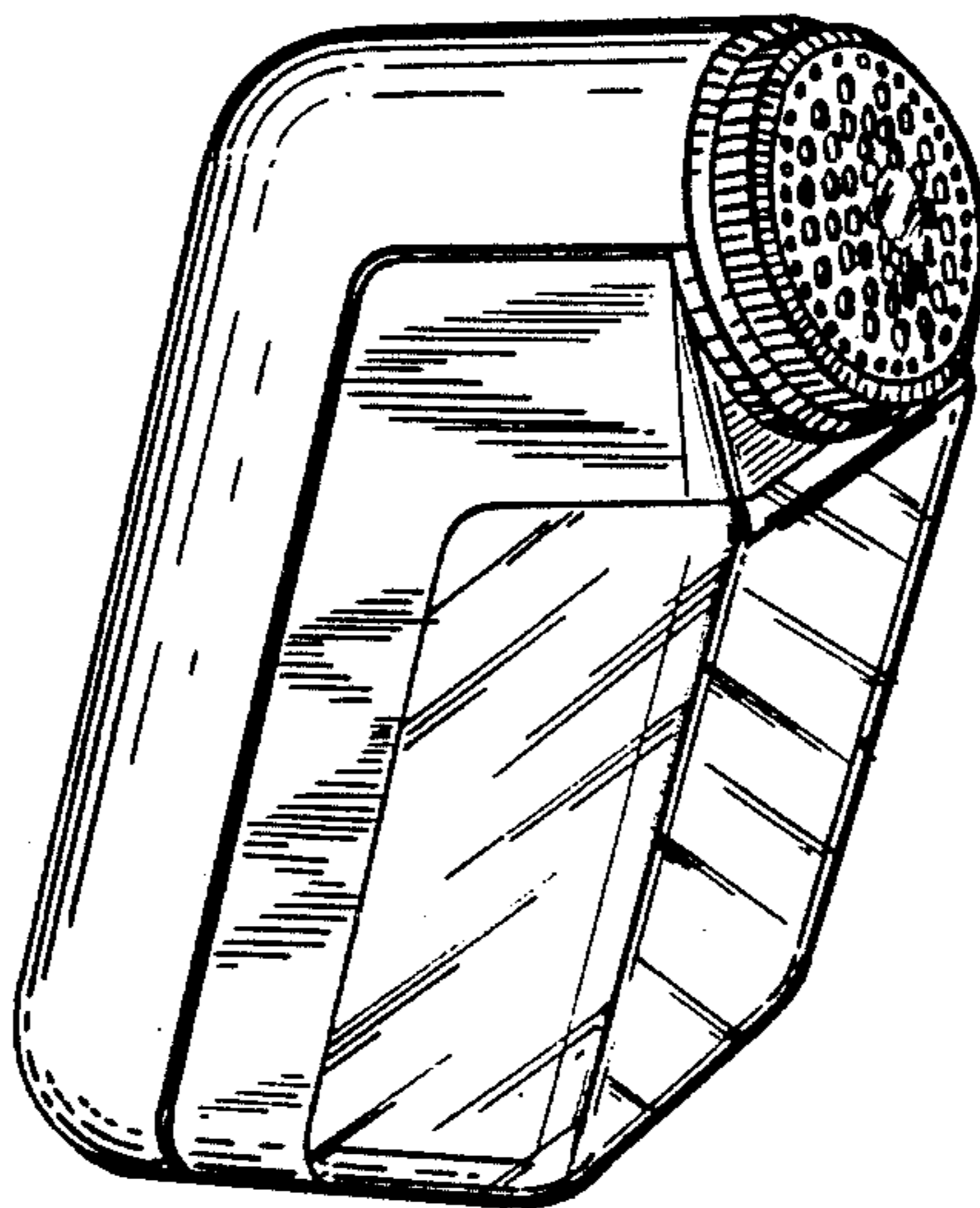

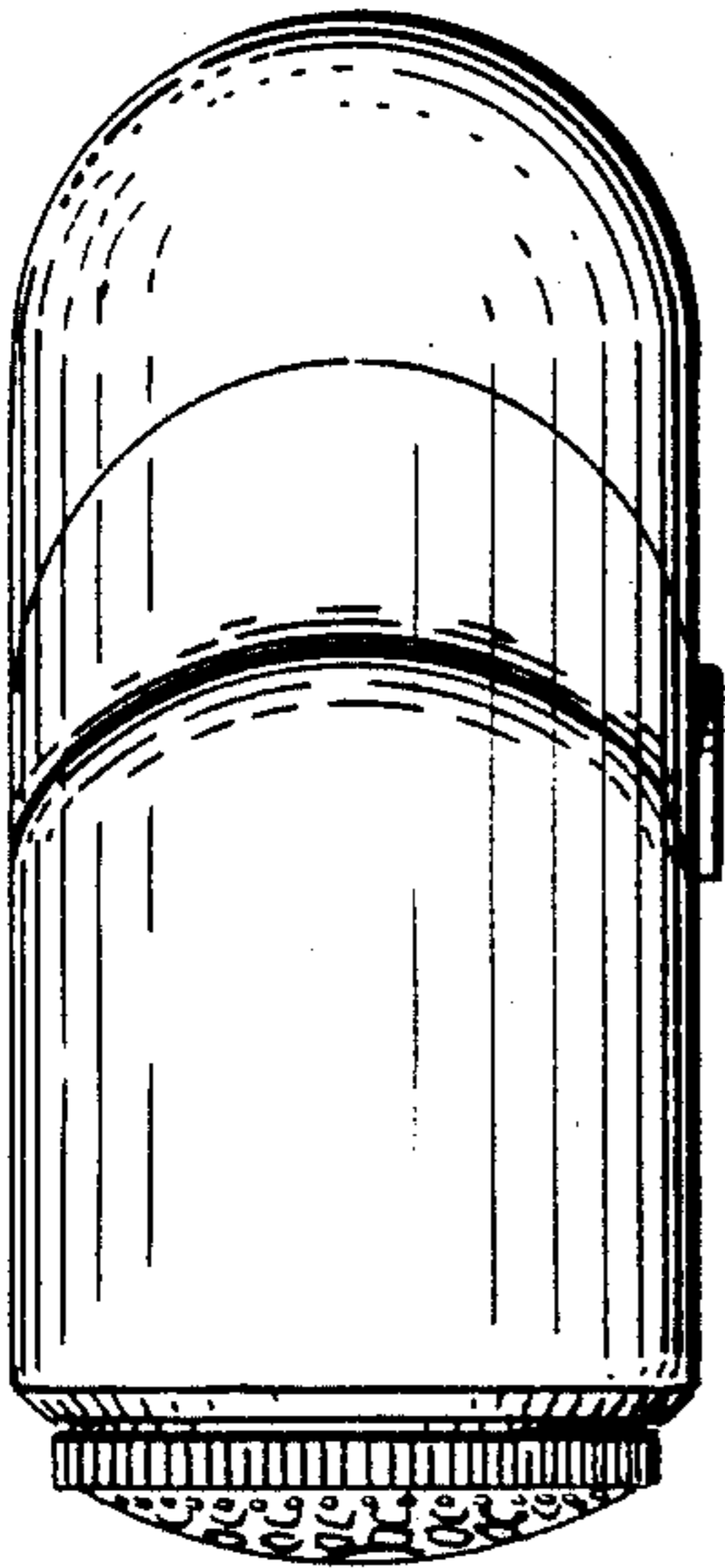
The ornamental design for a lint remover, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

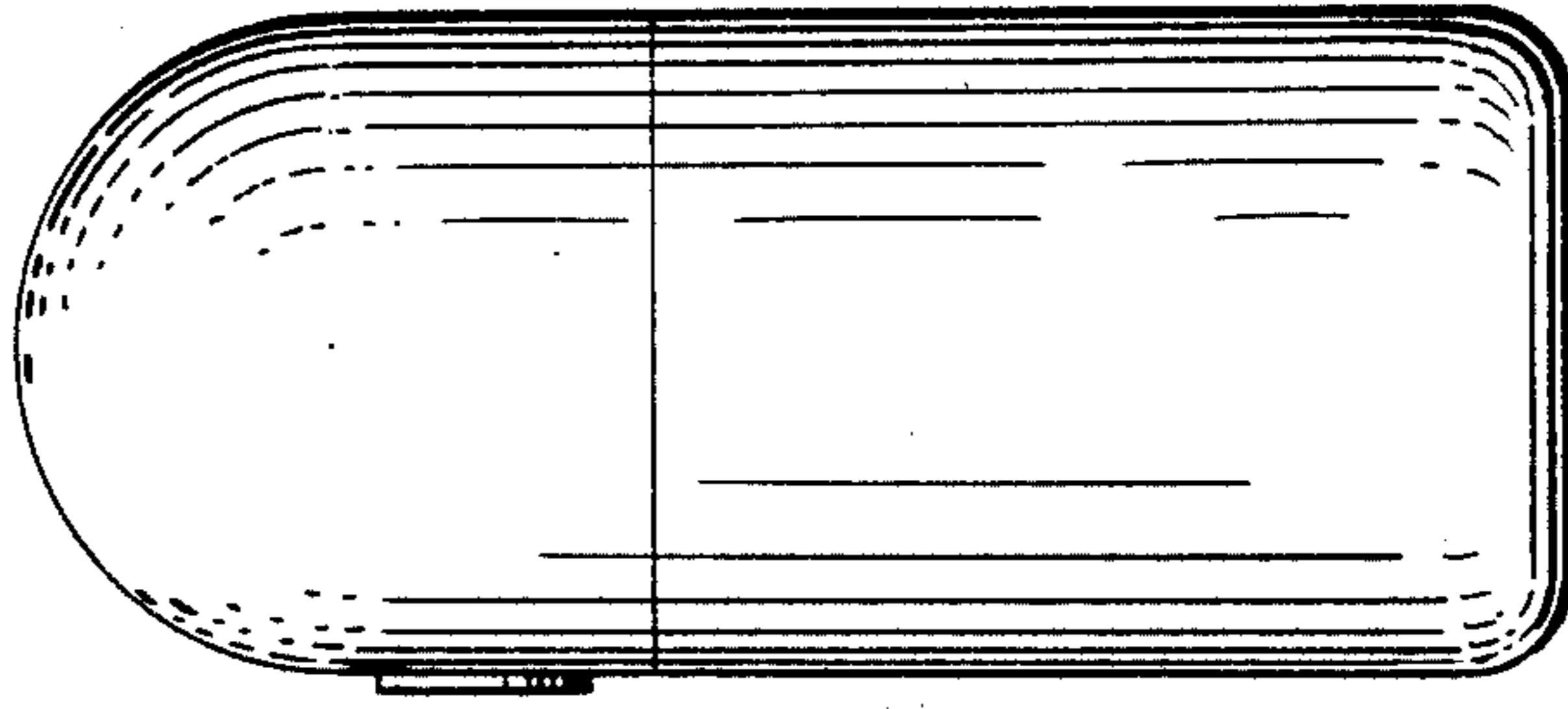
FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a lint remover showing my new design;

 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

 The lint remover is shown with the head guard removed in FIGS. 1-6 for clarity of illustration.



