[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a modular wall mounted cabinet and bench unit for a keyboard instrument, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a modular cabinet for a keyboard instrument showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

The broken-line showing of a keyboard is for illustrative purposes only.

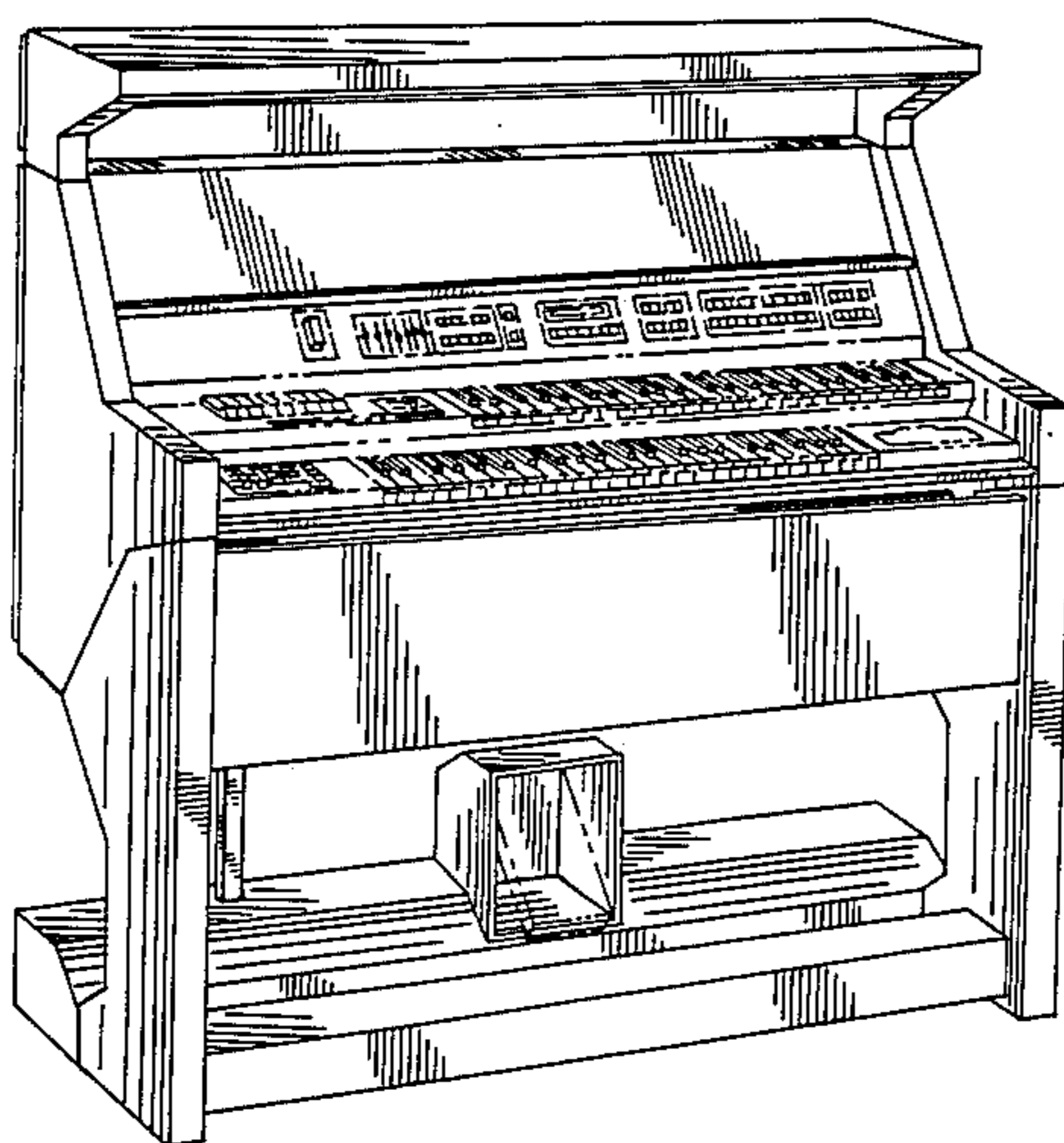

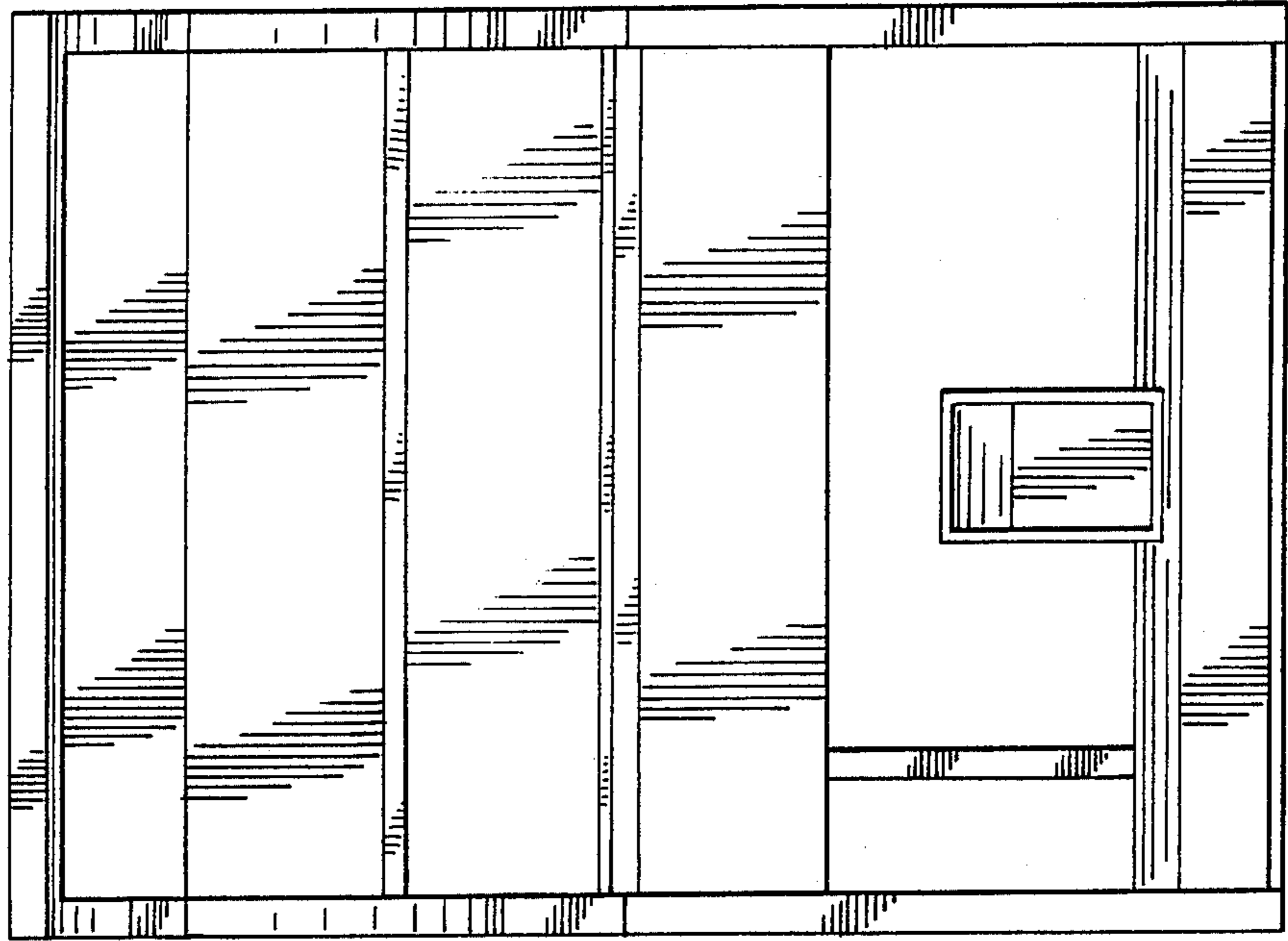

