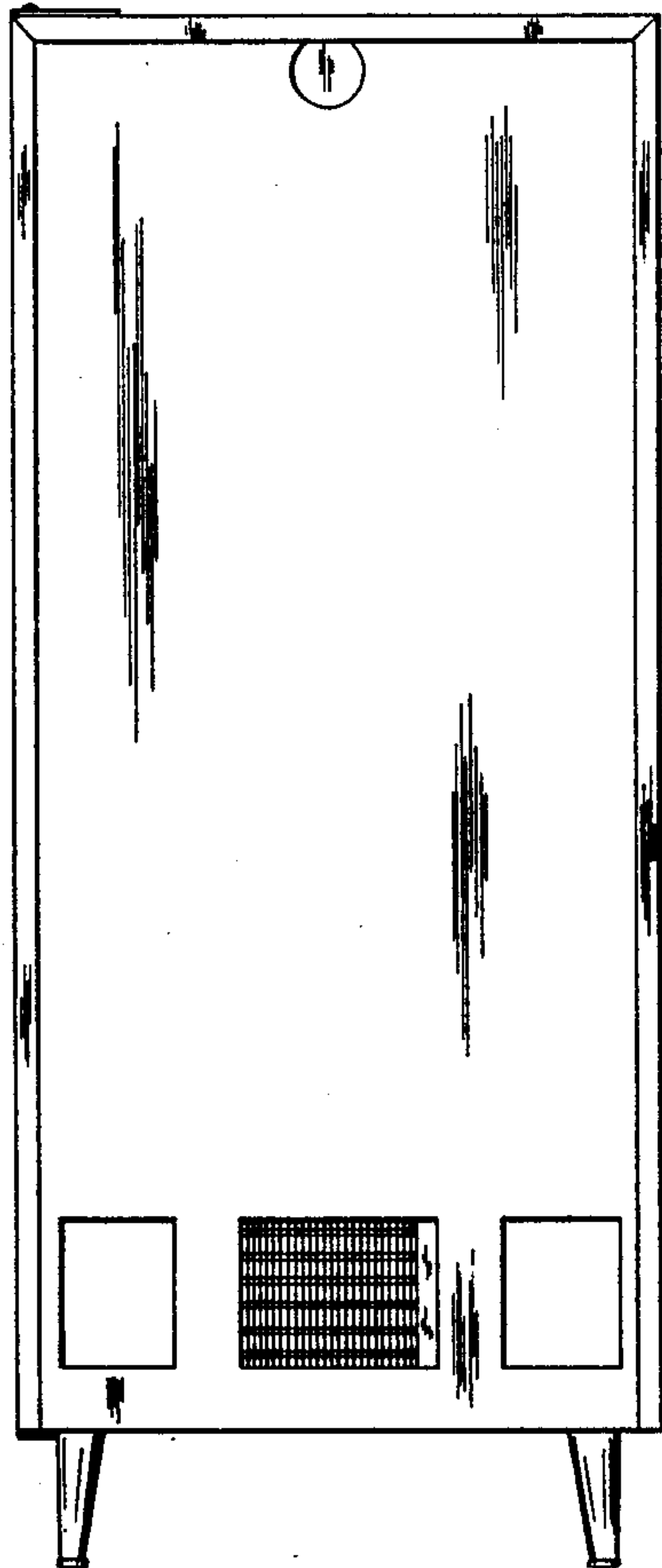

