FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

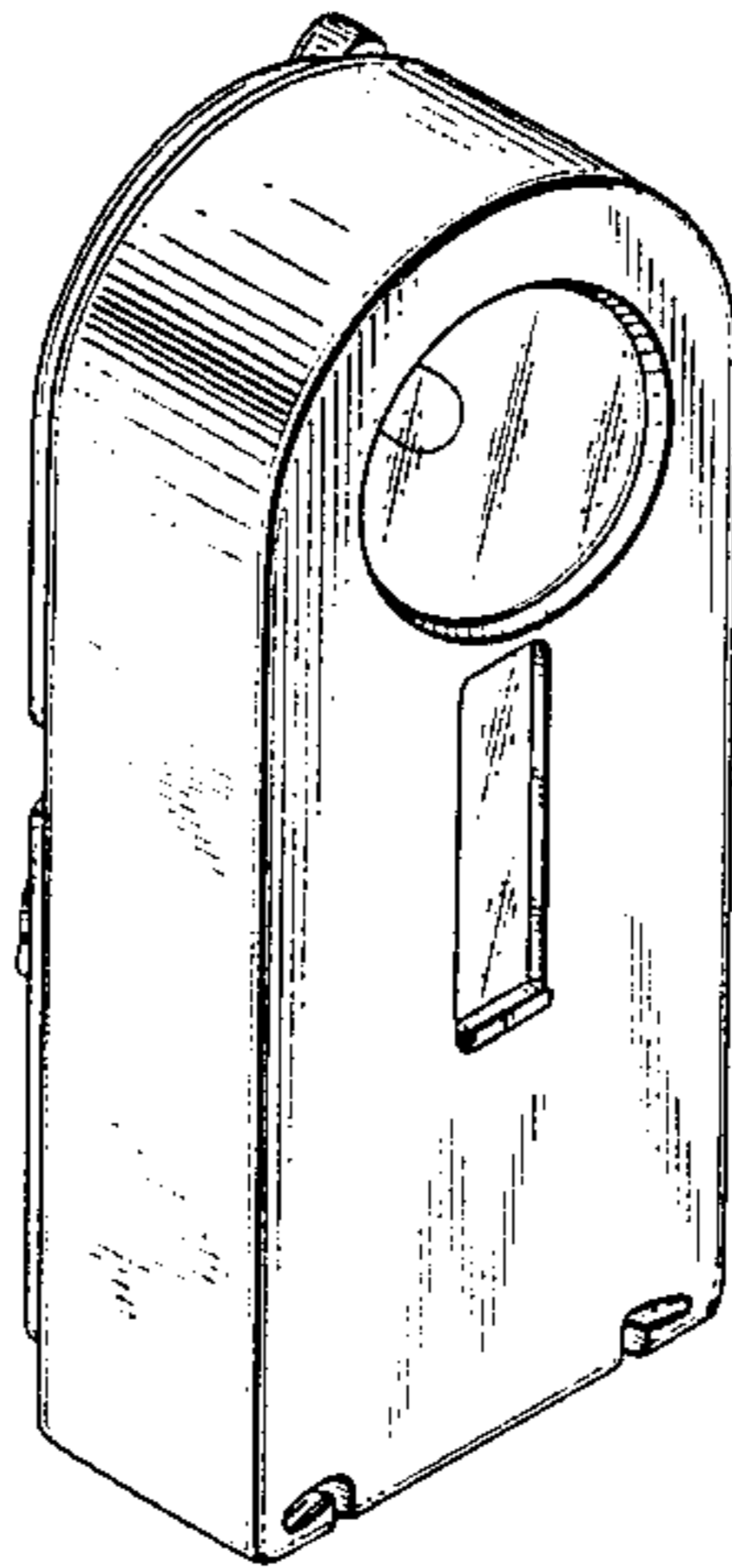
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

