FIG. 3 is a left end view;

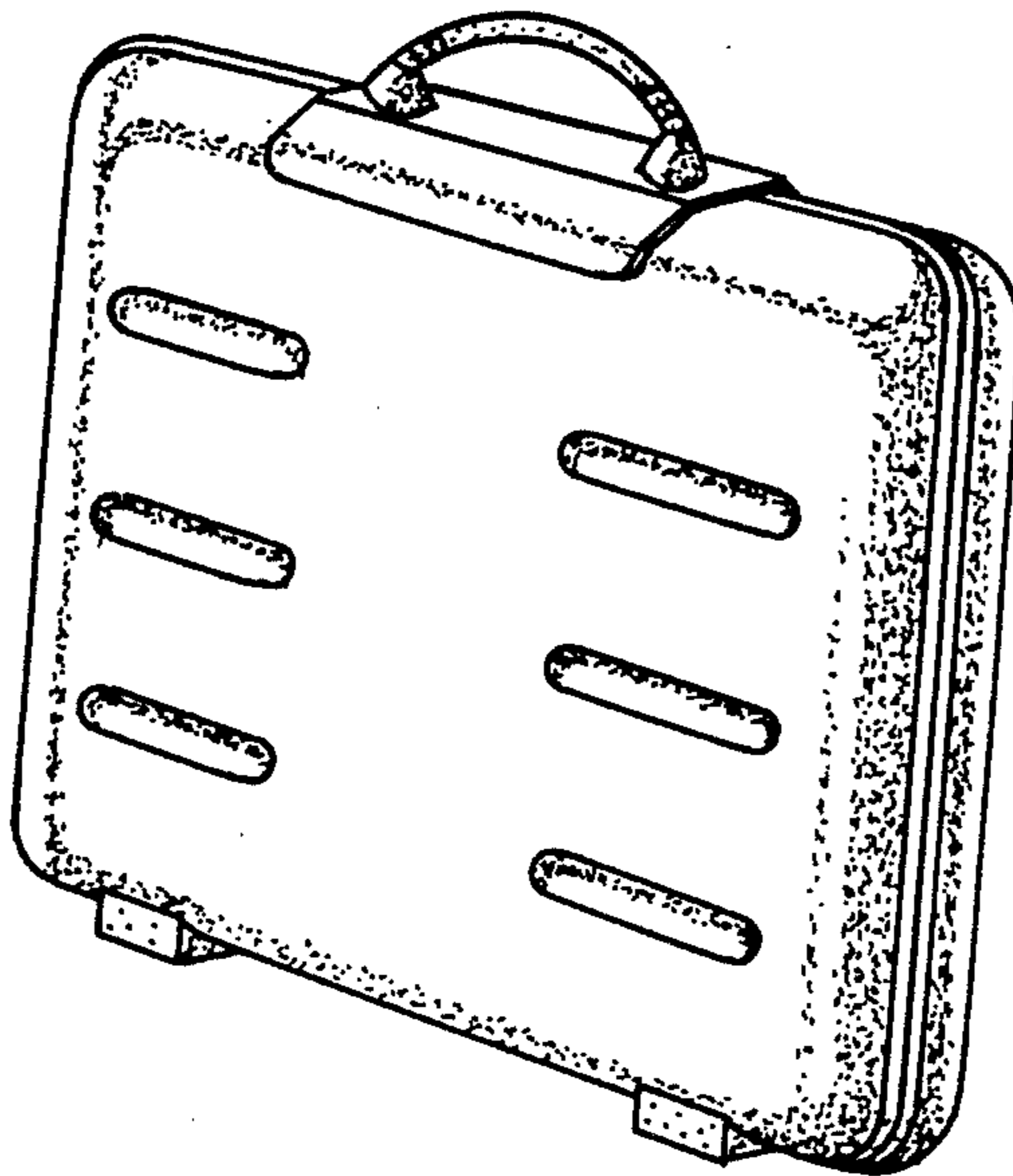
FIG. 4 is a right end view;

FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view.



