[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a portable receptacle for accommodating rigid refuse bags, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portable receptacle for accommodating rigid refuse bags showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevation thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear side elevation thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 8 is a right side elevation thereof, similar to FIG. 3 with a refuse bag.

The broken lines in FIG. 8 showing of refuse bag is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

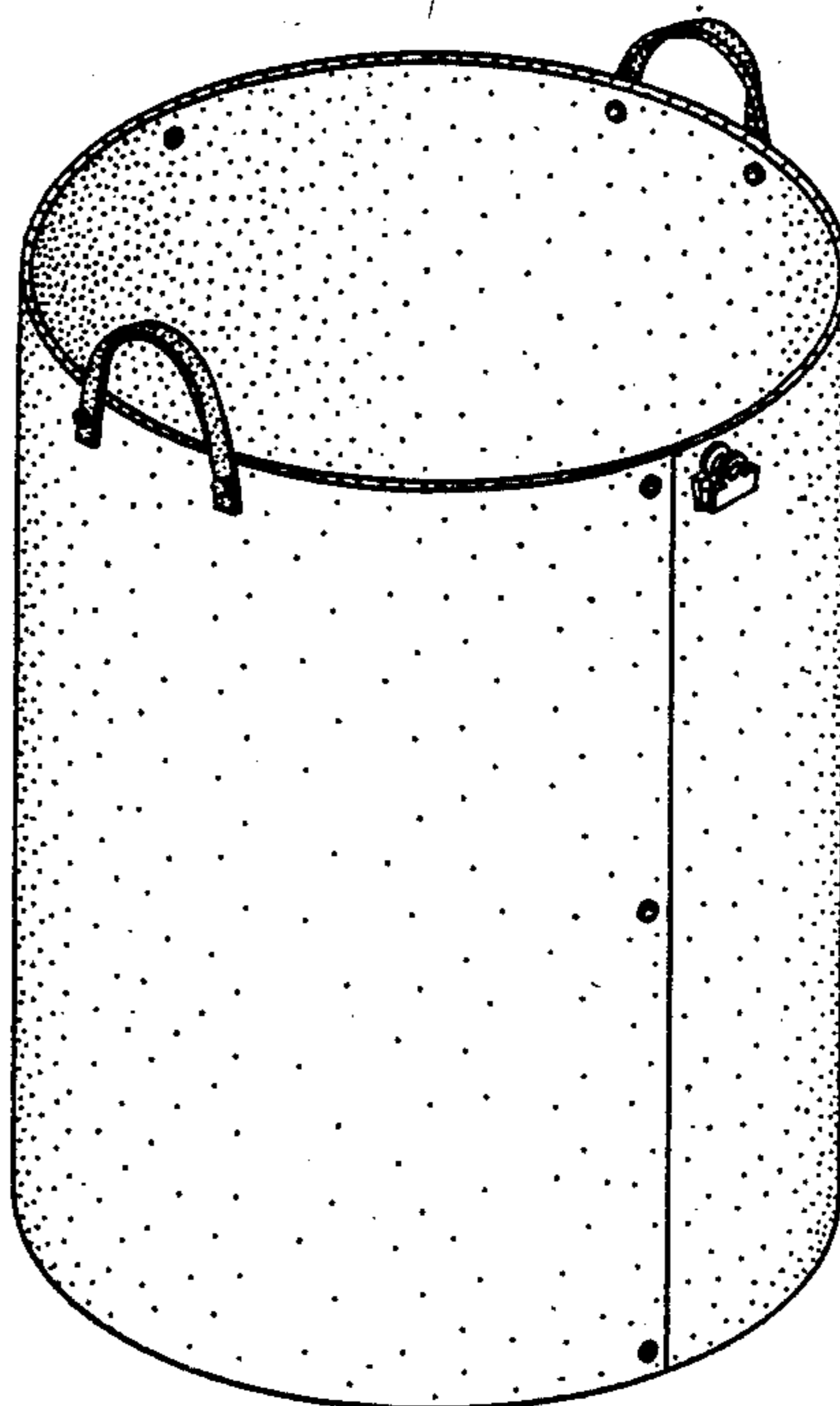

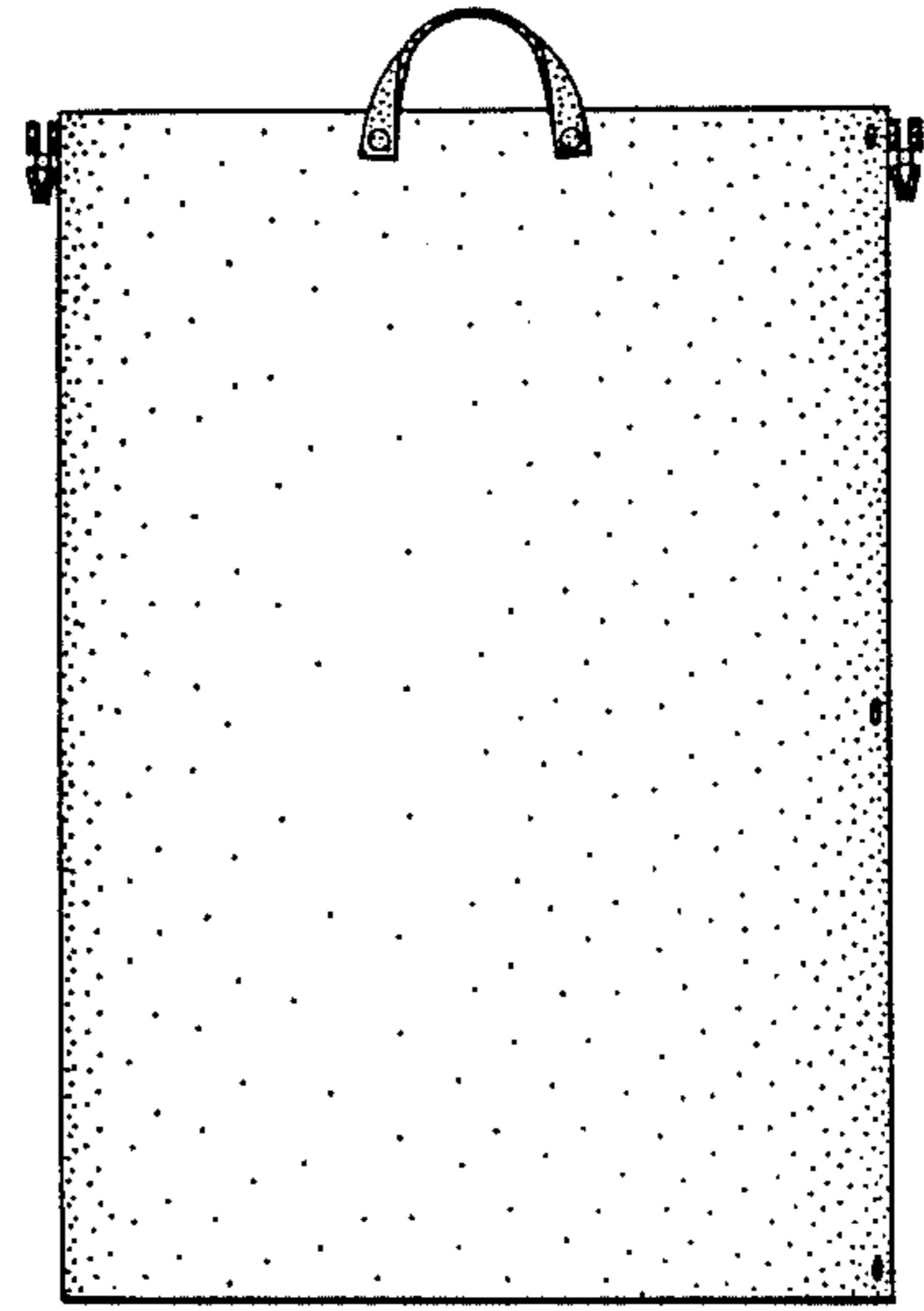
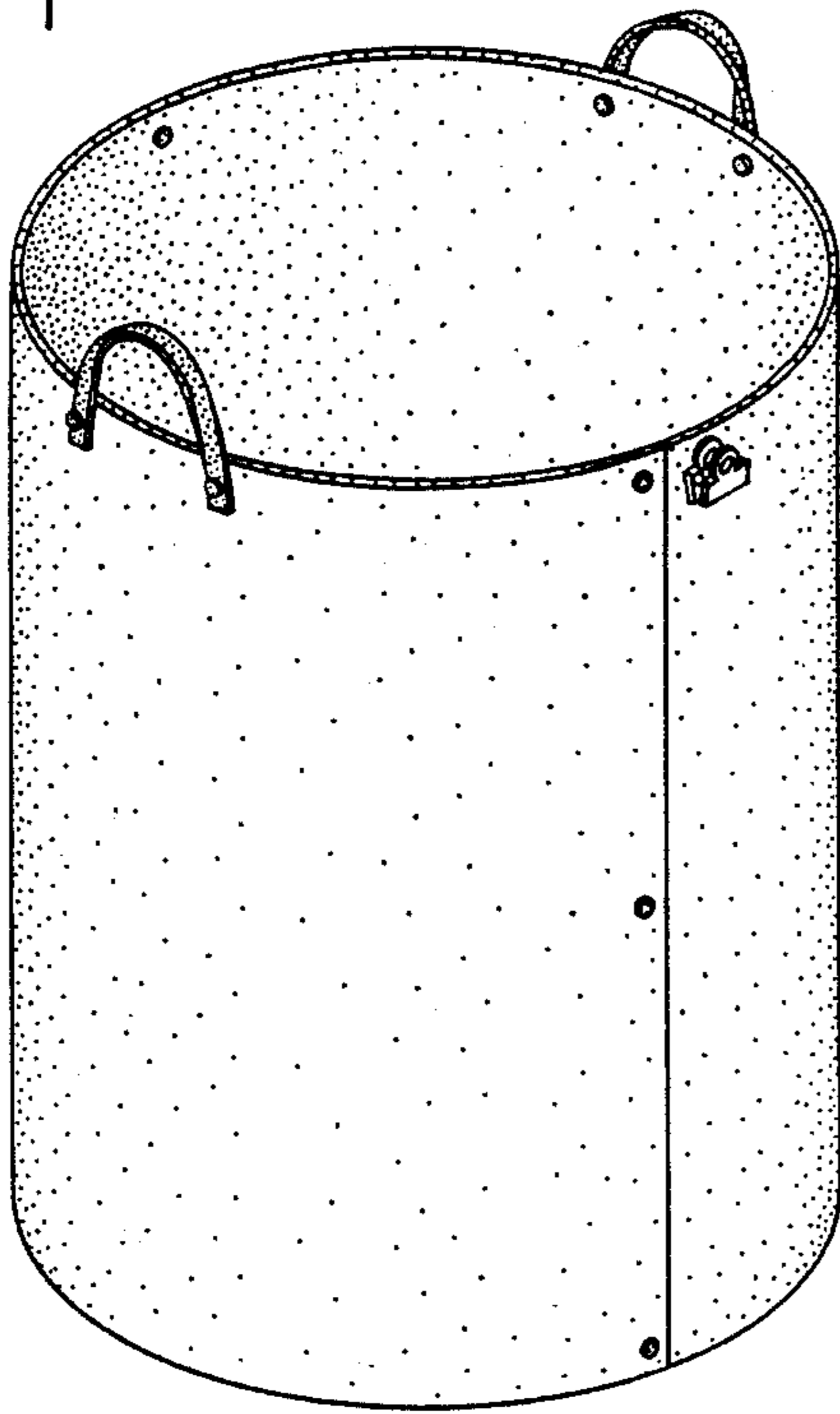