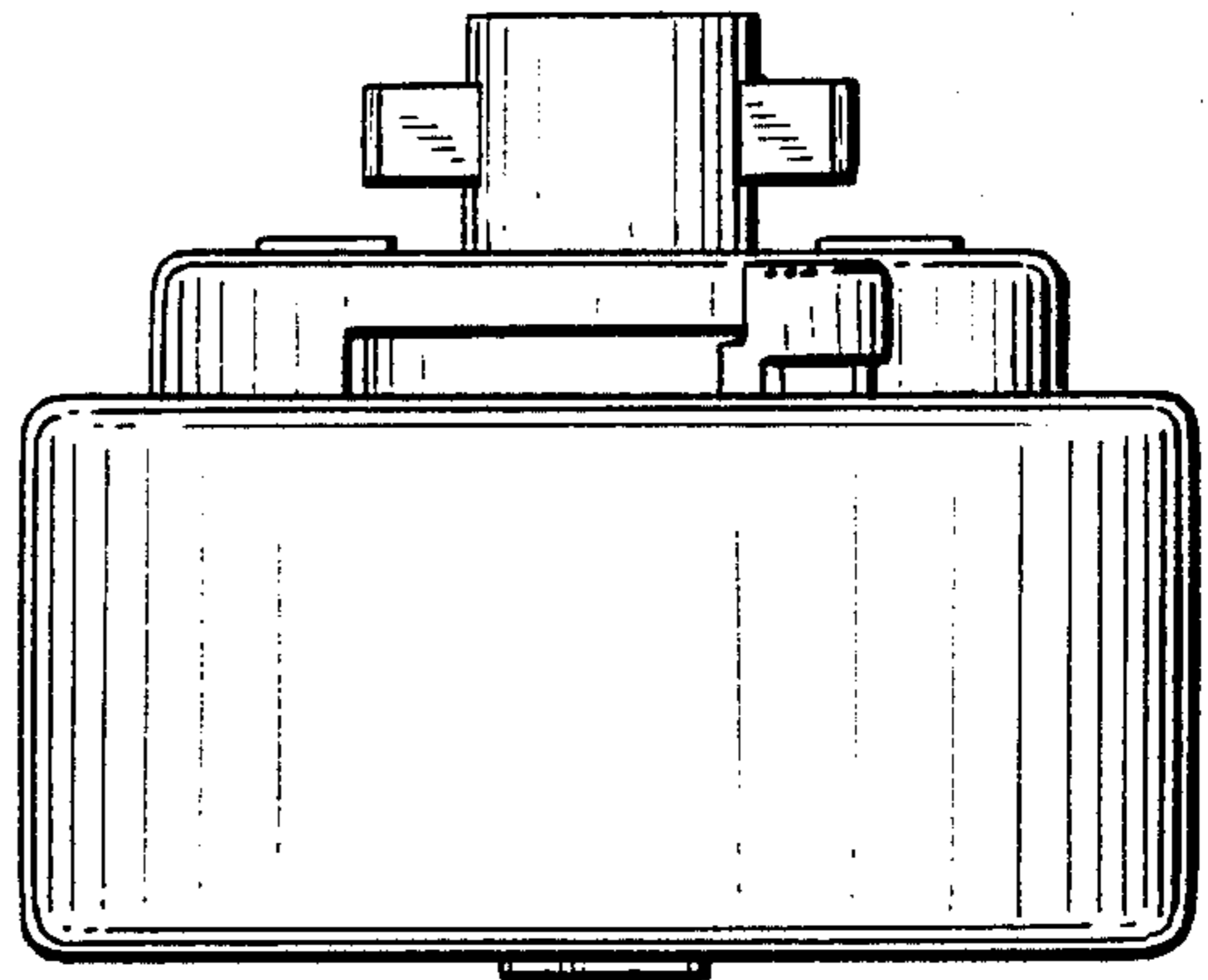
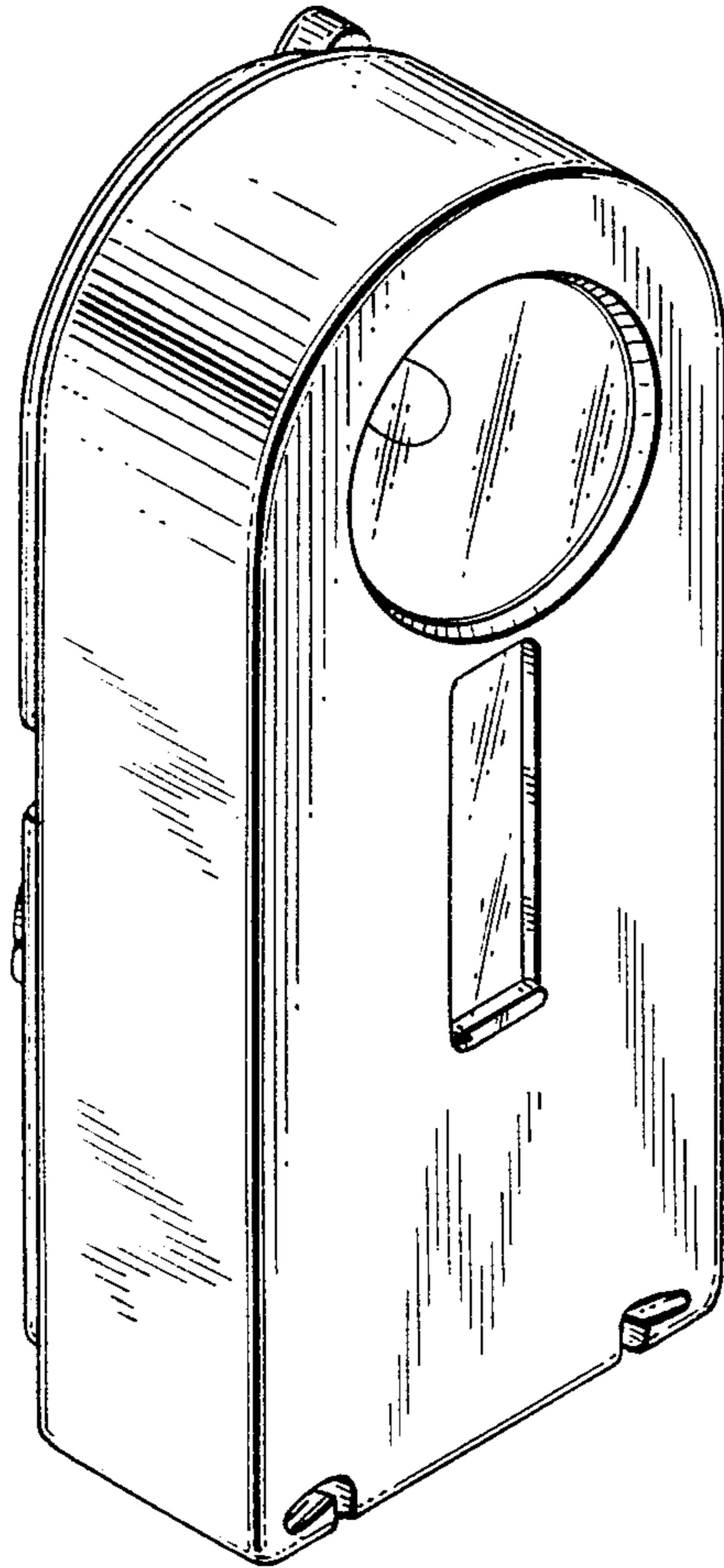