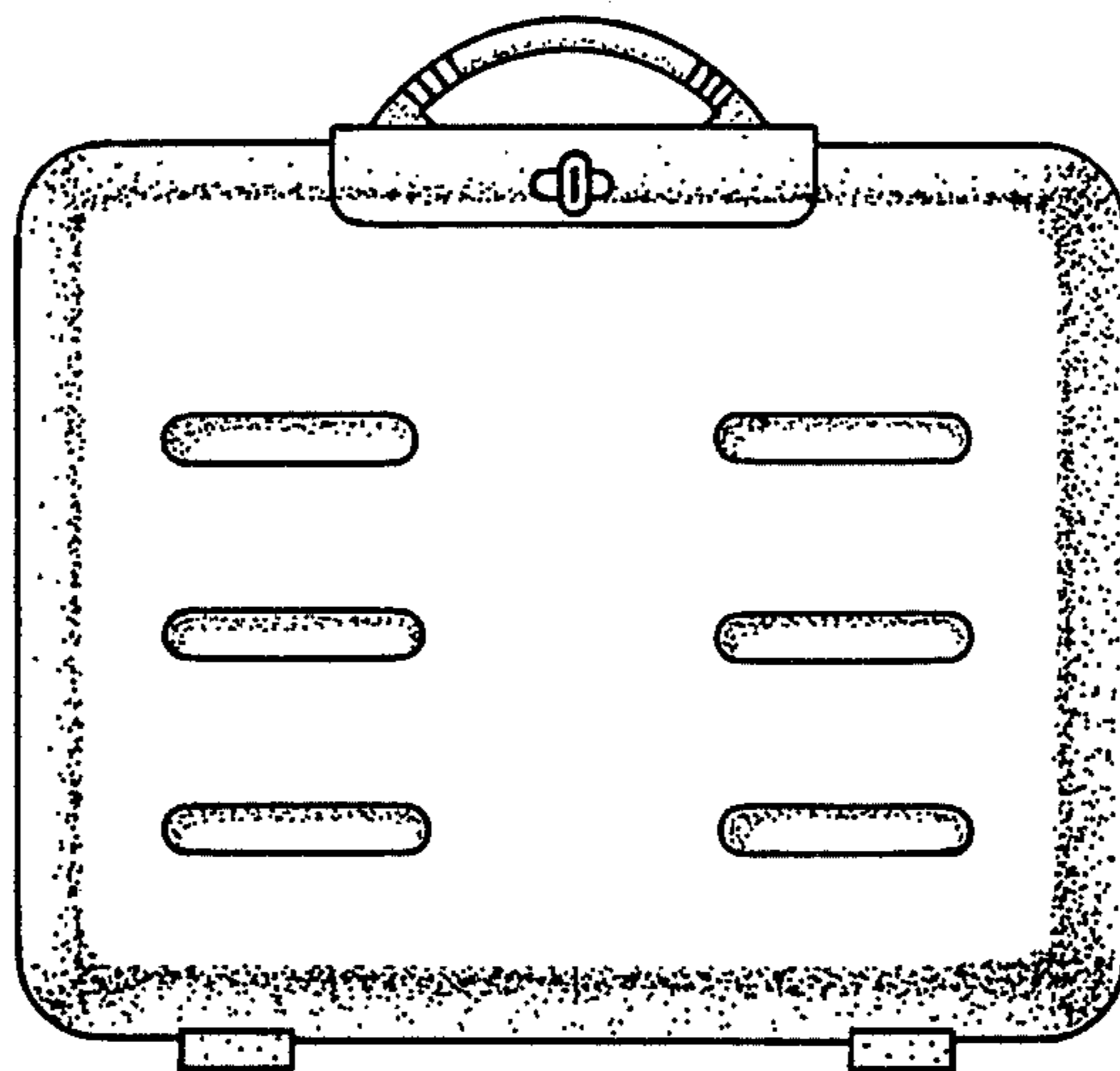