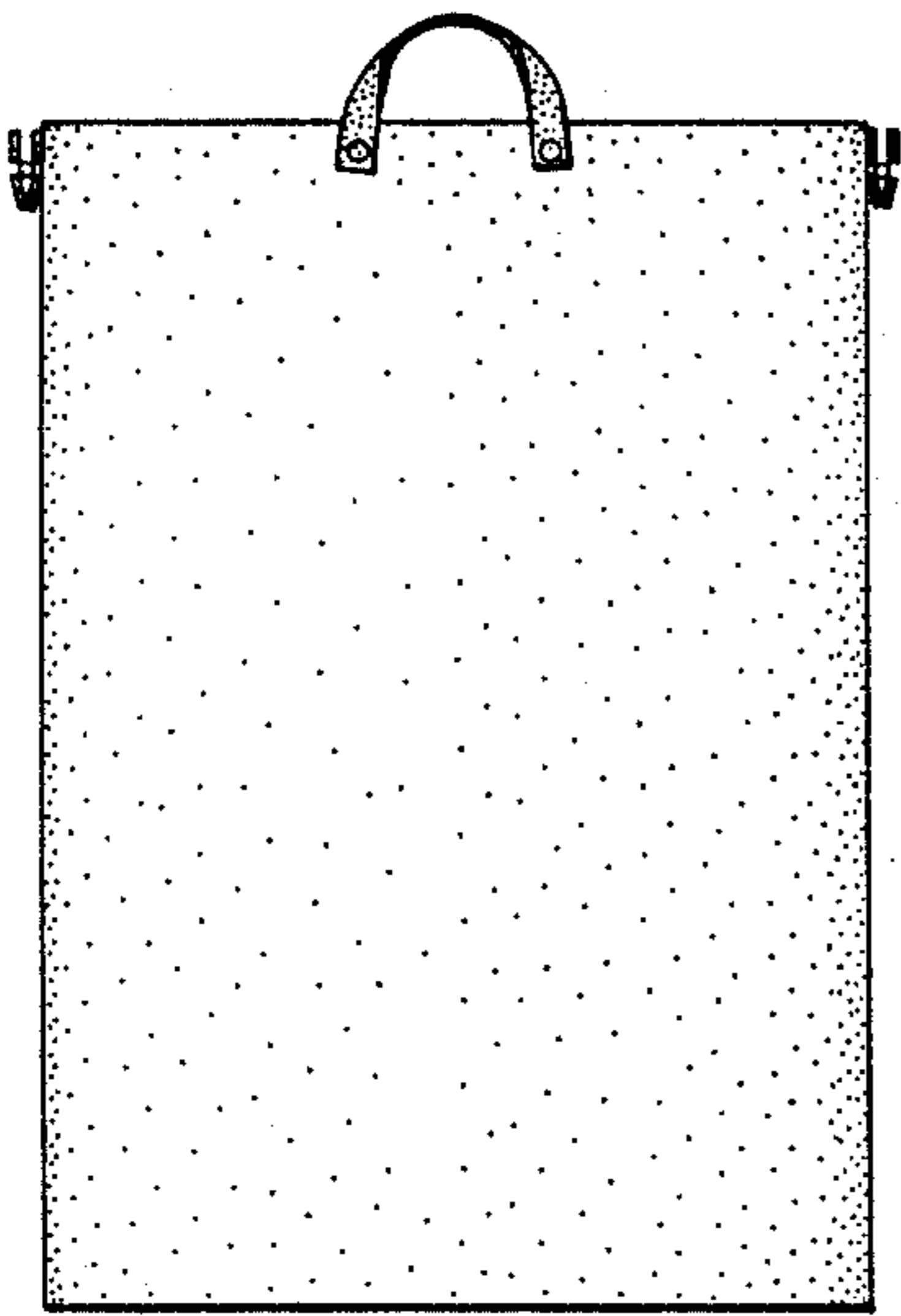

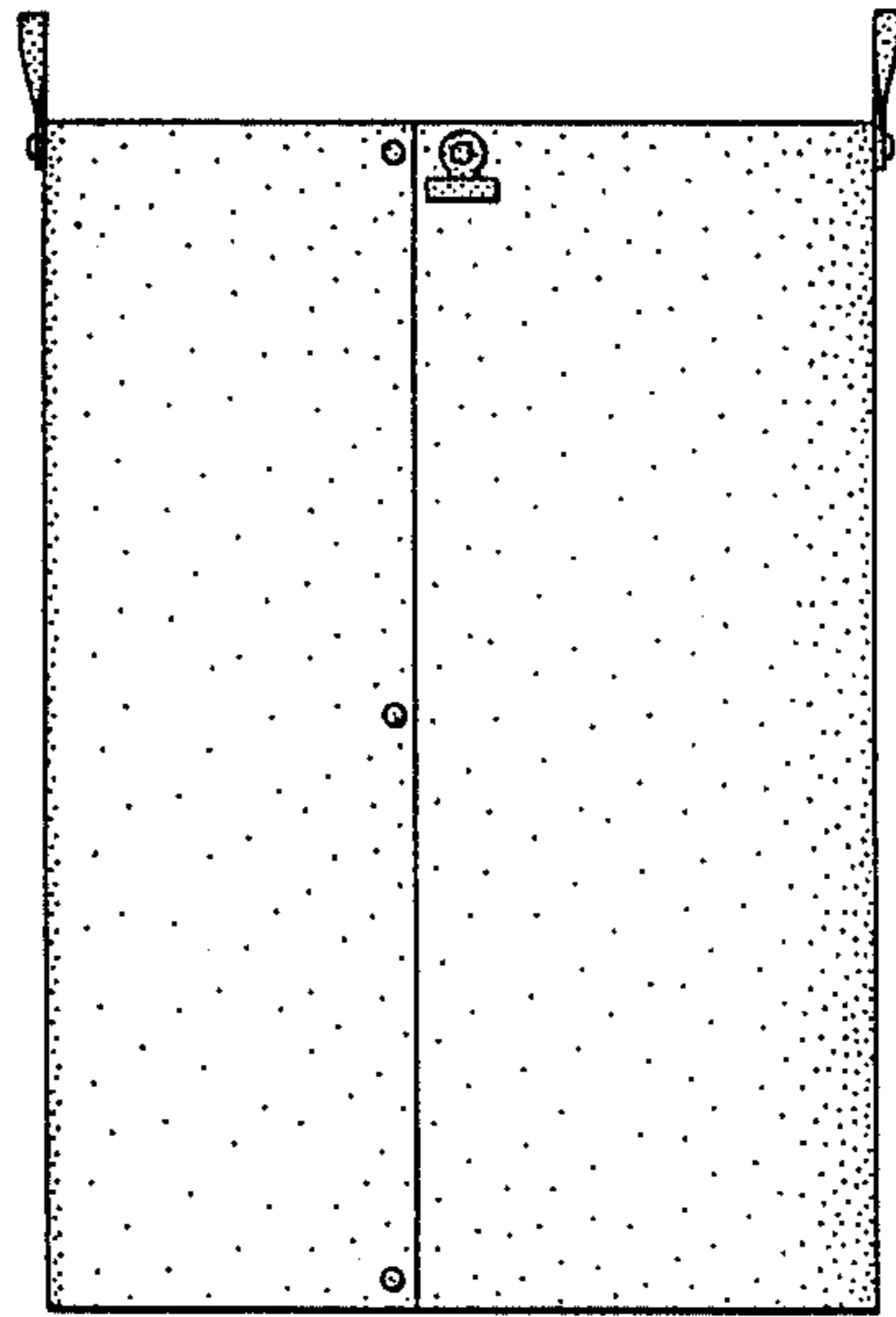

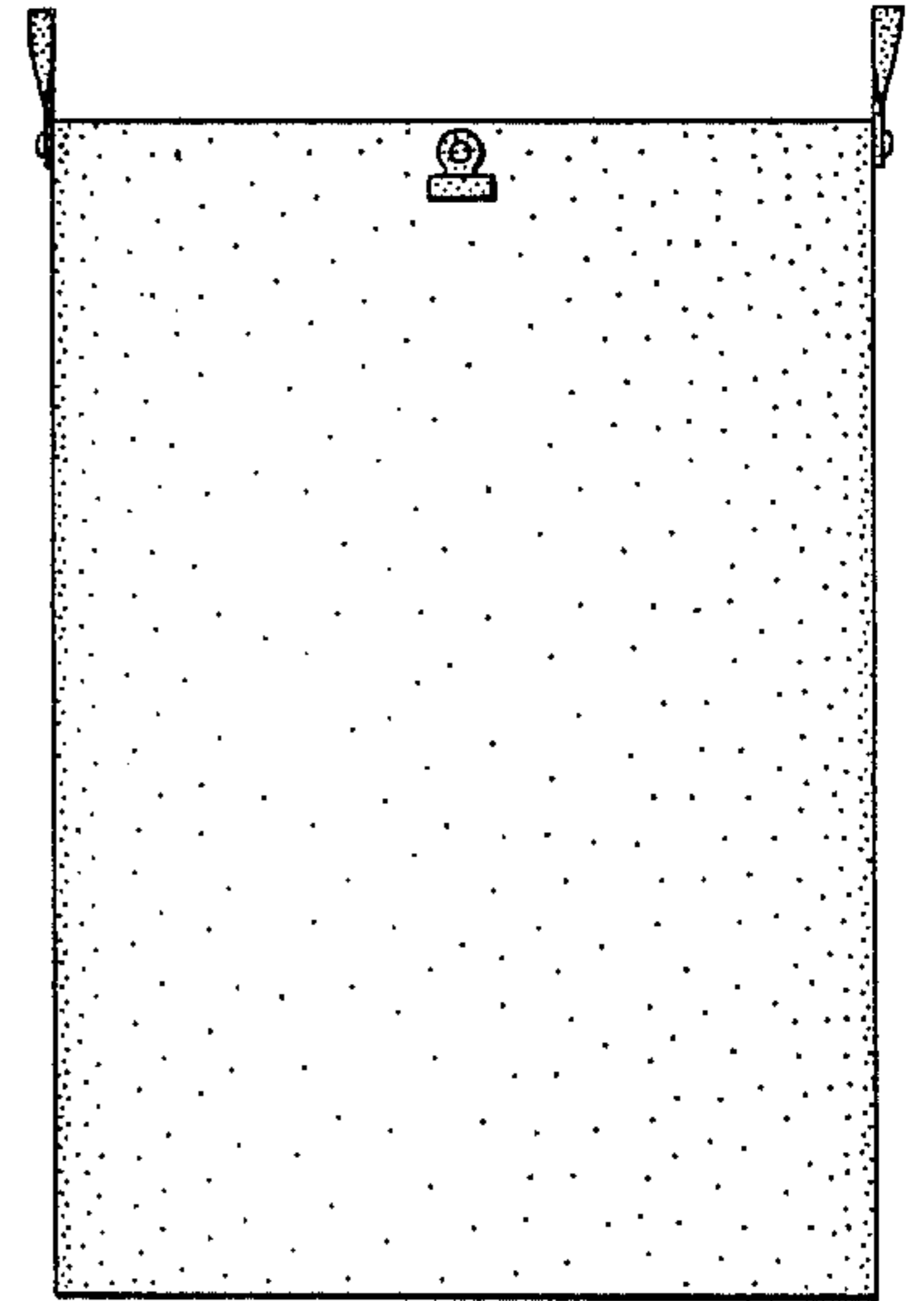

