DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right side and bottom perspective view of an air conditioner showing our new design, FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof, FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof, and FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view.

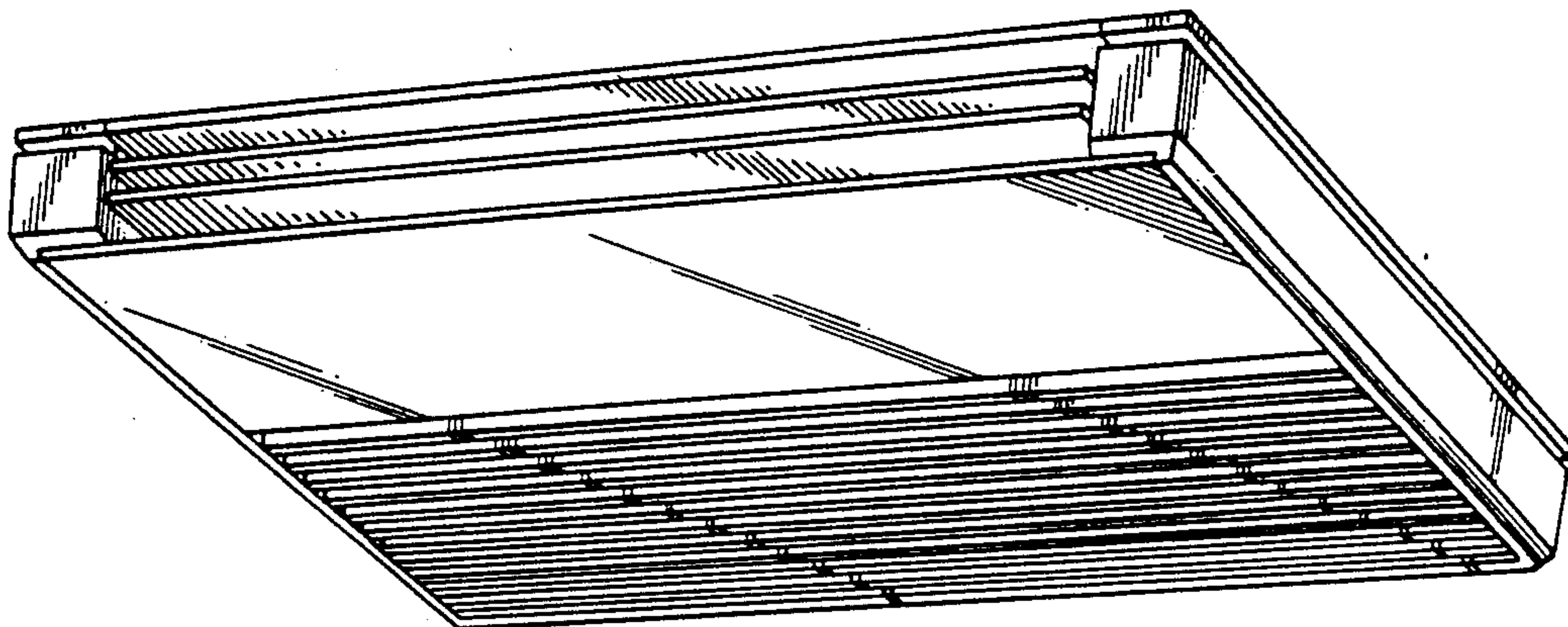

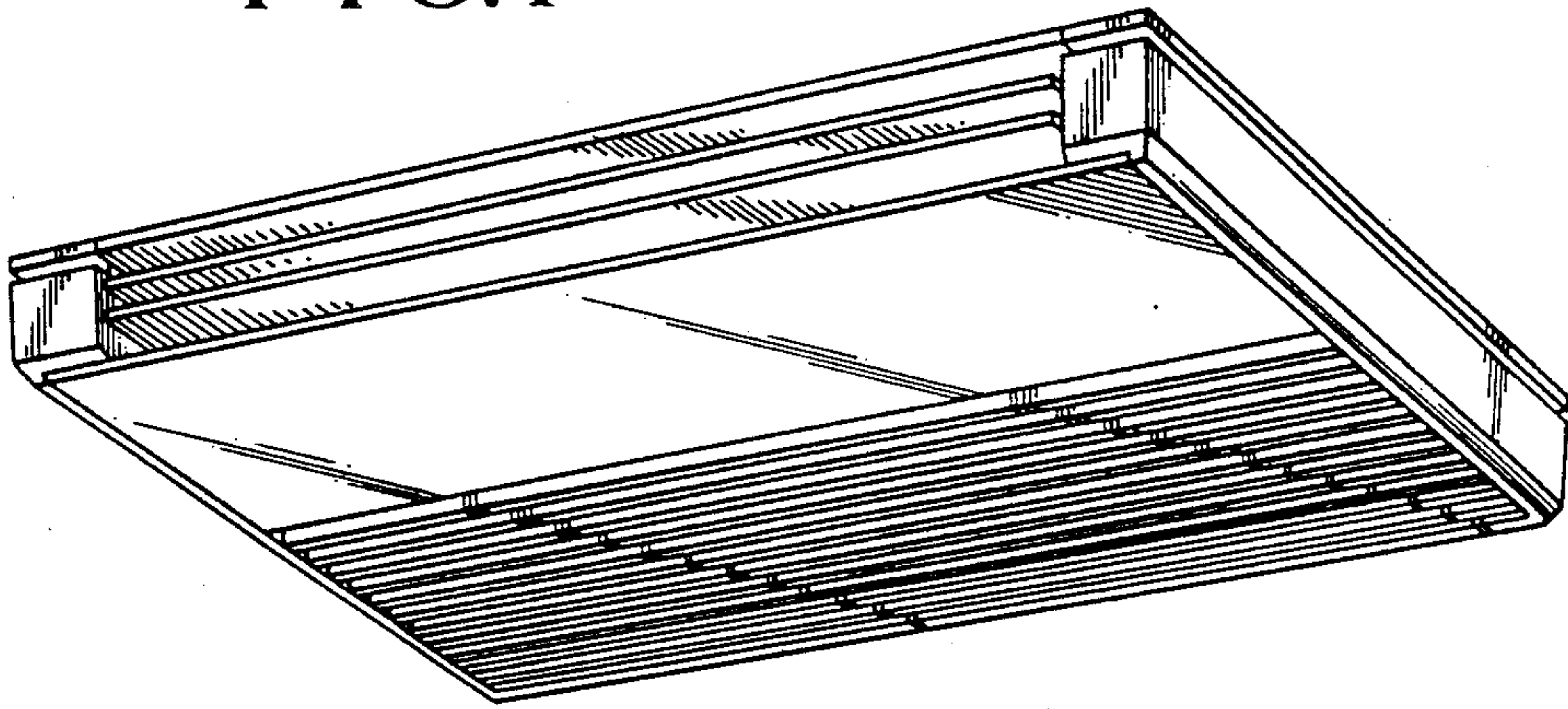