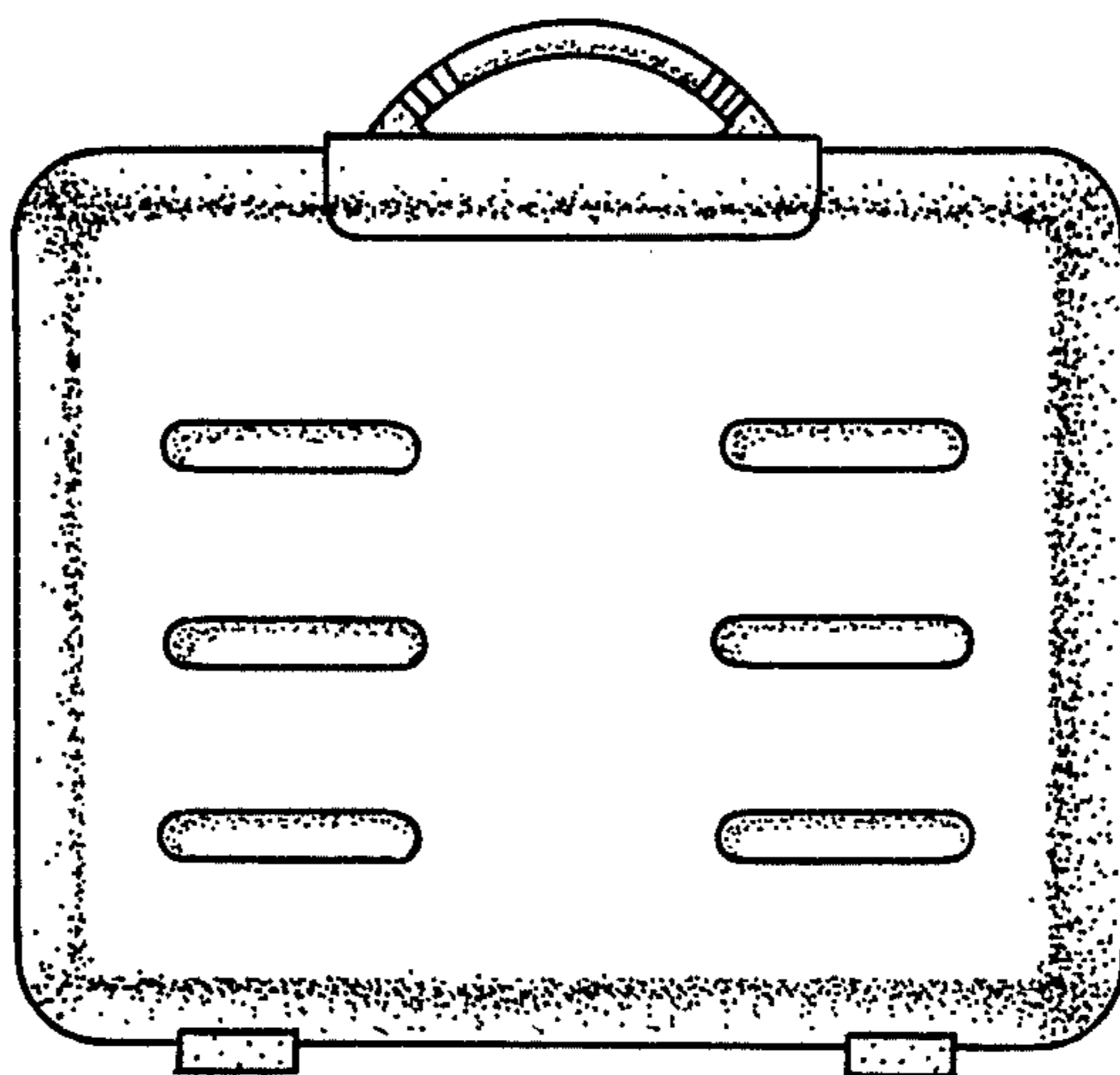

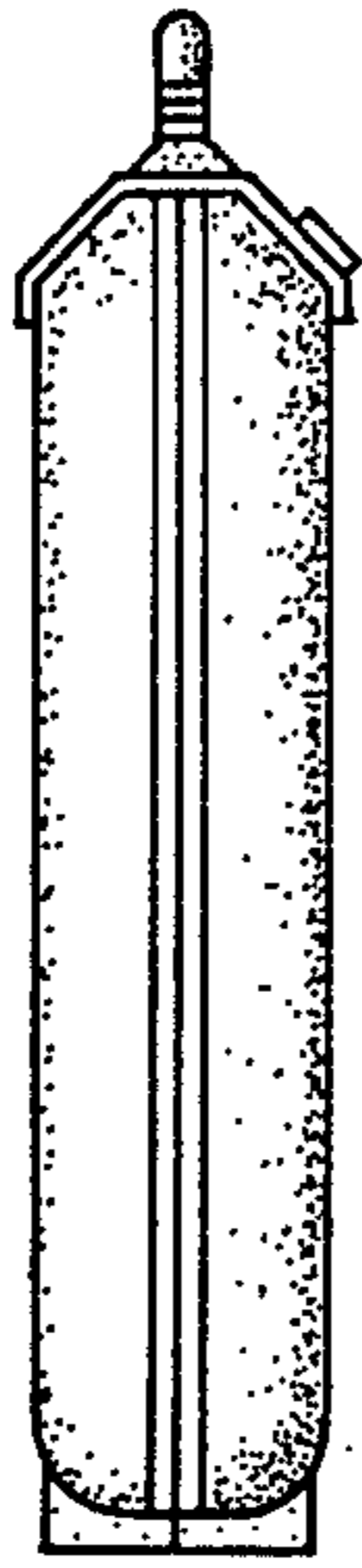

