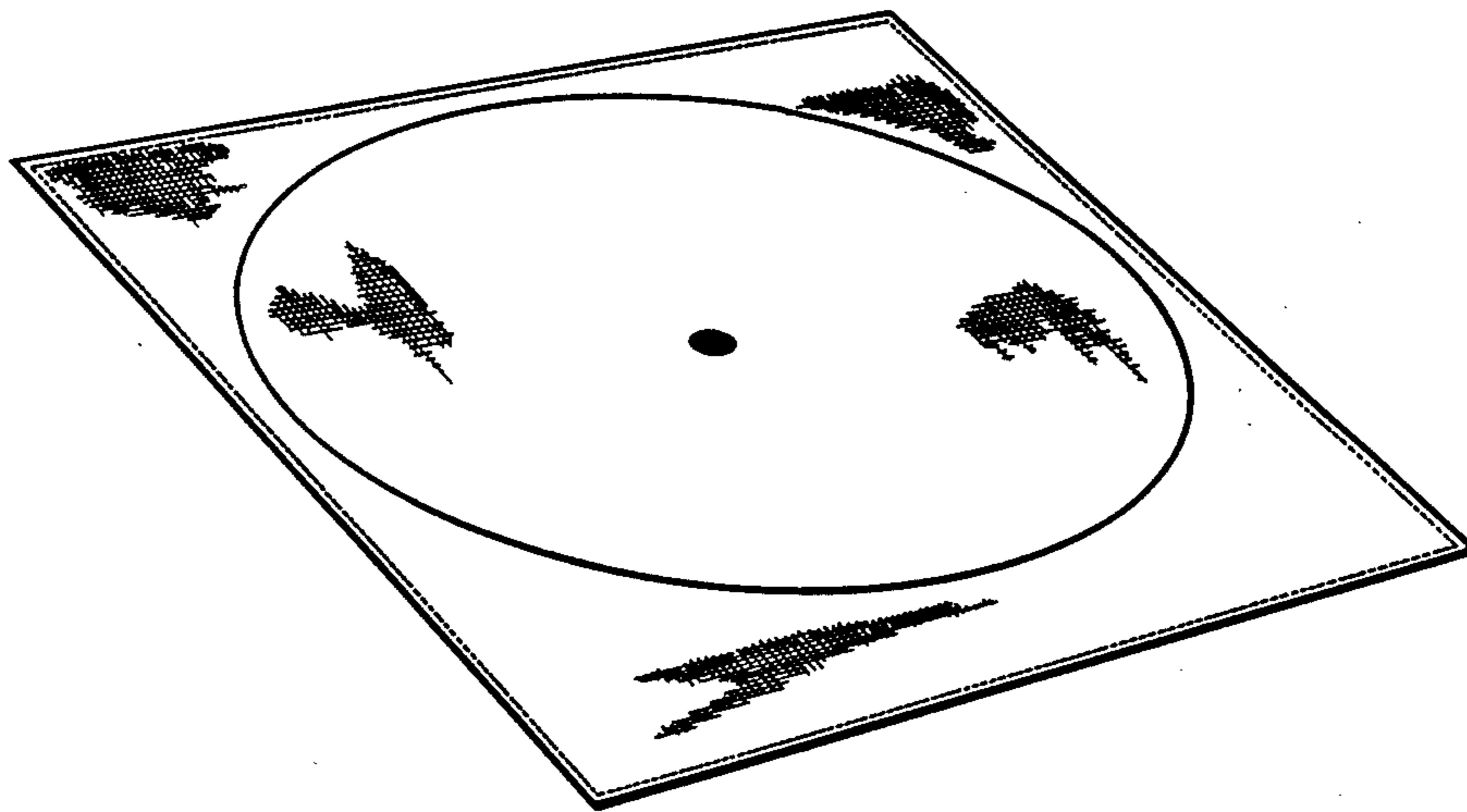

FIG. 4 is an end elevation thereof.