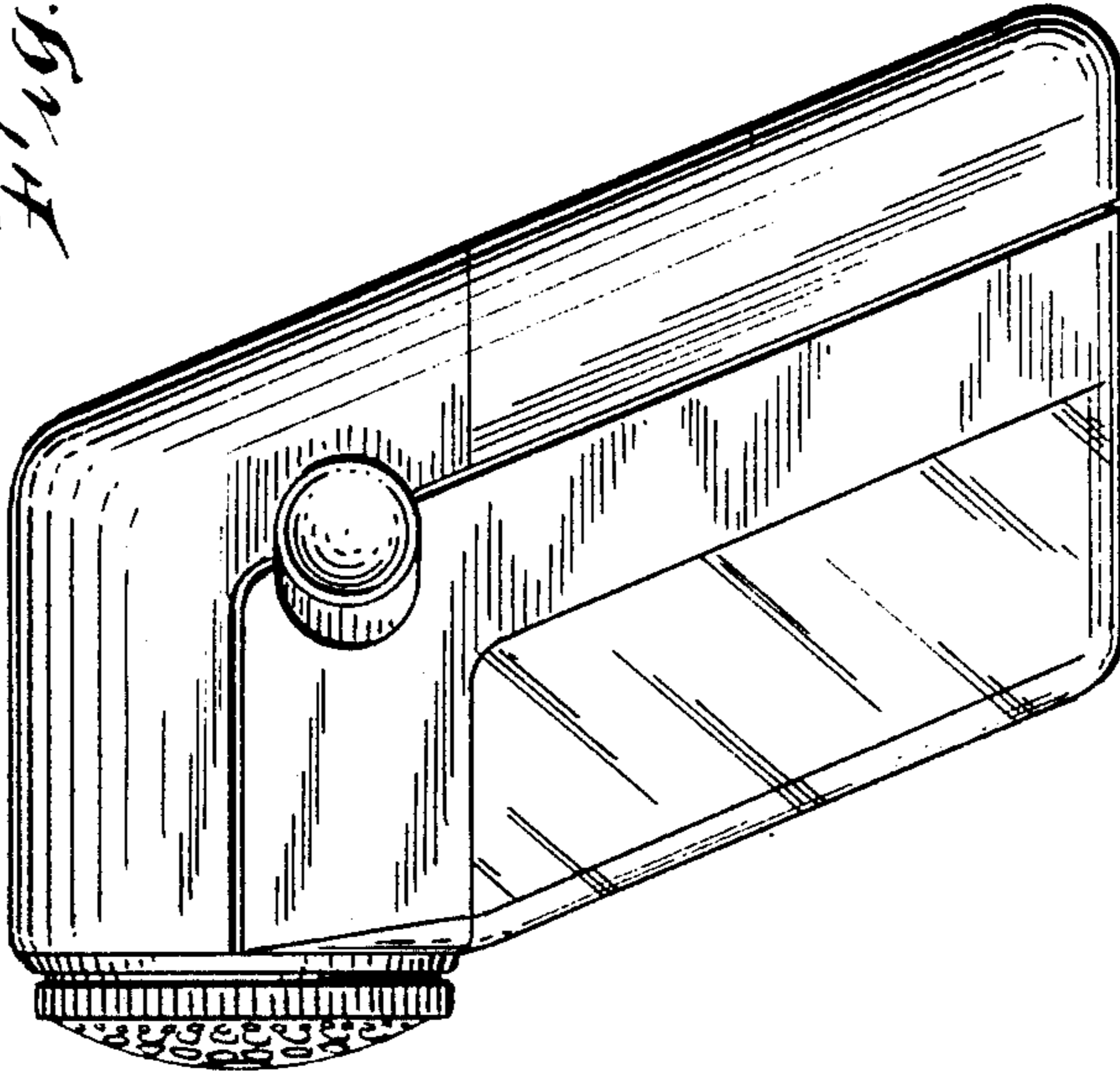

