[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for folding eyeglasses, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the folding eyeglasses showing my new design, the temples being omitted for ease of illustration only;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along the line 4—4 in FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof, showing the eyeglasses in the folded position.

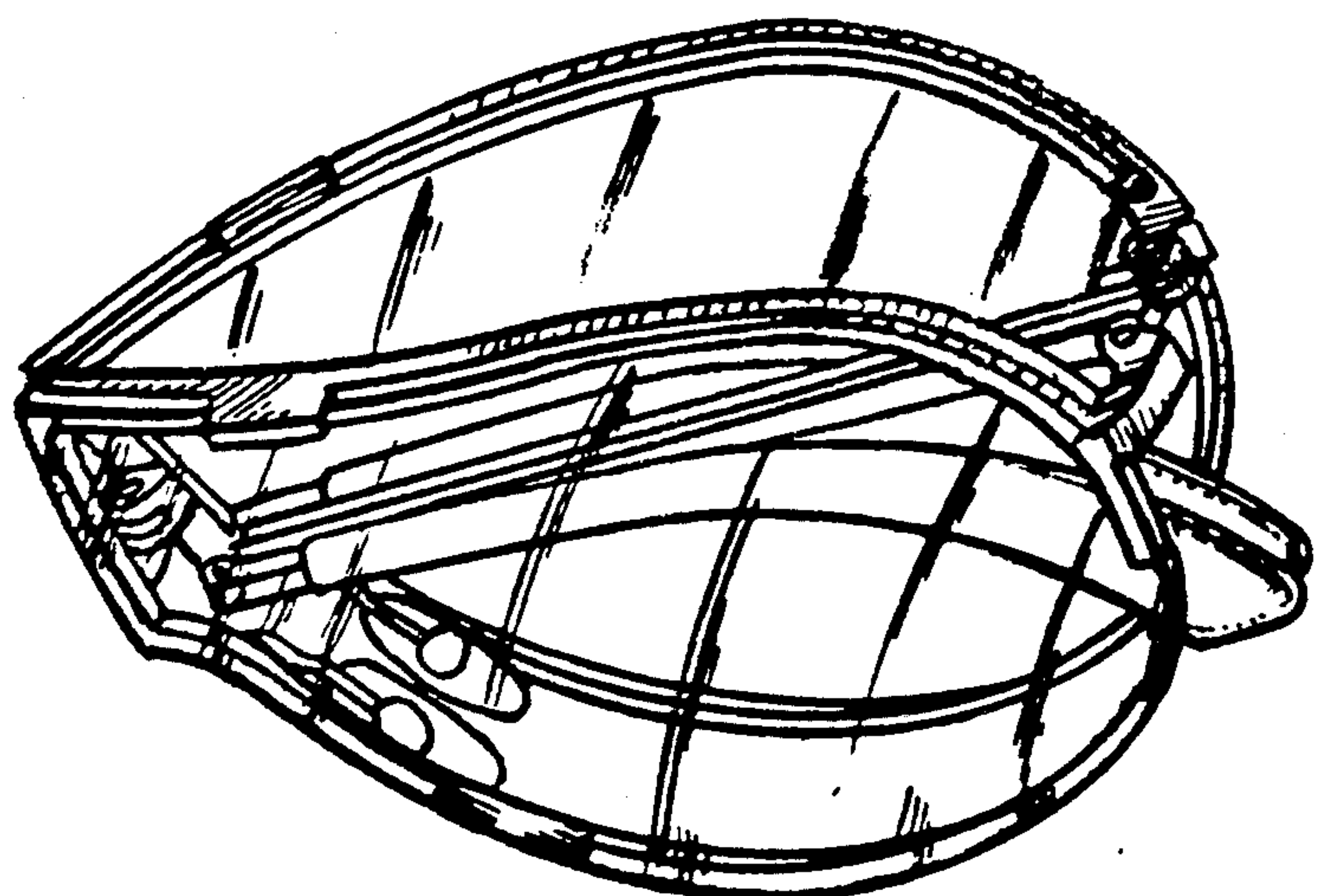
