DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a compact enclosure for personal computers showing my new design.

FIG. 6 is a back side elevational view thereof.

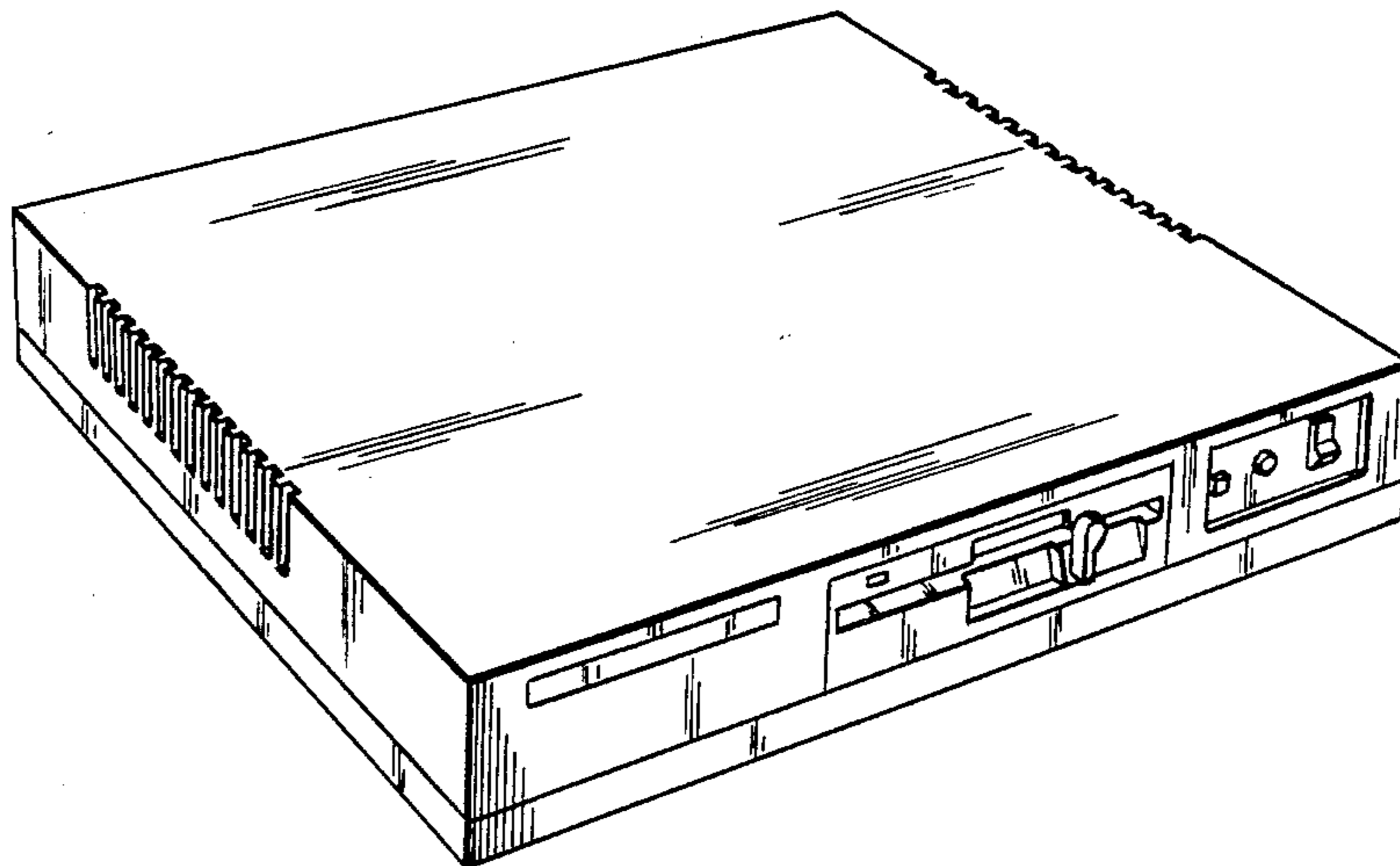

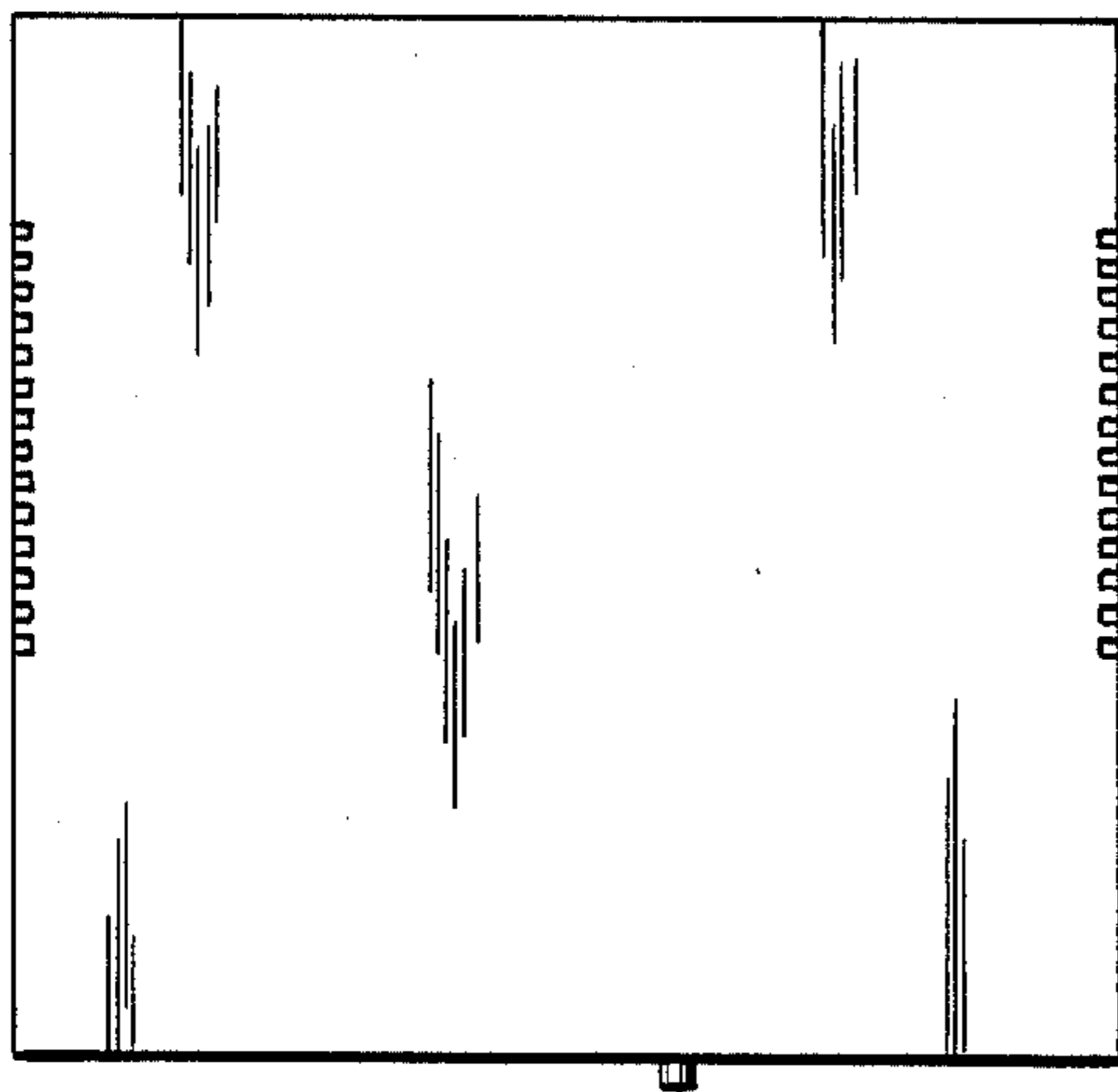