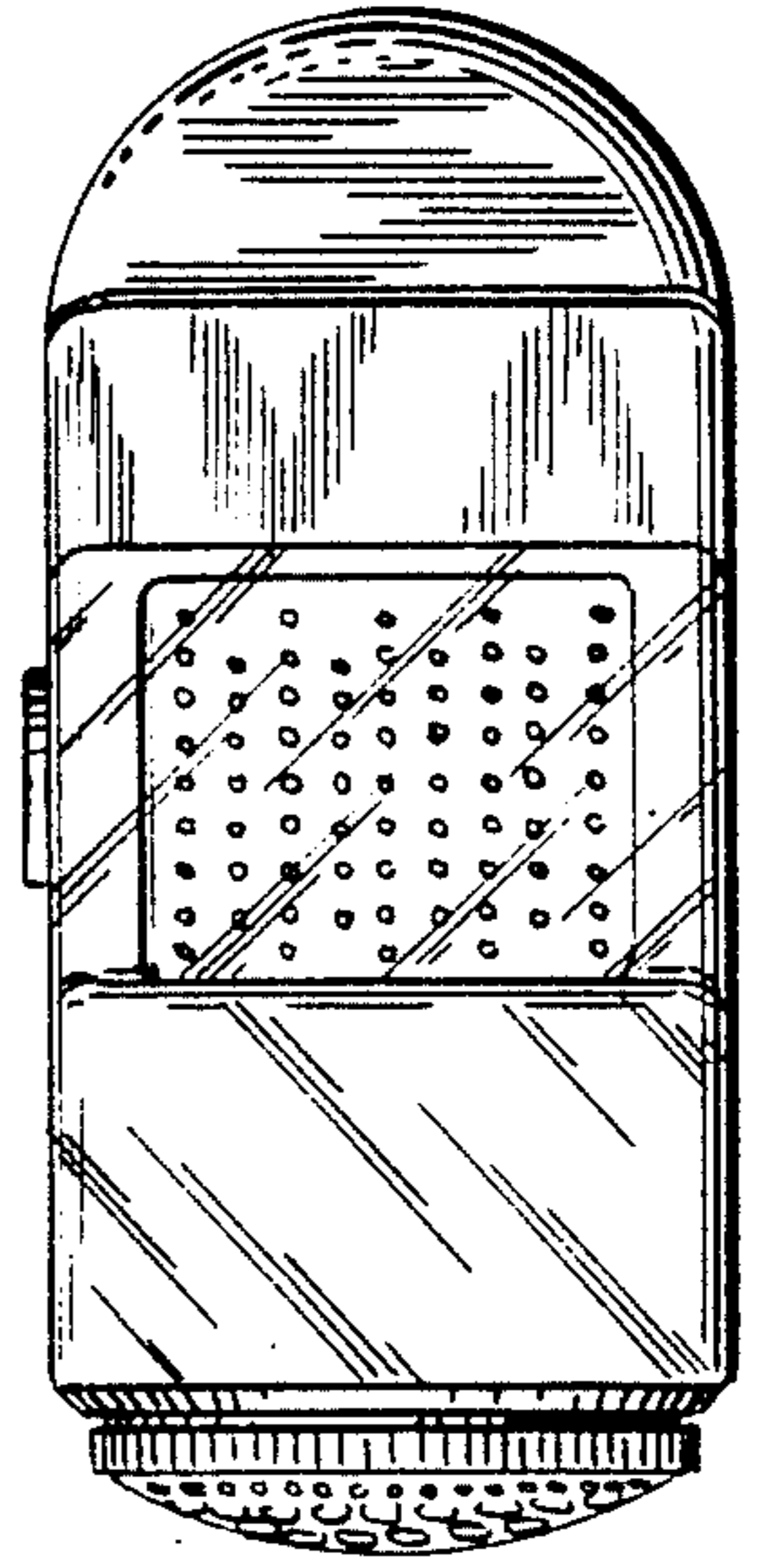

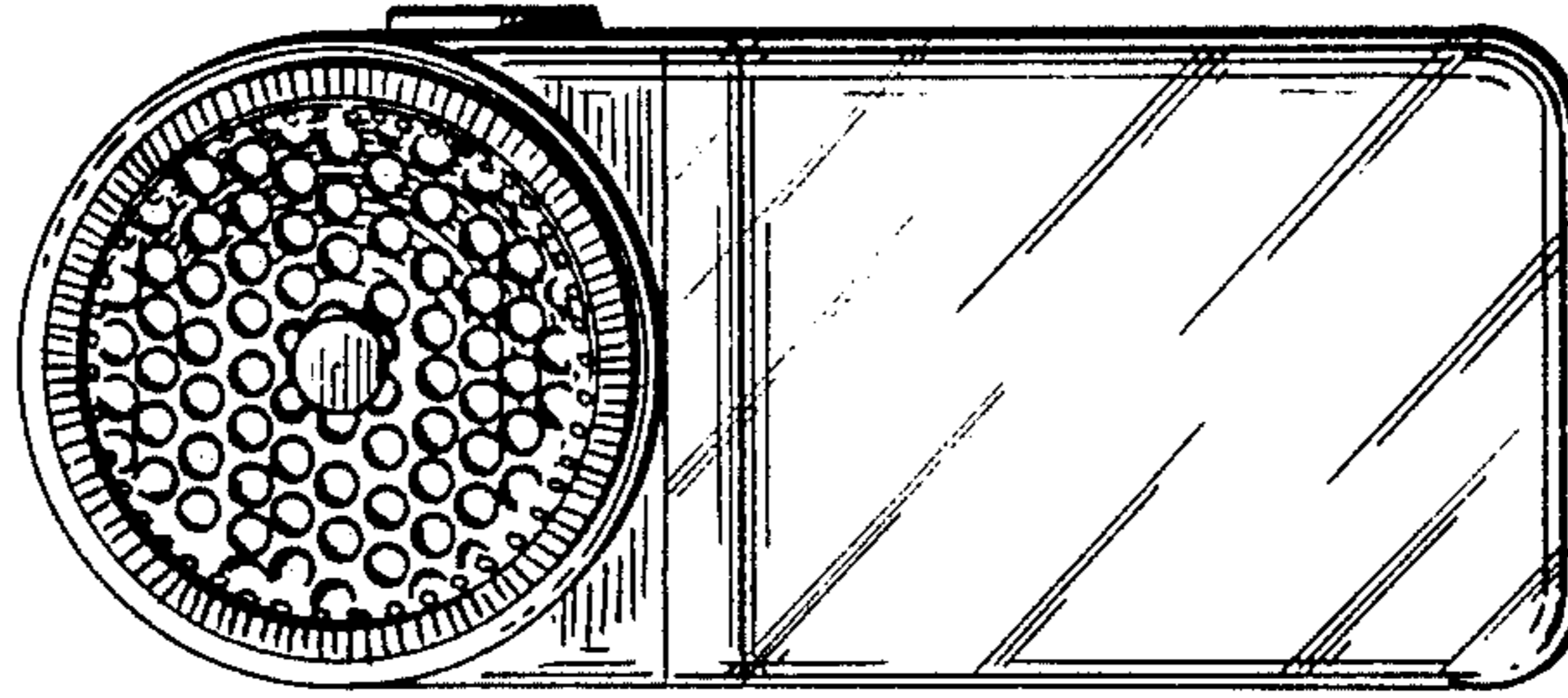