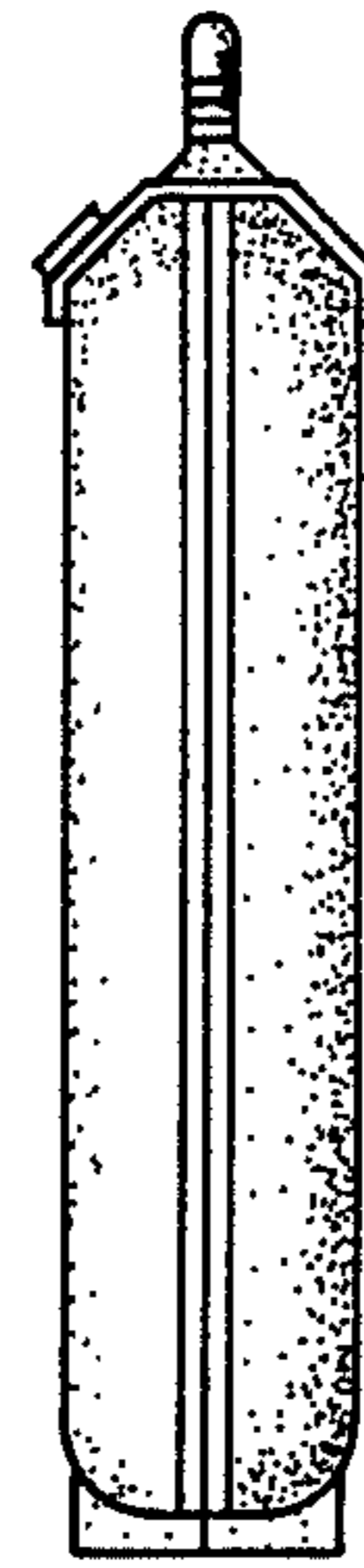

