DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a shoe sole showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along 6—6 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along 7—7 of FIG. 1.

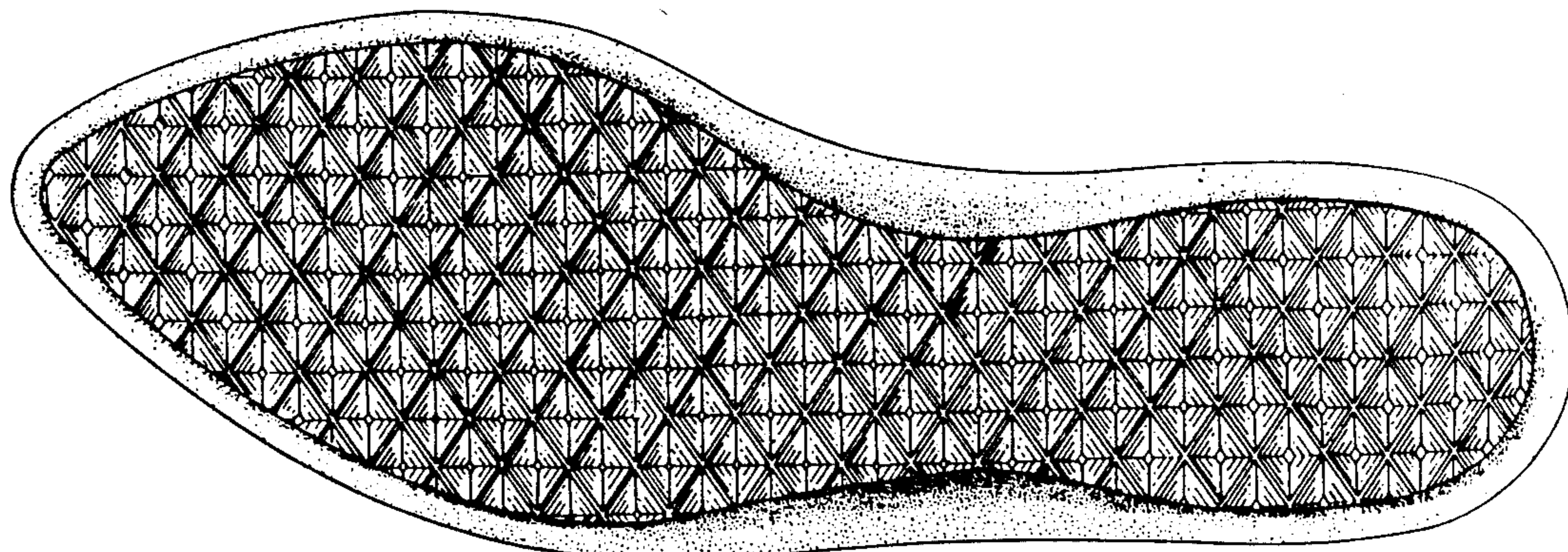