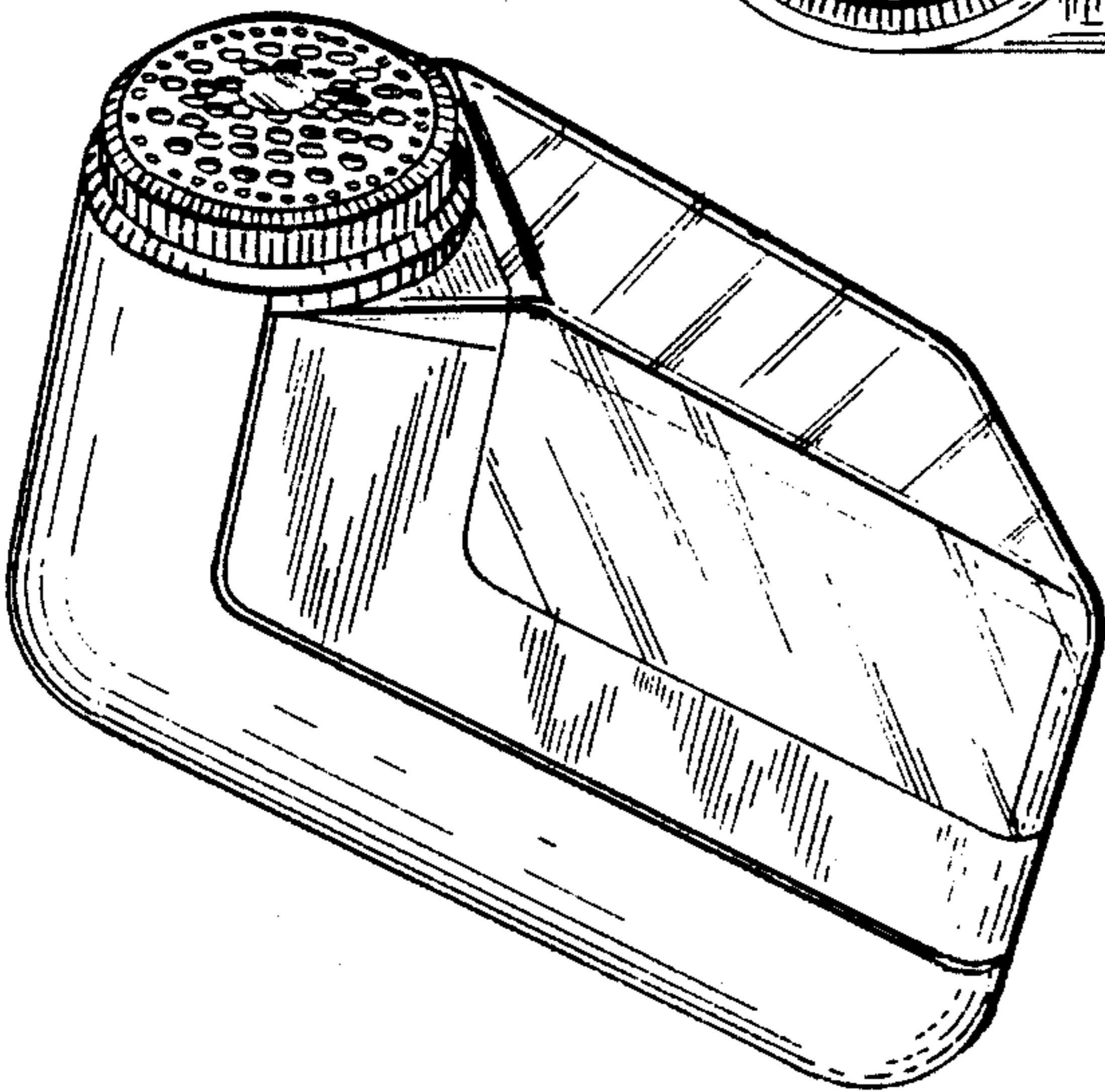