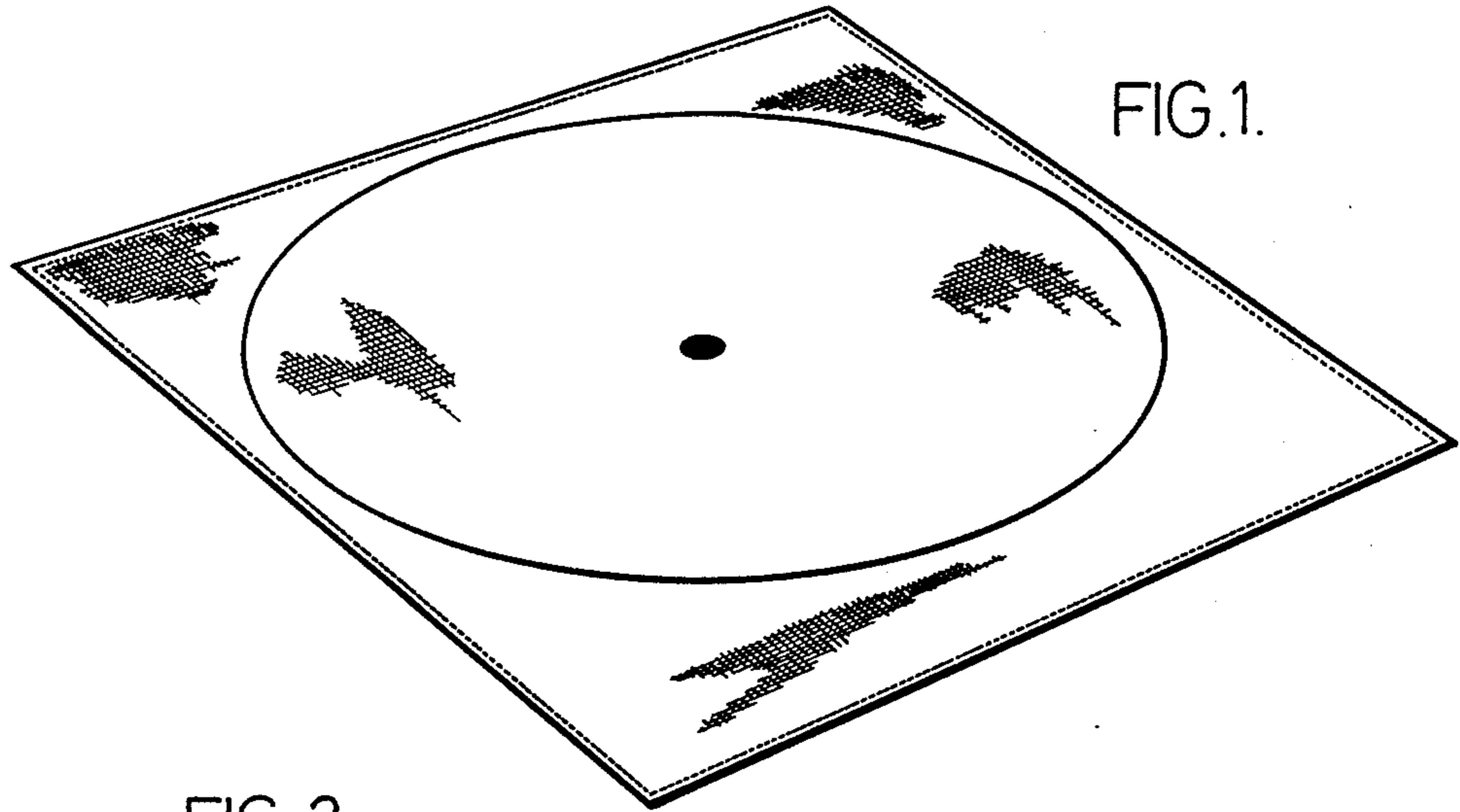