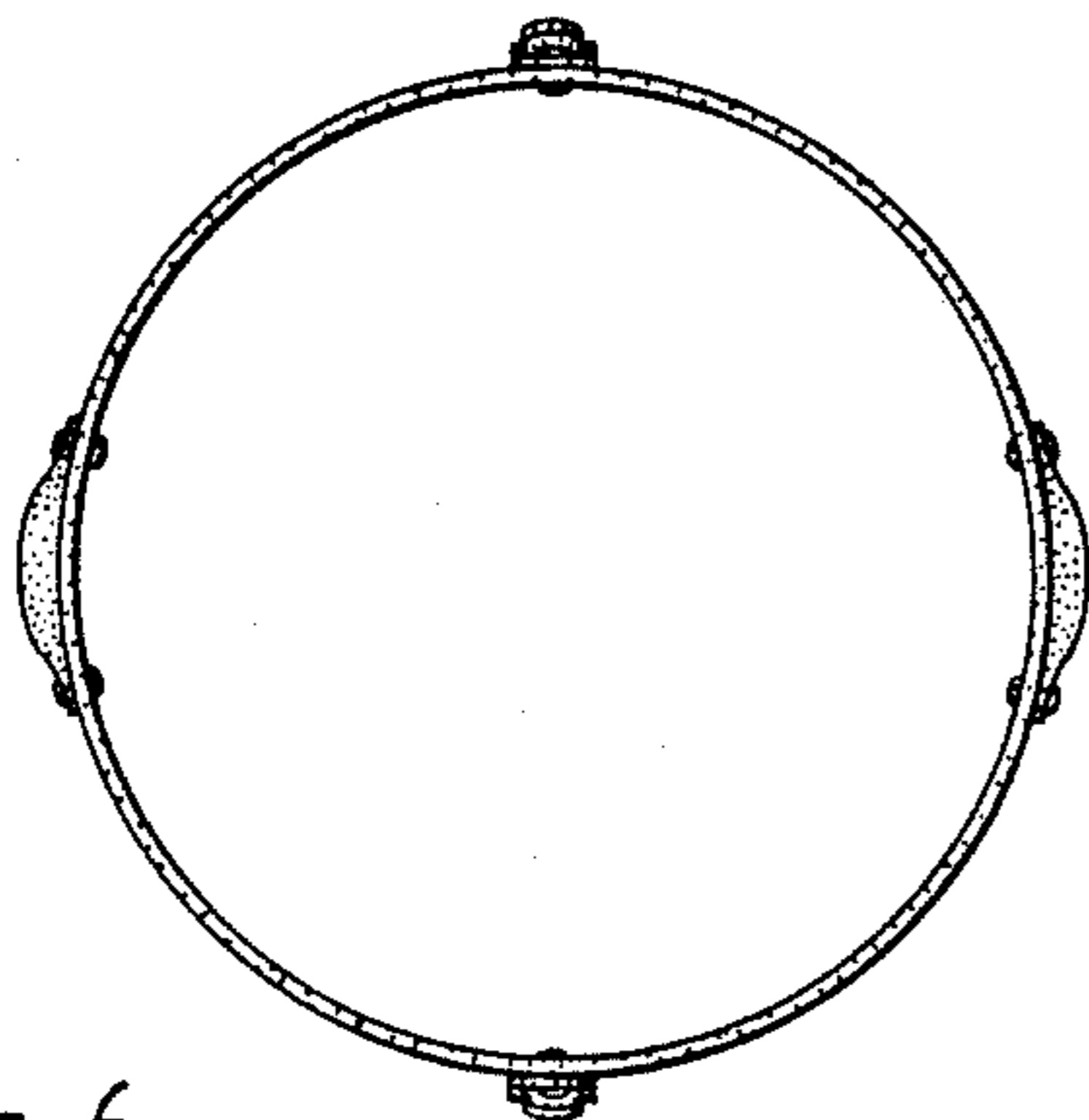

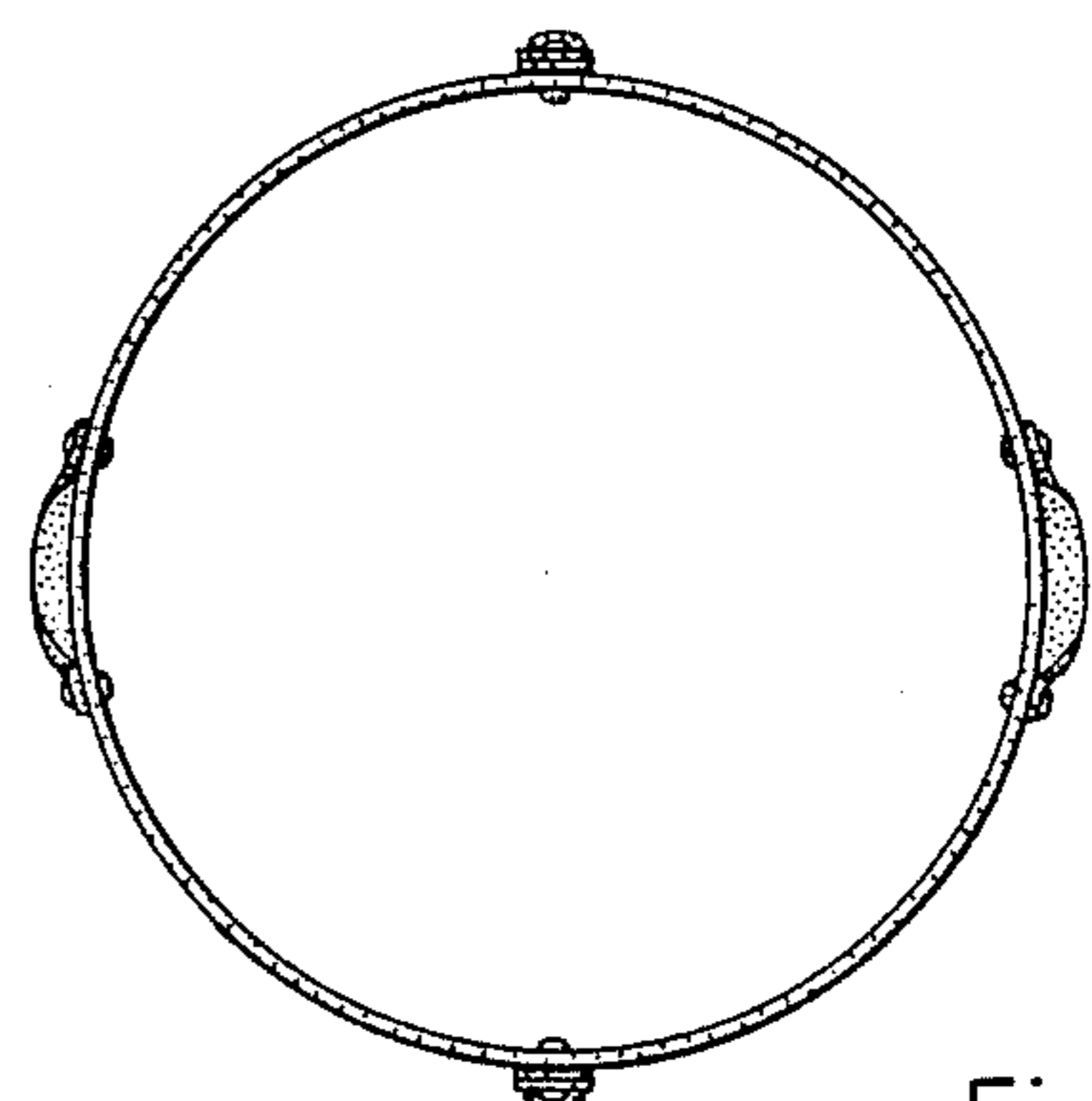

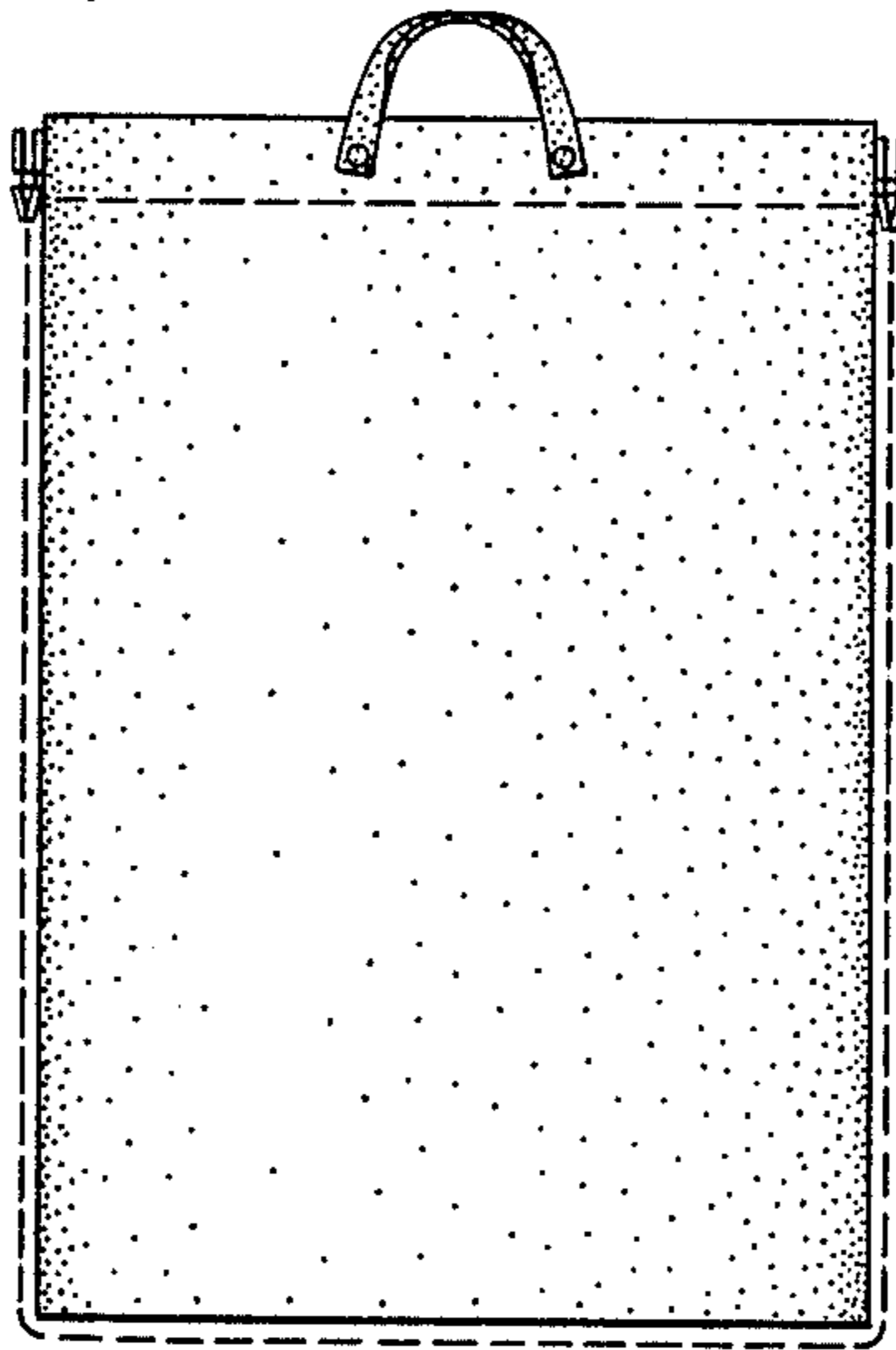