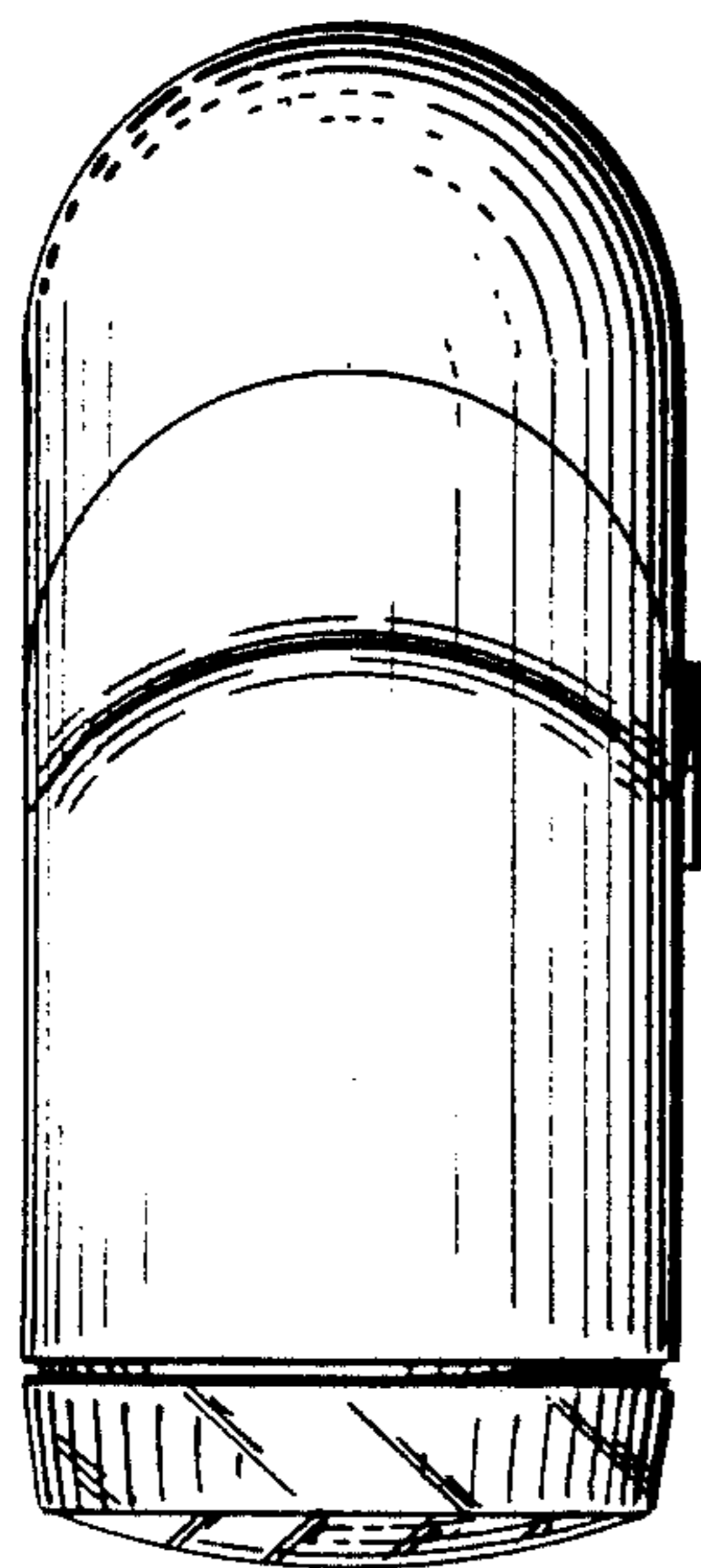