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

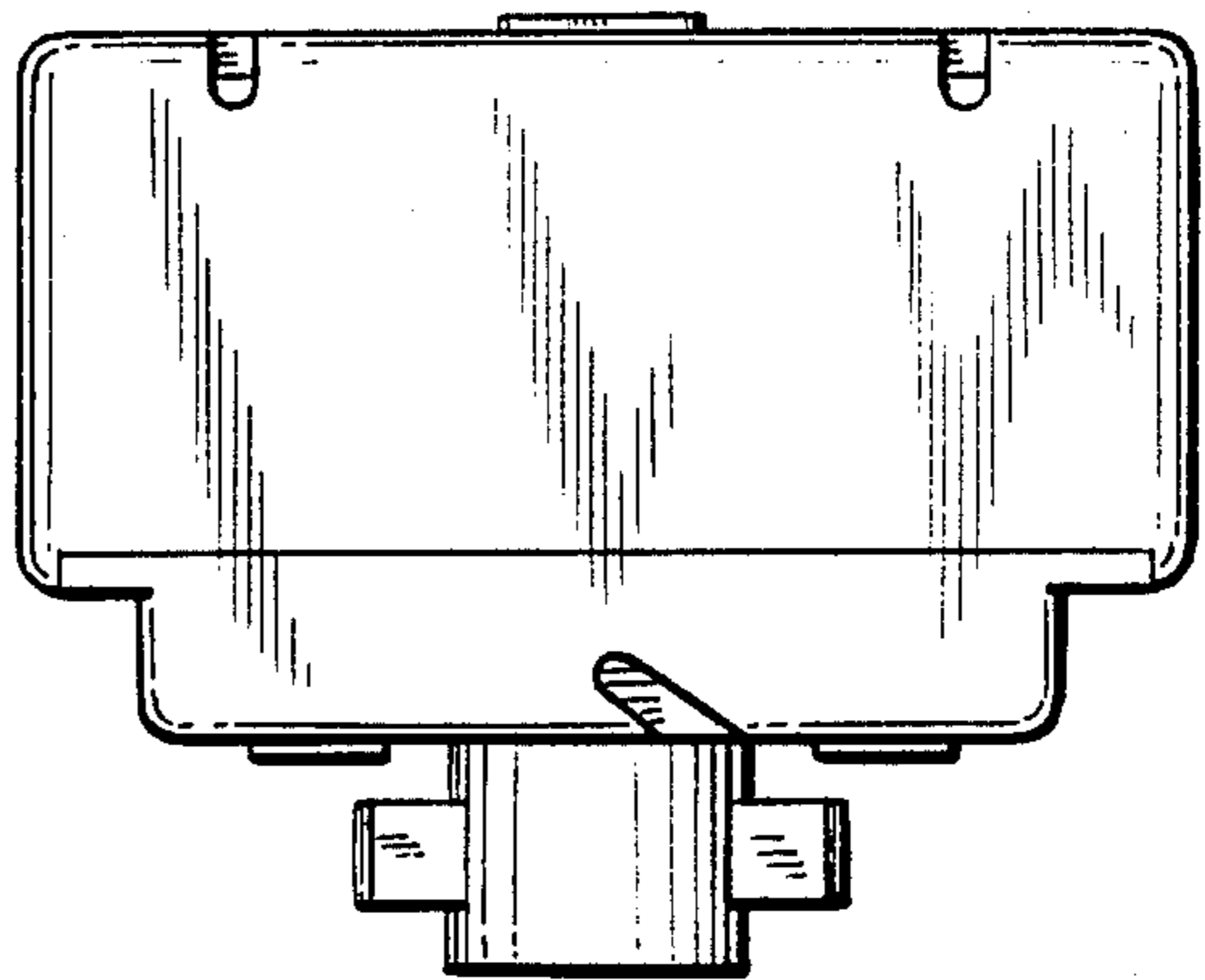

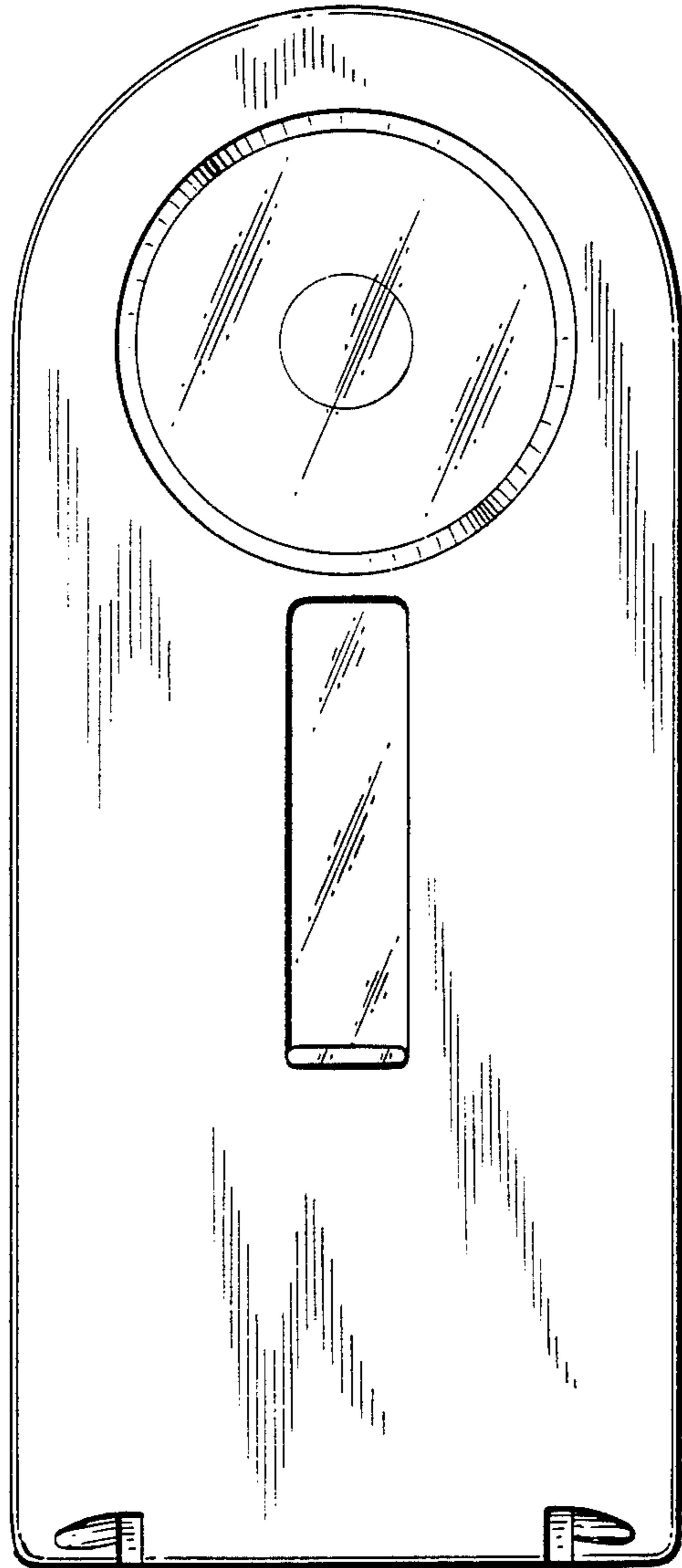