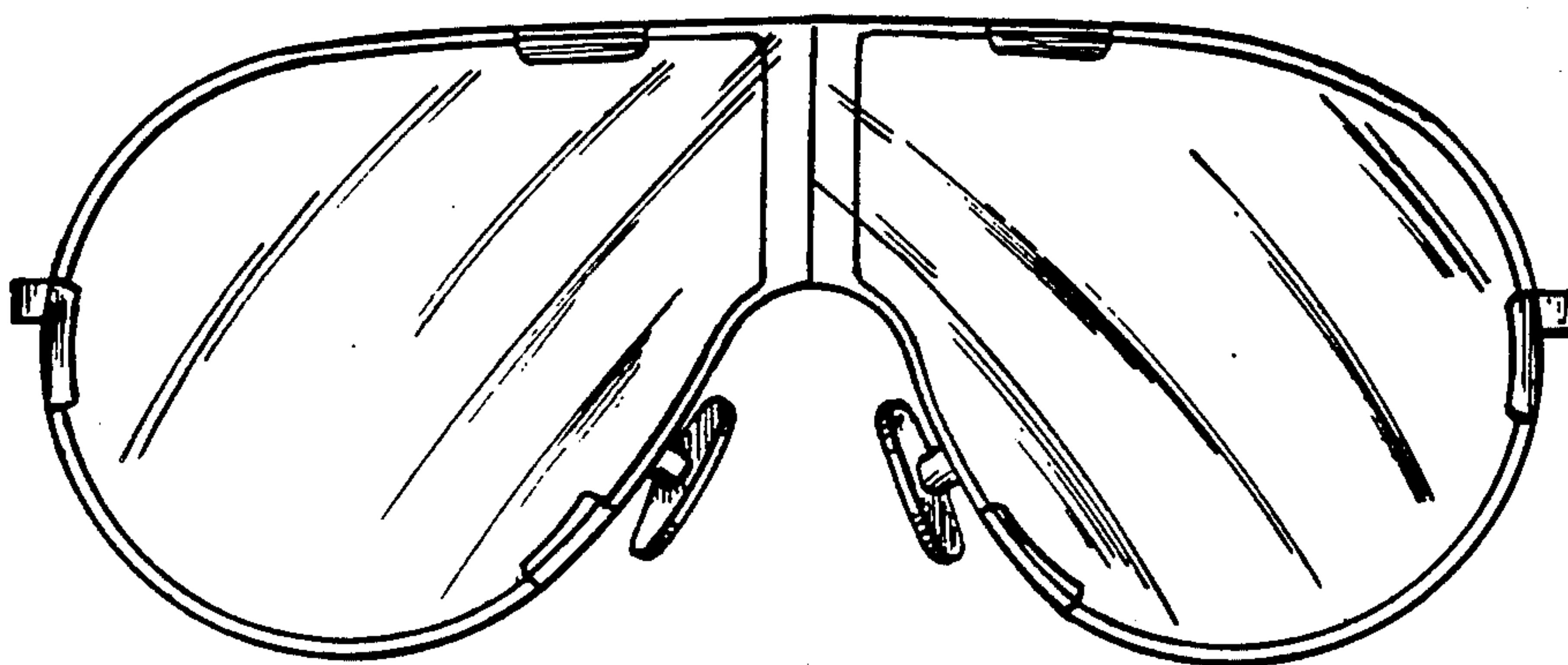

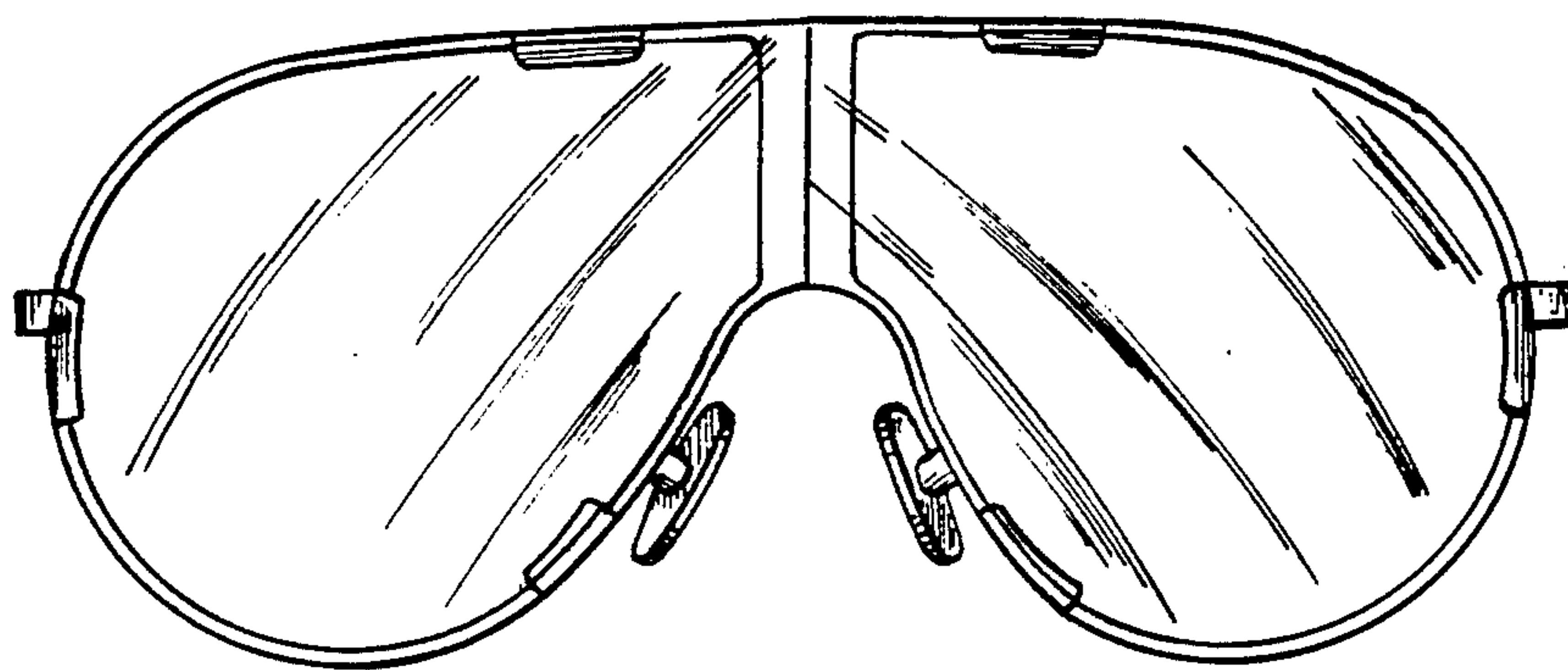

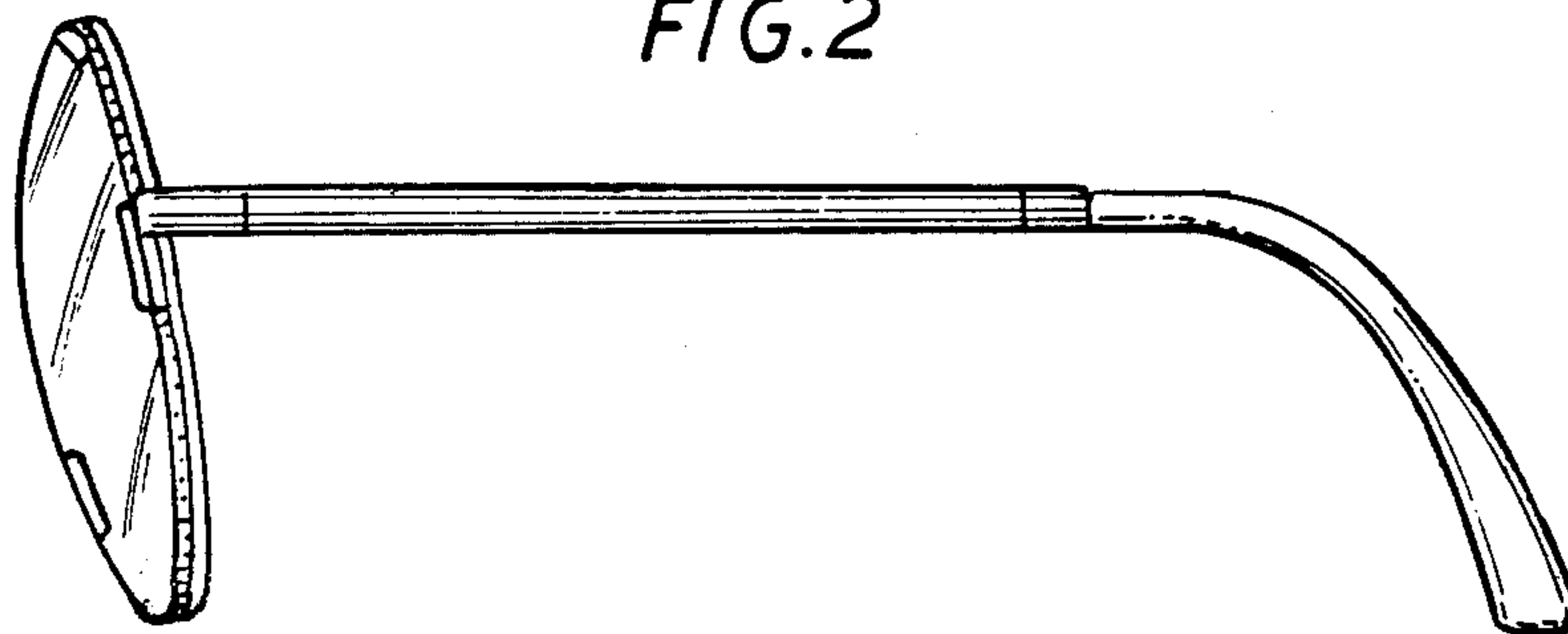