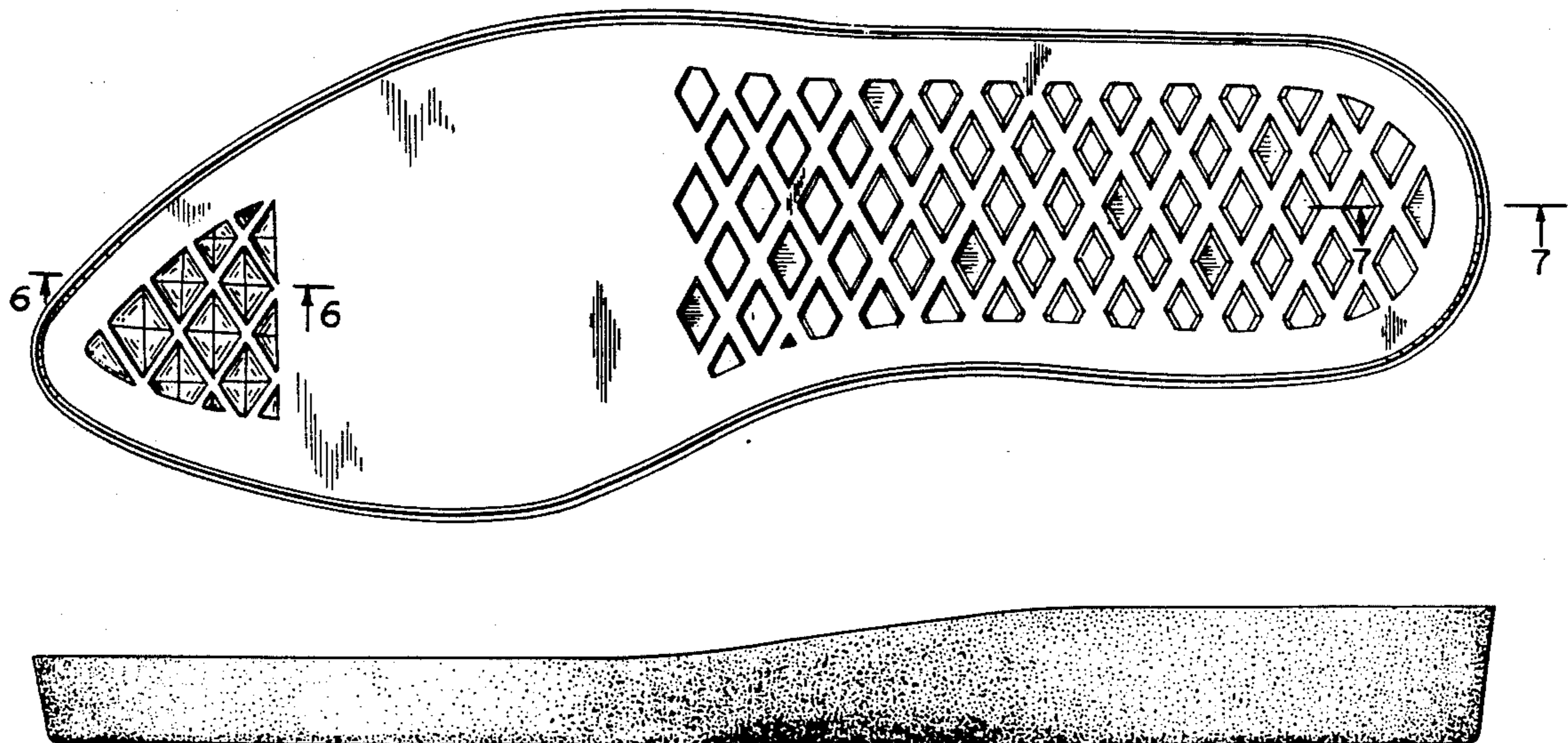

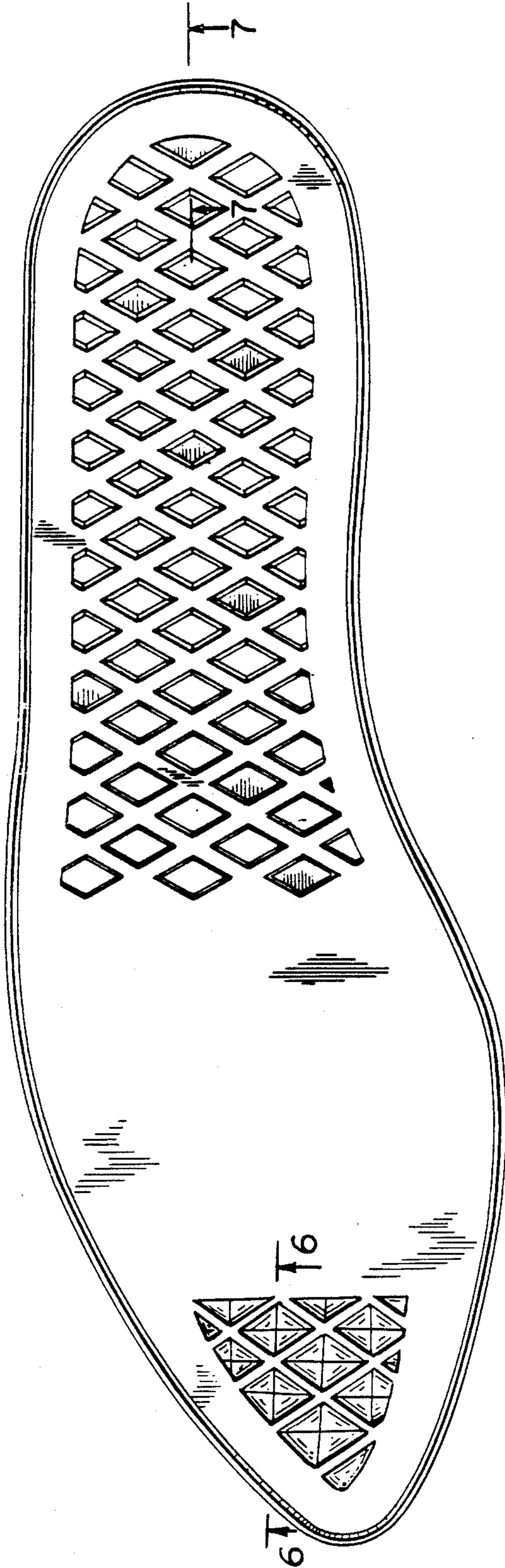

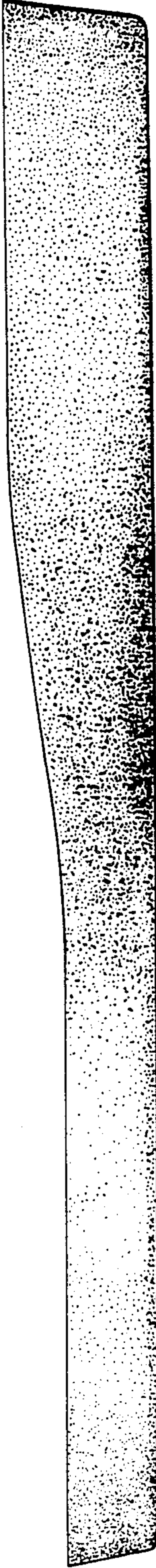