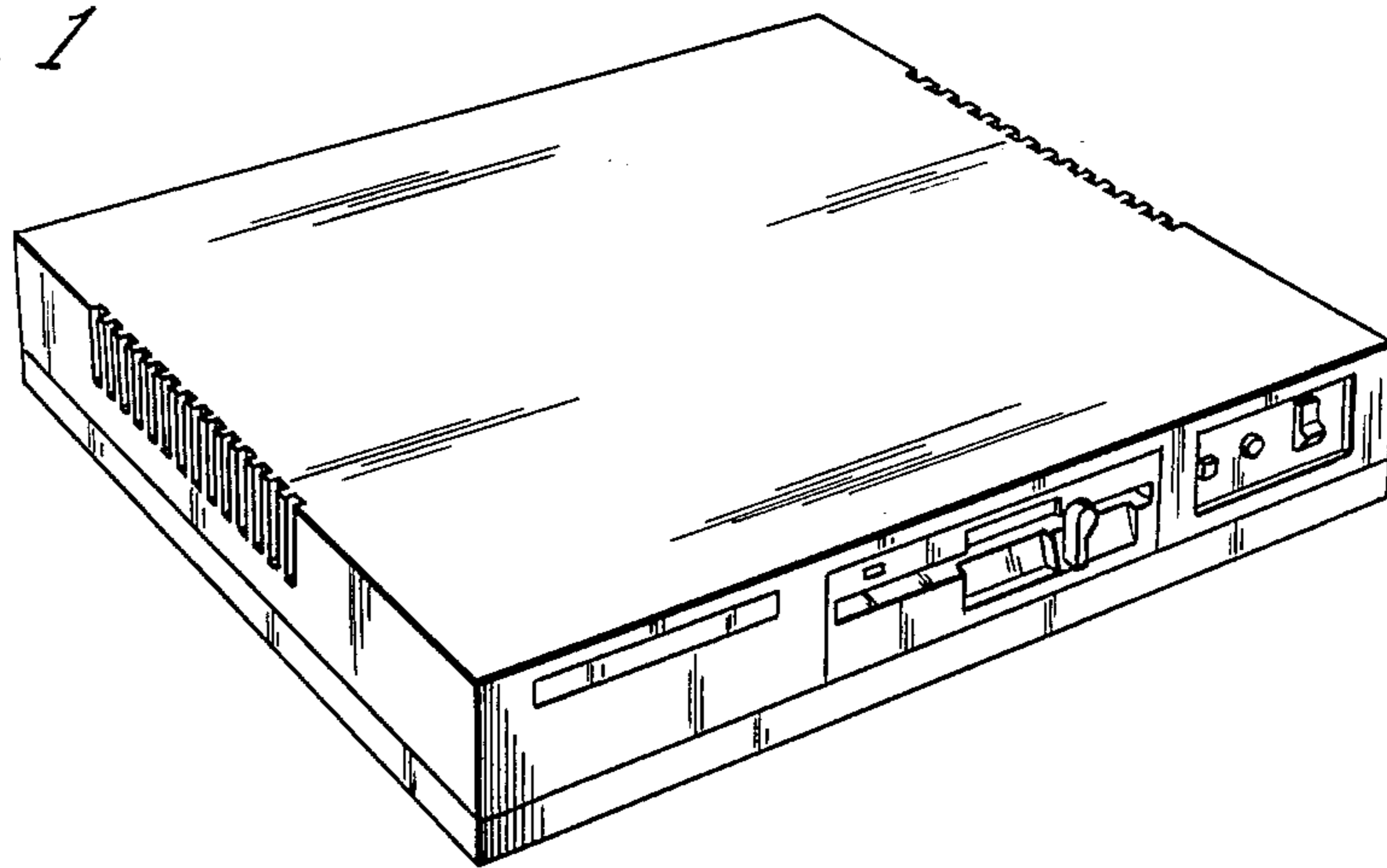

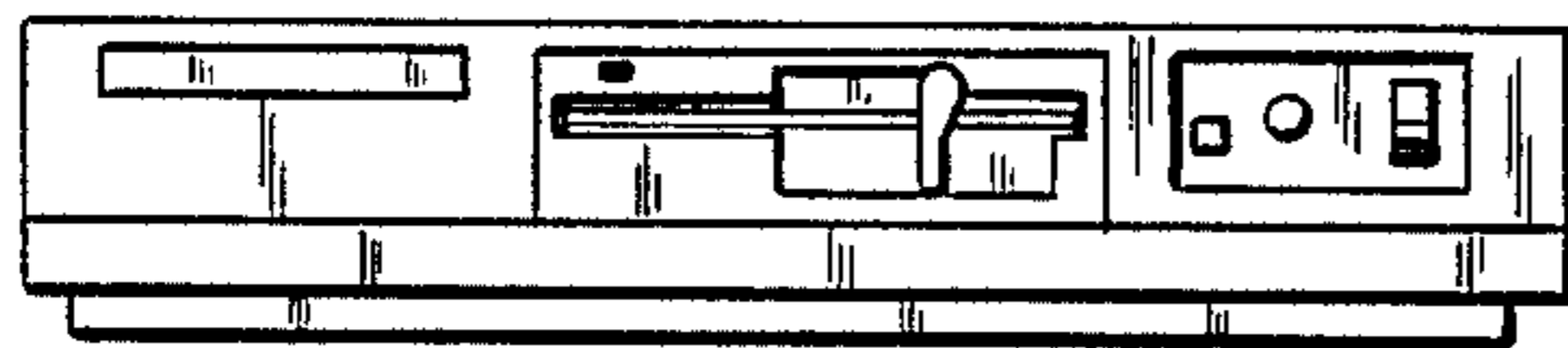