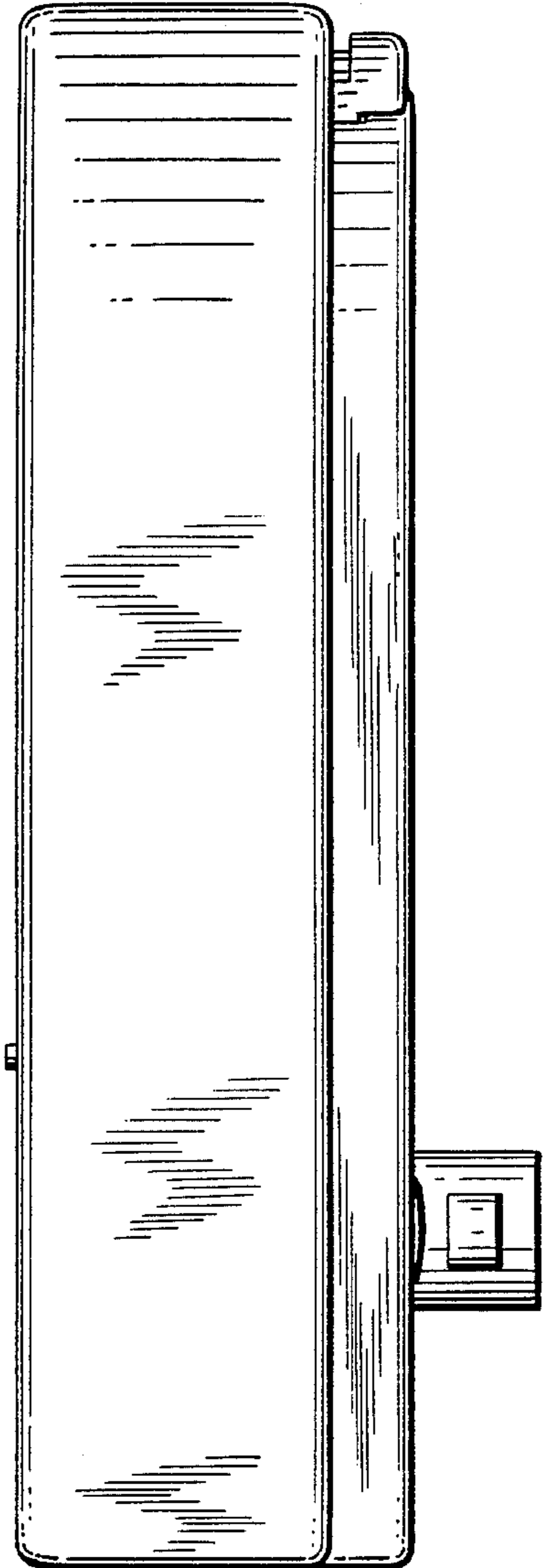

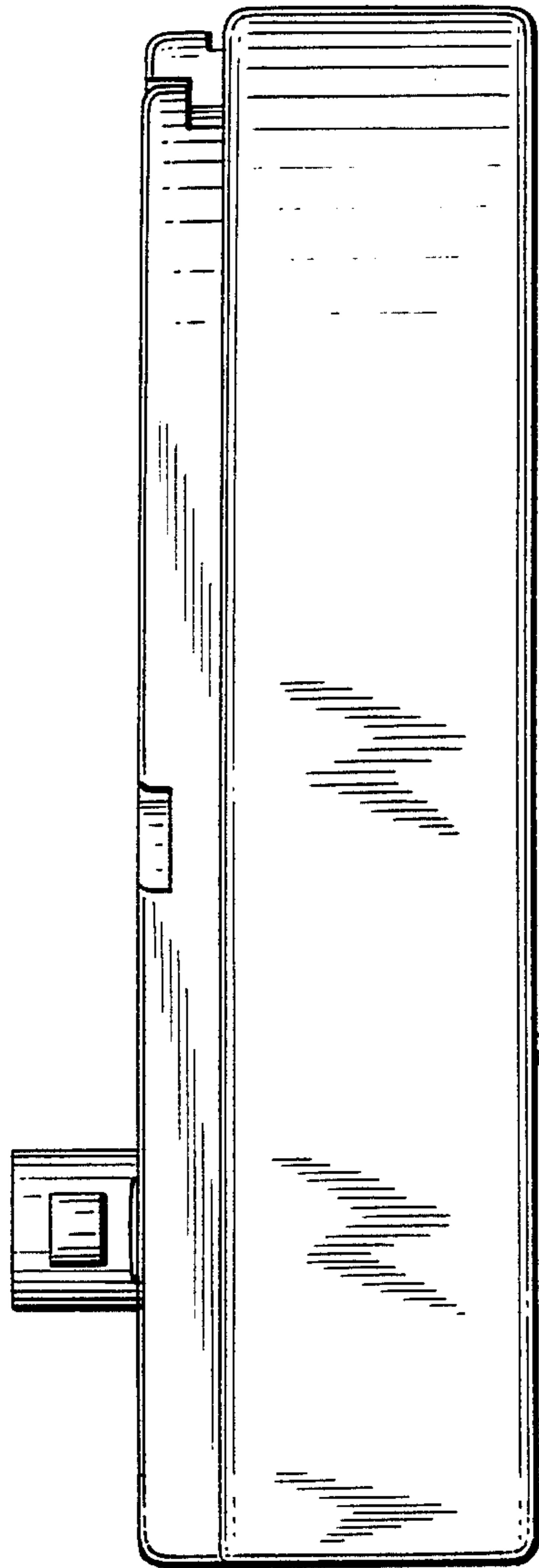