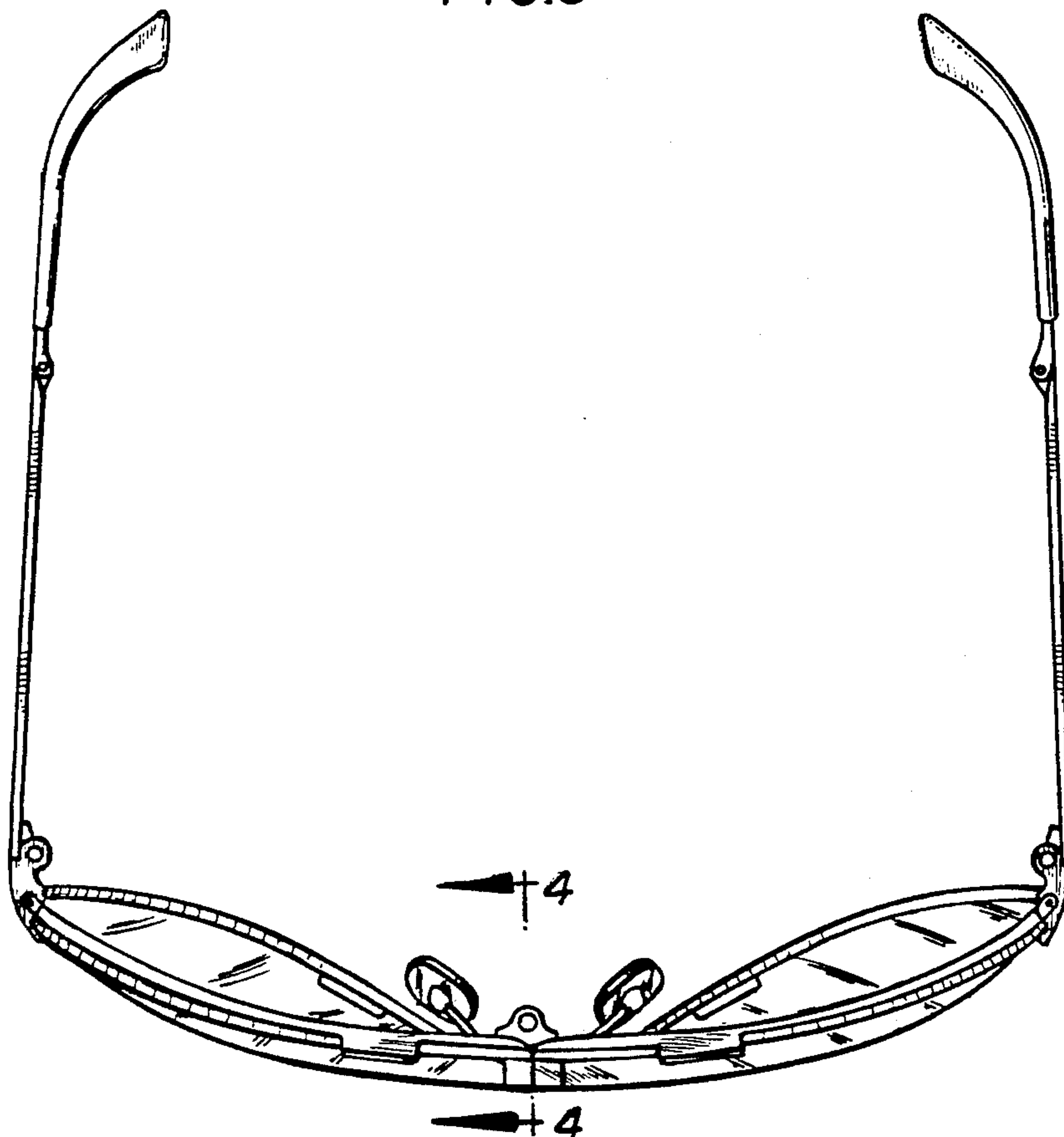

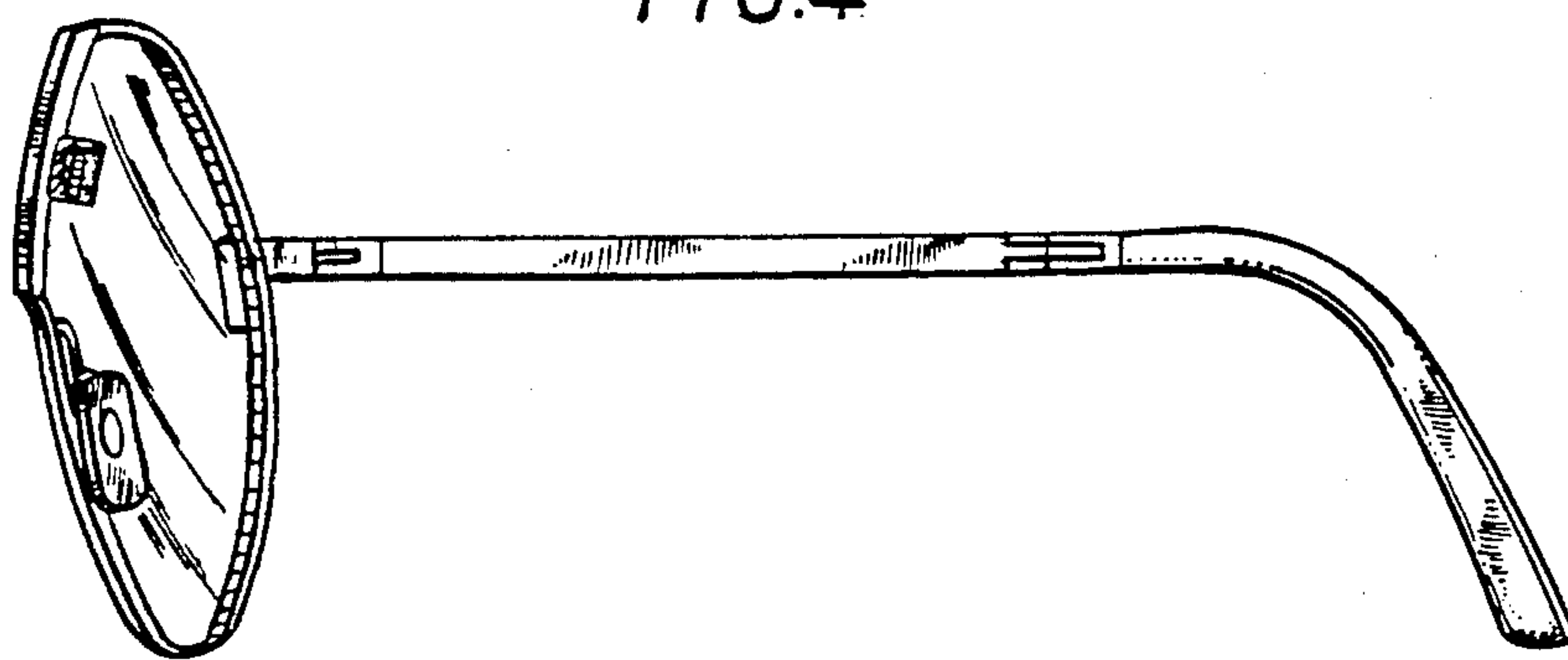

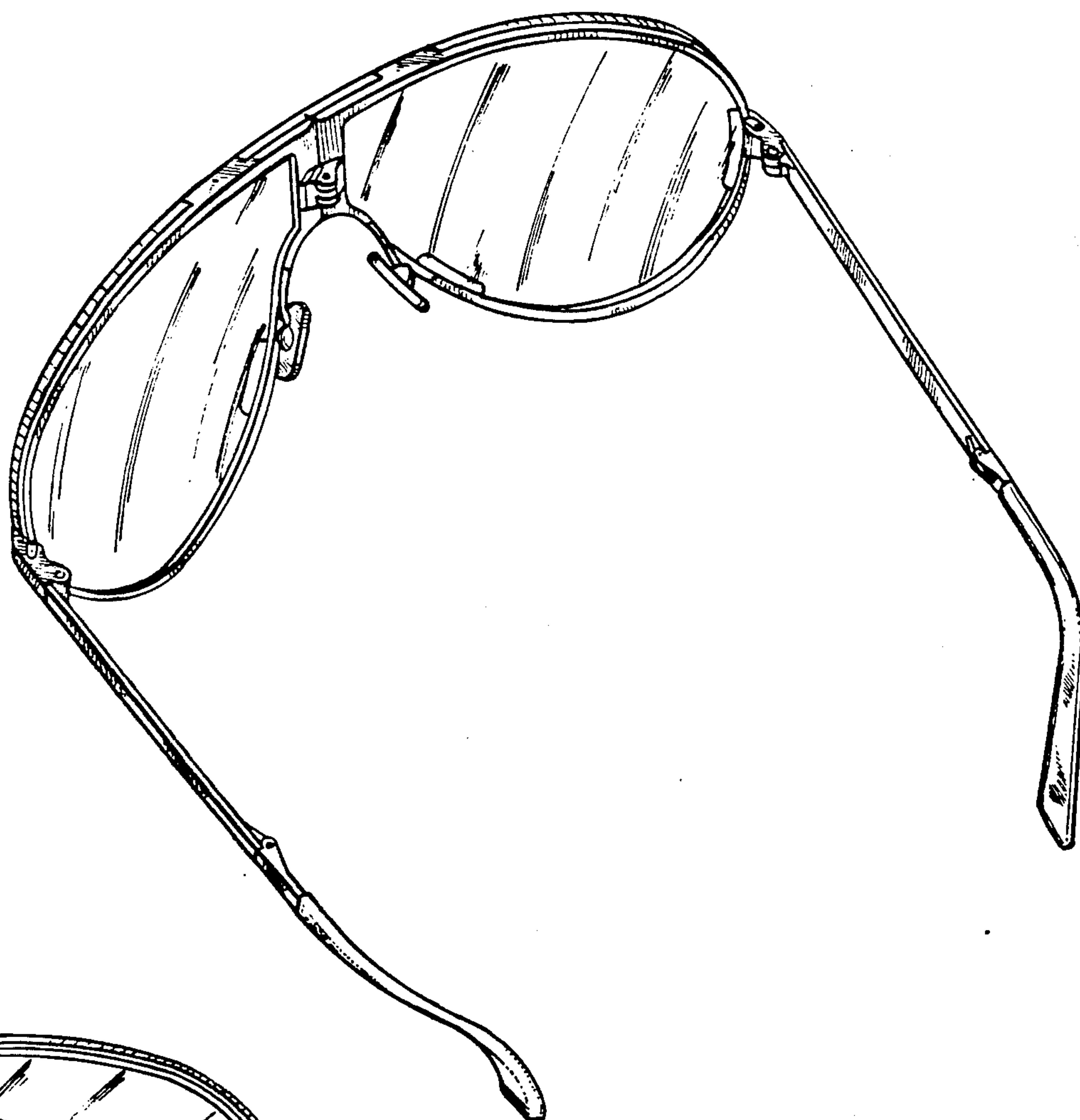