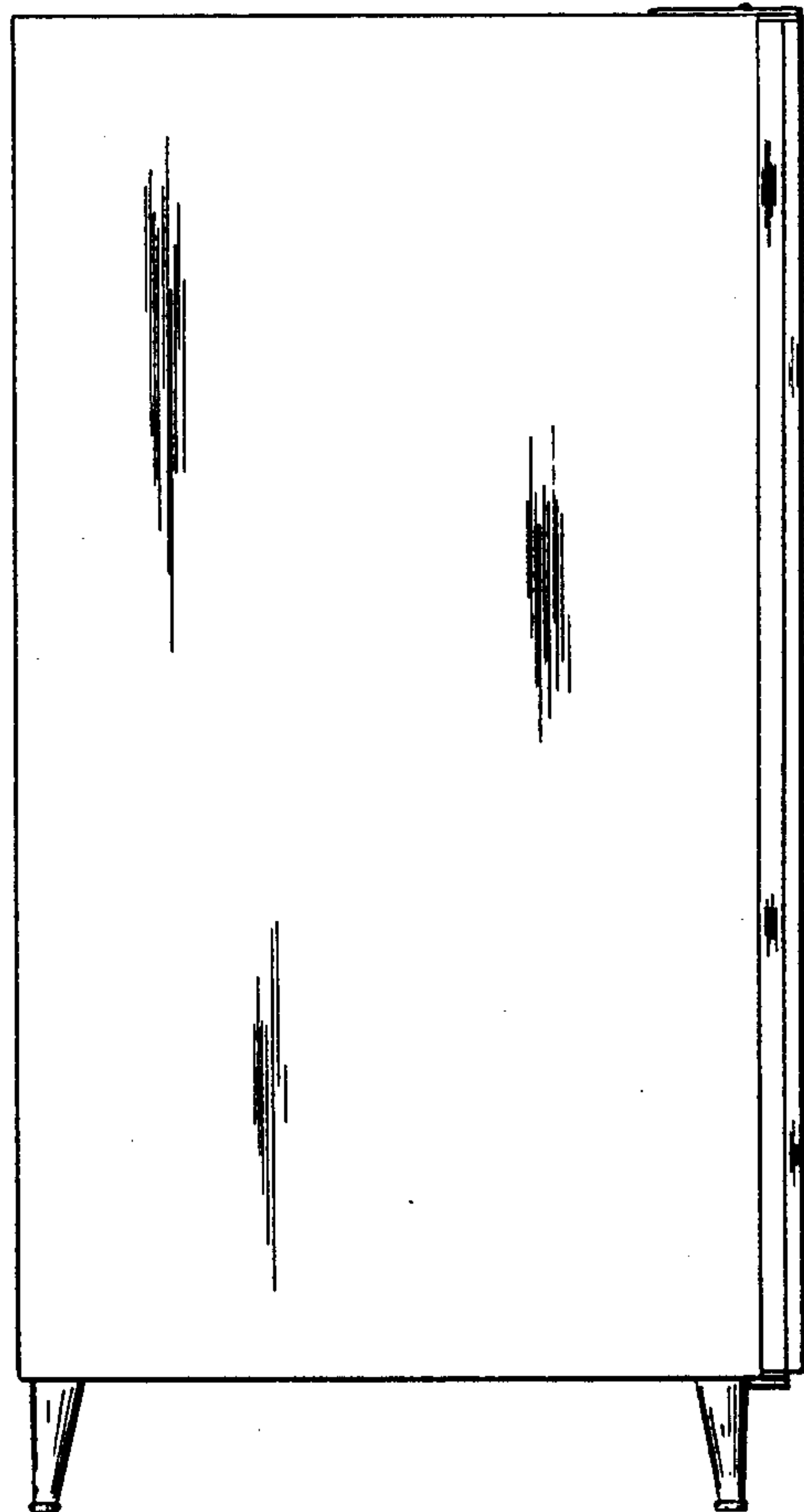

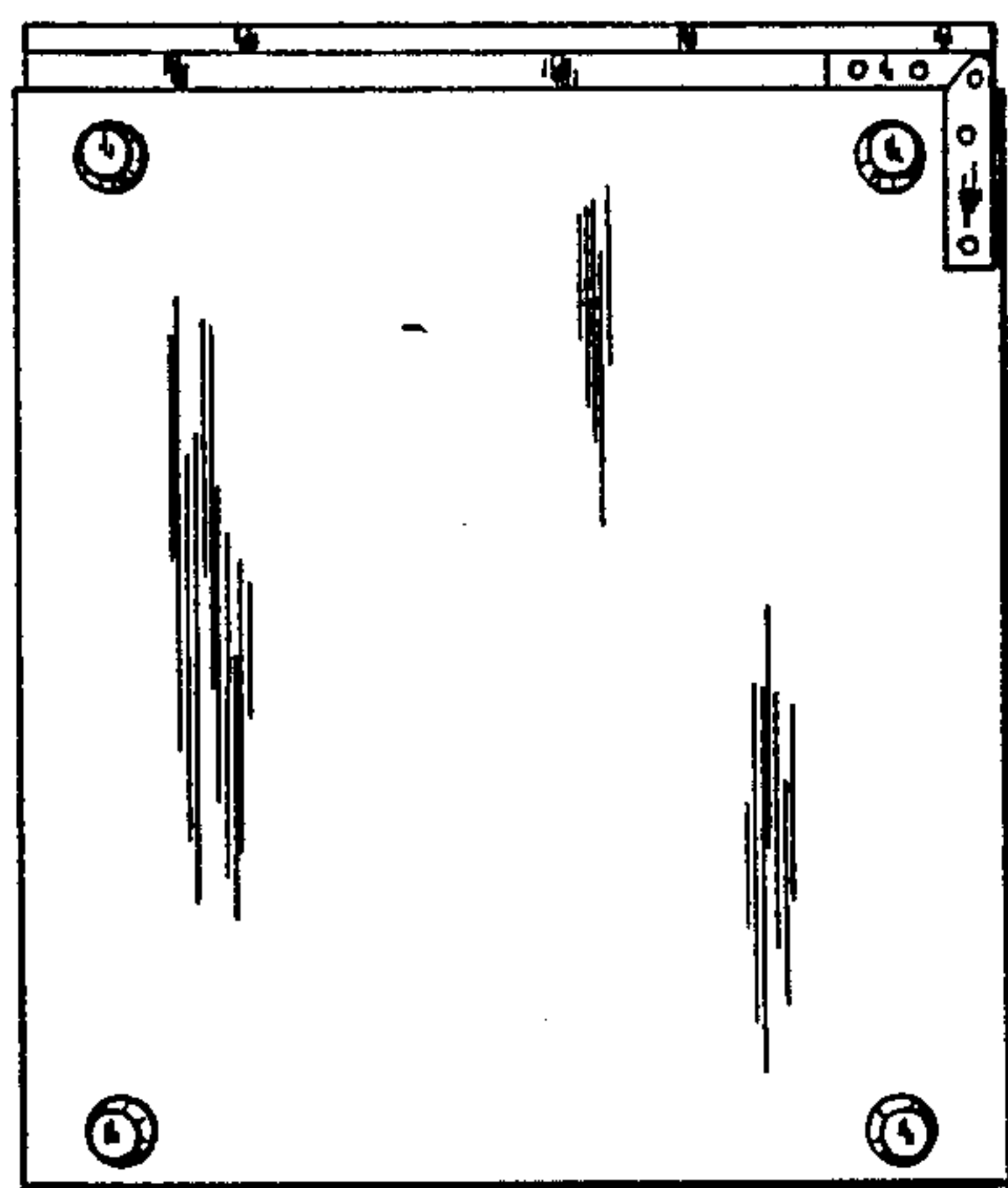