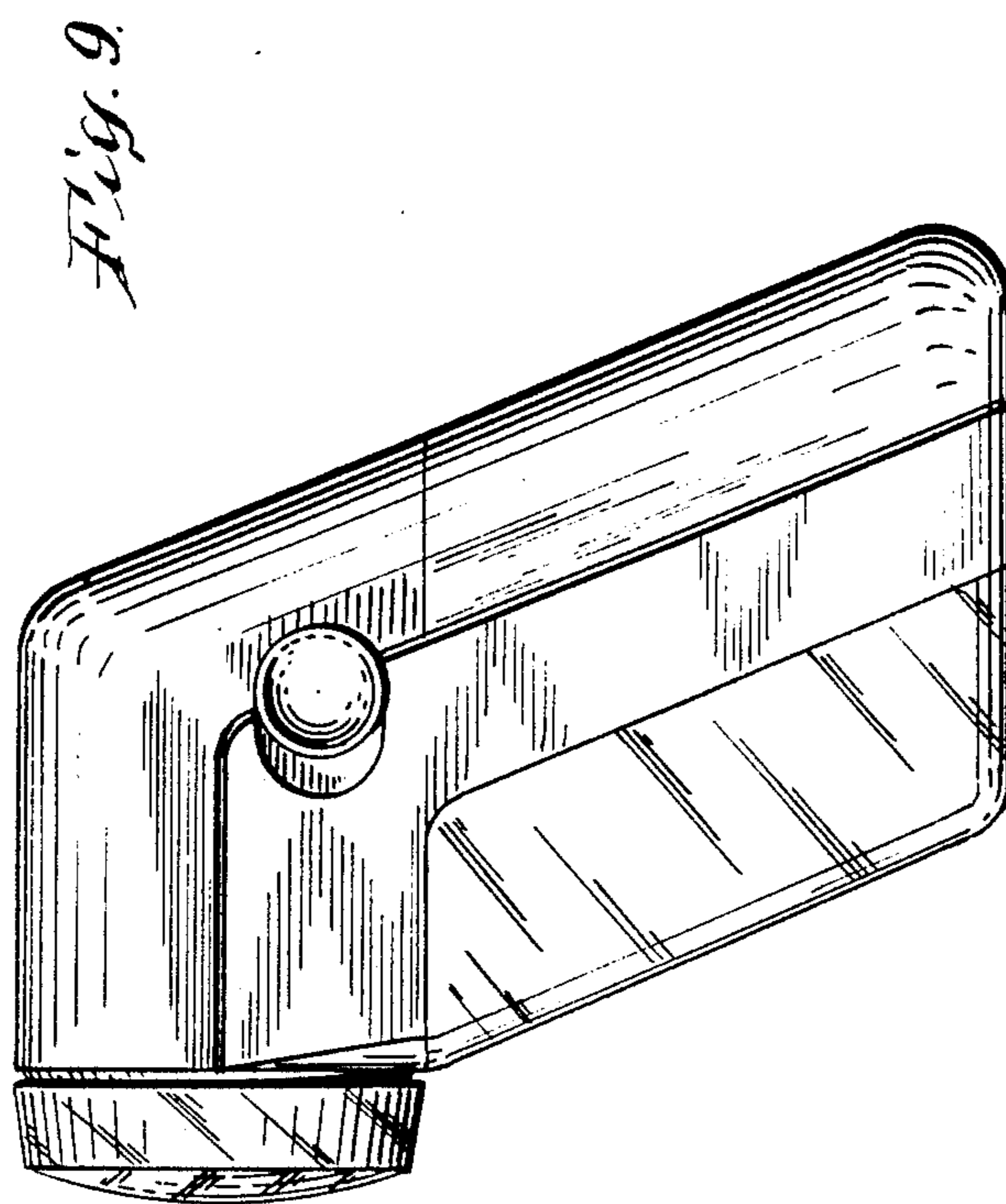

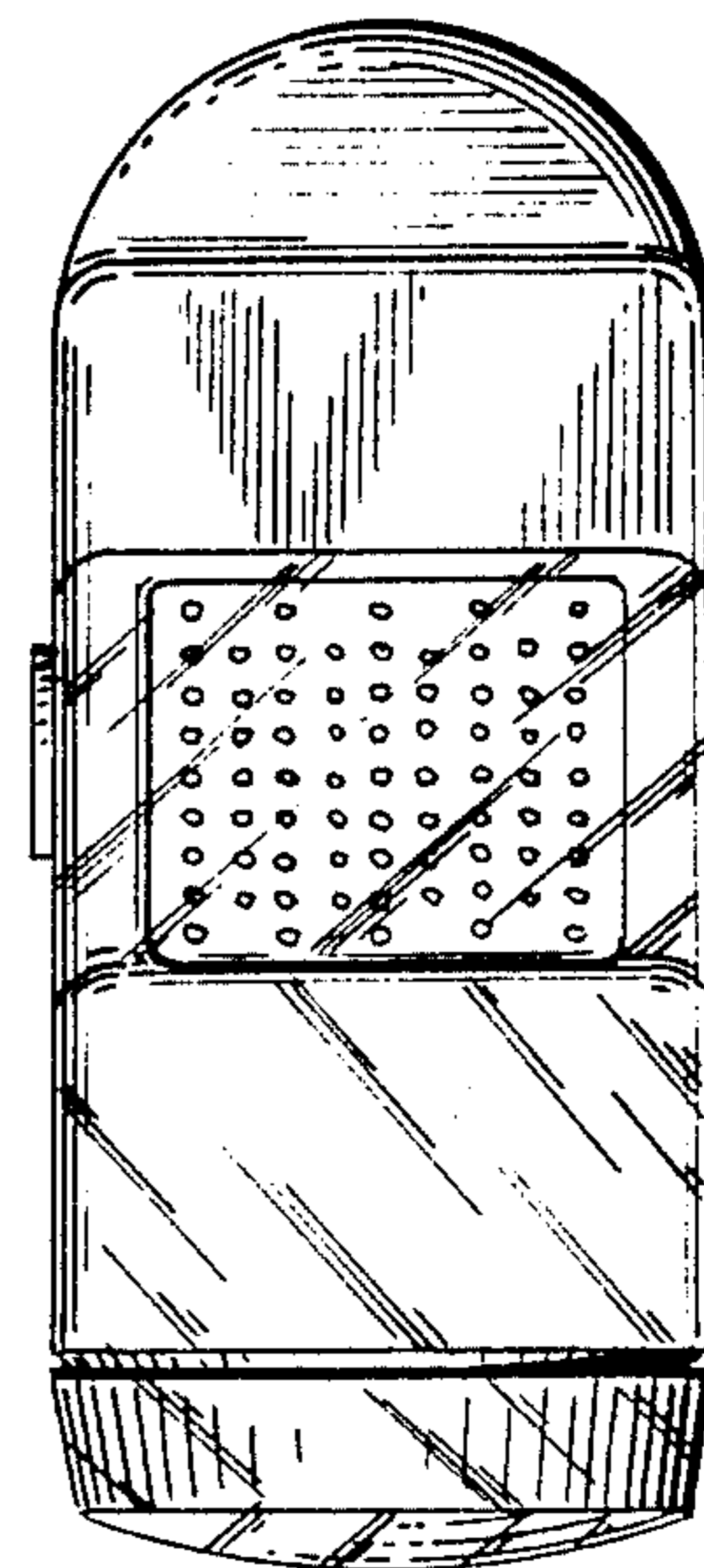