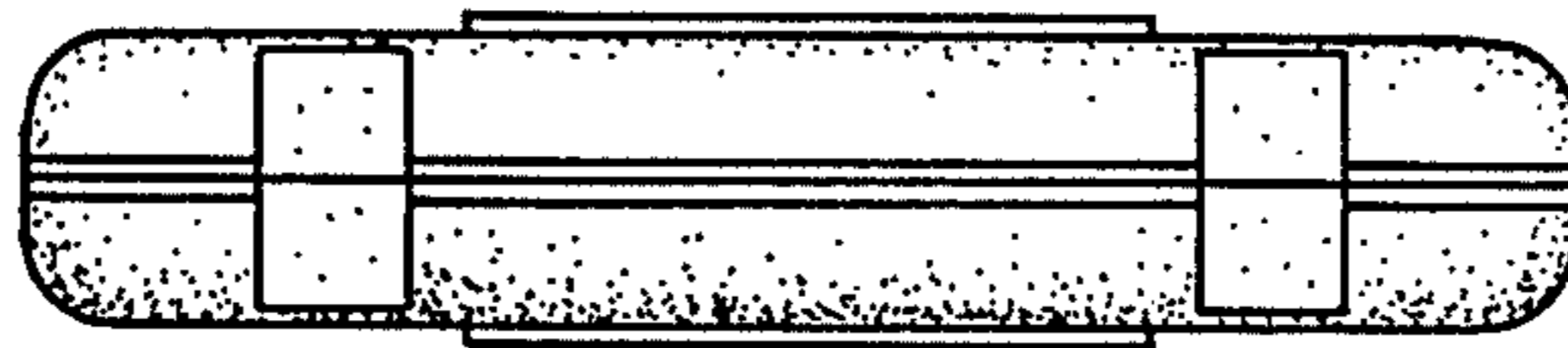

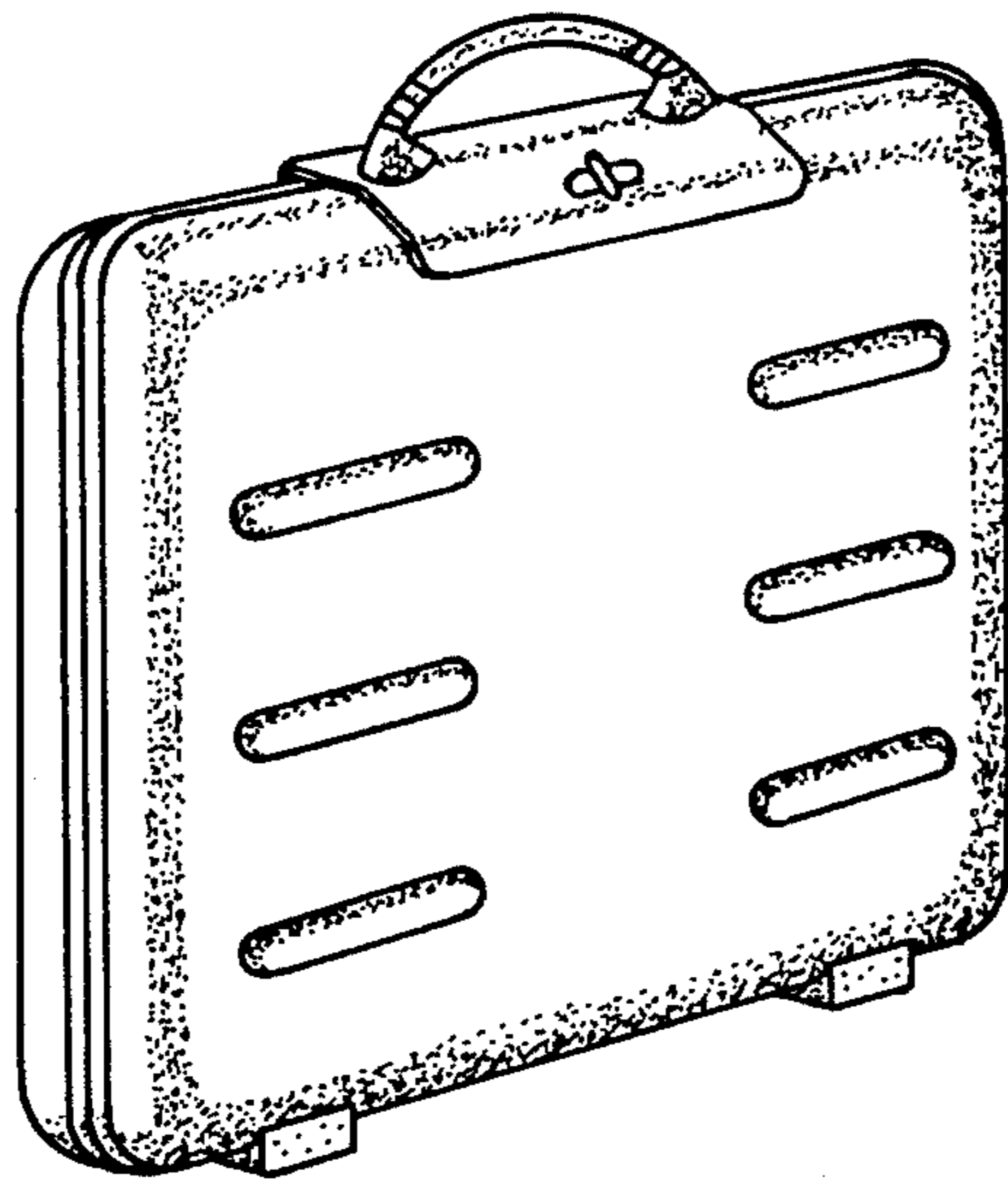