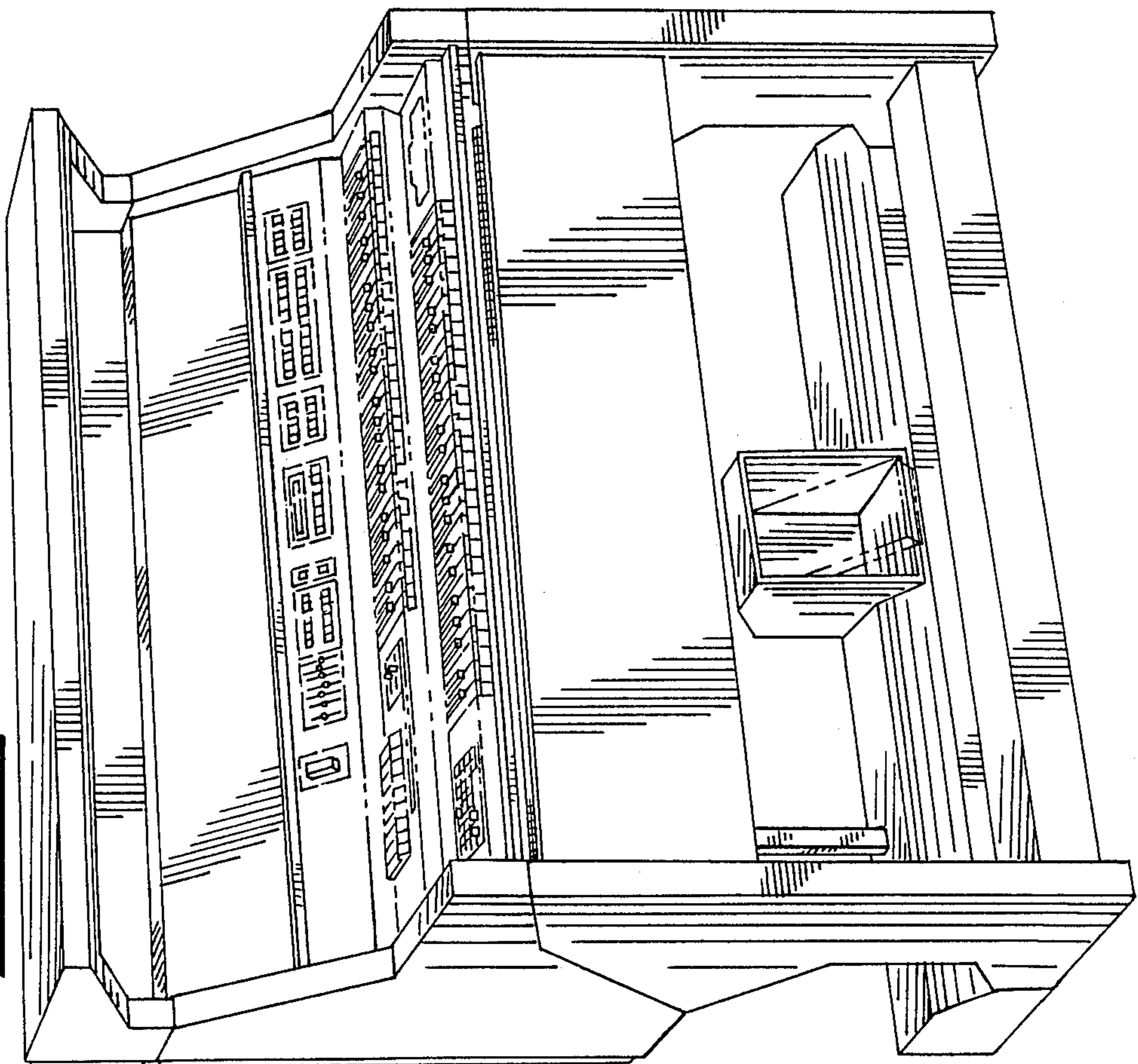

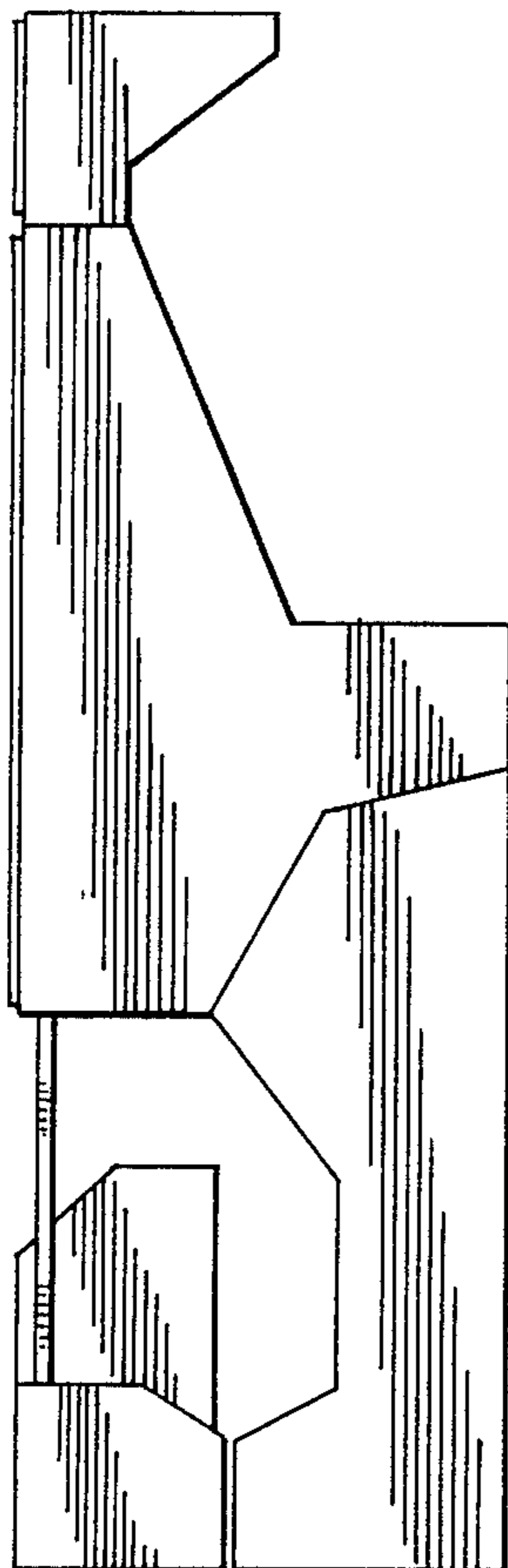

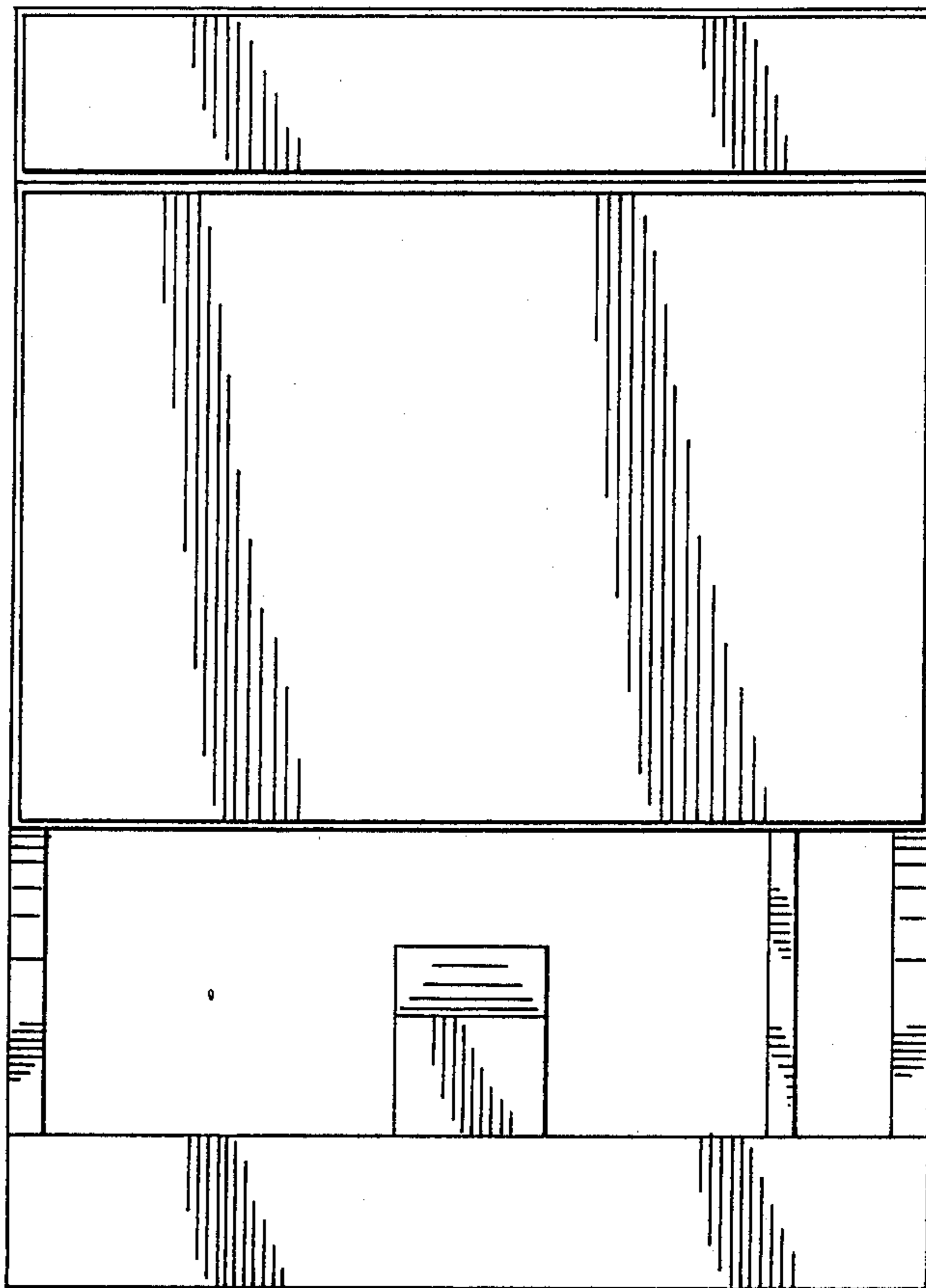
