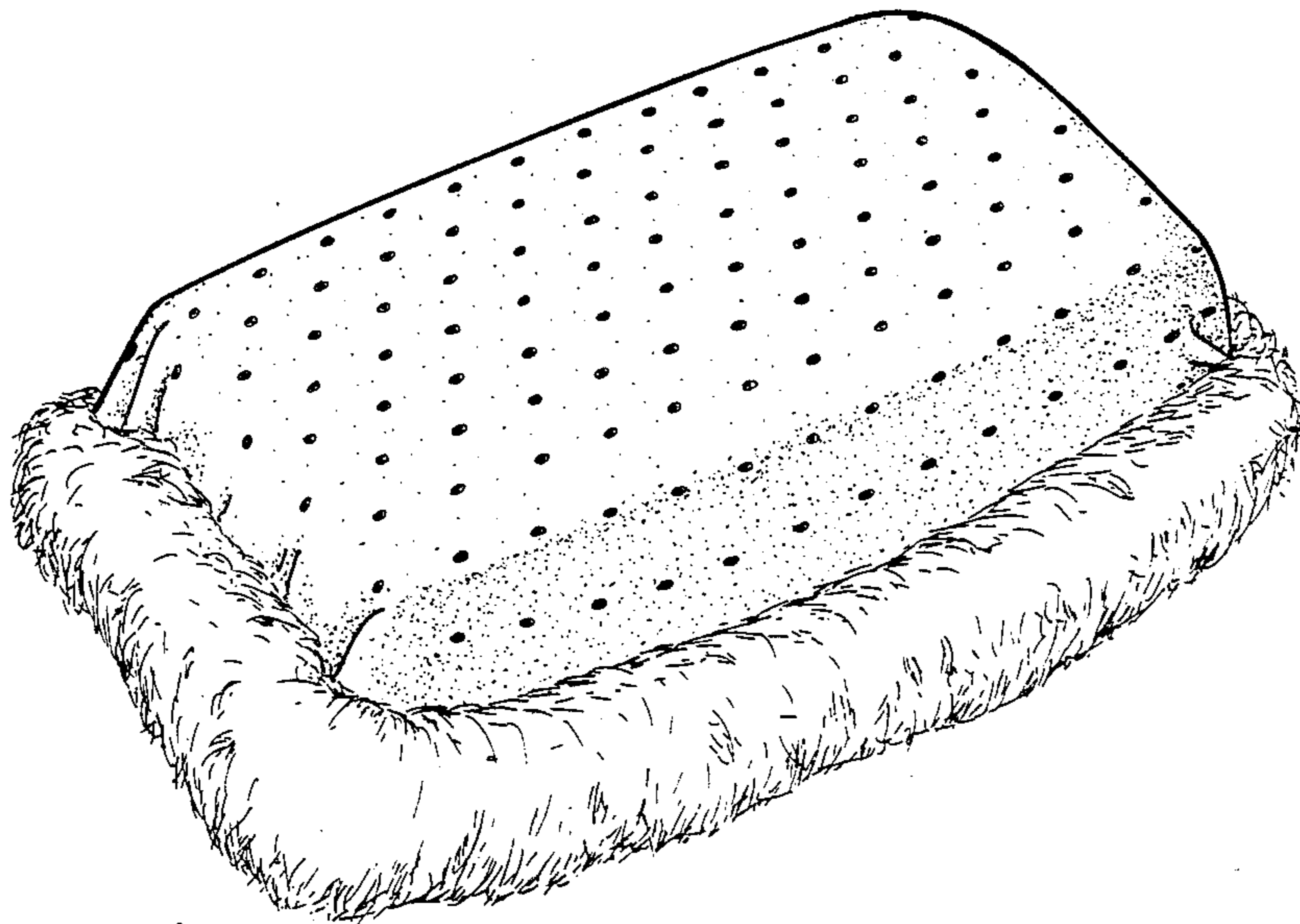

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a chamois and pile covered sponge showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof.