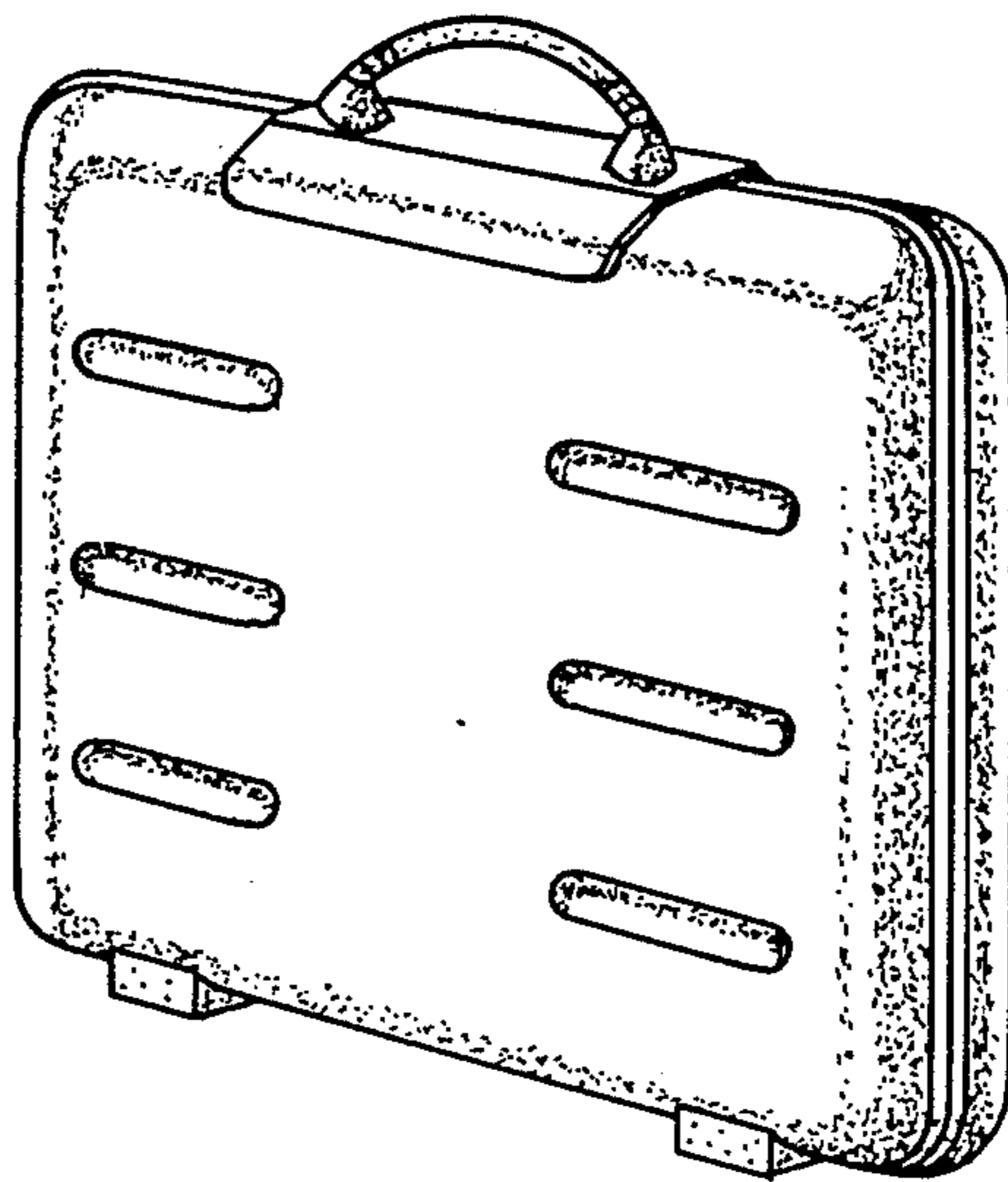