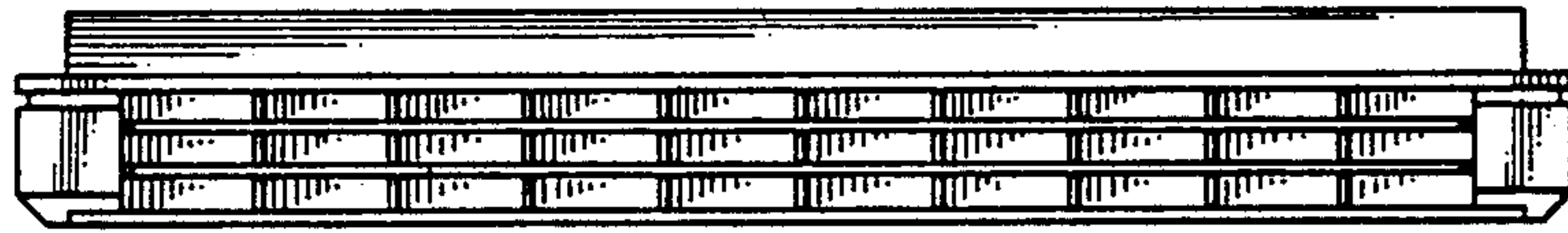

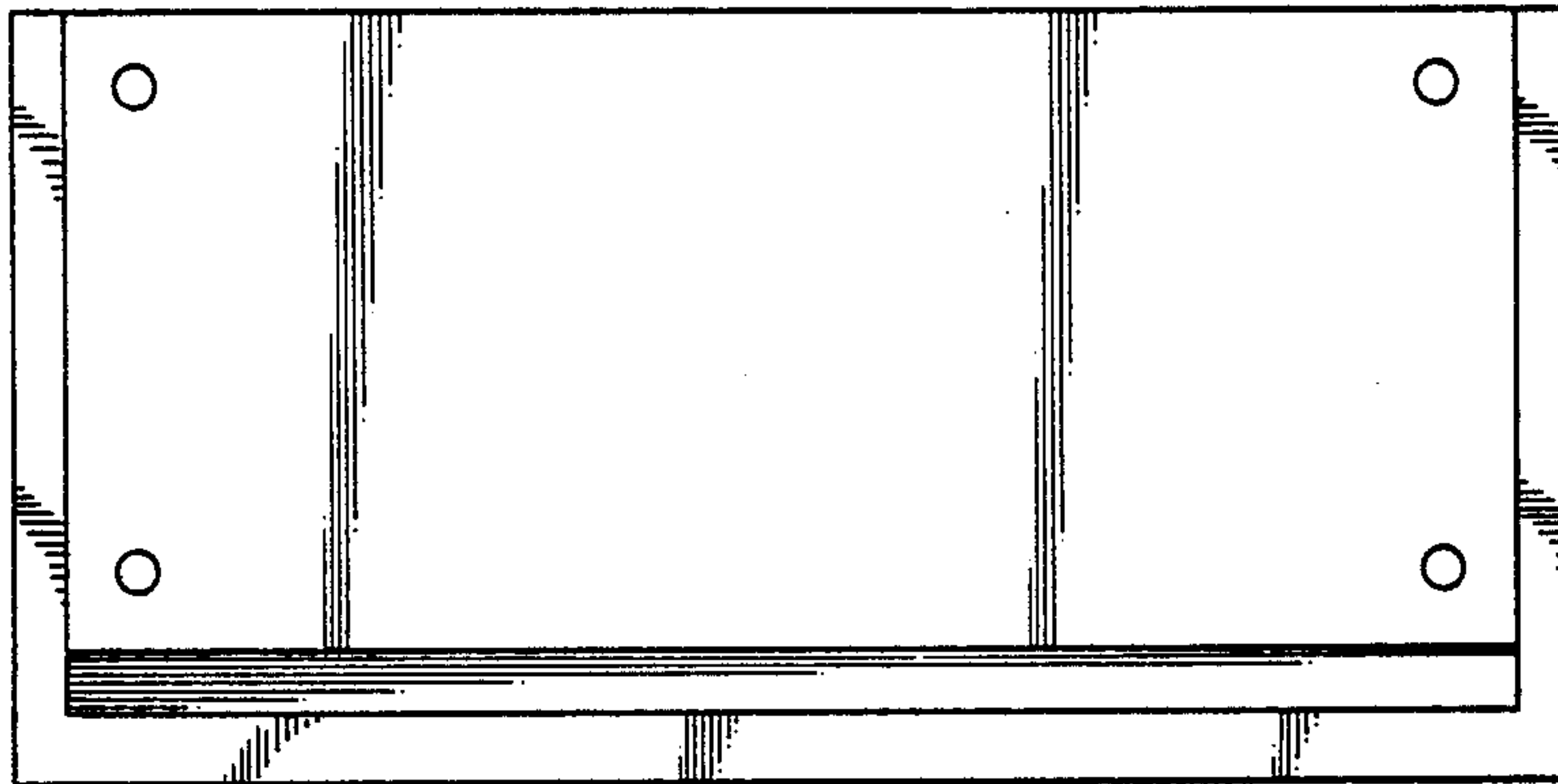

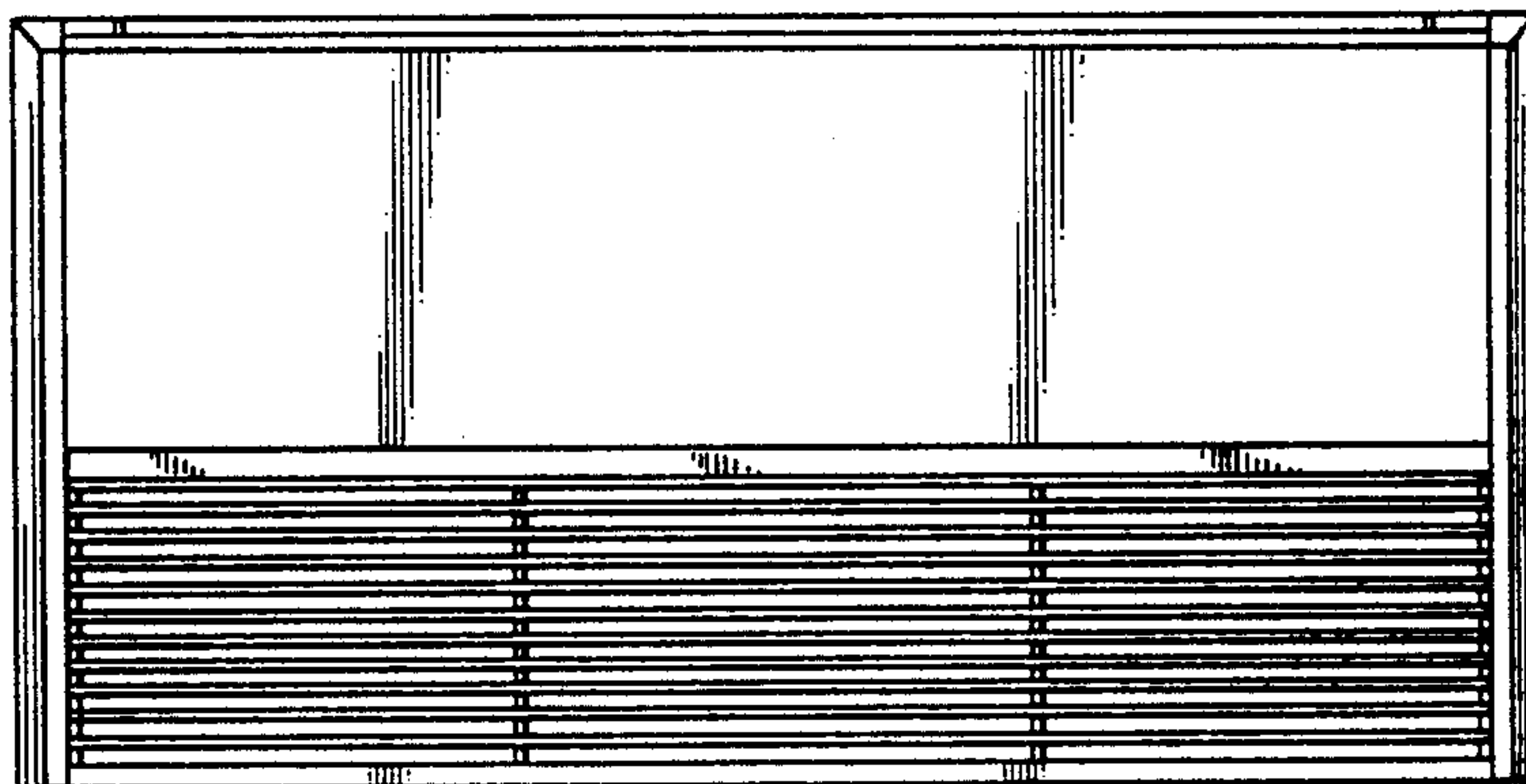