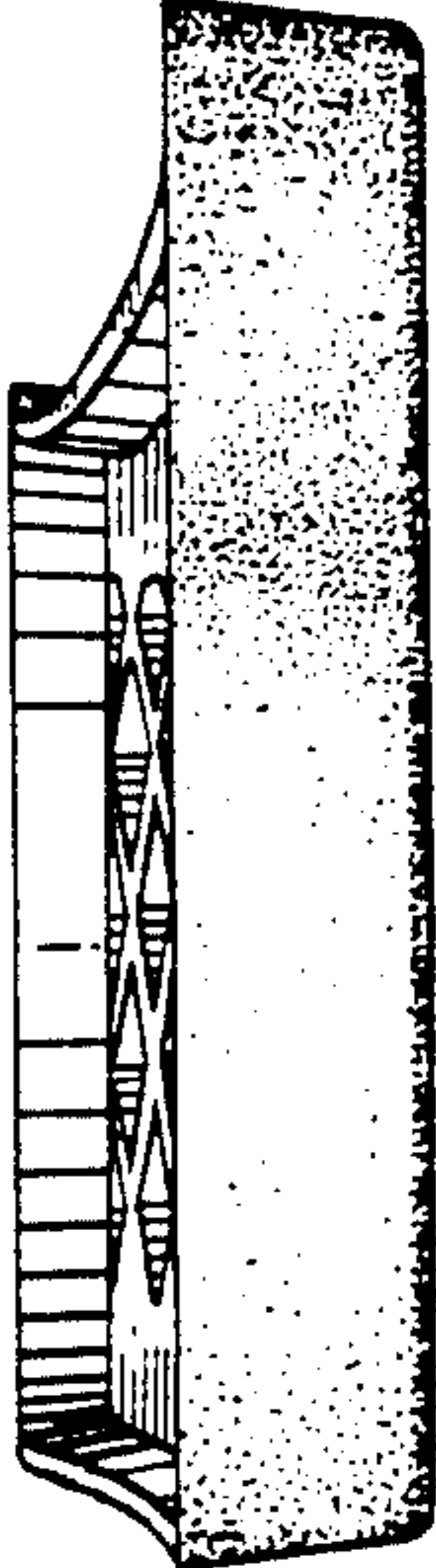

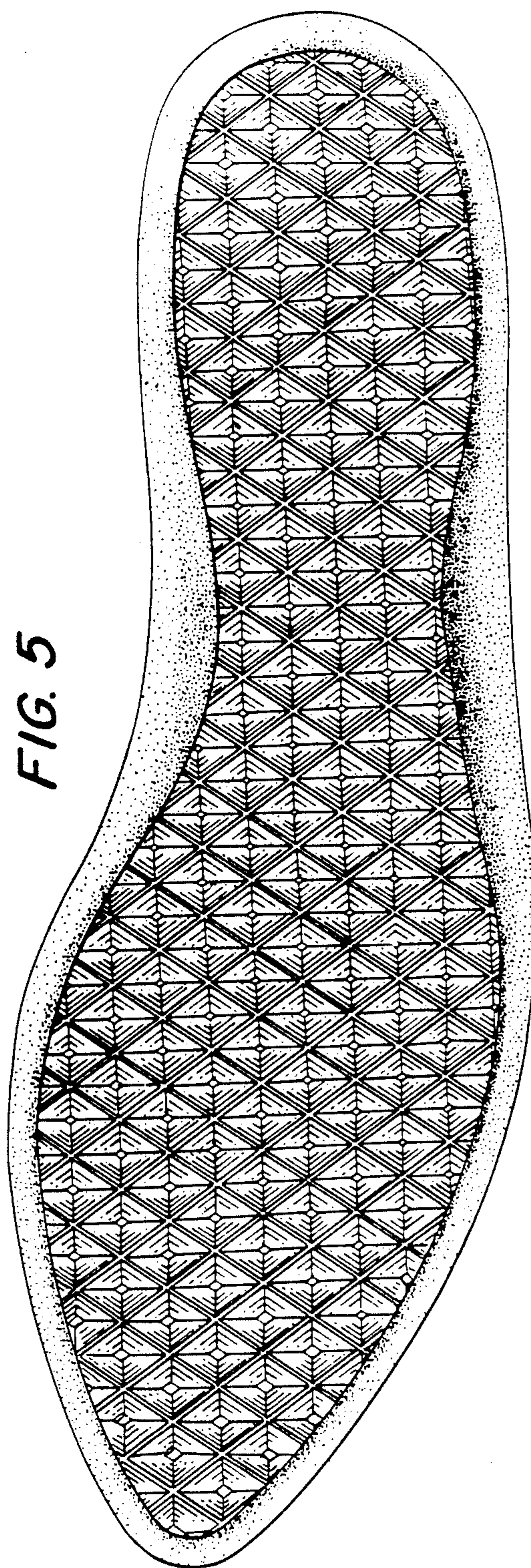

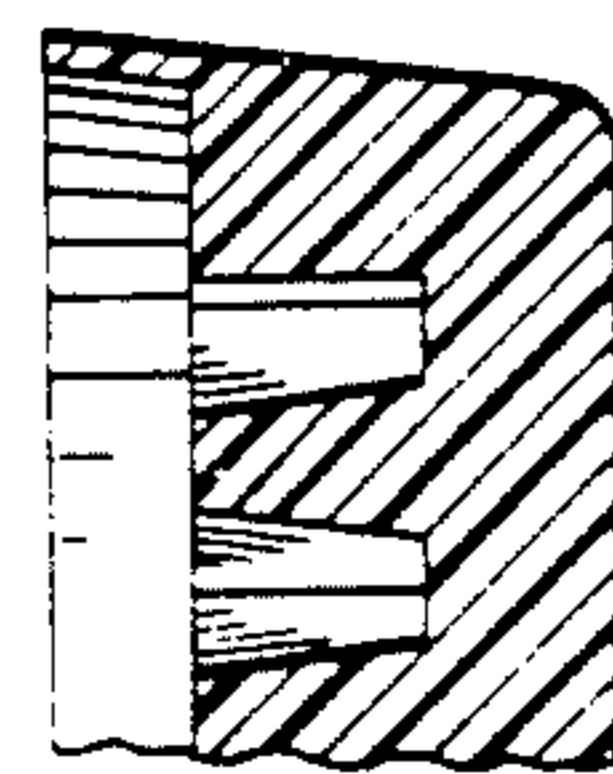