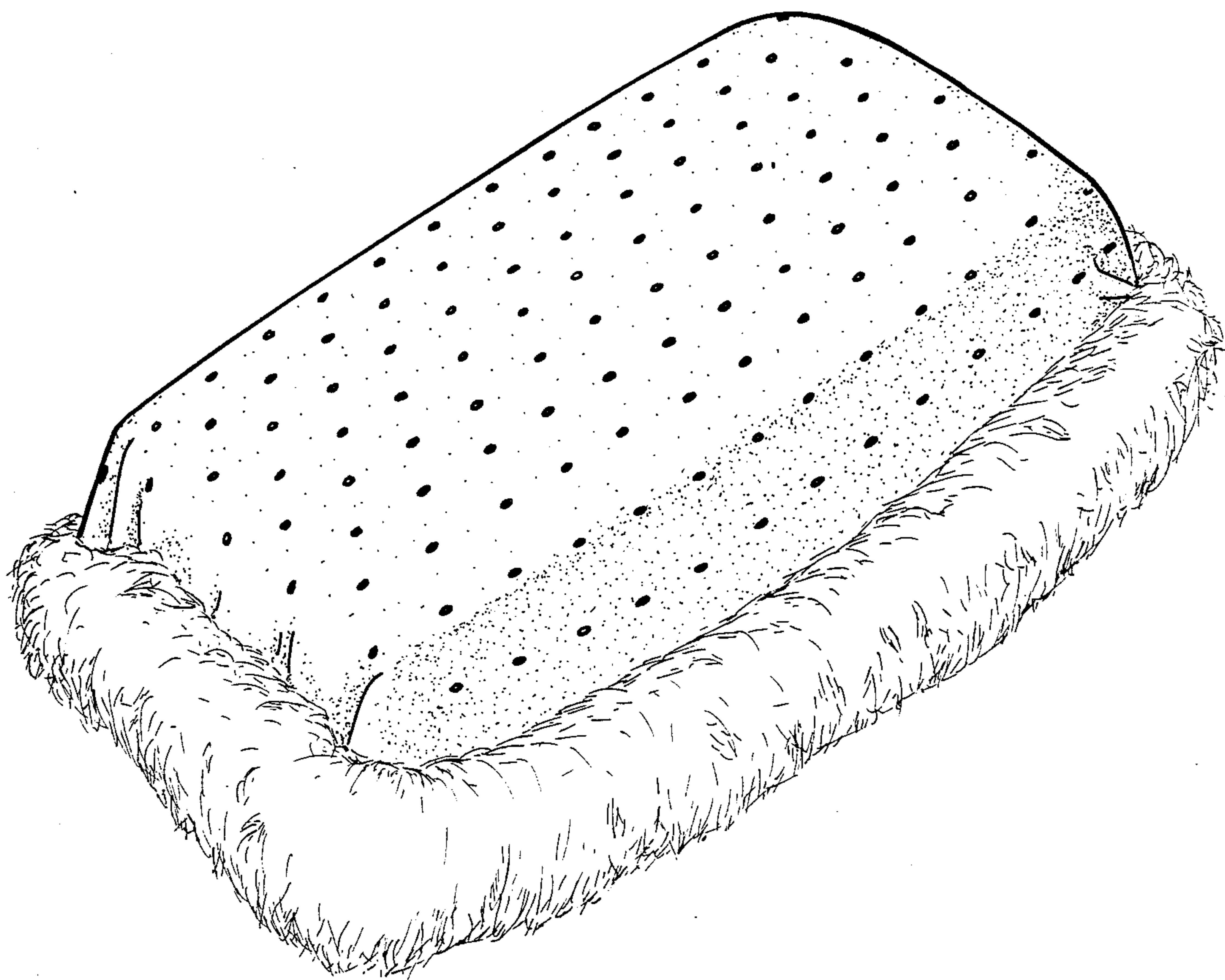