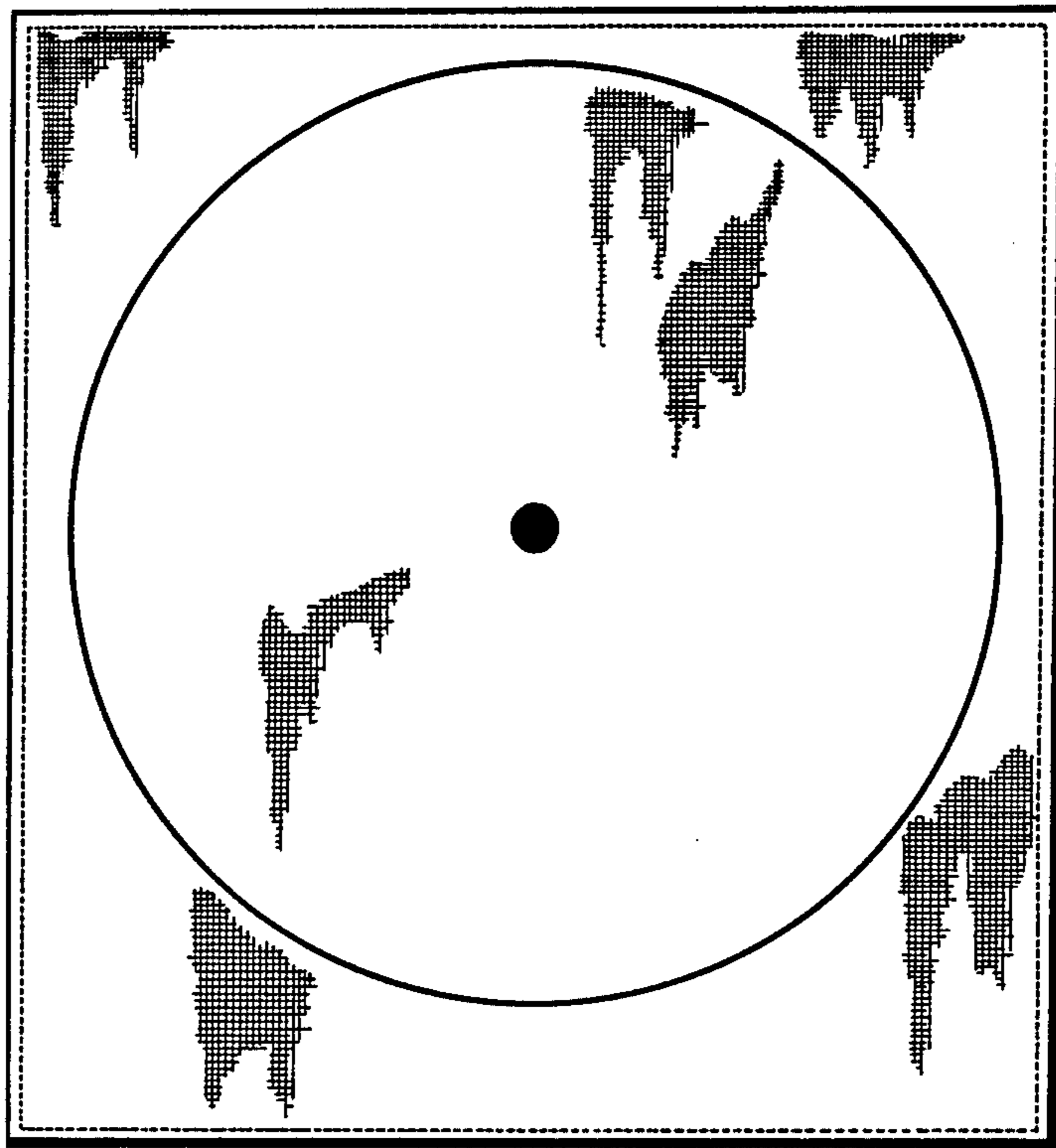