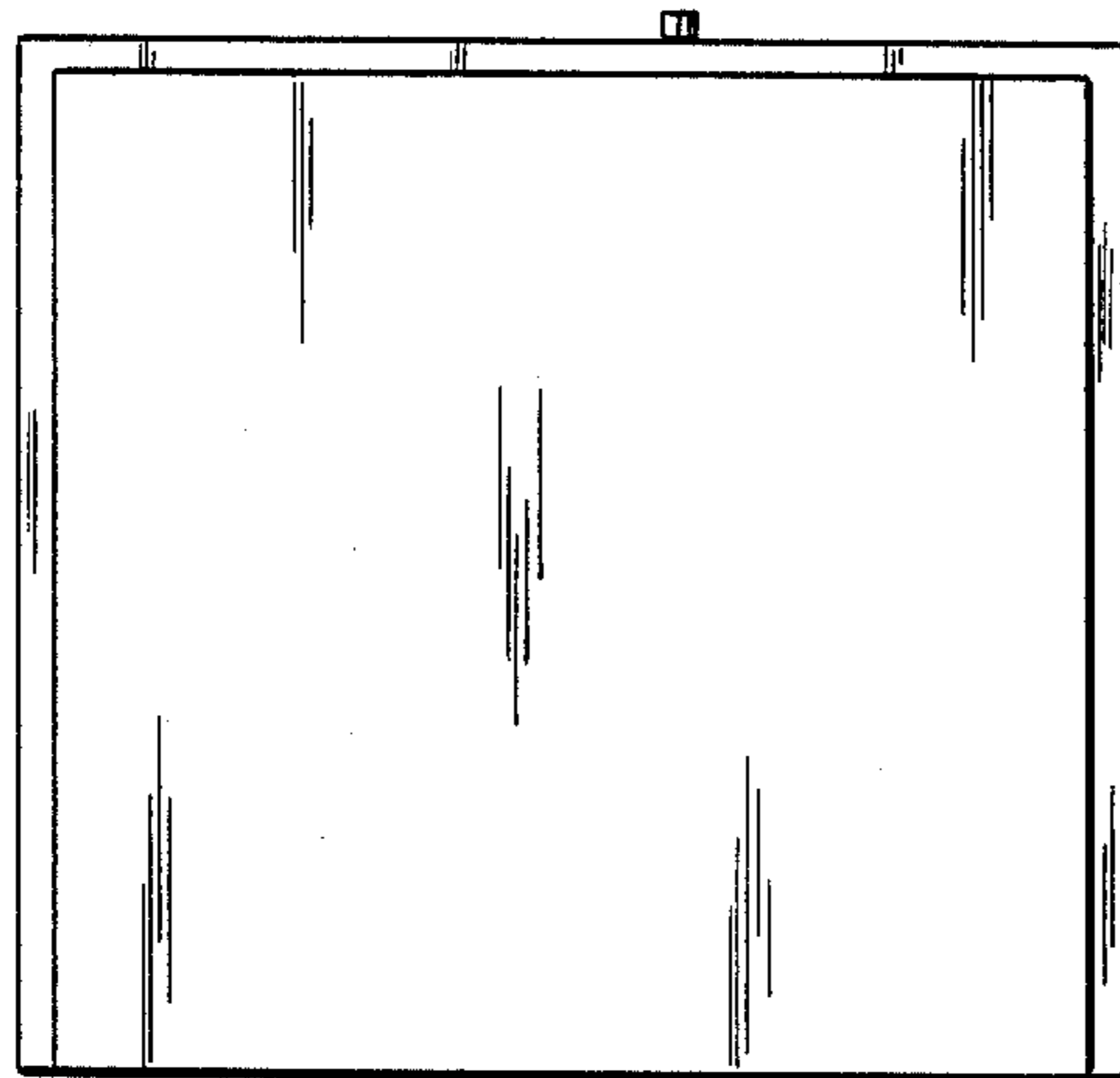

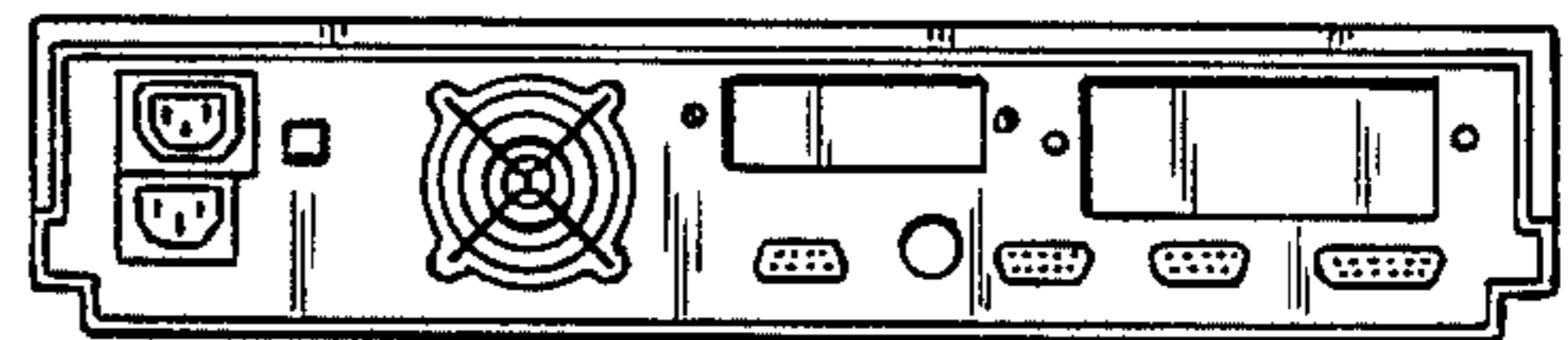