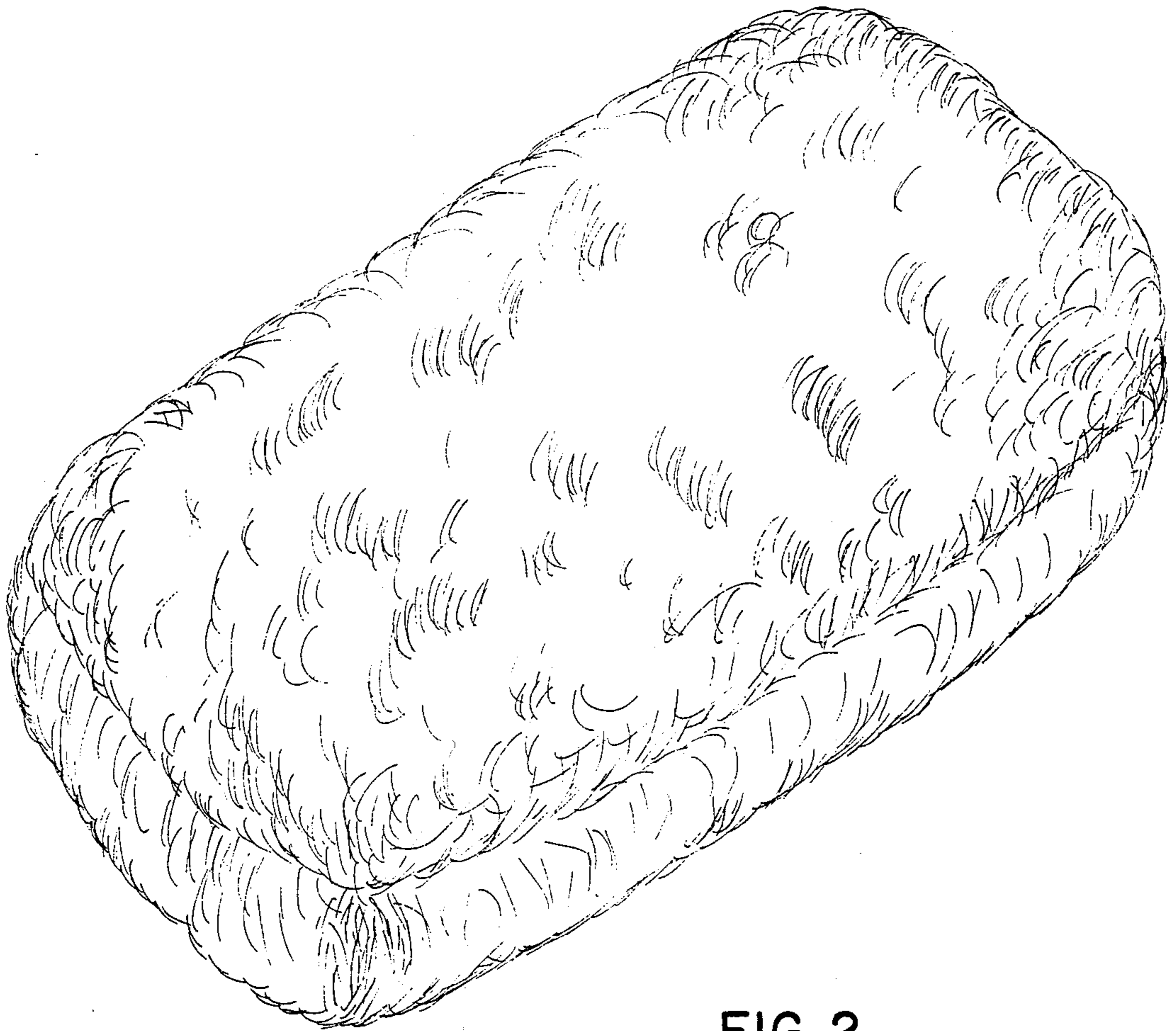