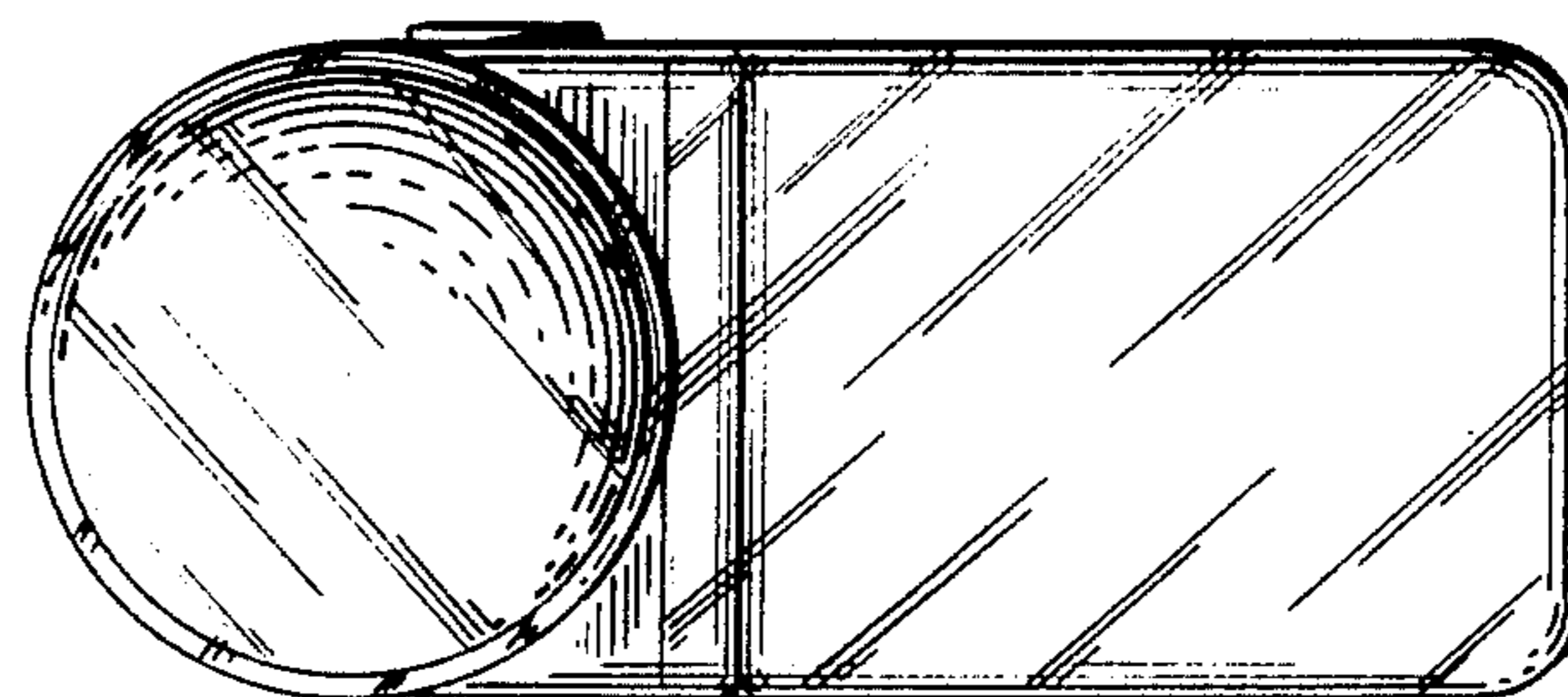
